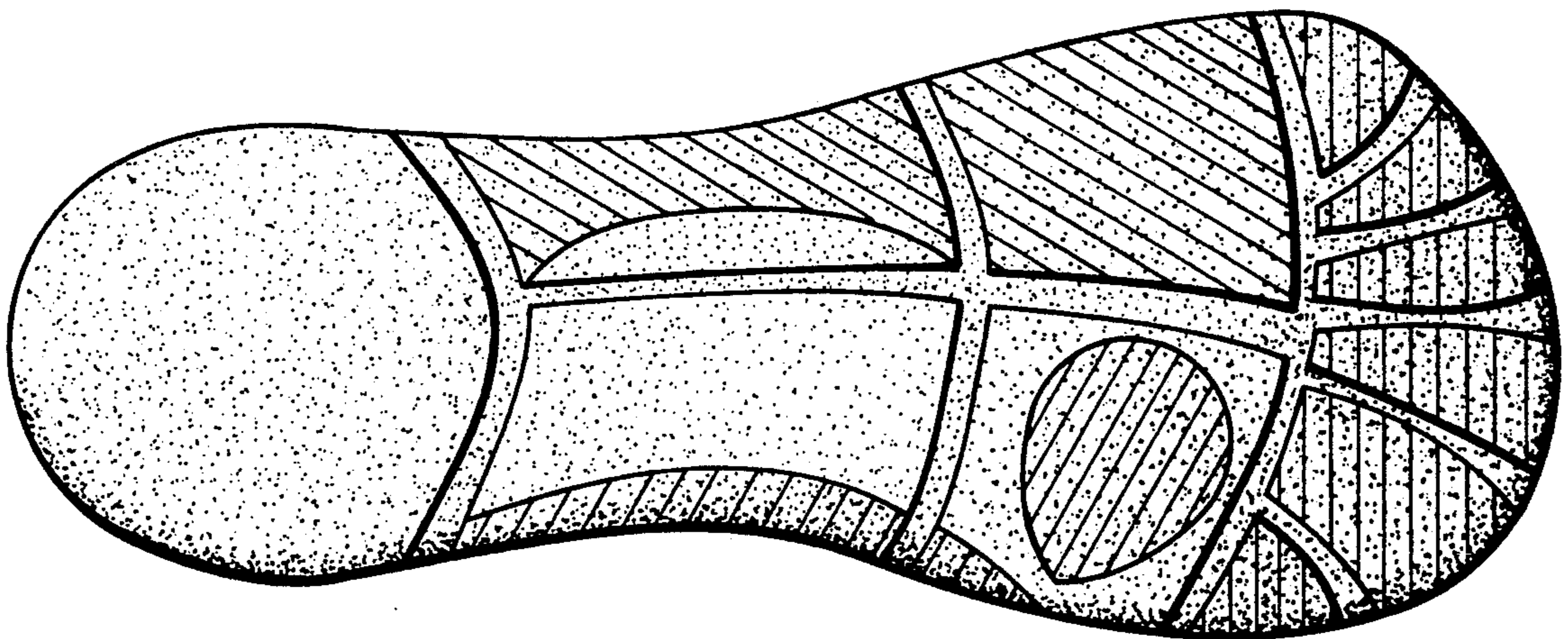

The broken line showing of a shoe upper in FIGS. 2, 3, and 5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



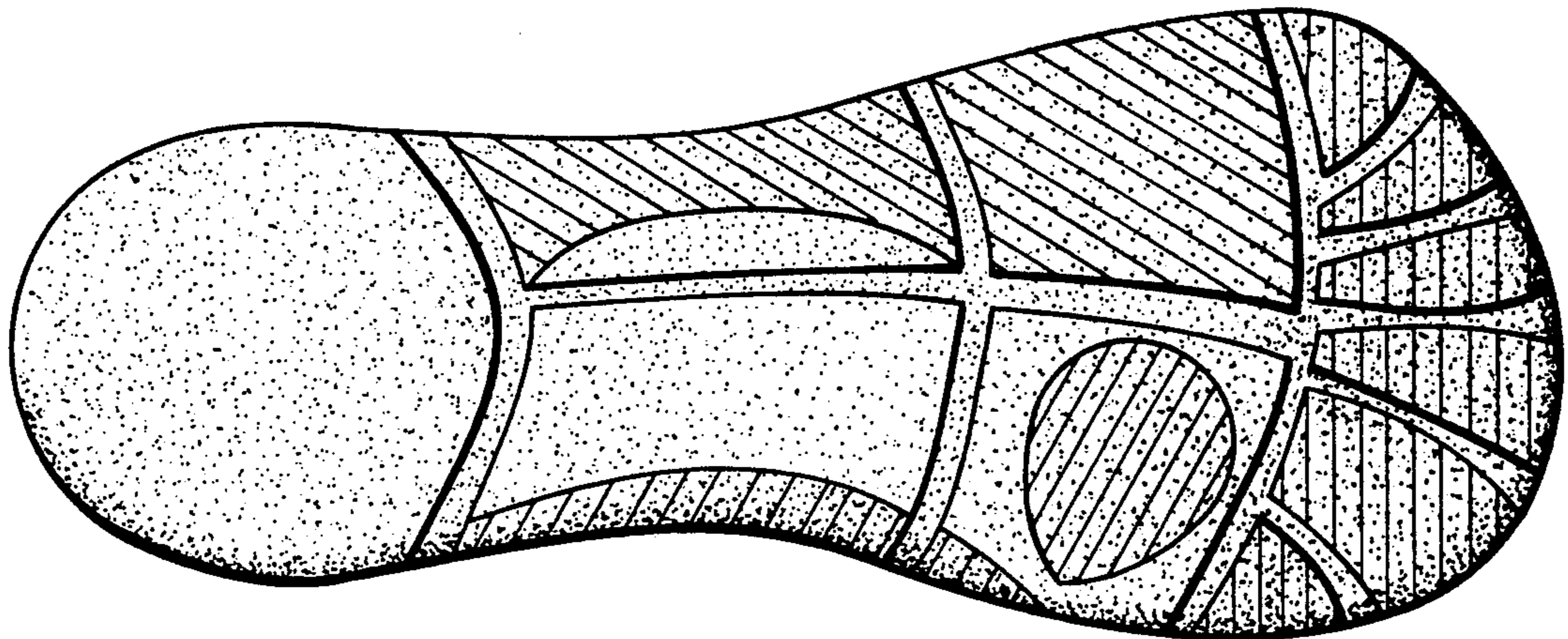

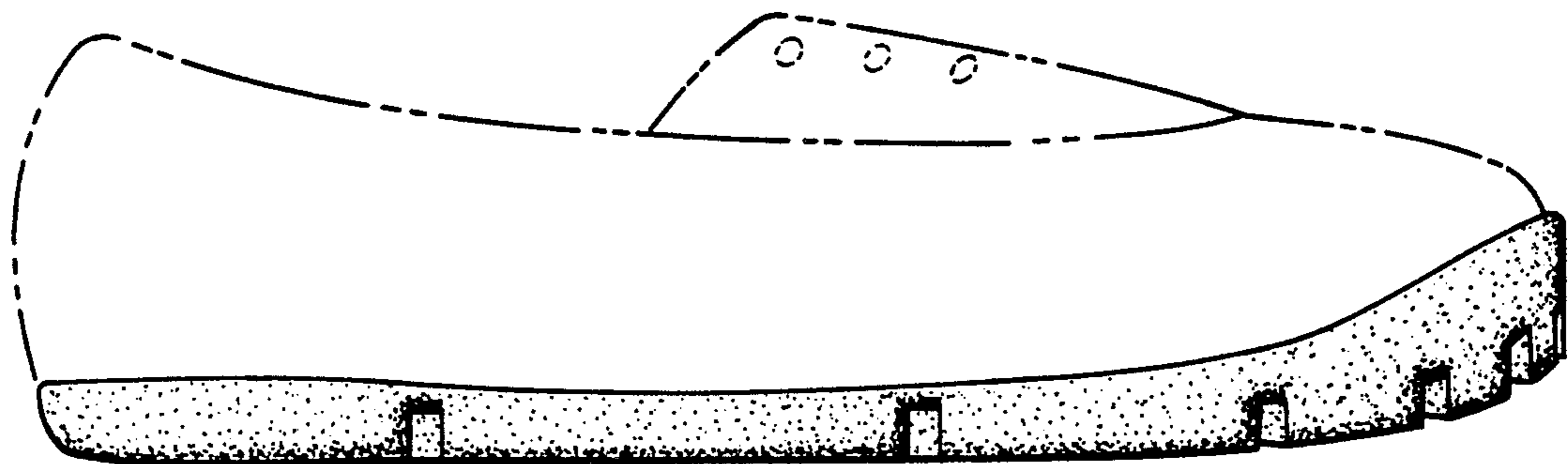

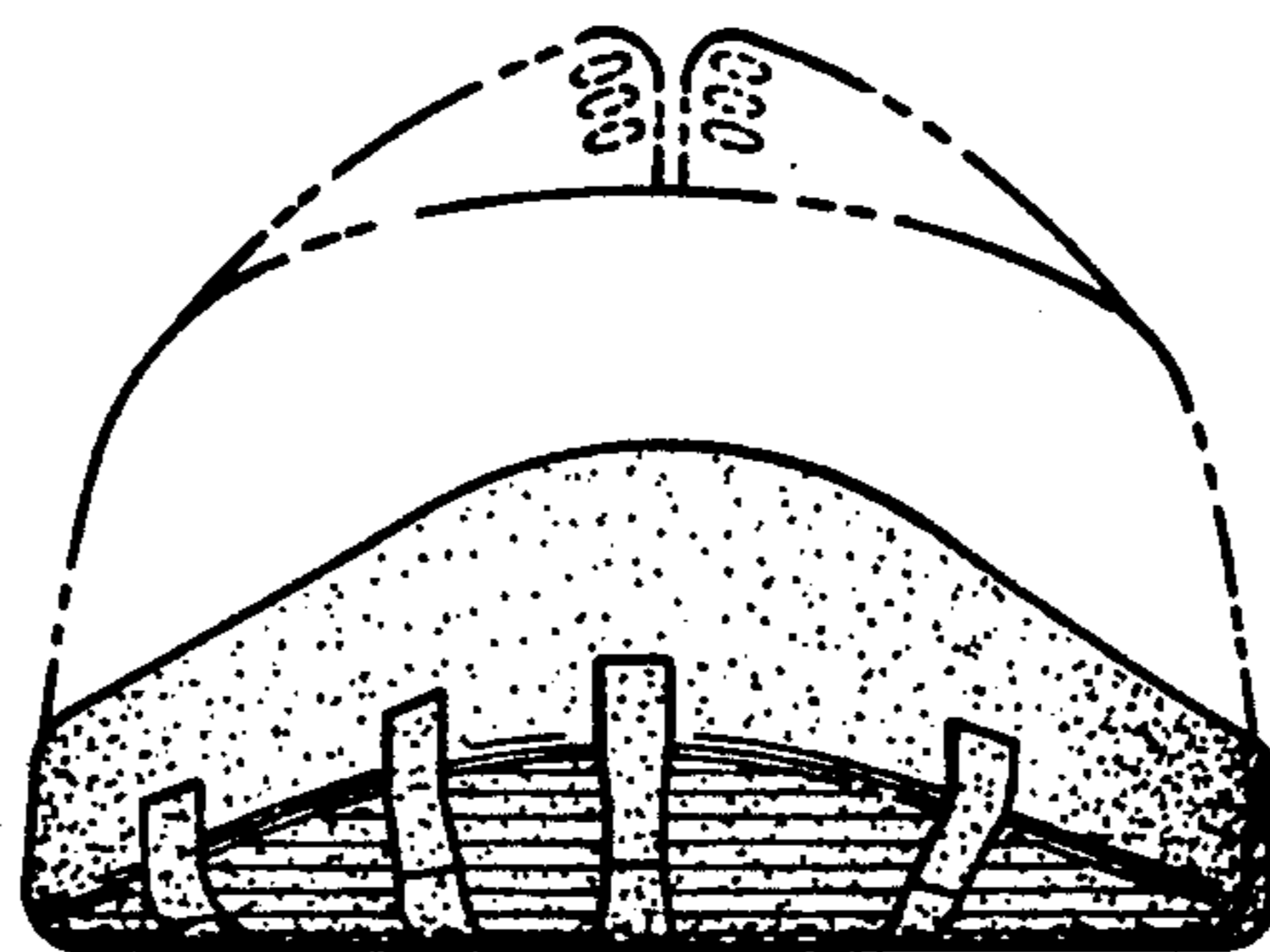

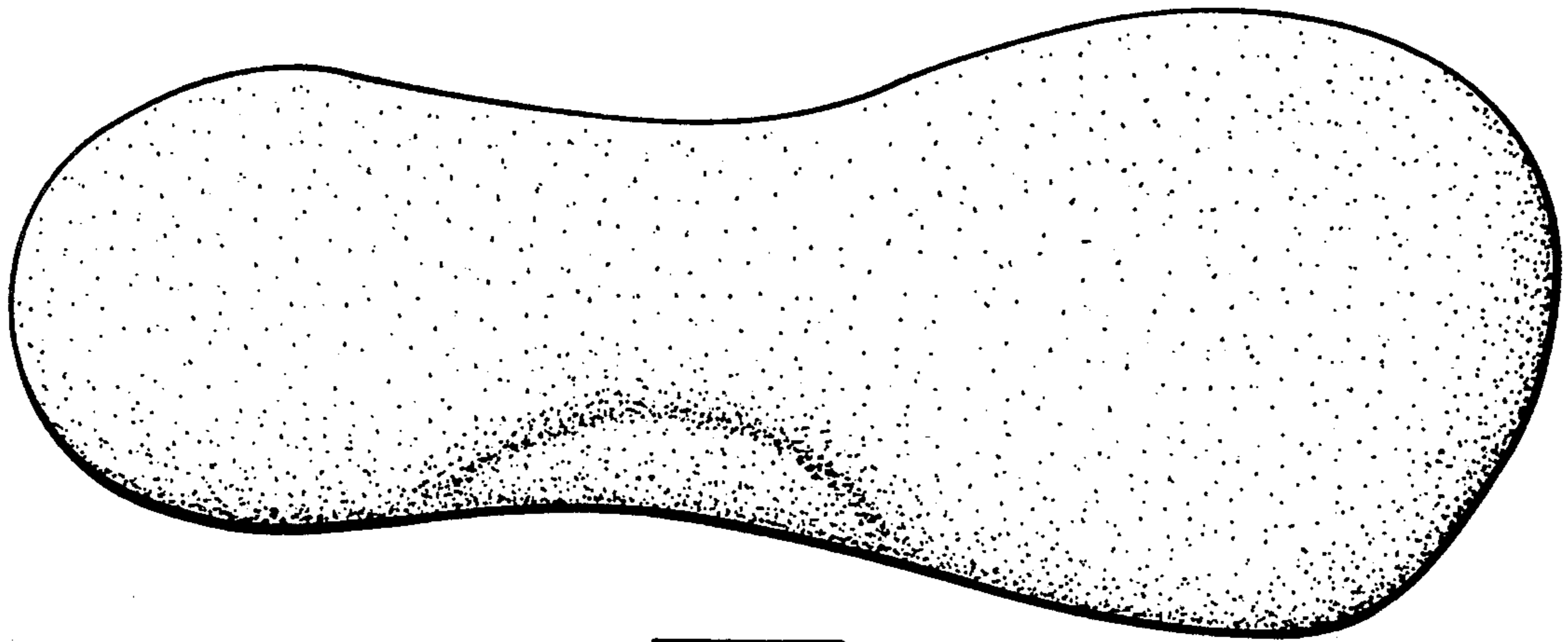

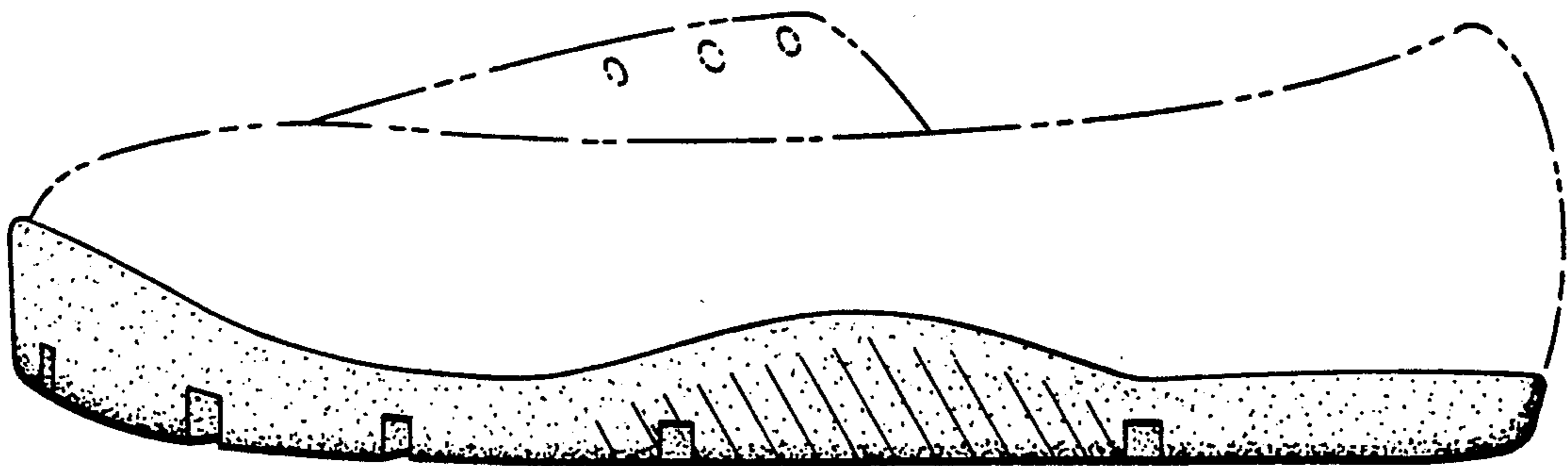

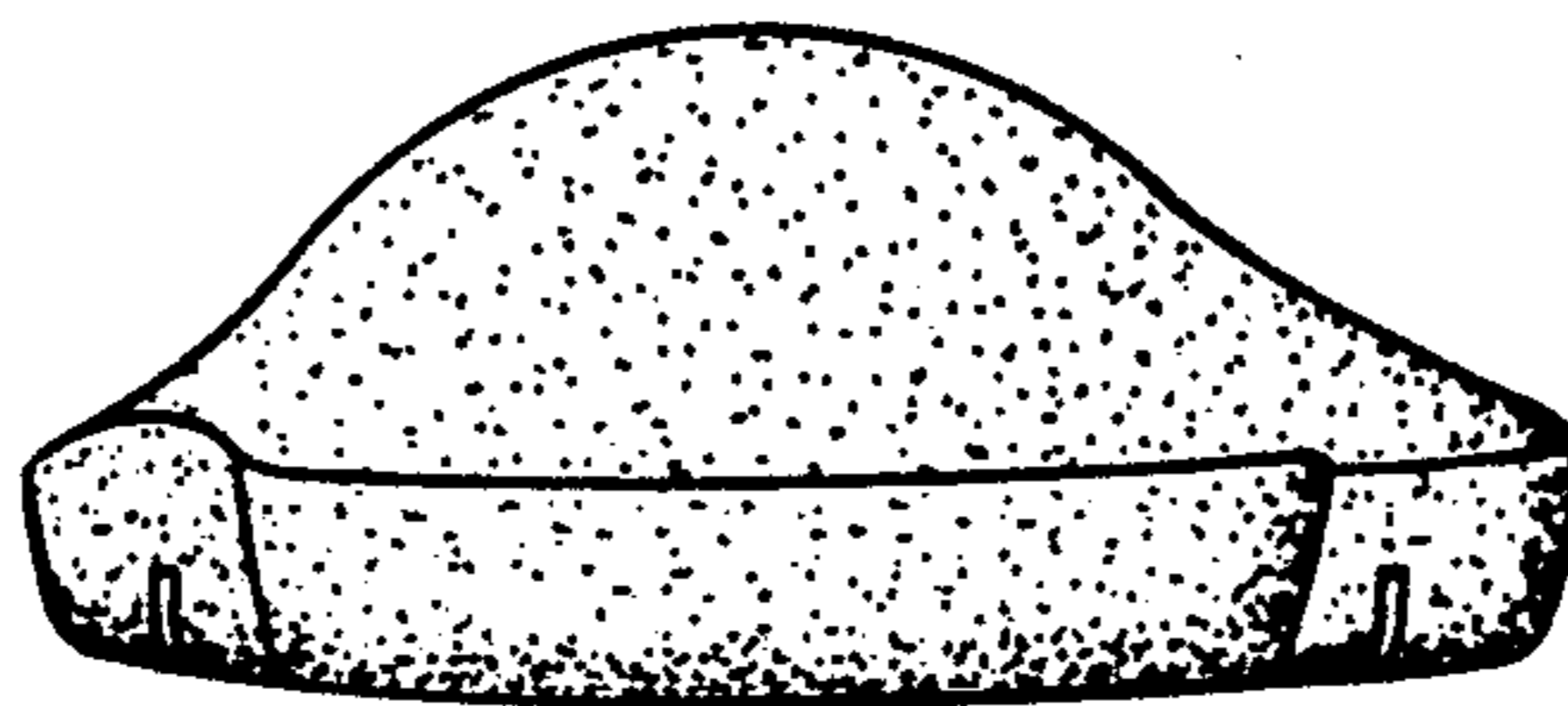
