[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a float for eyeglasses, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a float for eyeglasses showing my new design, the broken line showing of the spectacles is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being identical; and,

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being identical.

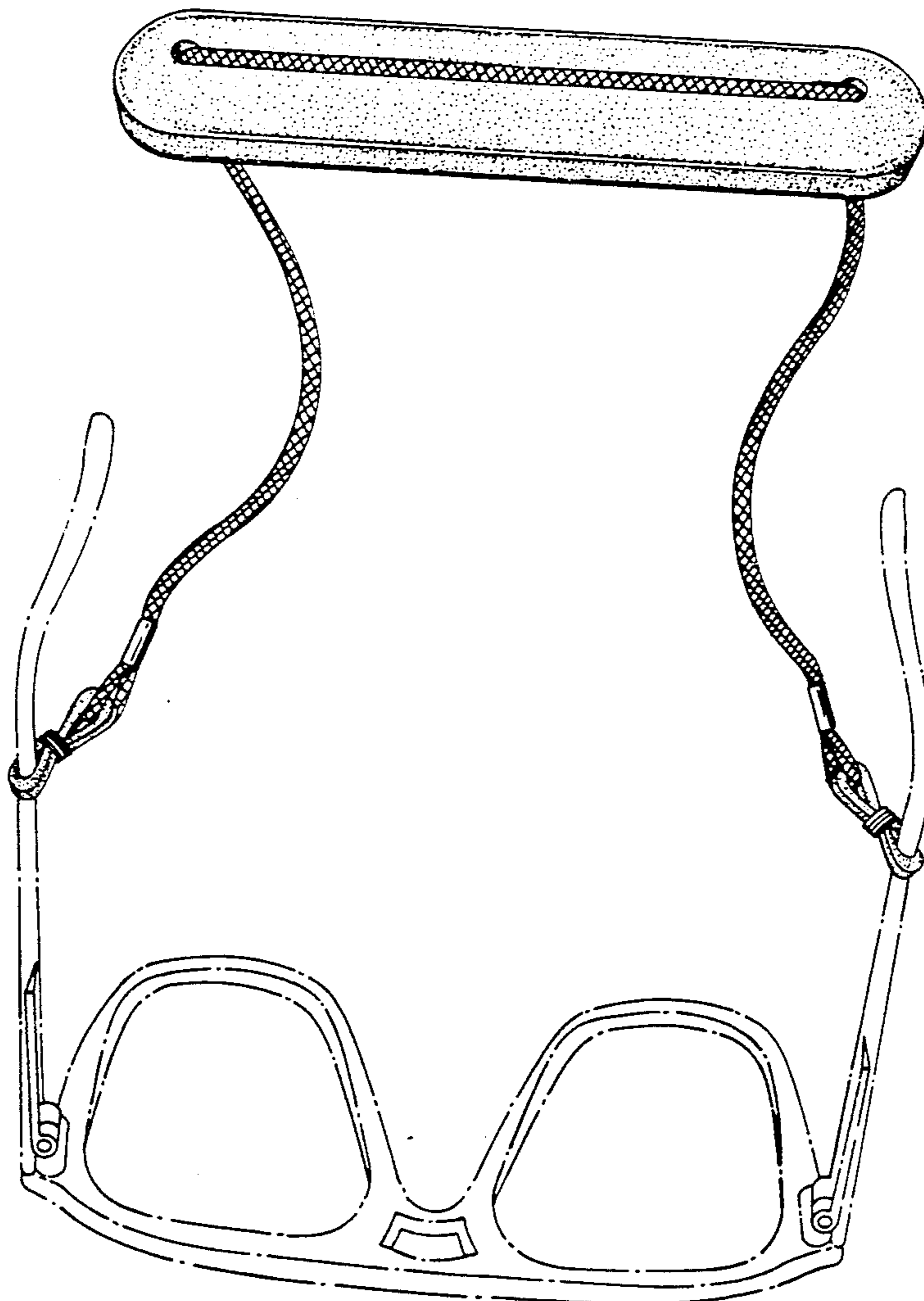

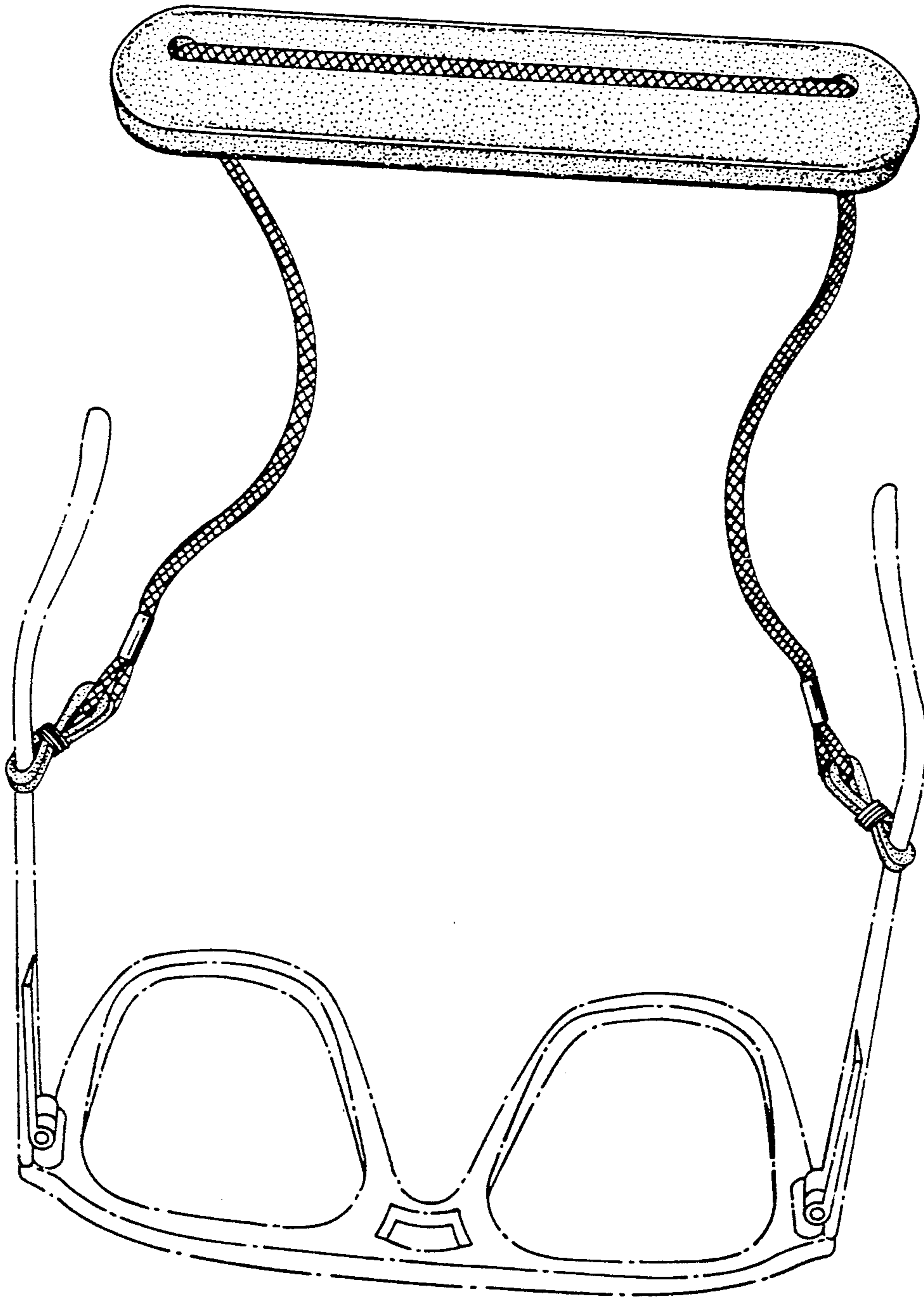

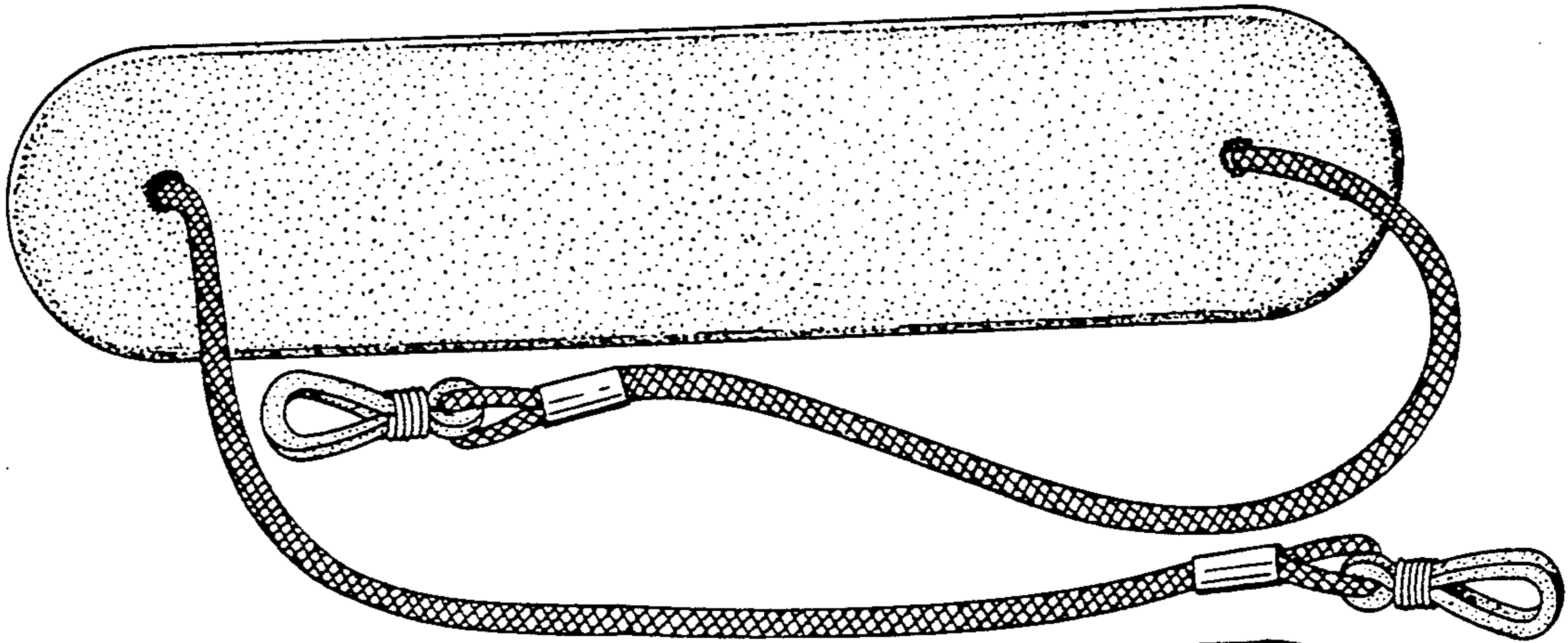

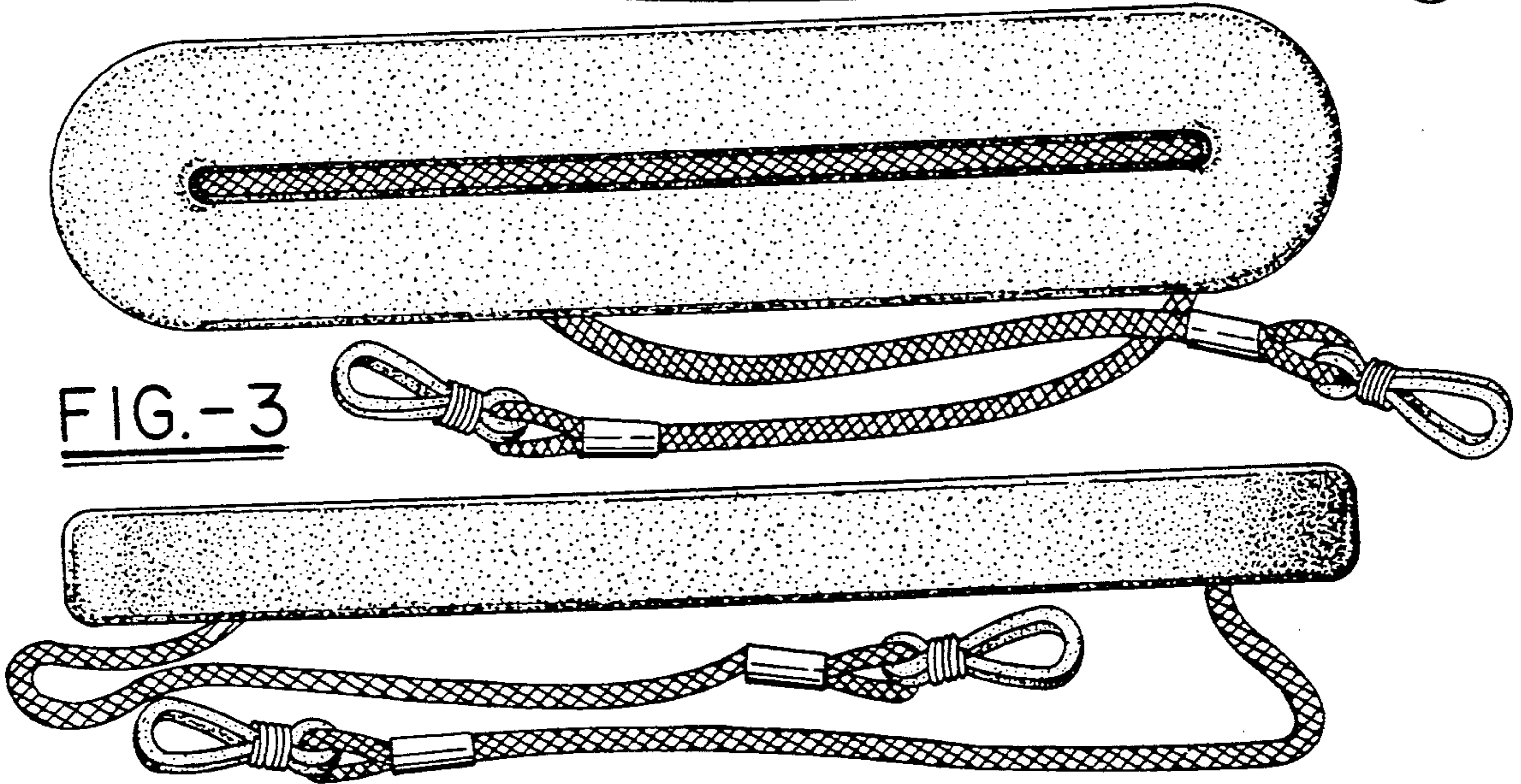

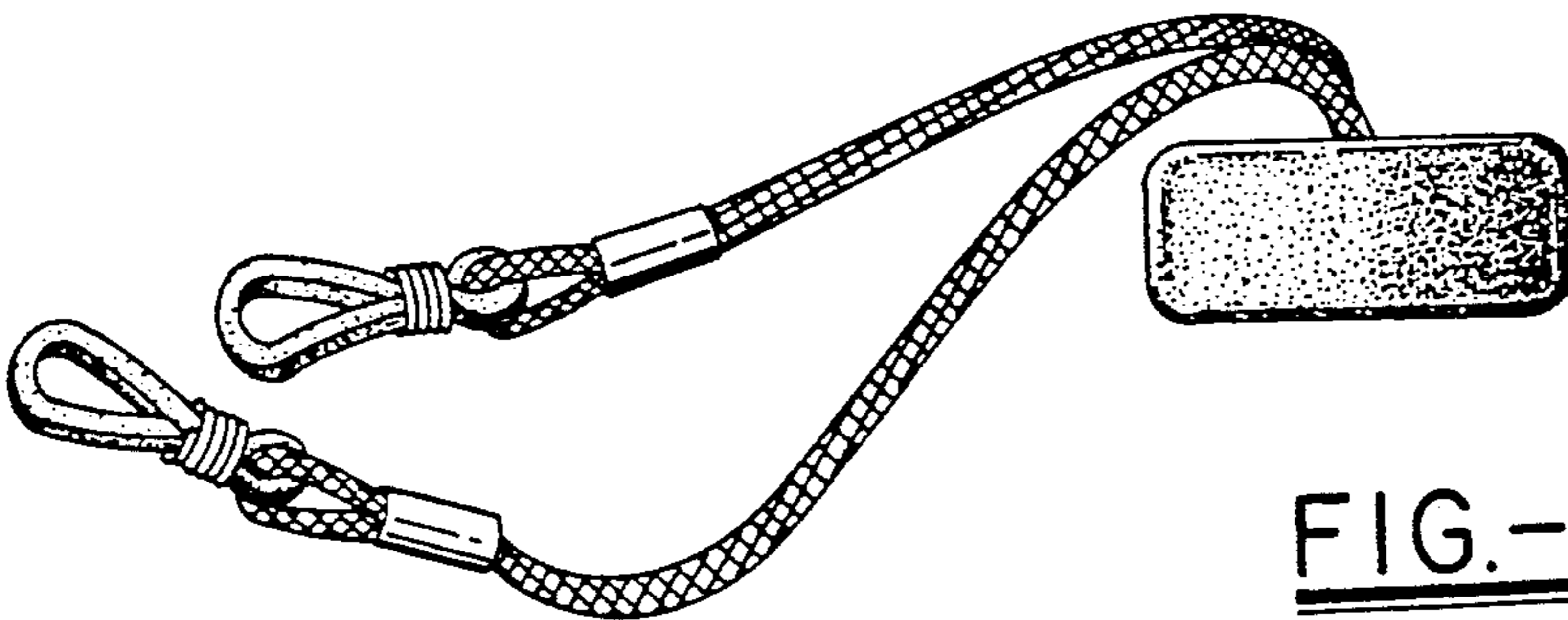
