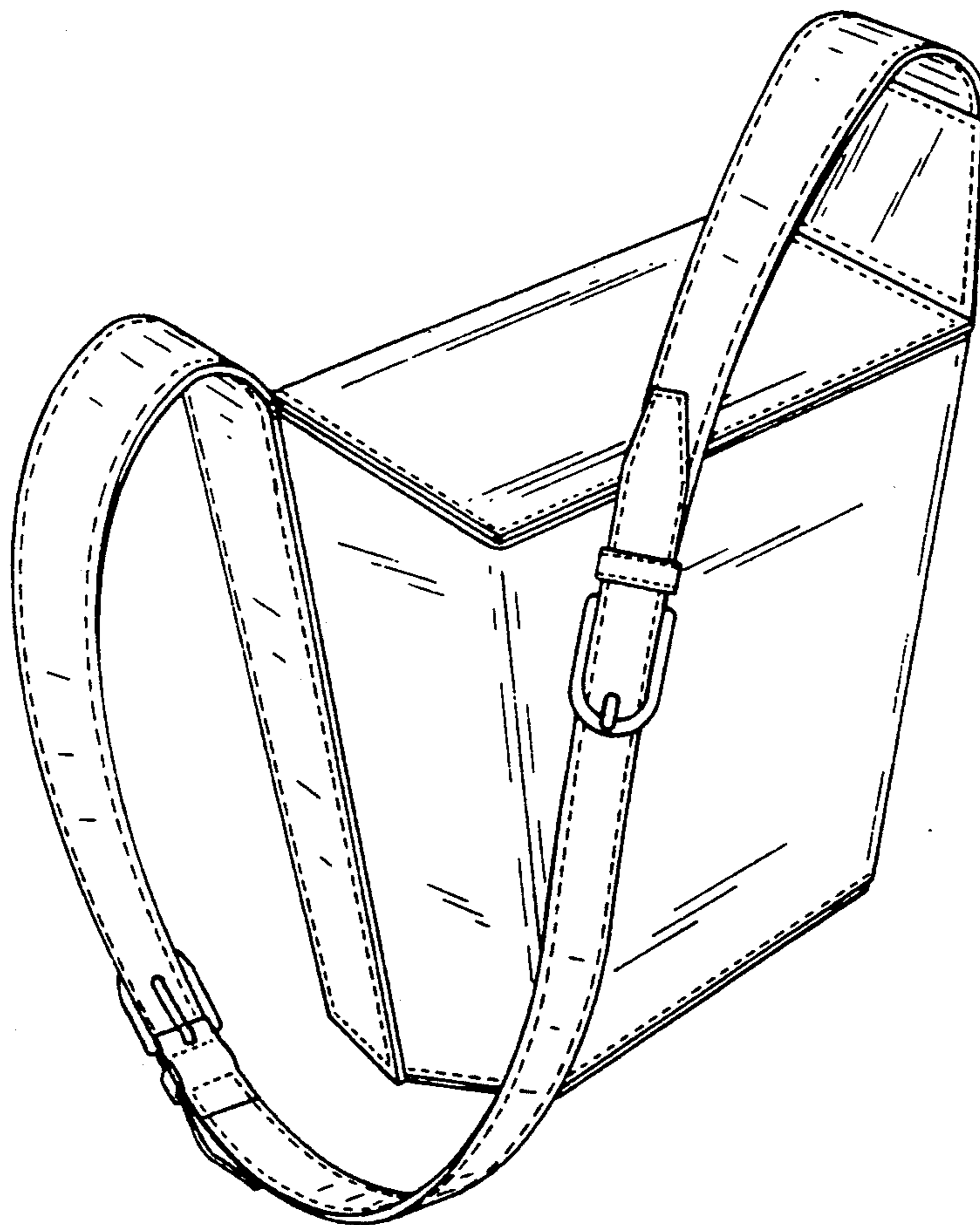
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being a mirror image;

FIGS. 3-5 show the extension belt forming part of the handle omitted for ease of illustration only.



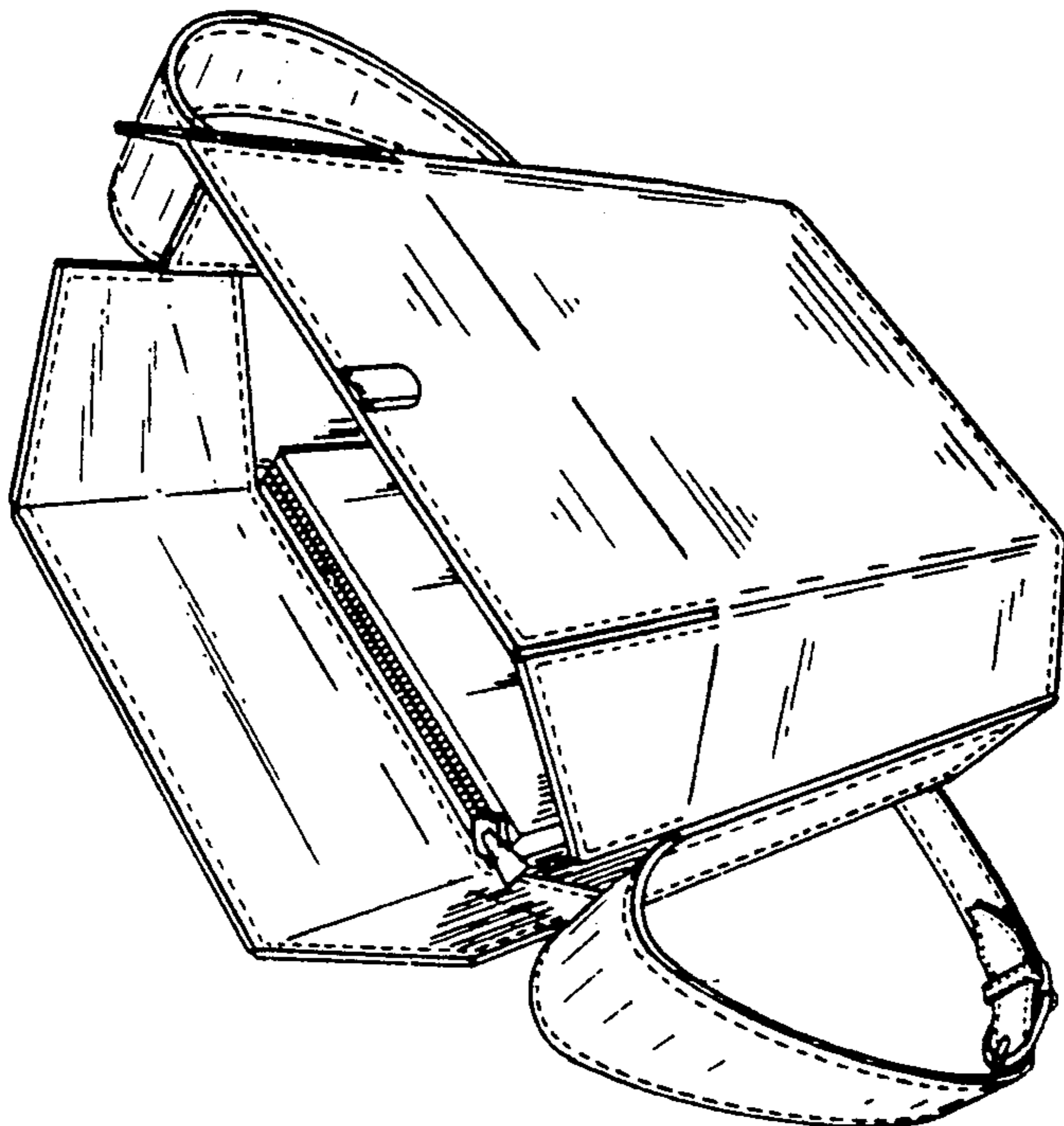

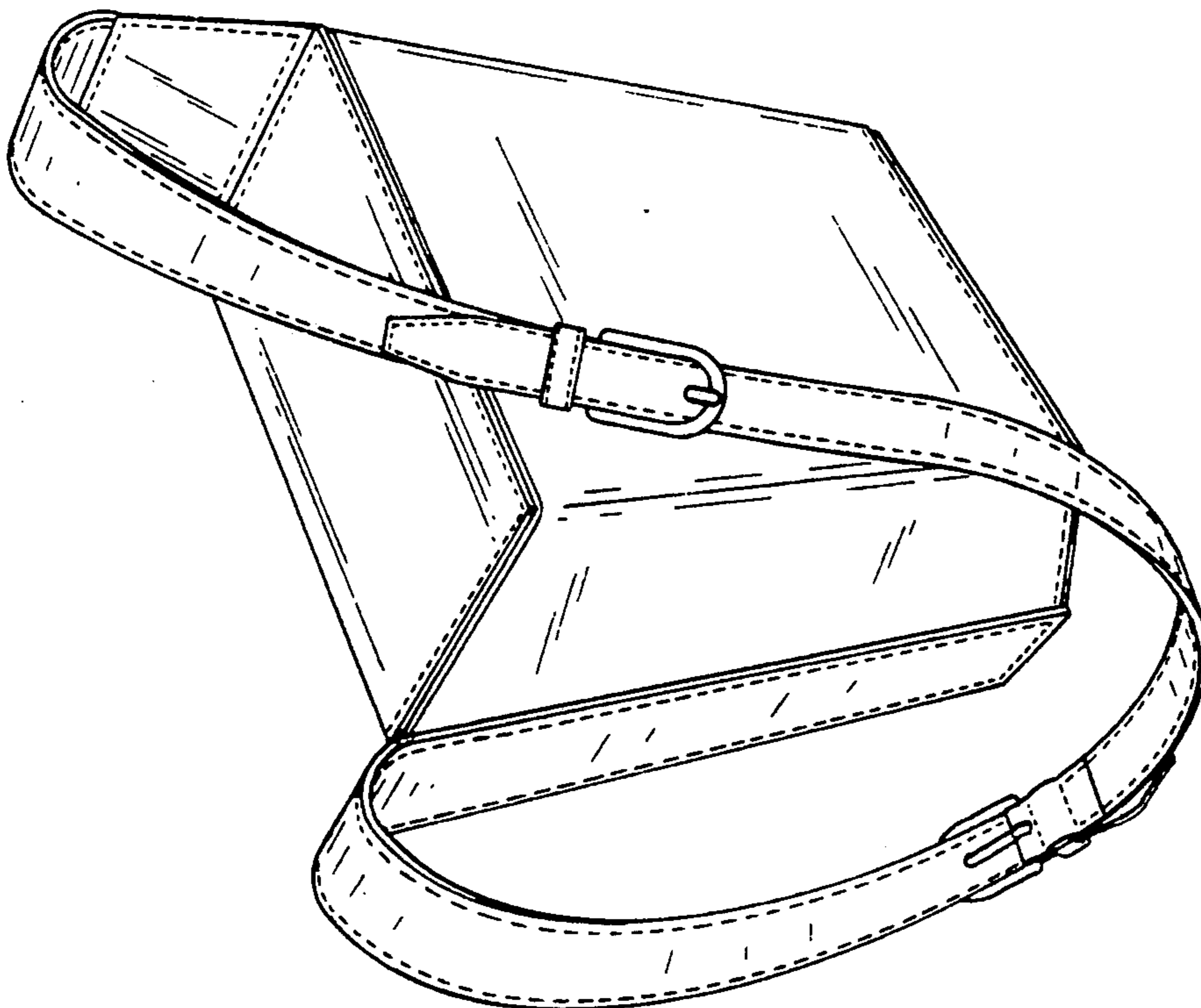

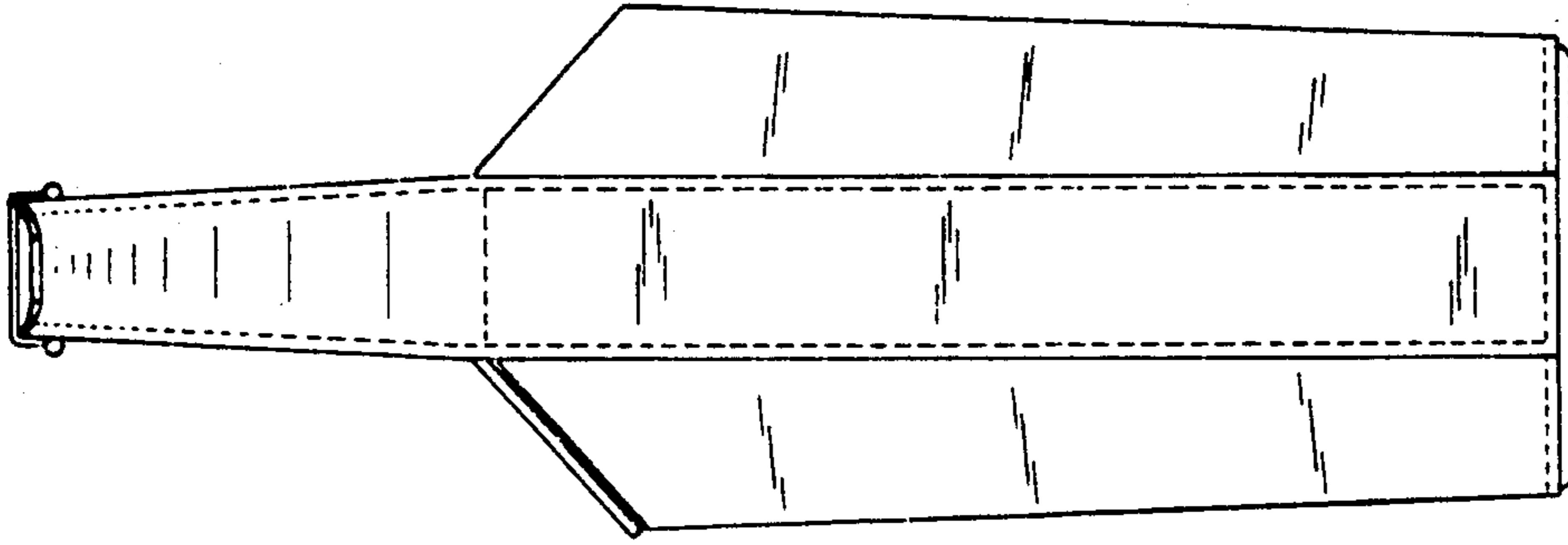

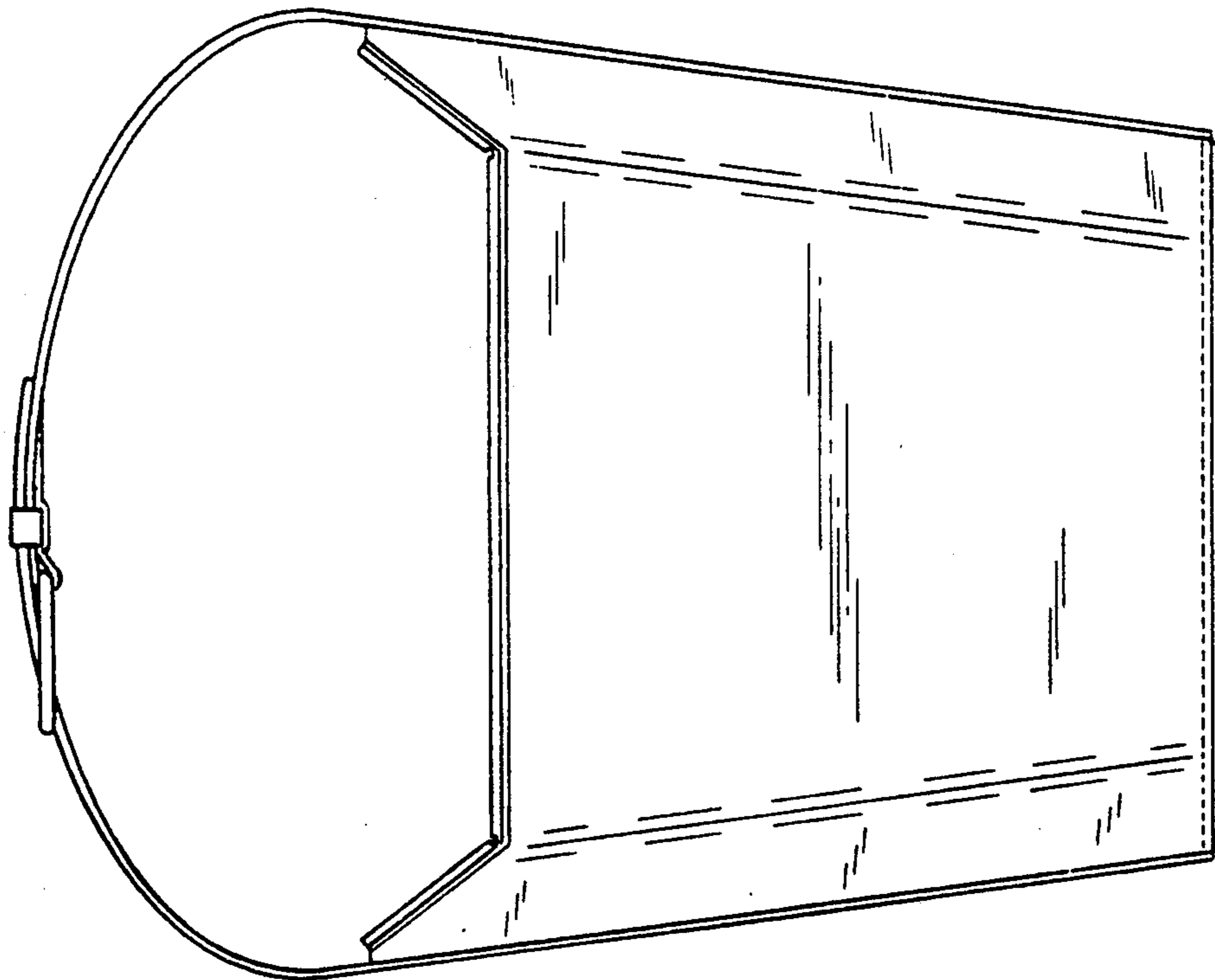

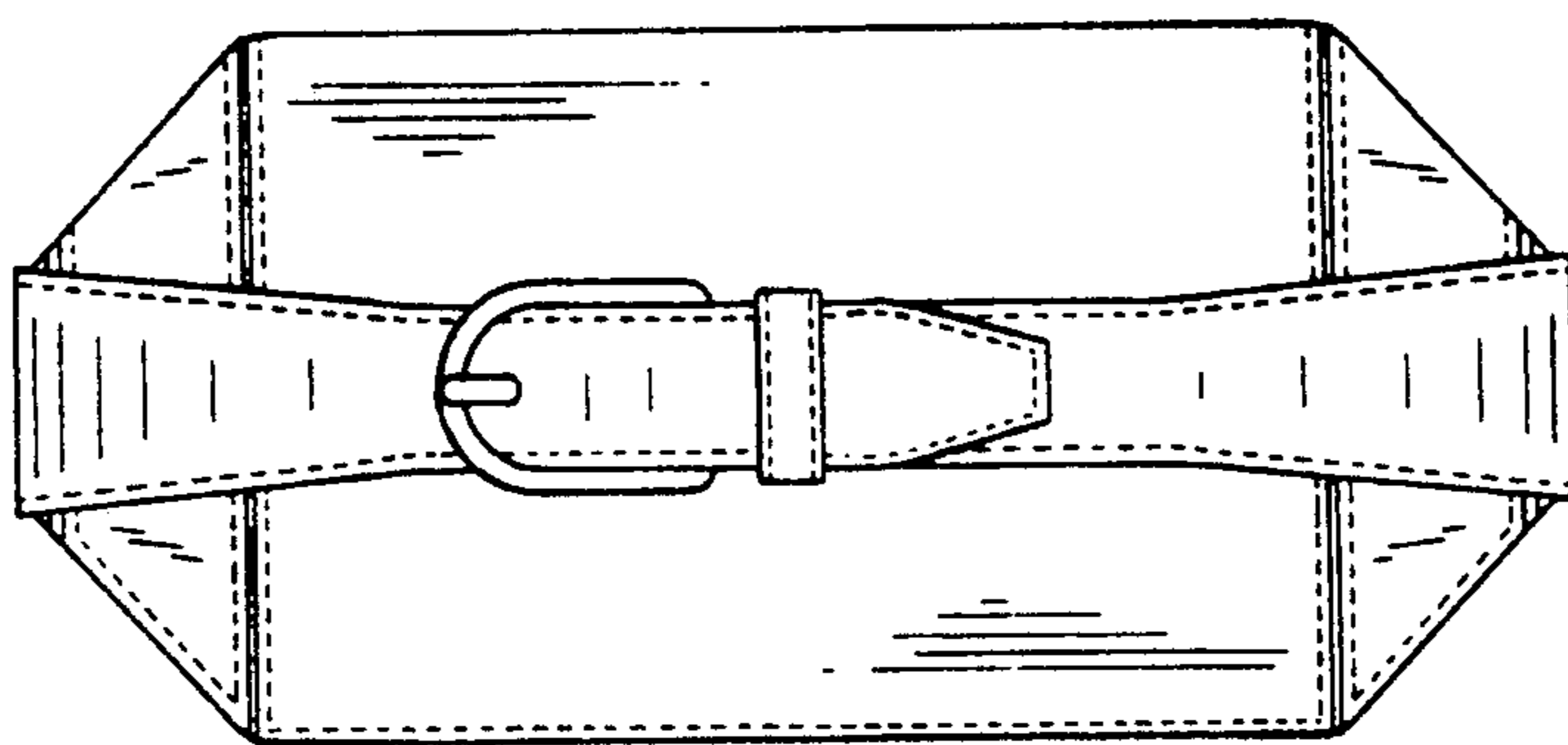

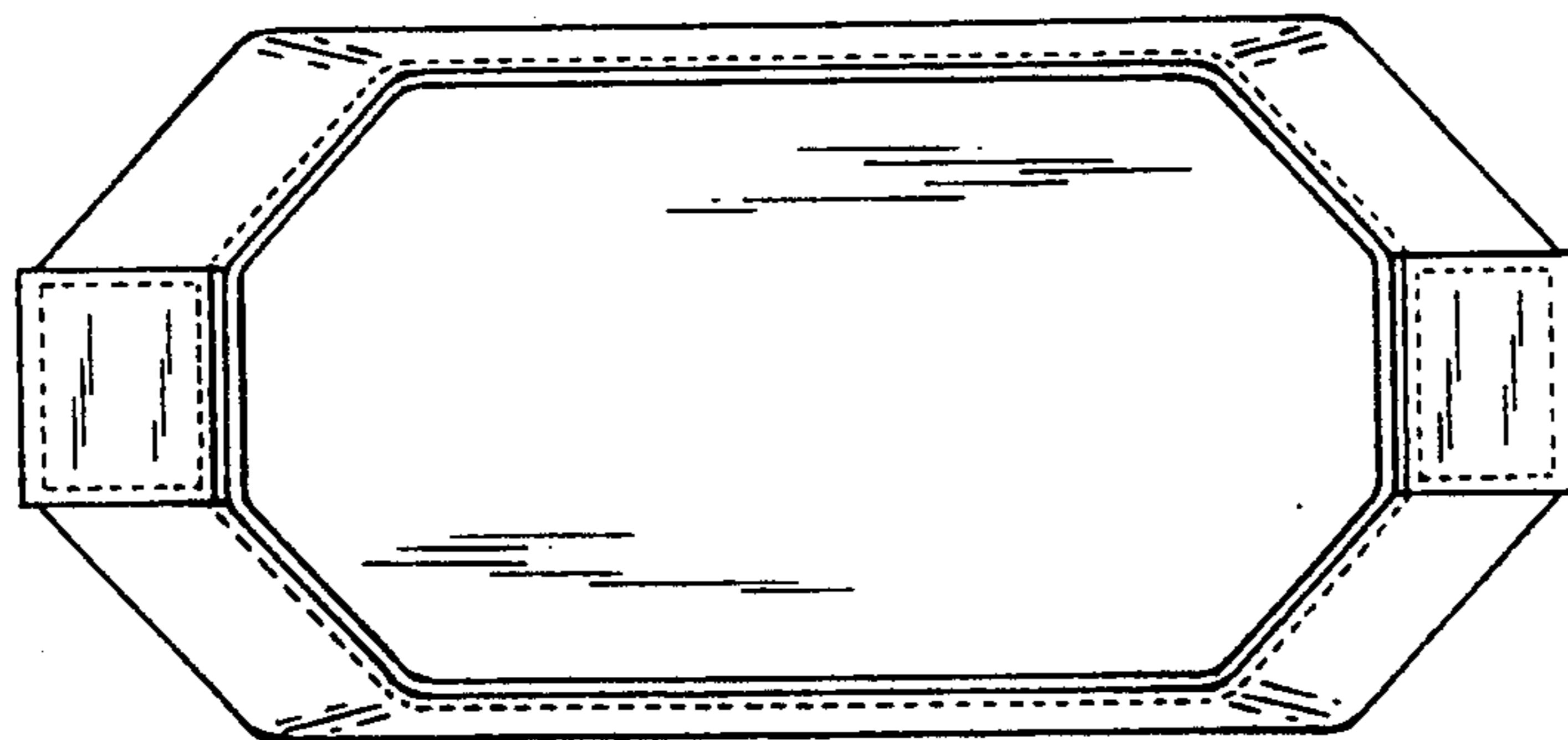
