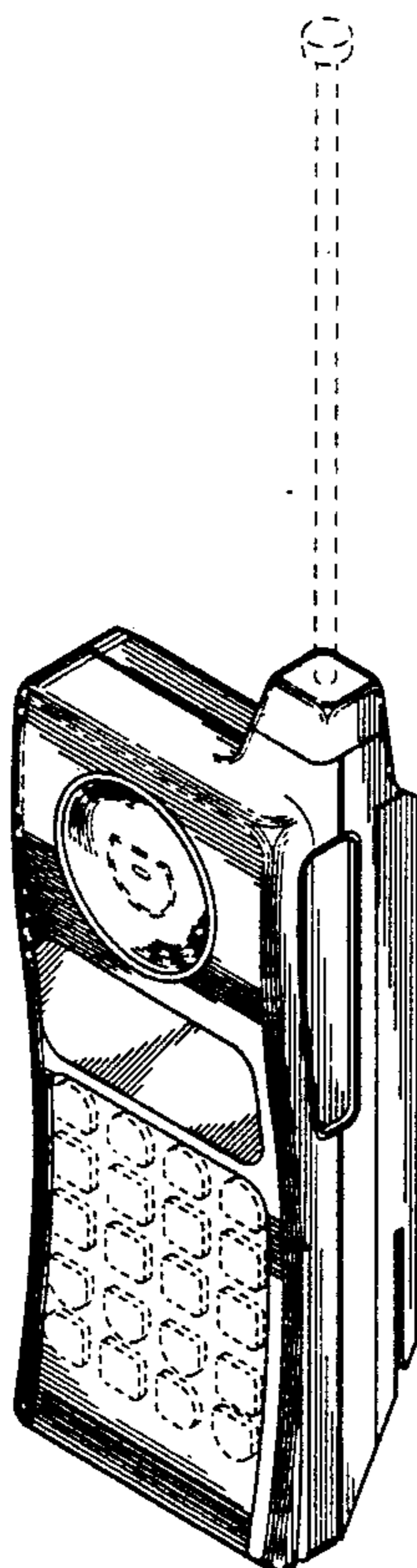

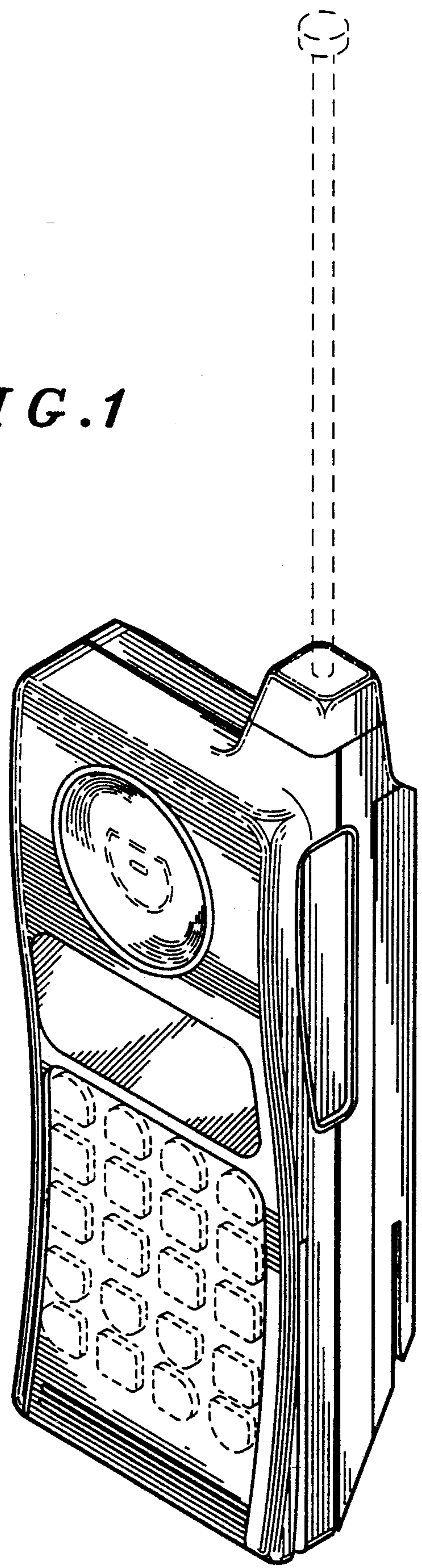
FIG. 2 is a left elevational view thereof in full lines, with the broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

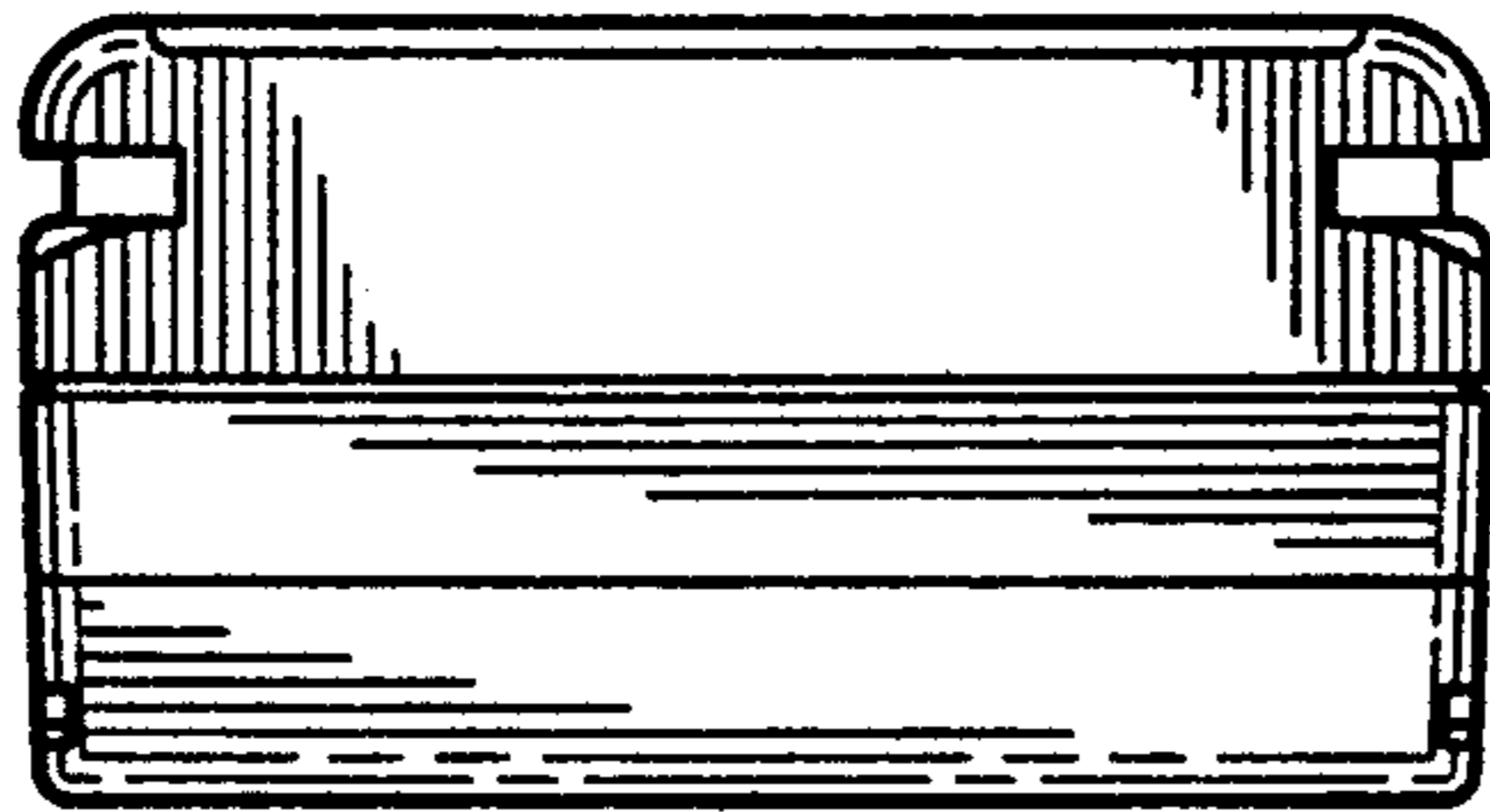
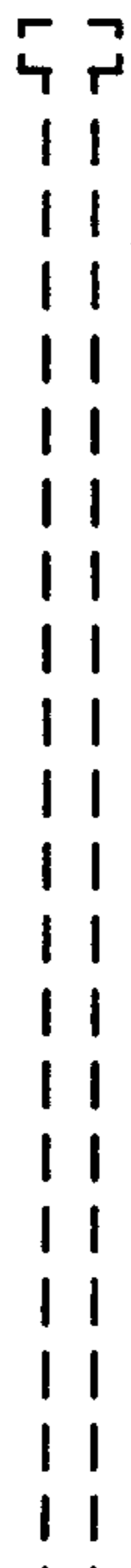
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof in full lines, with the broken line matter being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; and,

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



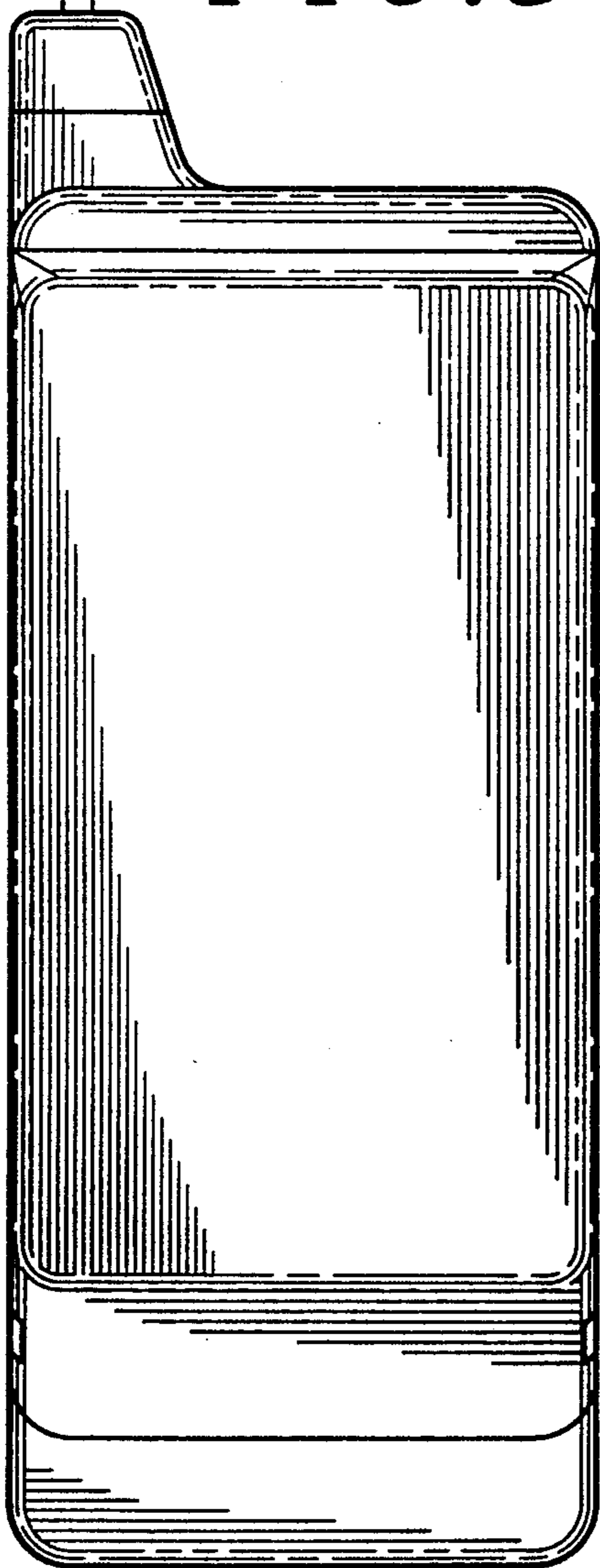
