FIG. 5 is a front elevational view;

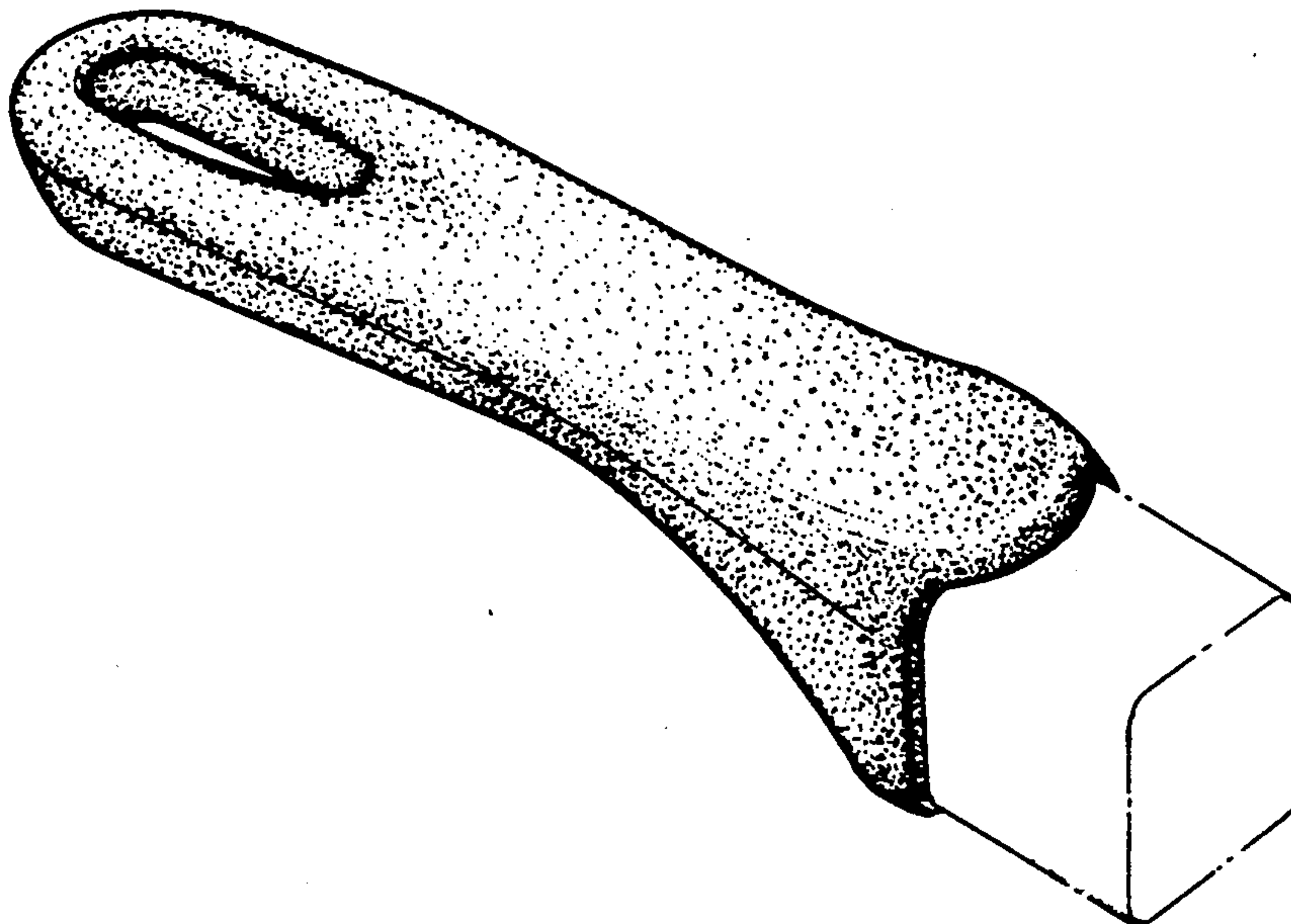
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view;

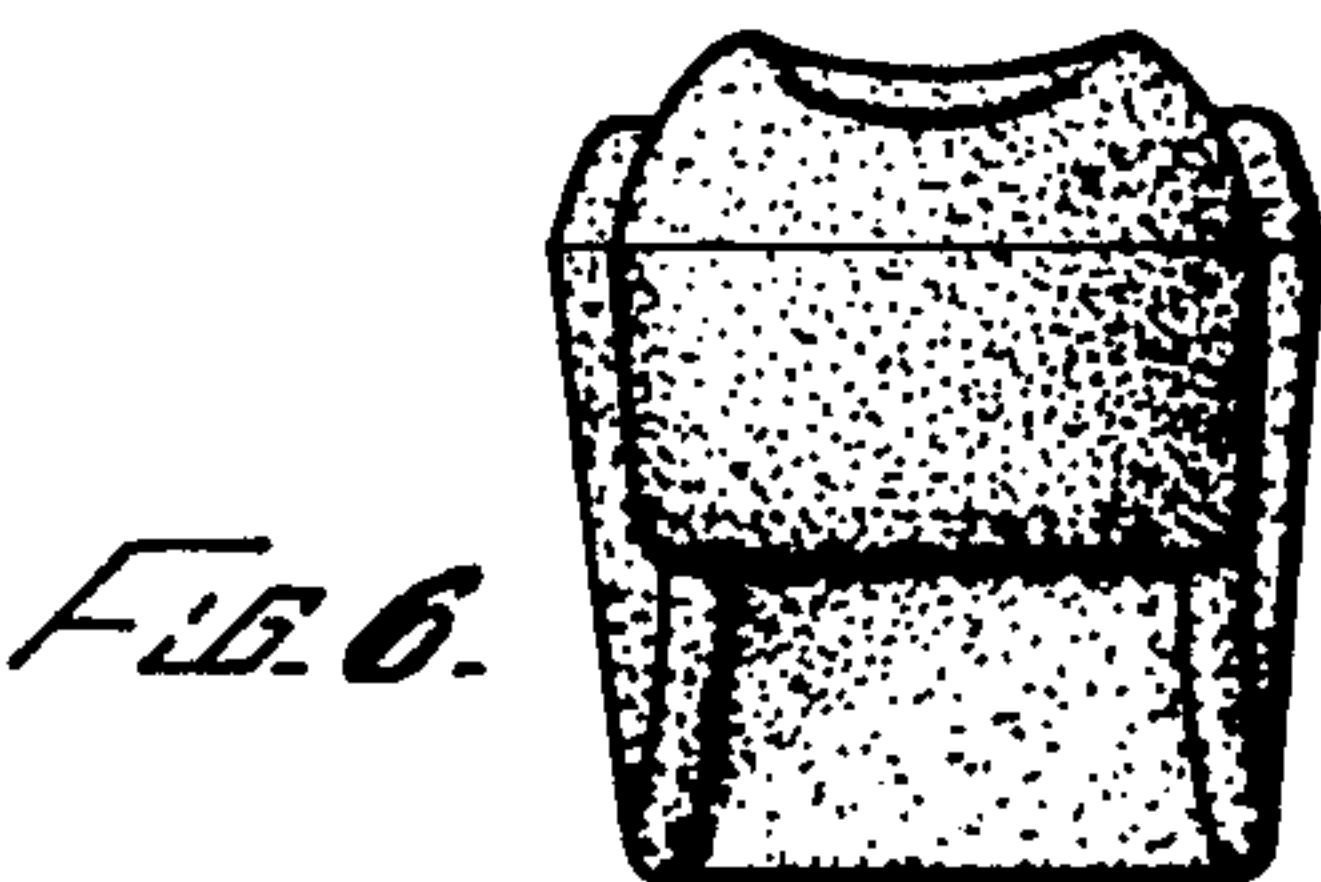
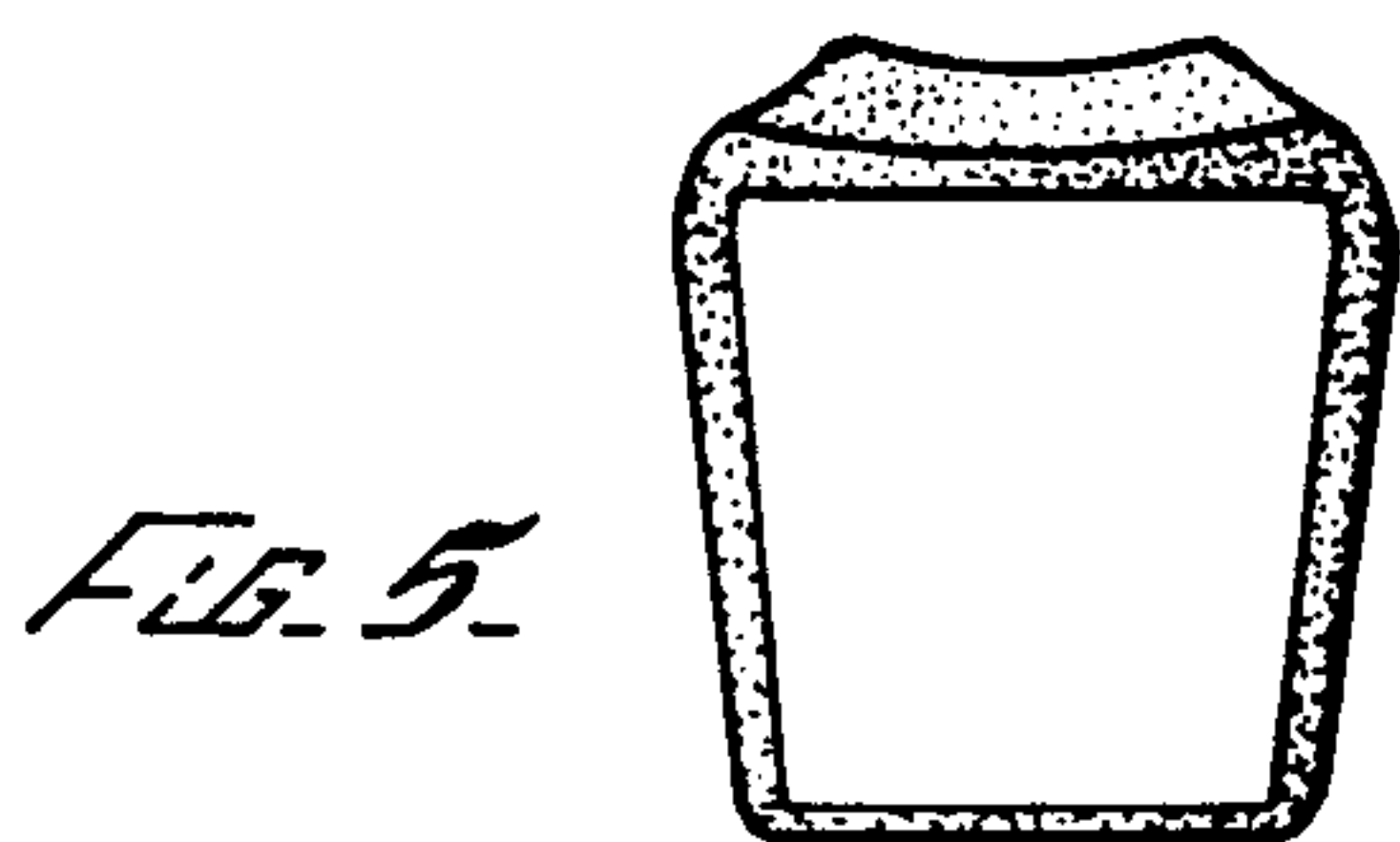
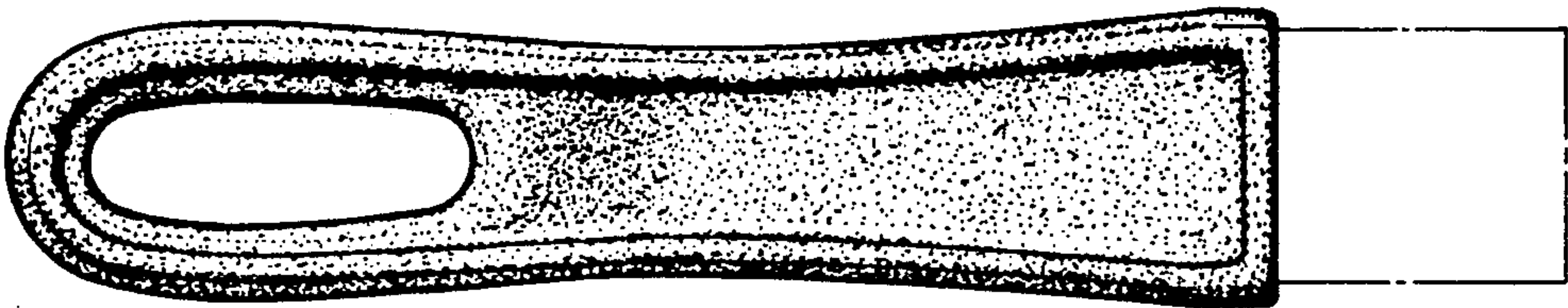
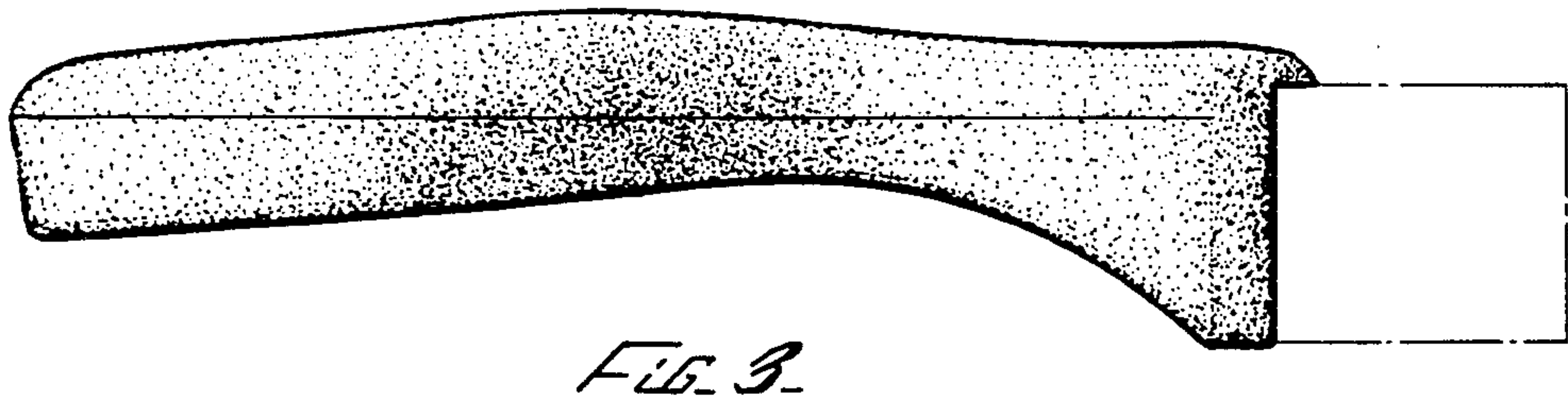
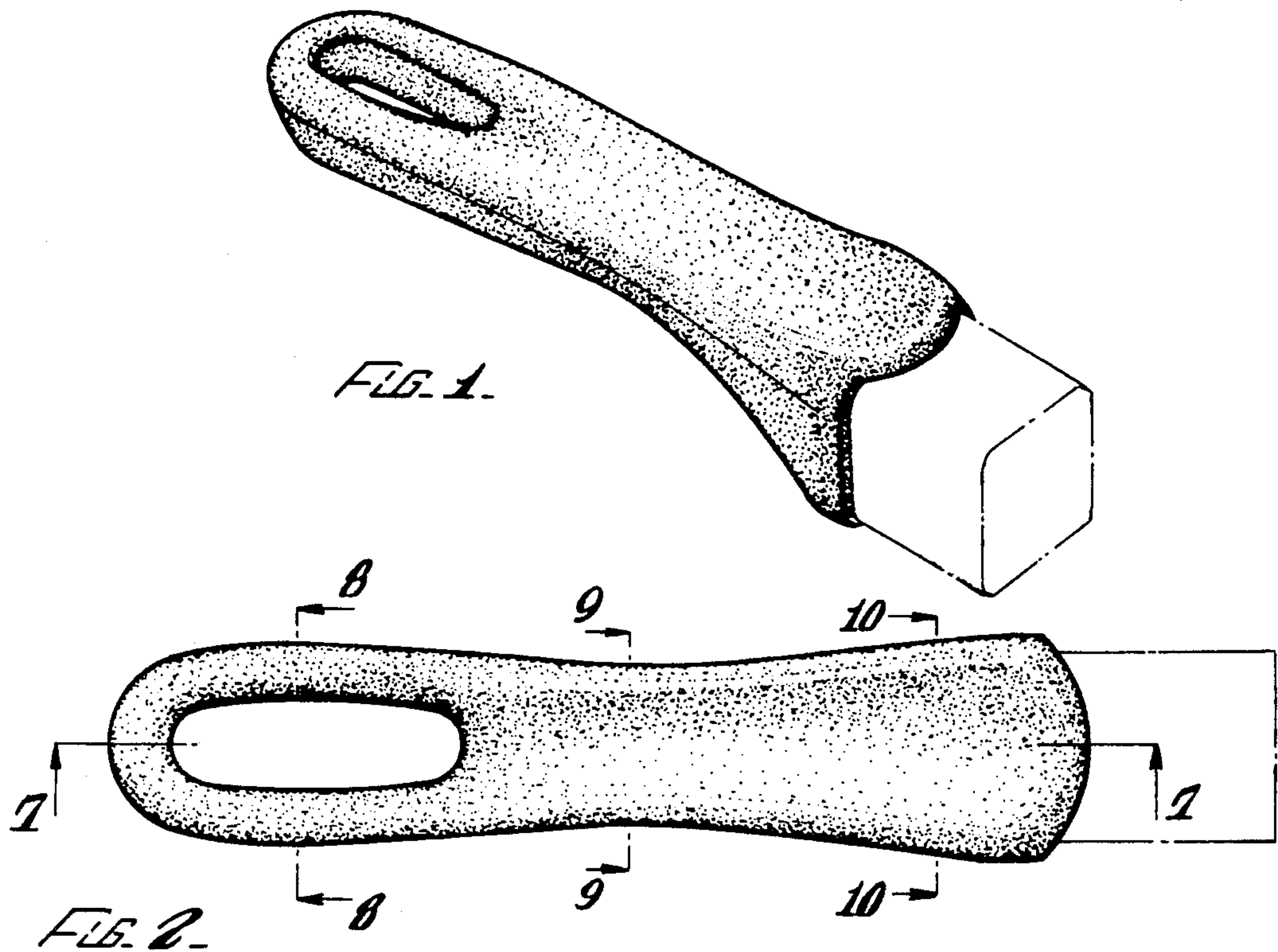
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 7—7 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 10—10 in FIG. 2.





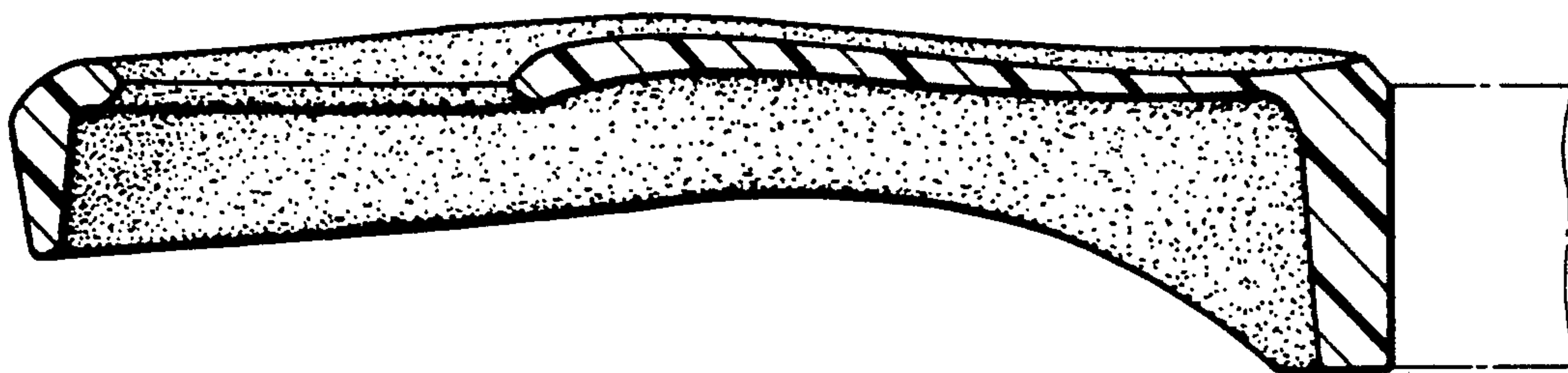

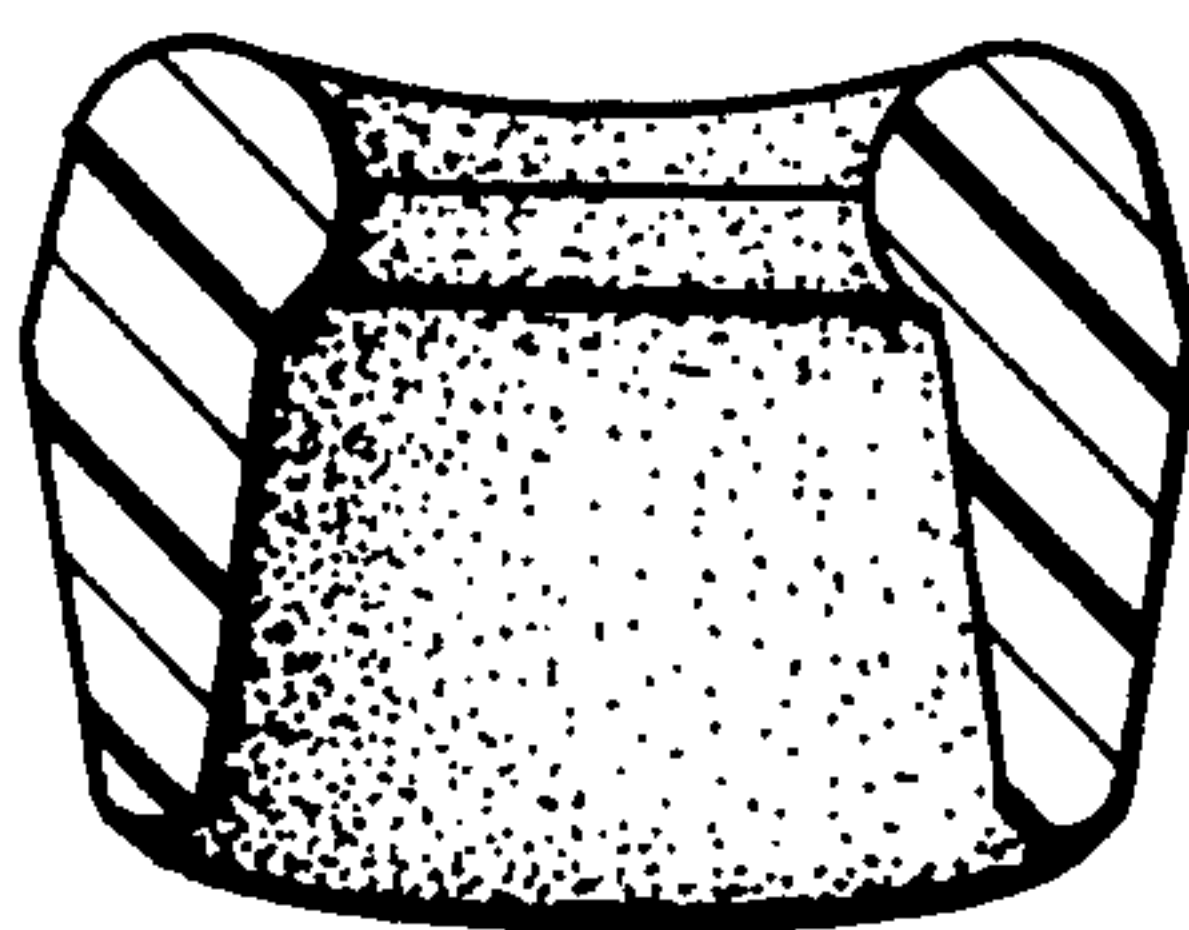

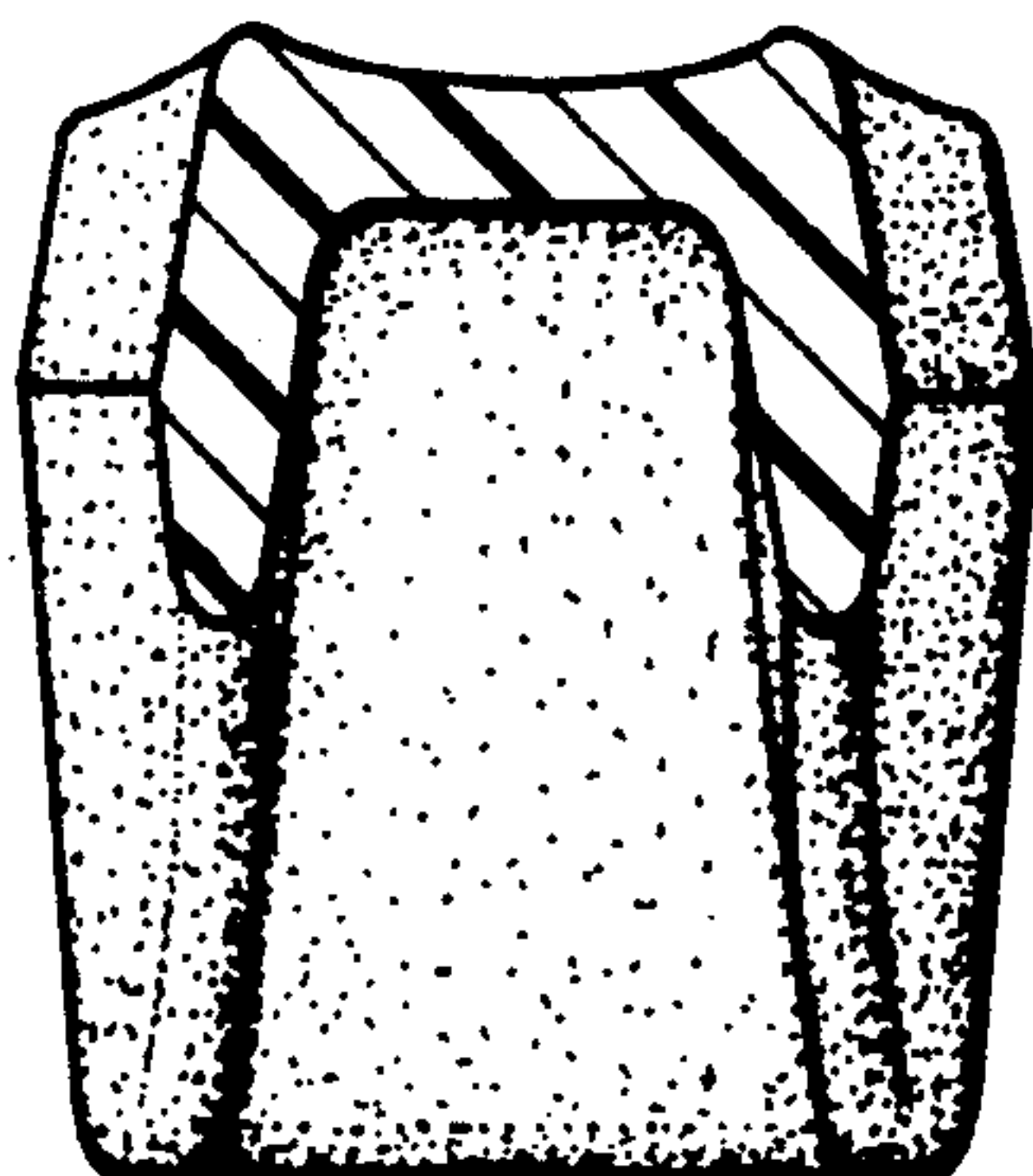

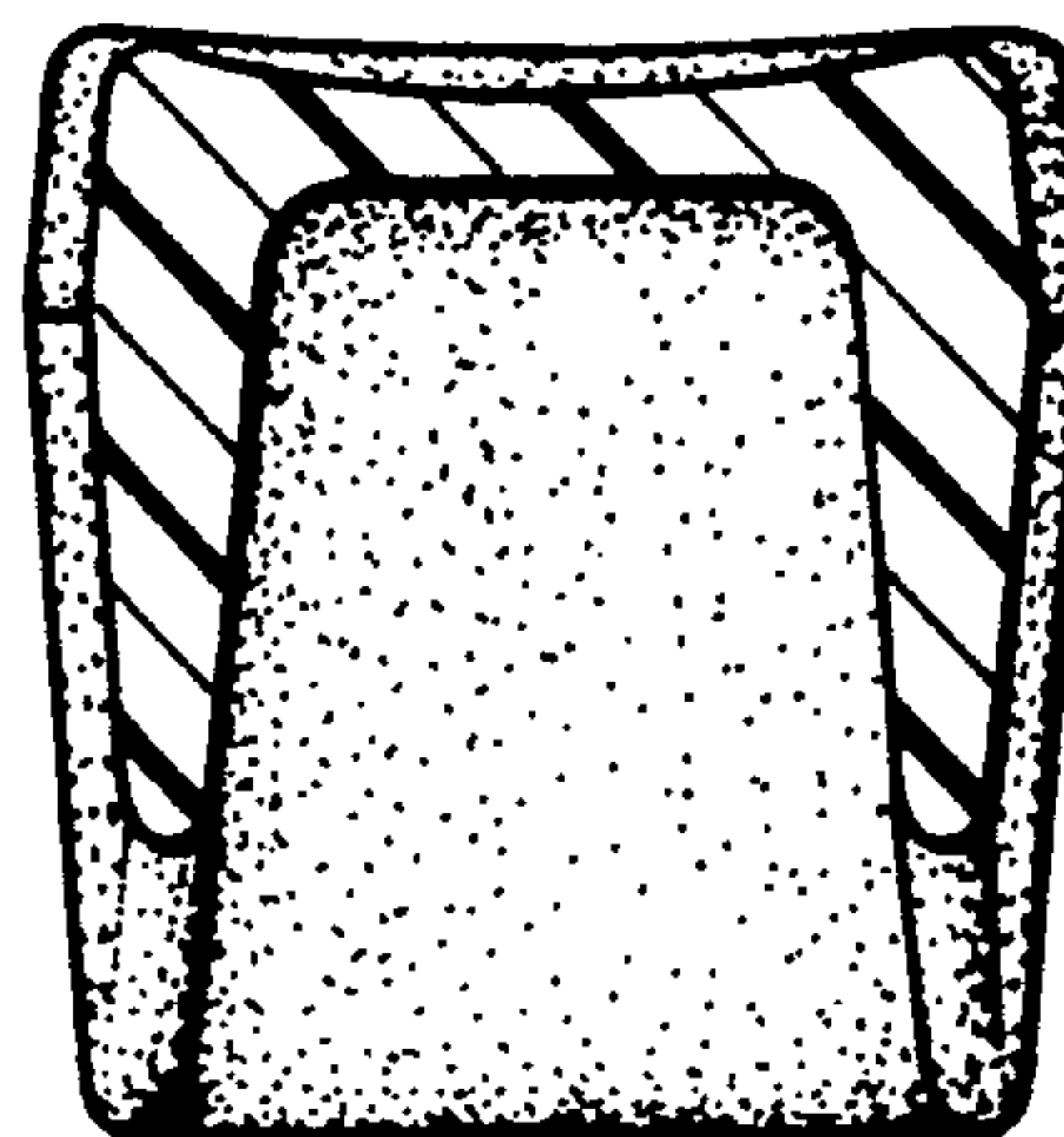
