[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined digital clock and card holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined digital clock and card holder showing my new design. The broken—line showings of FIGS. 1 and 7 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof. The dominant features of my design reside in those portions of the drawings shown by means of full lines.

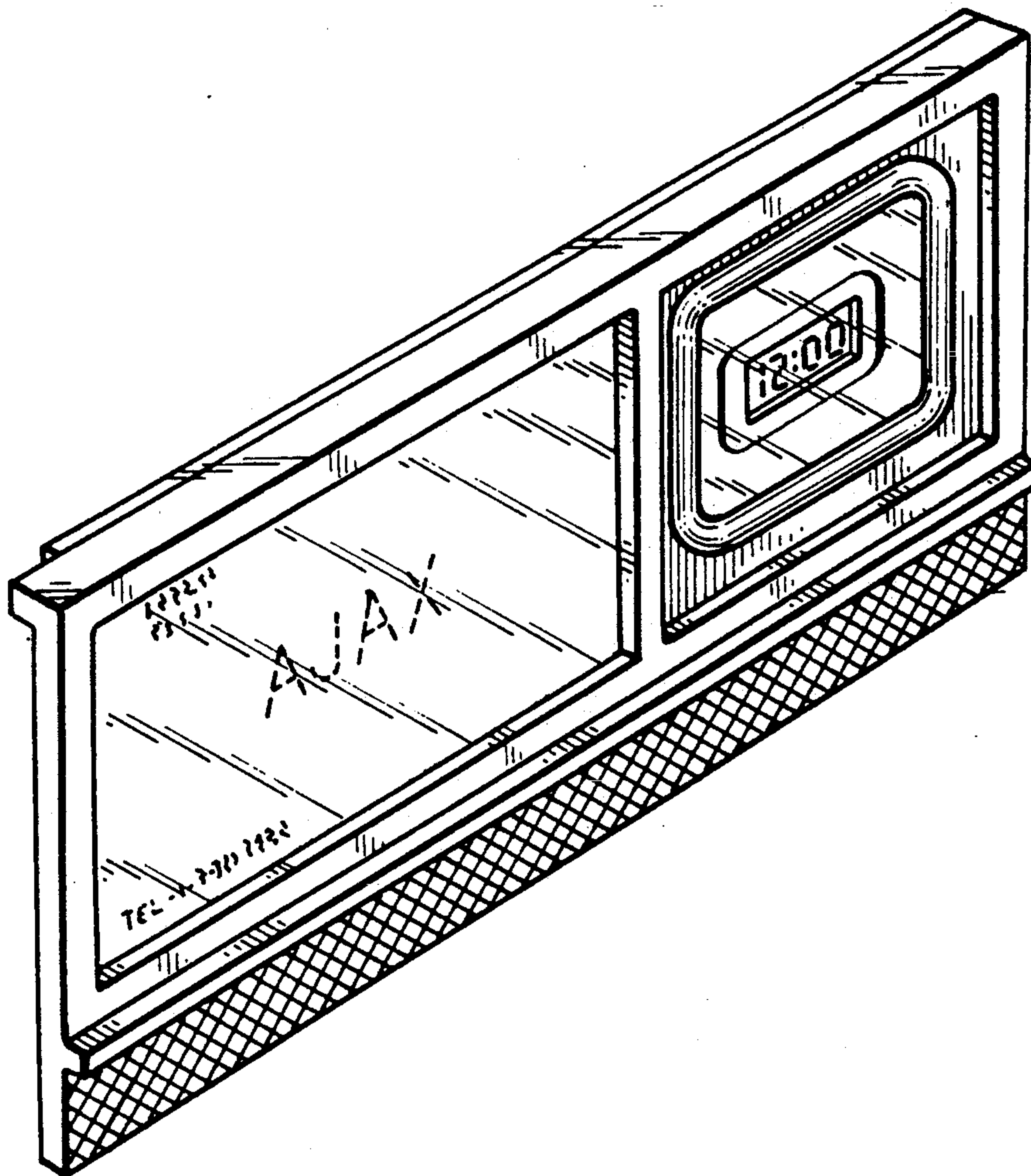

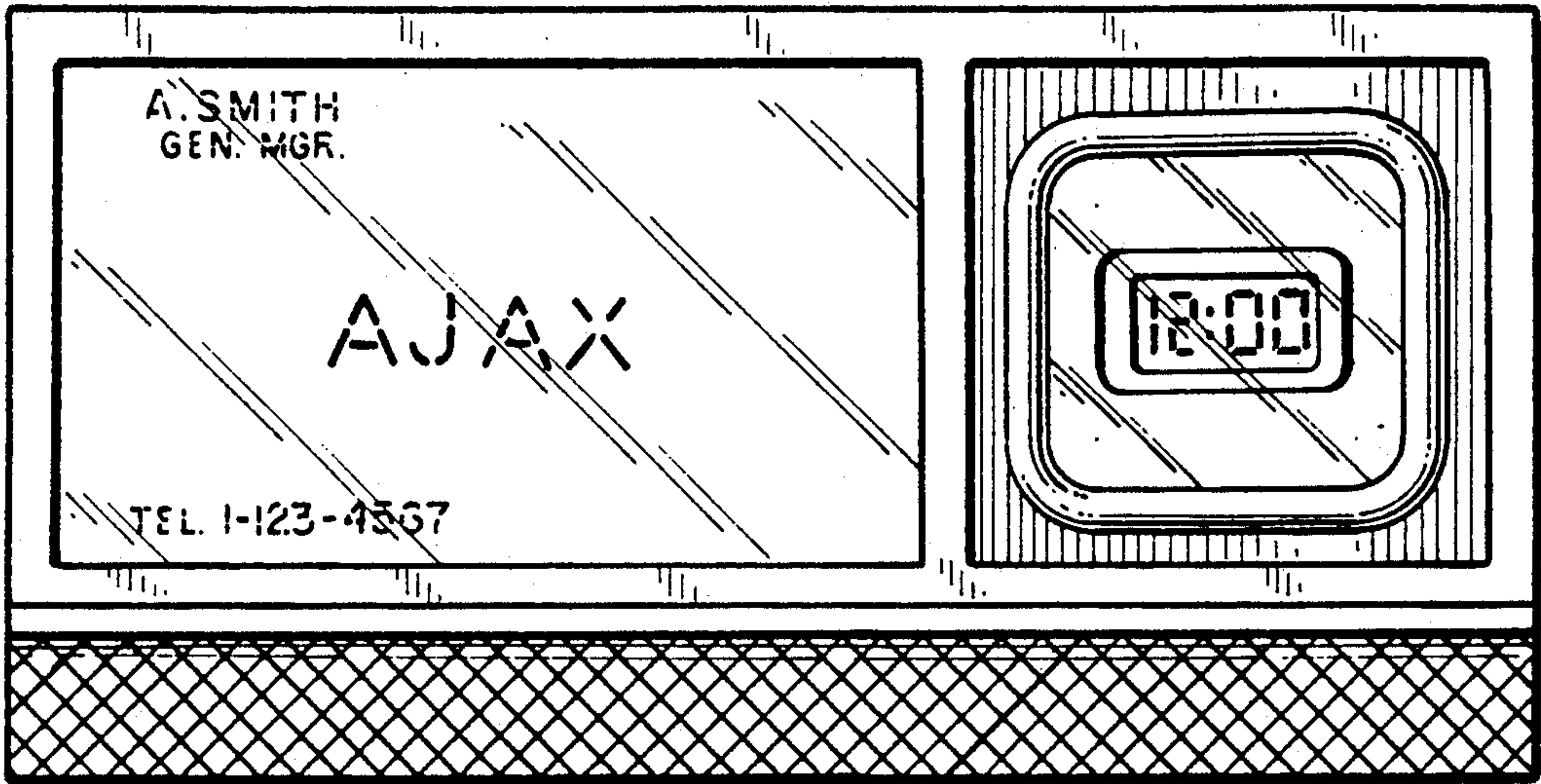

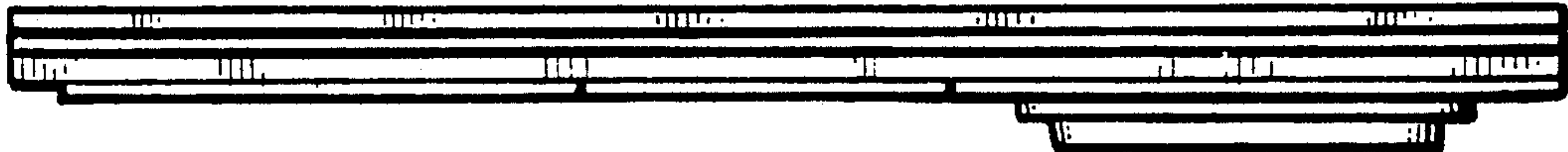

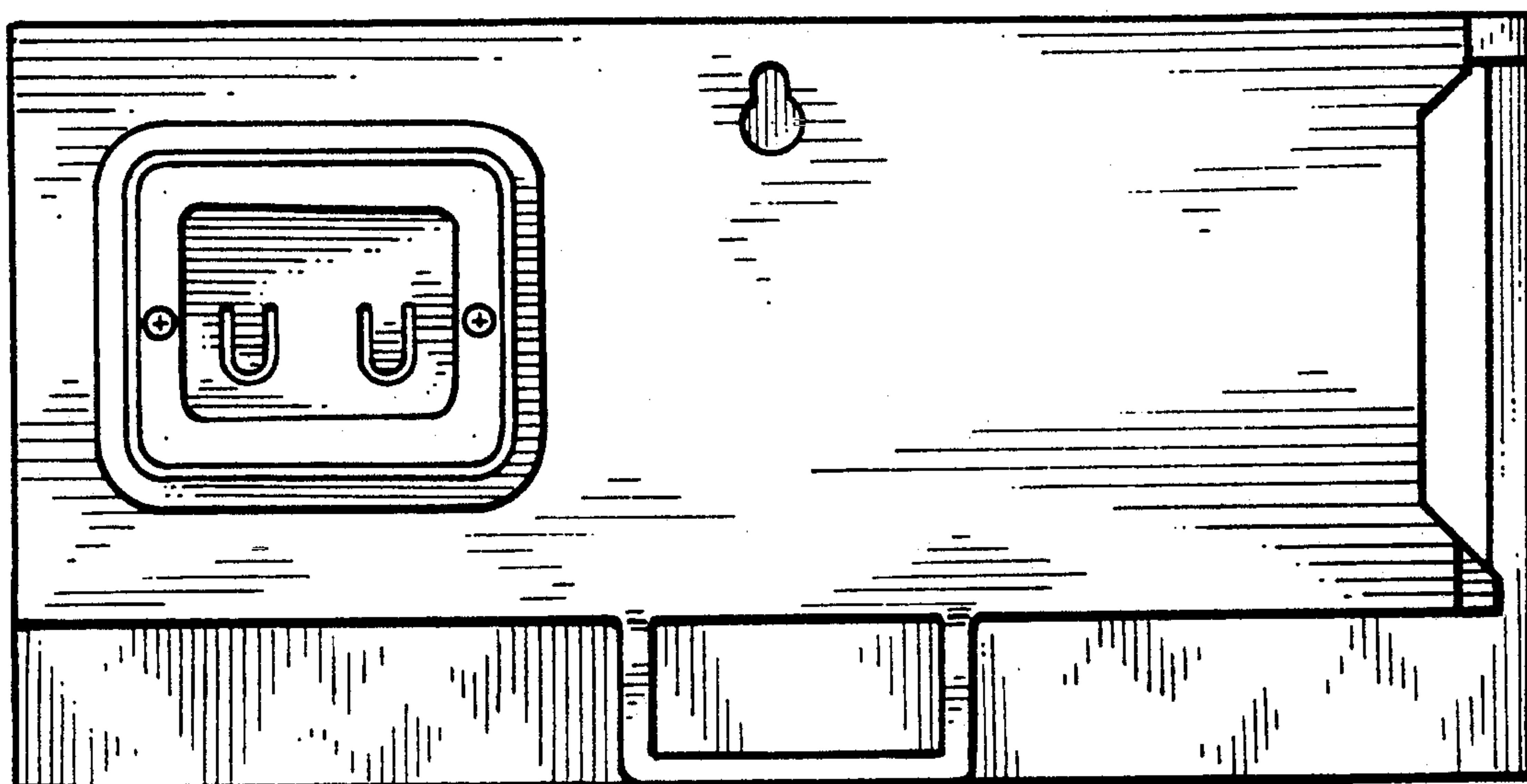

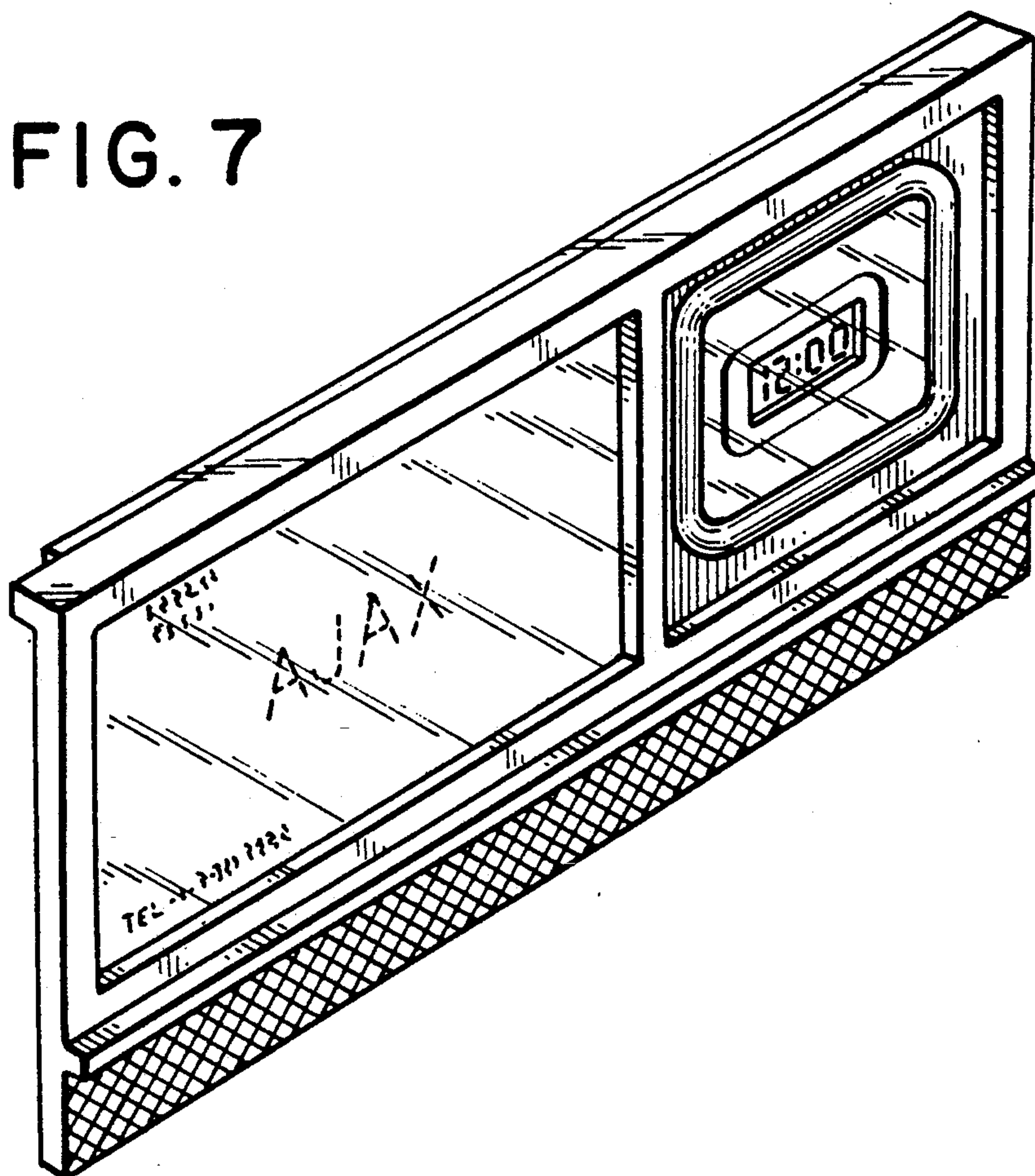
