[57]. CLAIM

The ornamental design for decalcomania for china din-

nerware or similar article, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of my new design of FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of my new design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of my new design of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a fifth embodiment of my new design of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing in FIGS. 1-5 of the background surface for the decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article is illustrative of environmental structure only and forms no part of the claimed design. The decalcomania in FIGS. 1-5 is of no substantial thickness.

The stippling in FIGS. 1-5 represents shading in color.
