DESCRIPTION

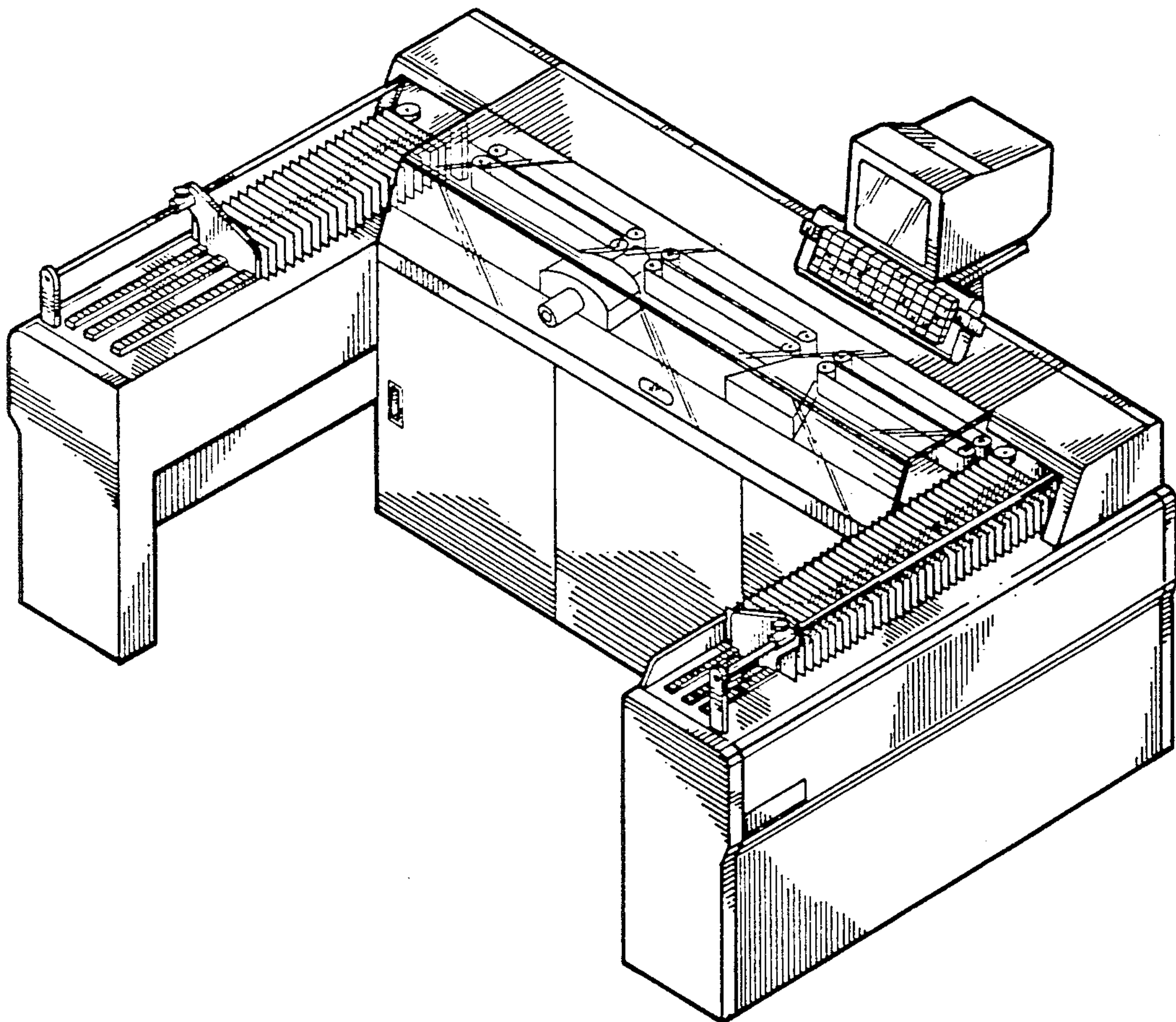
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a document processing console showing our new design;

The rear is plain and unornamented.



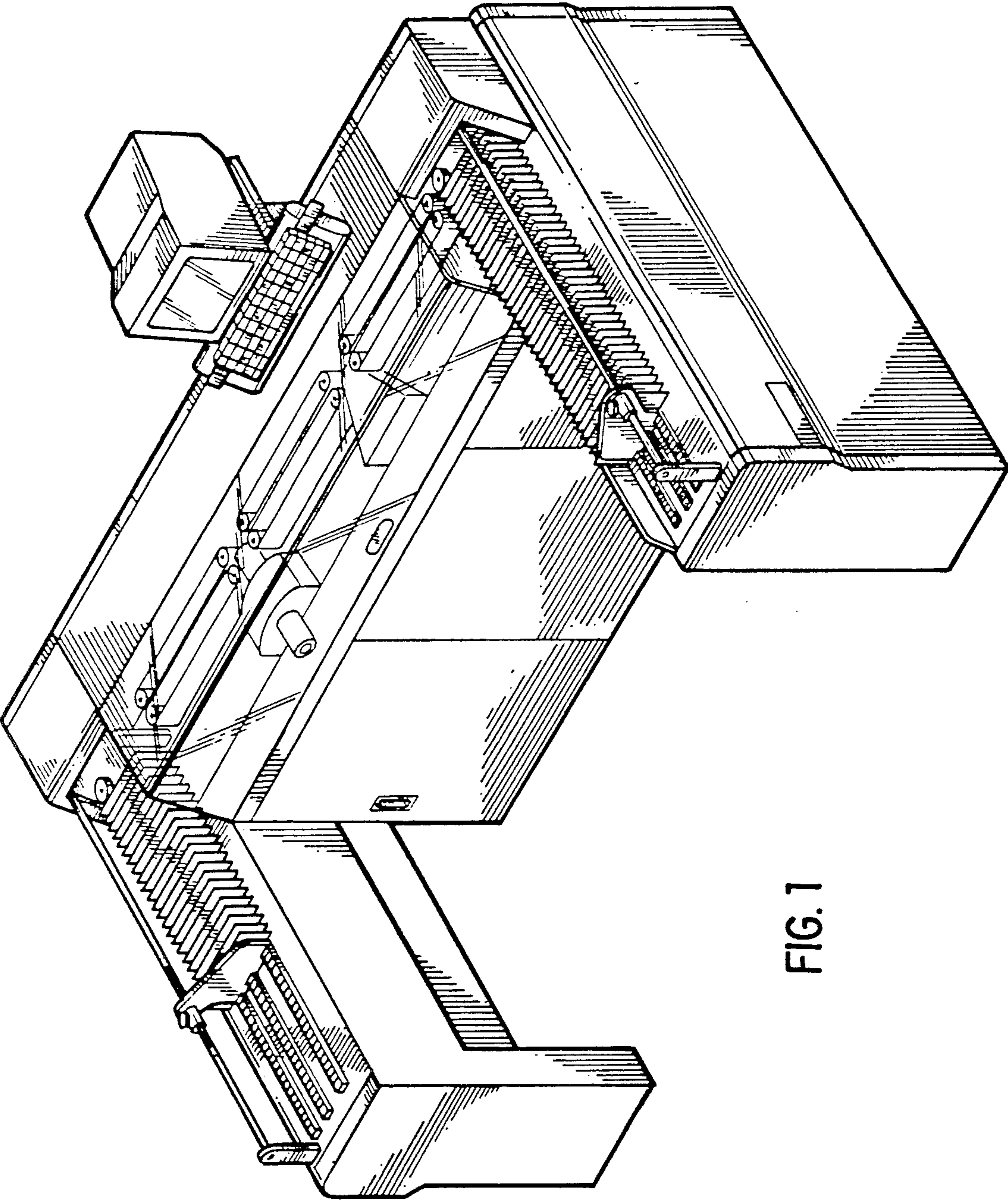

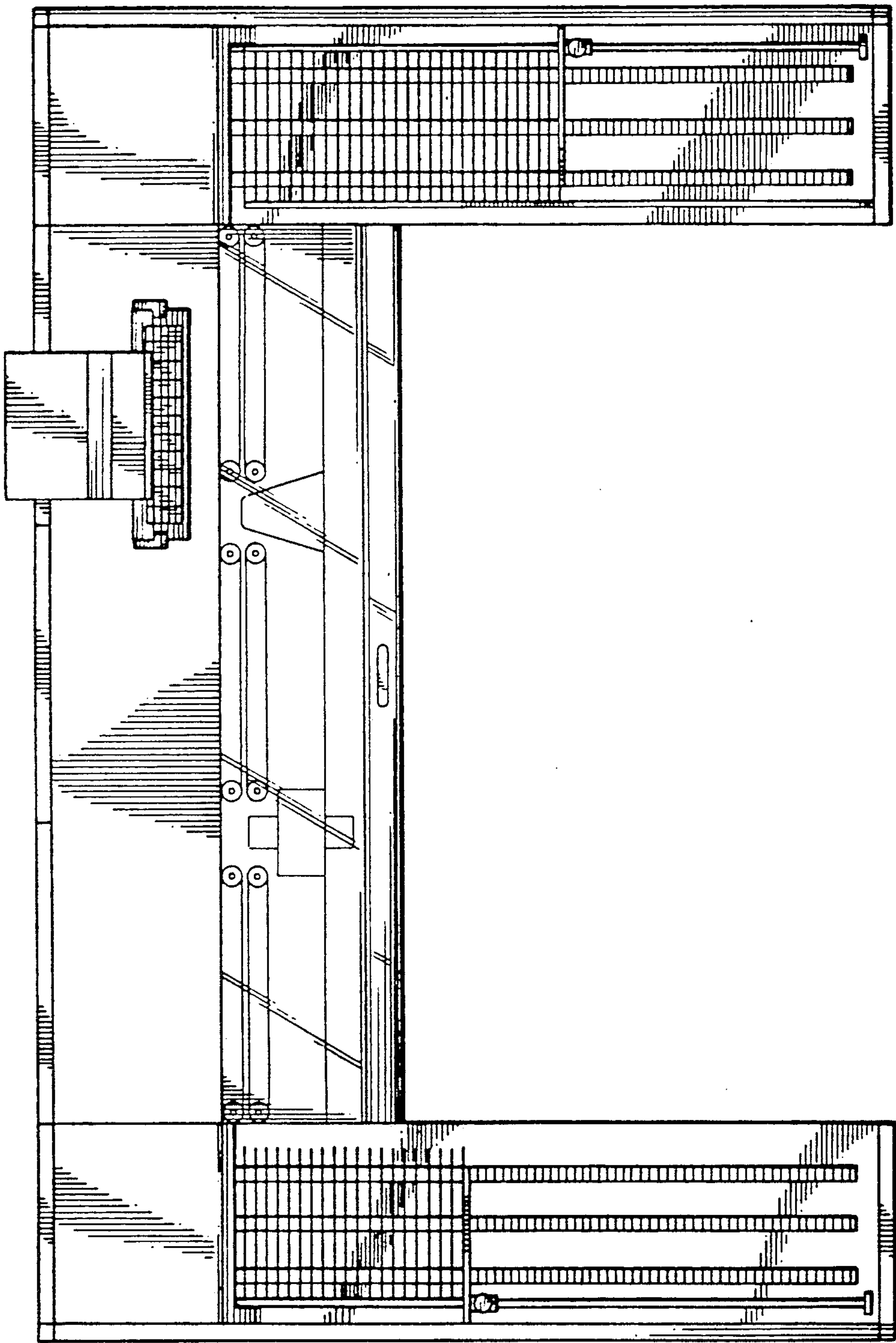

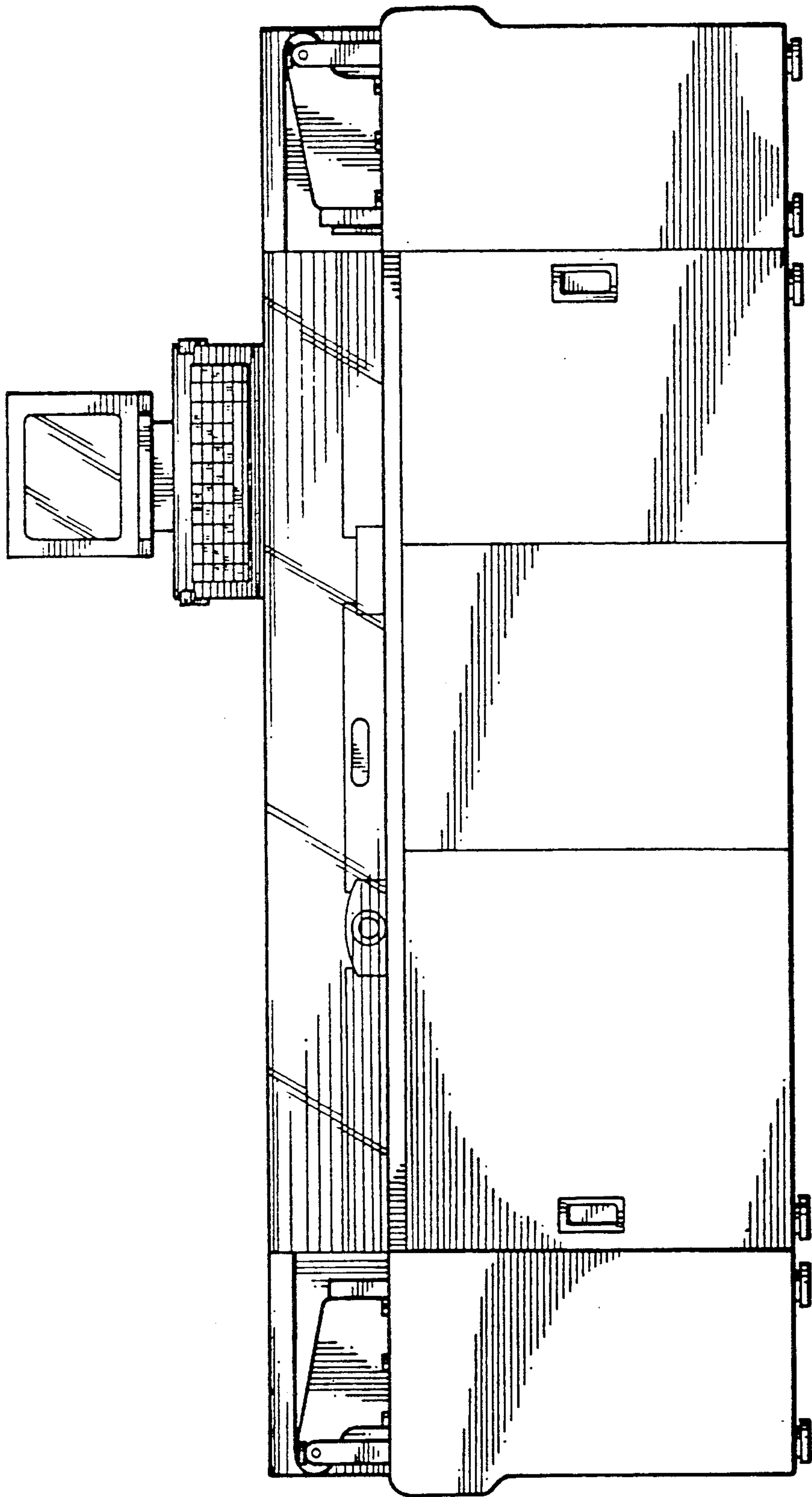

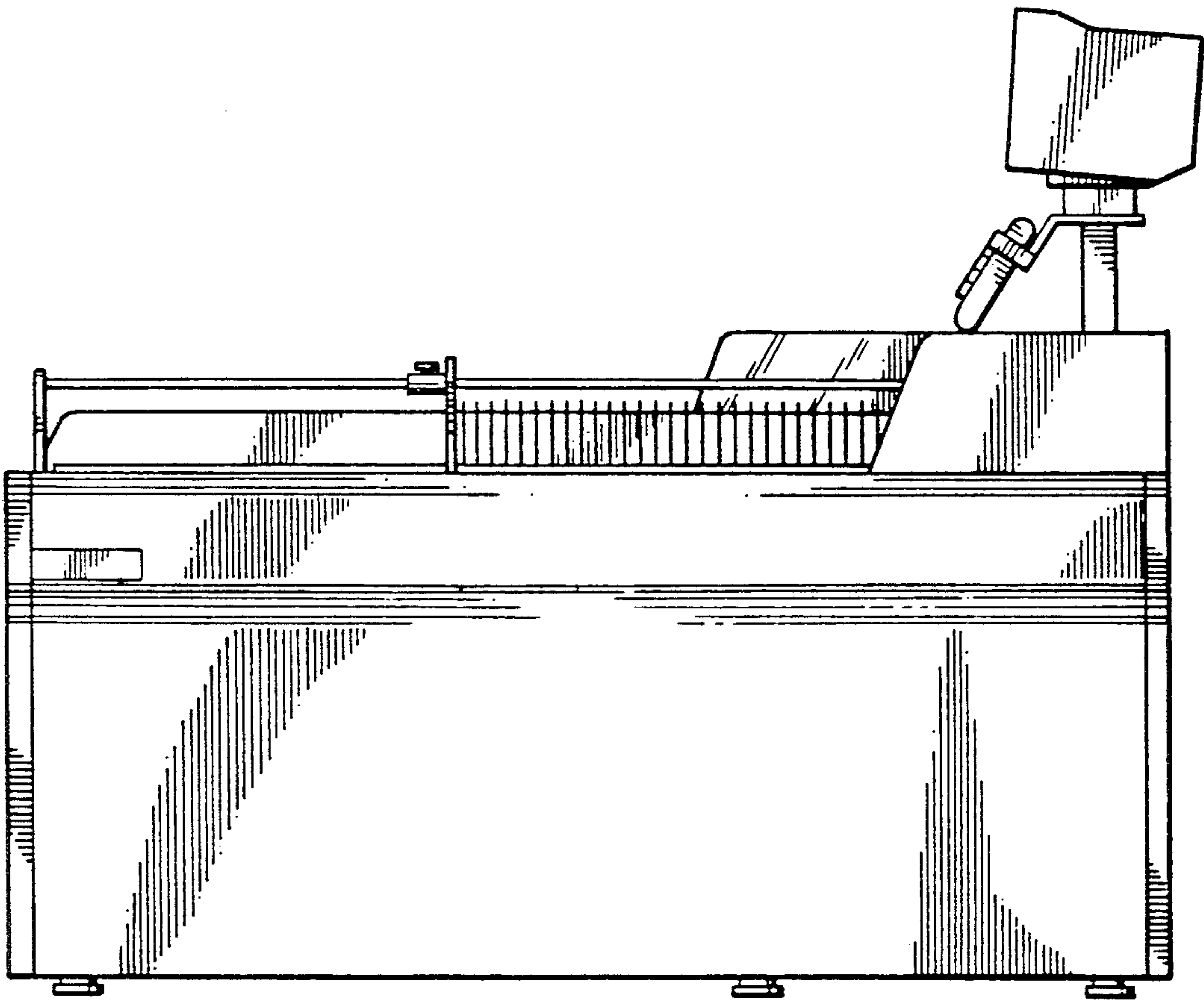
