The ornamental design for an aerial toy, as shown and described.

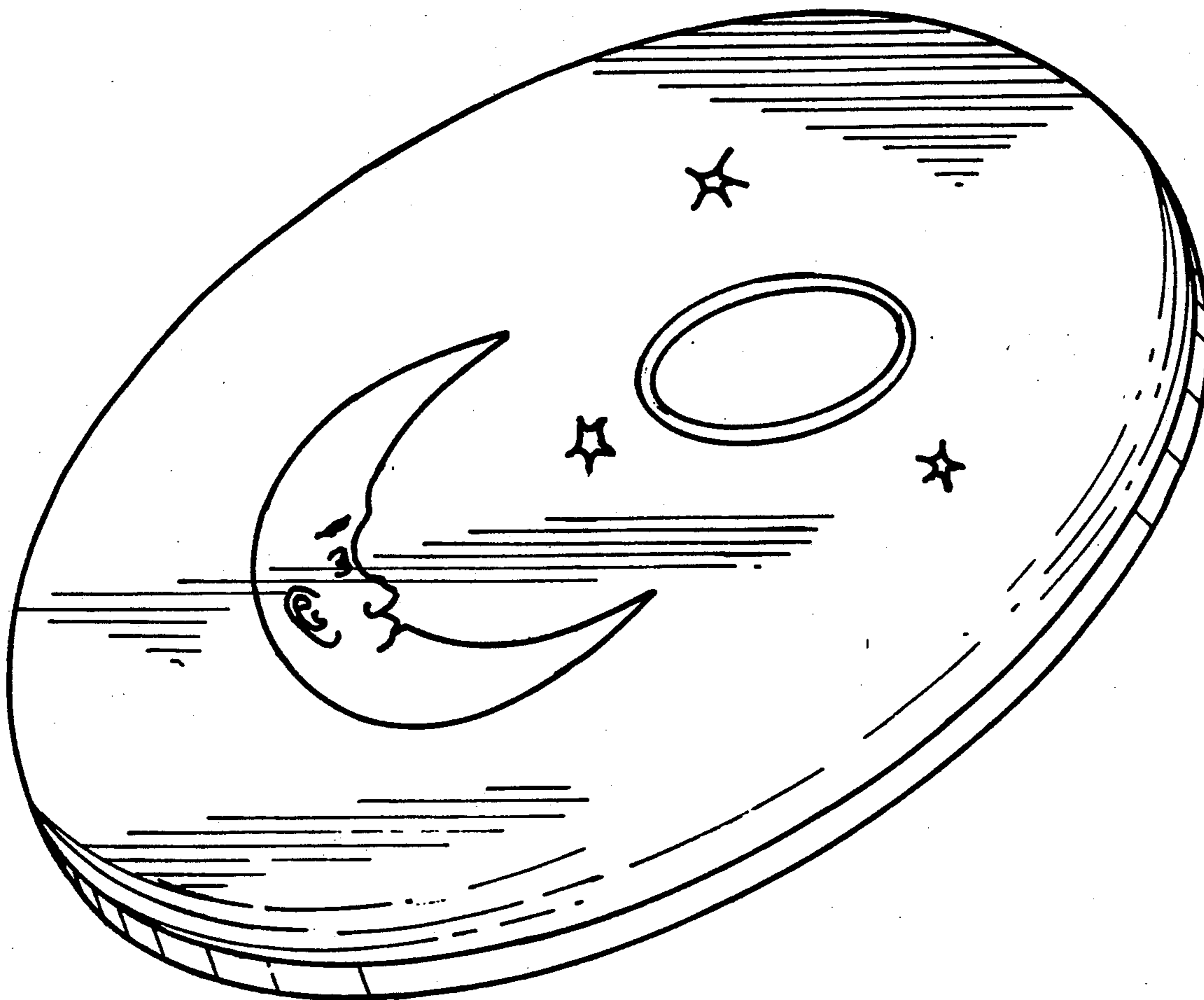
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.



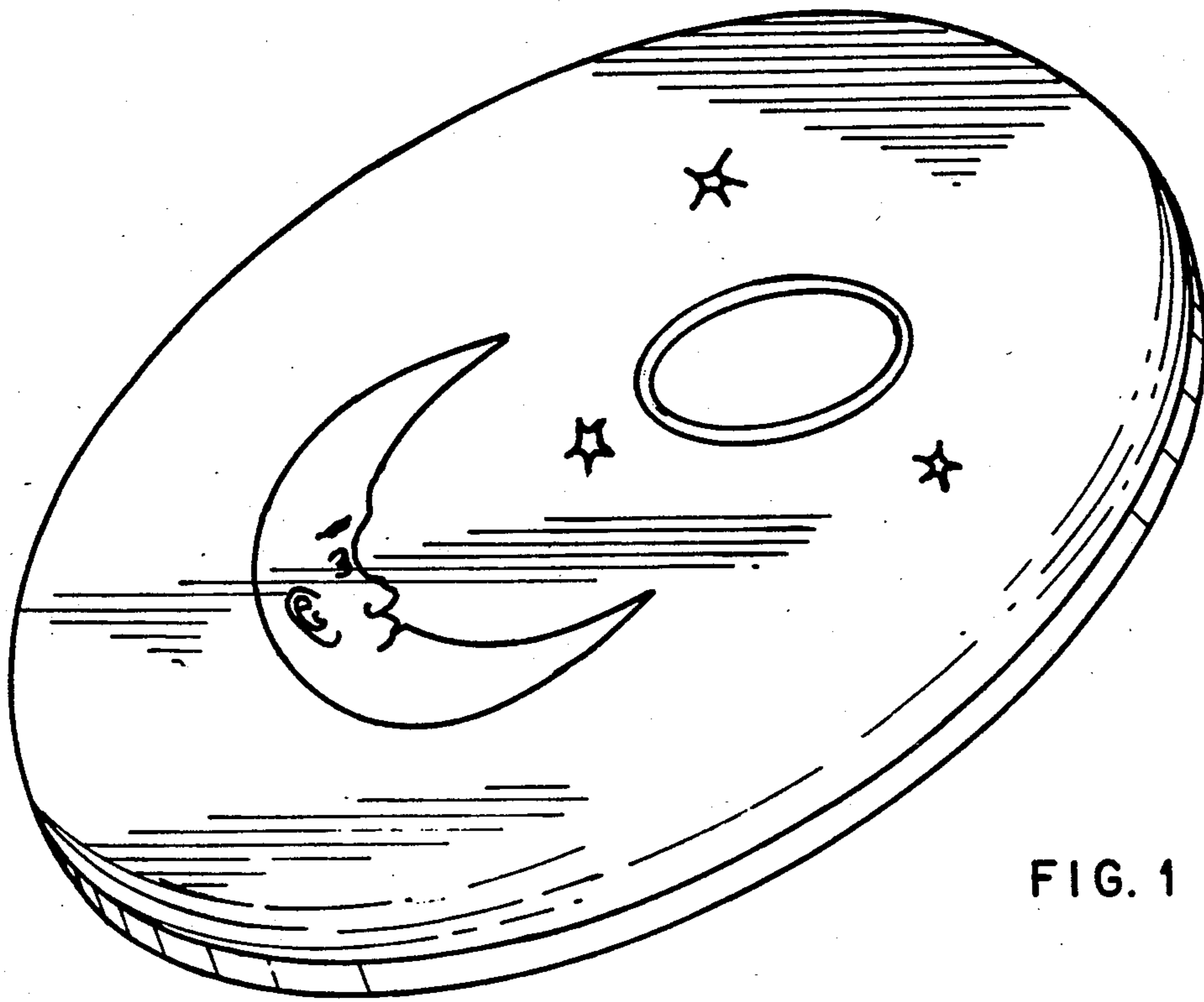

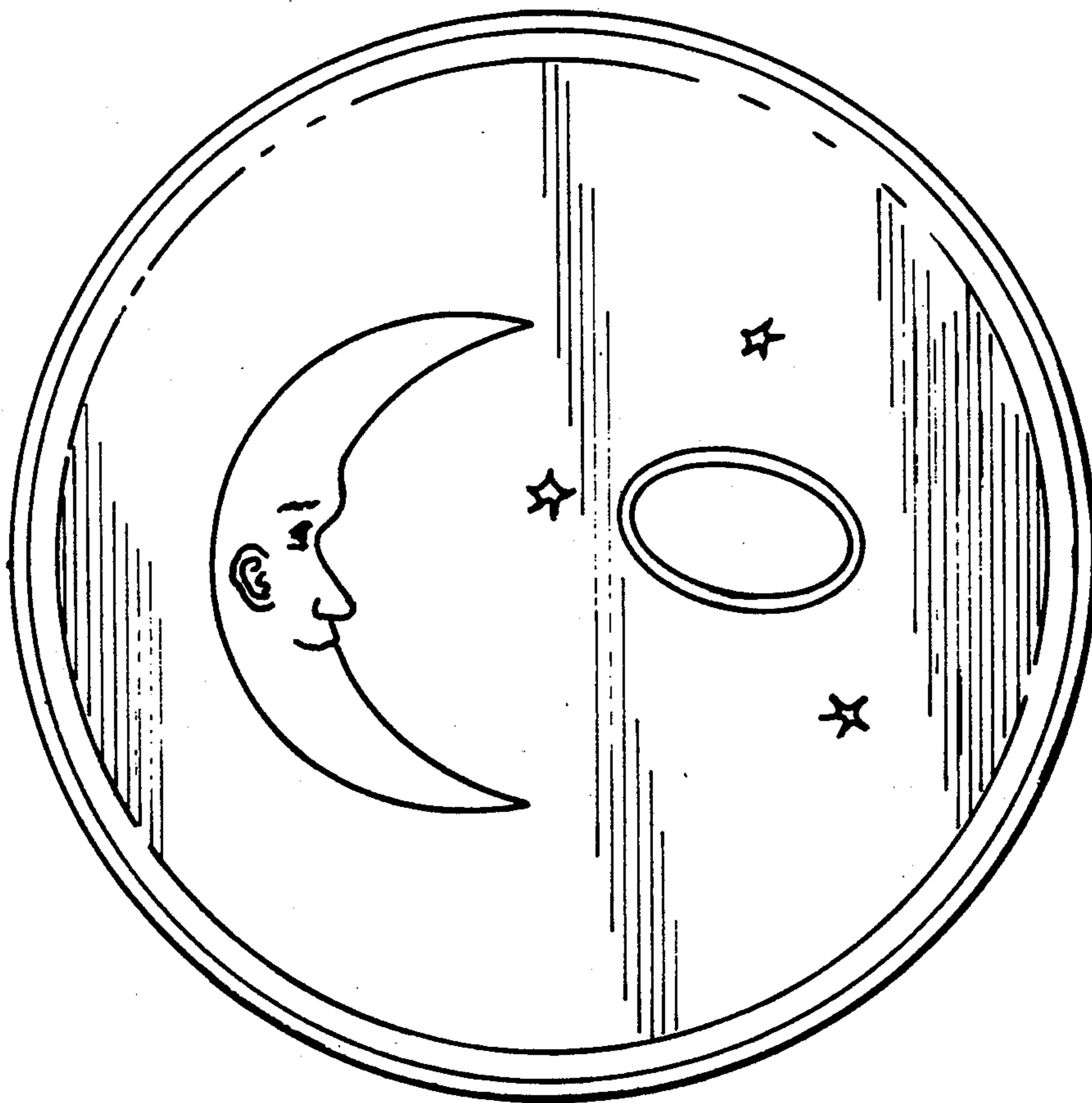

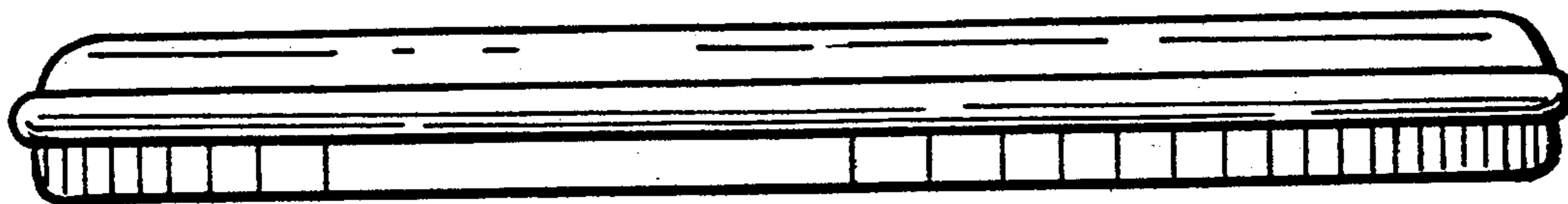

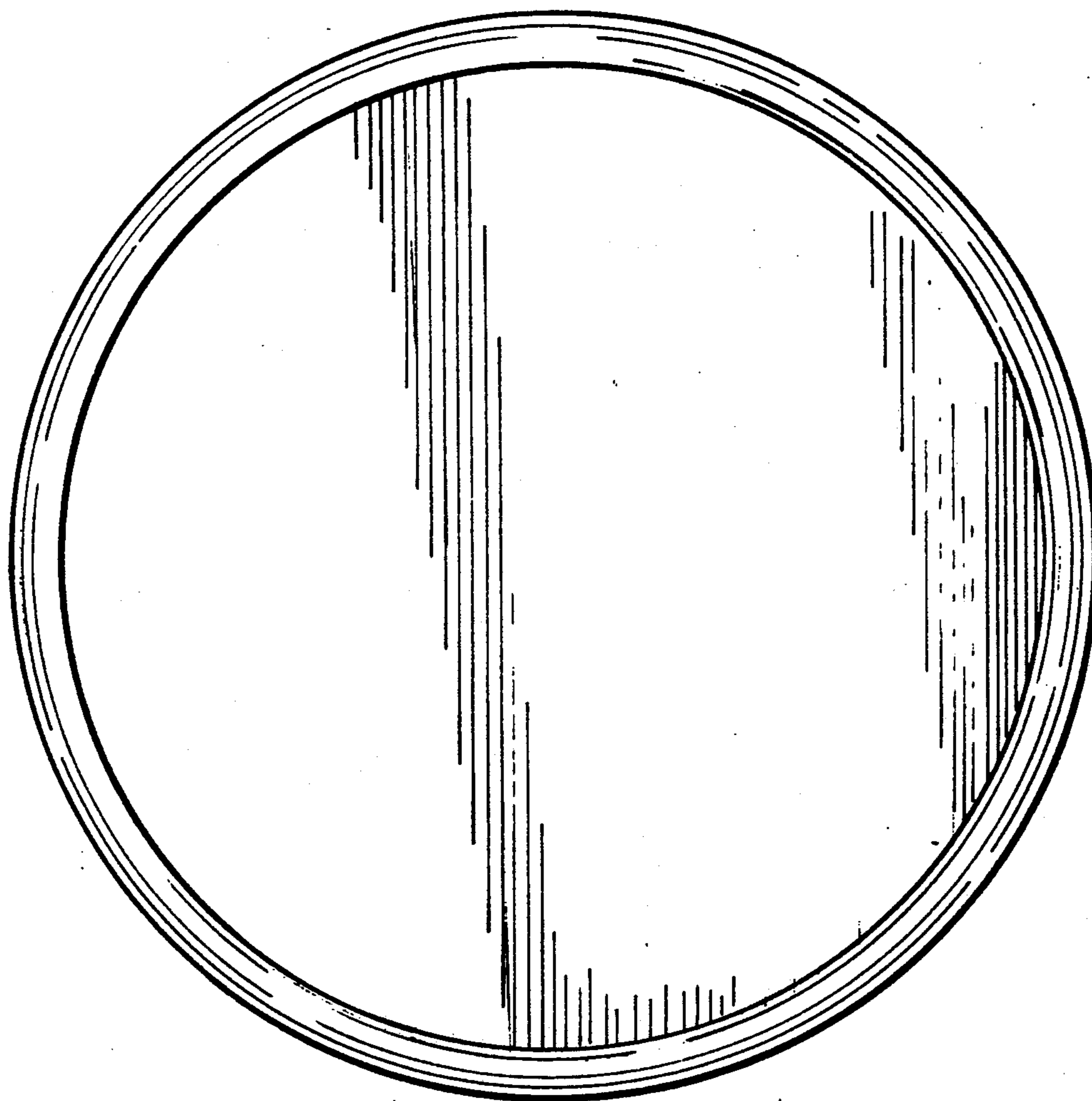
