FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;

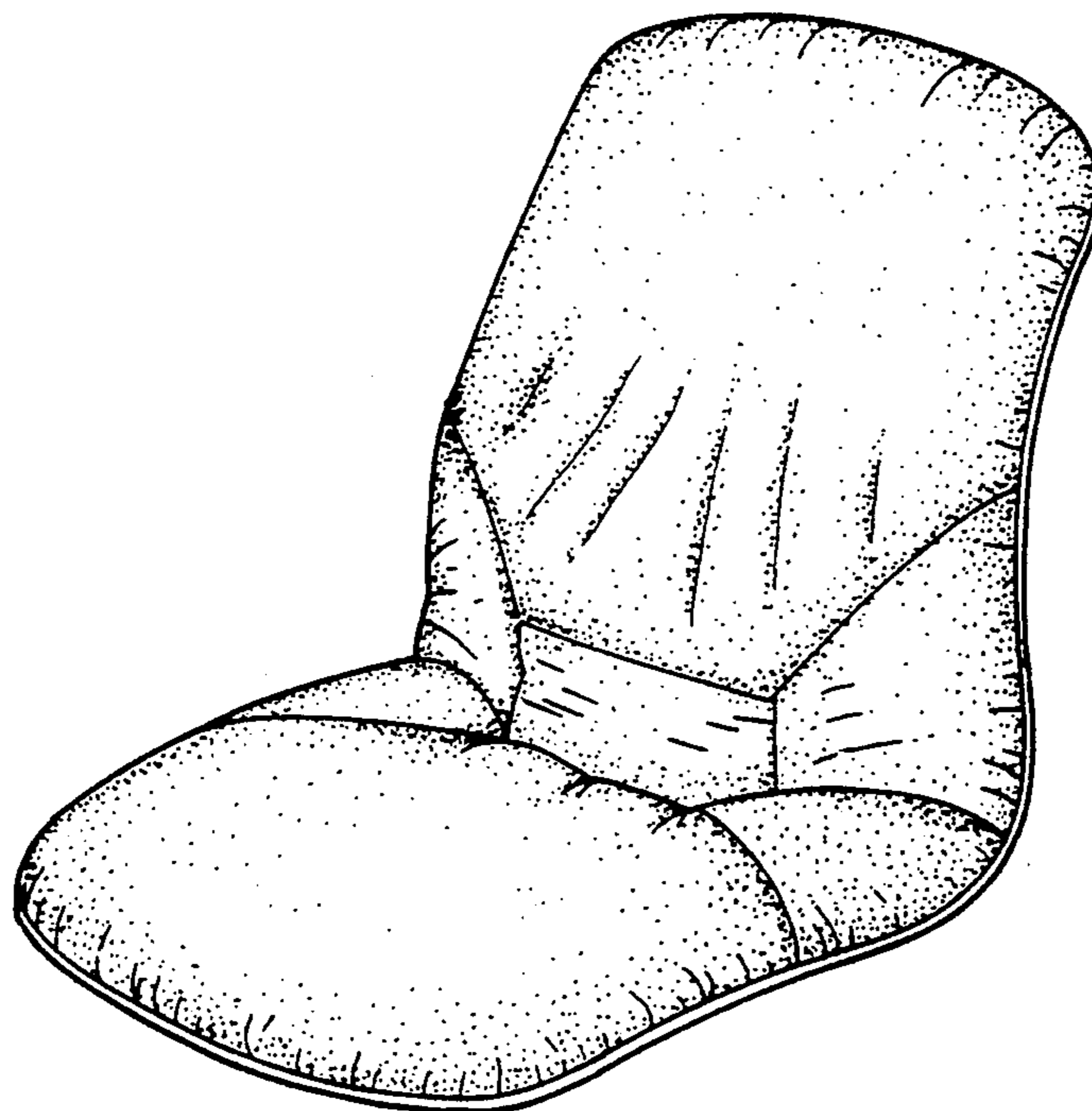
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view;

The broken line showing of arms and a base in FIG. 1 is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



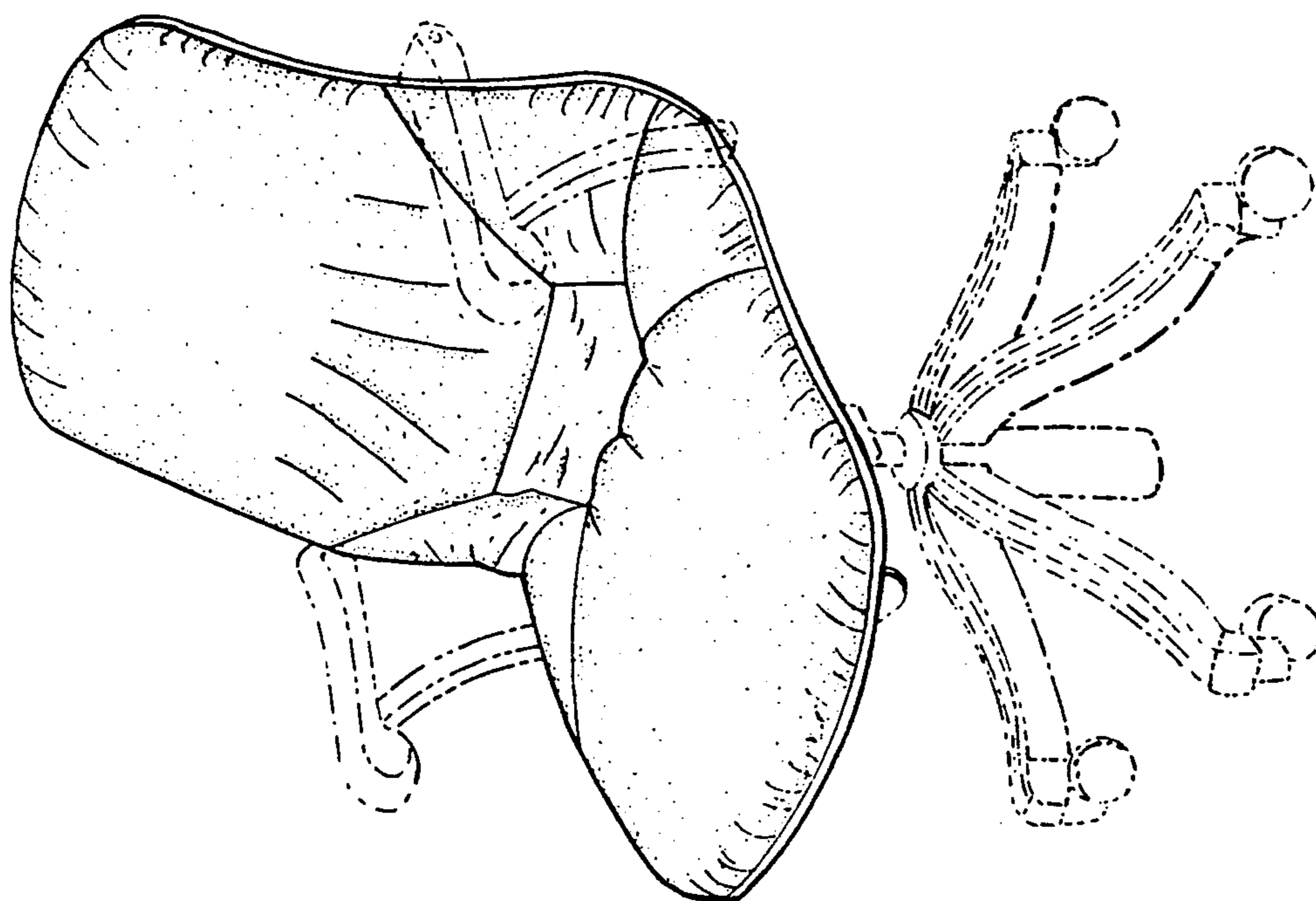

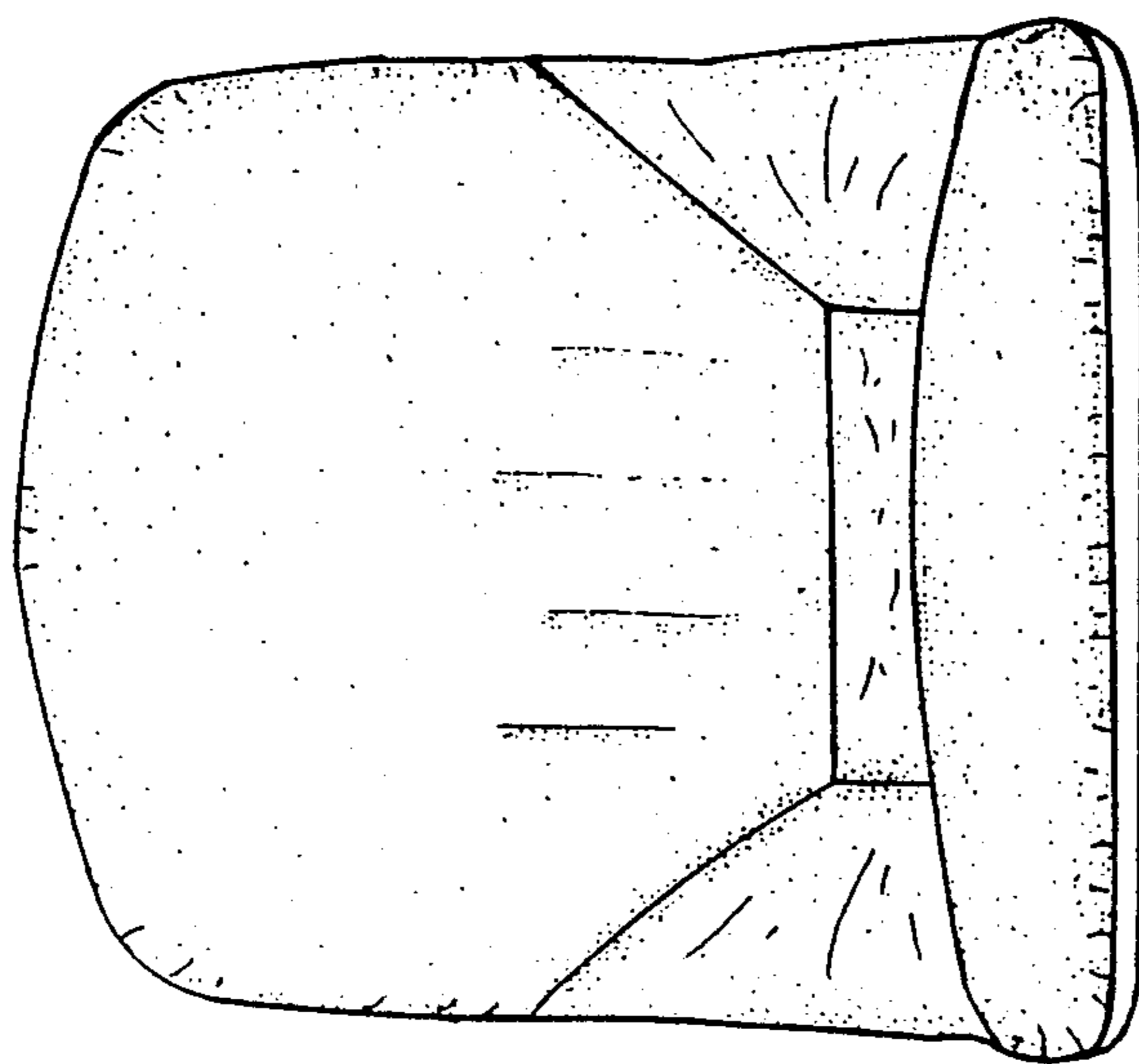

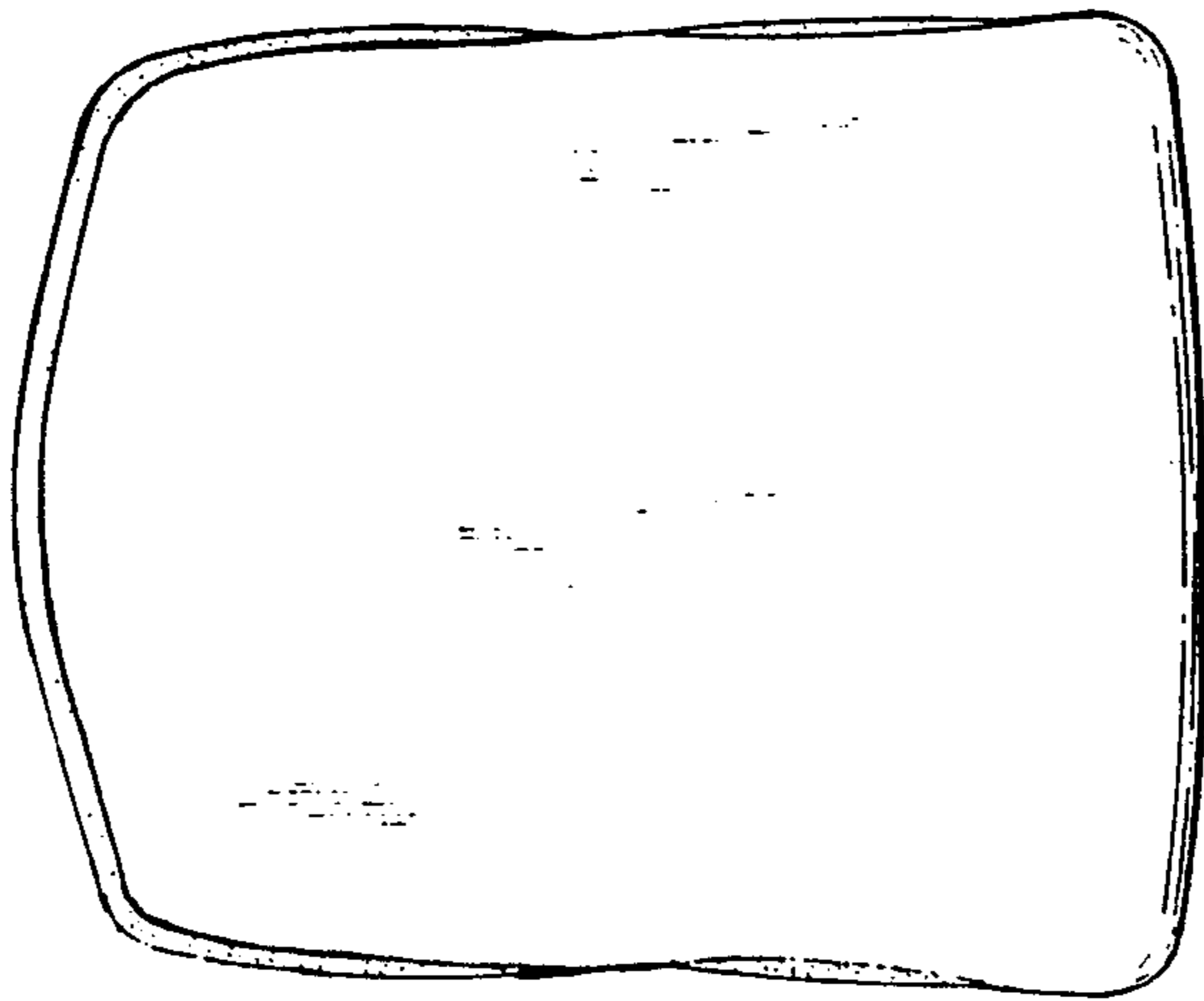

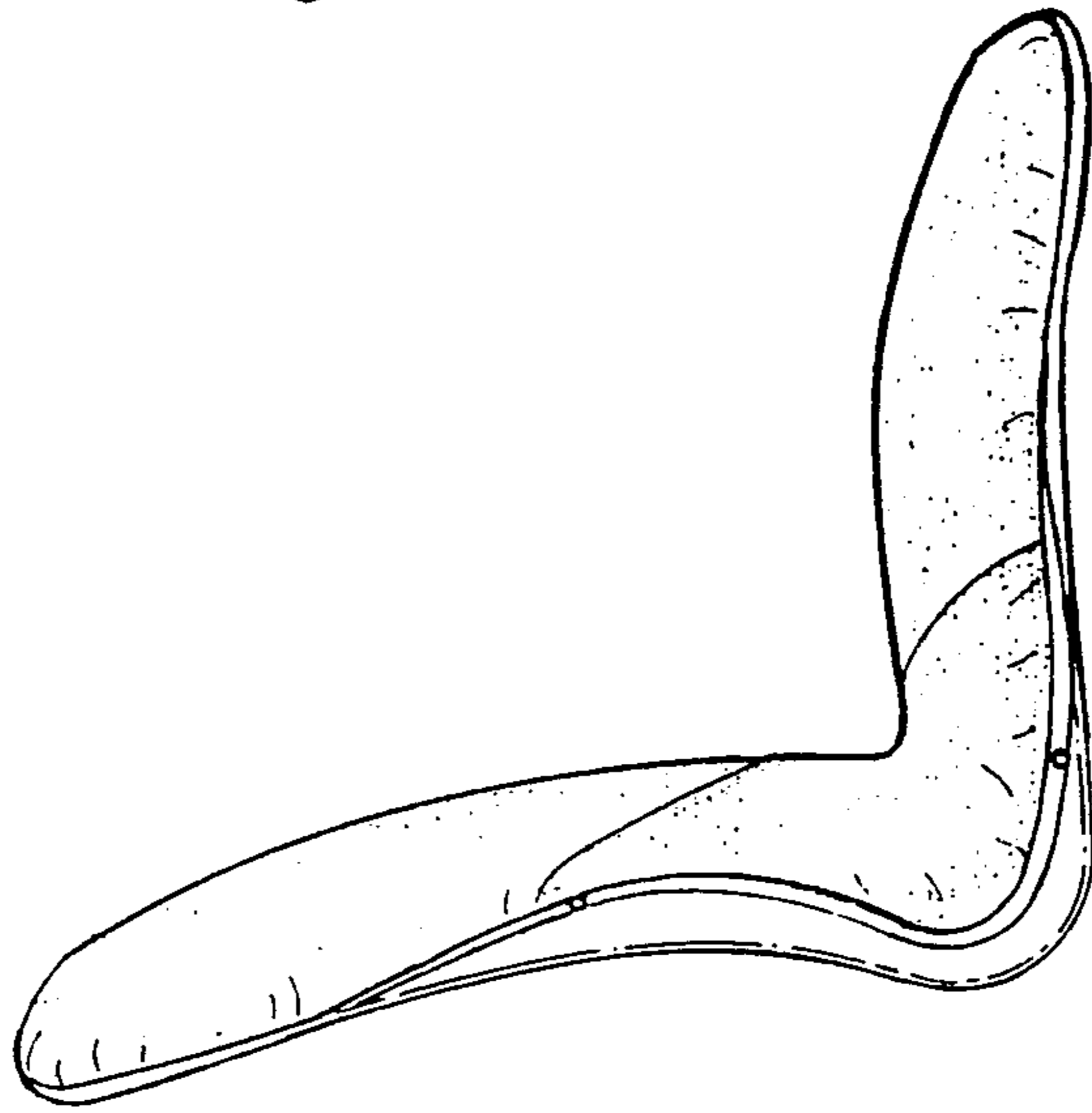

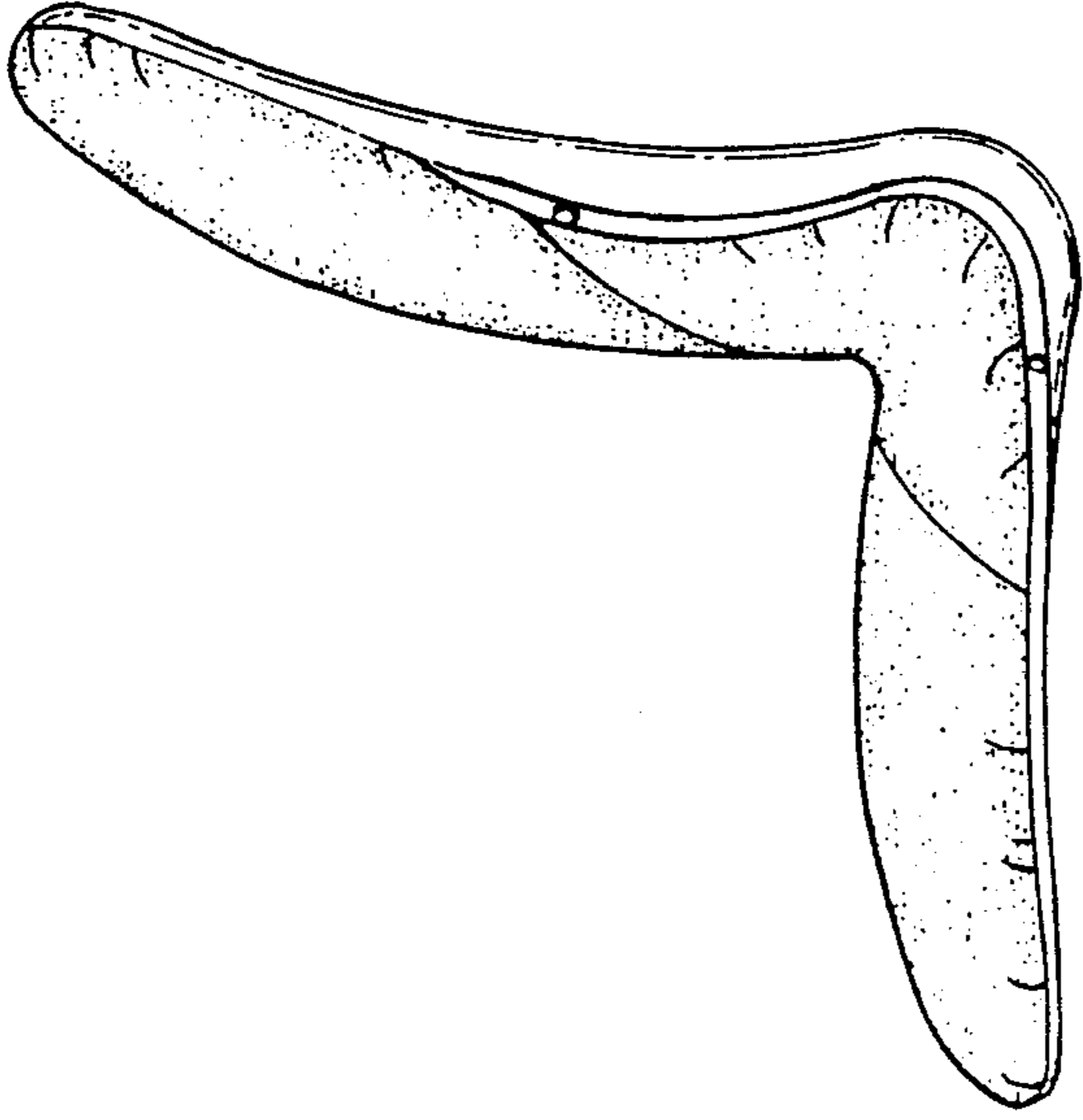

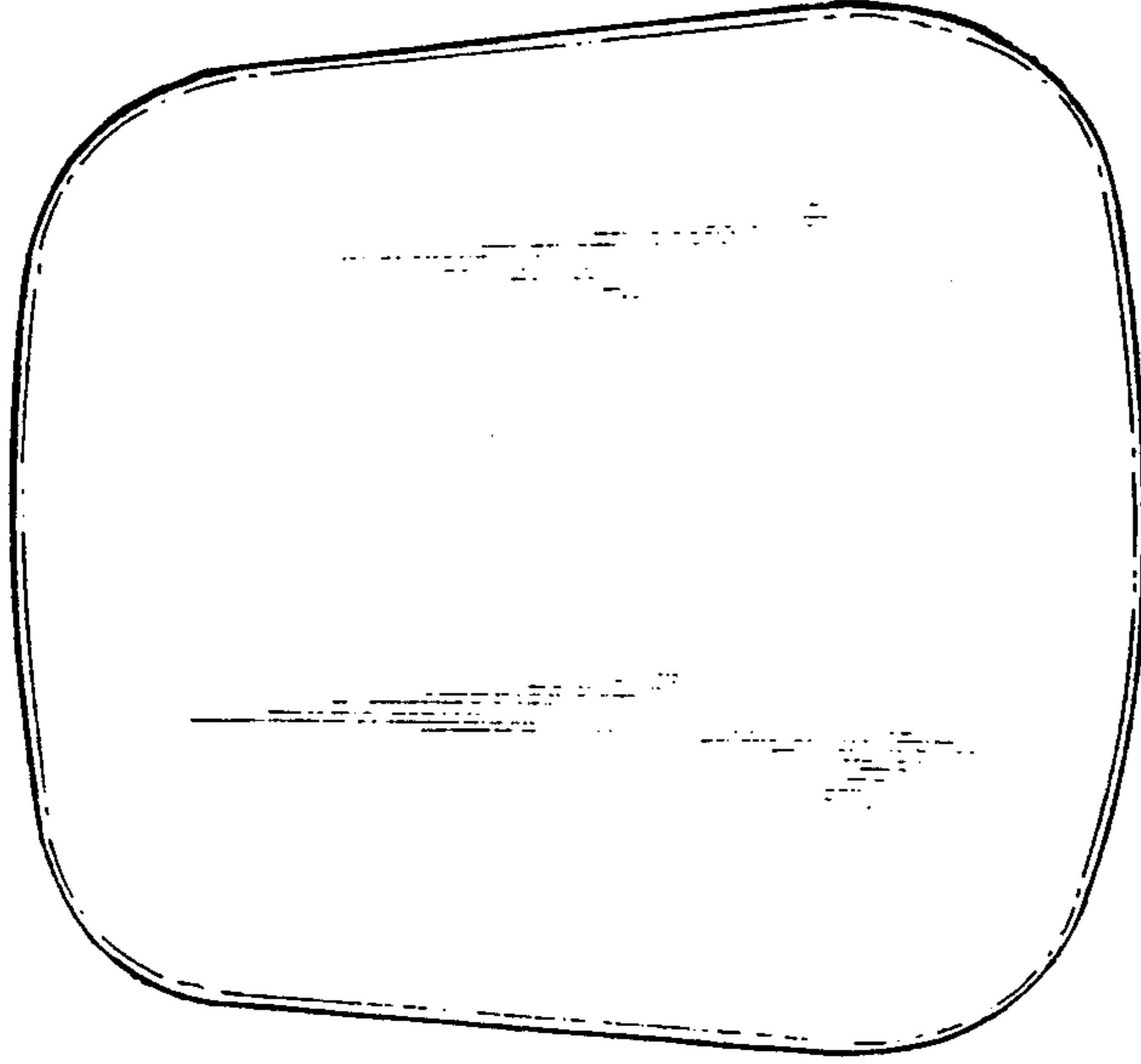

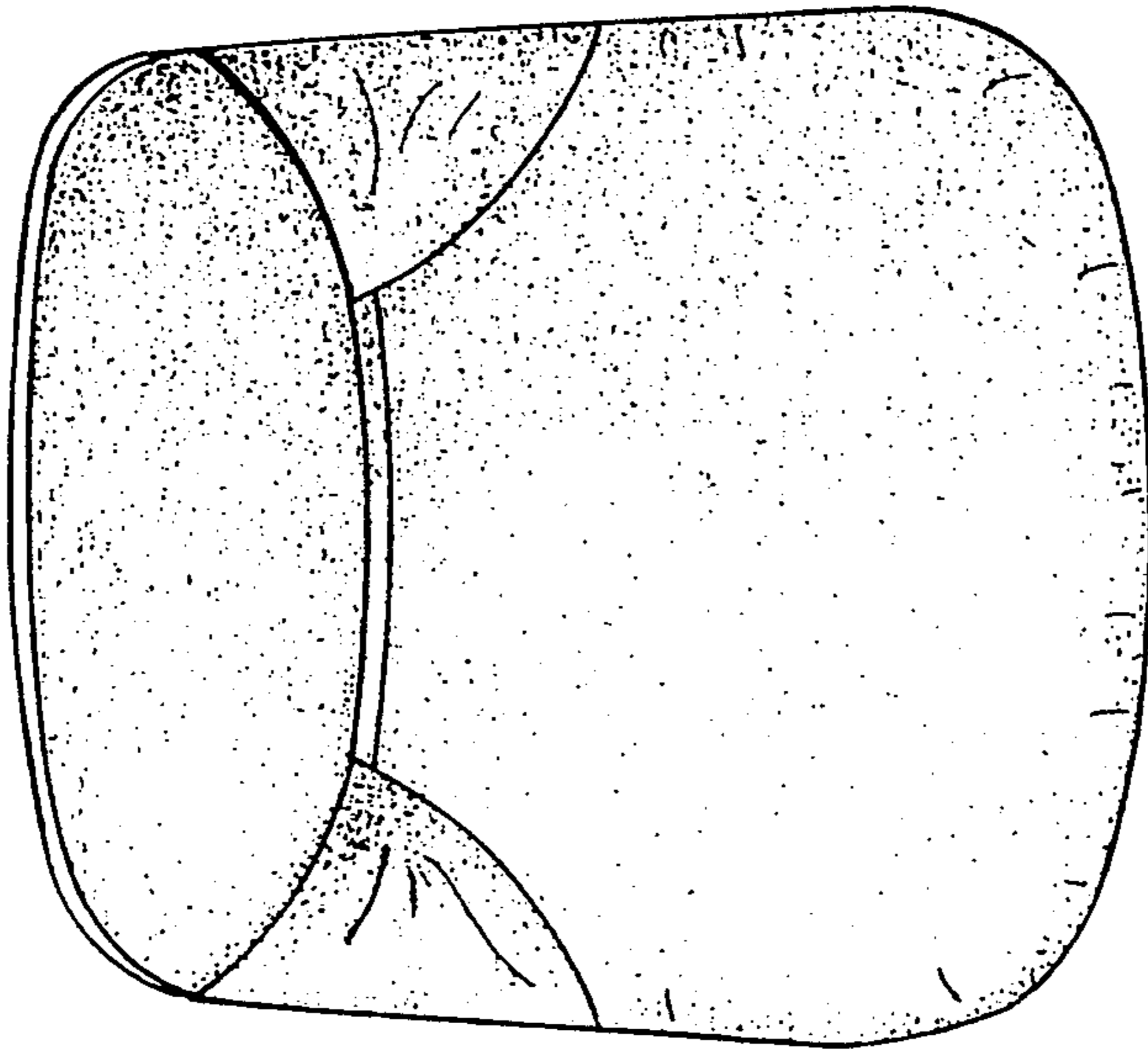

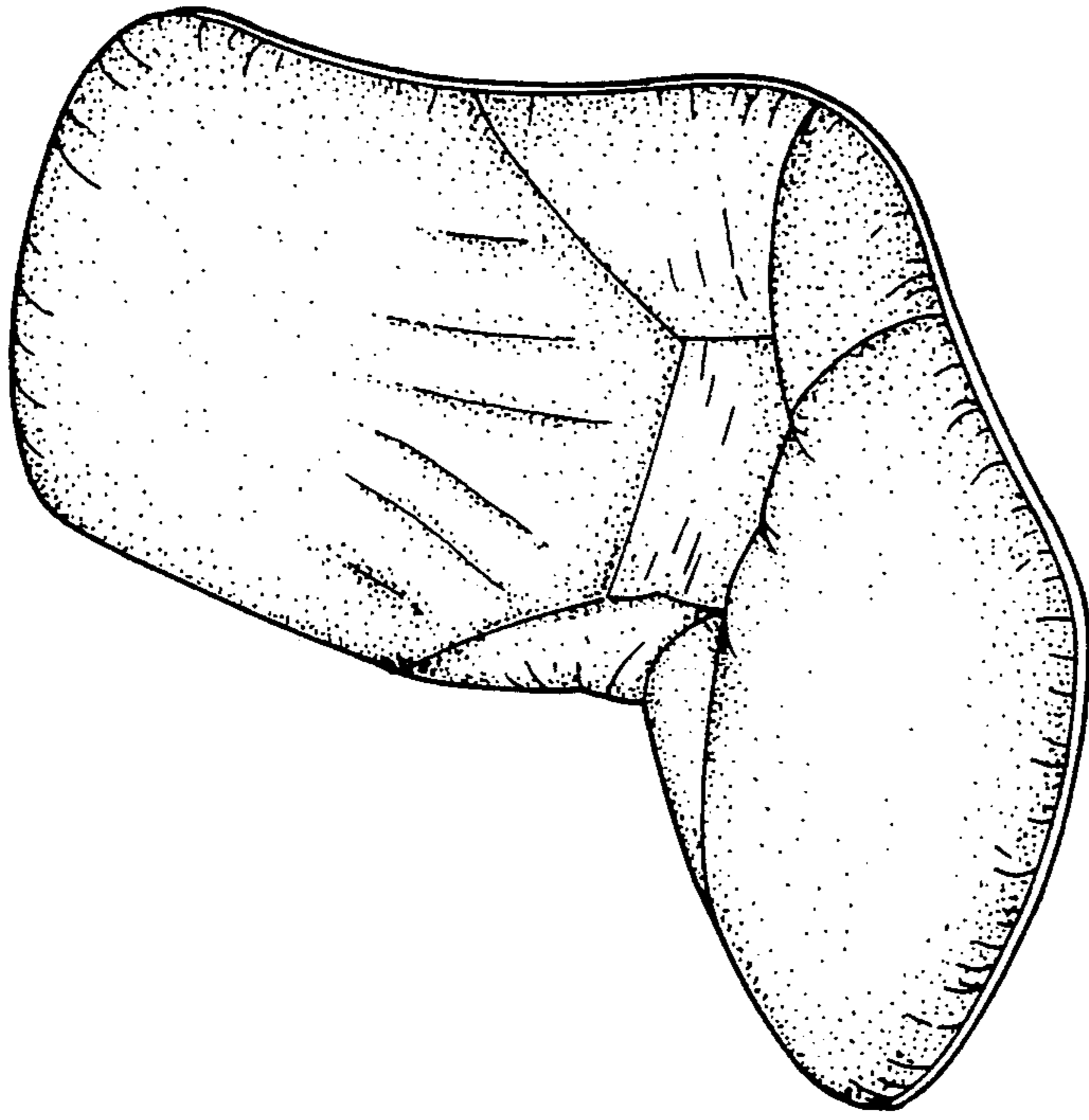
