DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and the left side of a combined lavatory and table top showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and the left side of a second embodiment thereof;


FIG. 8 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and the left side of the third embodiment thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 8;


FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 8; and,


















