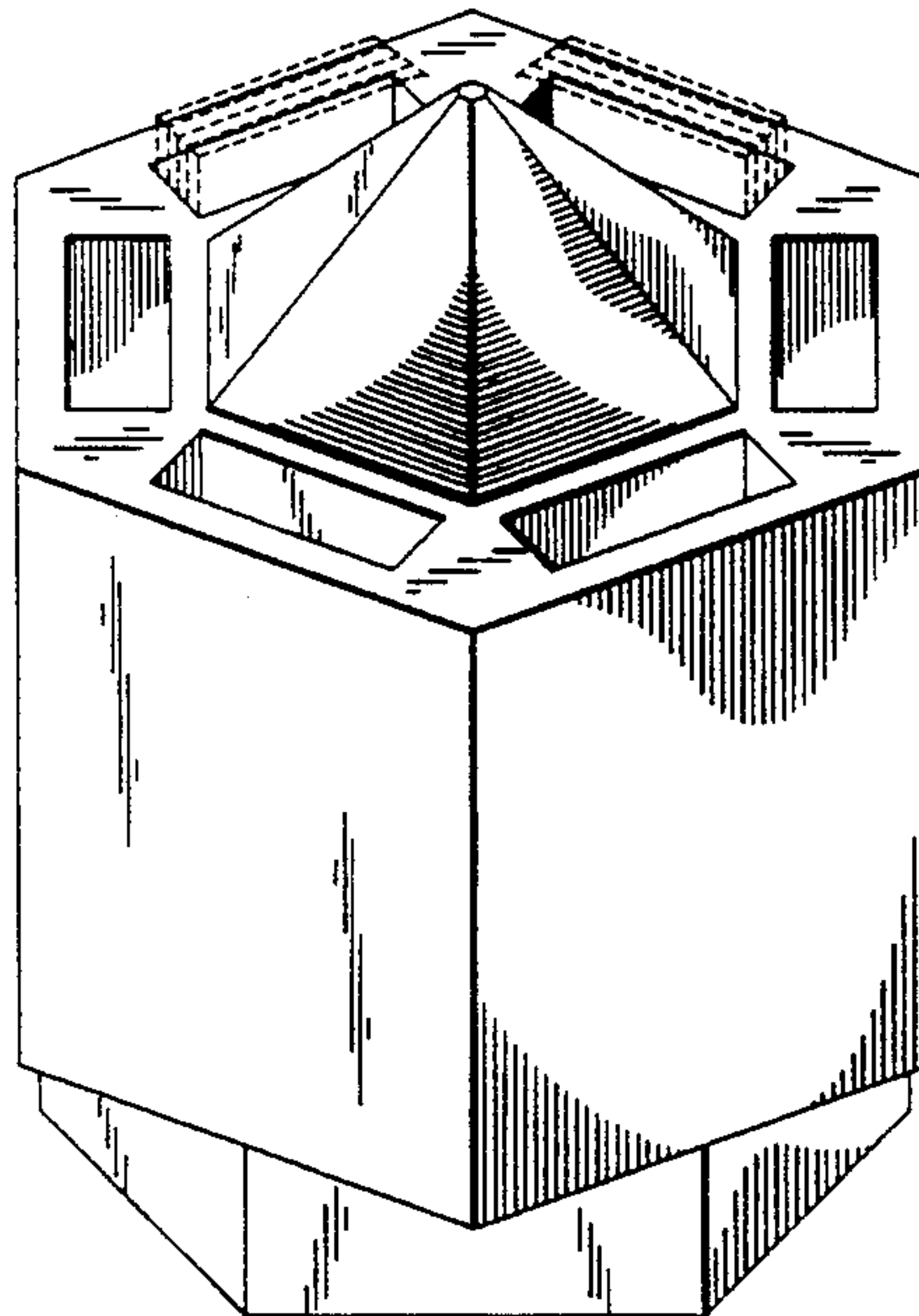

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 represent environment only and form no part of the claimed design.



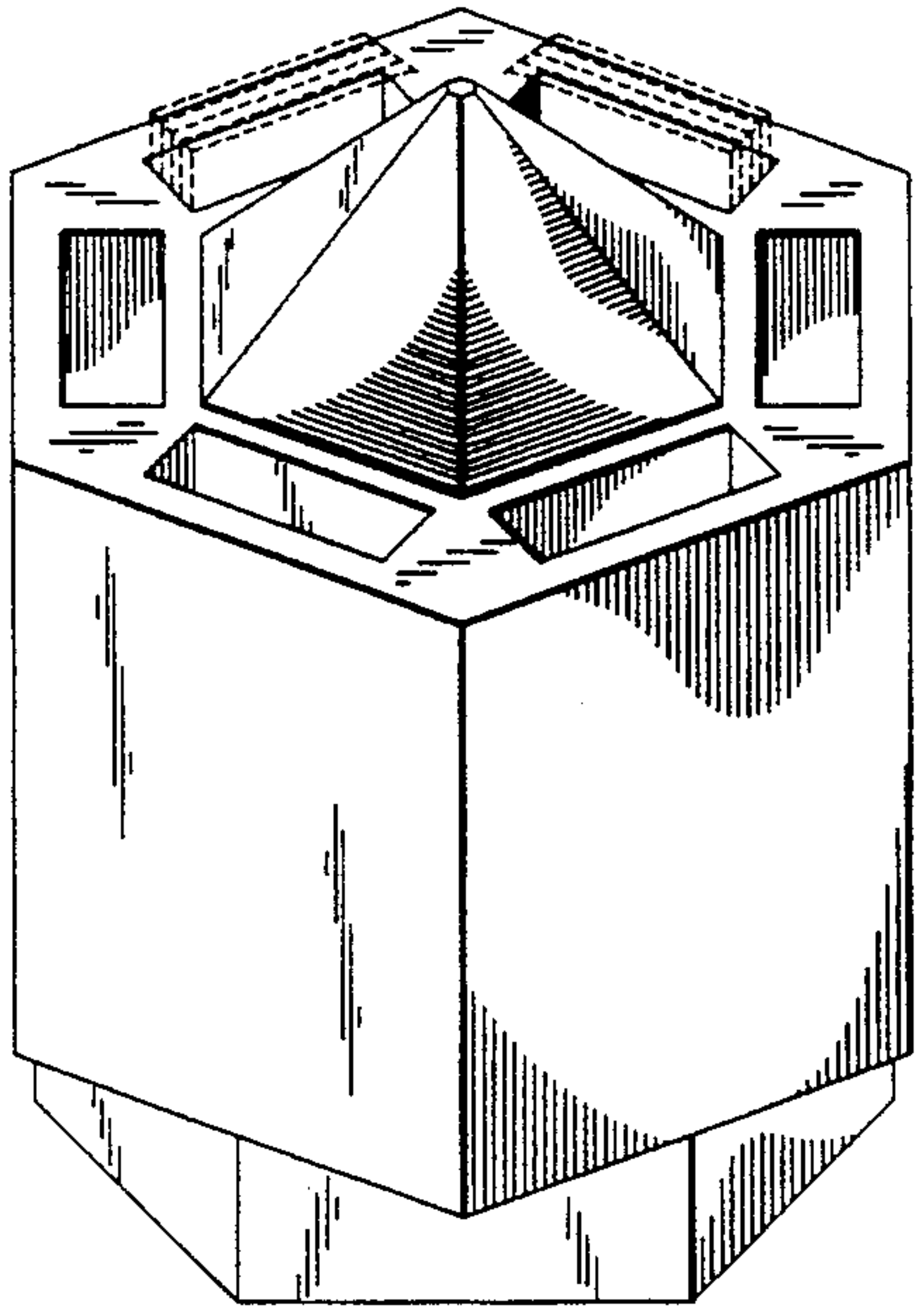

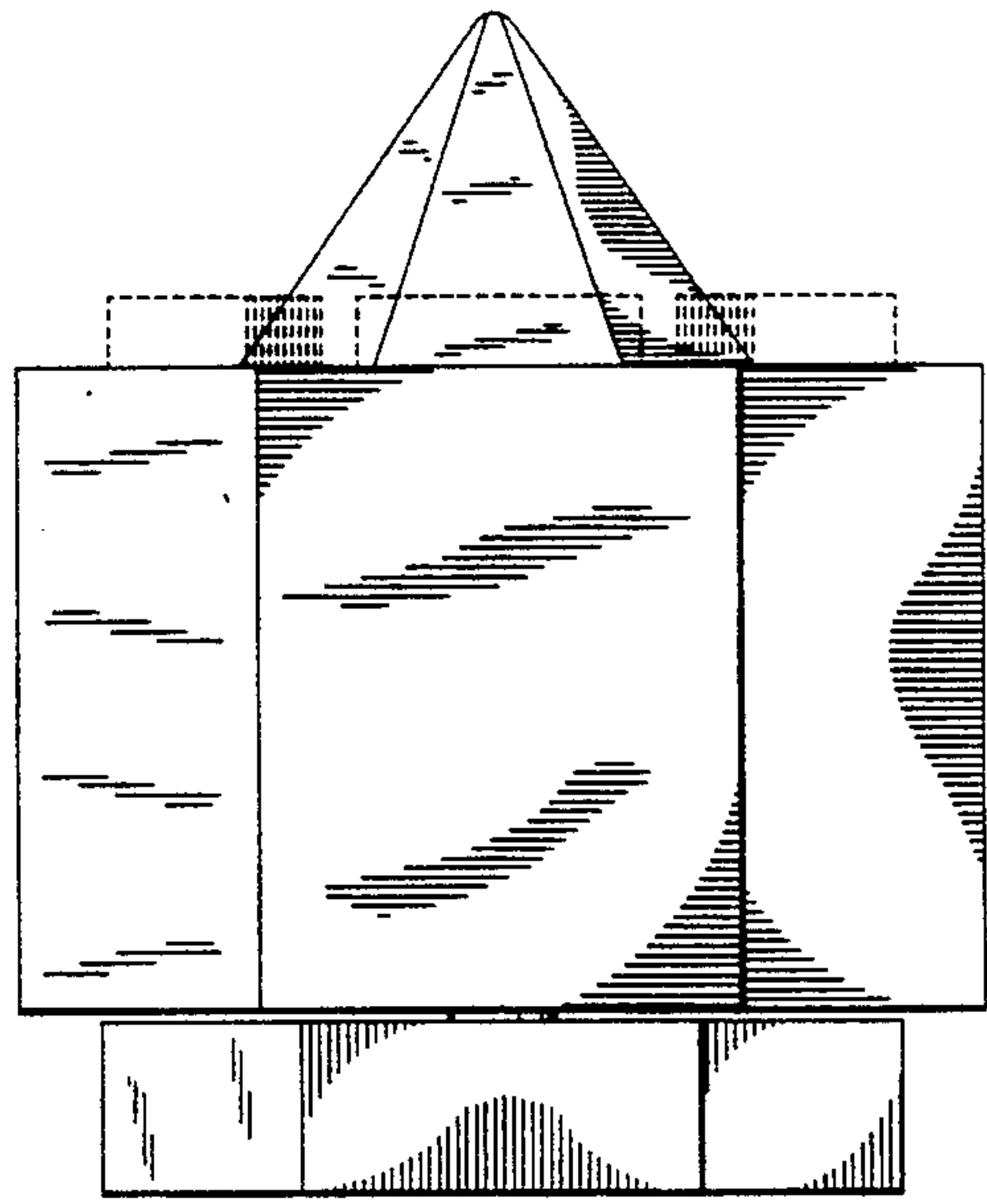

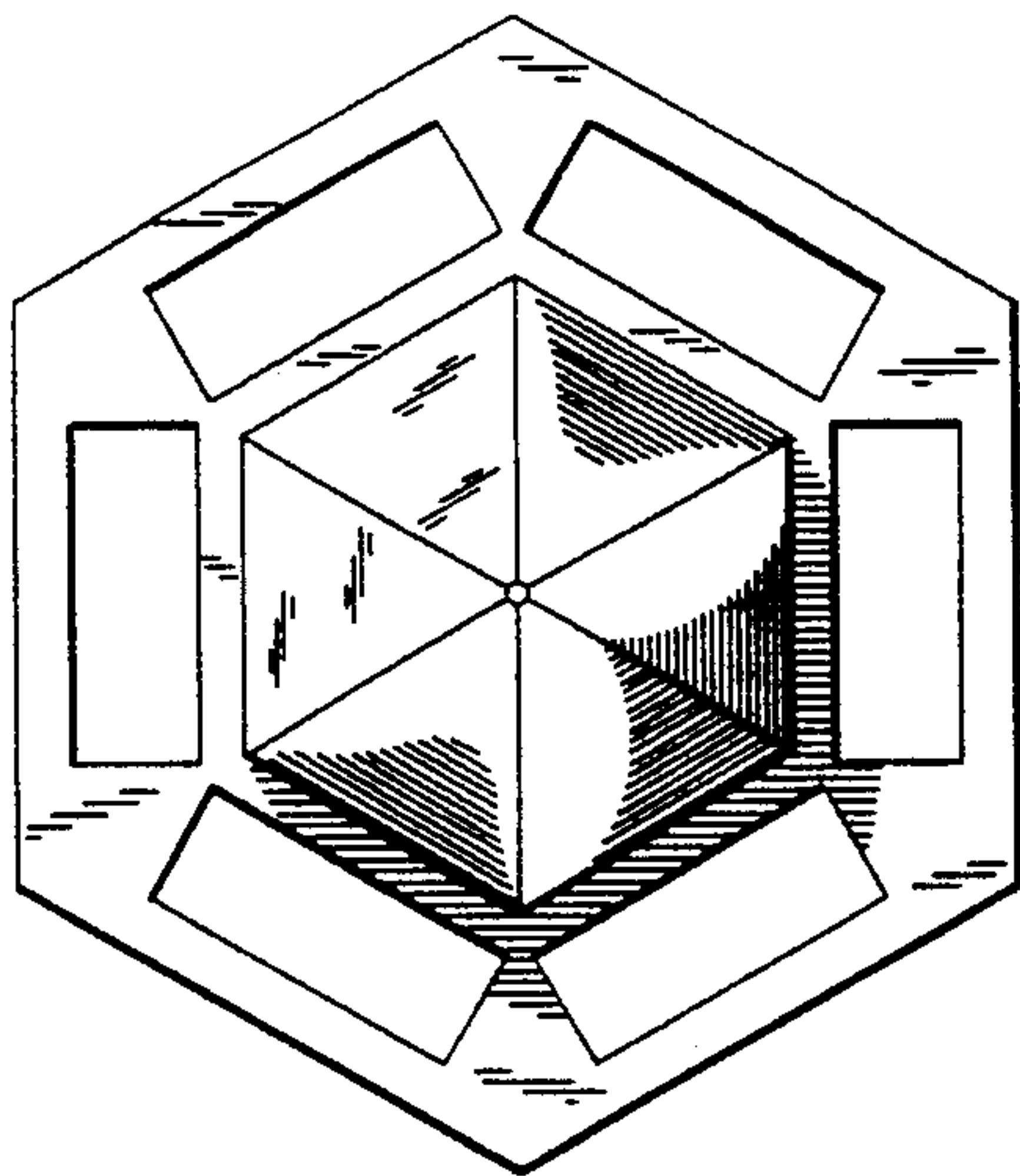

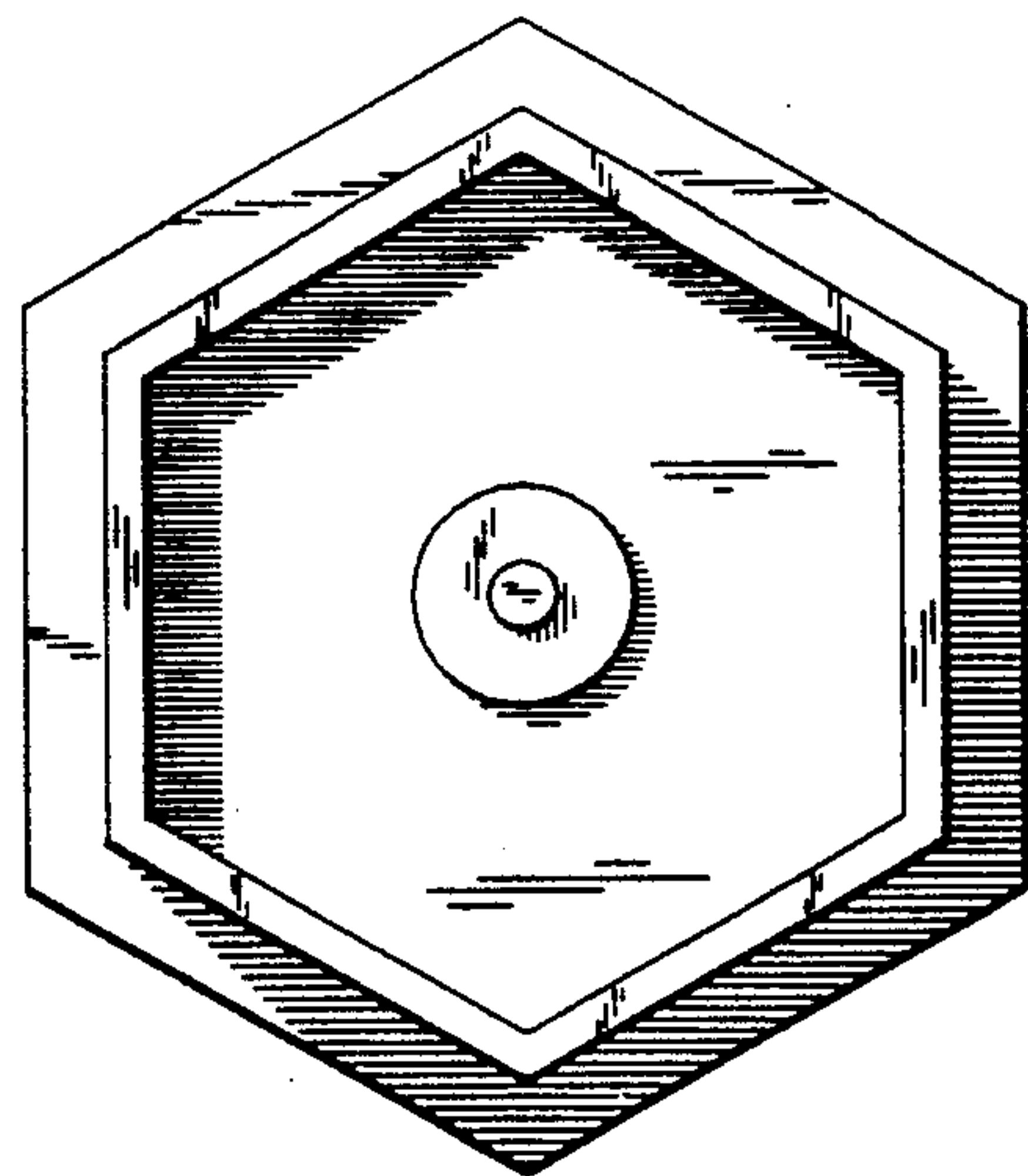
