### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a baby swing, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a baby swing showing my new design with the end flaps in an open position; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view of one of the two identical ends;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a baby swing showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of FIG. 6, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is an end elevational view of one of the two identical ends of FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 6;


FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a baby swing showing my new design with the end flaps in an open position;


FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of FIG. 11, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 13 is an end elevational view of one of the two identical ends of FIG. 11; and,


FIG. 14 is a top plan view of FIG. 11.

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






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


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




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




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
