FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image;

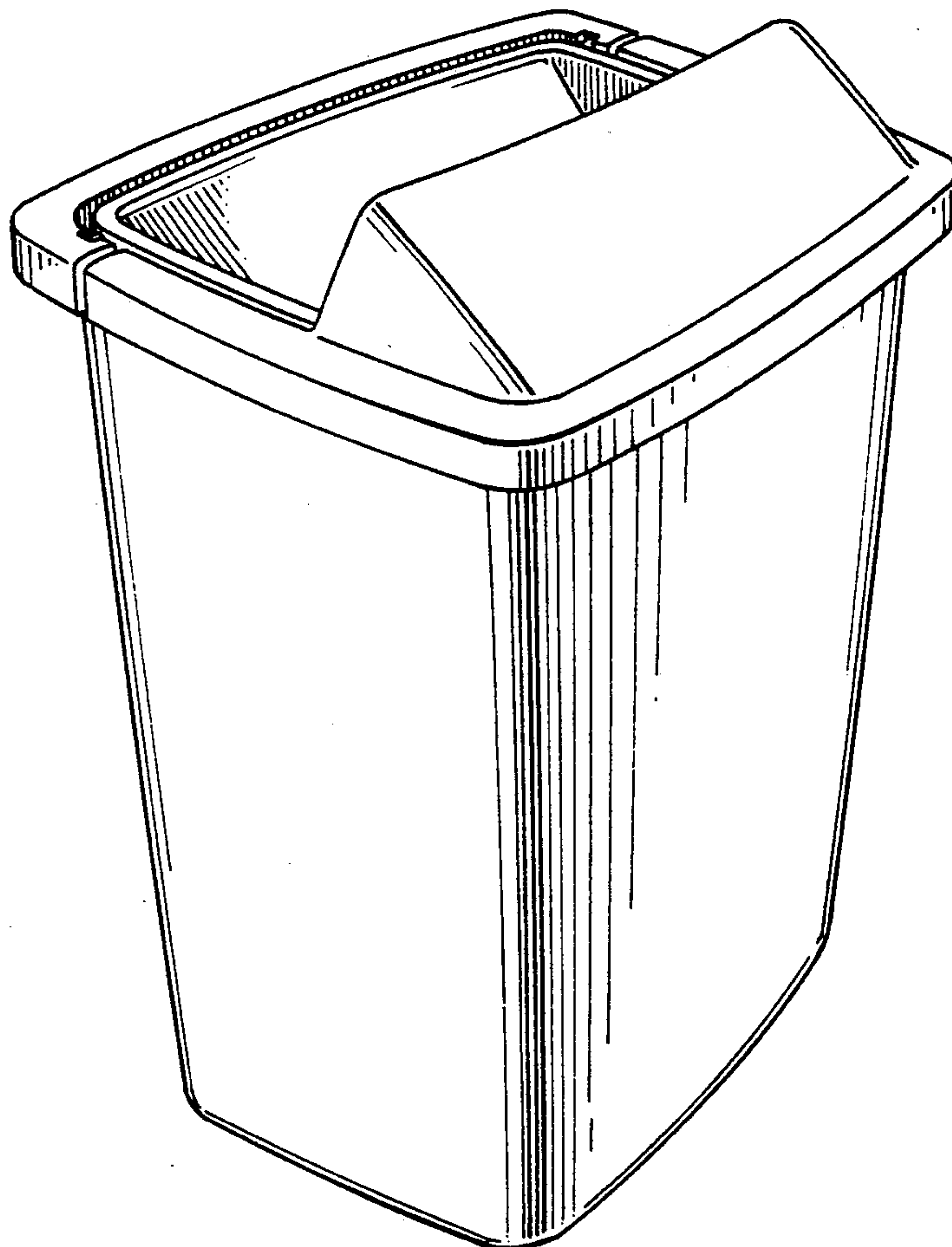
FIG. 4 is front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



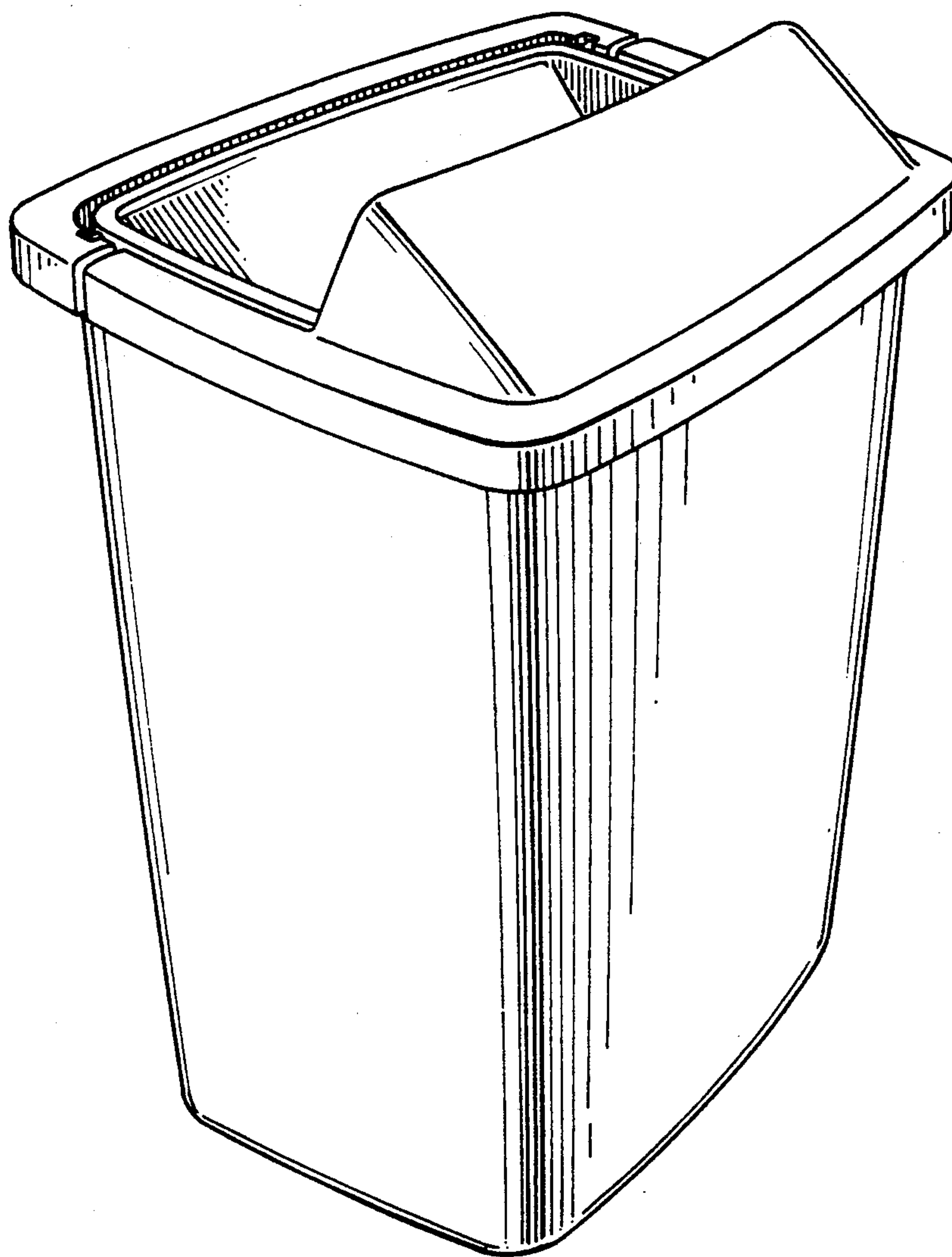

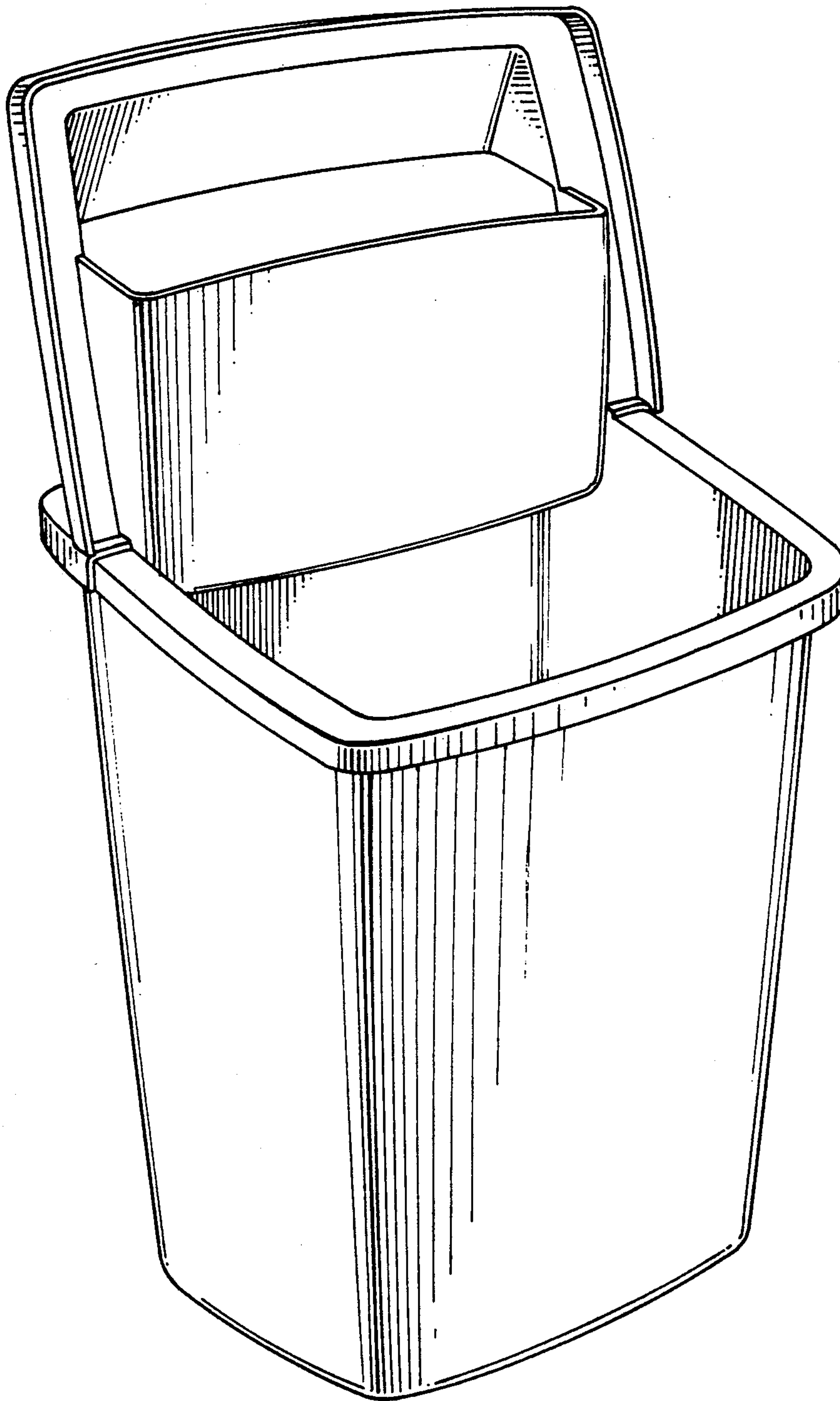

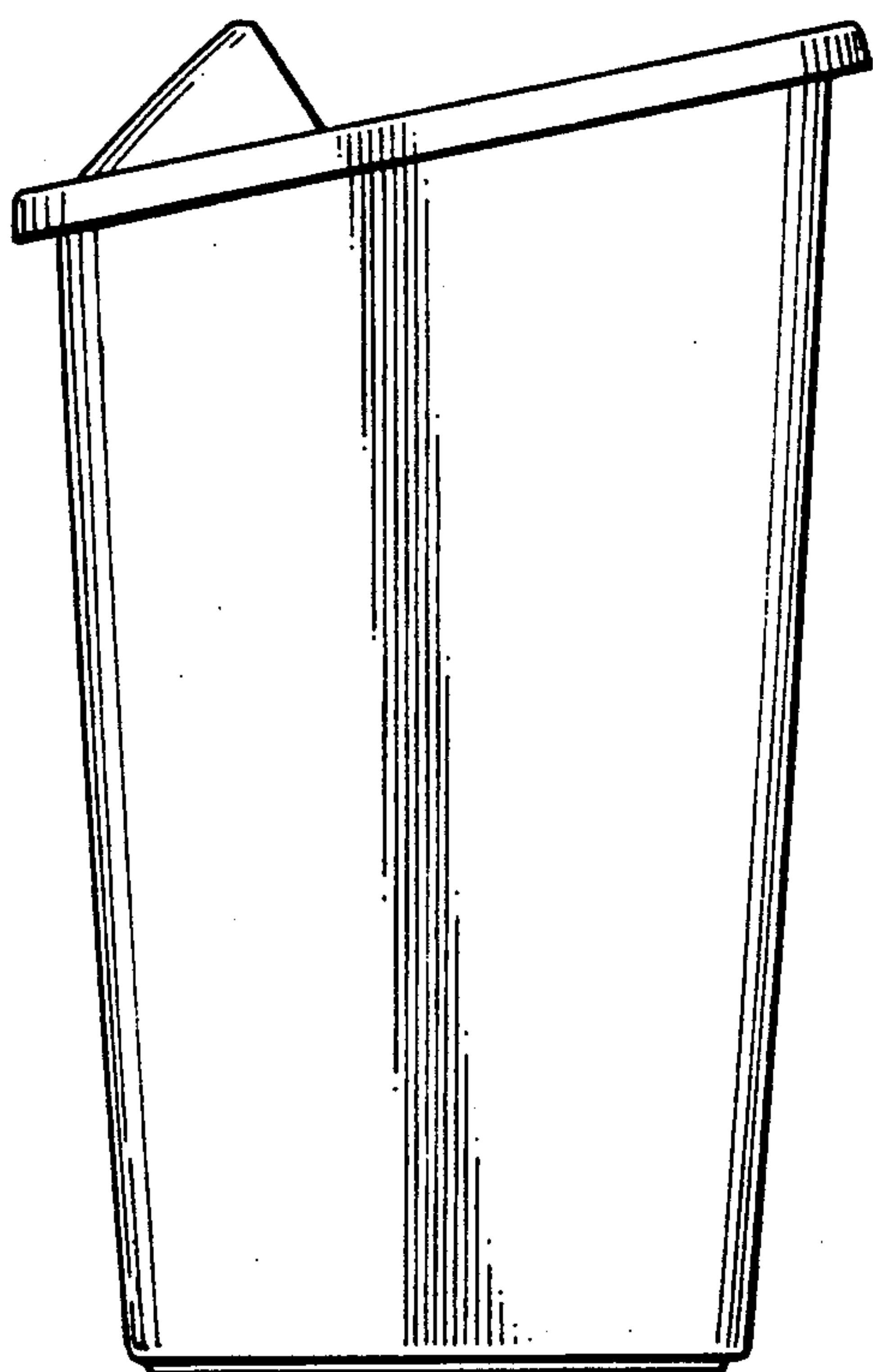

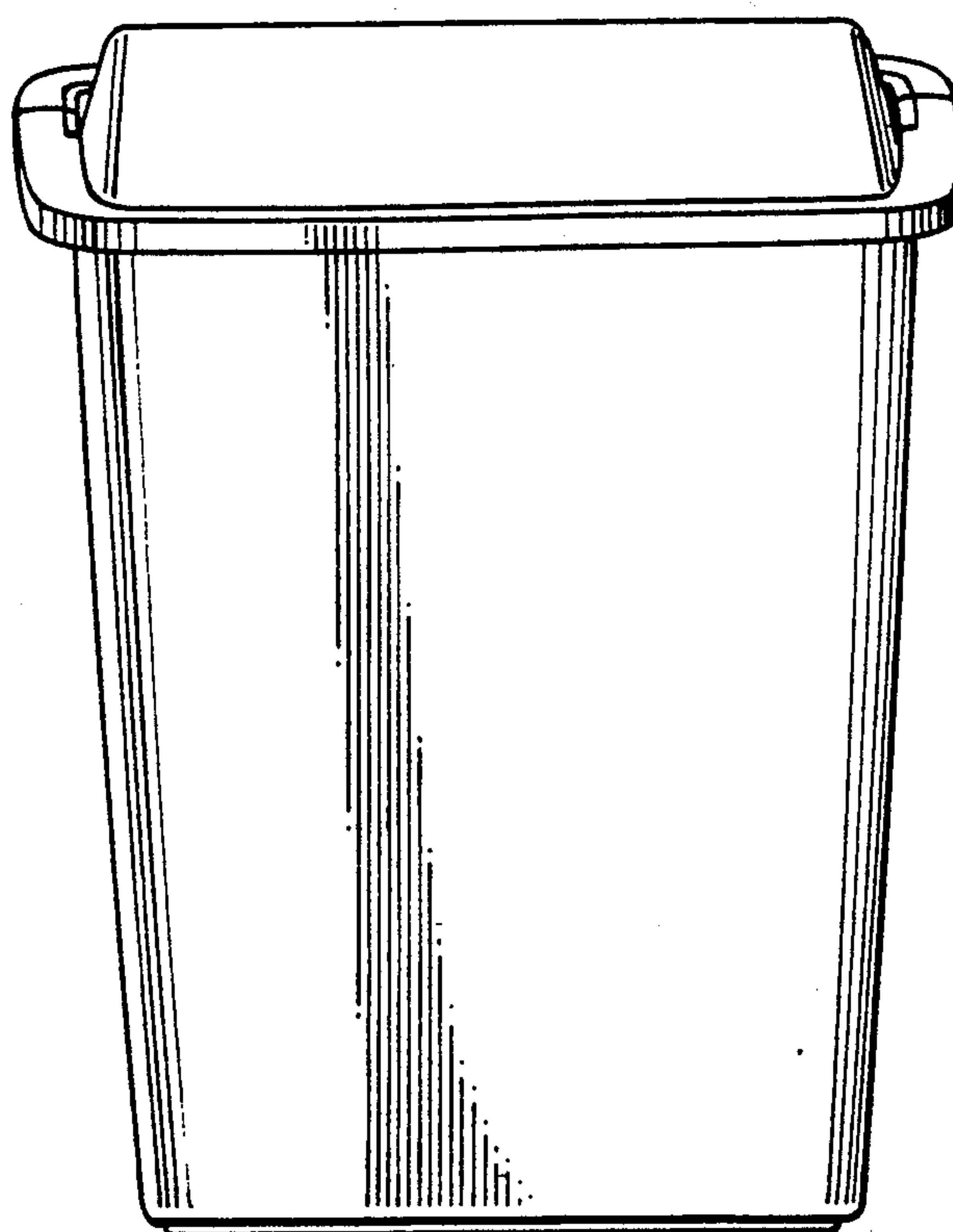

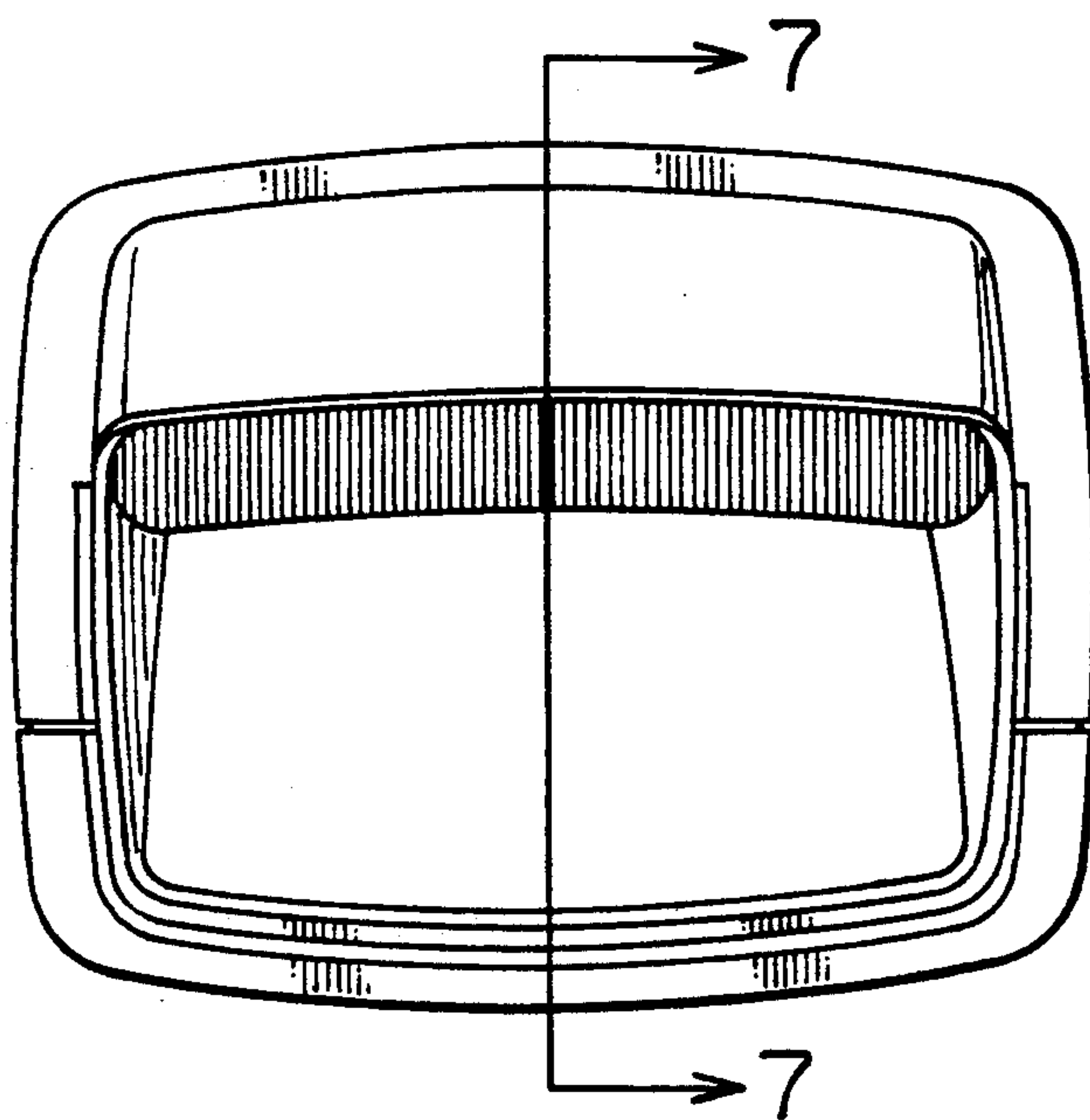

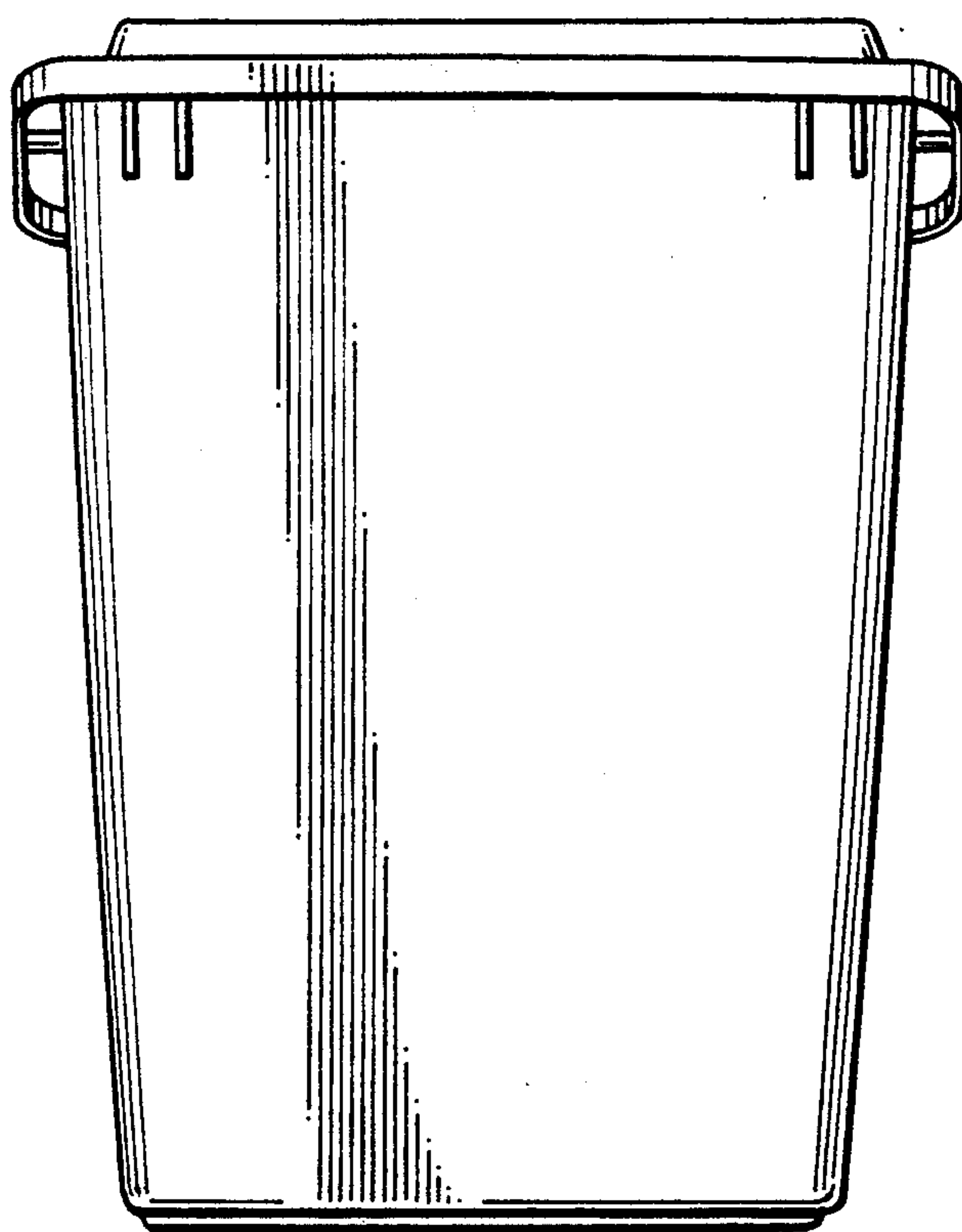

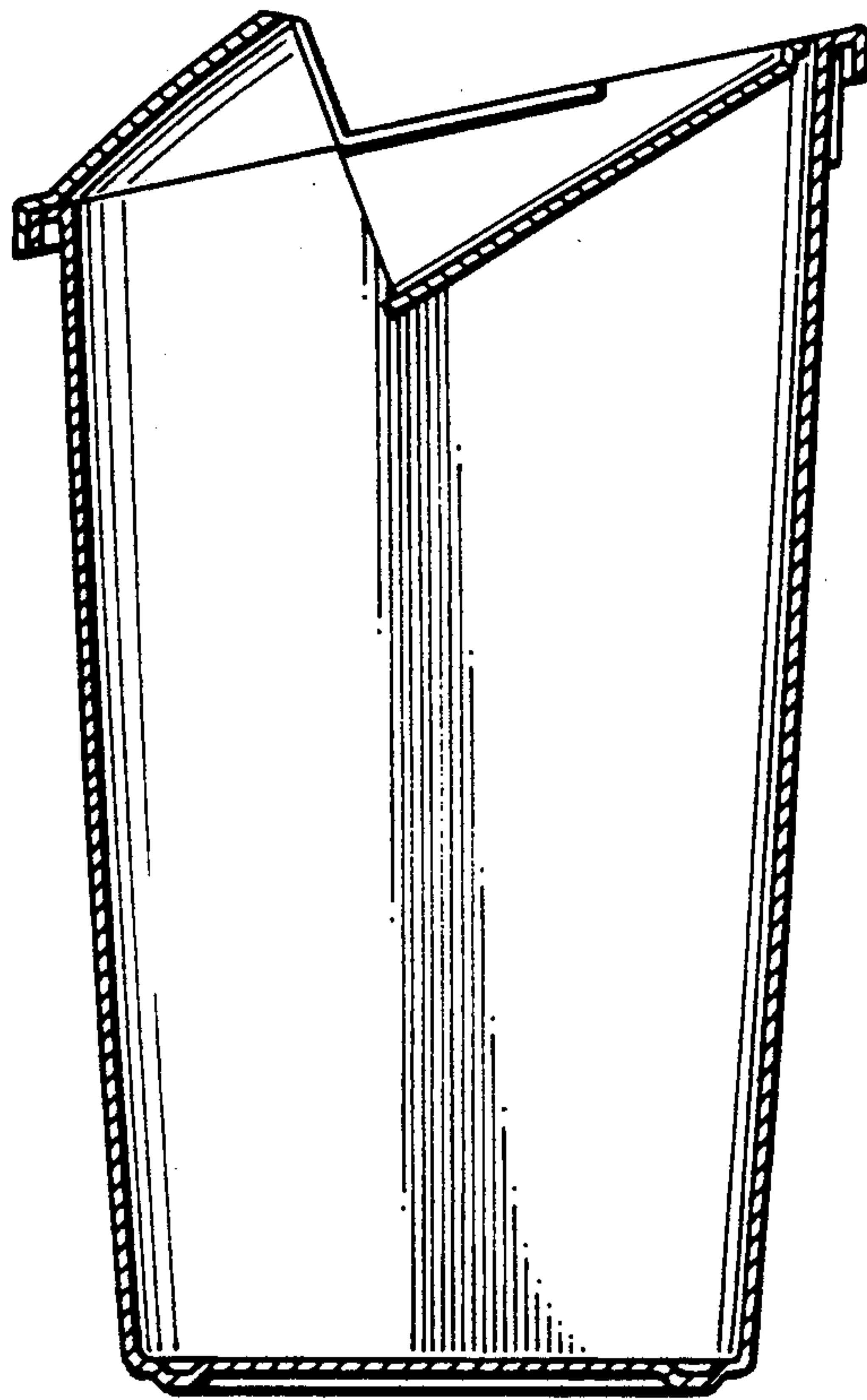

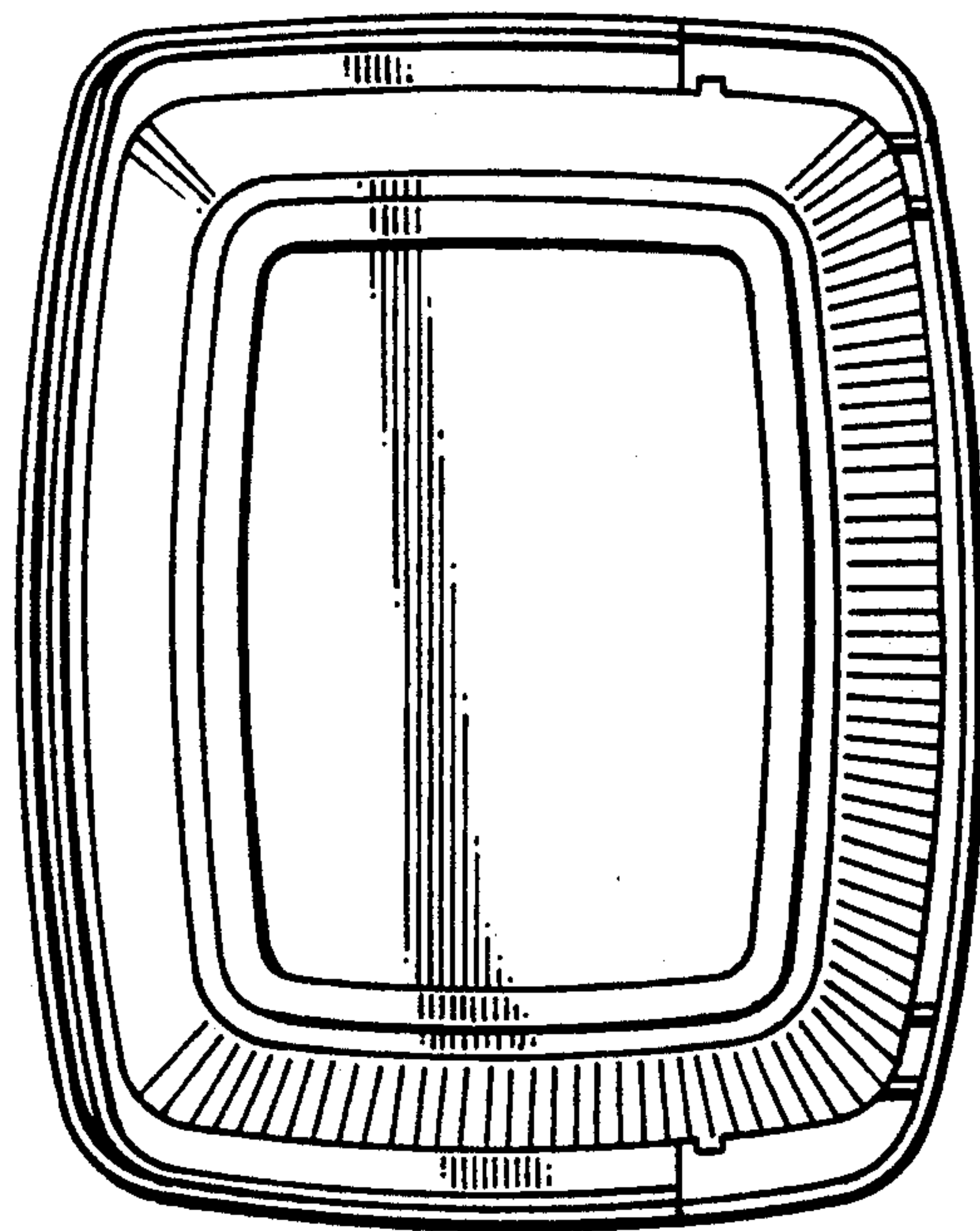
