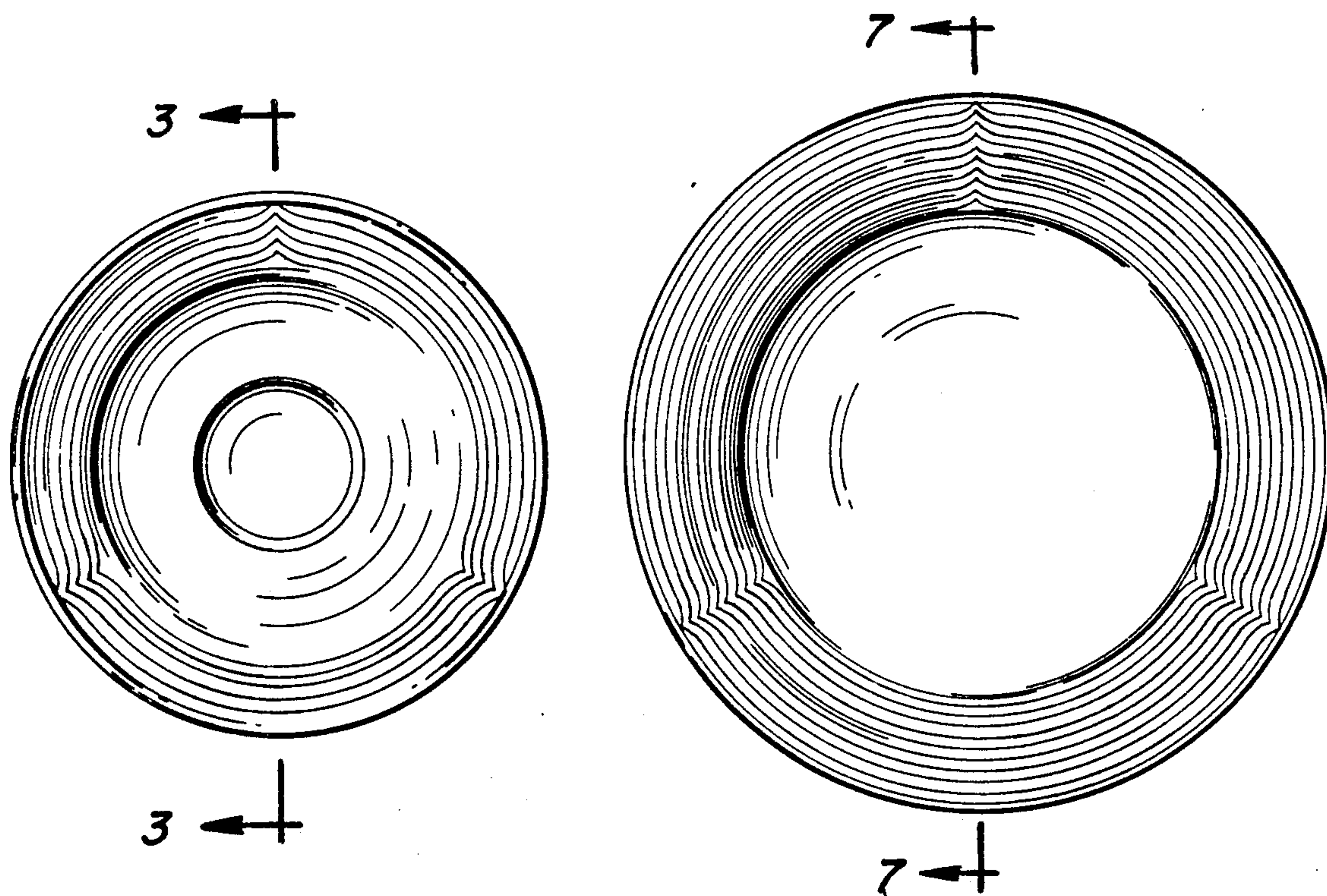

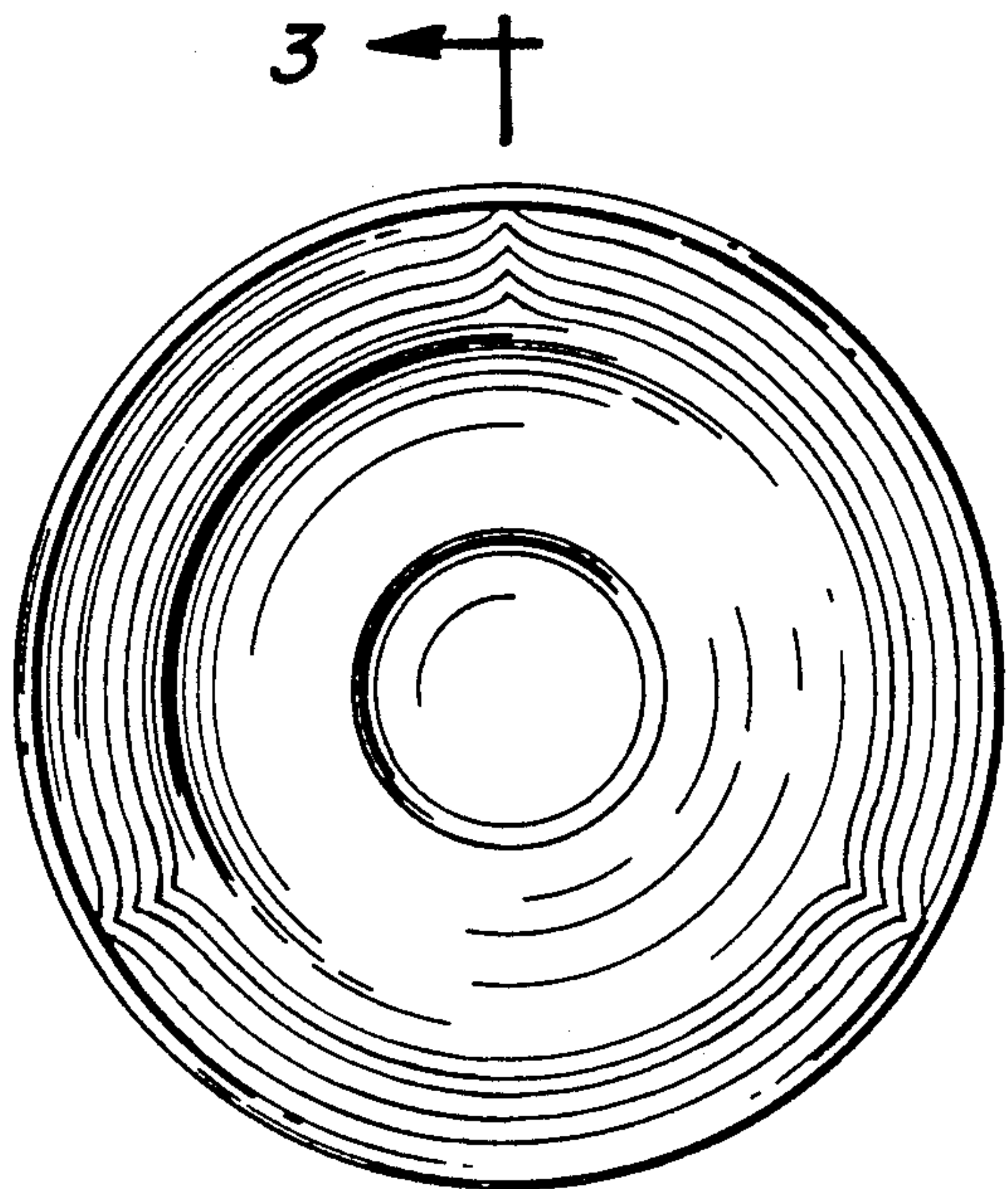
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a plate or similar article, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a plate or similar article
showing my new design as embodied in a saucer;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line
3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a plate or similar article
showing my new design as embodied in a dinner plate;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5;
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 7—7 of
FIG. 5; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5.

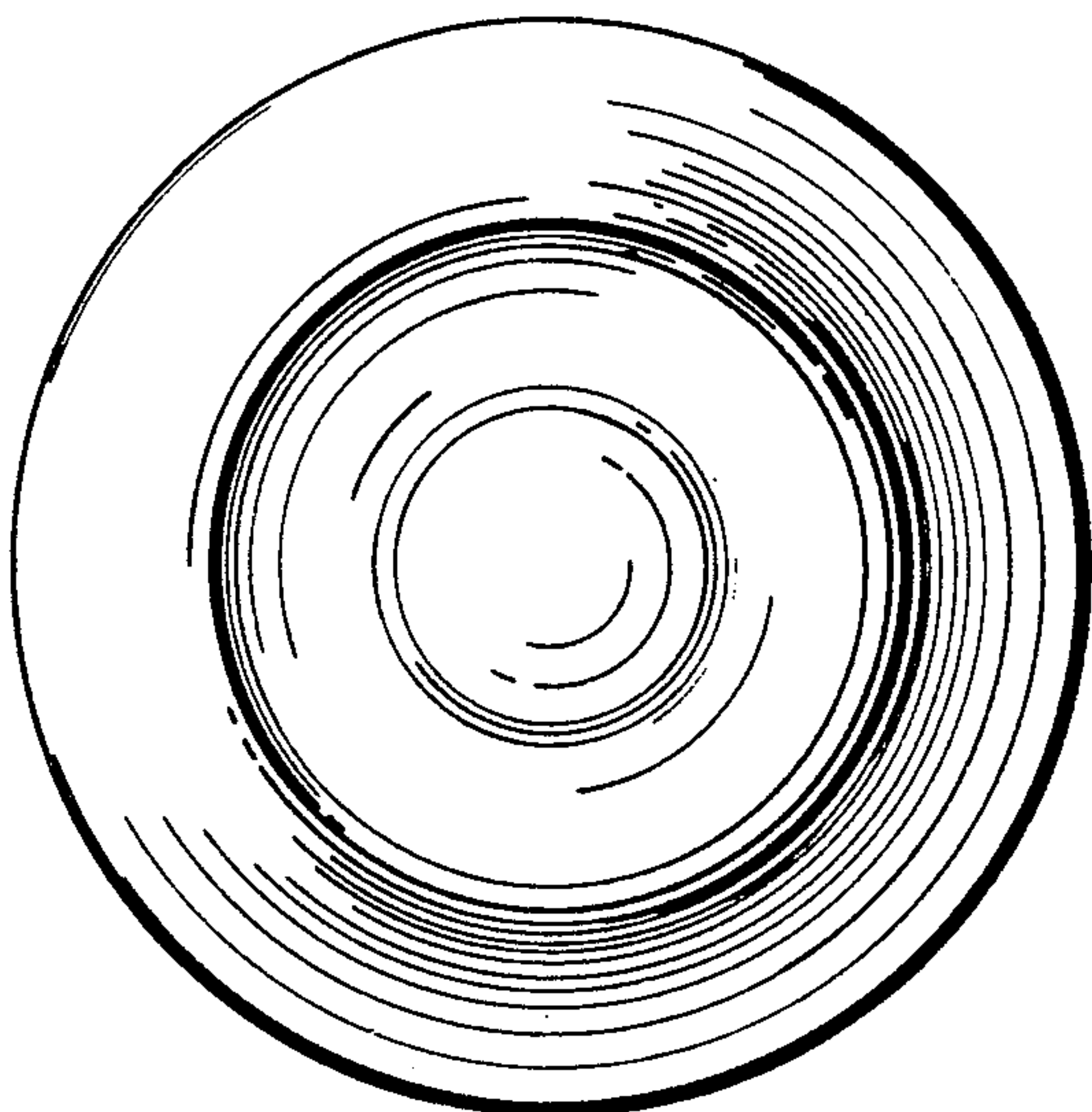

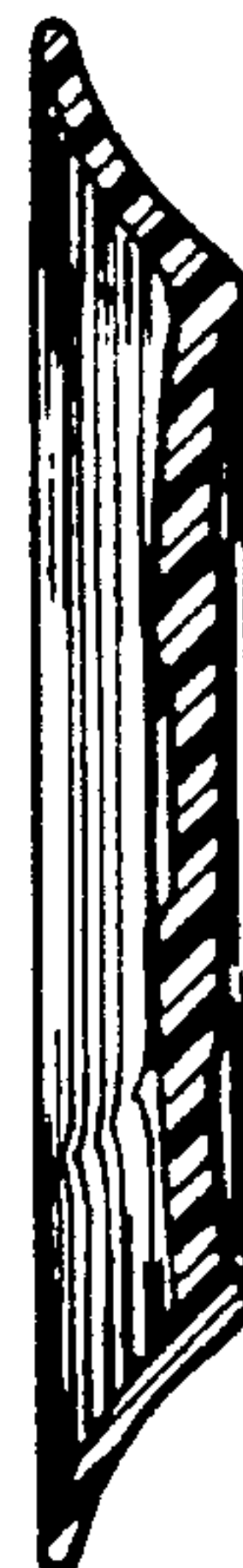

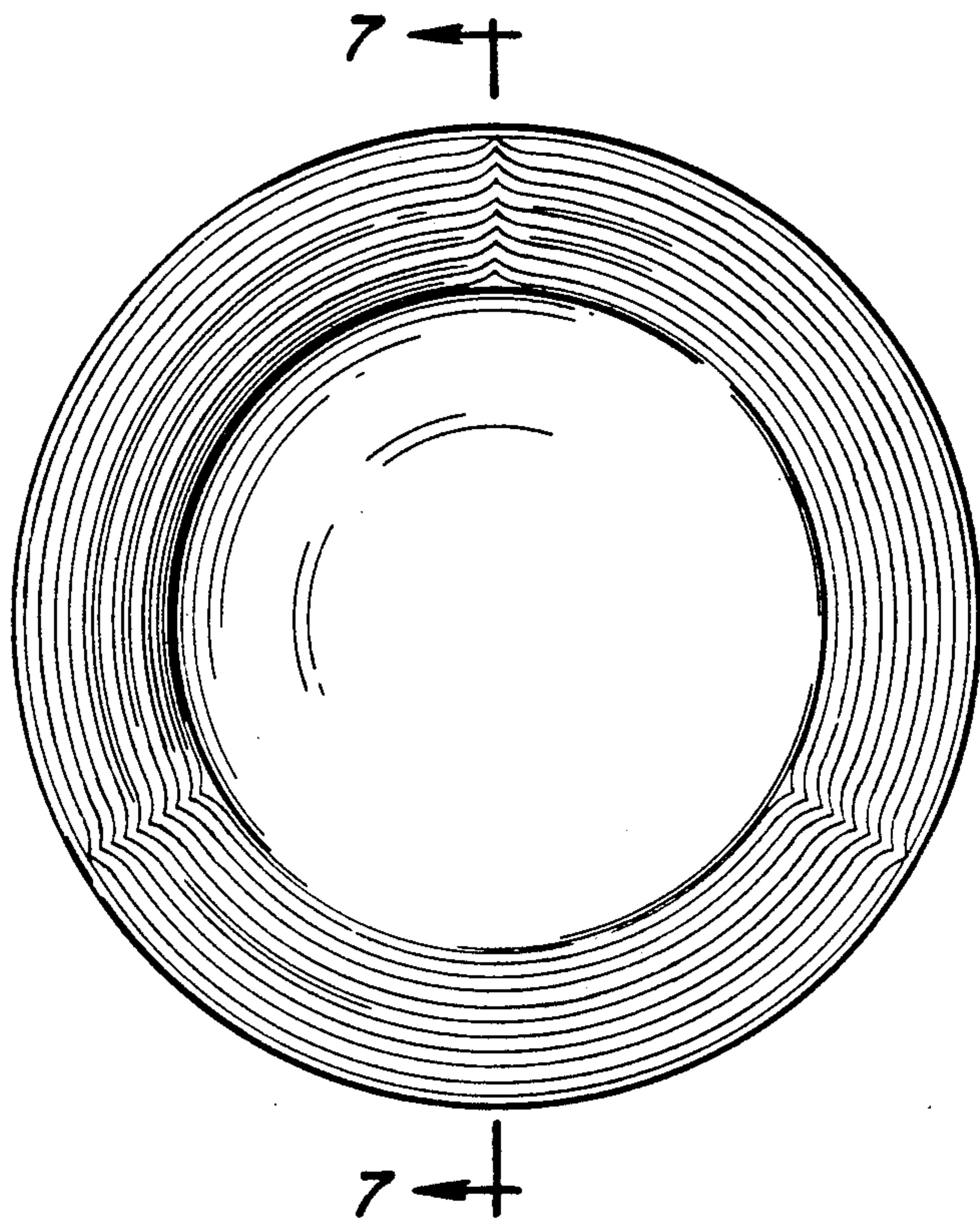

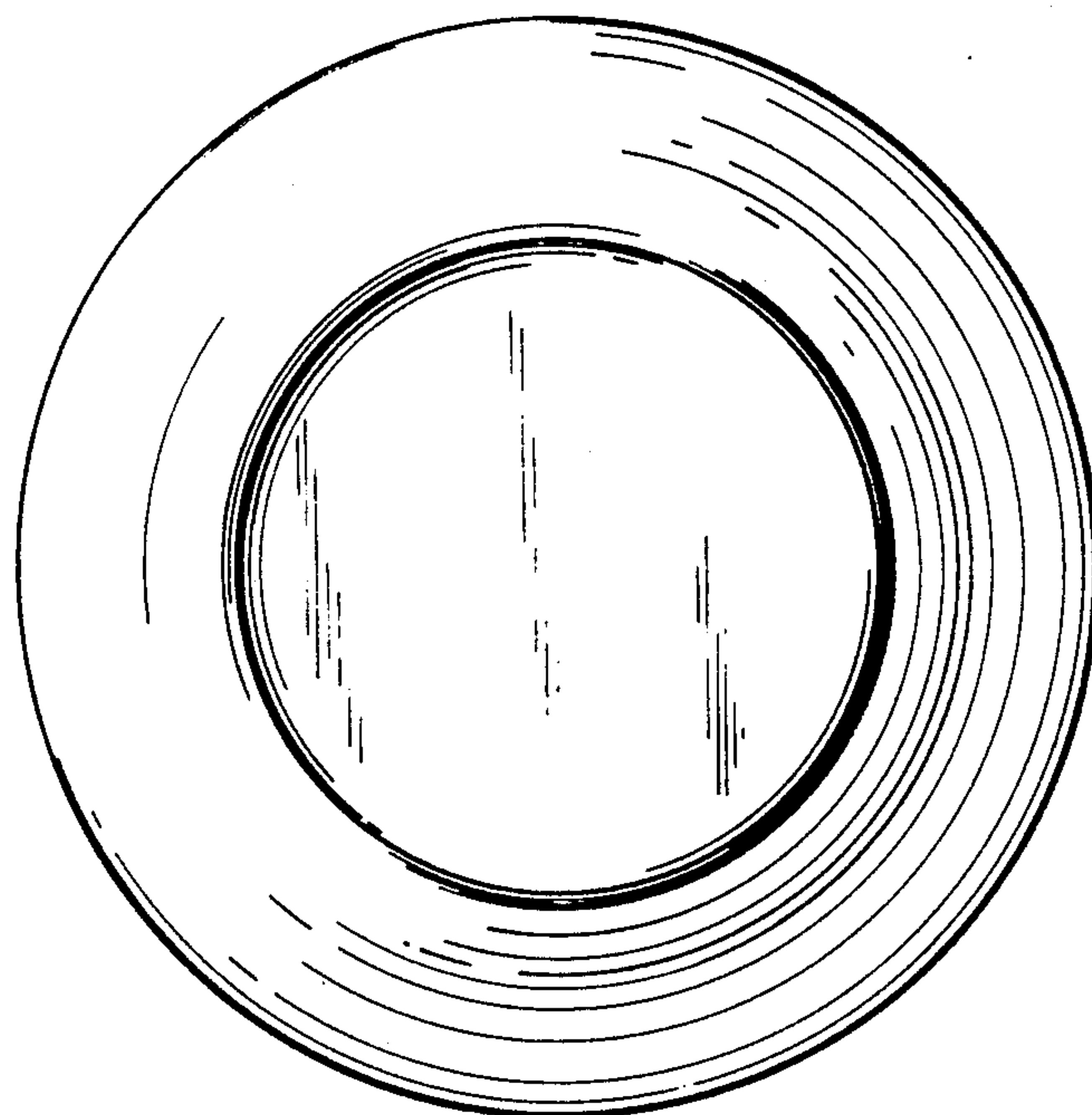
