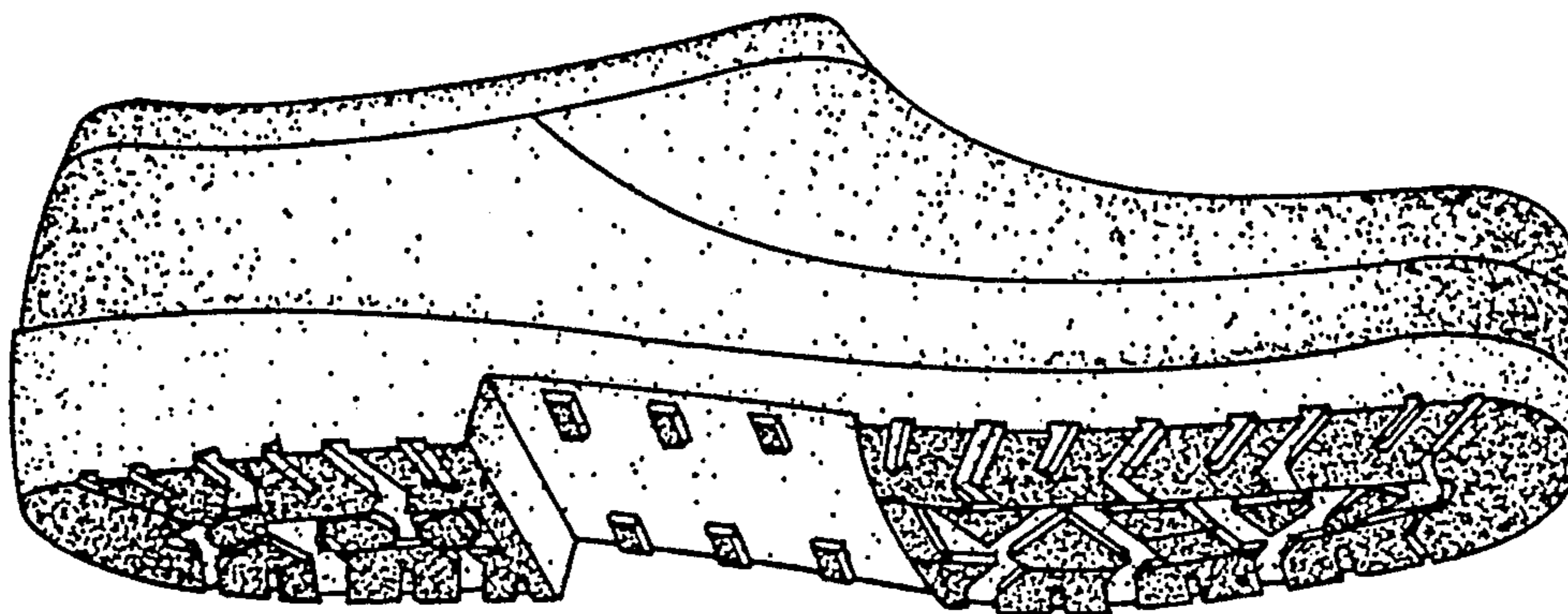

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front and bottom perspective view of a work shoe embodying my new design, the rear being a mirror image of the front;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.



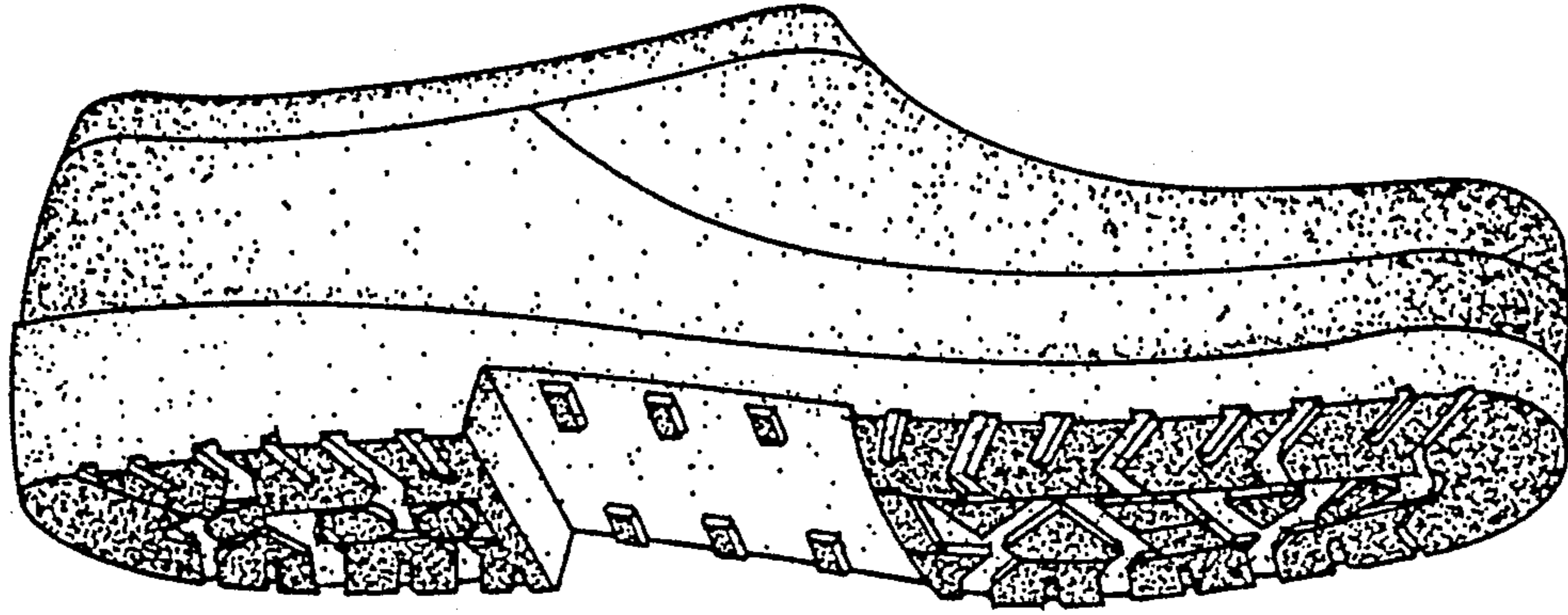

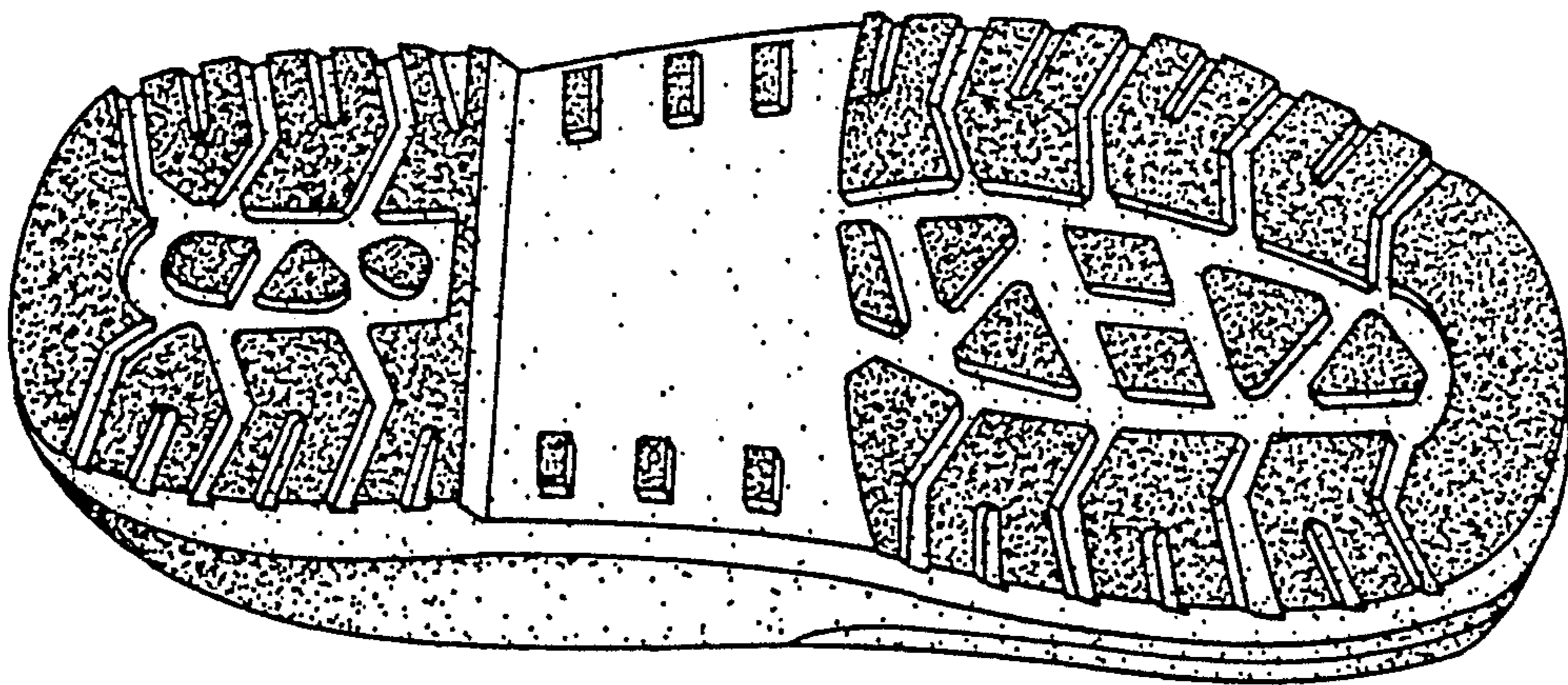

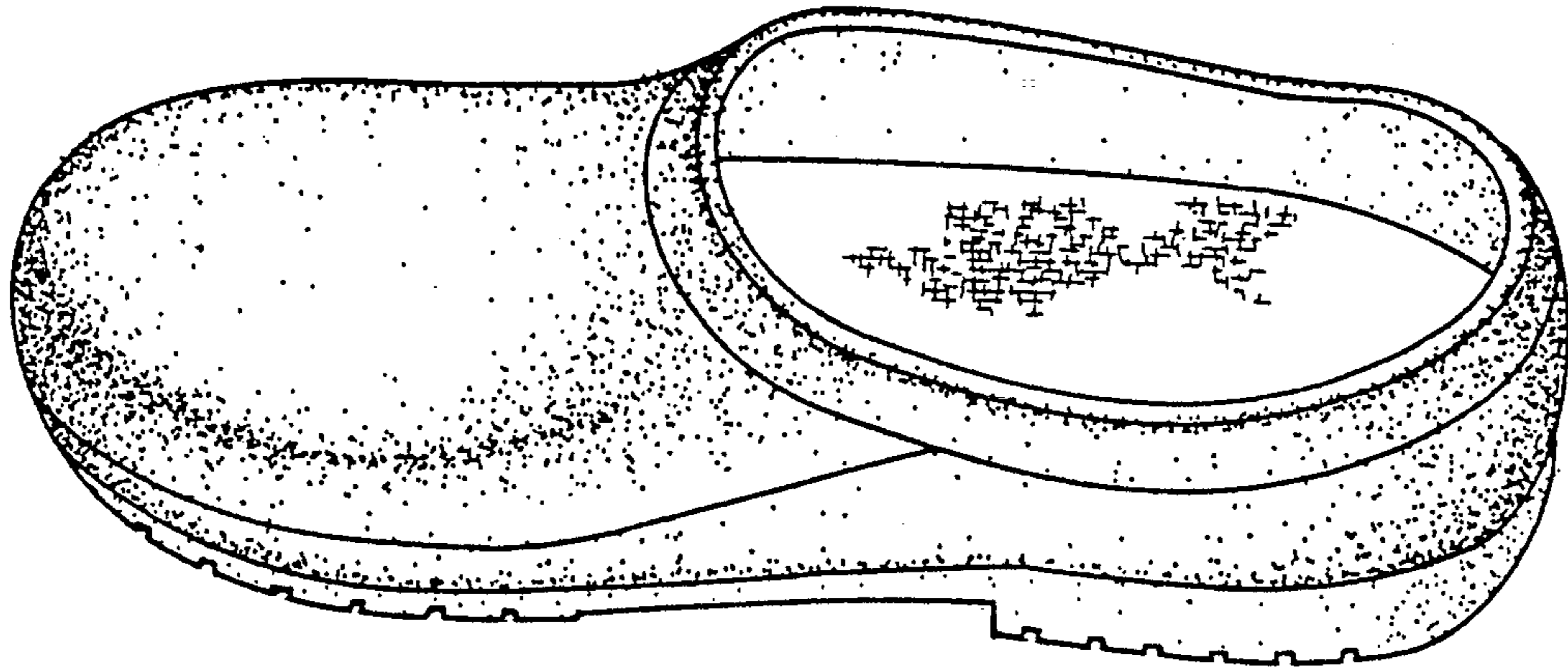

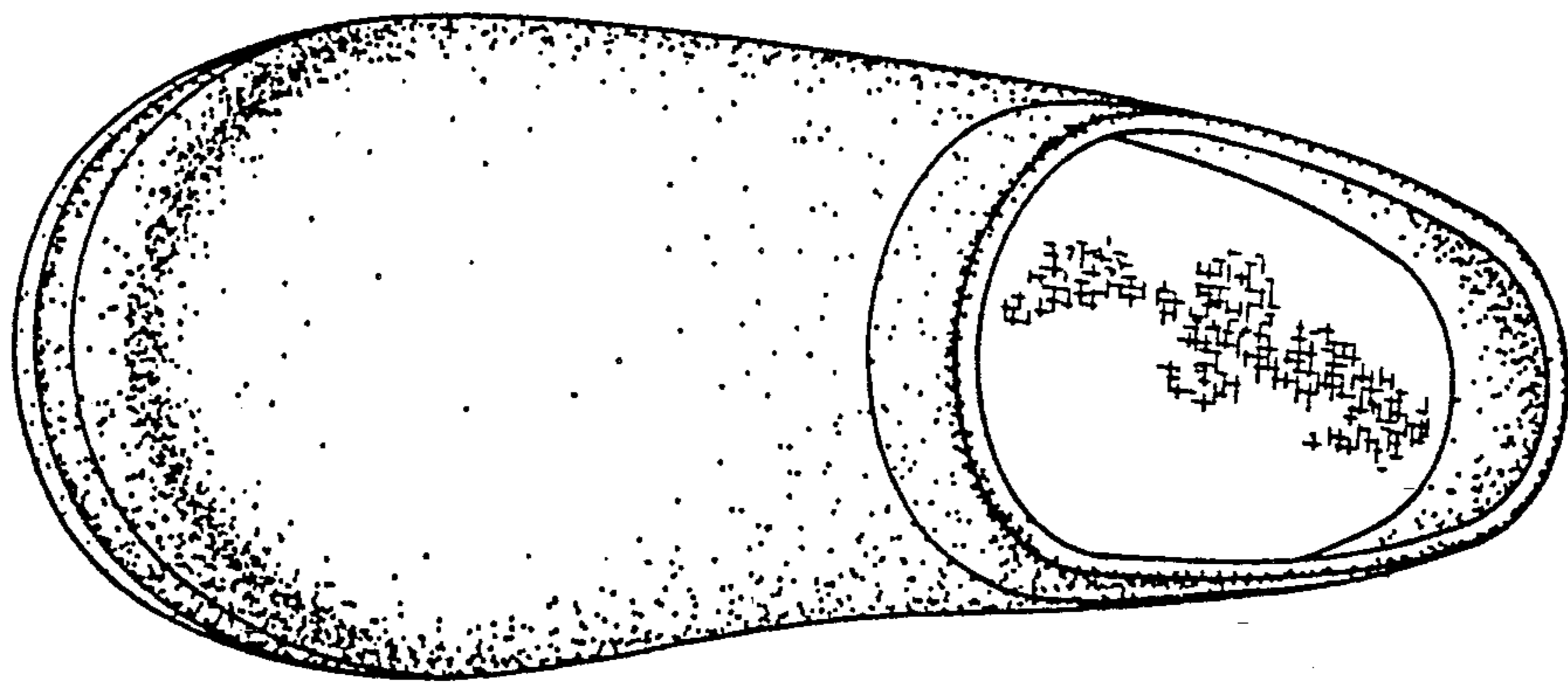
