position, the undisclosed rear being a mirror image.

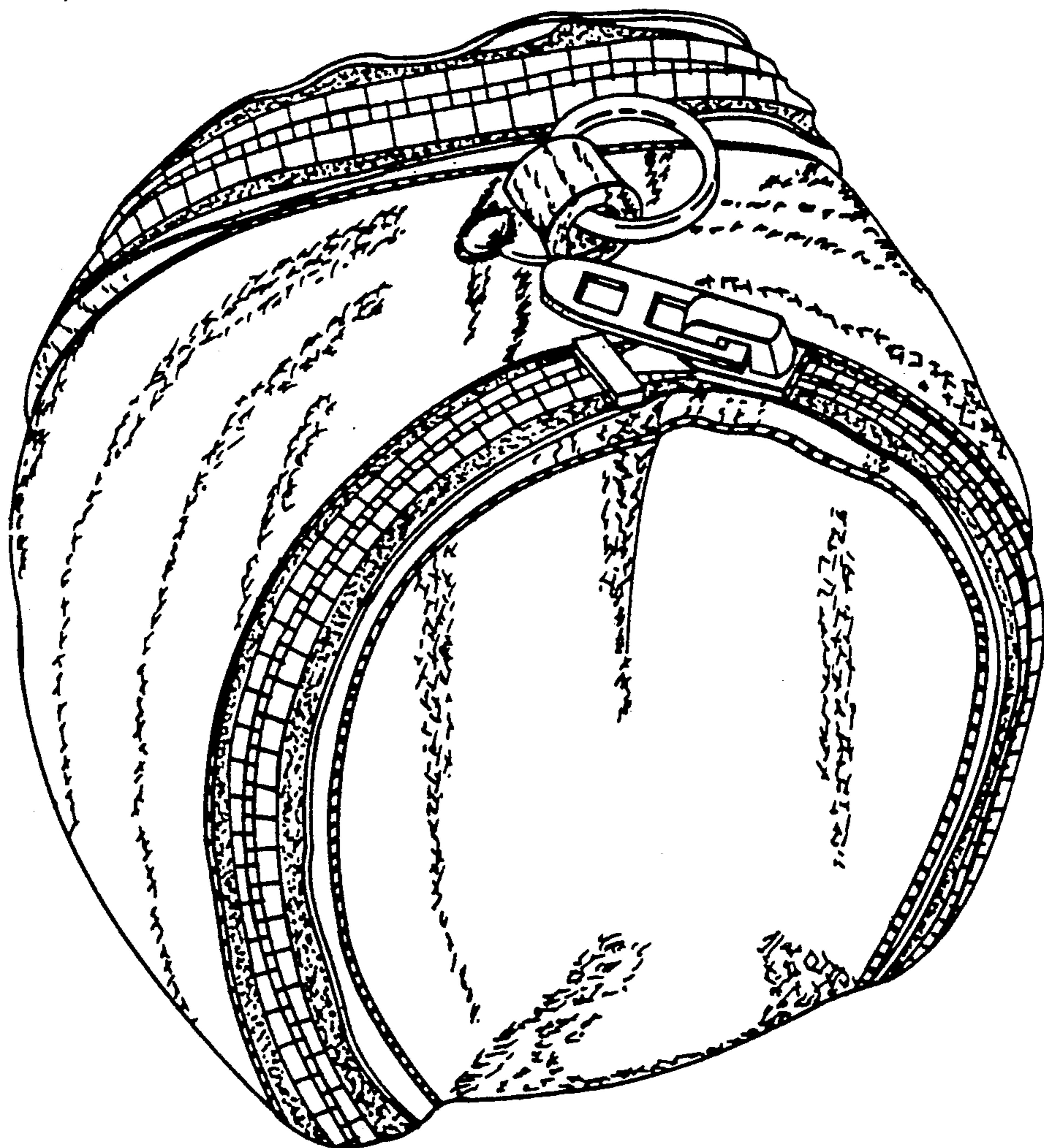

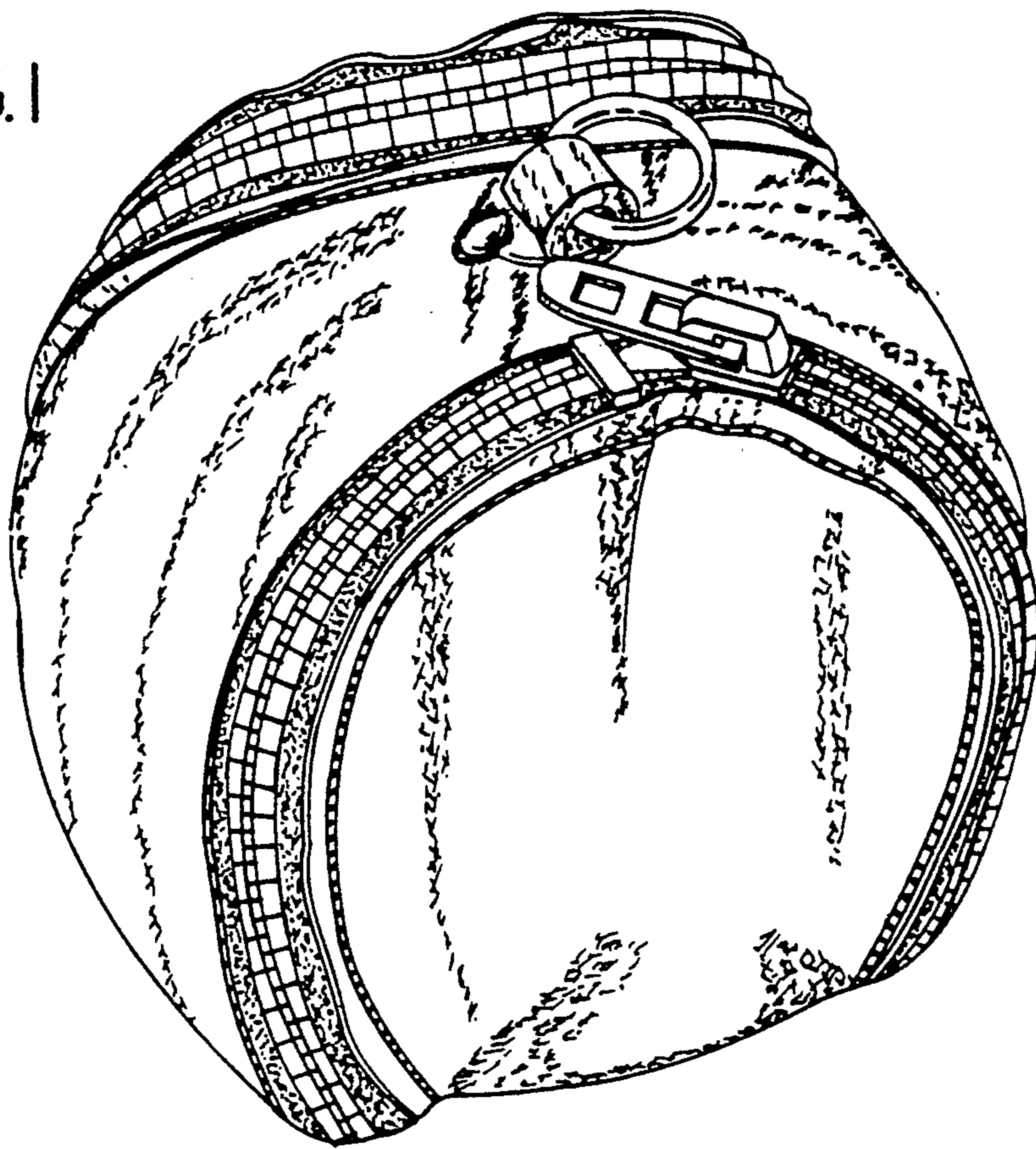

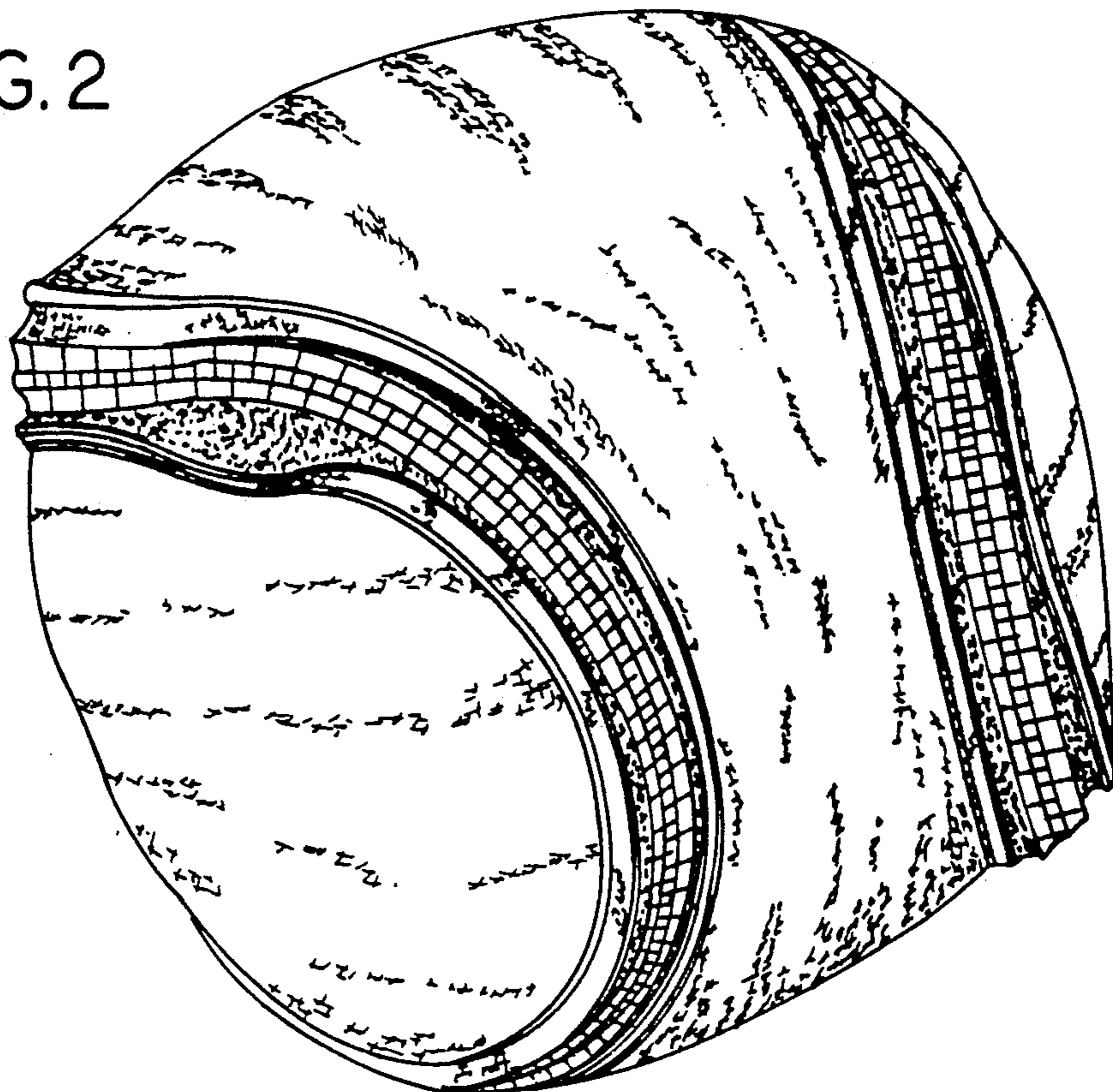
