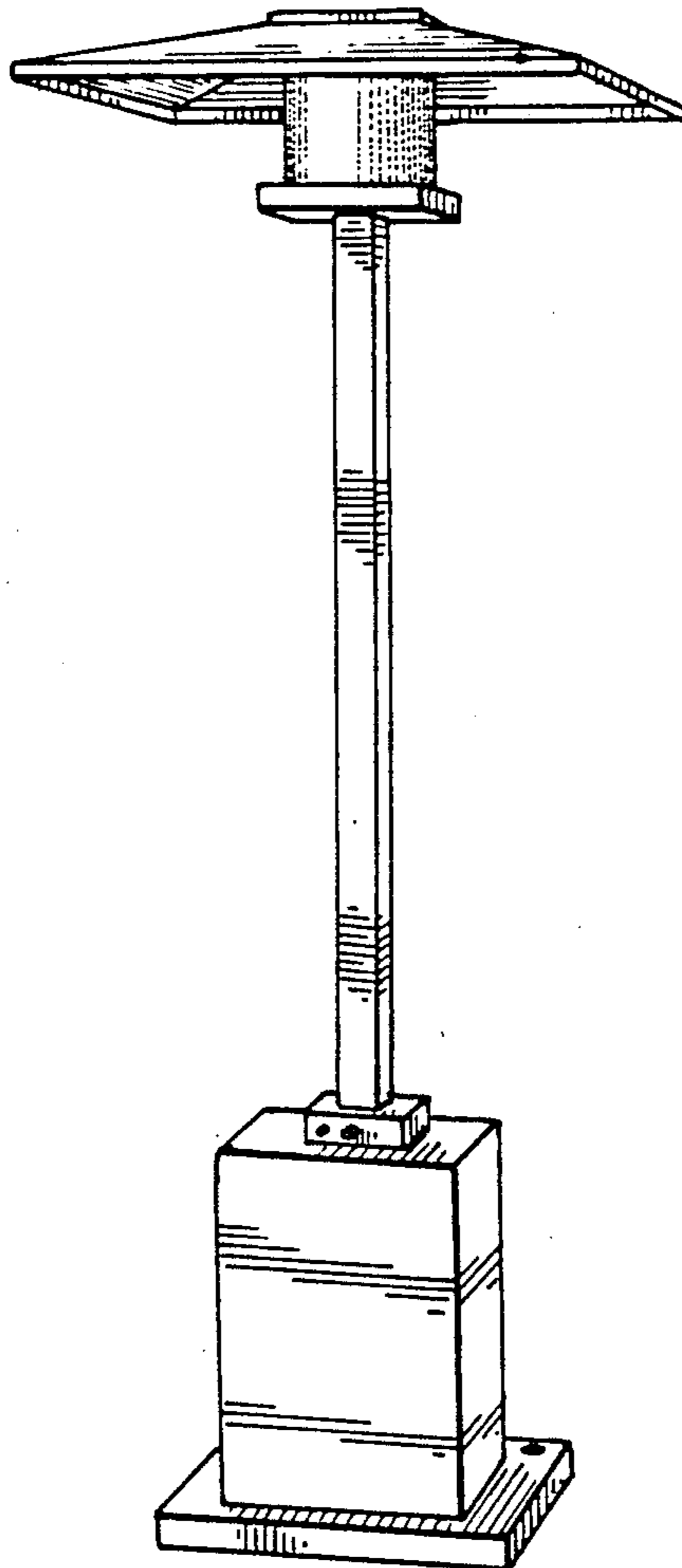

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an outdoor heater, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of an outdoor heater showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown; FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of an outdoor heater showing a second embodiment of my new design, the sole difference being the configuration of the base.



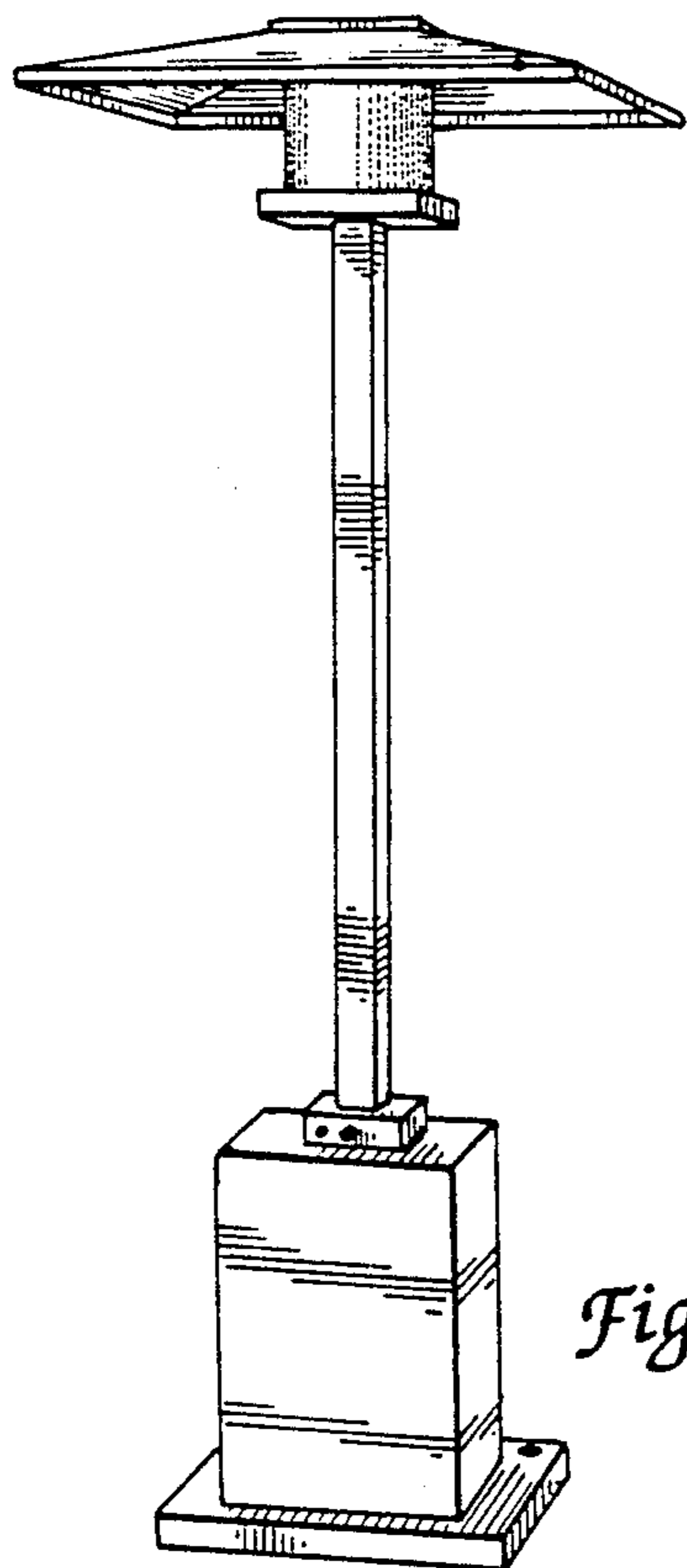

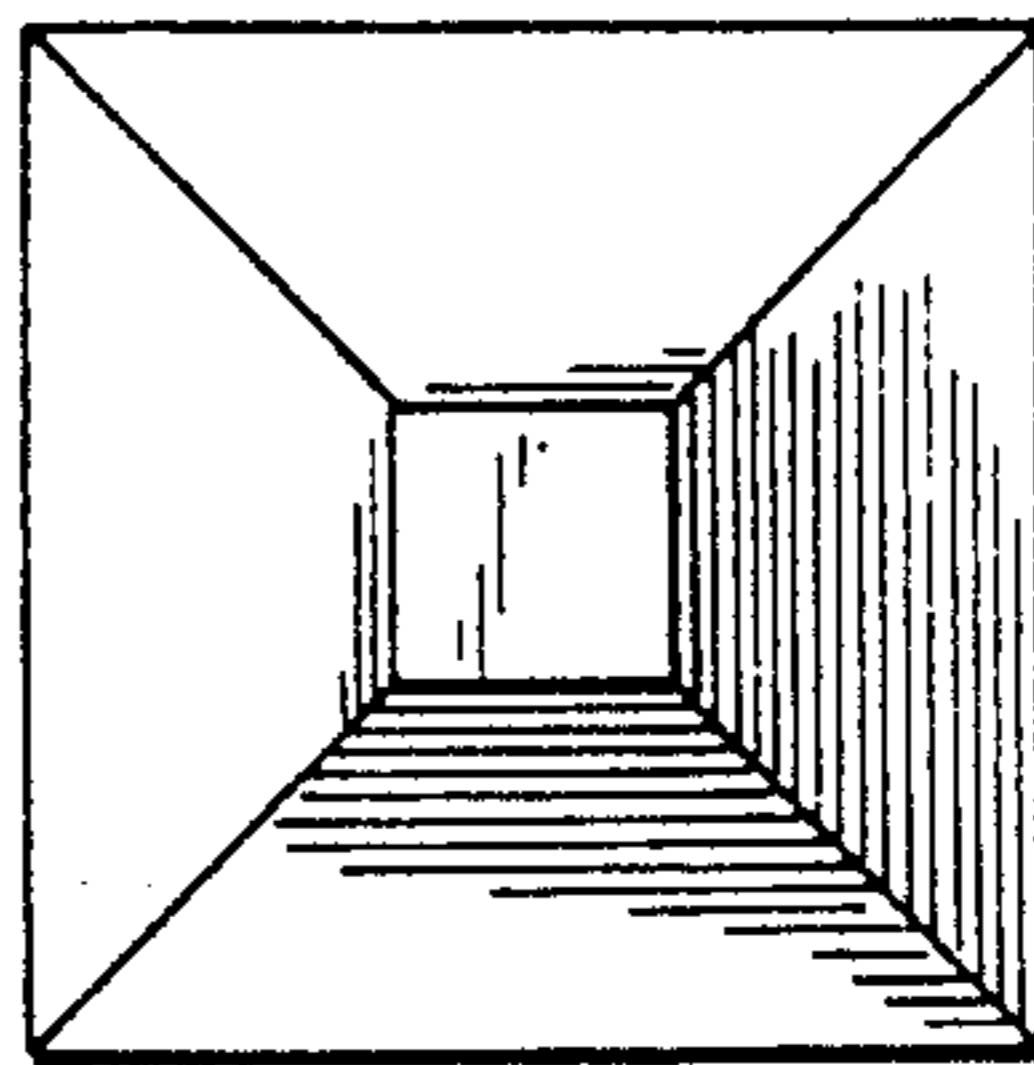

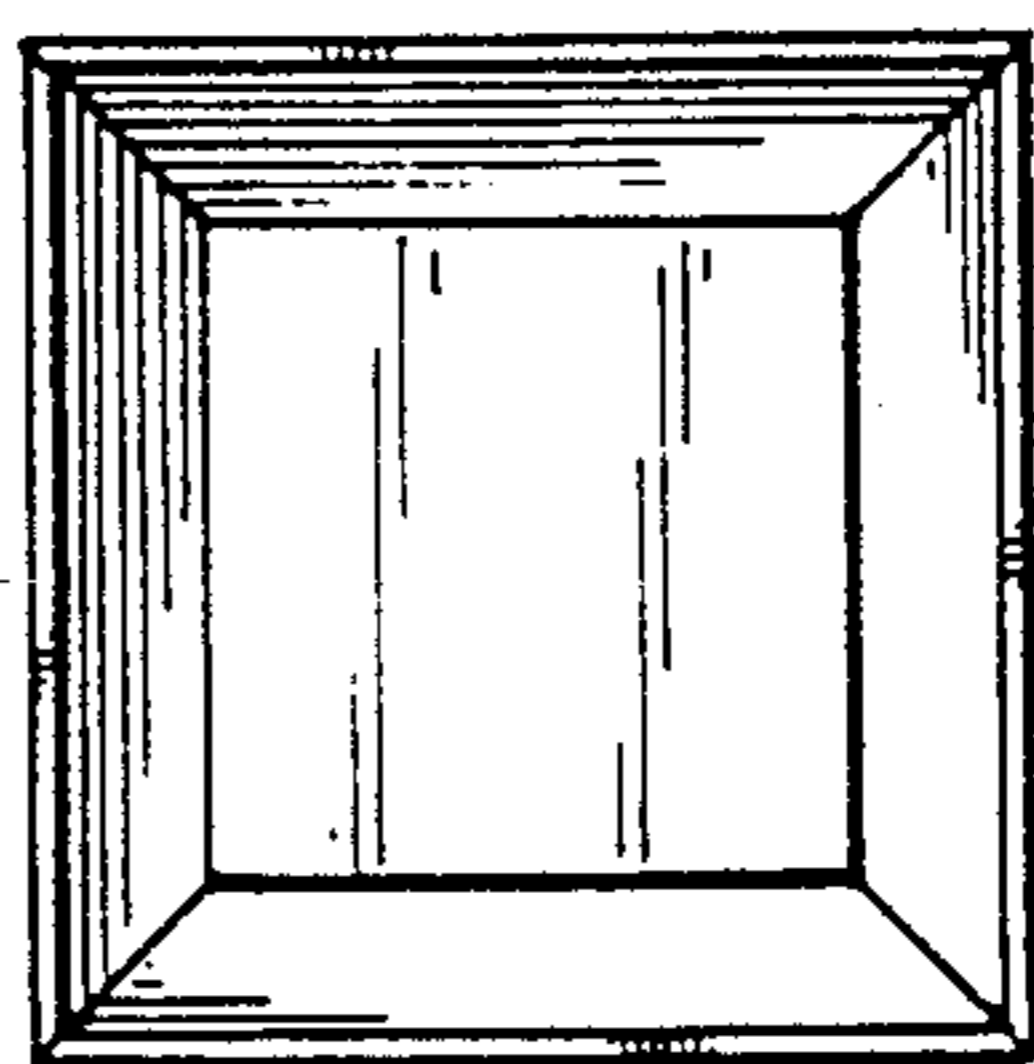

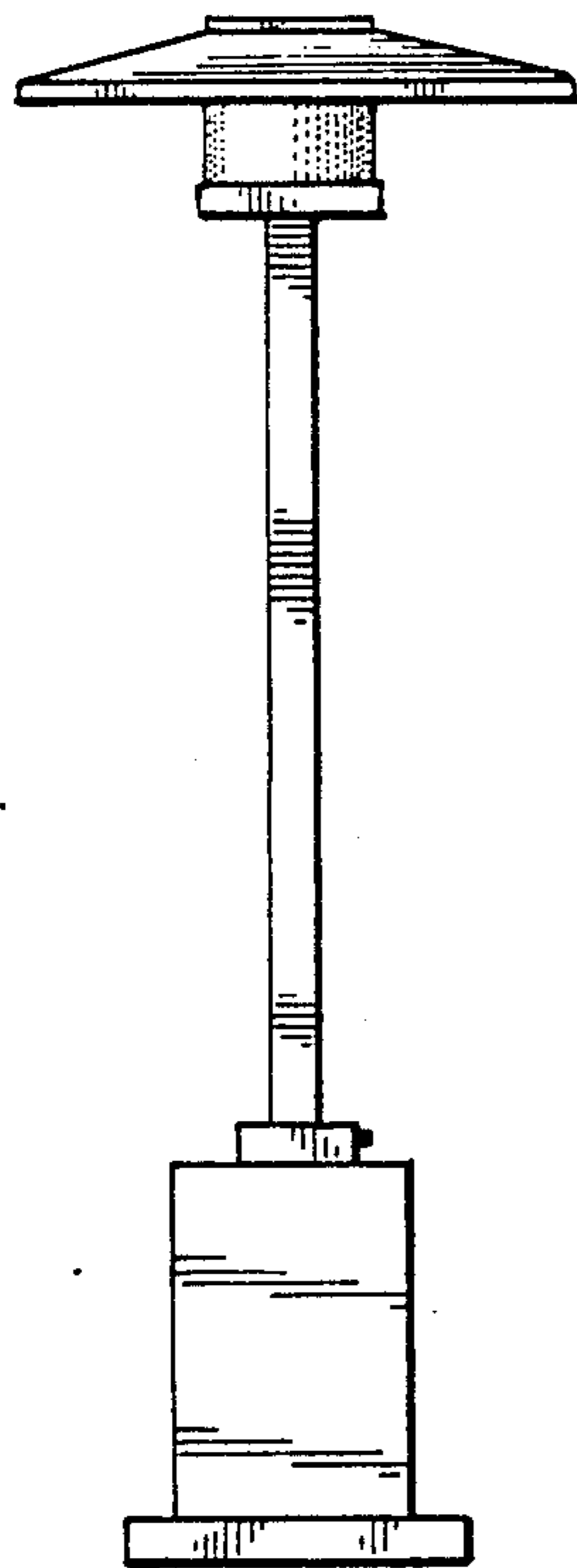

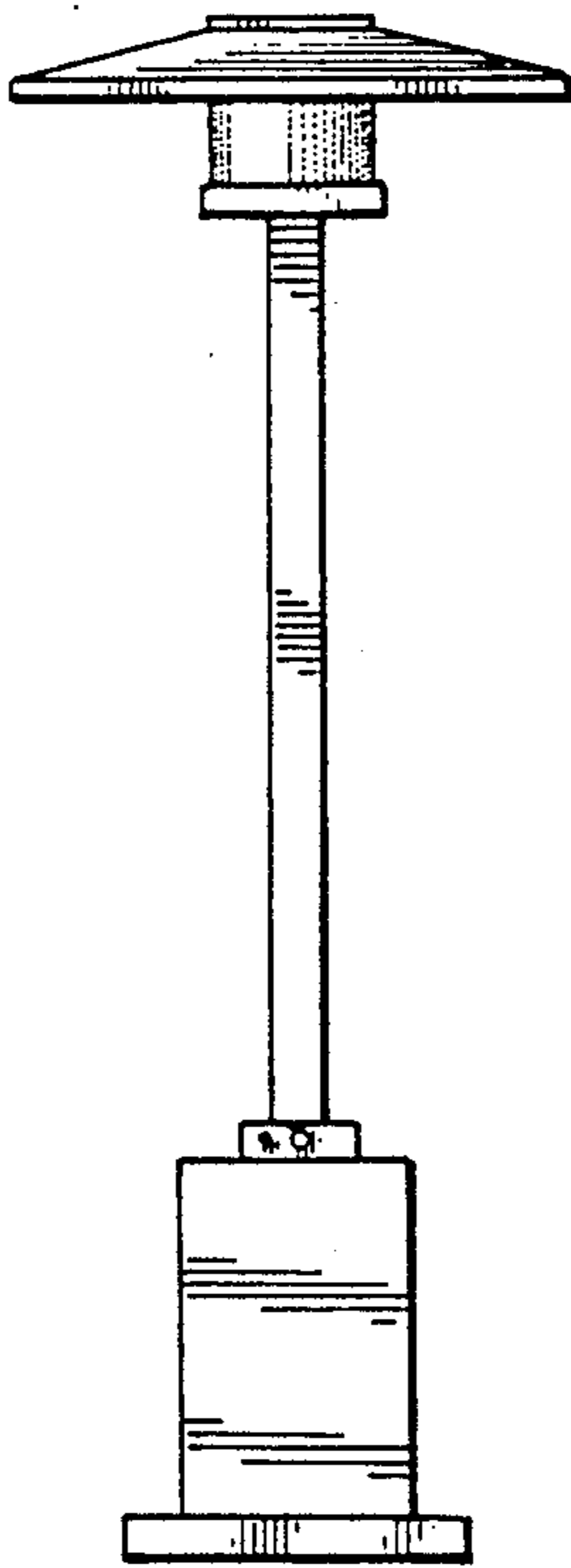

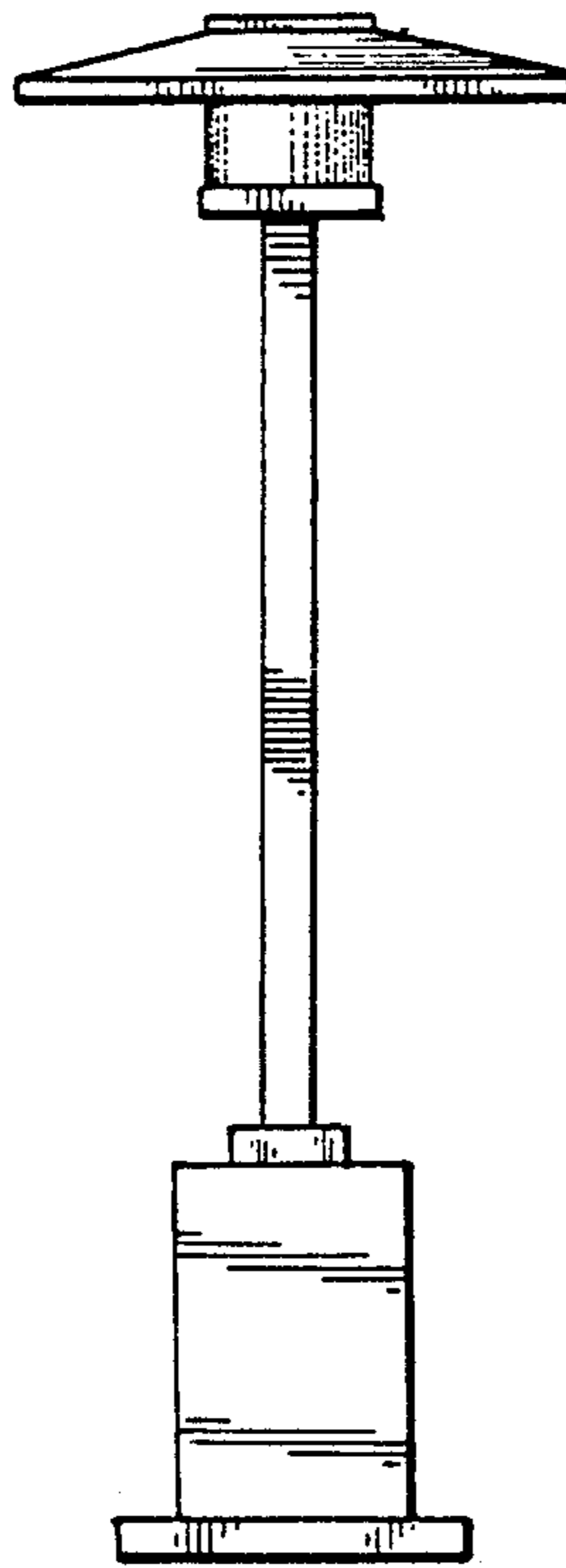

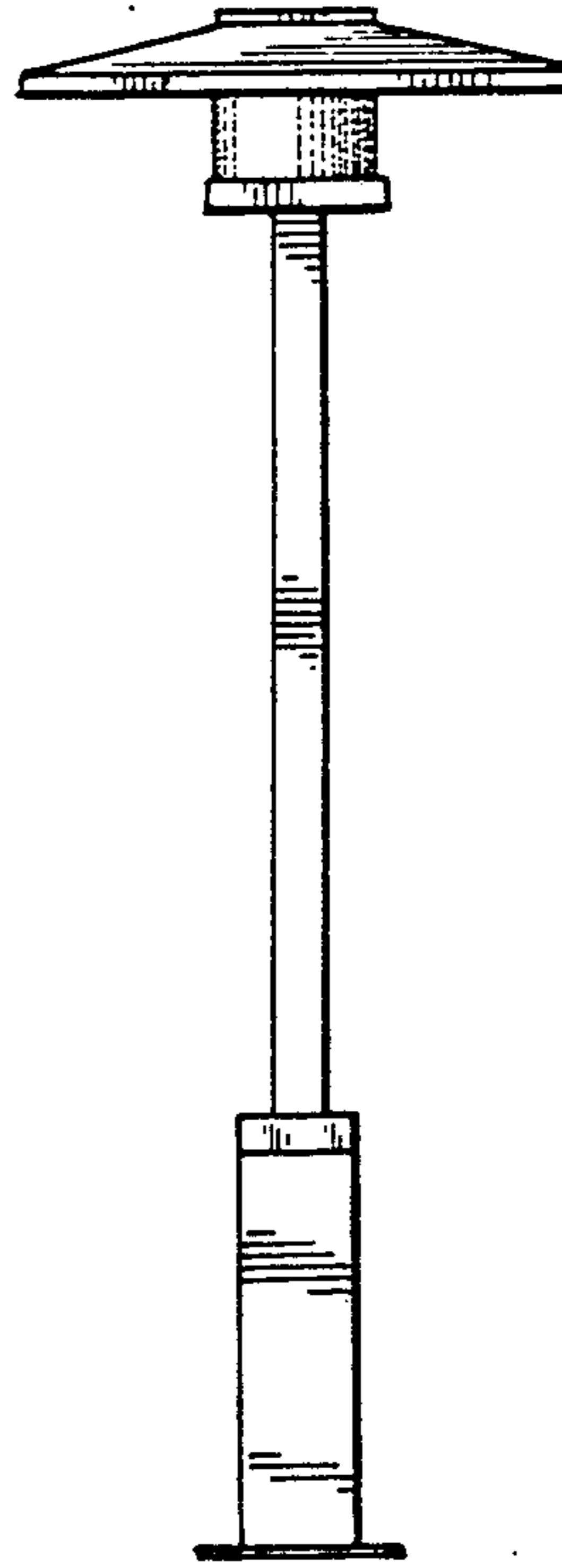
