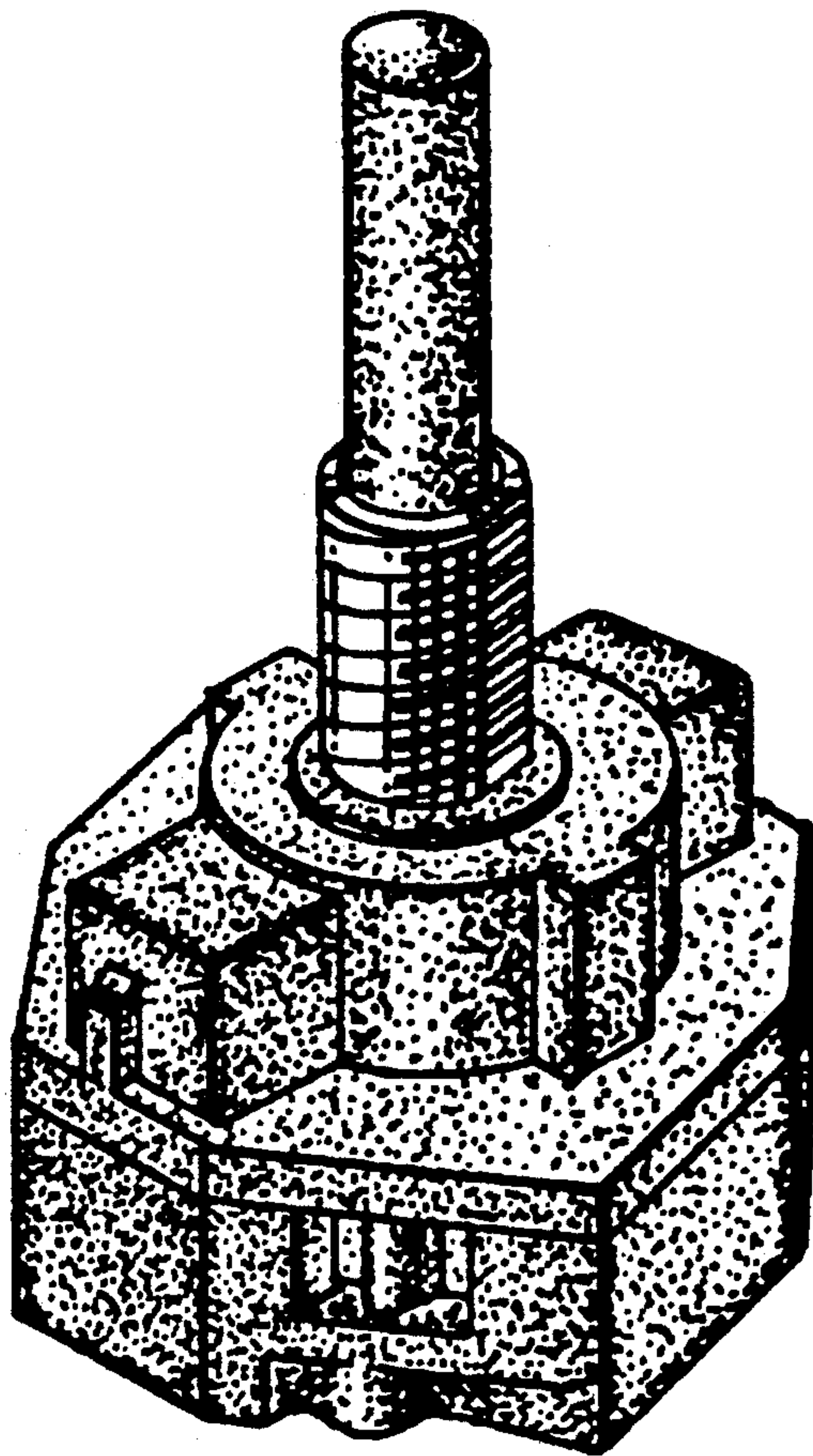

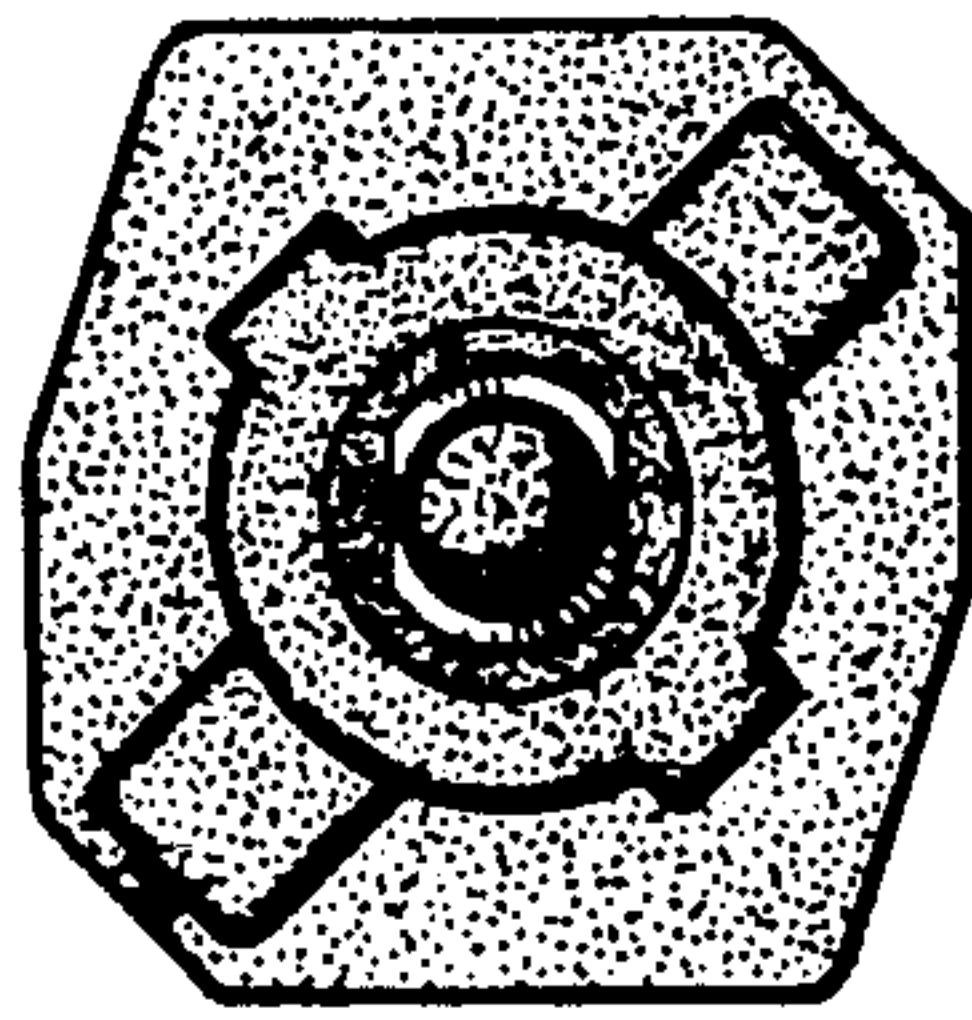
## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a switch housing, as shown and described.

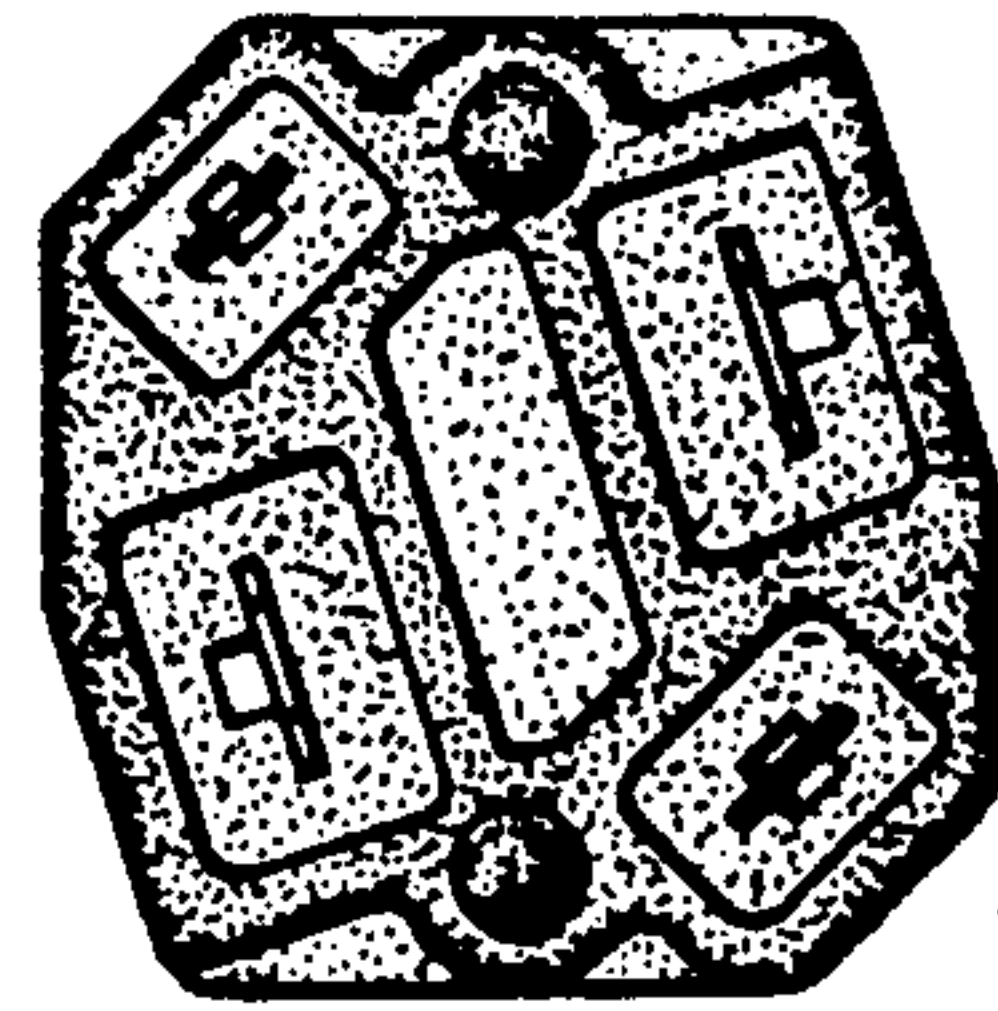
## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a front and upper left perspective view thereof.

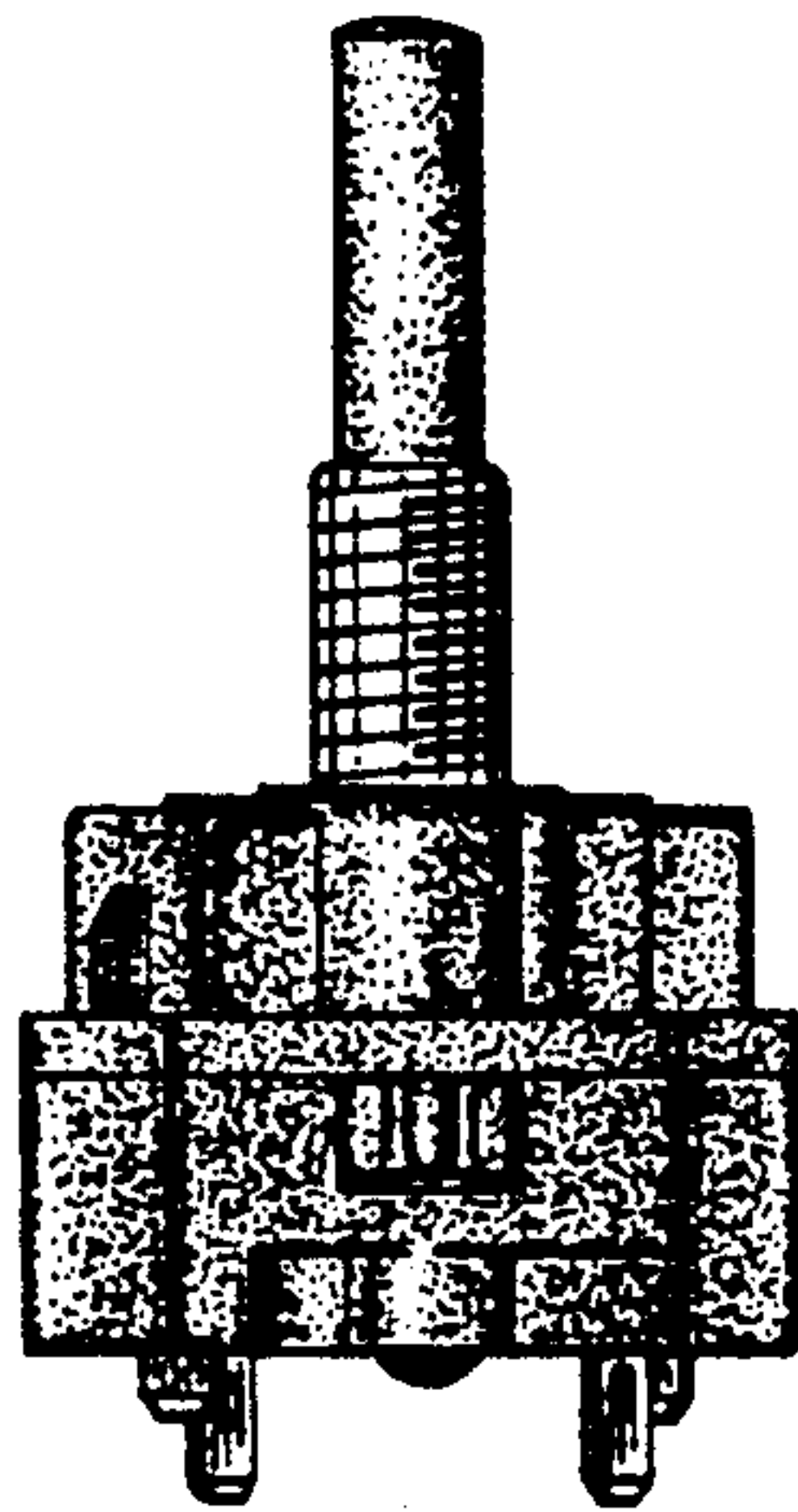




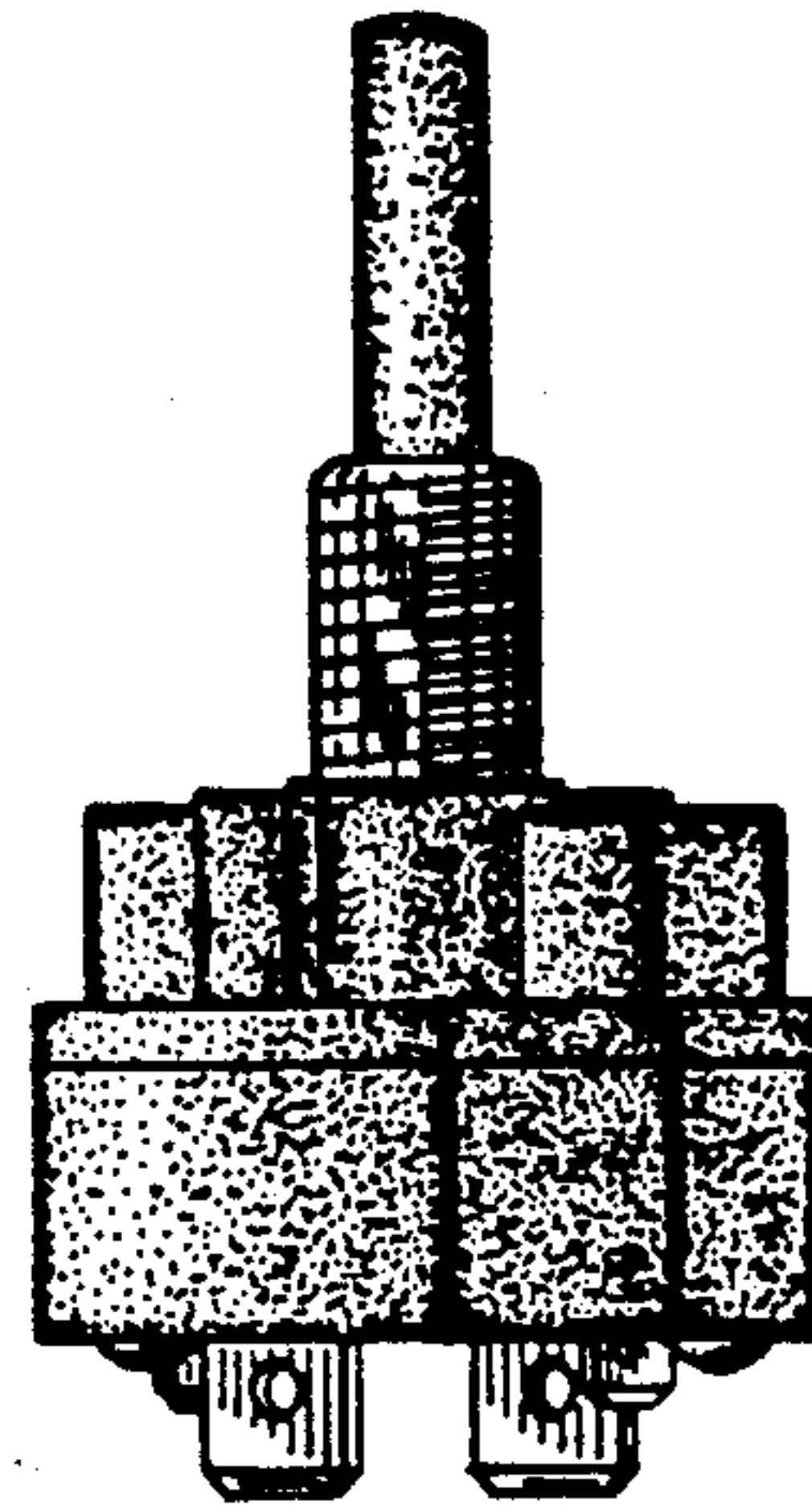

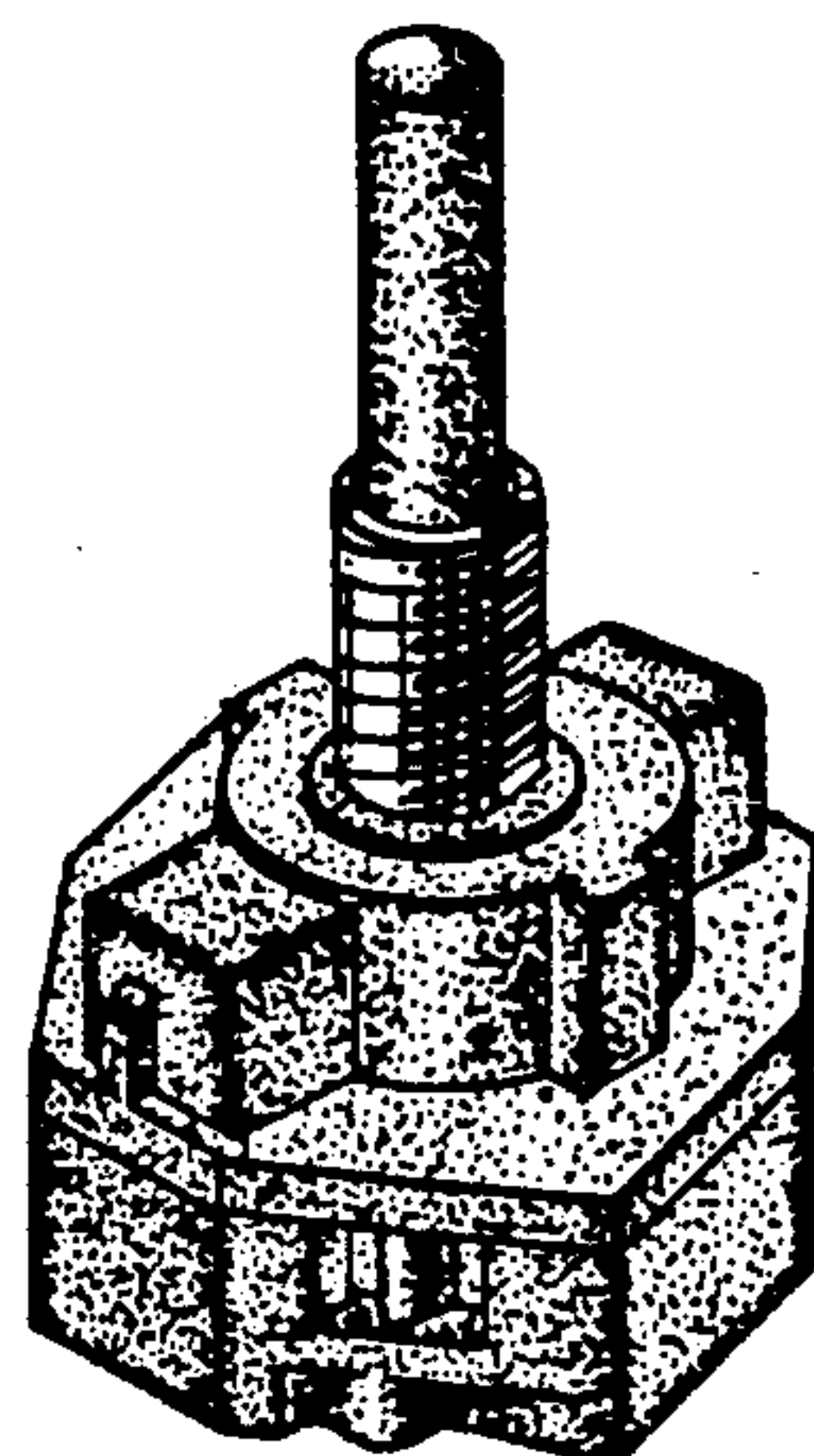
