FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a juvenile vehicle wheel showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

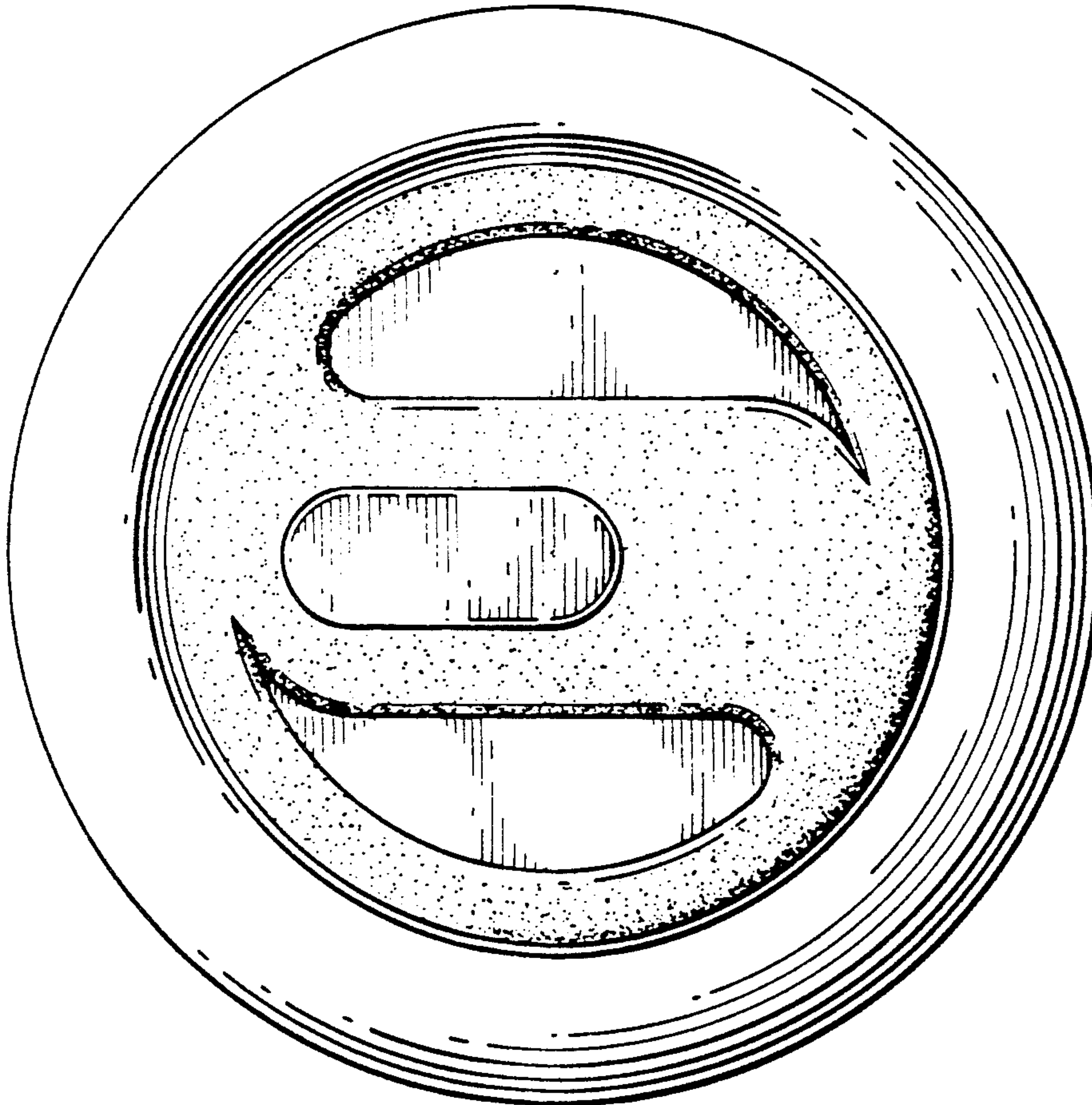
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second modified embodiment of the design shown in **FIGS. 1-5**.

The characteristic feature of the juvenile vehicle wheel, in accordance with this invention, resides in the use of a reflector on the face of a juvenile vehicle wheel, substantially as shown.

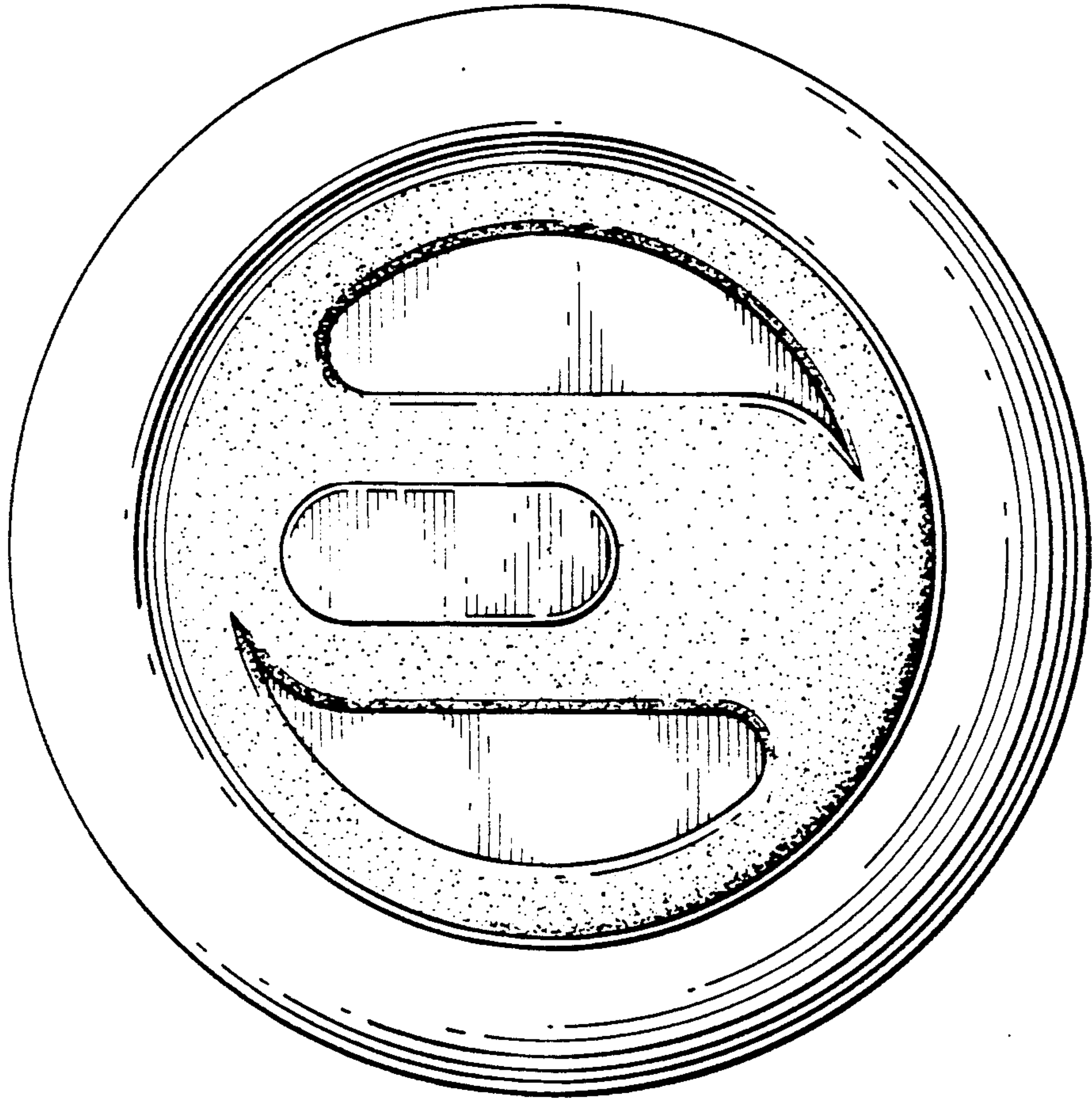

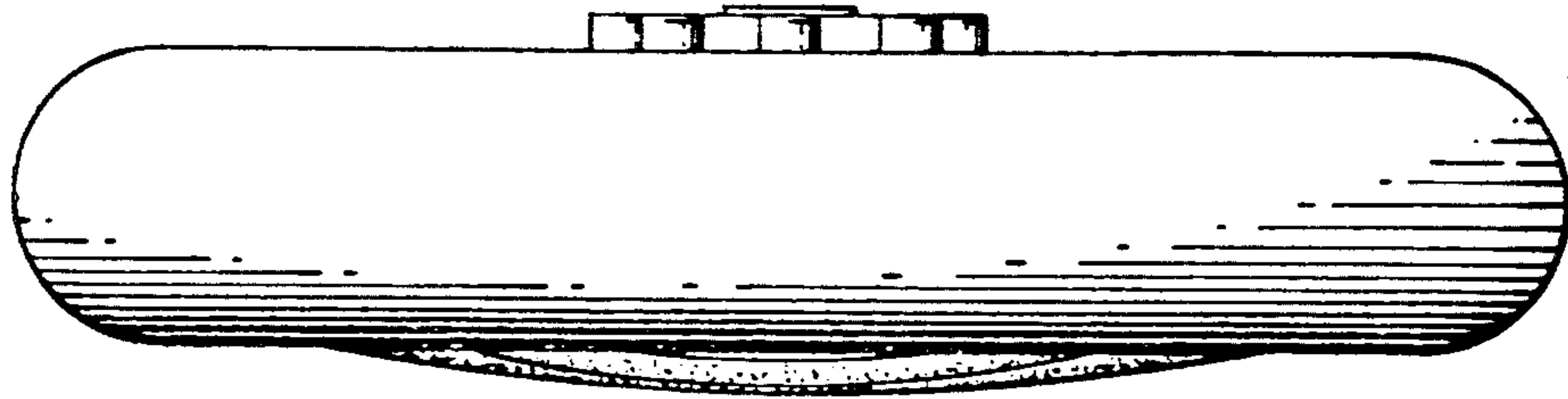

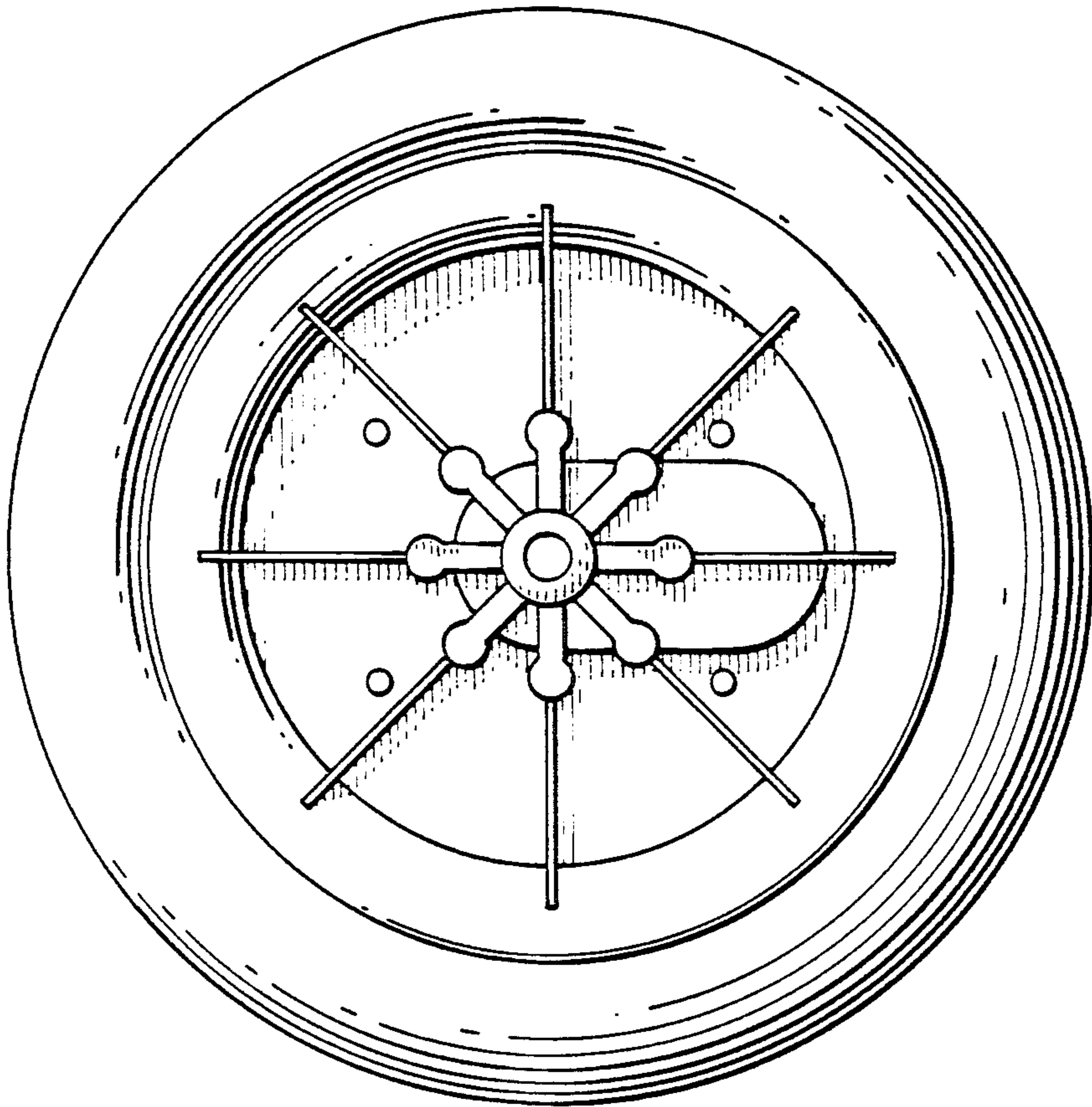

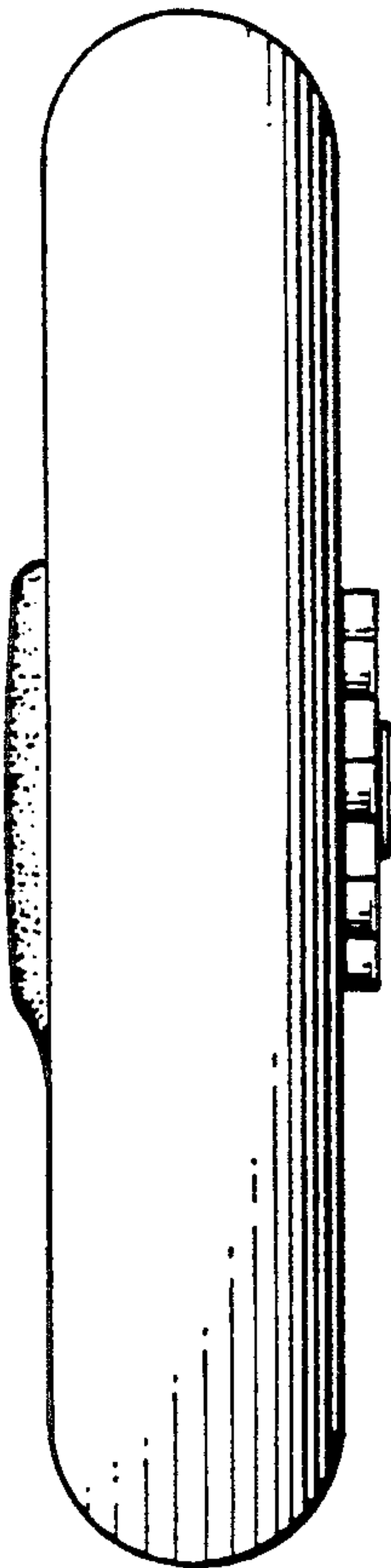

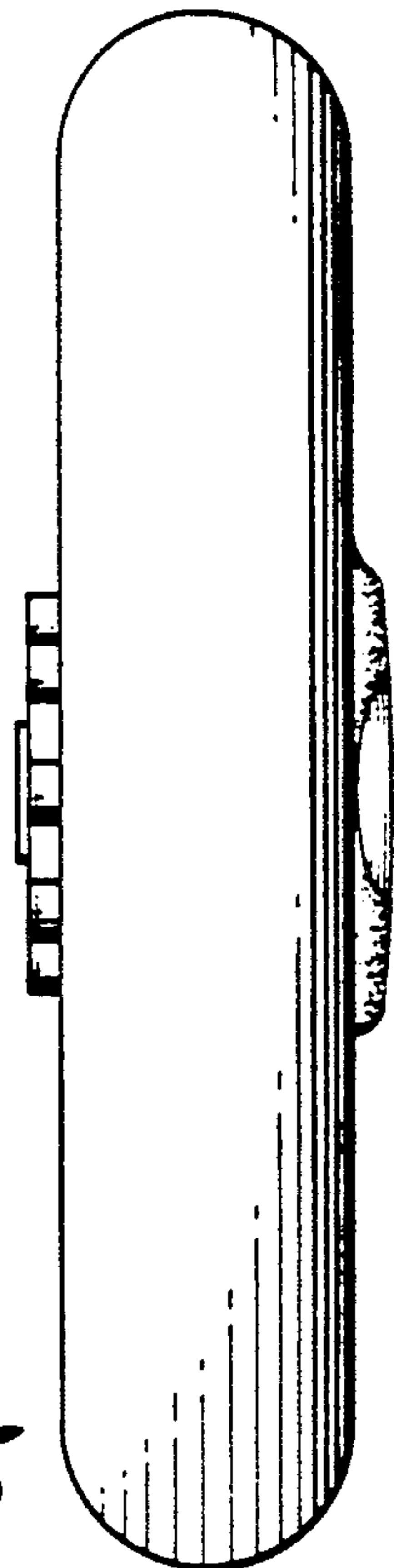

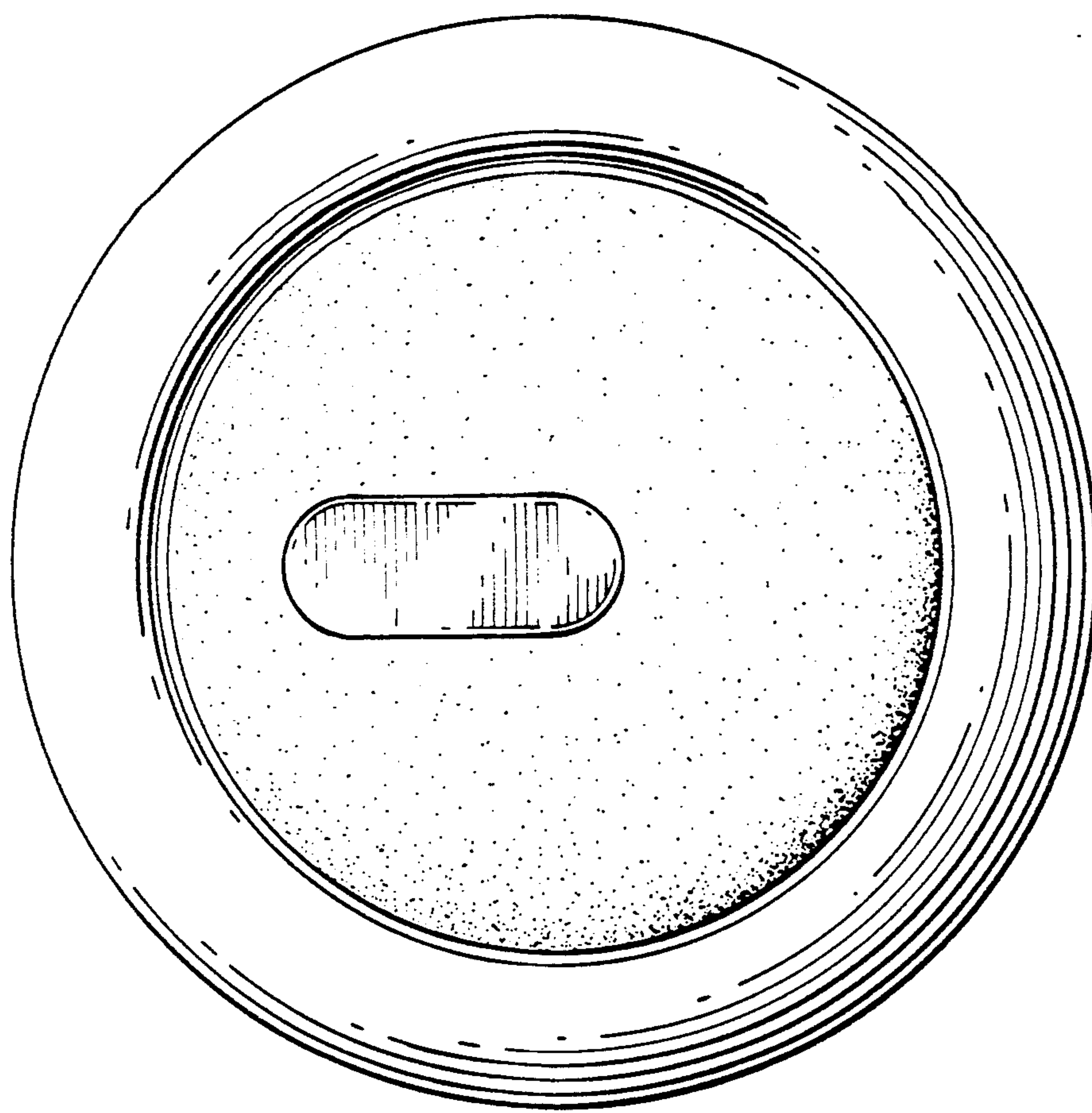
