[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined holder for writing instruments and a note pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left front perspective view of a combined holder for writing instruments and a note pad showing our new design, the writing instruments being depicted by means of broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

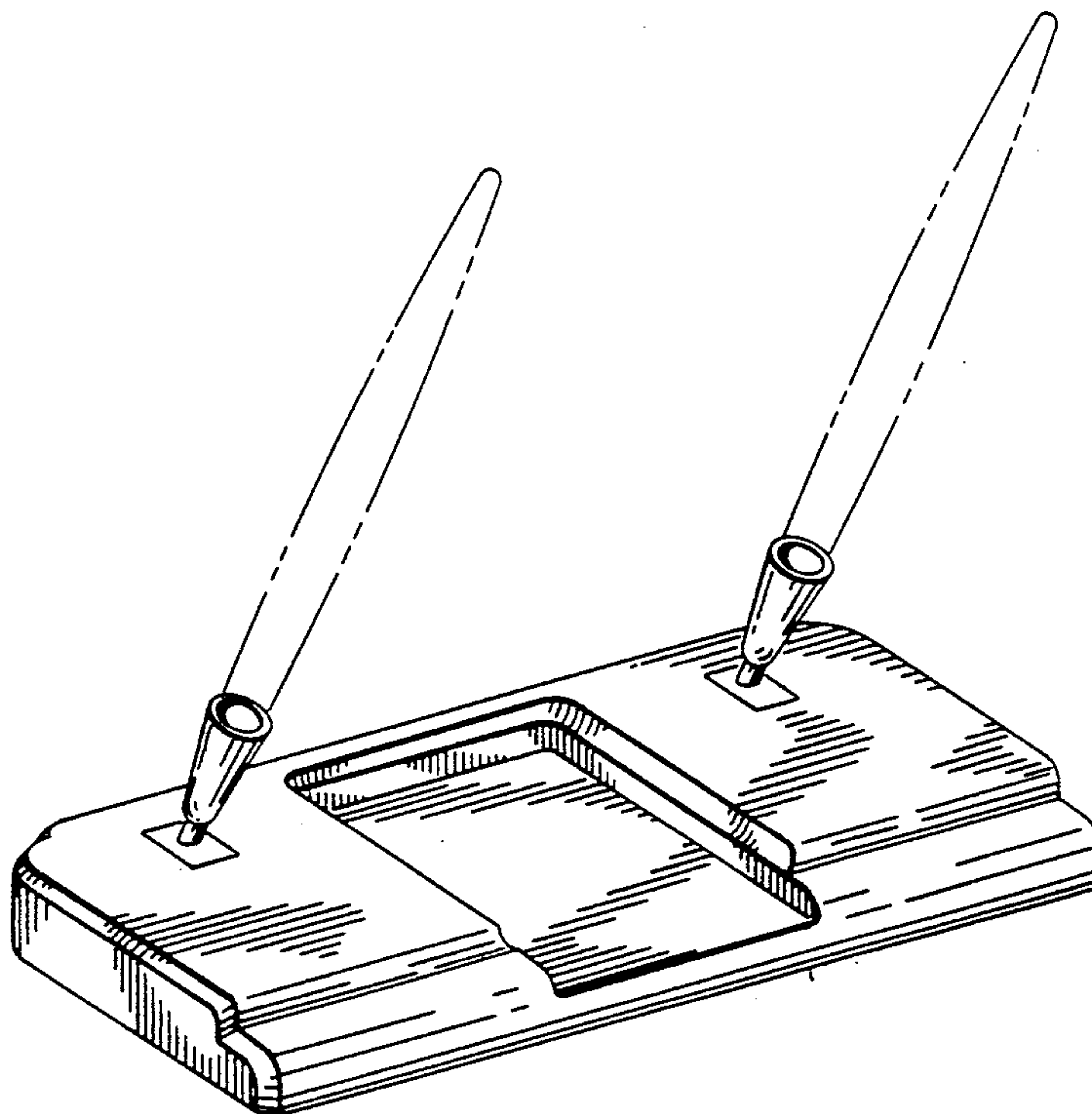
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The FIG. 1 view has been drawn to an enlarged scale with respect to FIGS. 2 through 6.



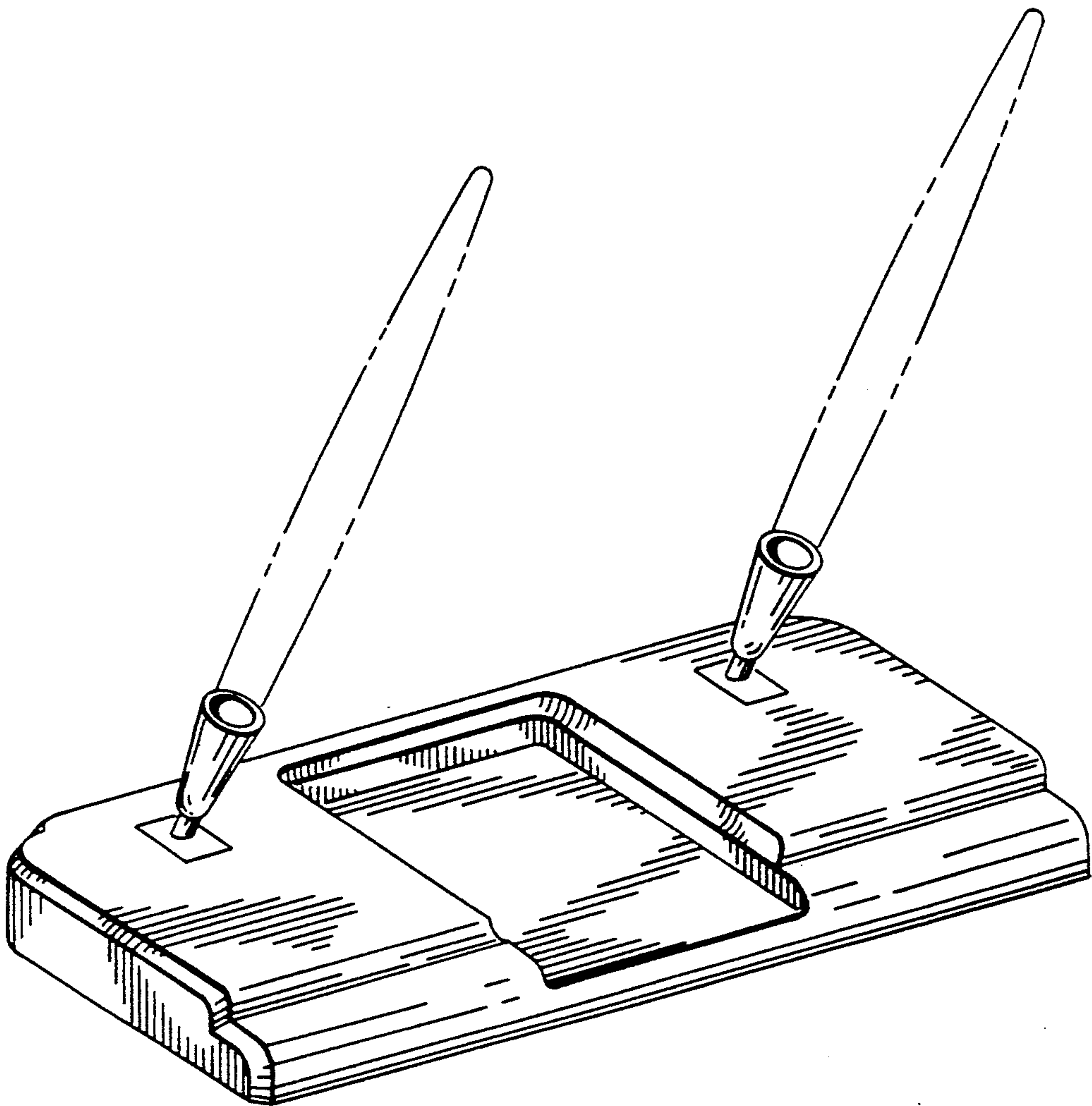

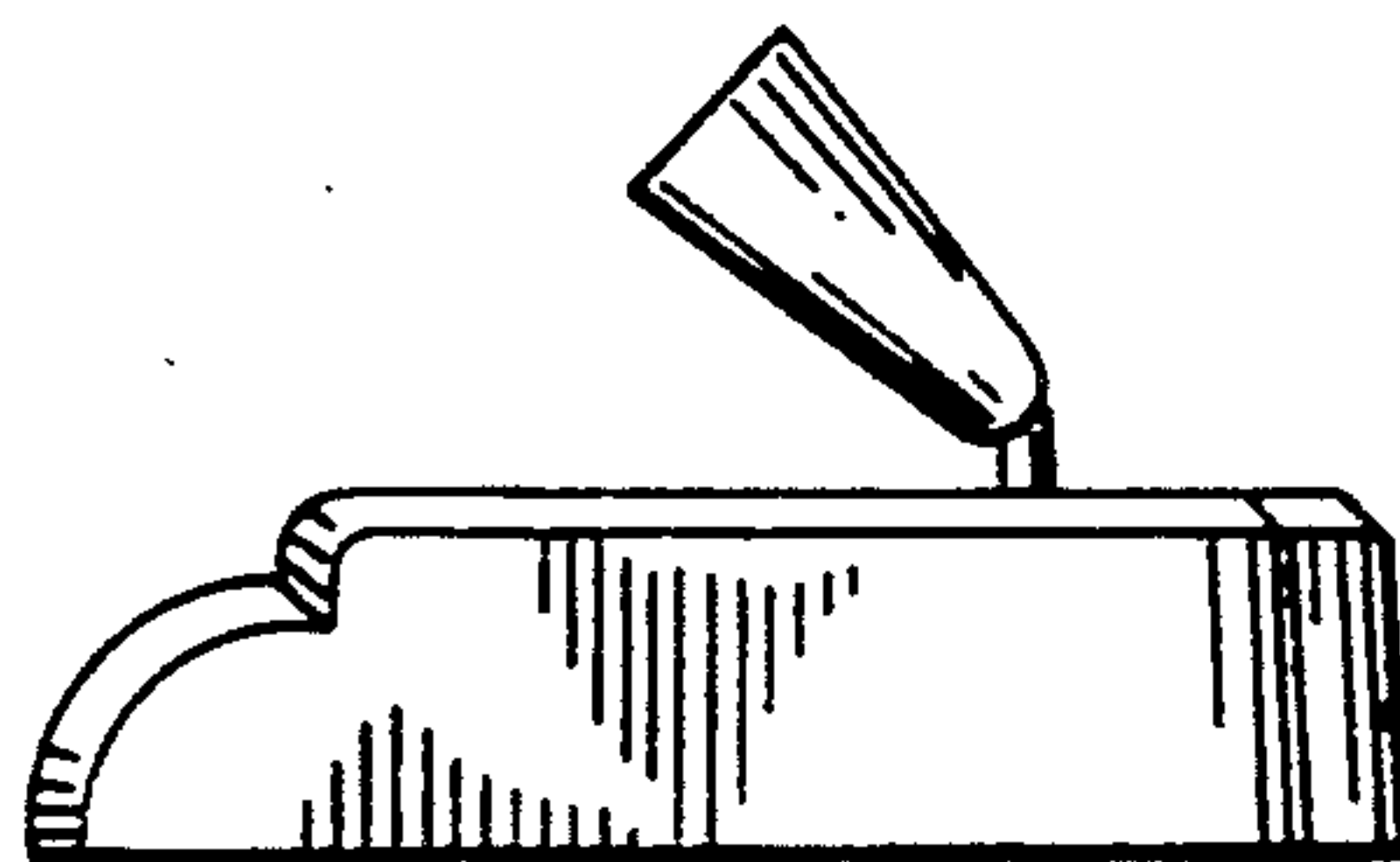

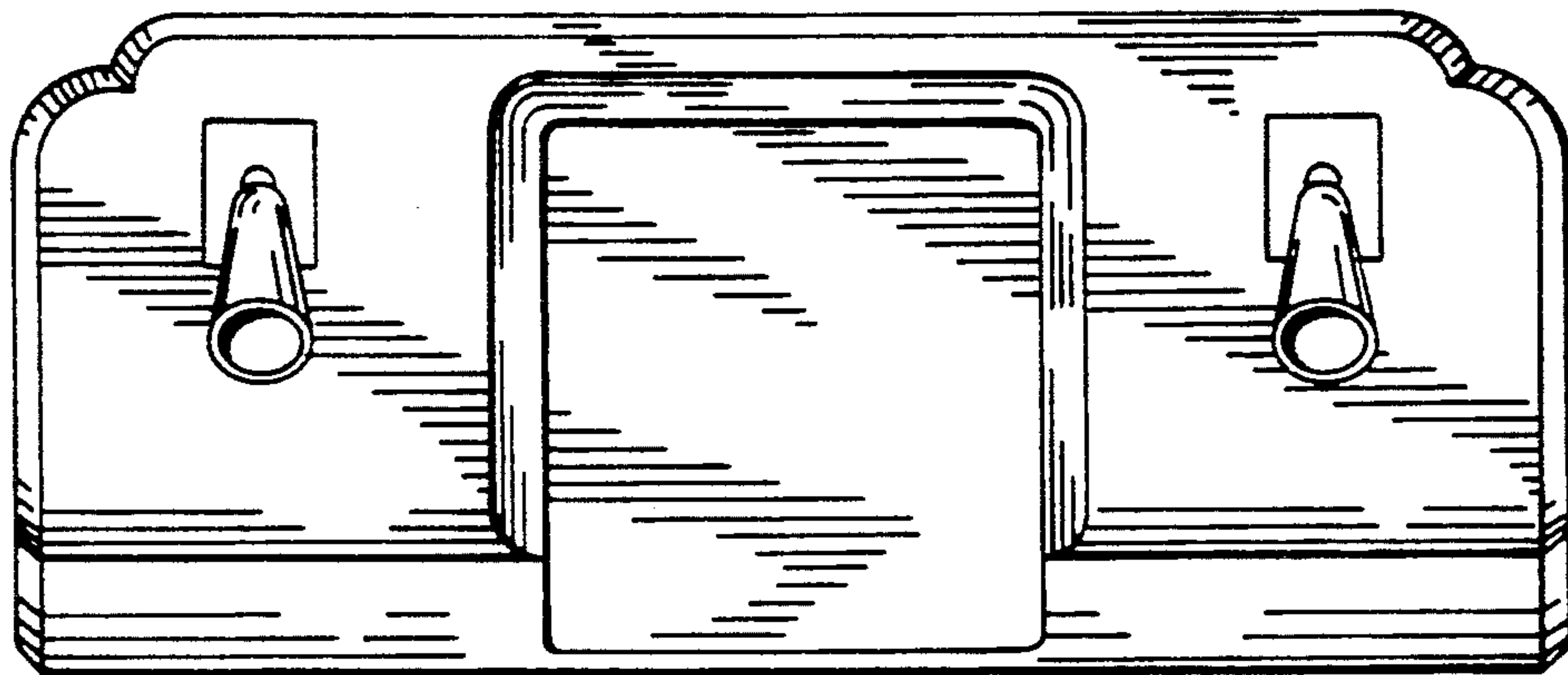

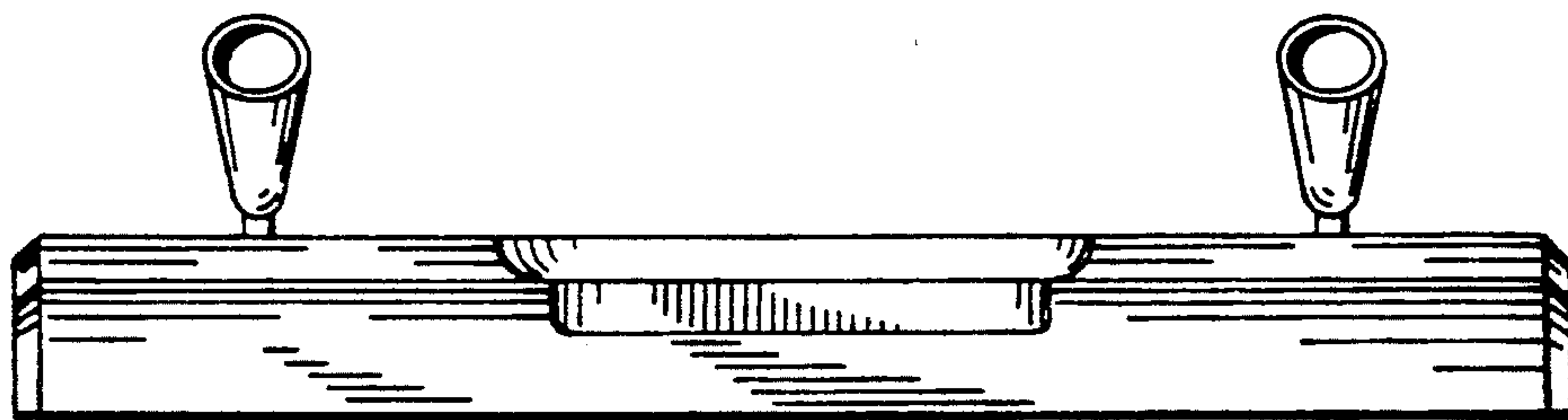

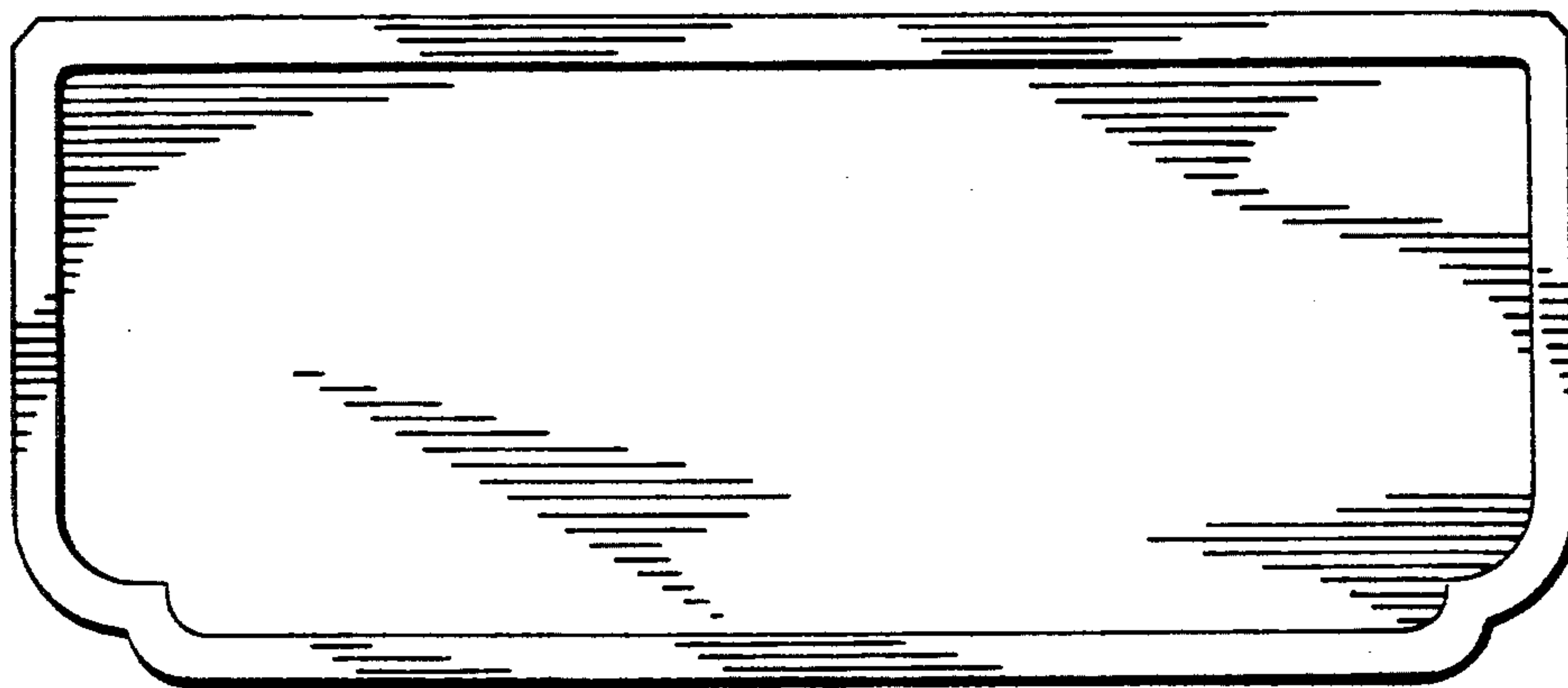

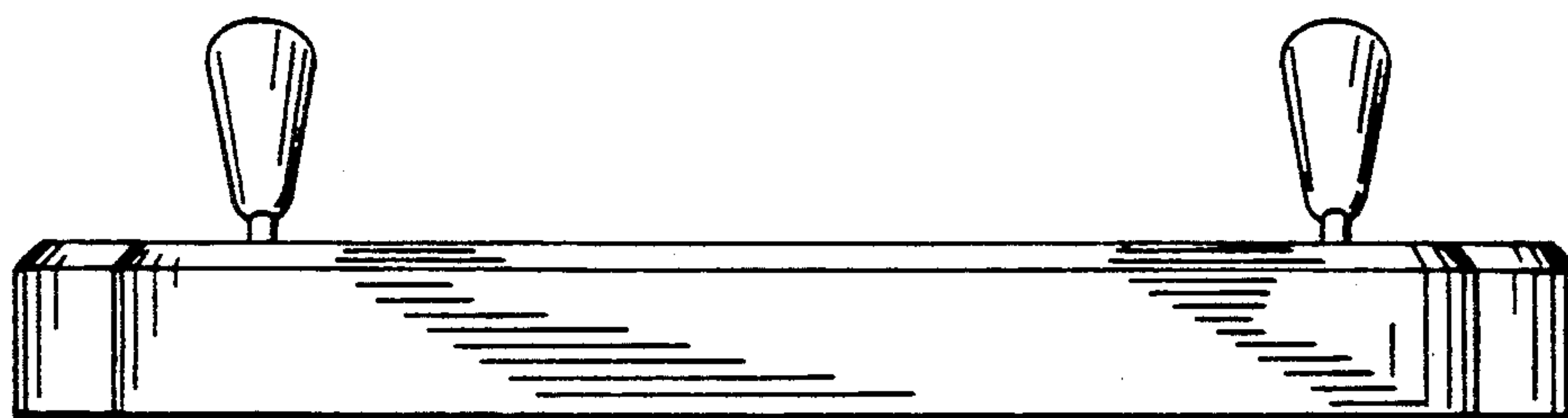
