FIG. 8 is a fragmentary rear elevational view thereof; and,

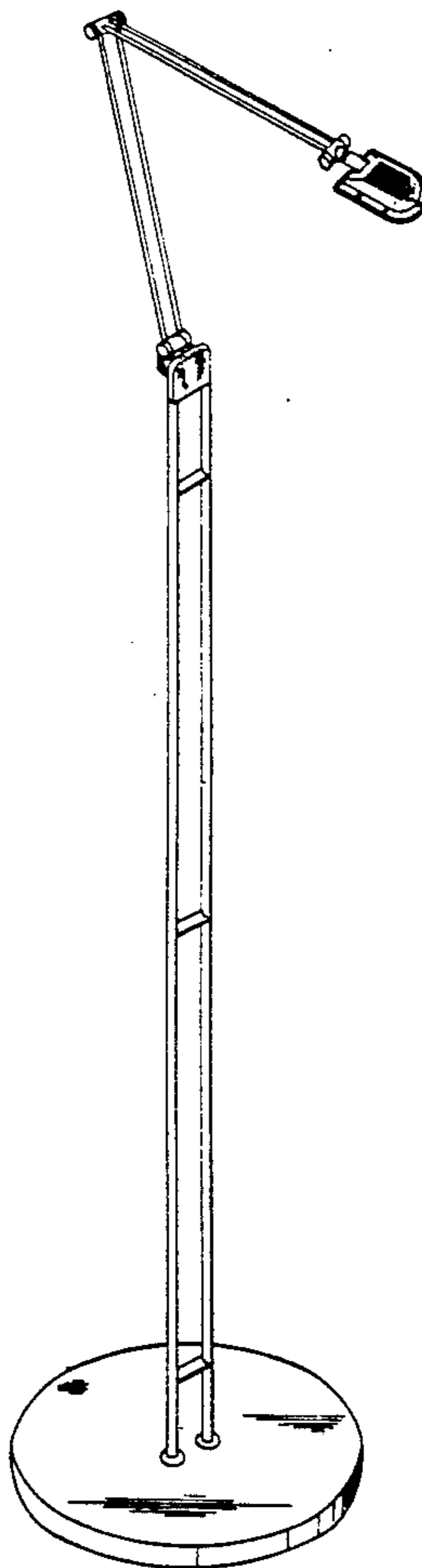
FIG. 9 is a fragmentary side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image.

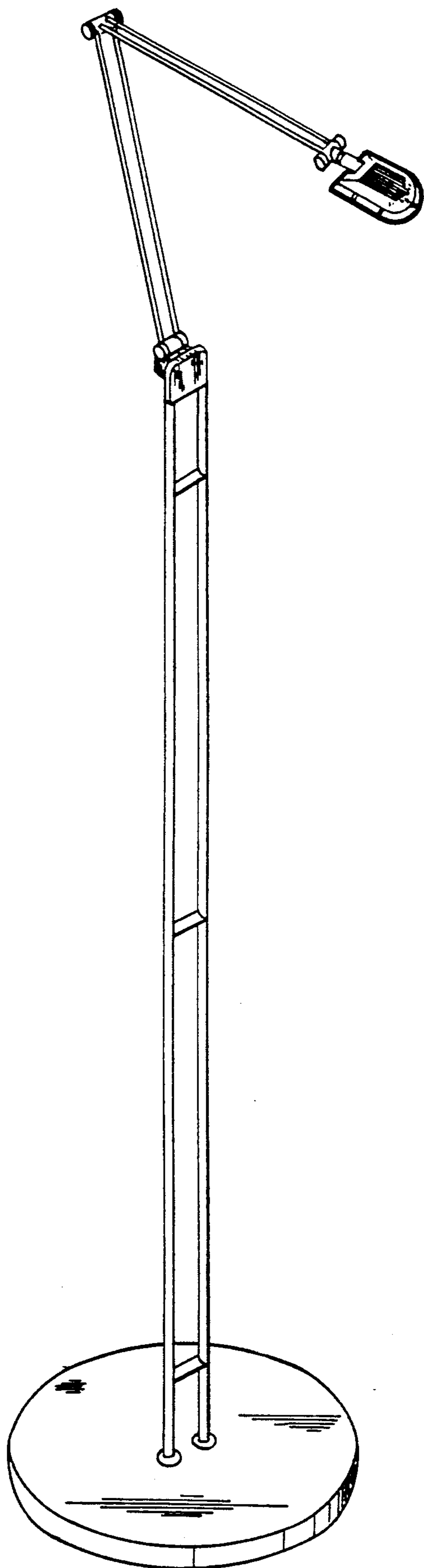

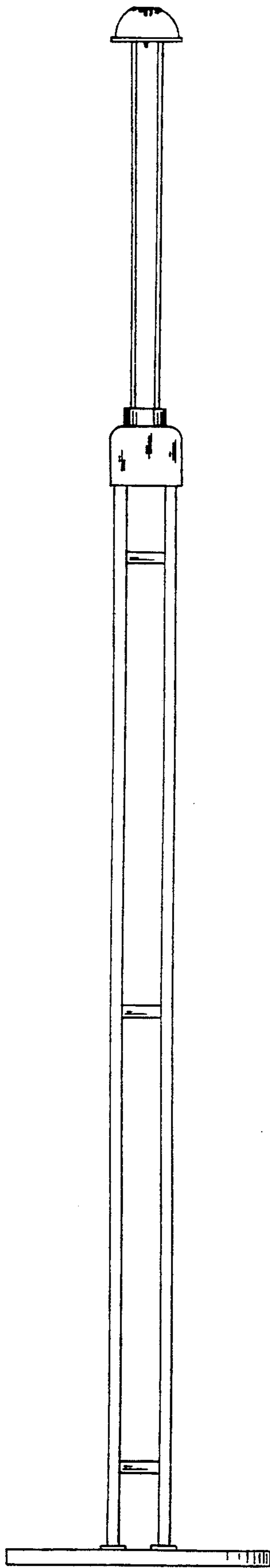

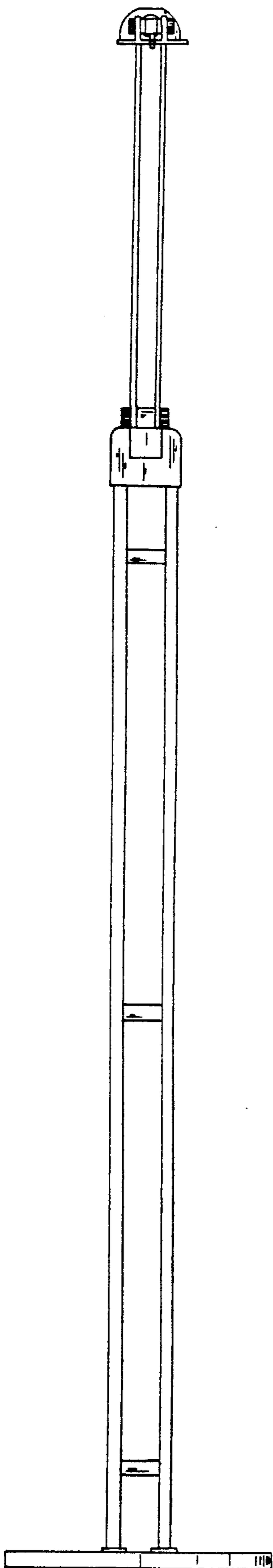

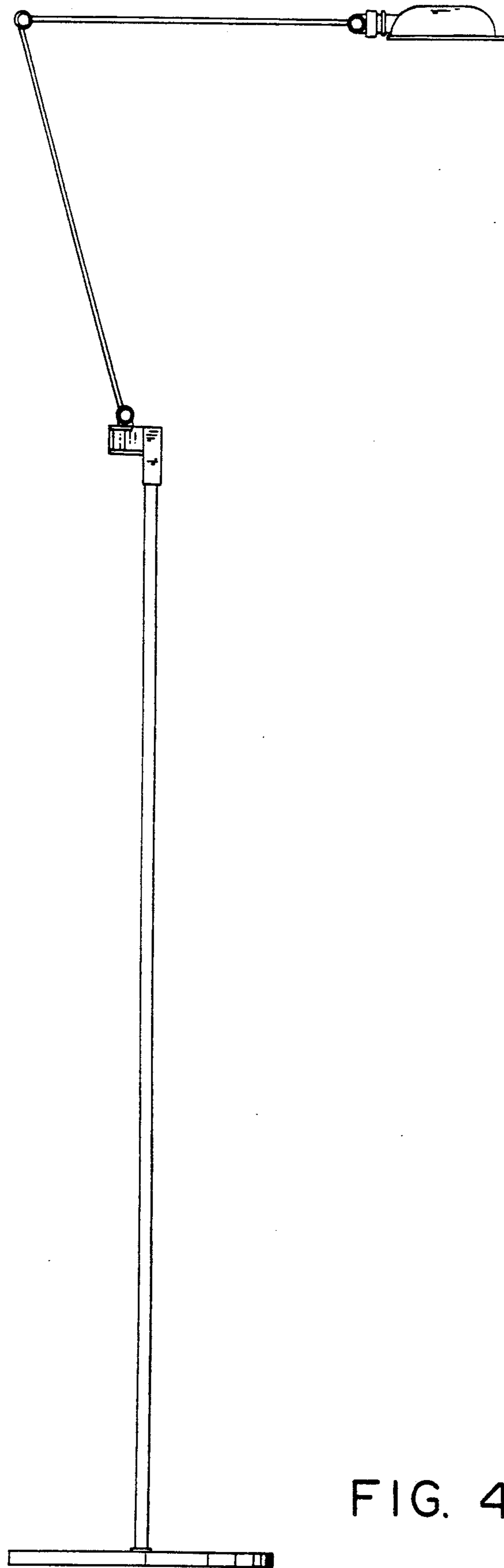

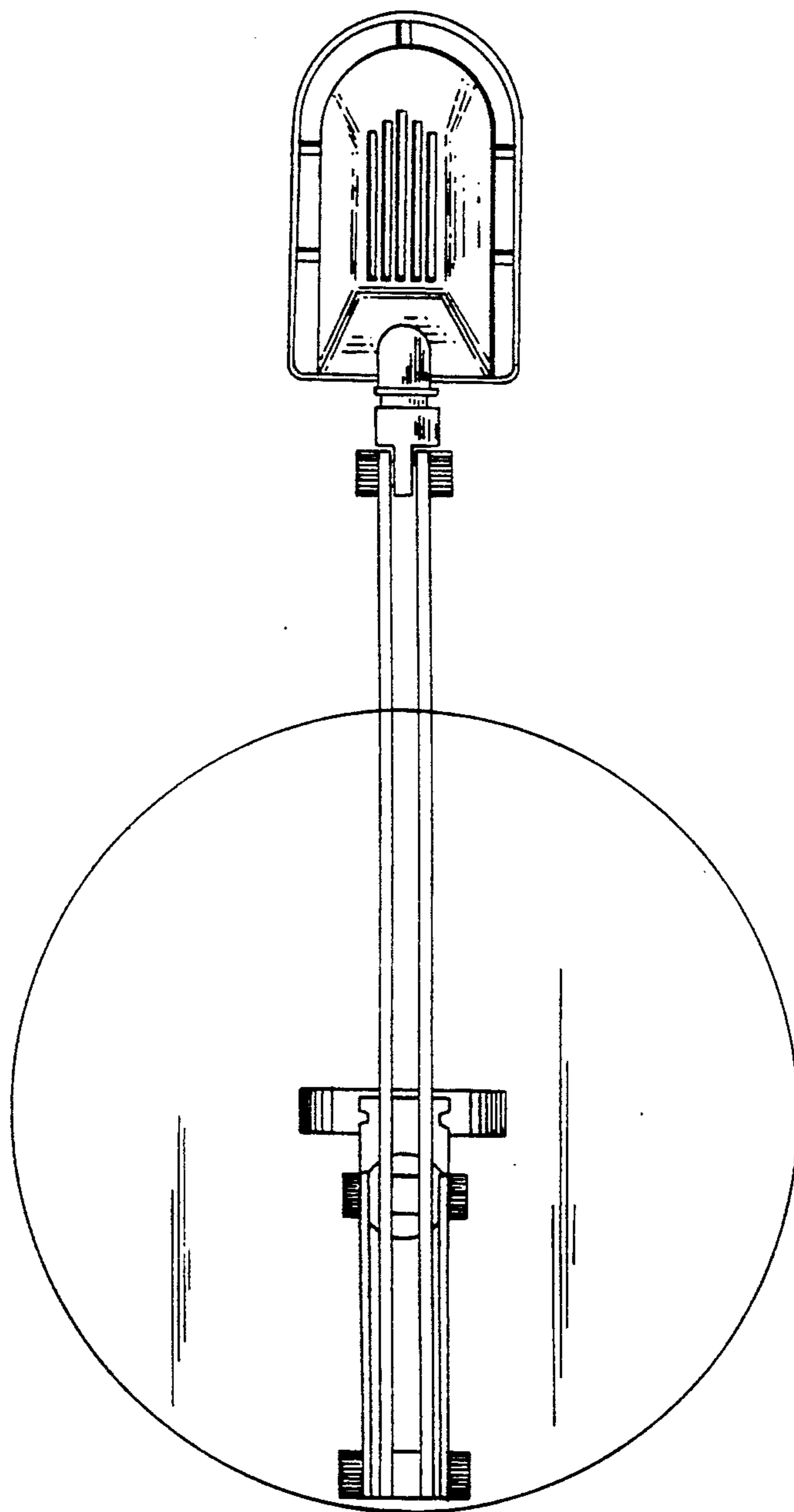

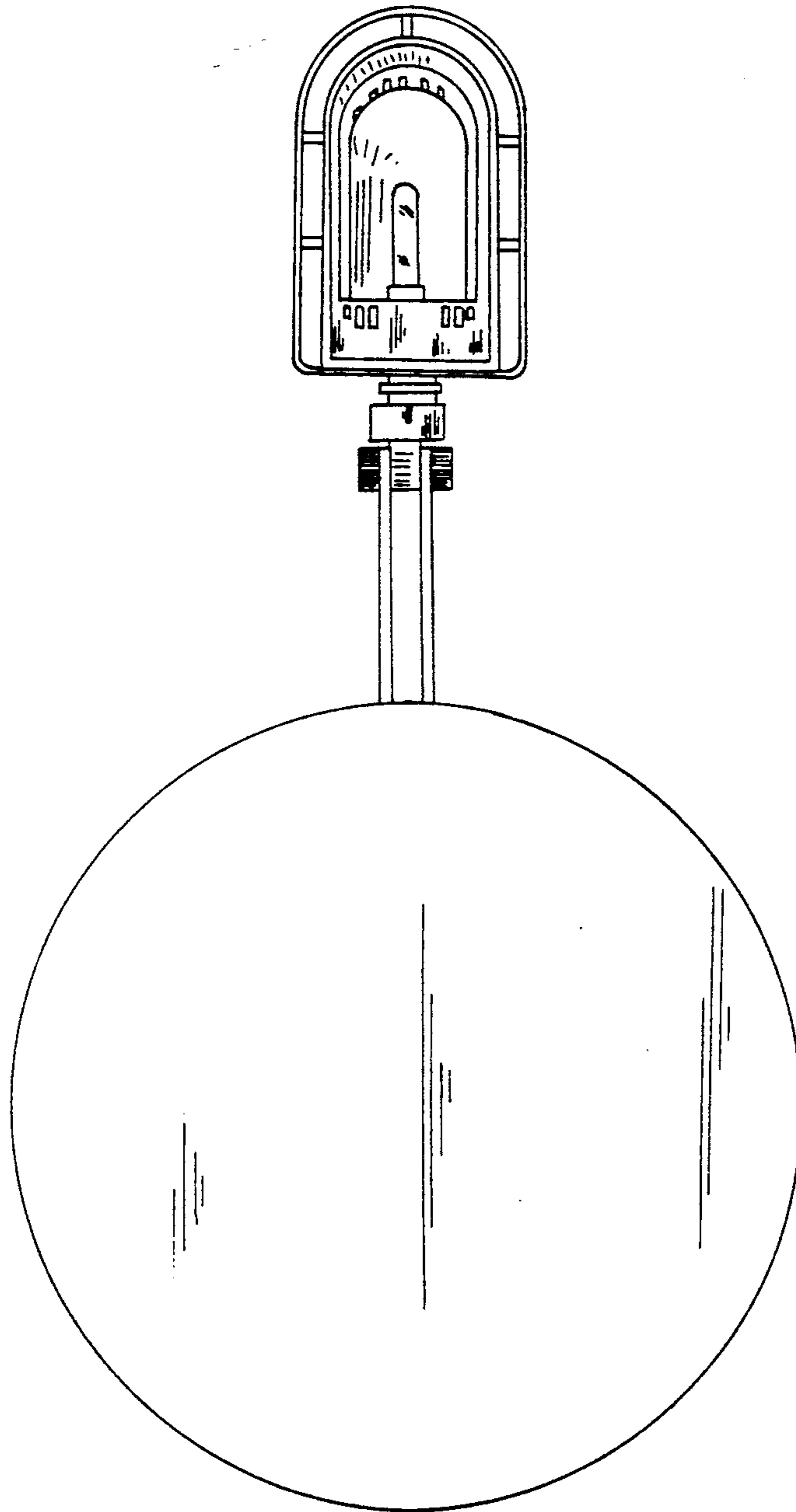

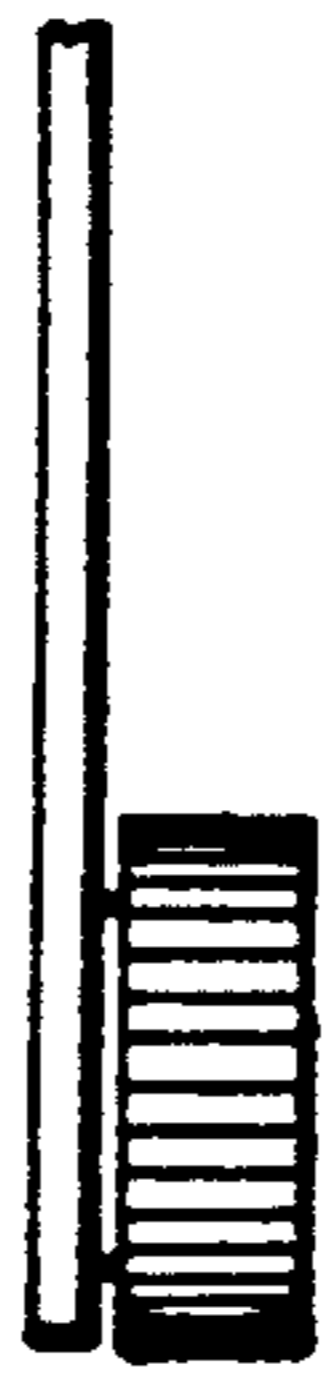

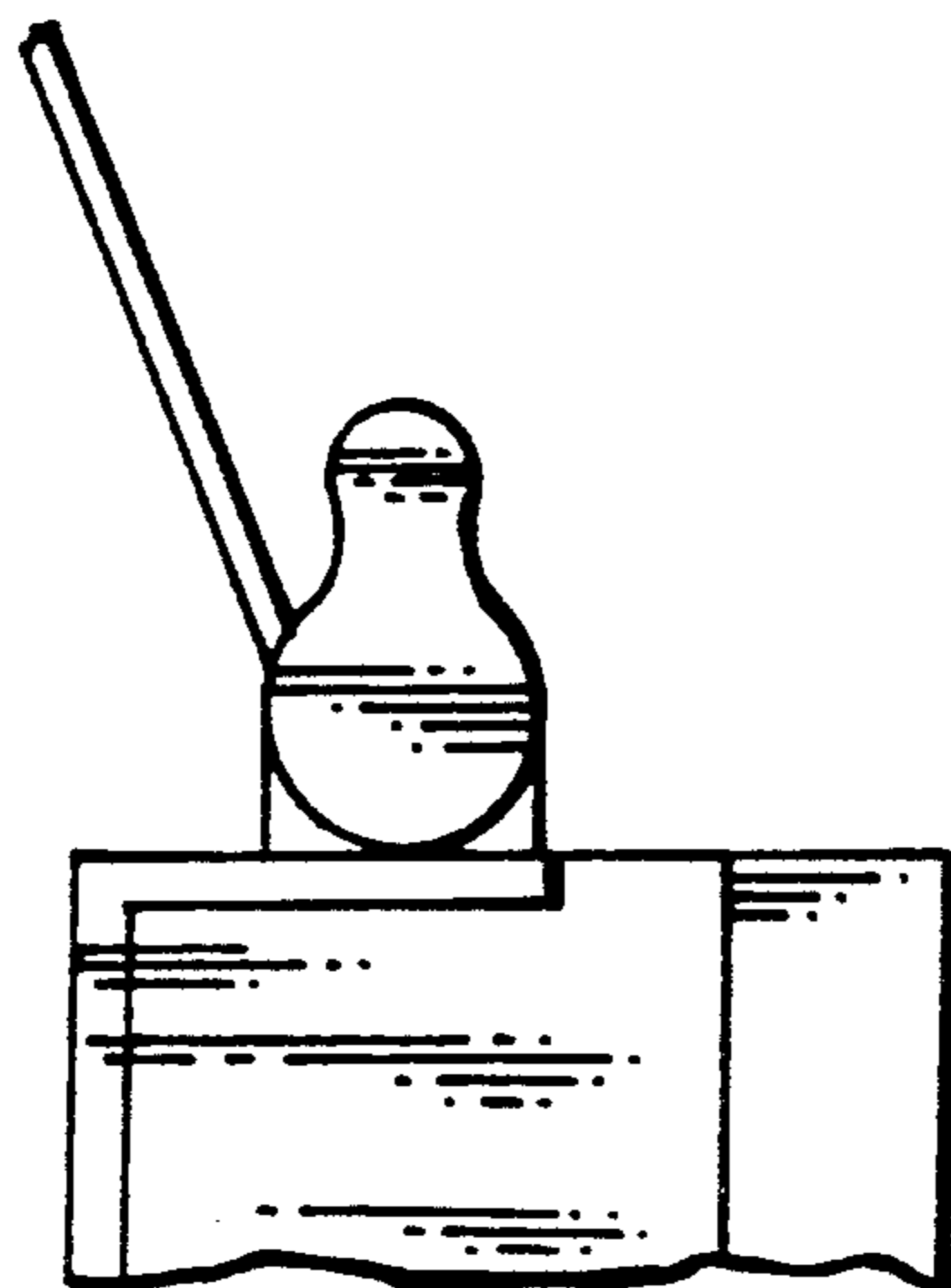
