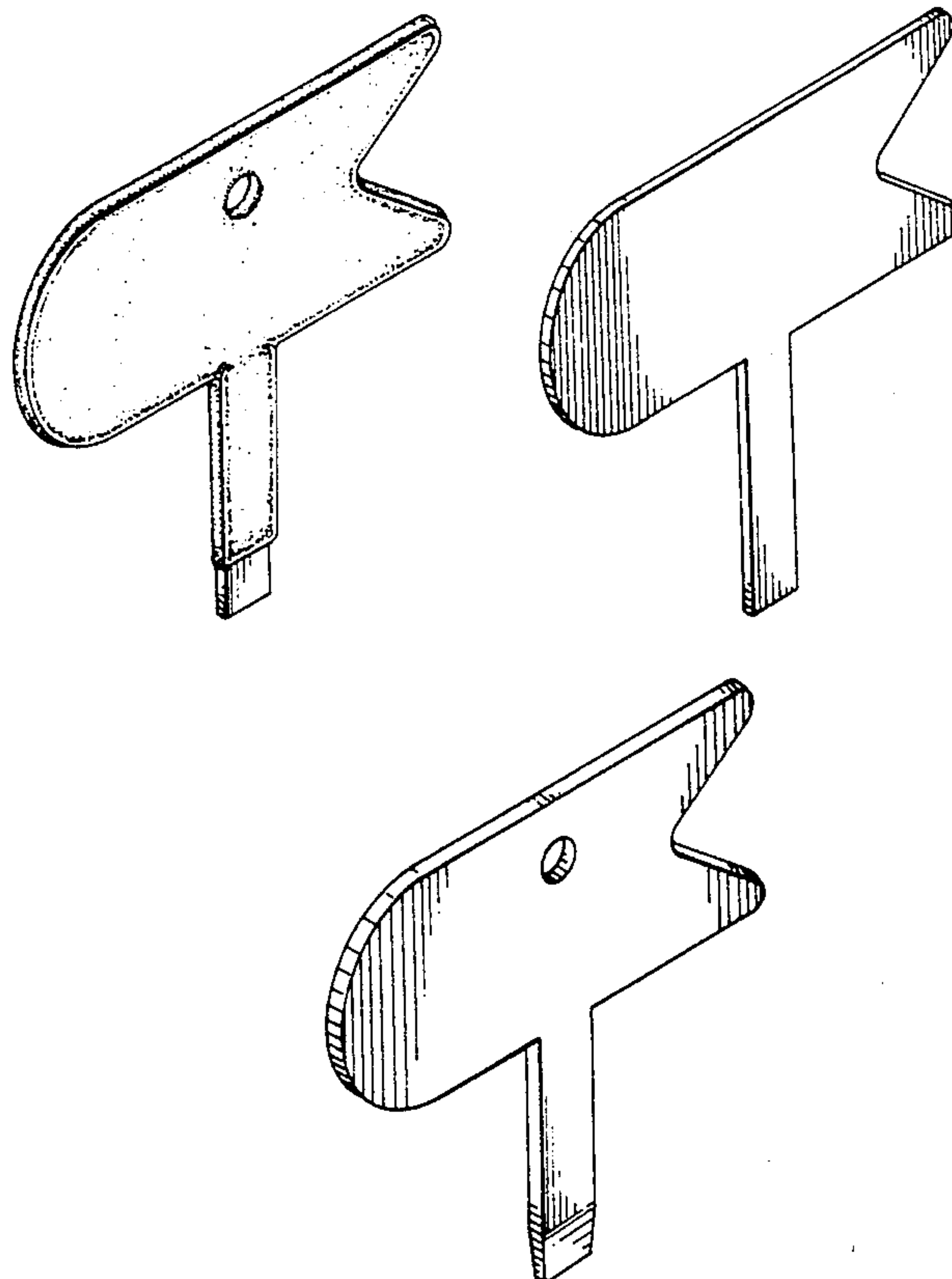

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an opener for jars and cans showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 12 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 13 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of FIG. 13, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 15 is a top plan view of FIG. 13;
FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 13;
FIG. 17 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 13; and,
FIG. 18 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 13.



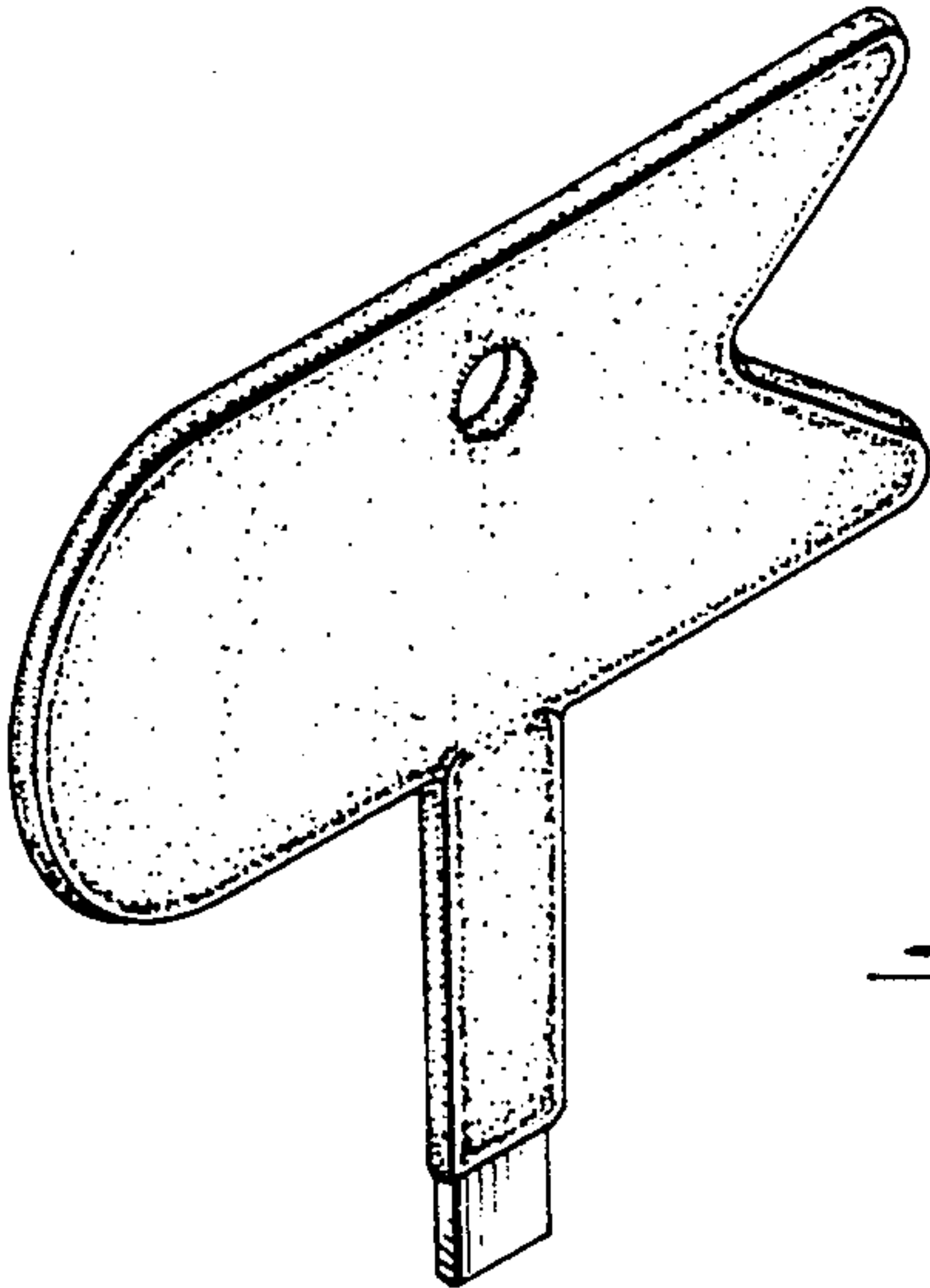

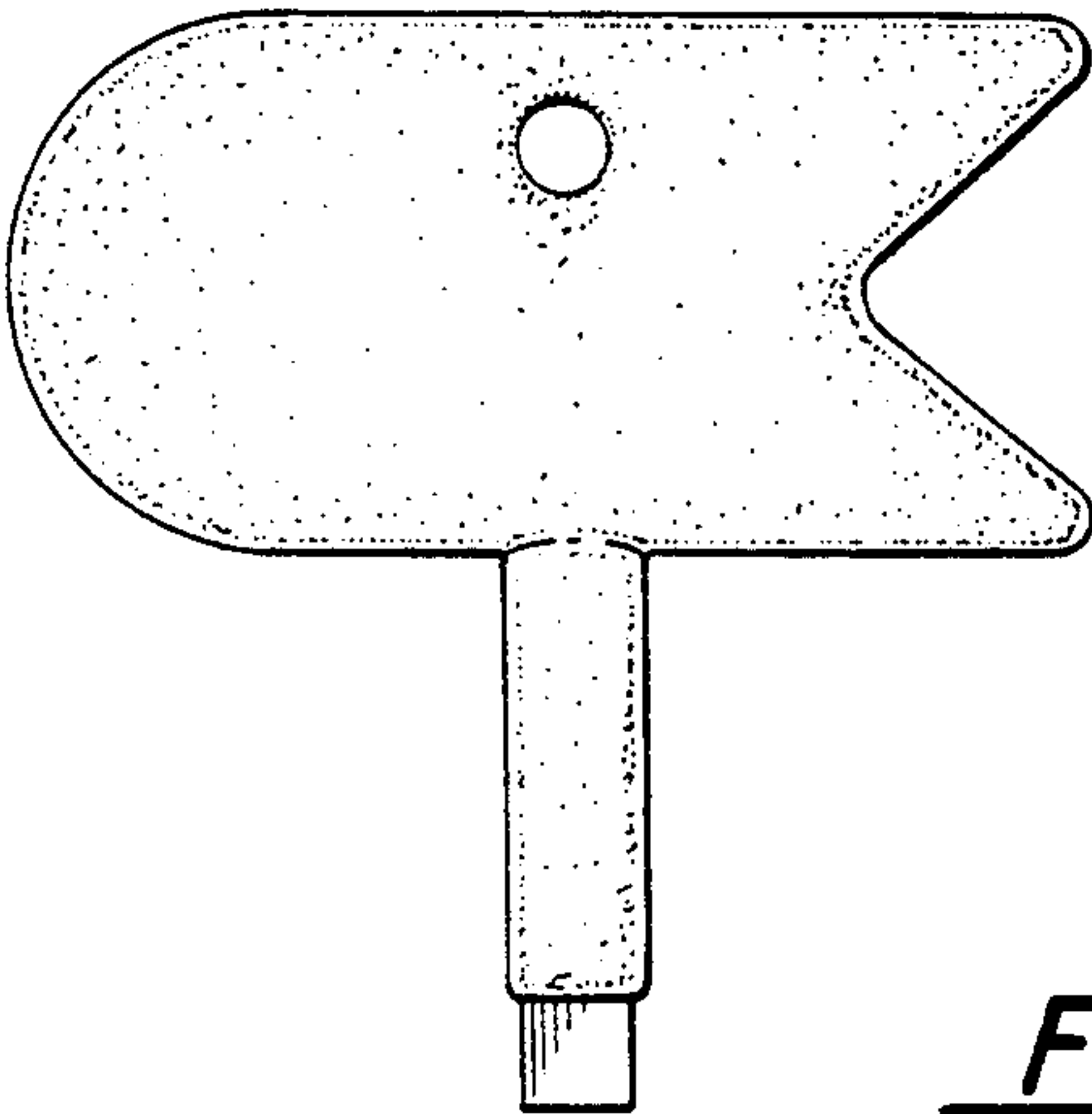

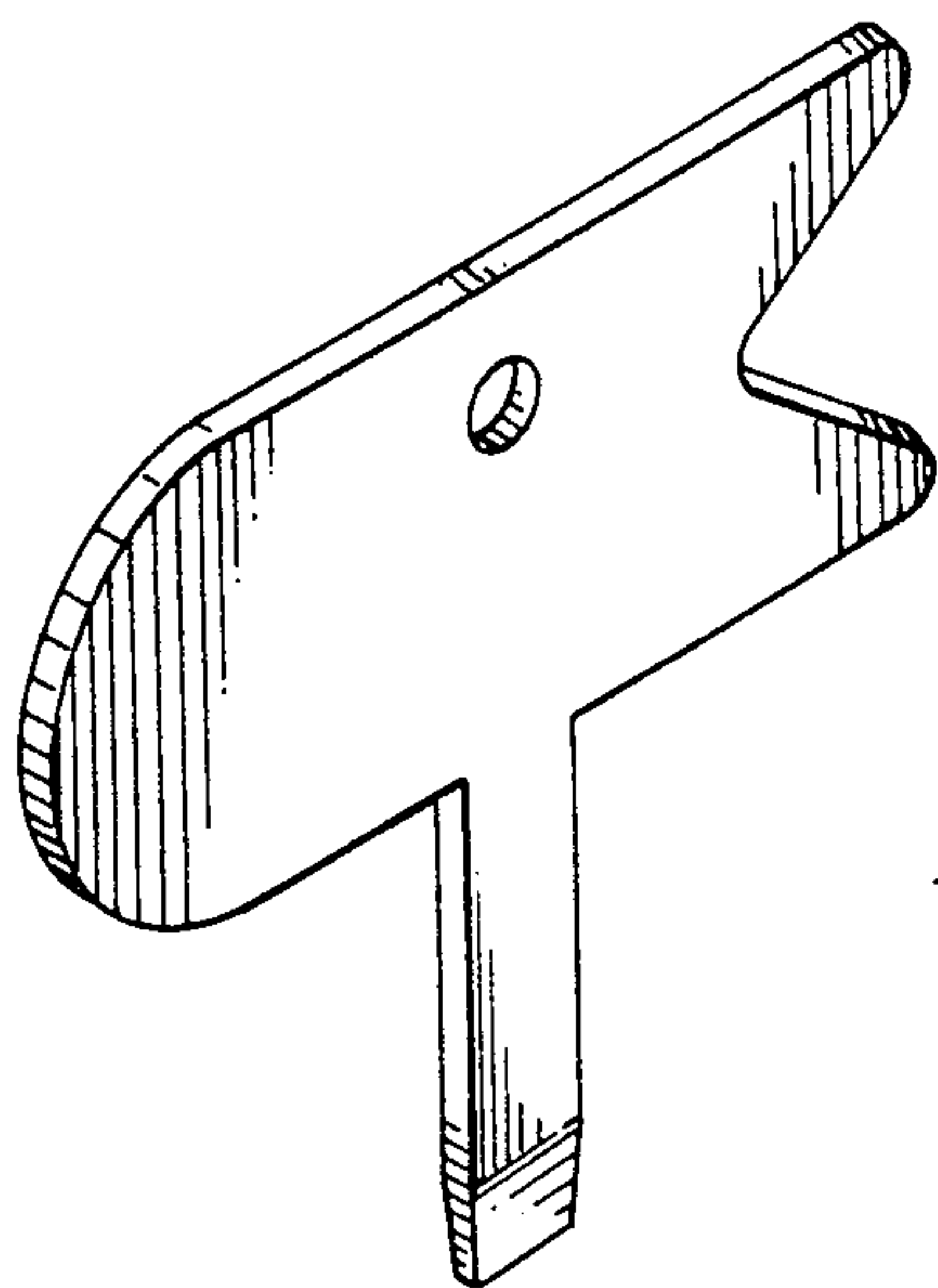

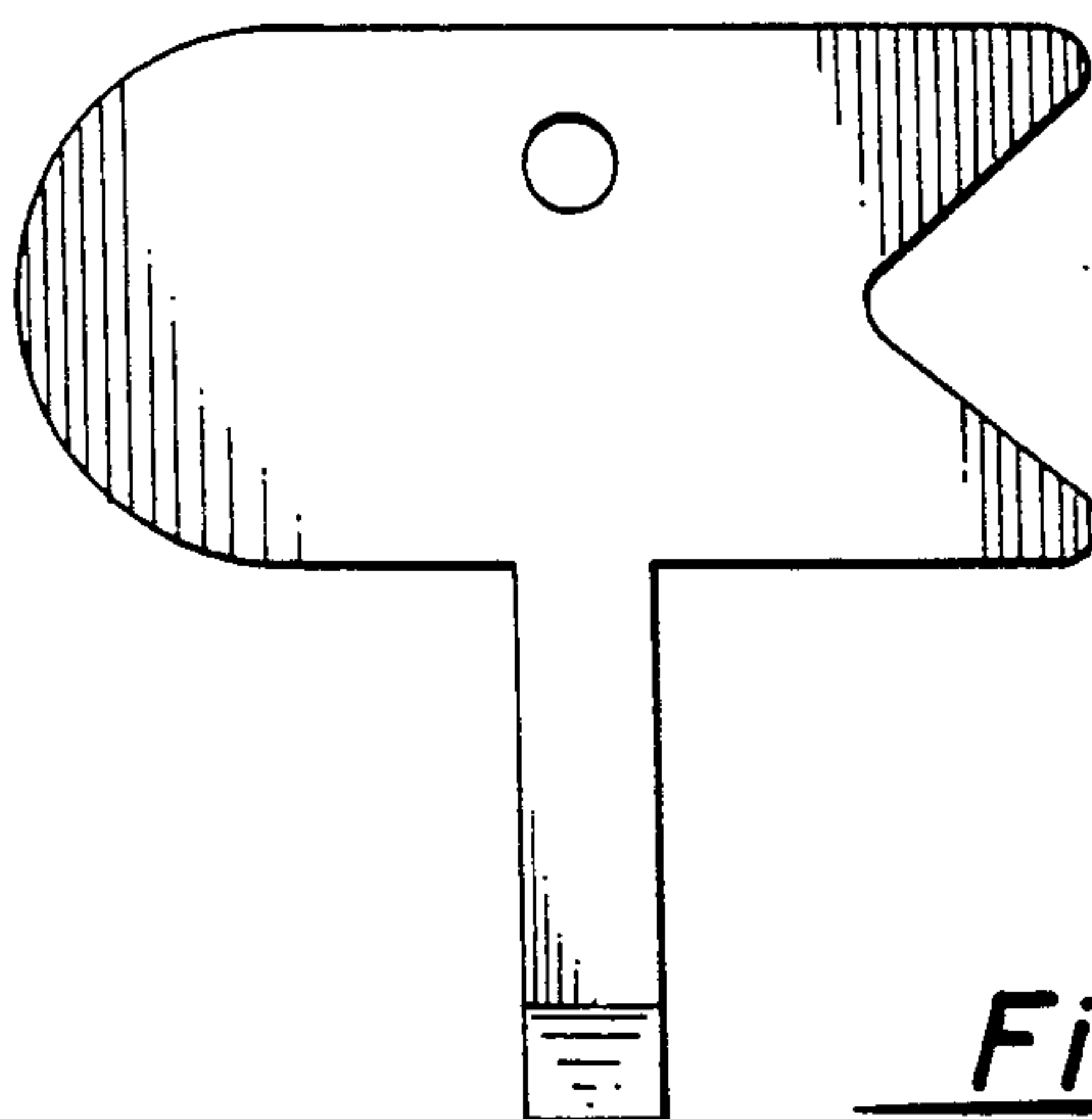

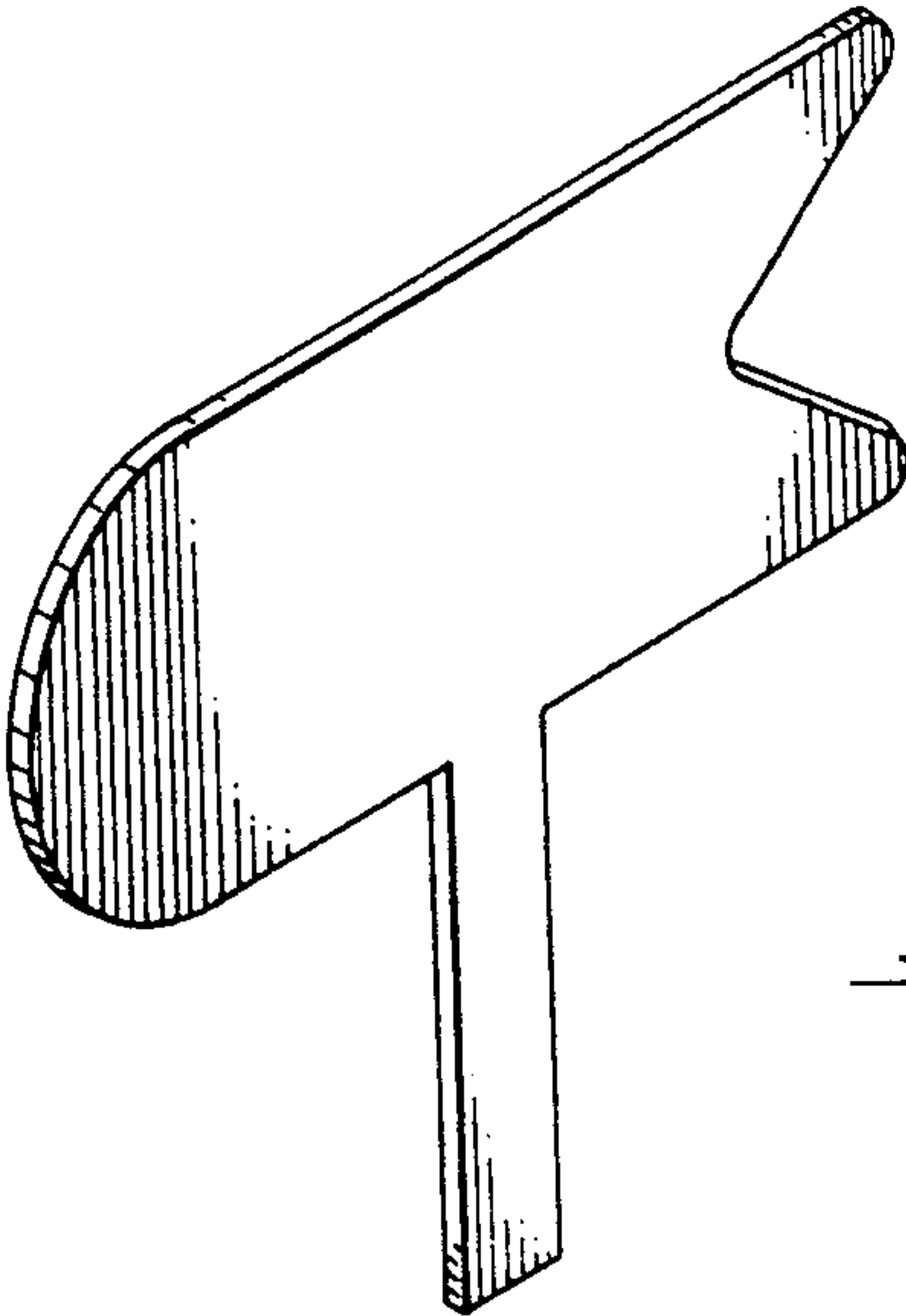

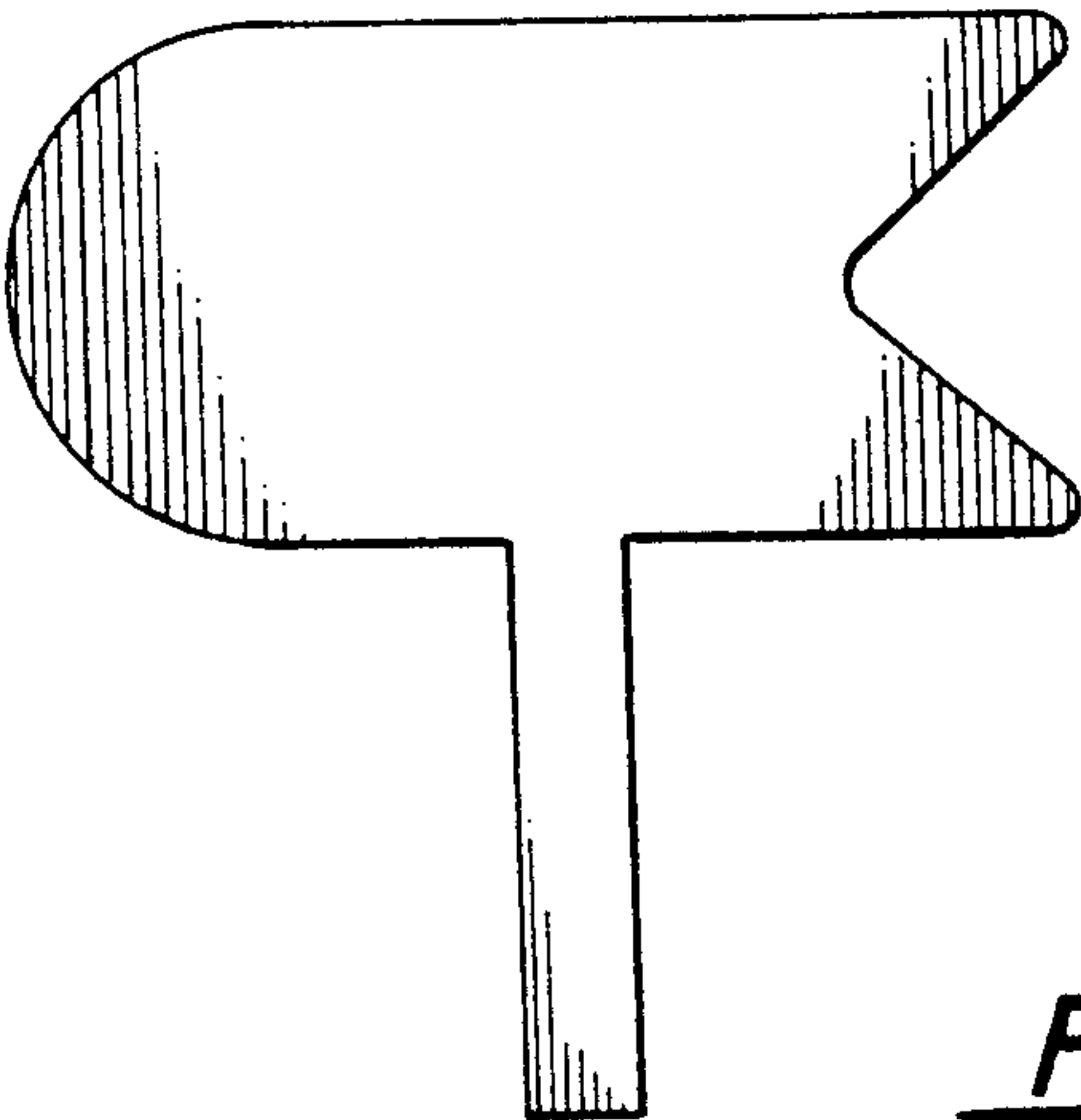
