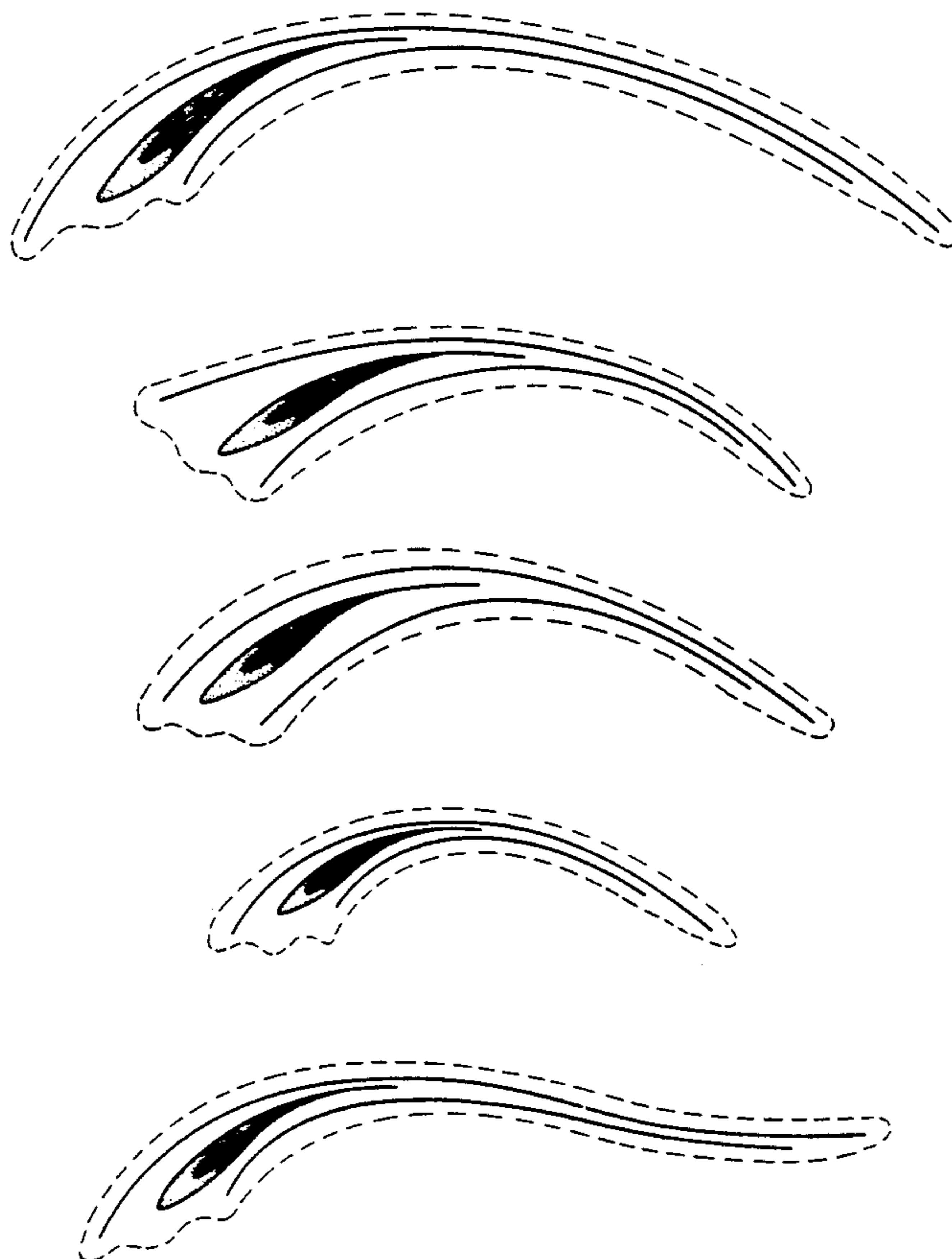

The stippling in FIGS. 1-5 represents shading in color.



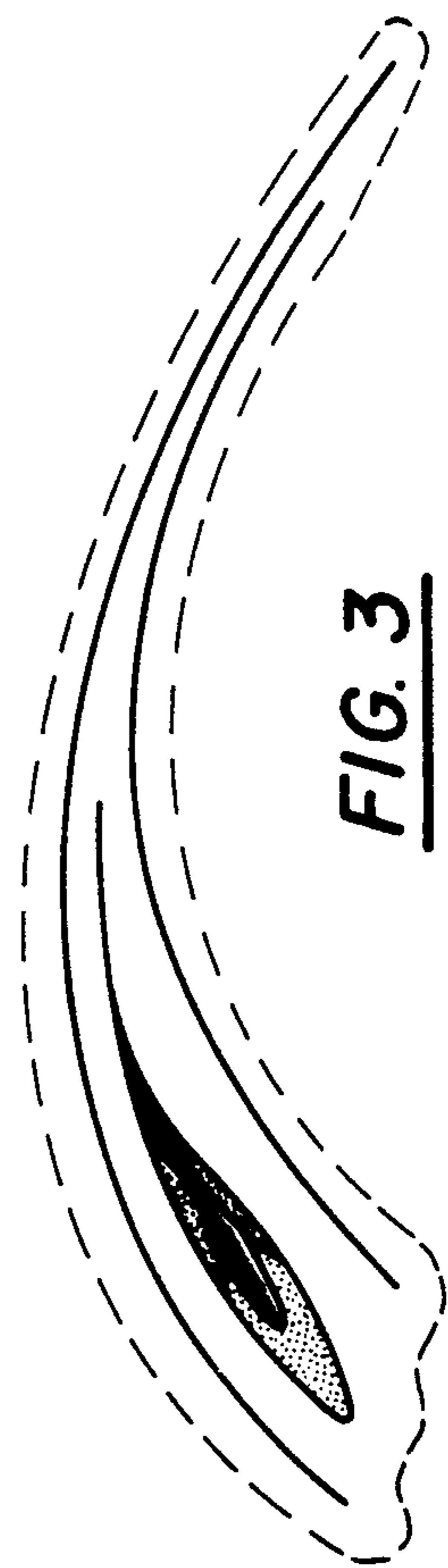
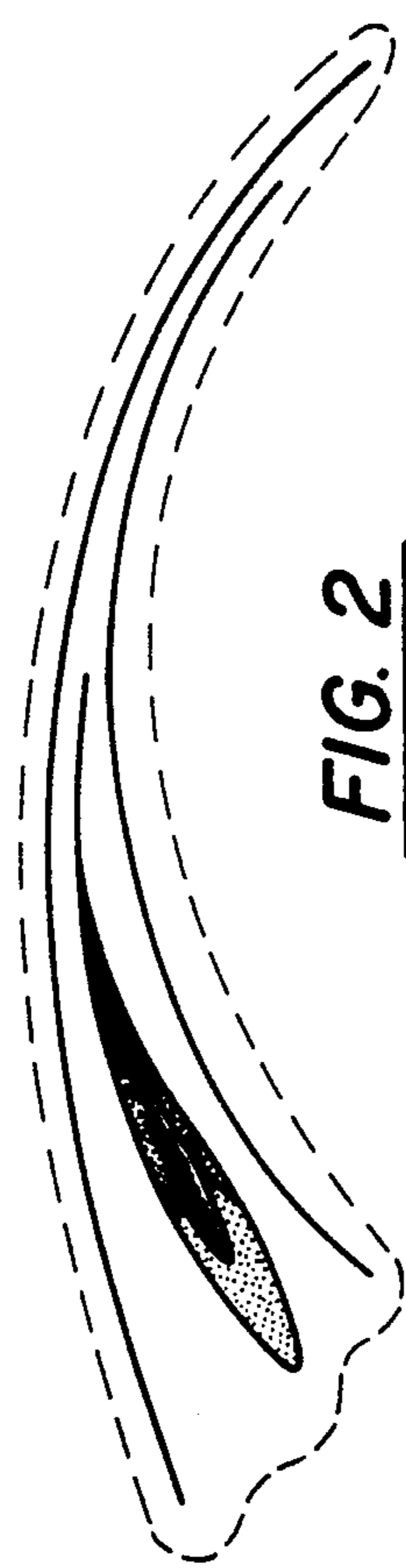
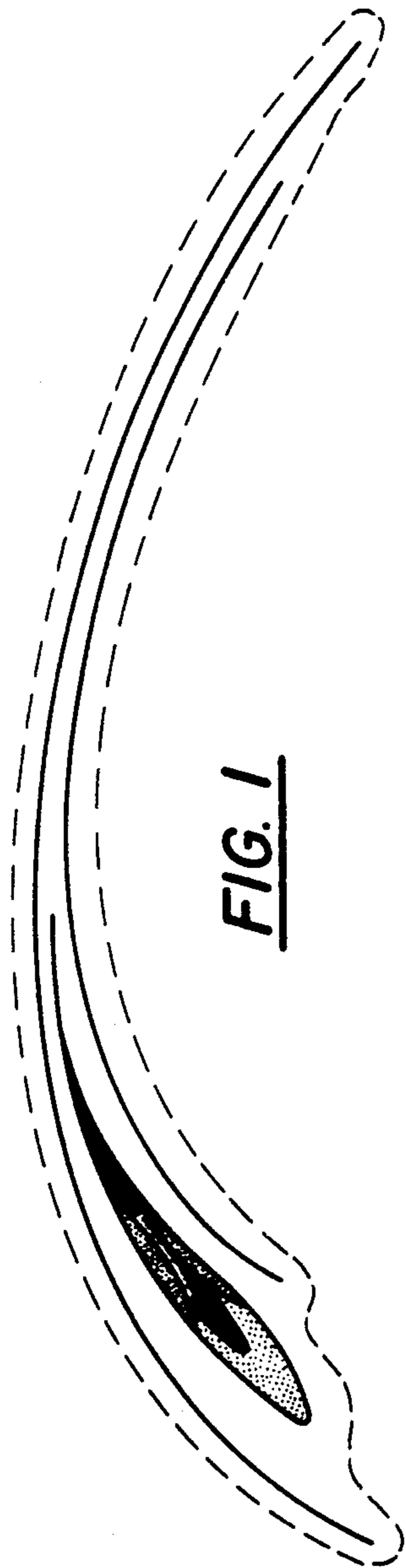
