a mirror image thereof;

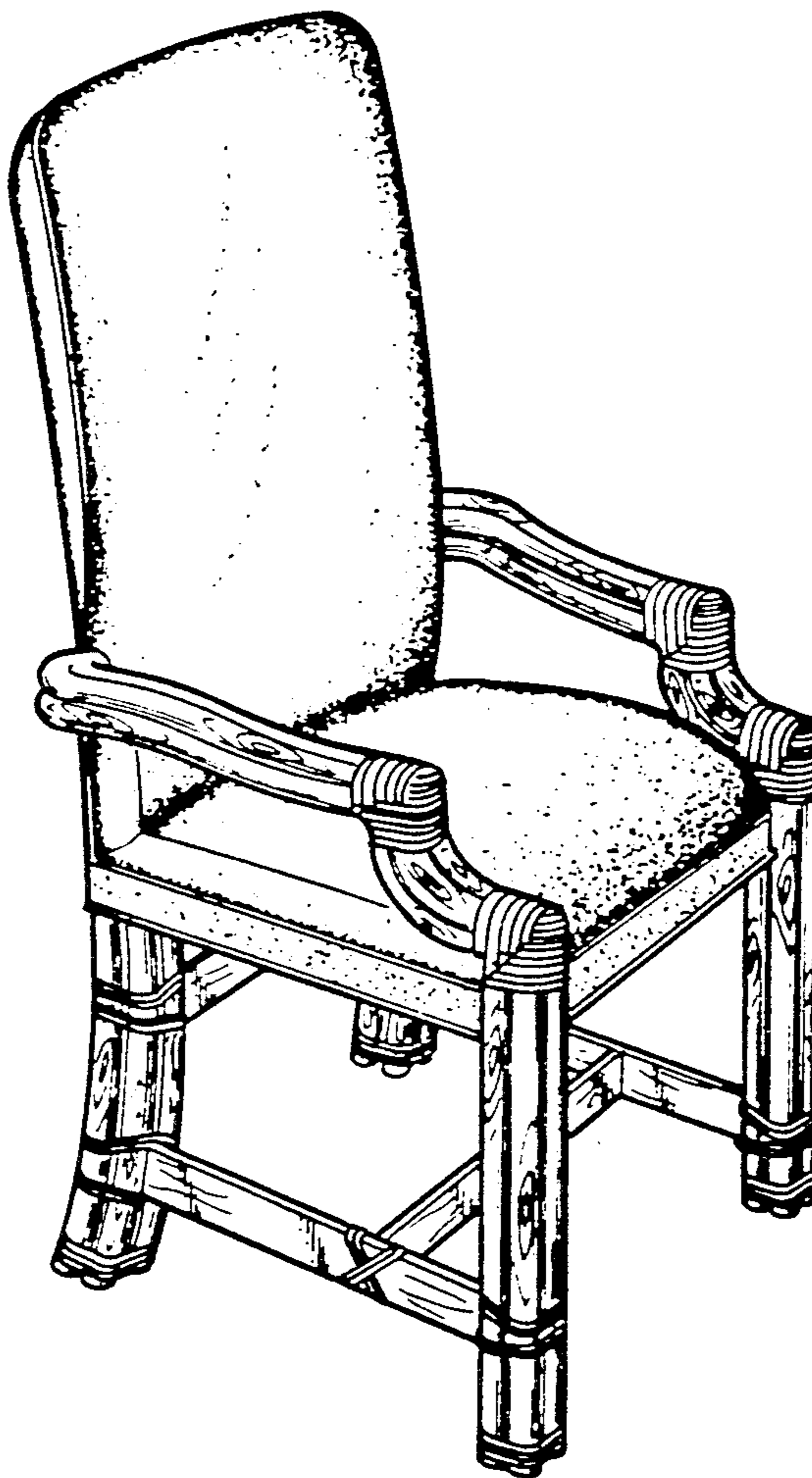
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

ond embodiment of my new design.



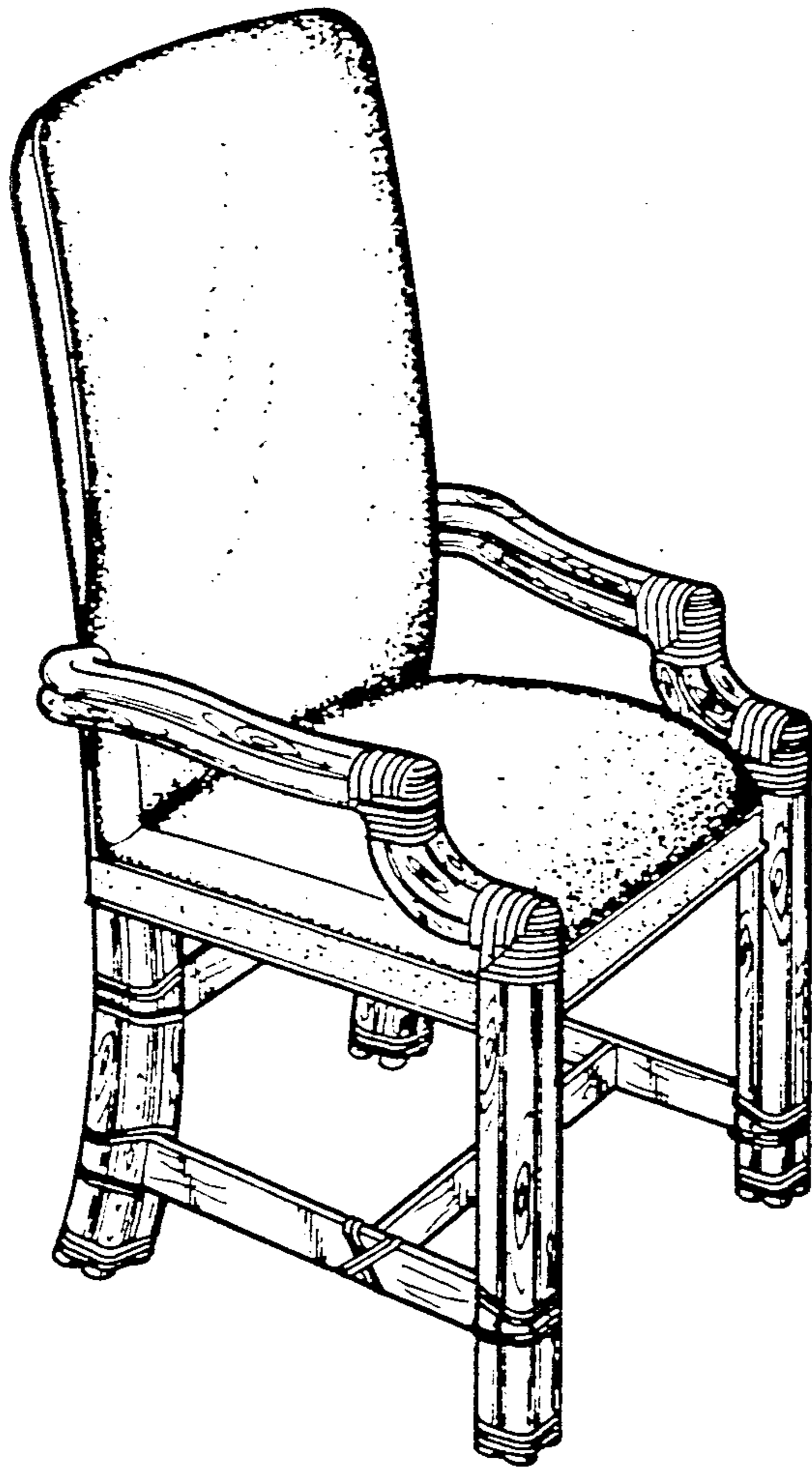

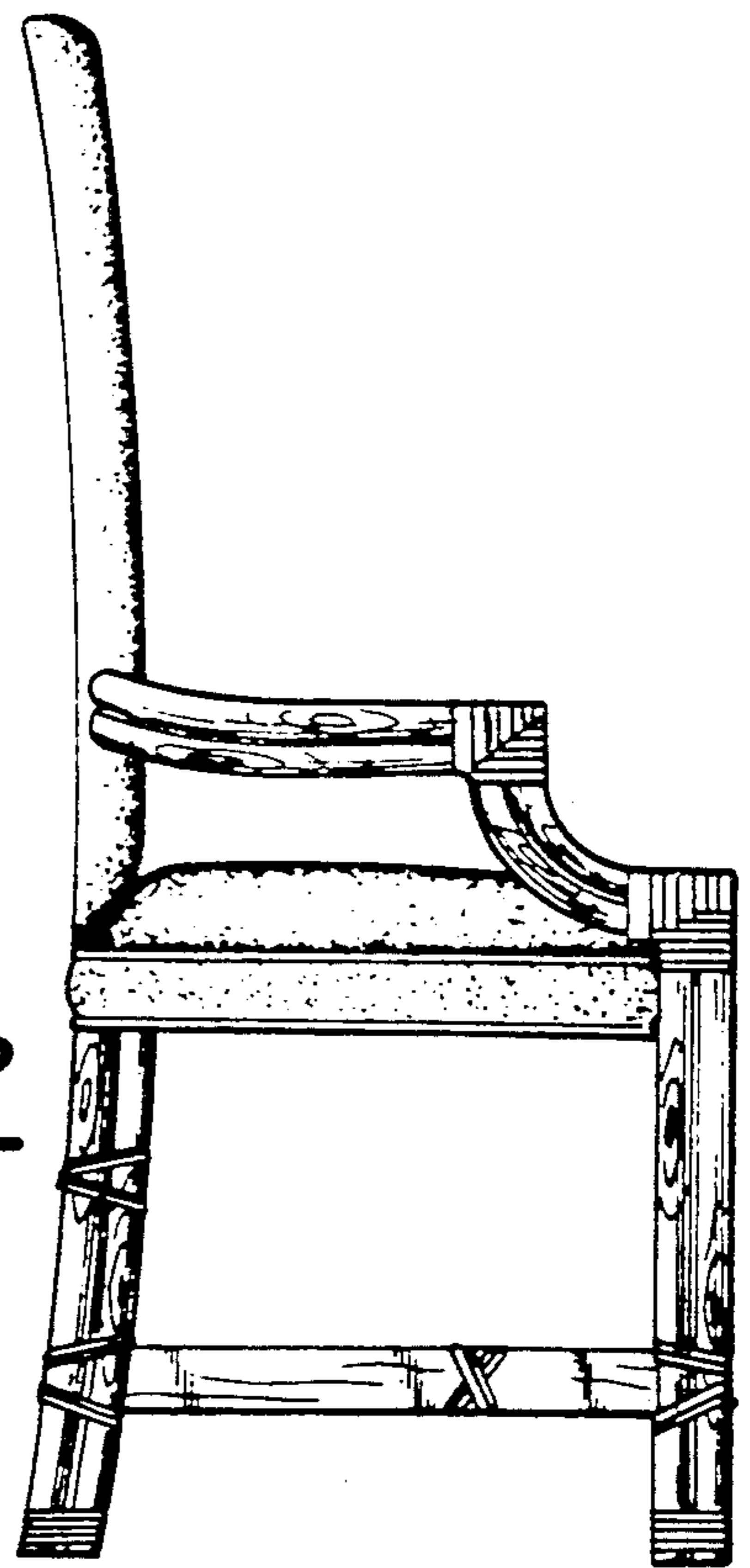

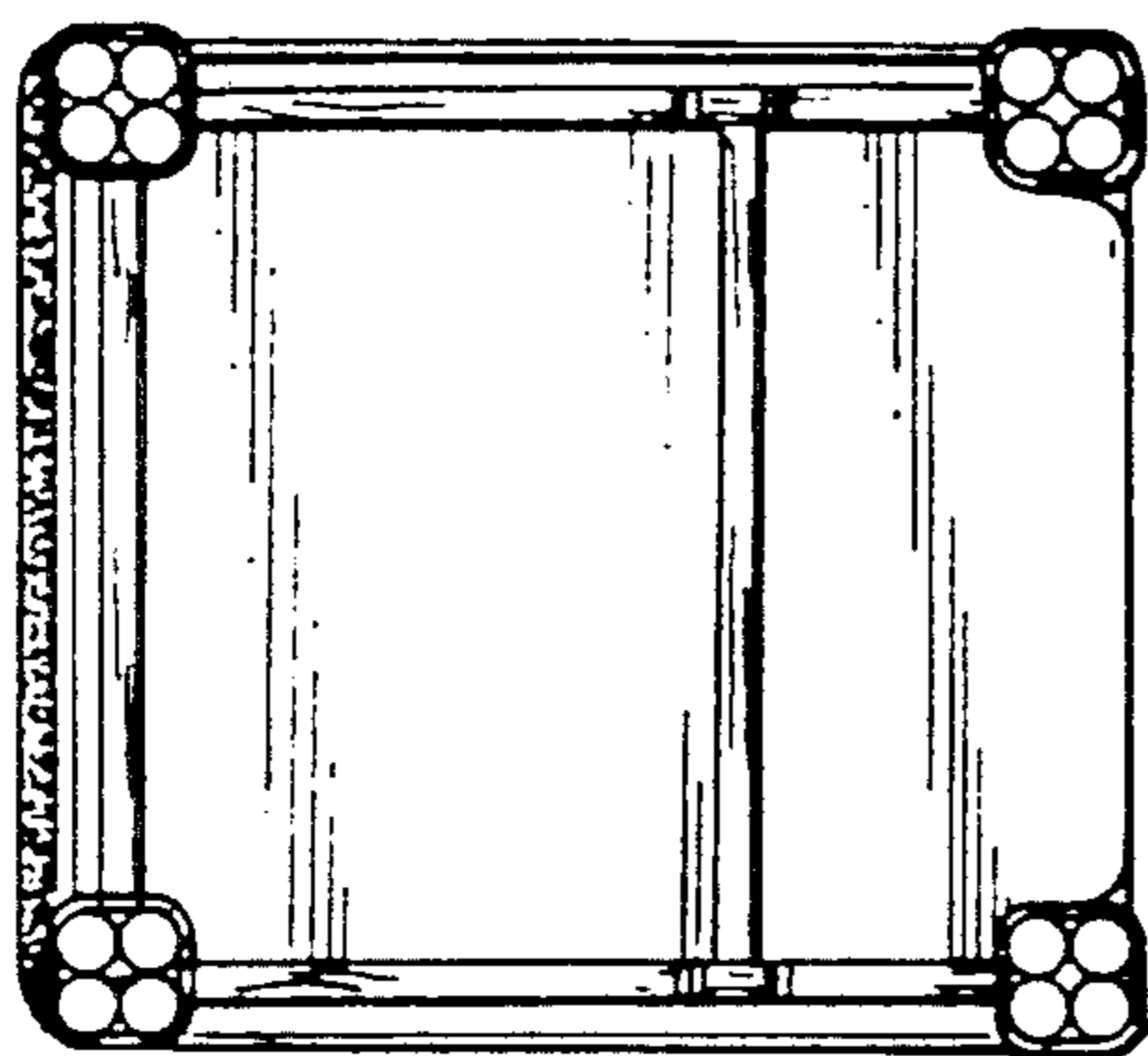

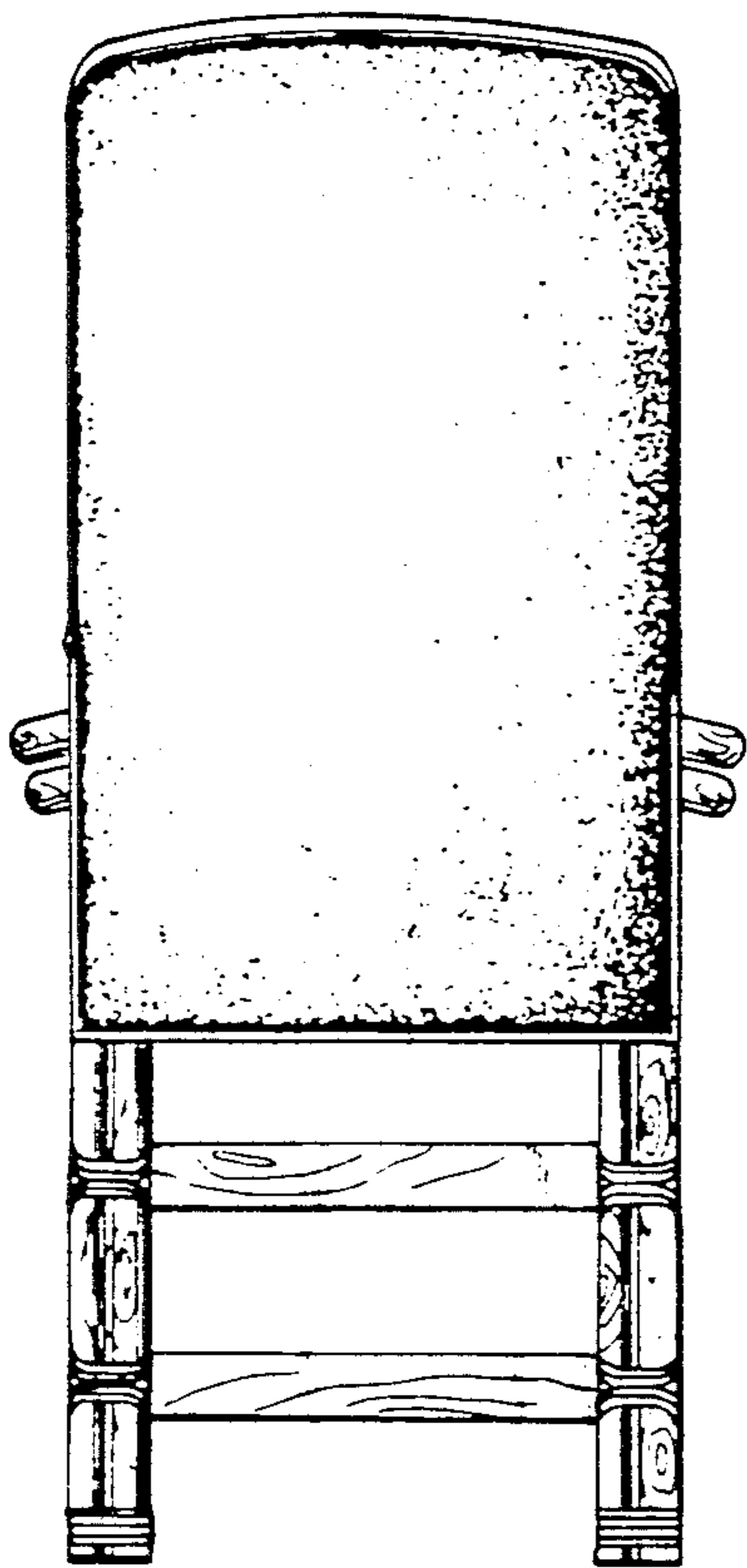

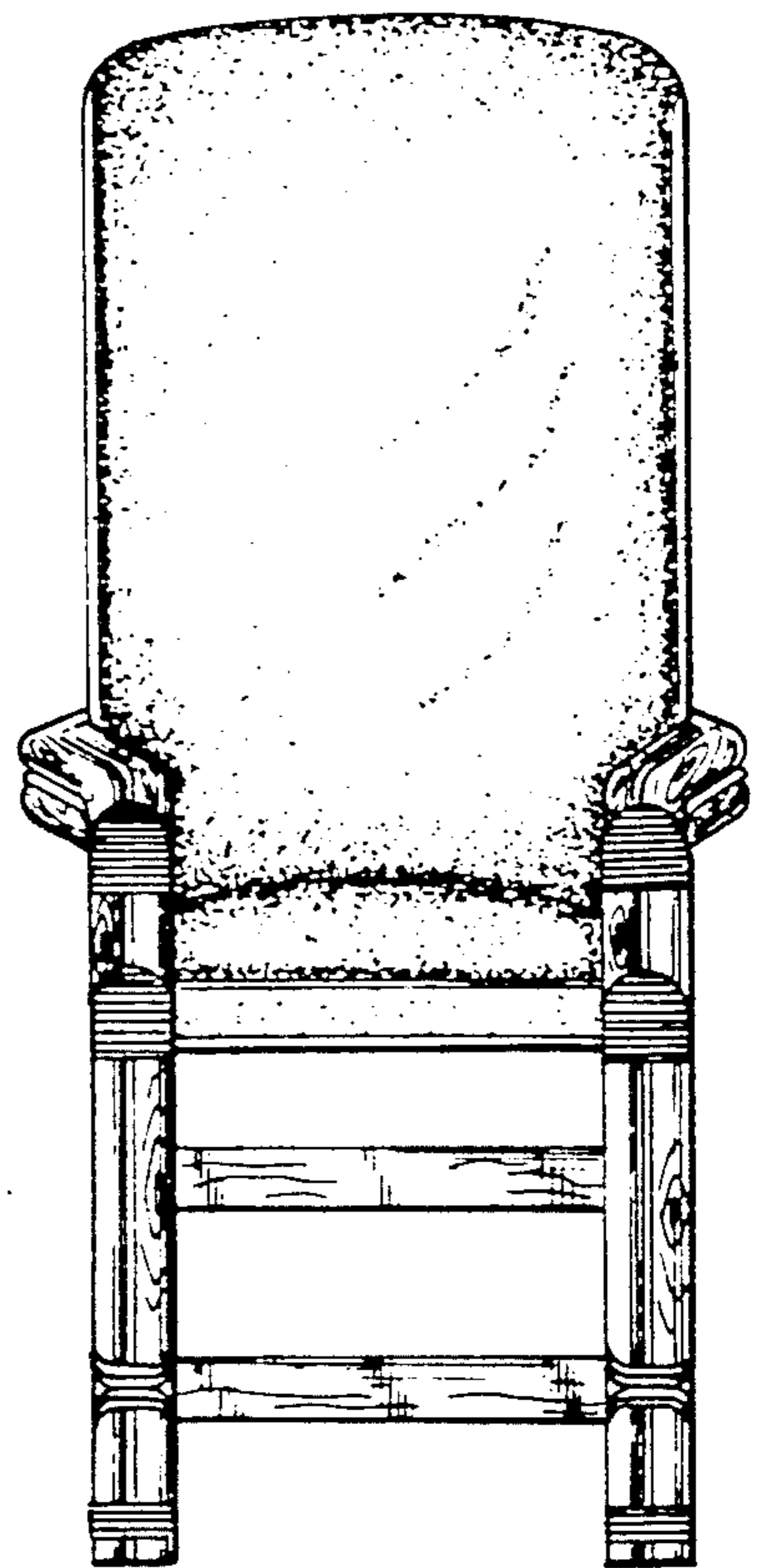

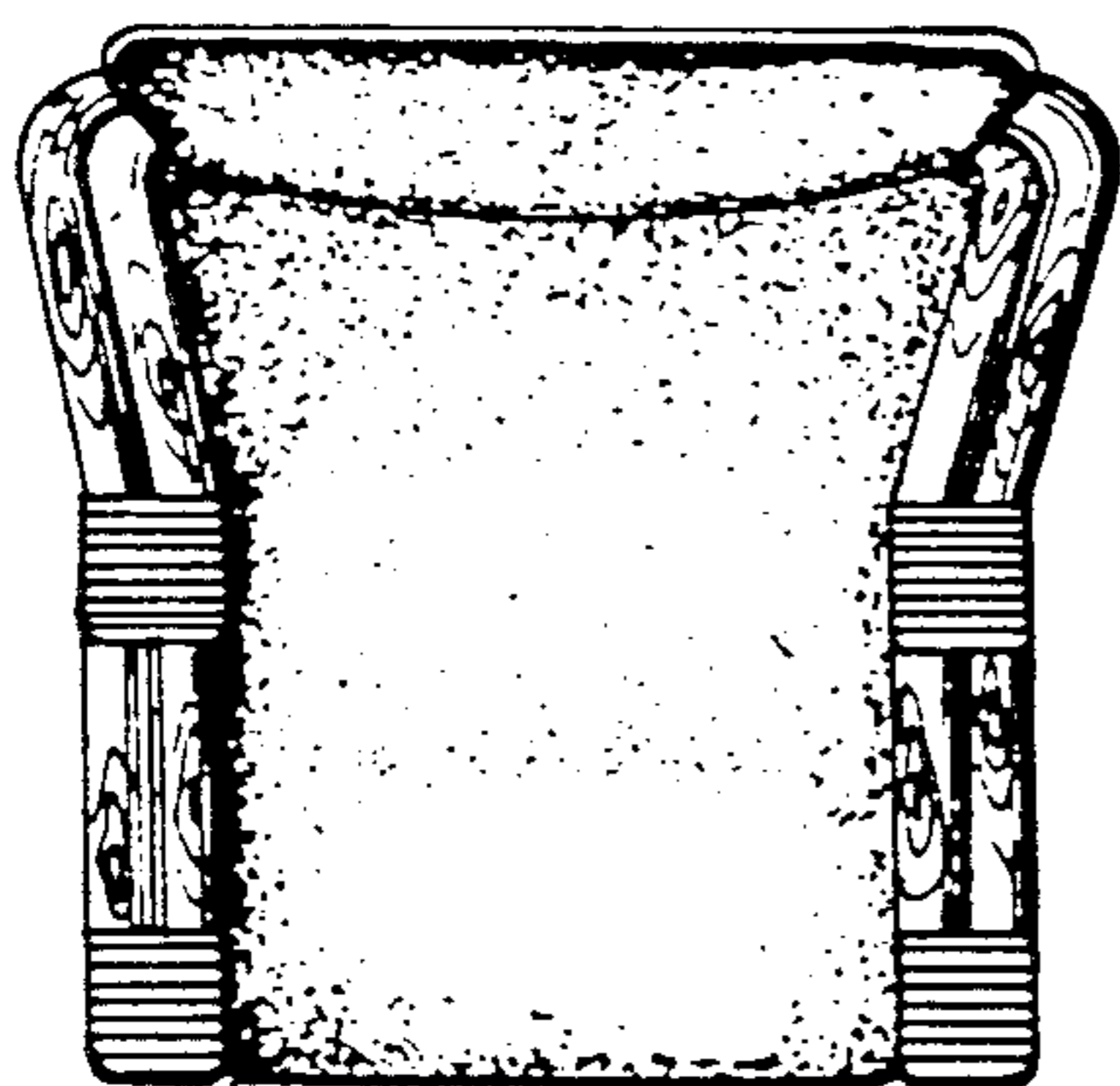

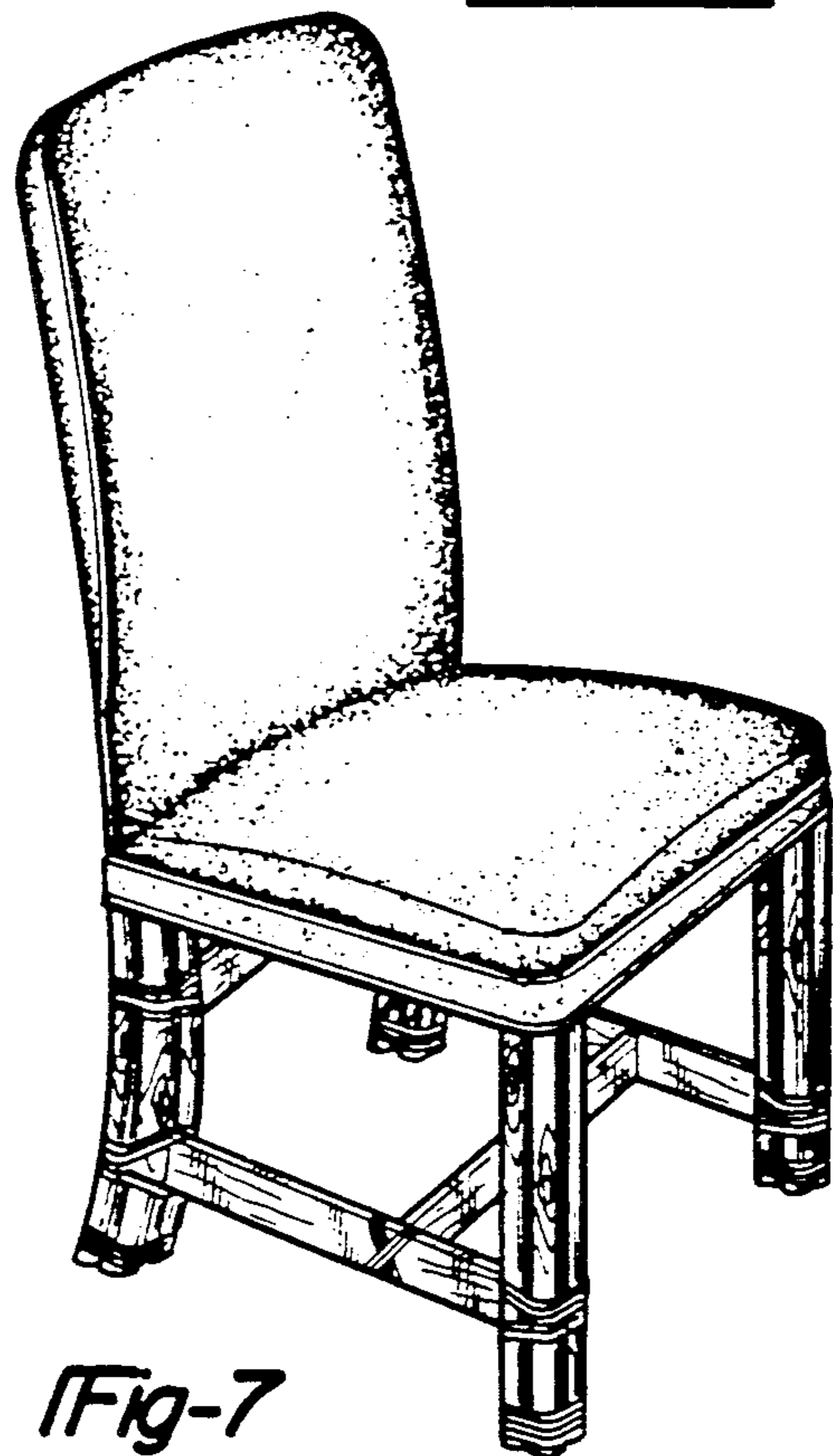
