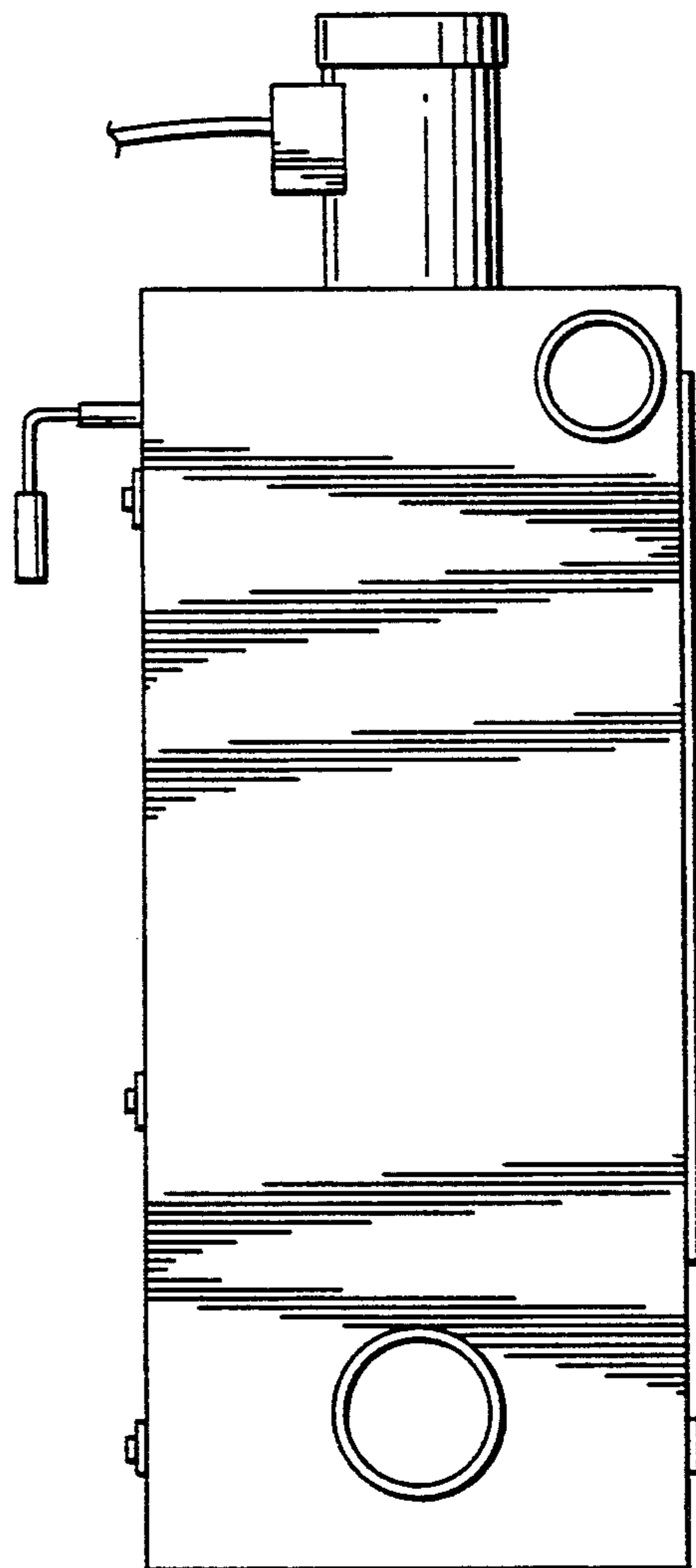
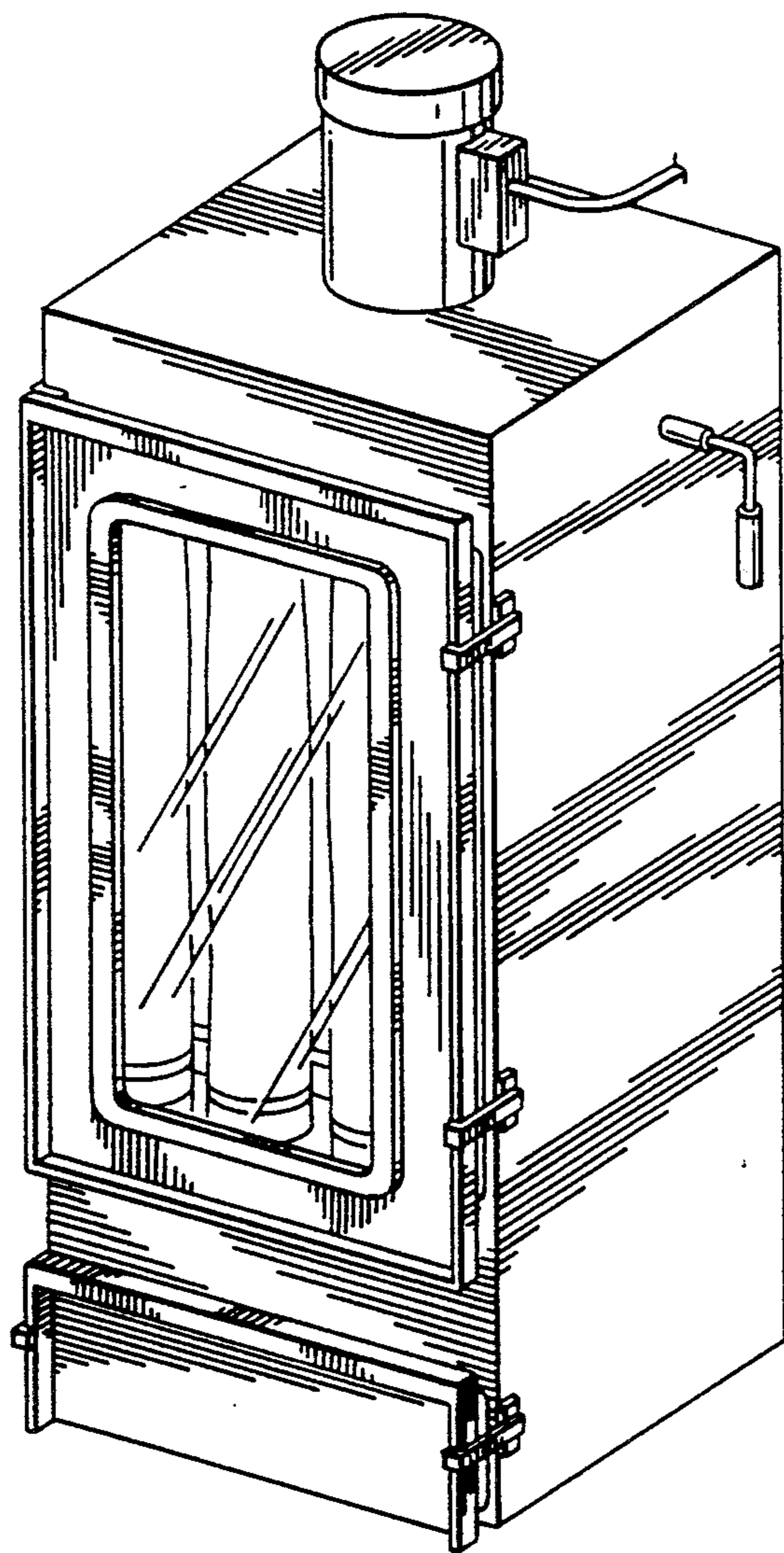

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vacuum system for collecting dust from sandblasting cabinets, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view as seen from the top, front, and right side of a vacuum system for collecting dust from sandblasting cabinets showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



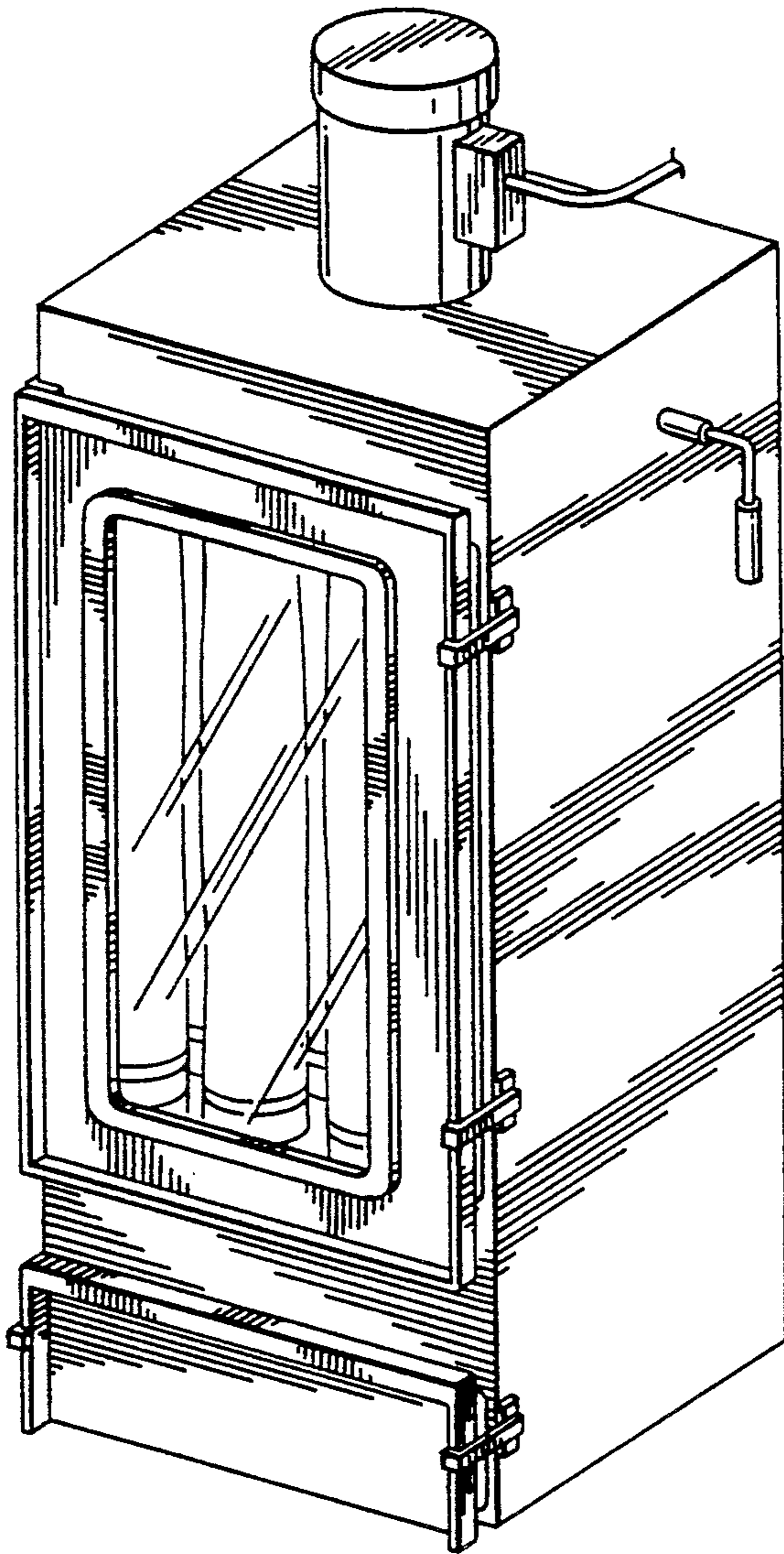

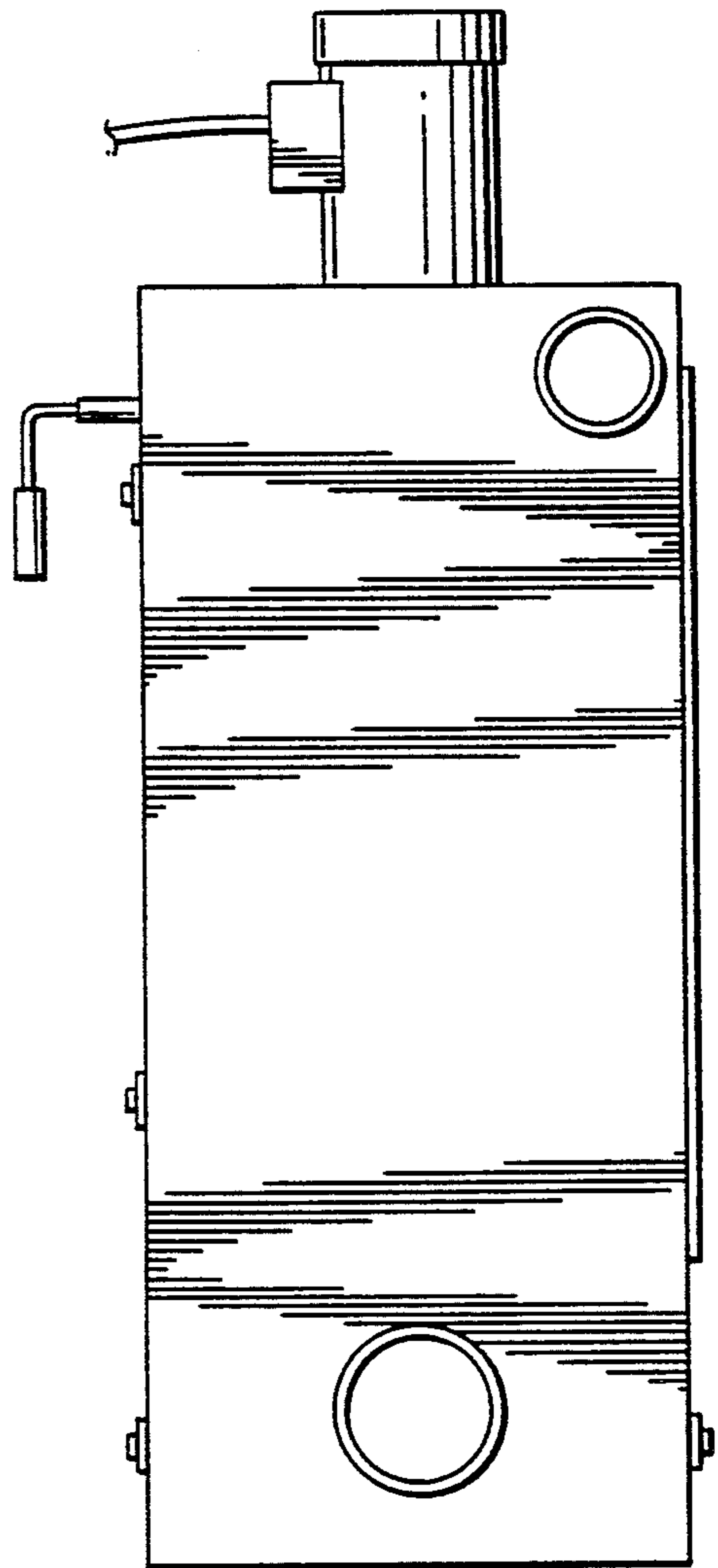

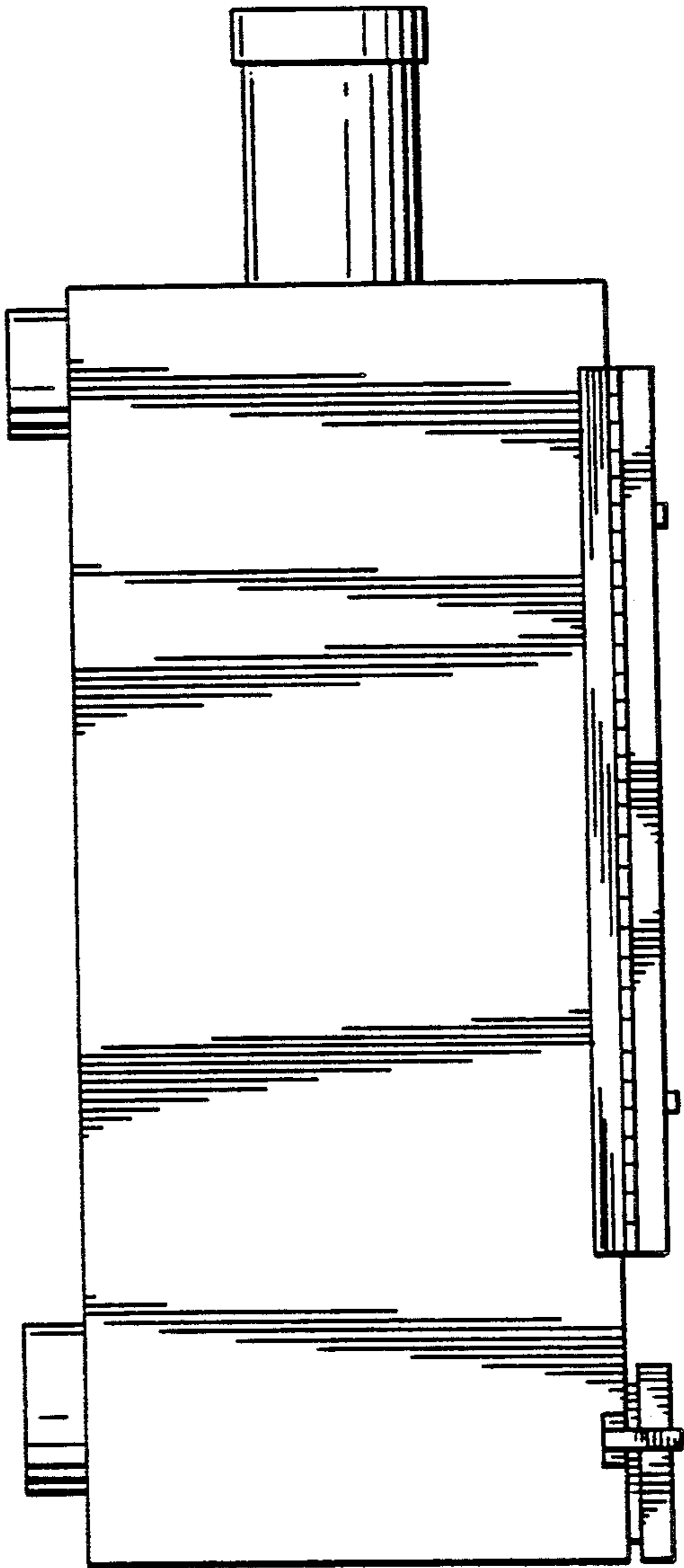

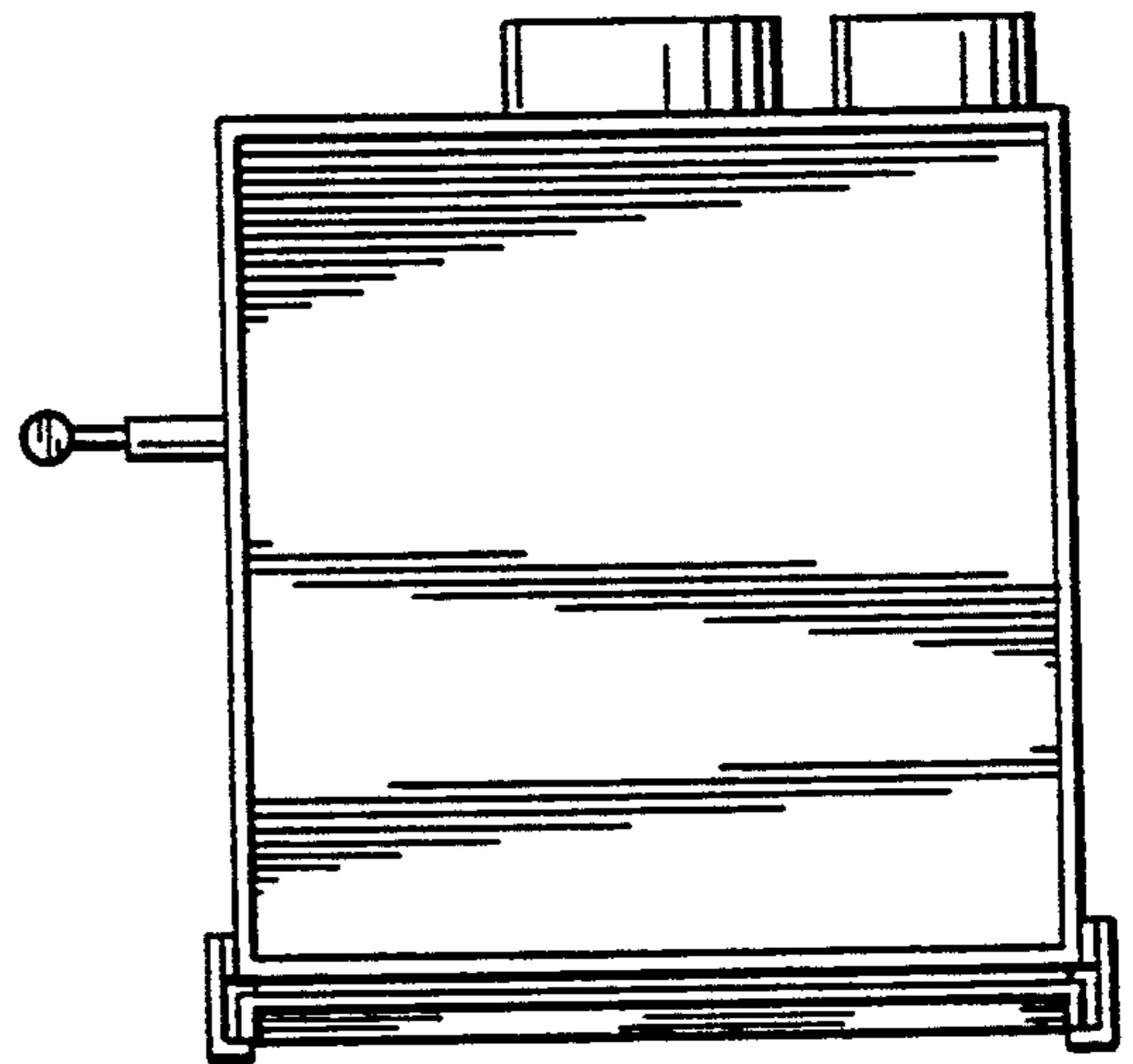
