FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

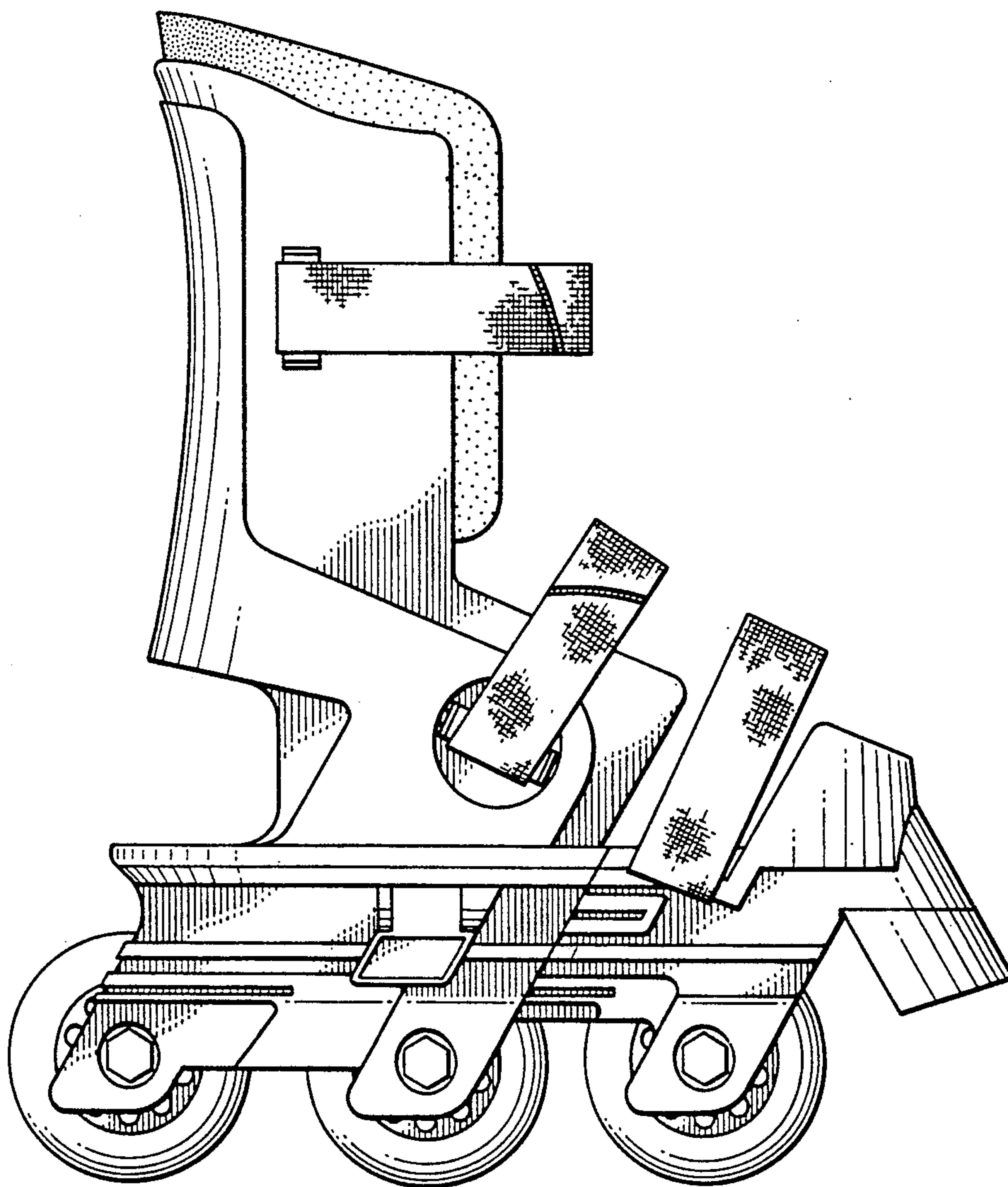
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view showing the roller skate in extended position and the latch in its raised position.



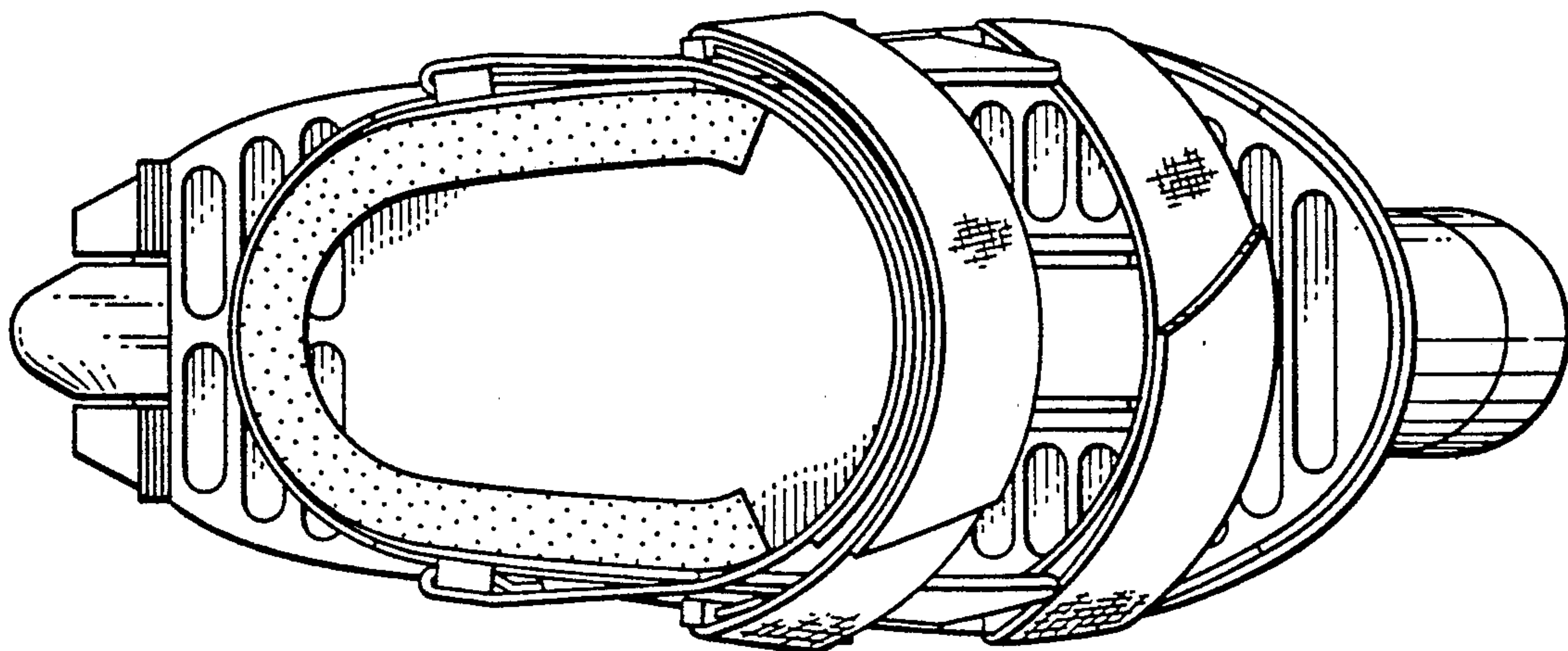

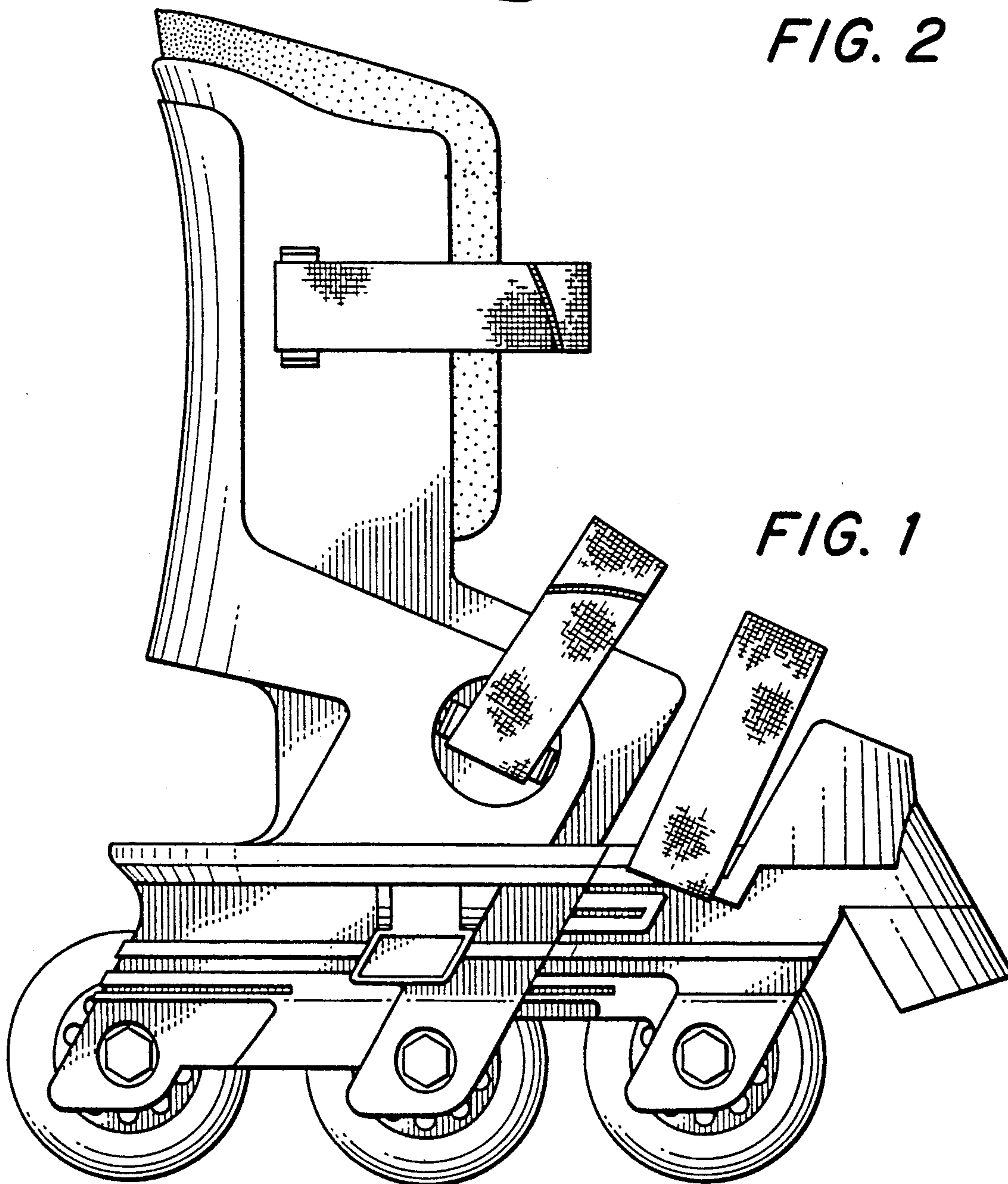

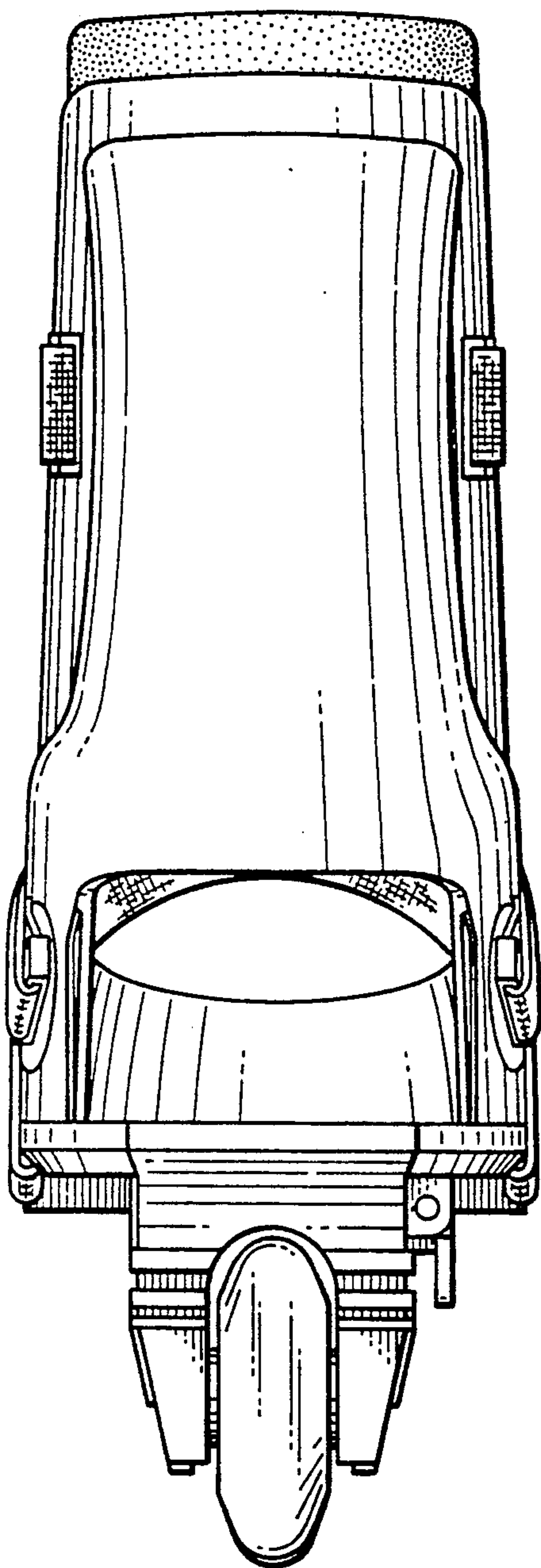

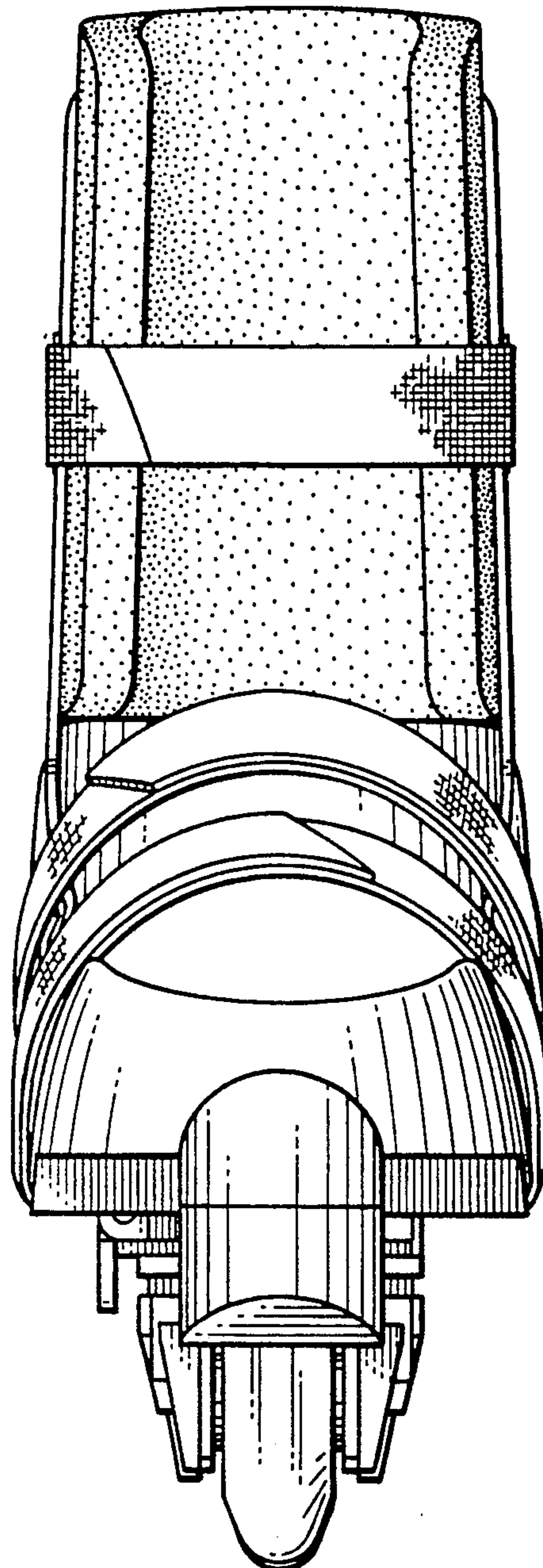

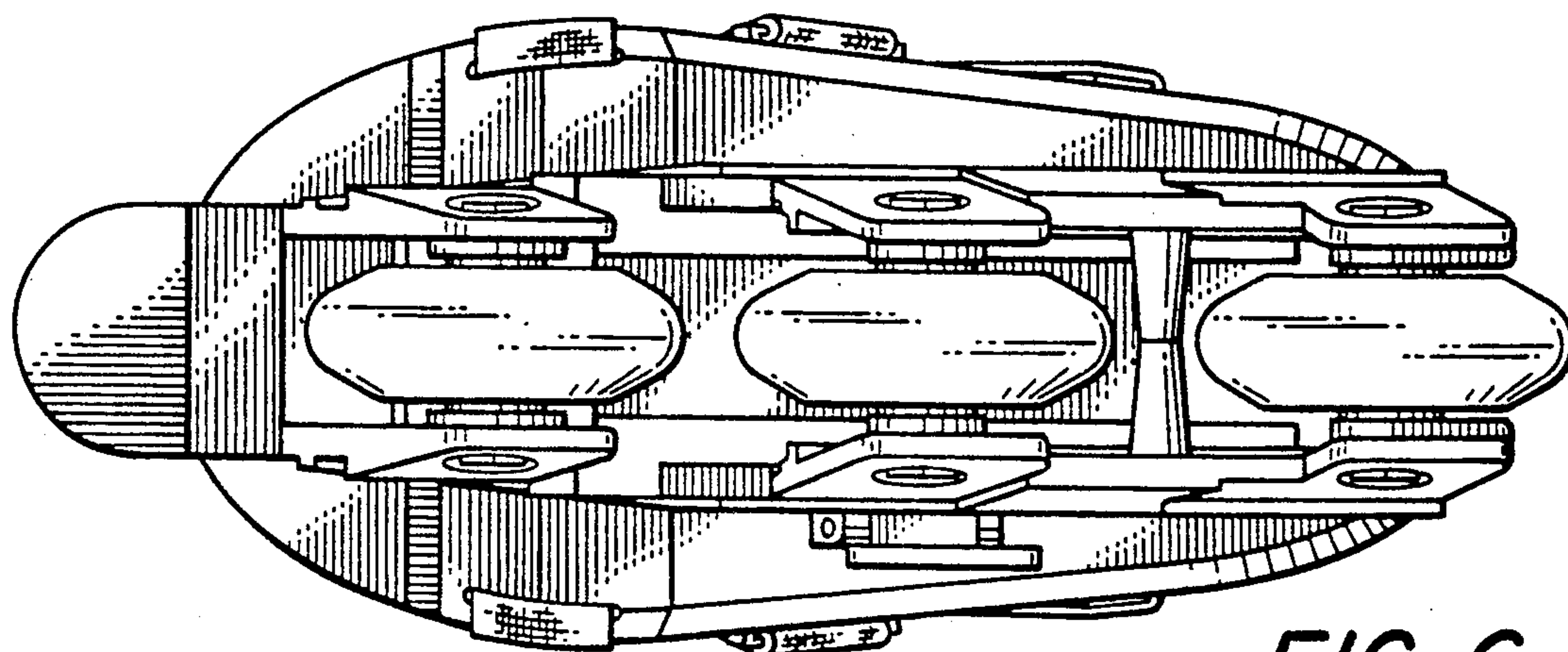
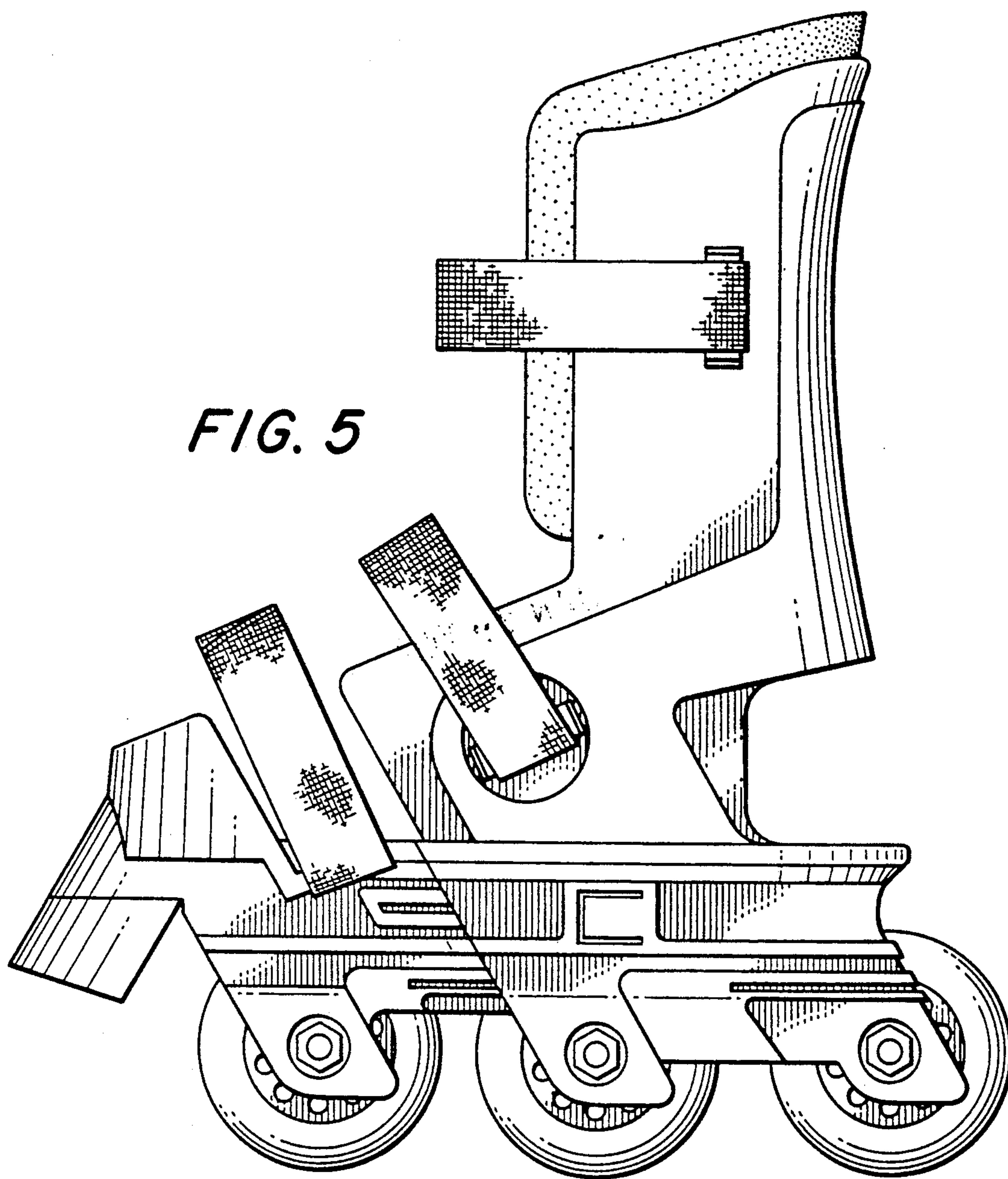

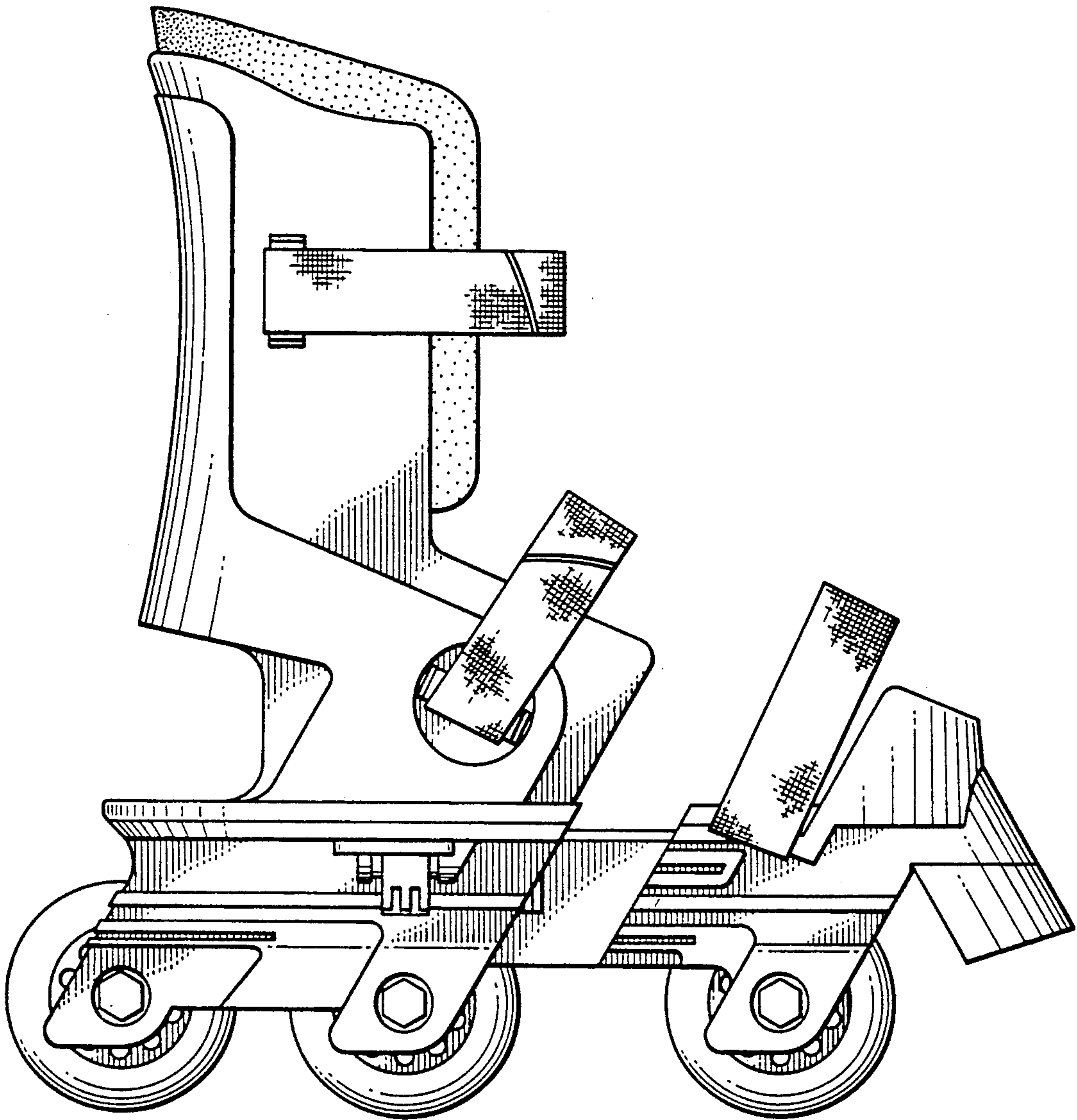
