## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a display for promoting the sales of eyeglasses or the like showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment, wherein the only difference resides in the front panel;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment, wherein the only difference resides in the front panel;


FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment, wherein the only difference resides in the front panel; and,

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment, wherein the only difference resides in the front panel.









***FIG 3******FIG 4******FIG 5******FIG 6******FIG 7***
