DESCRIPTION

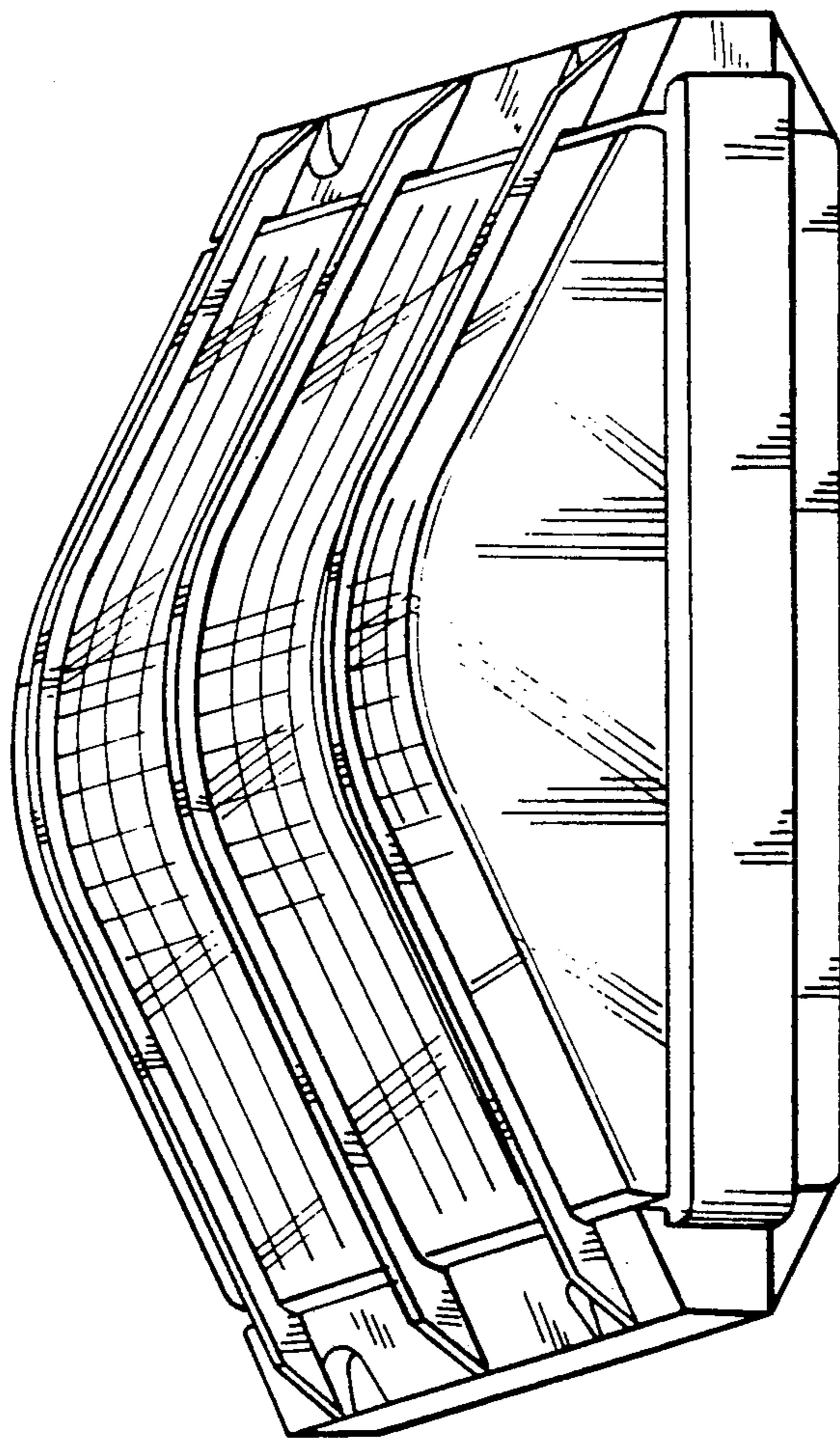
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a ceiling lamp showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view of the lamp with the diffuser;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



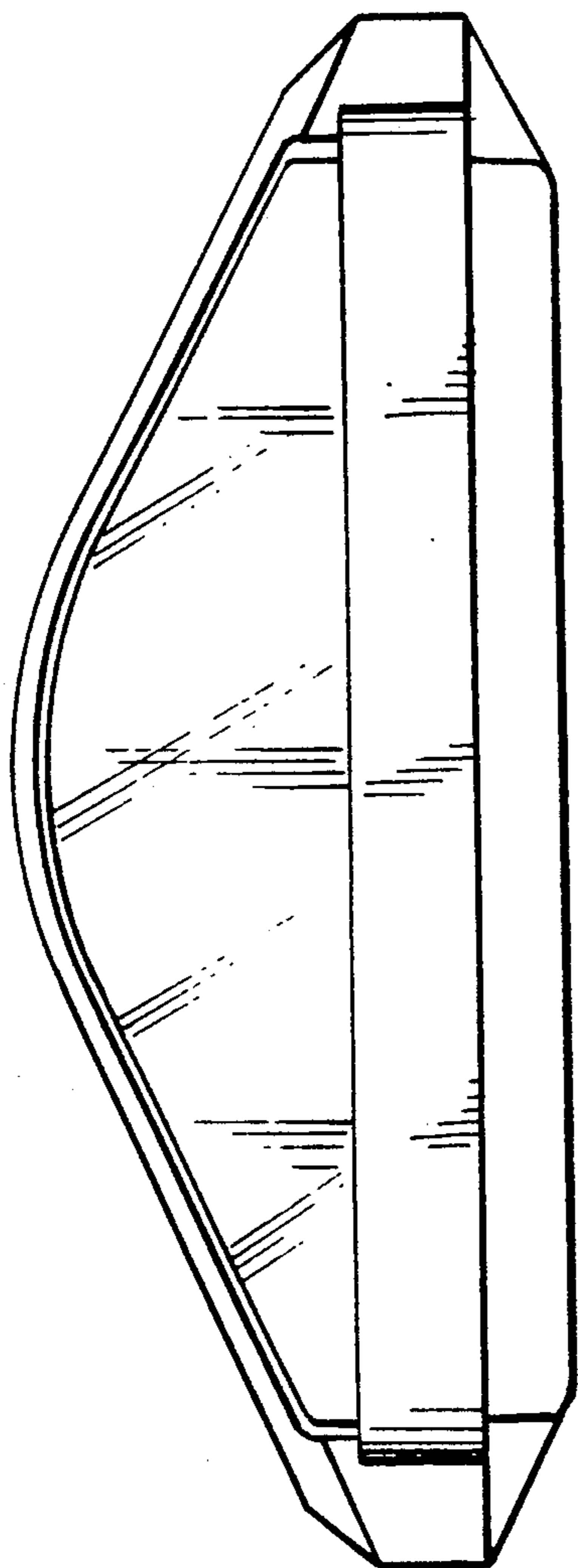

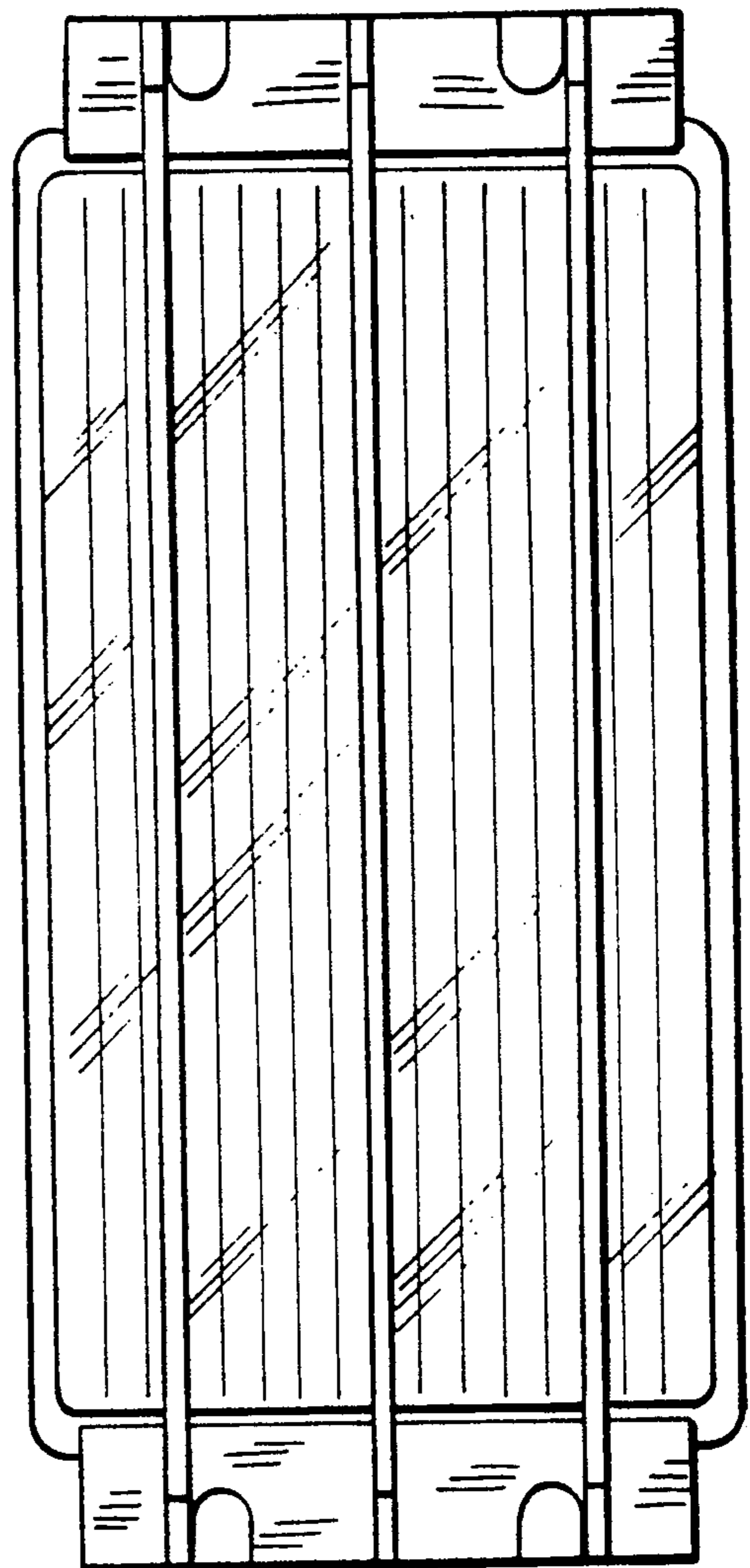

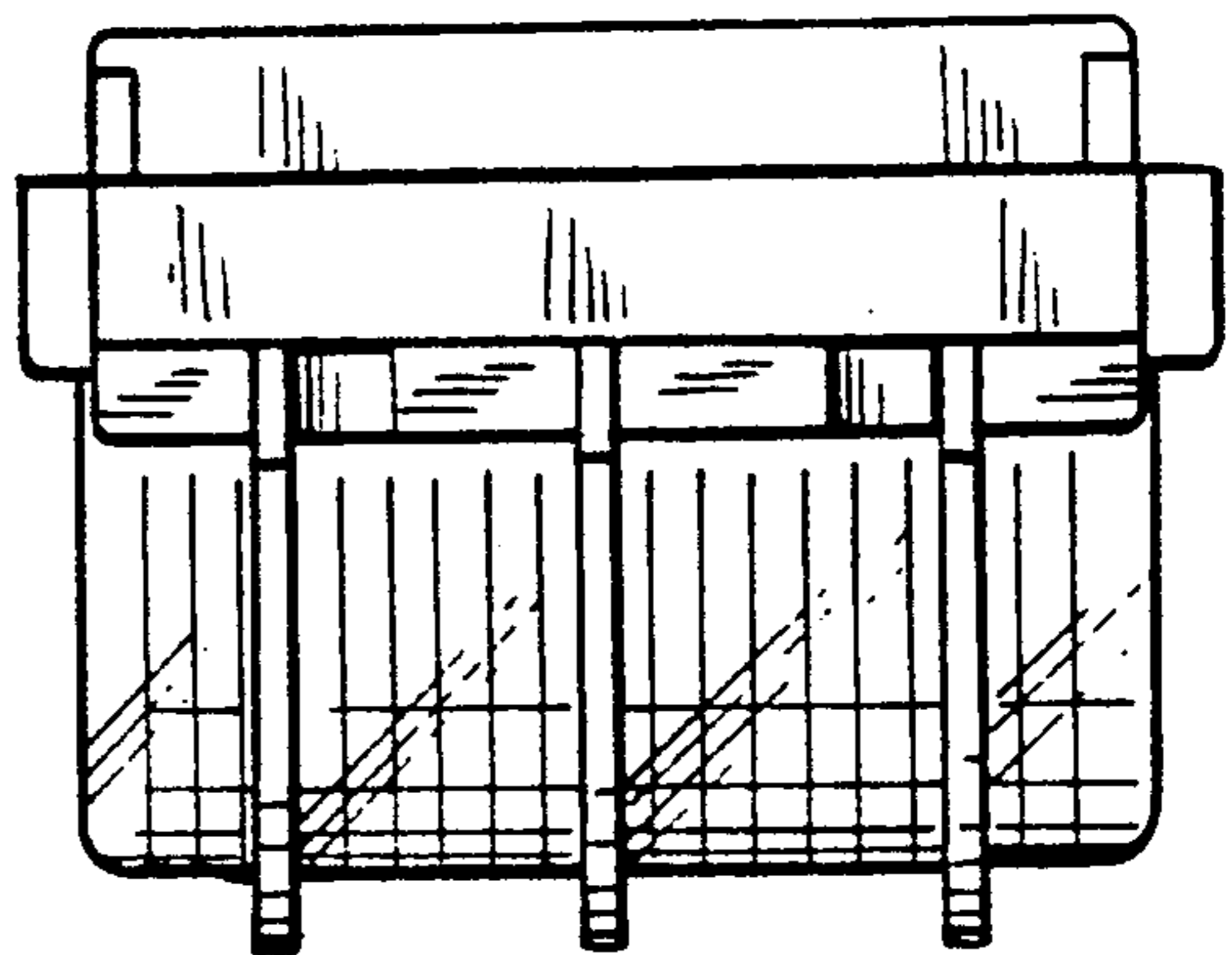

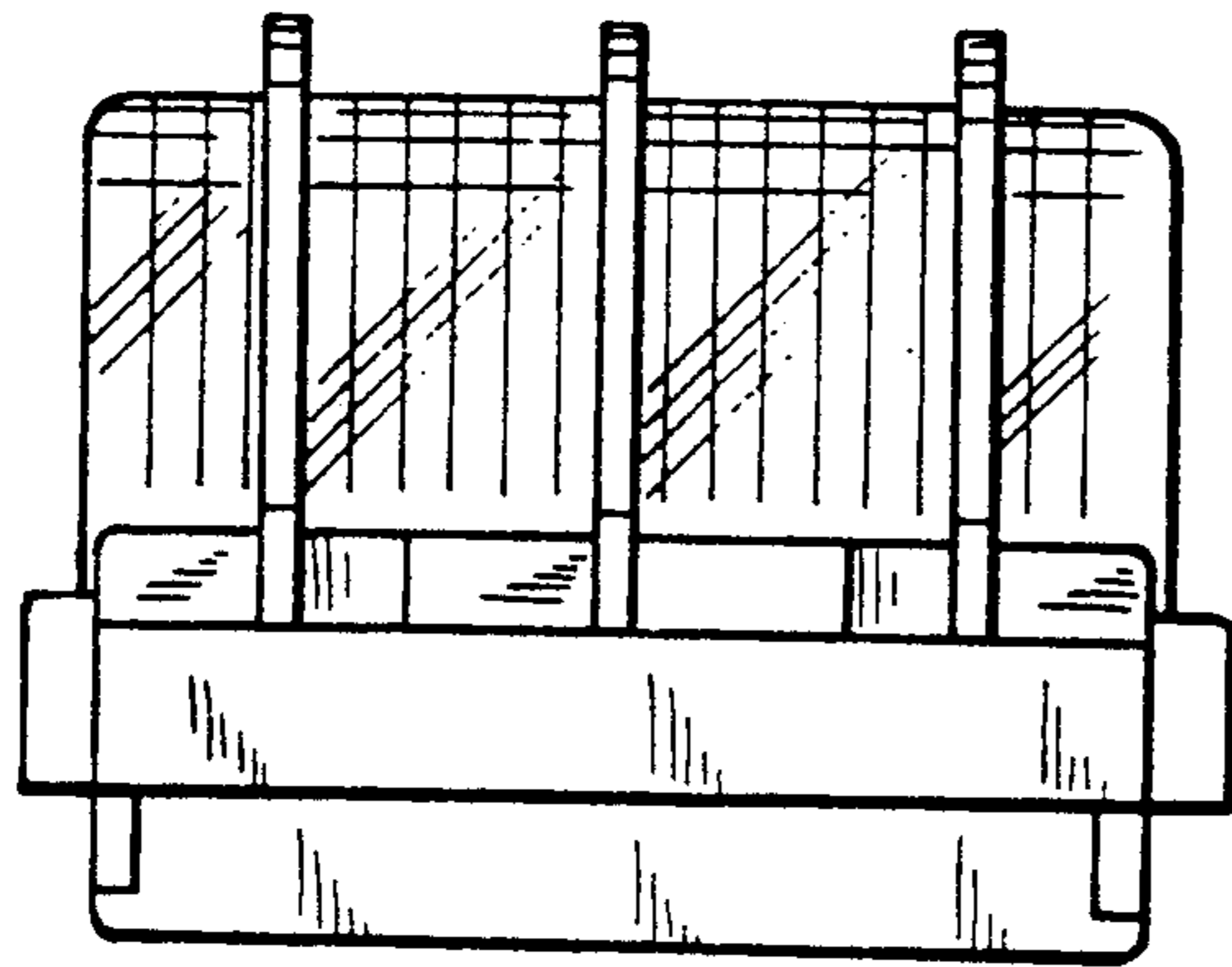

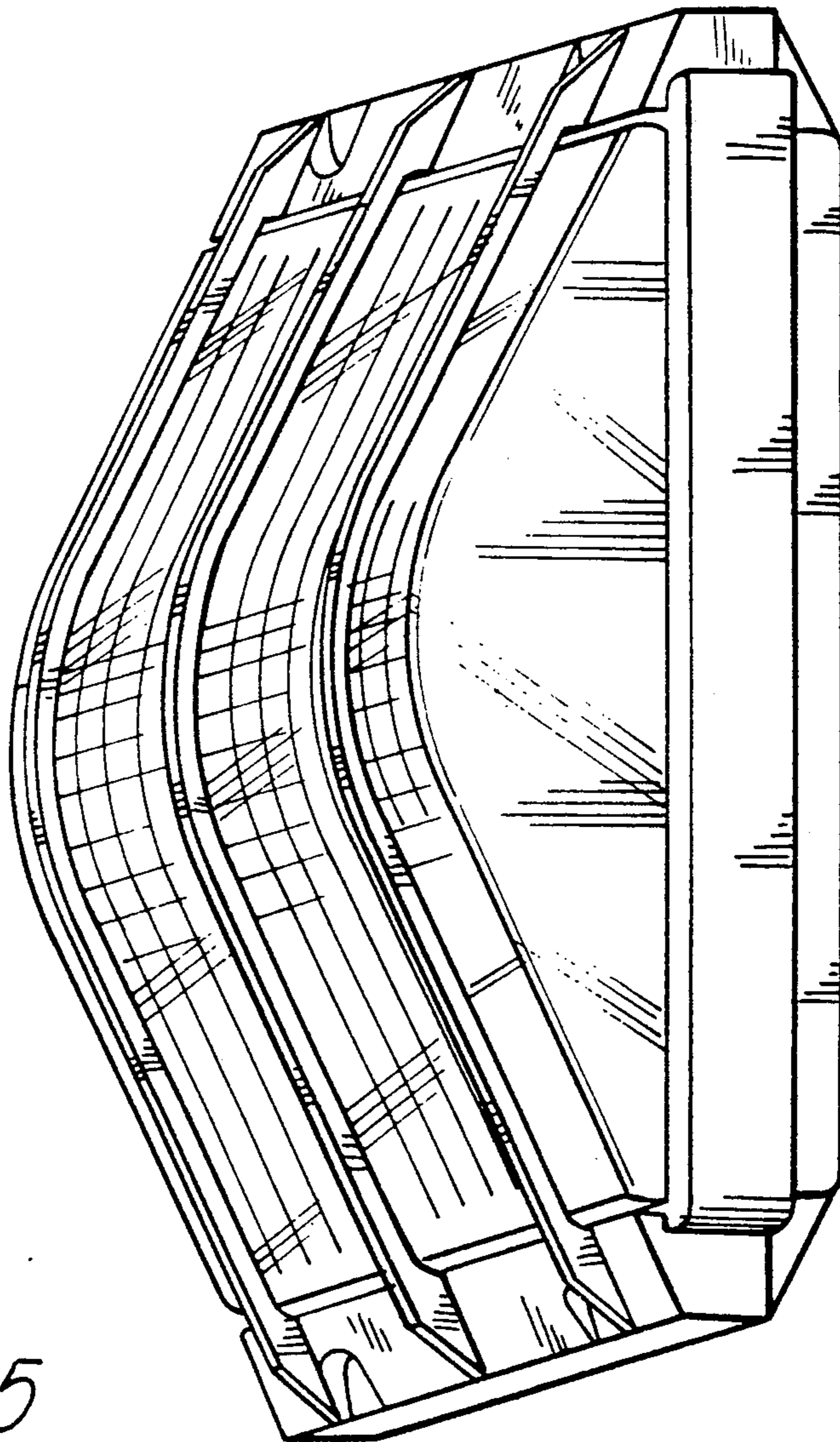
