FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a sports shoe showing a modified form of our new design;


FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of said modified design;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view.

The broken line showing of a shoe sole is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.







