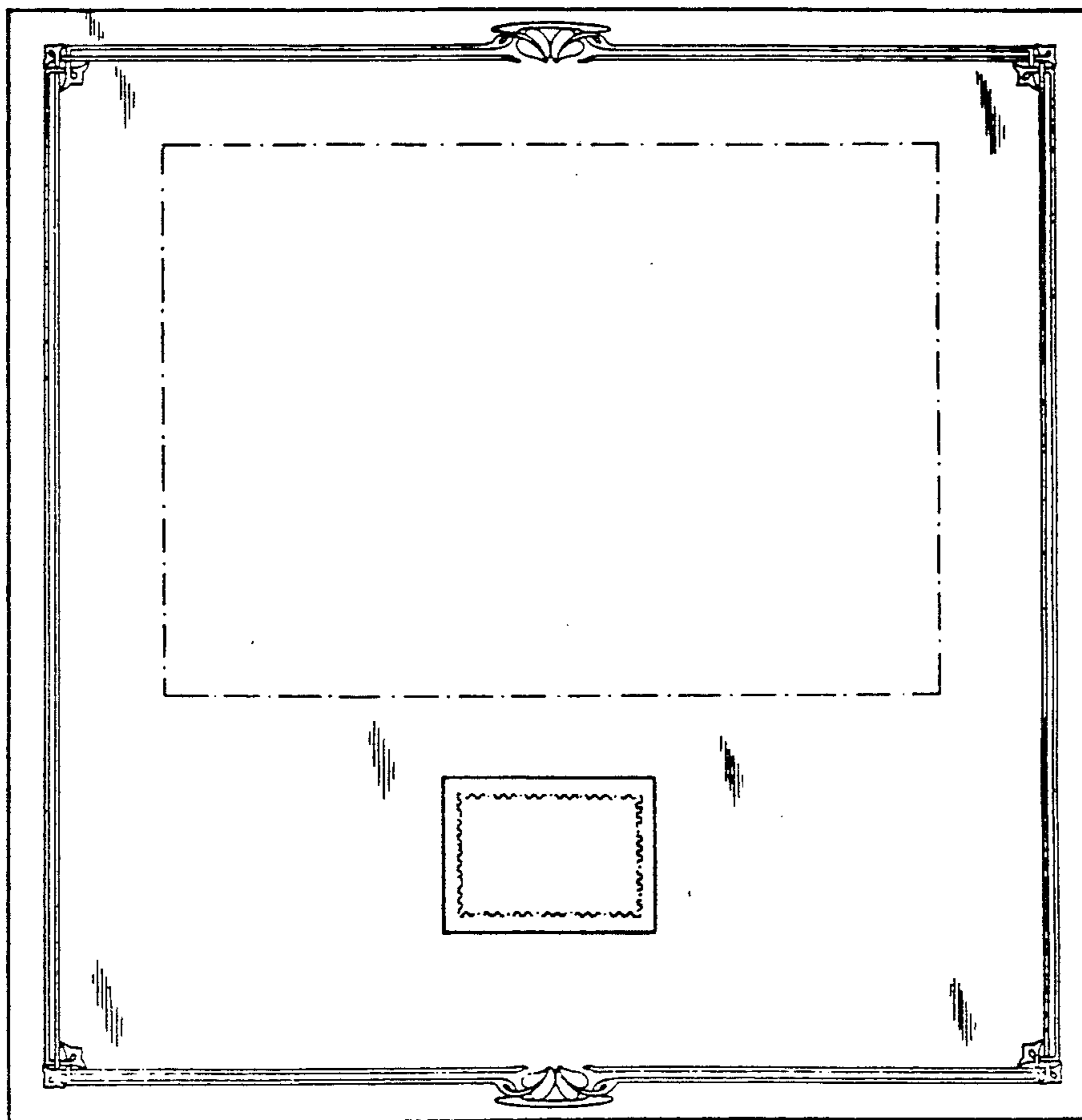
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a frame for postage stamp pictures showing my new design, the undisclosed rear side being plane and unornamented;

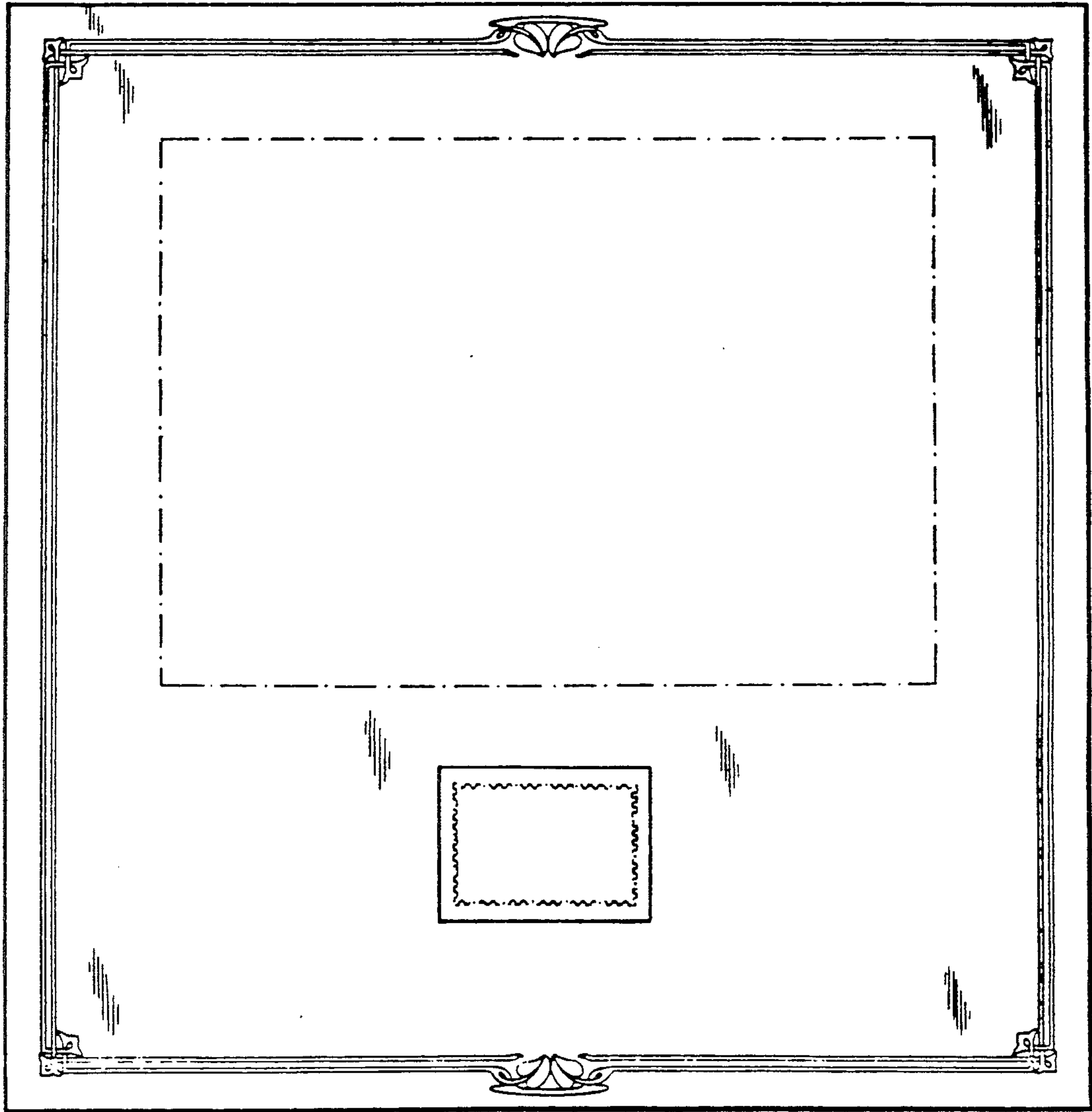

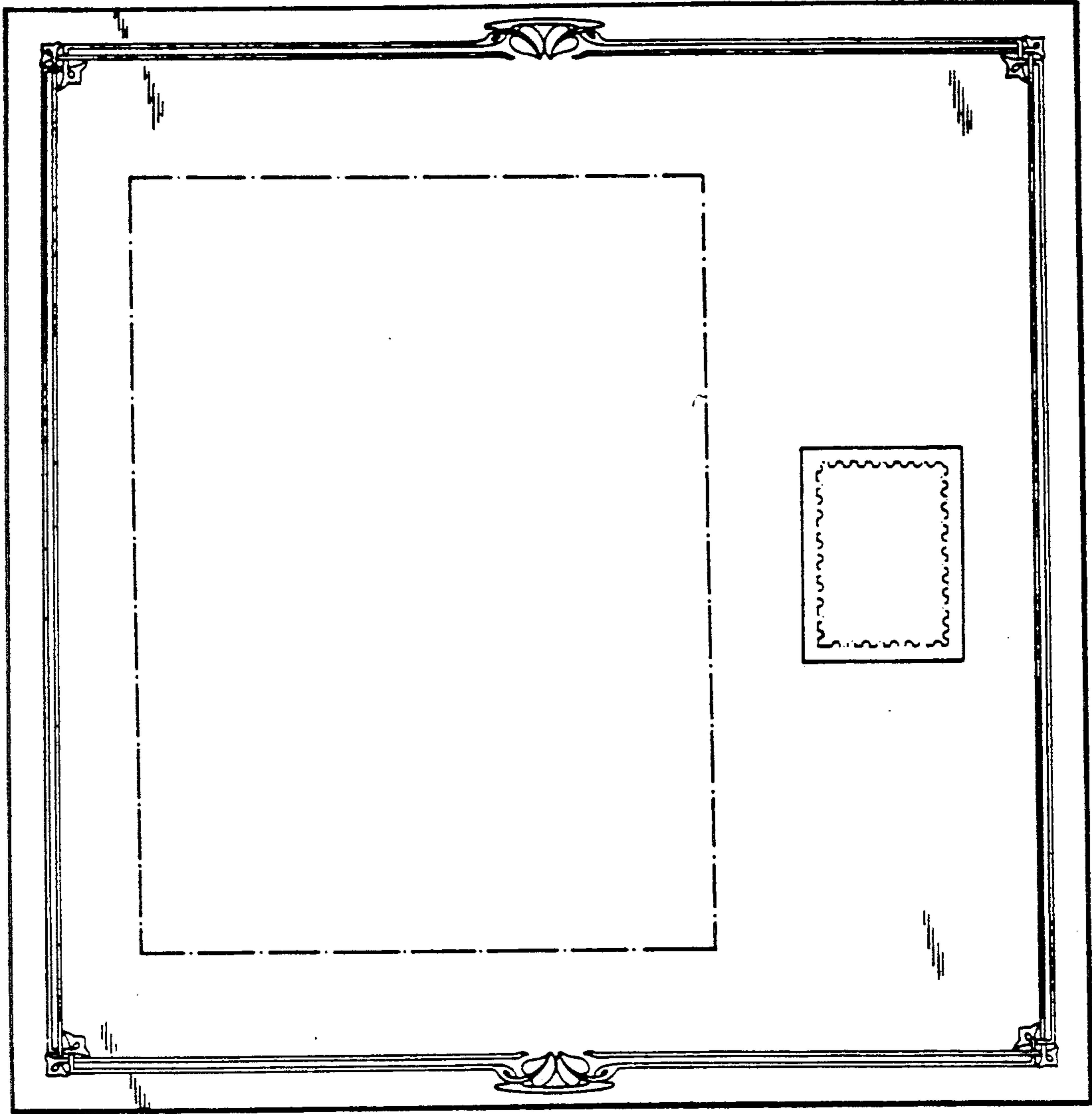

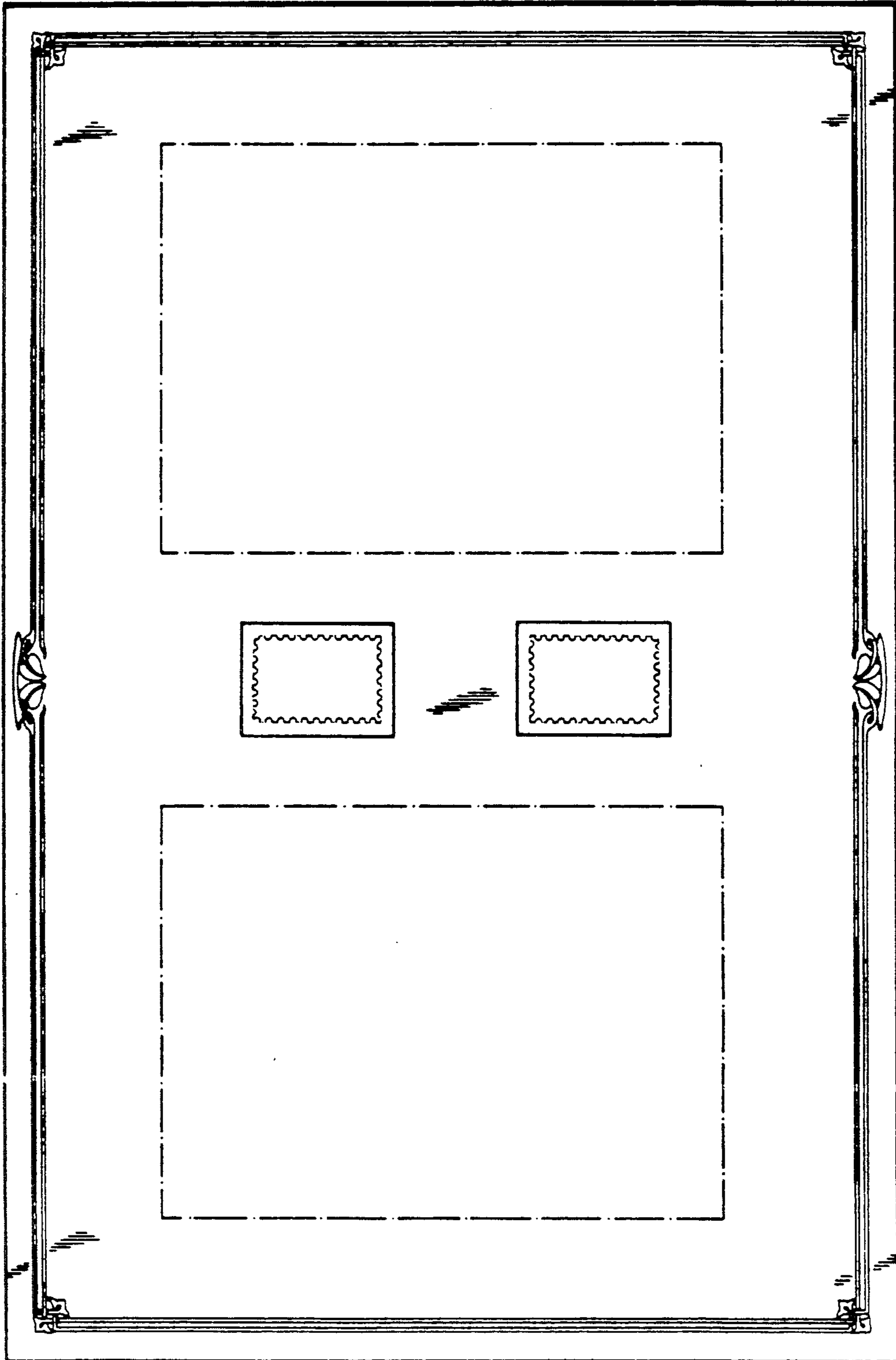
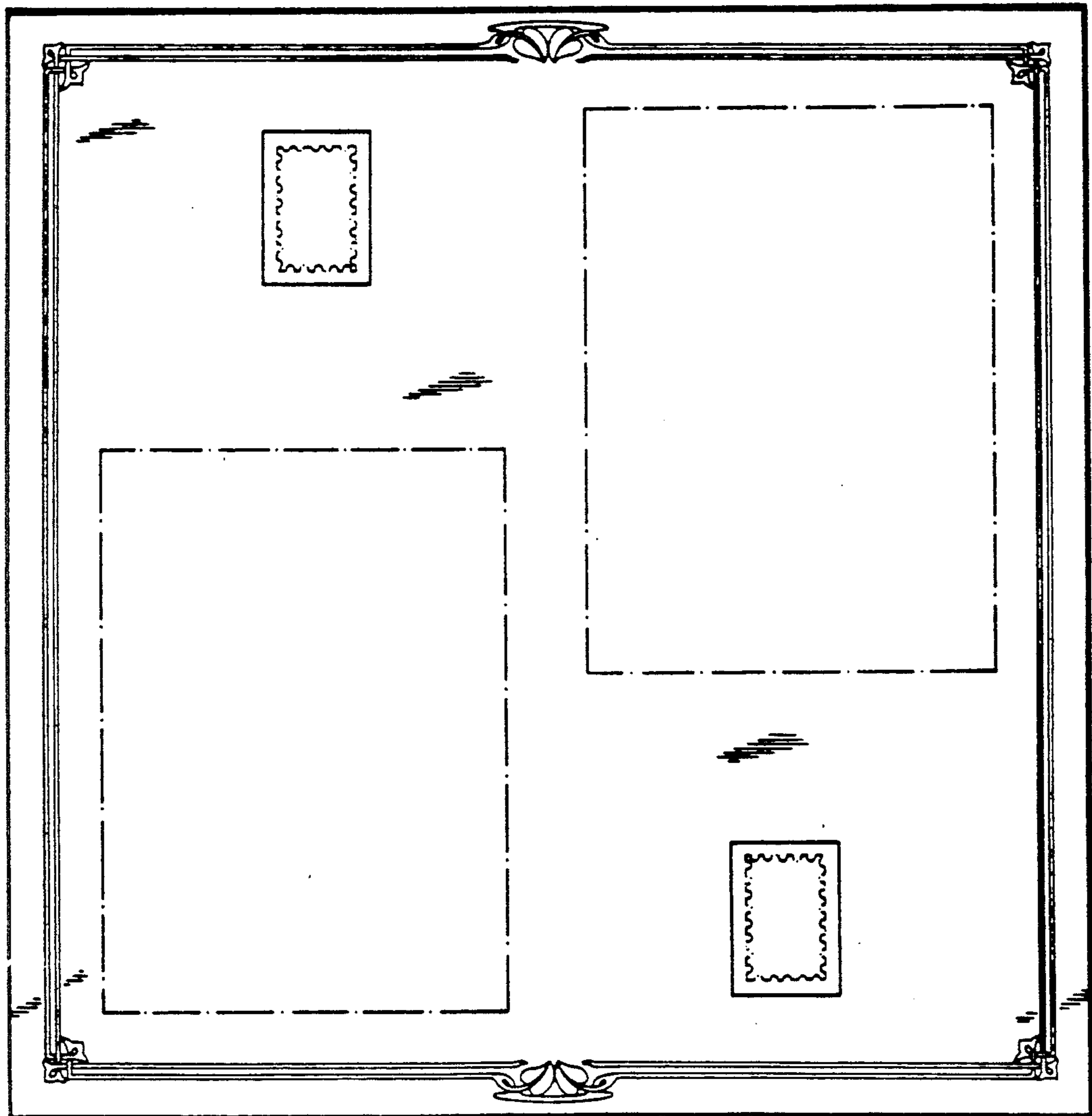

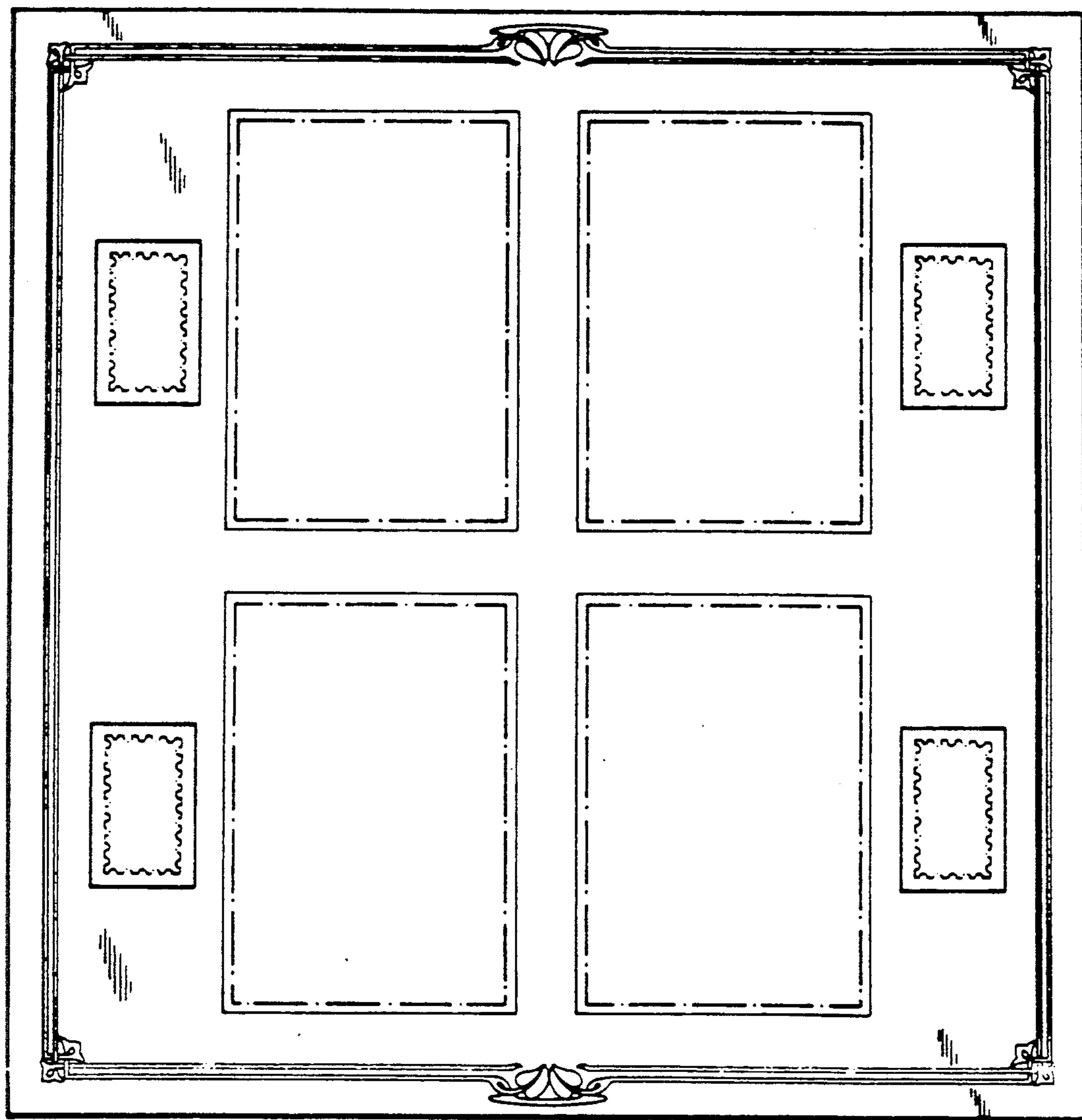
