DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an end elevational view of an inhalator, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view thereof being a mirror image;















