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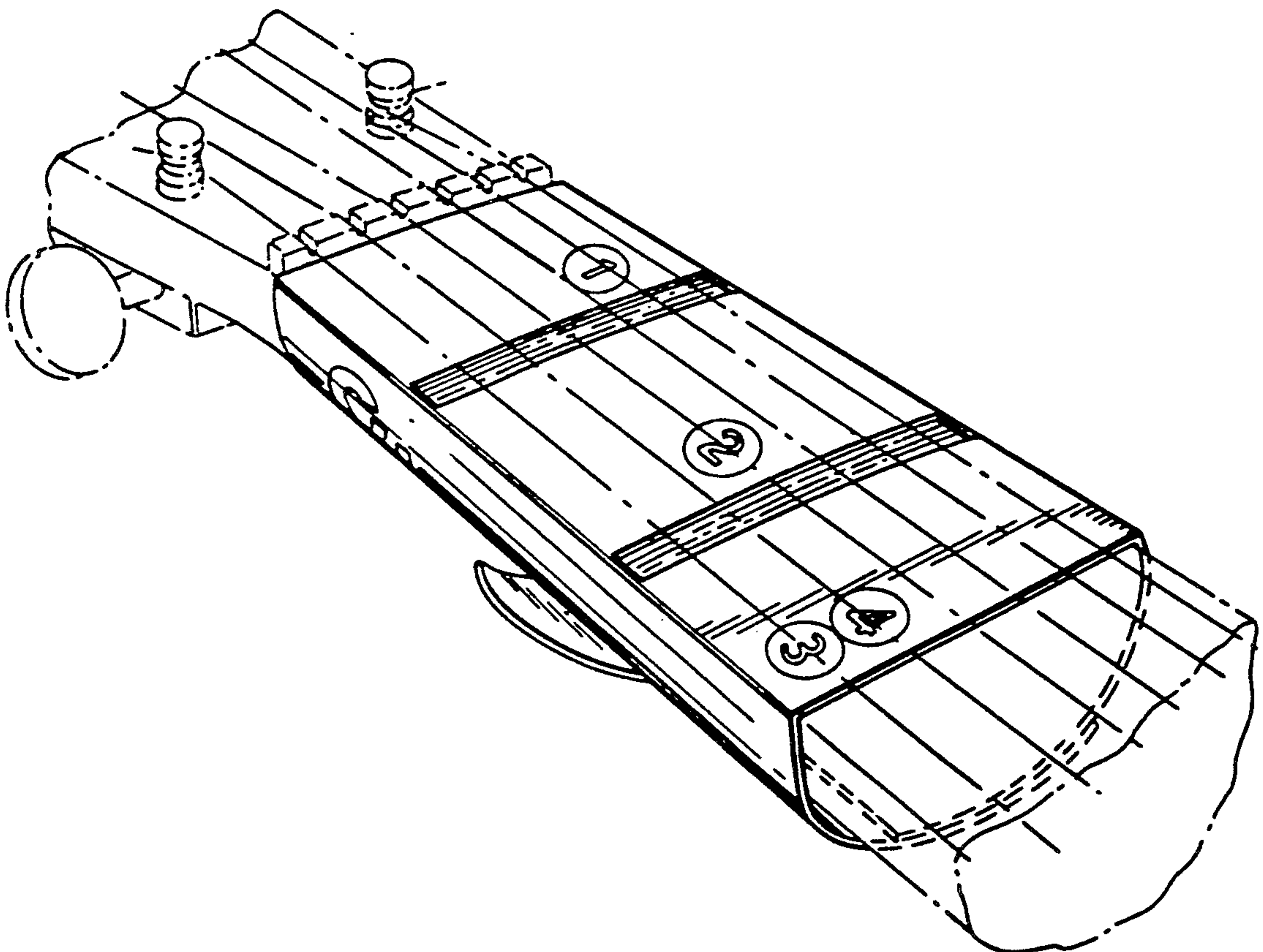

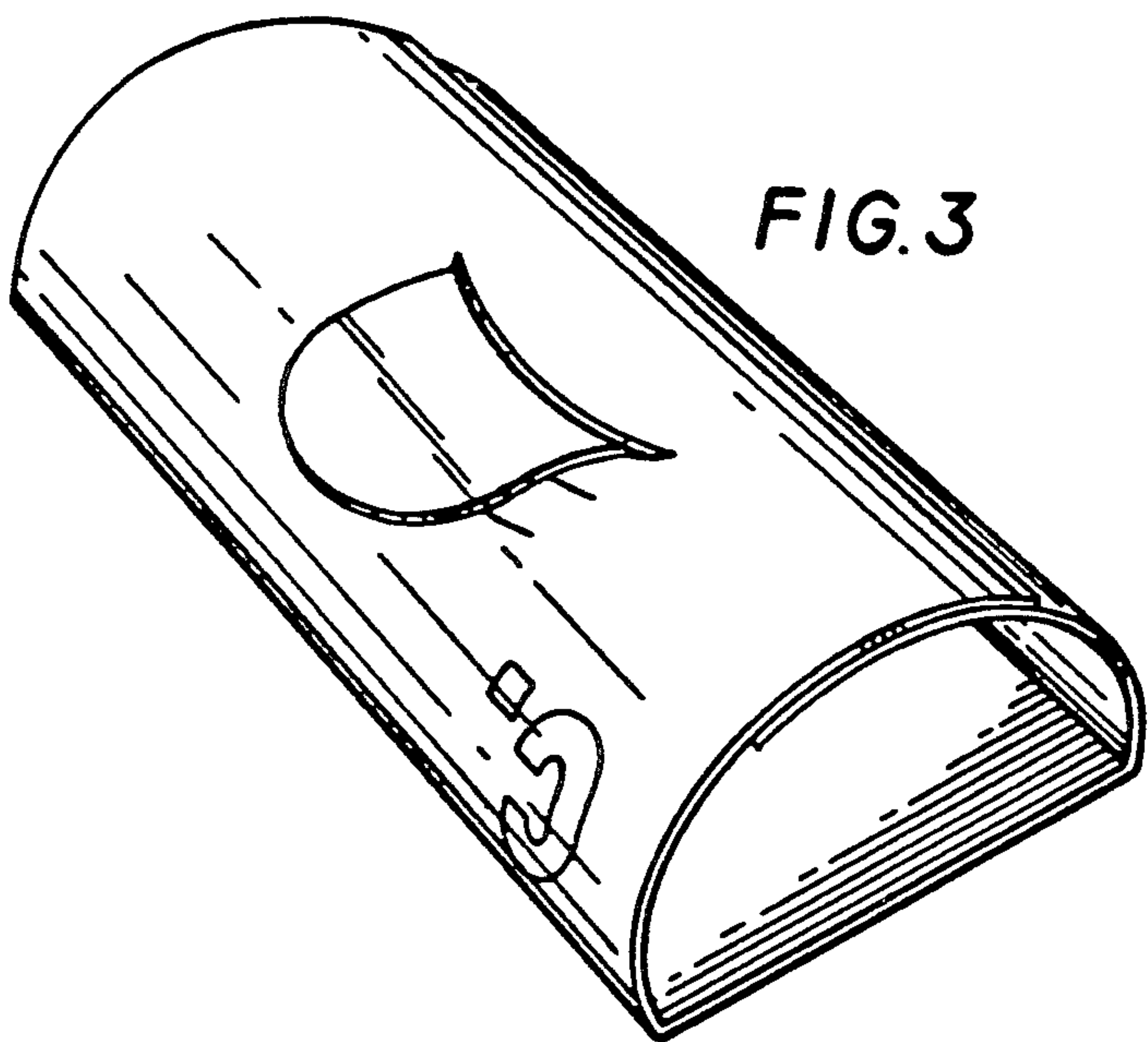
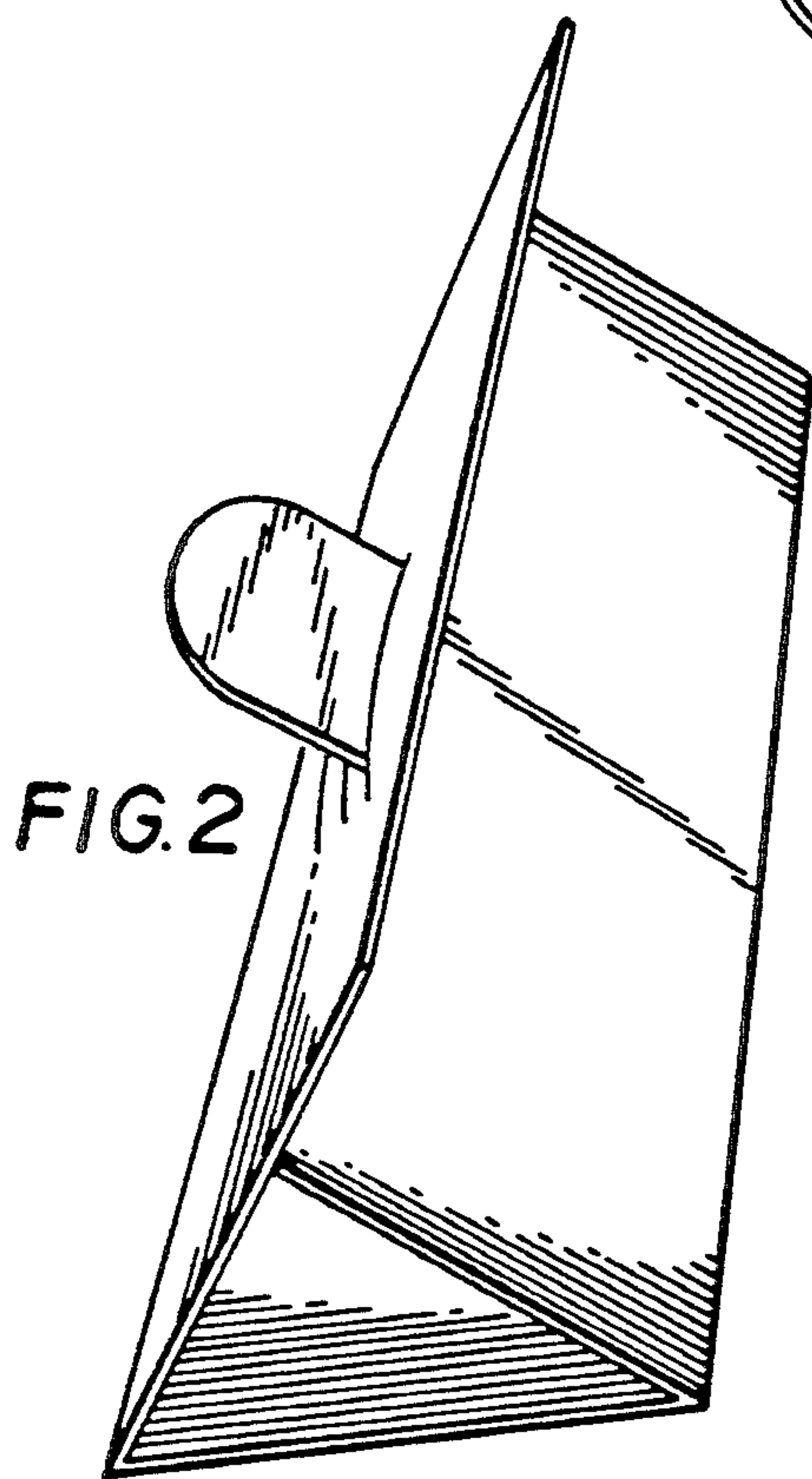
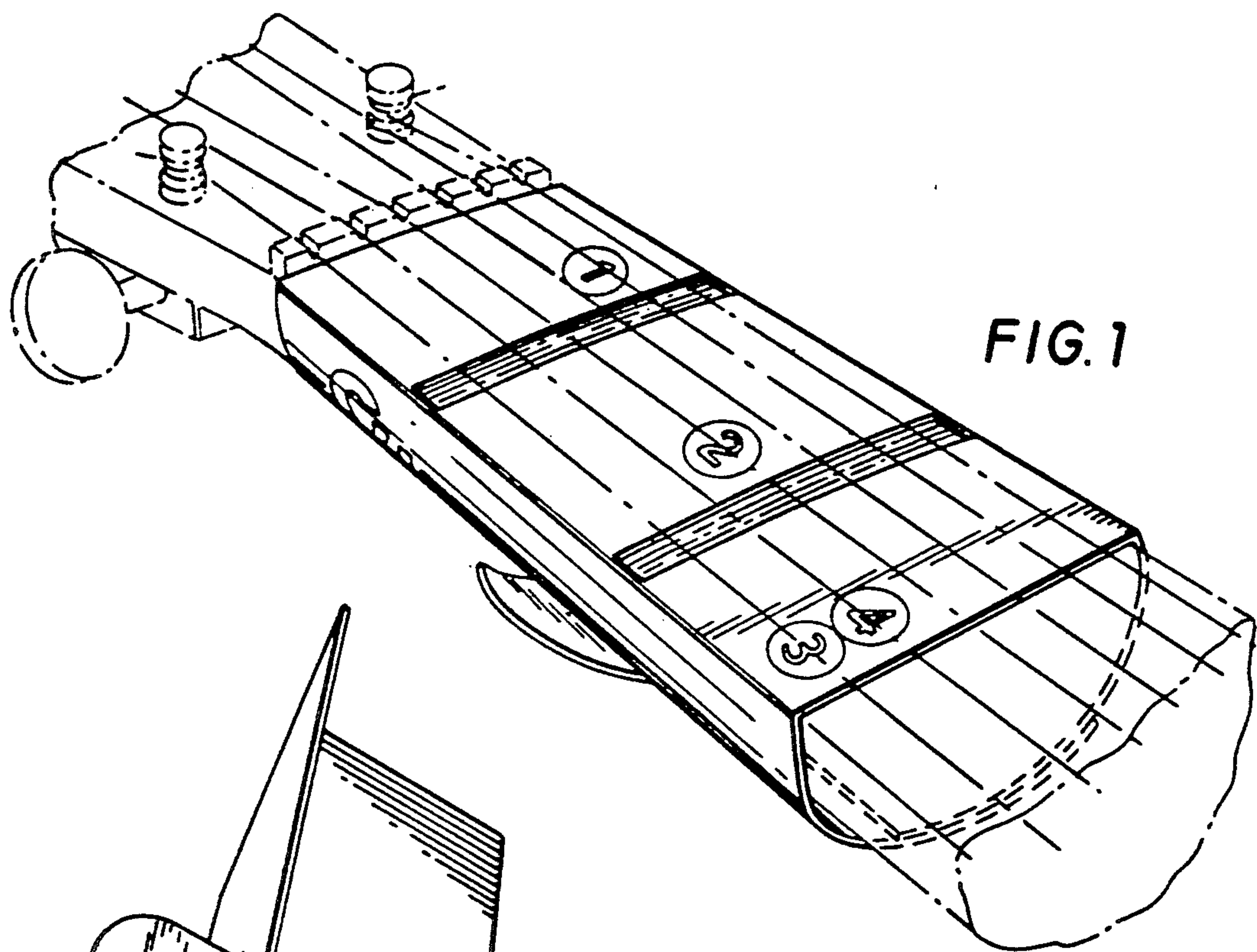

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chord teaching card showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, in a partially folded state;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof, folded to conform to a guitar neck;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof, in an open position; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof, in an open position.
The broken line portion of the drawing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.





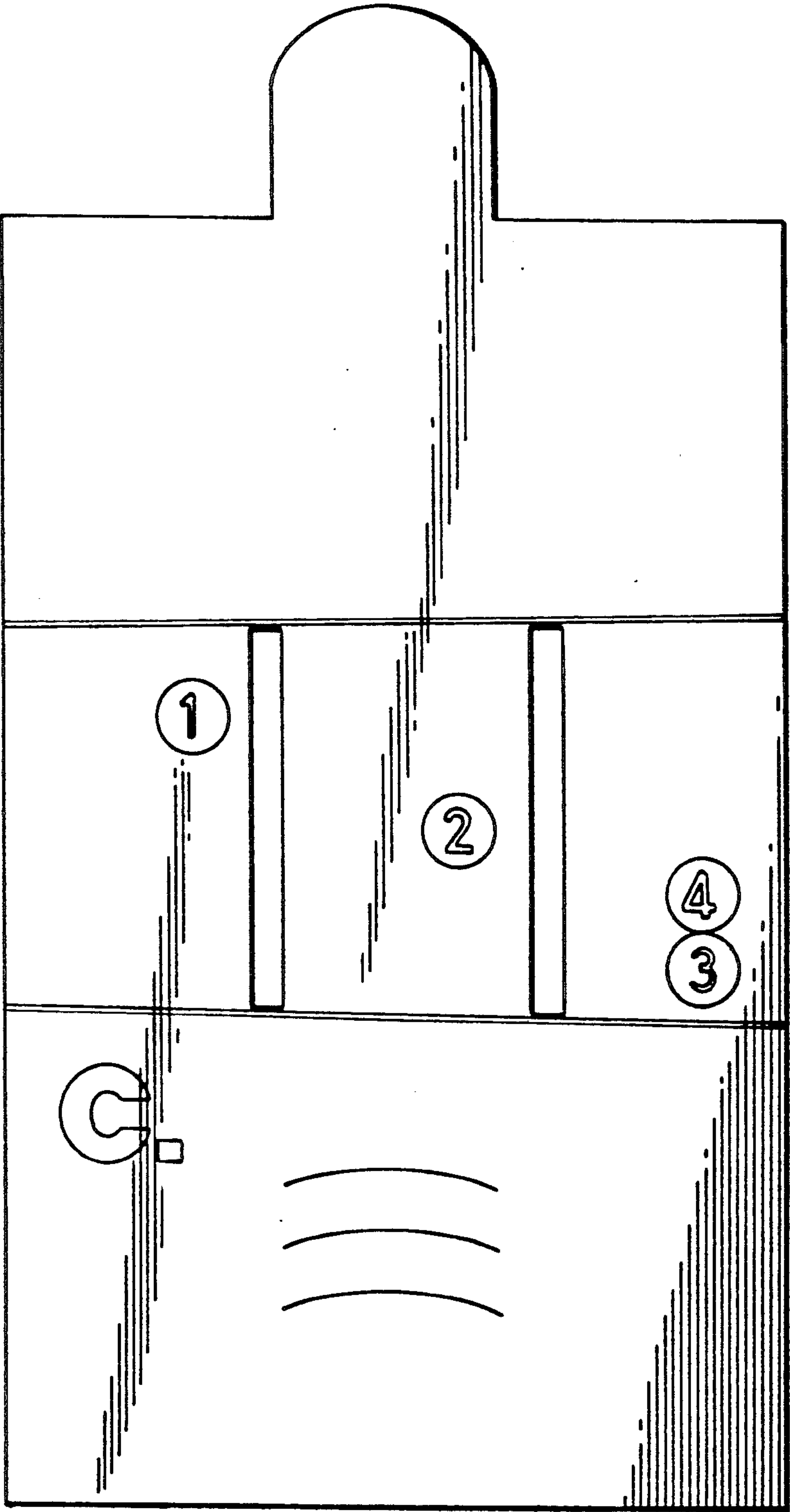
