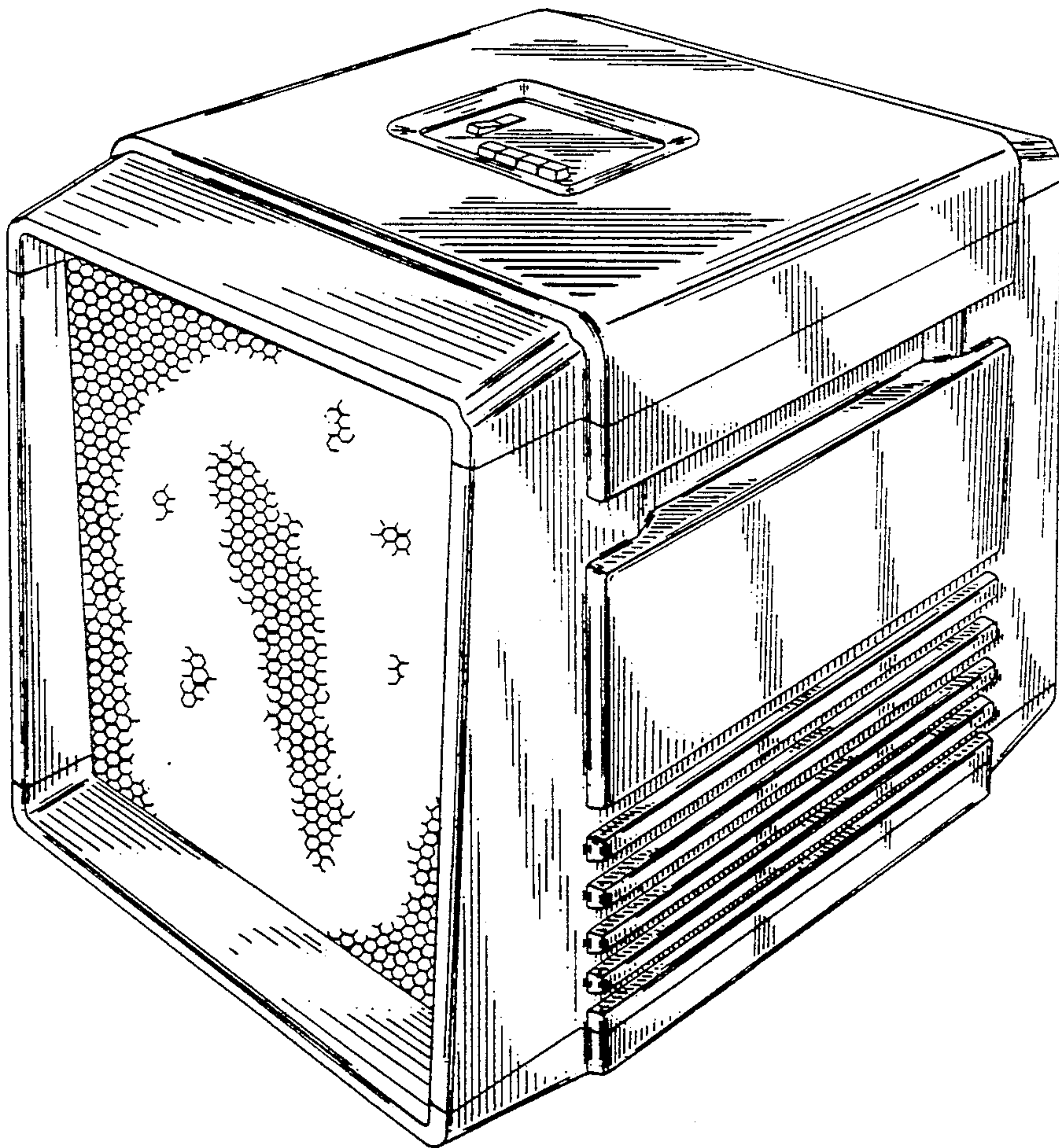

The honeycomb pattern is understood to extend throughout the entire front panel in FIGS. 1 and 2, and is shown partially for ease of illustration.



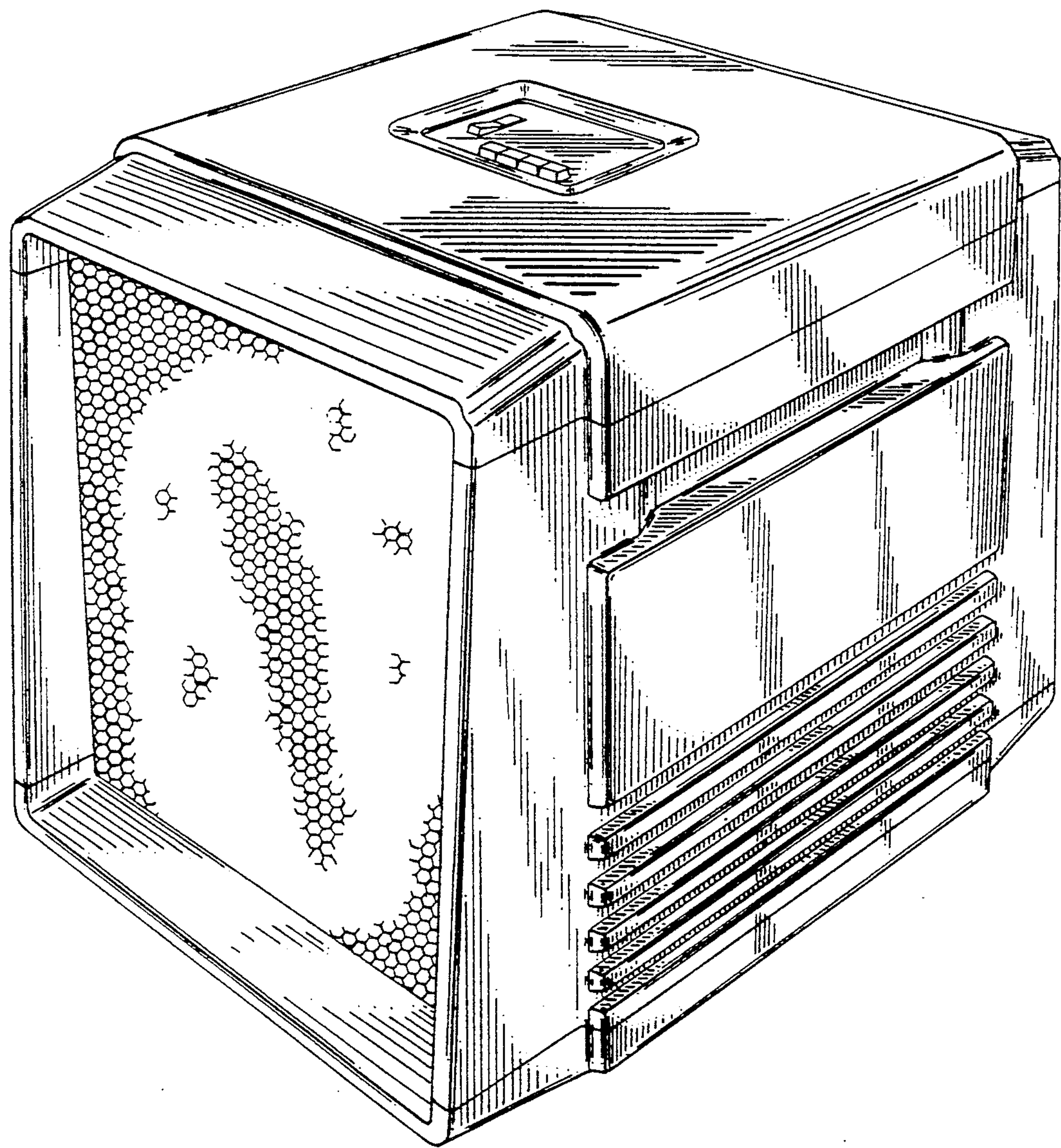

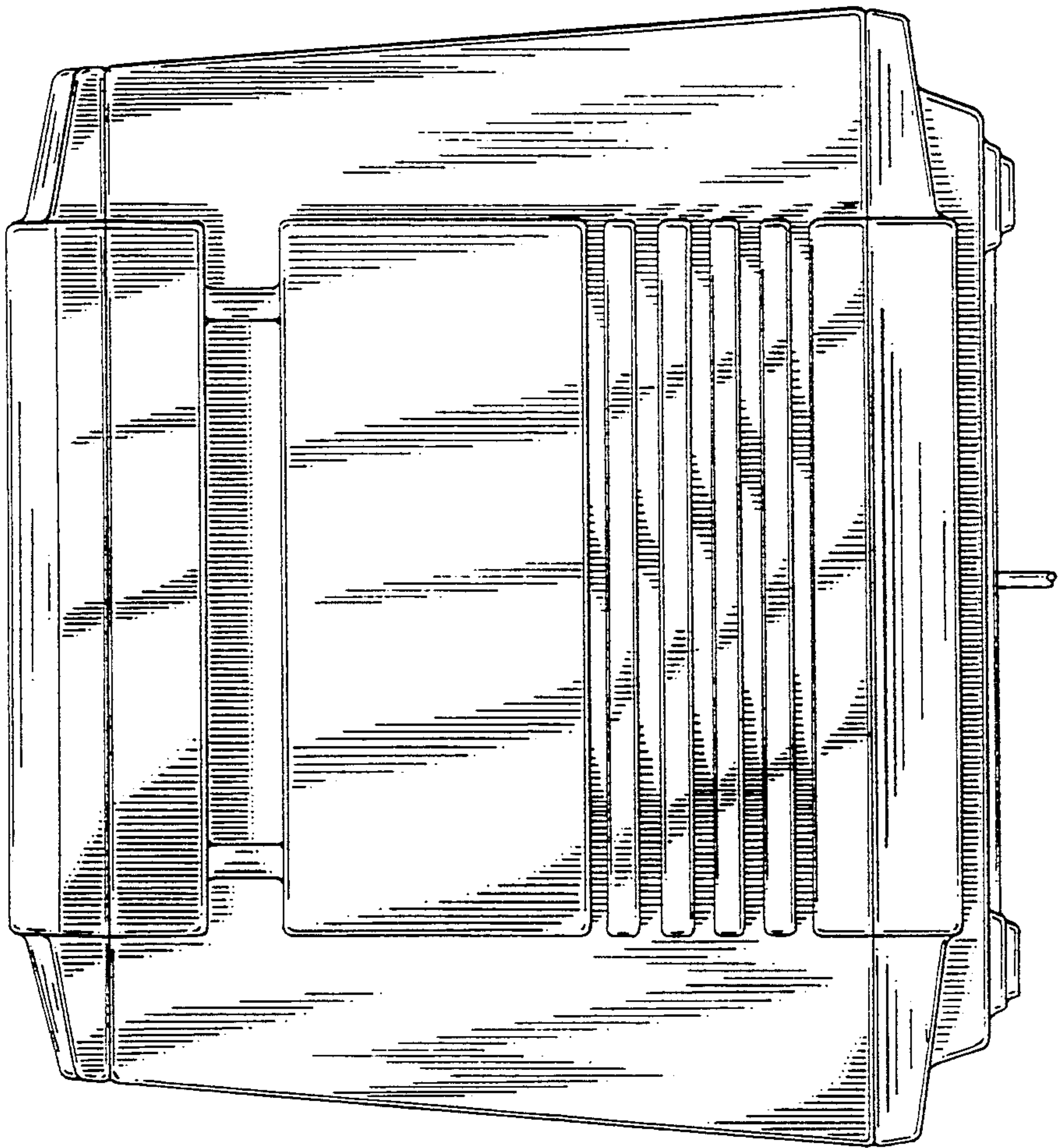

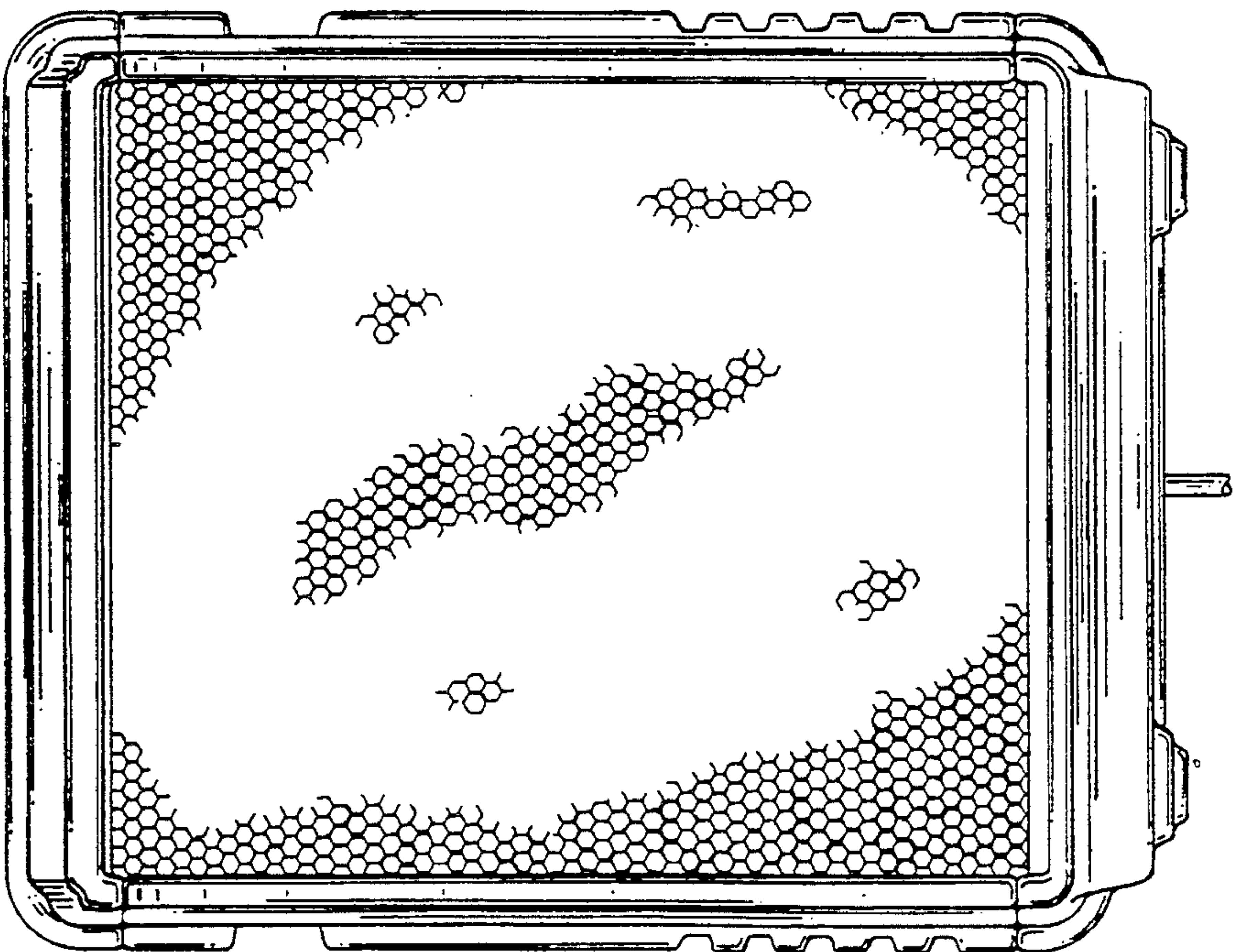

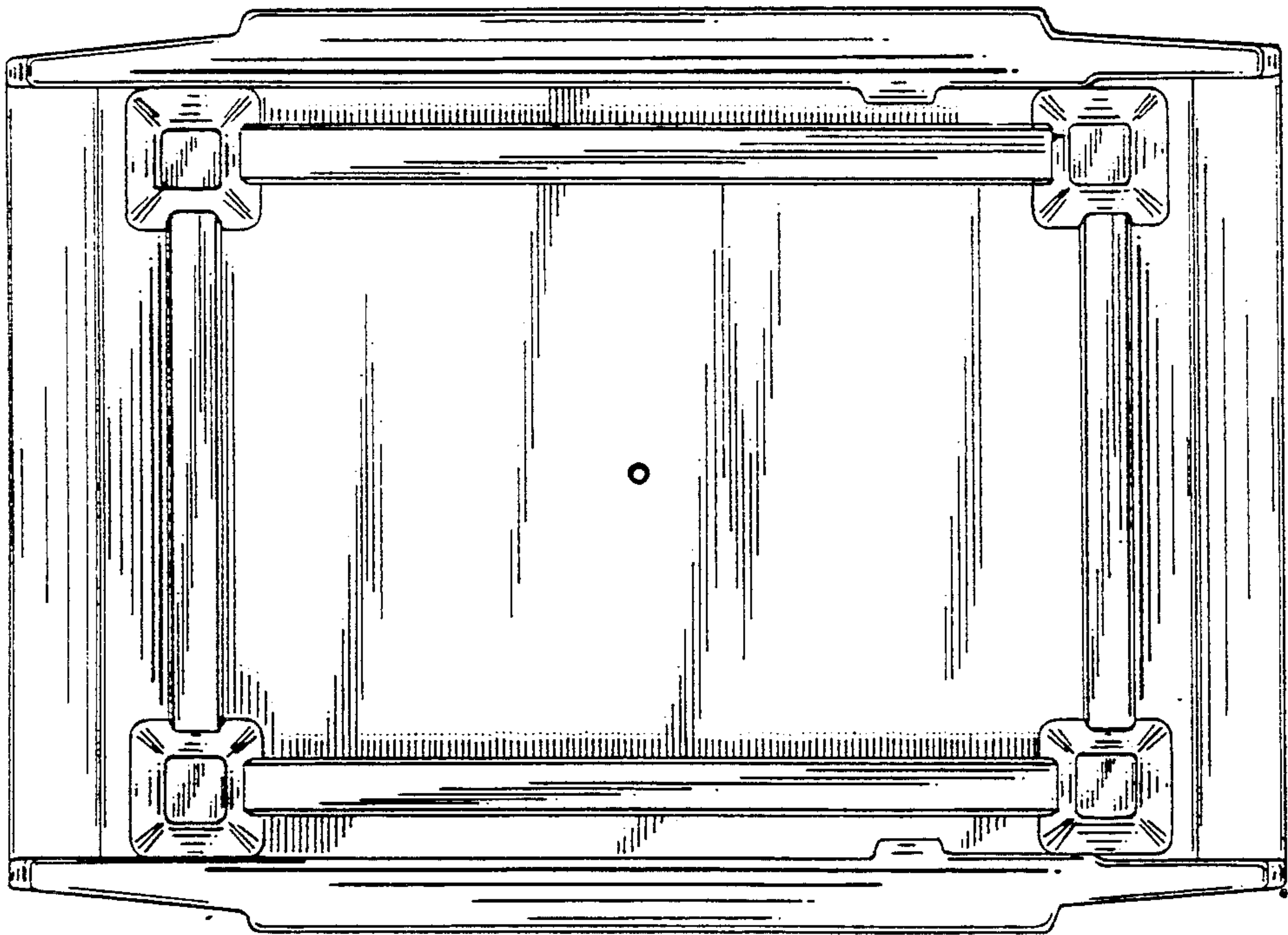

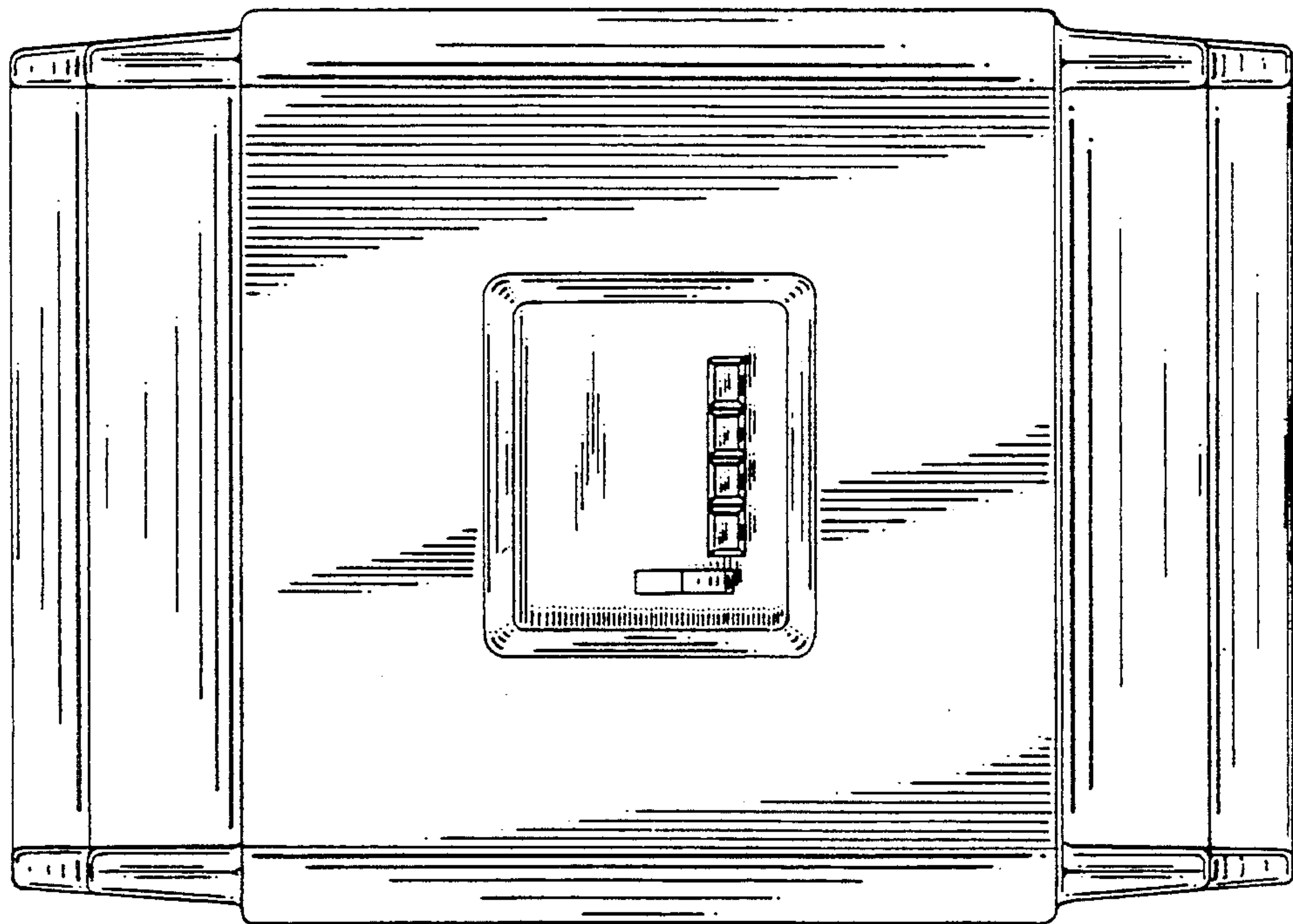
