FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2.

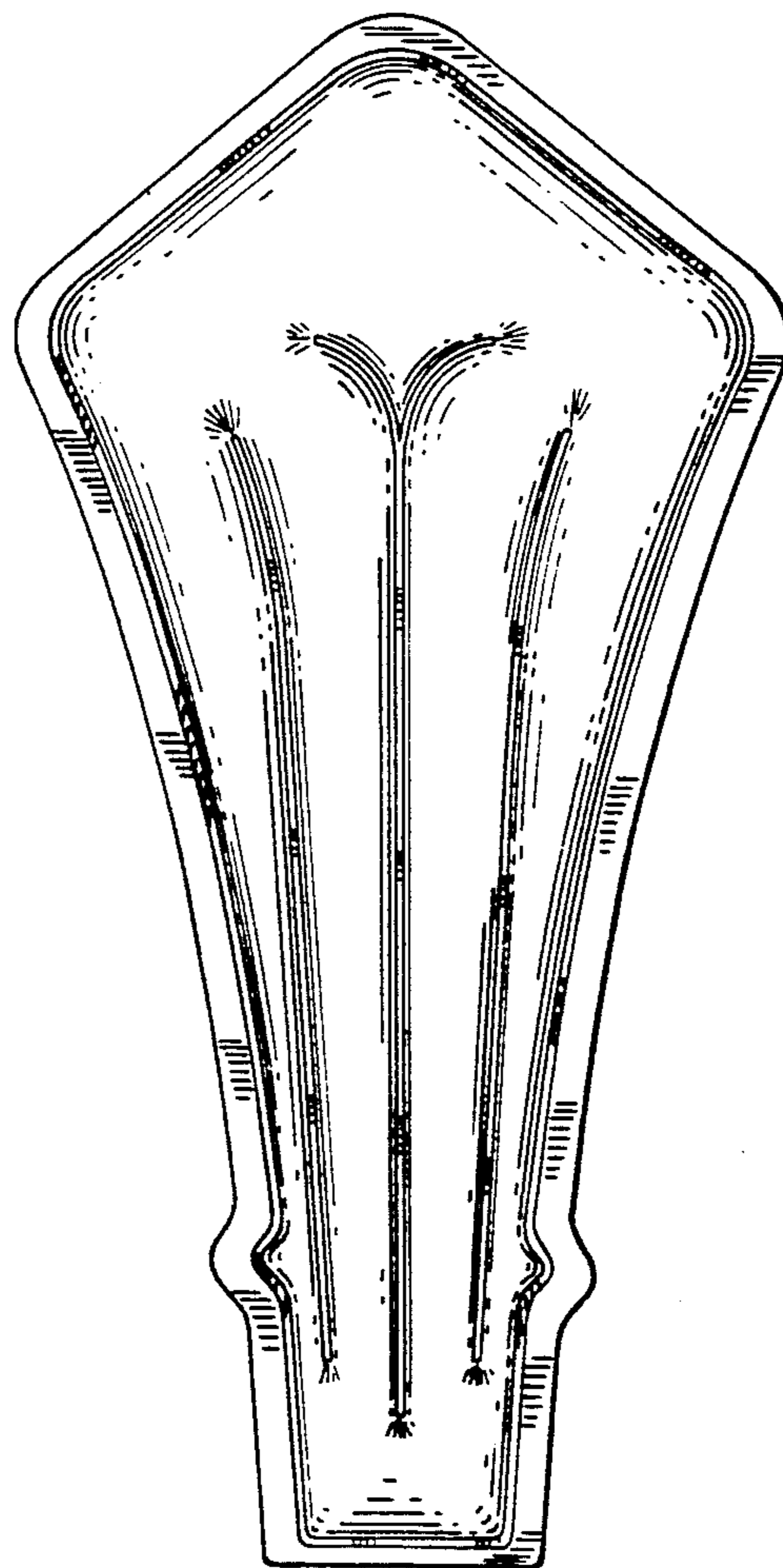
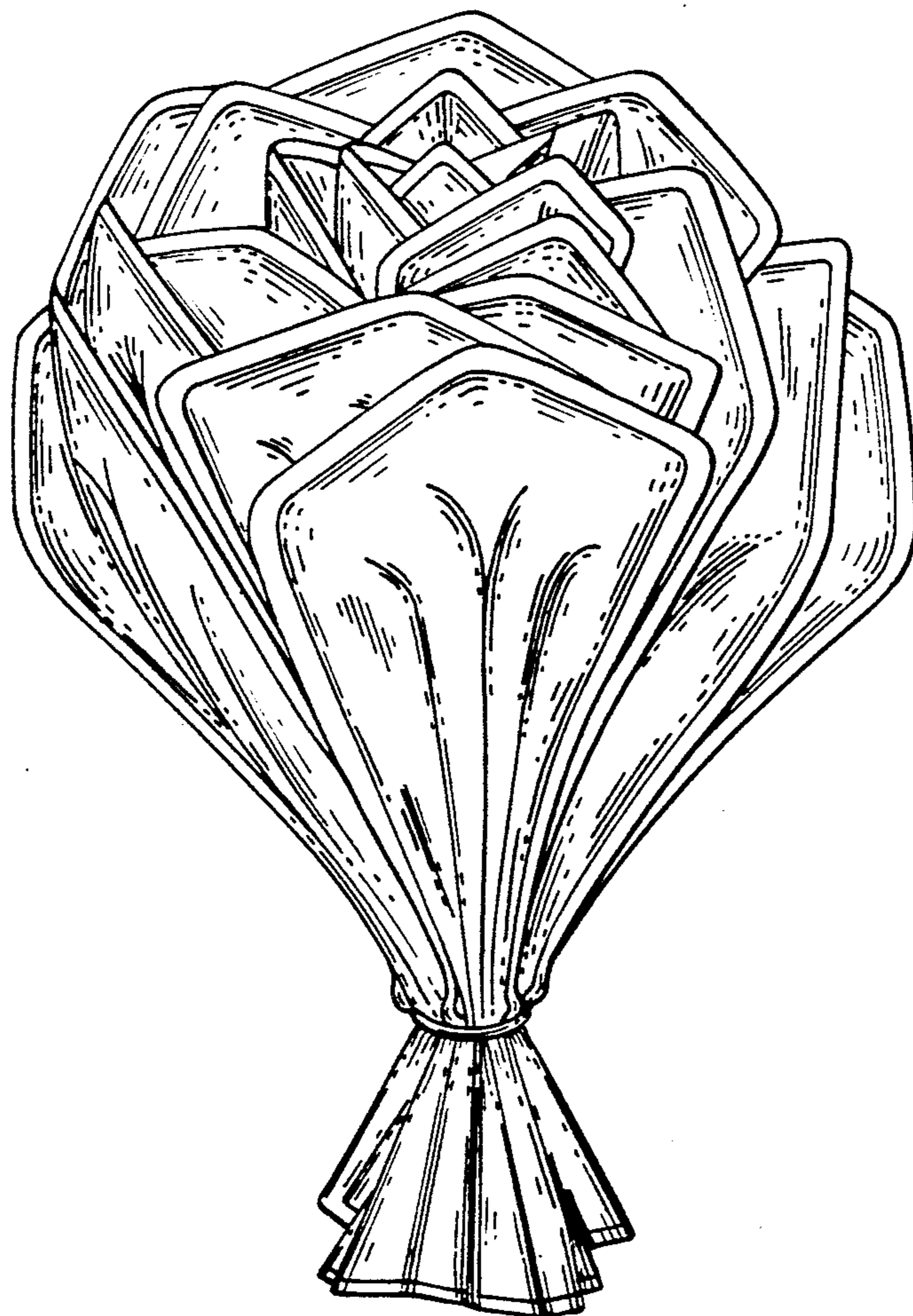

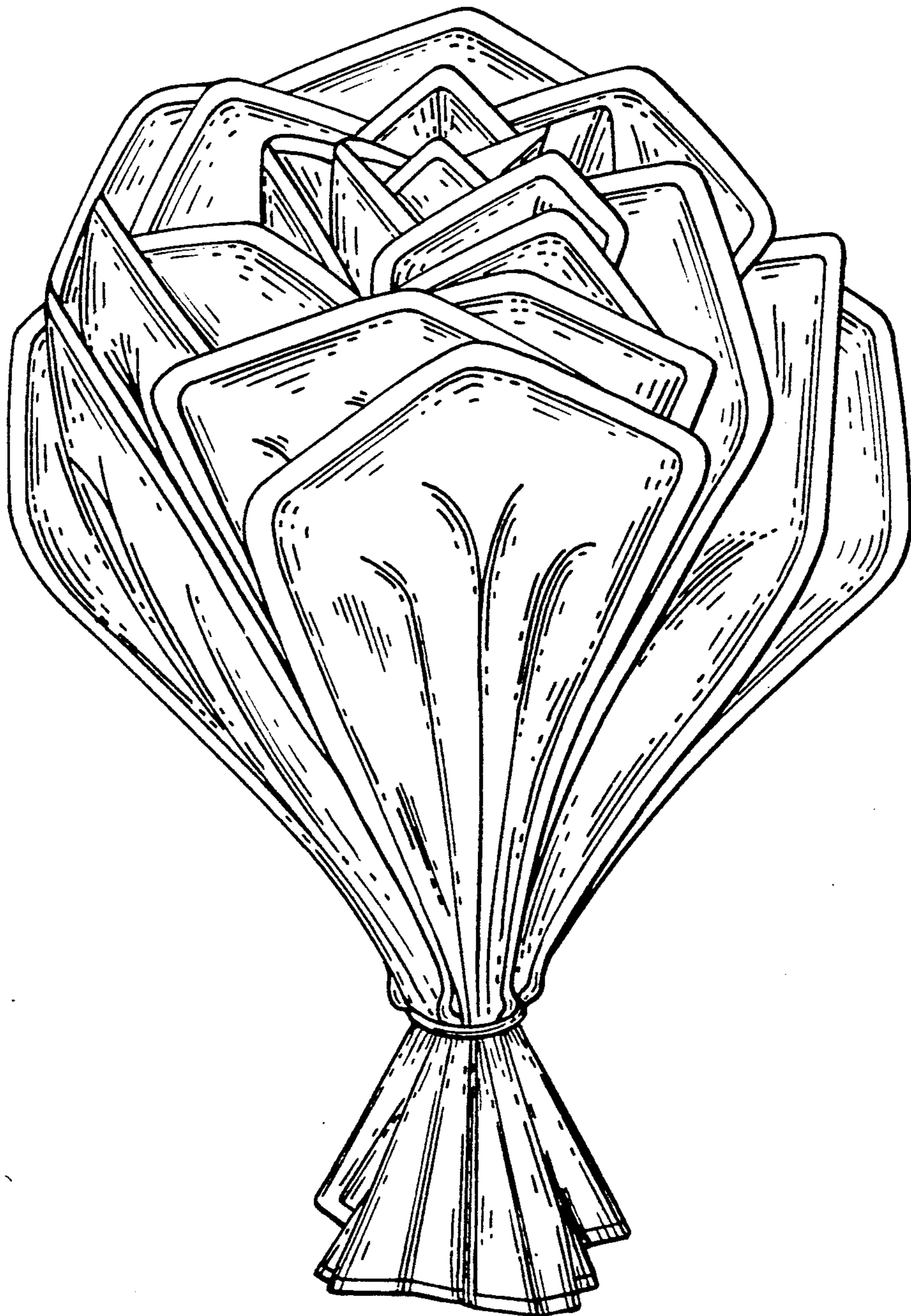

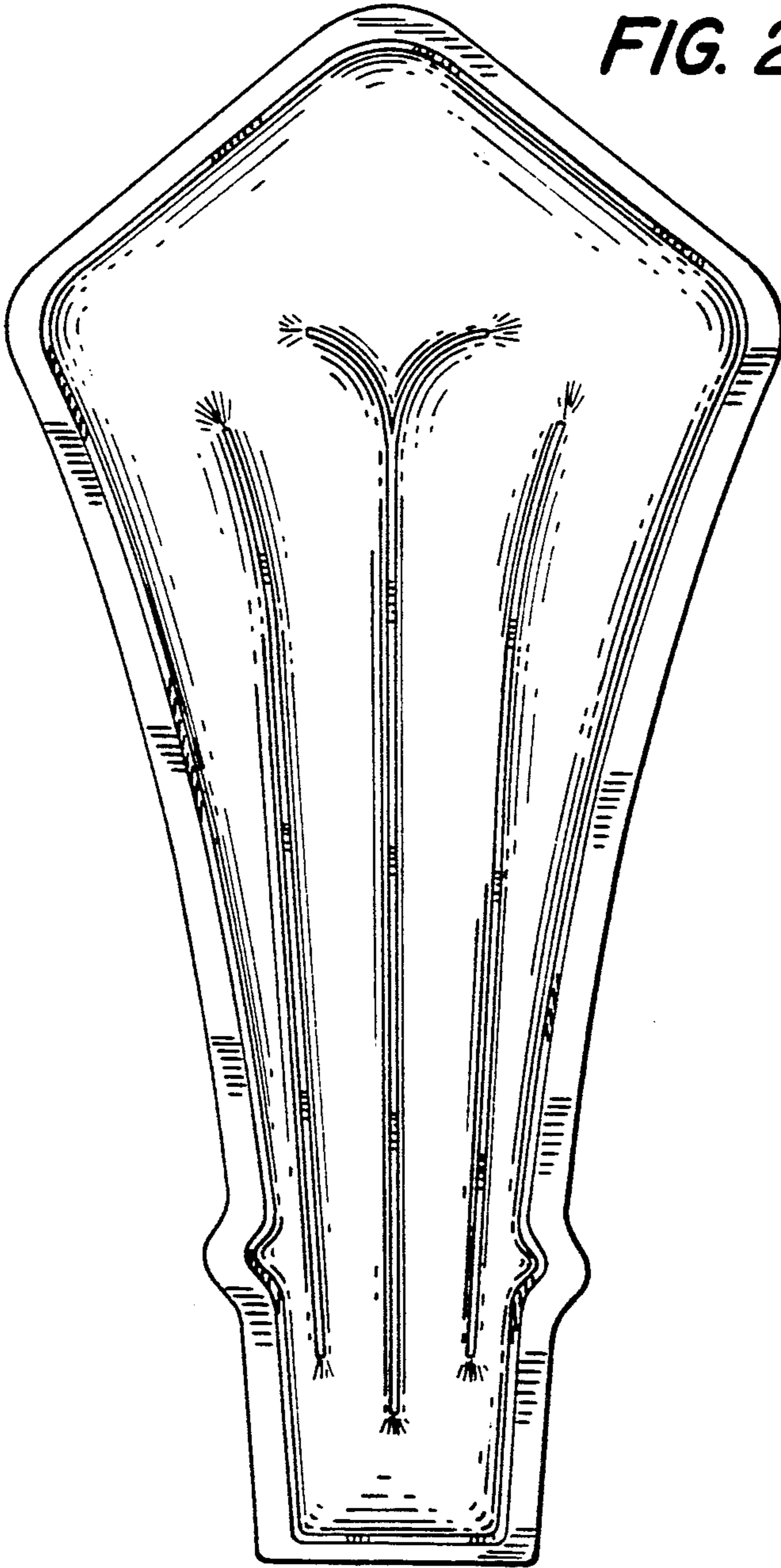

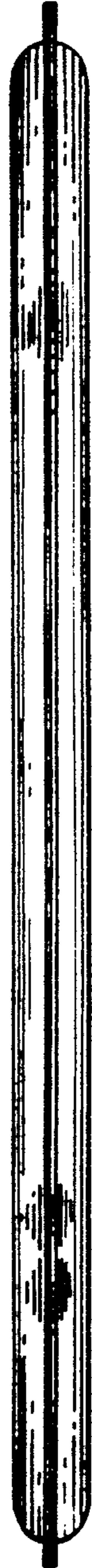
