single bicycle showing my new design;

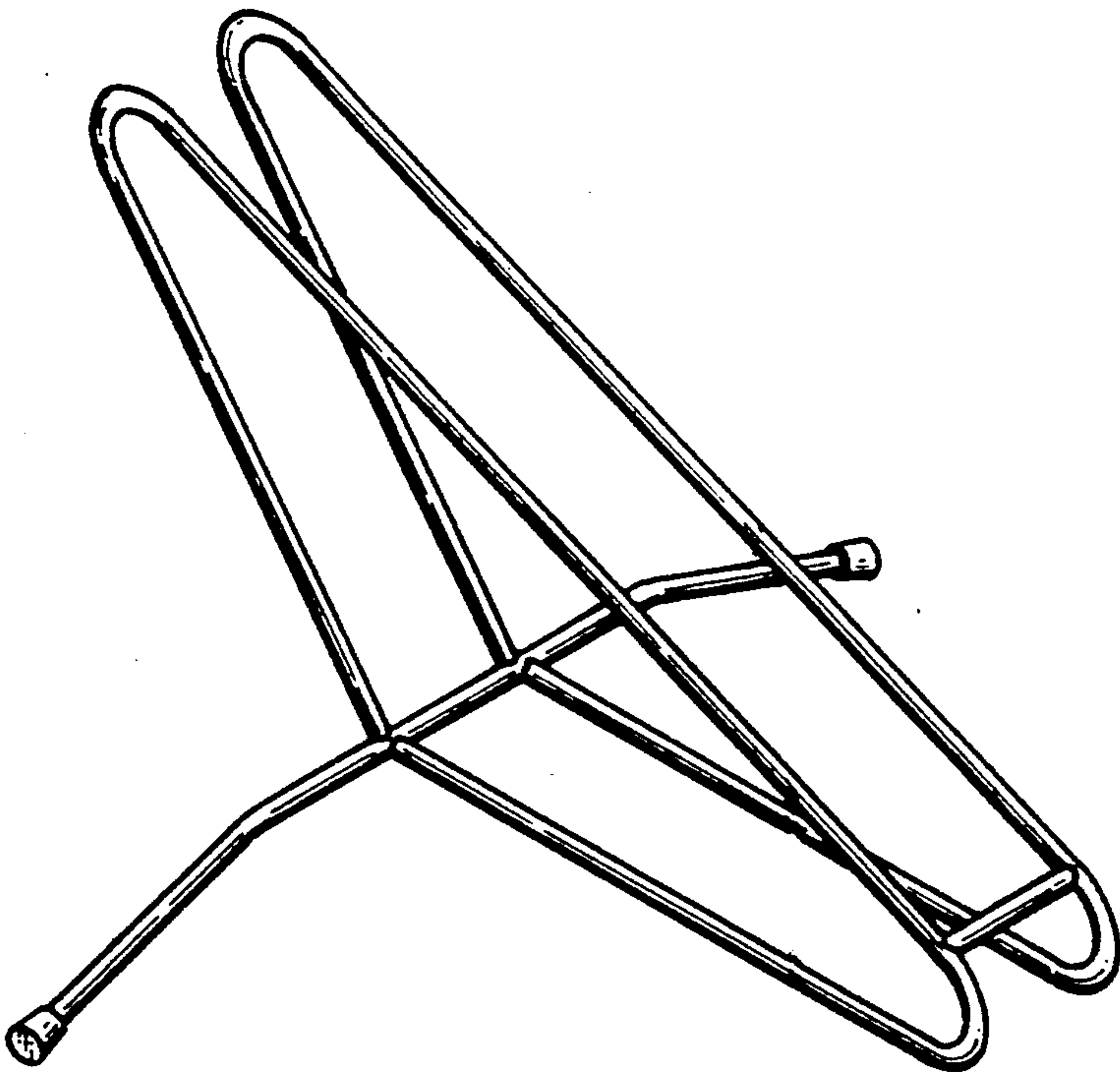
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



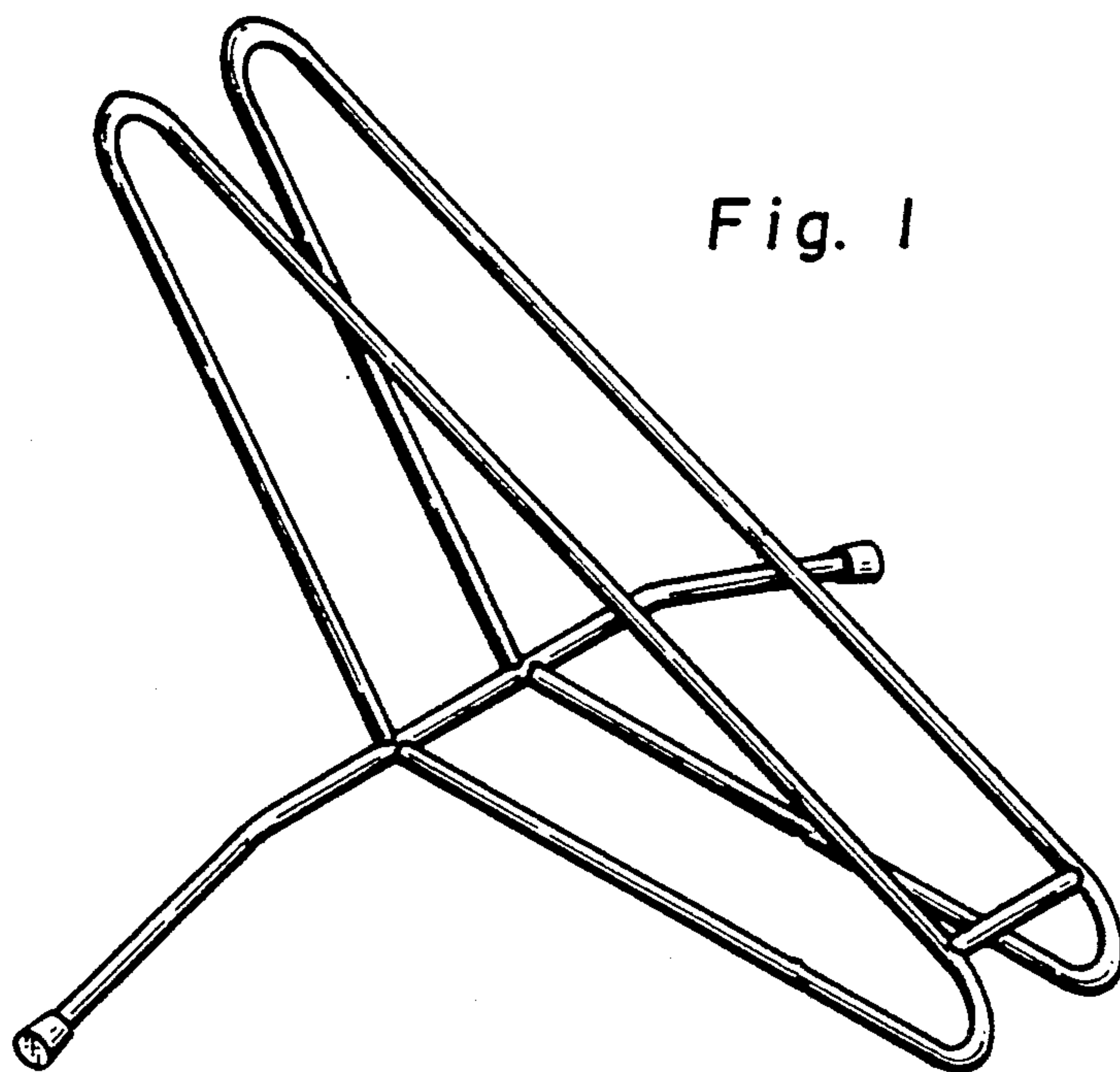

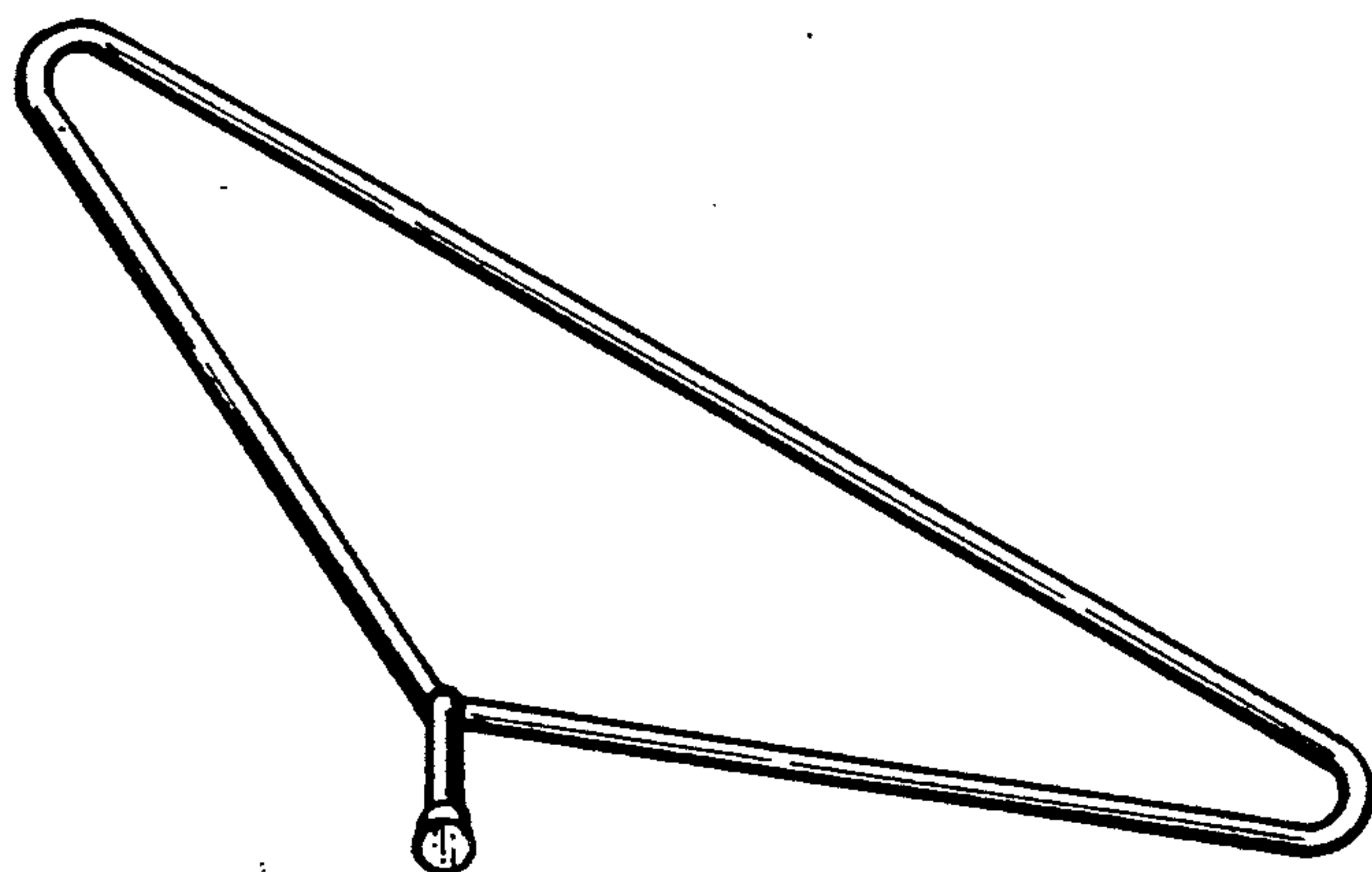

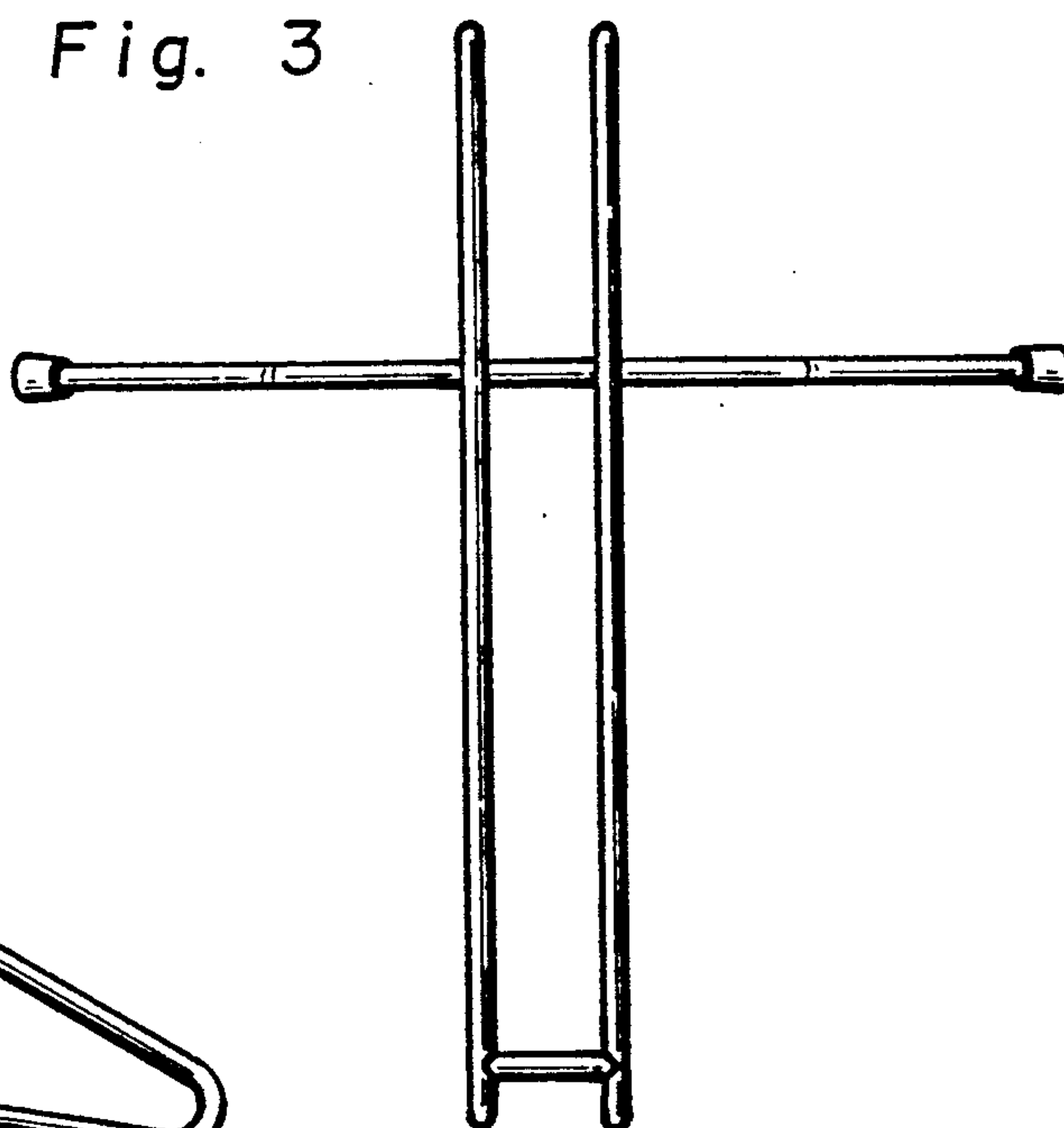

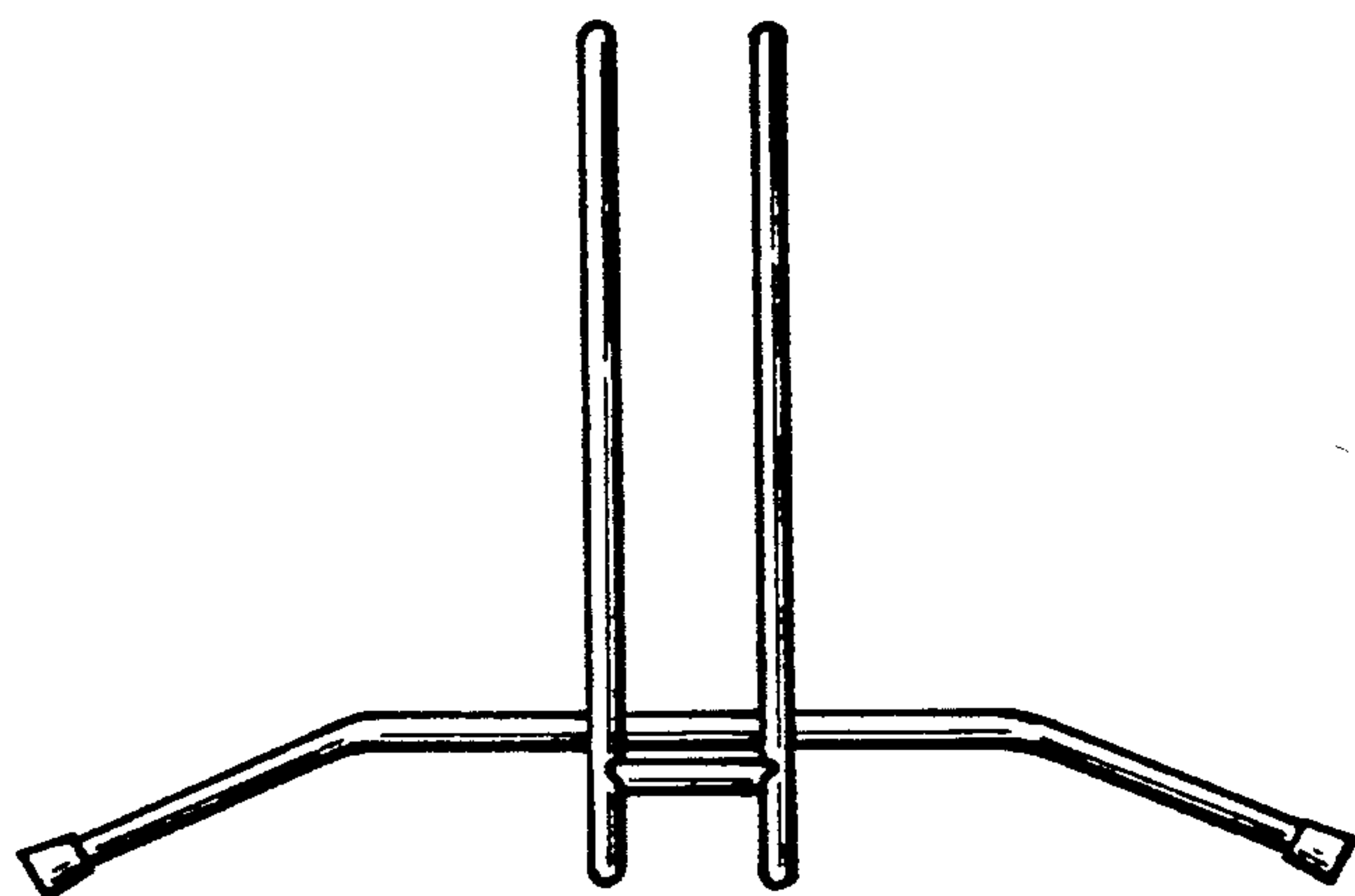

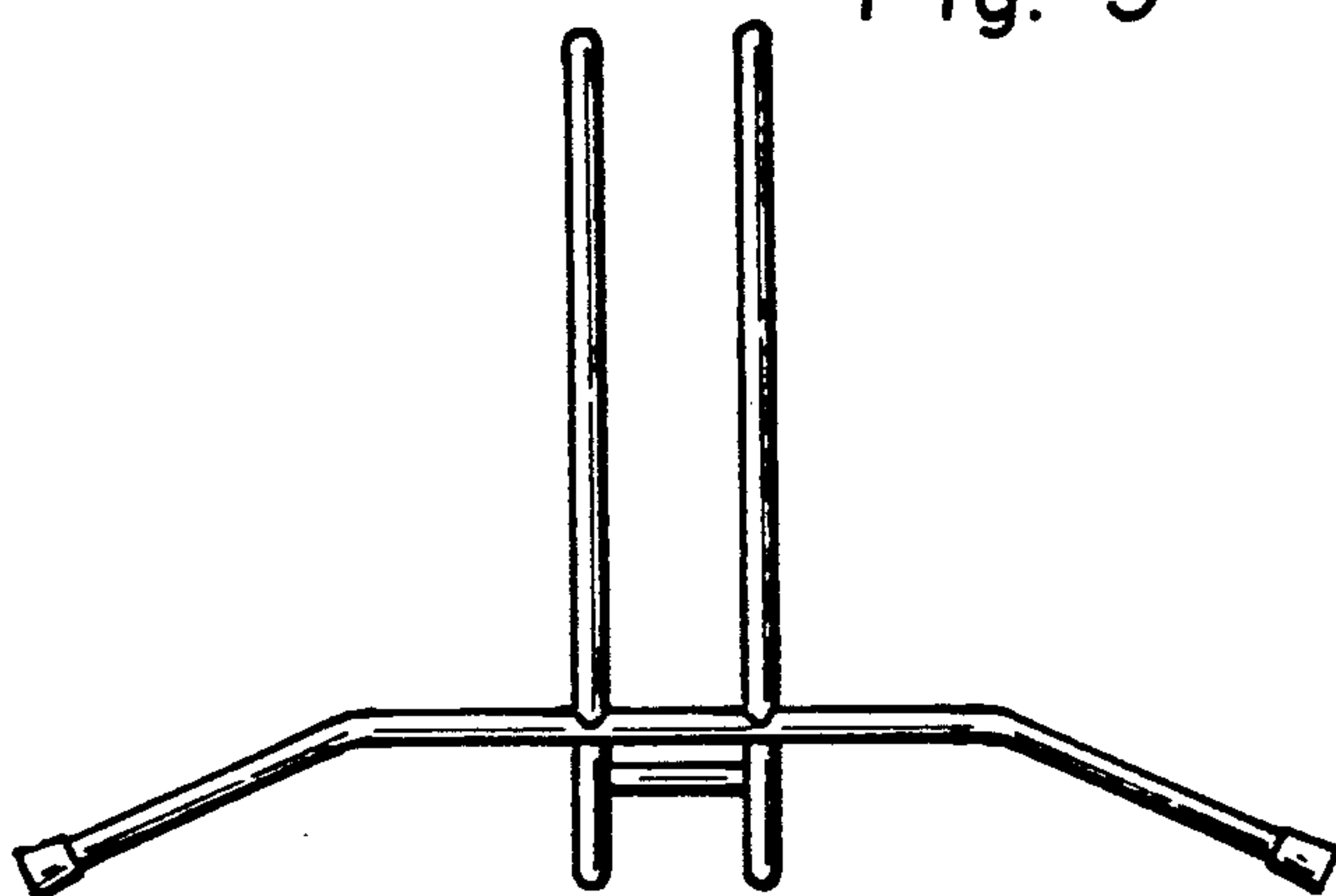
