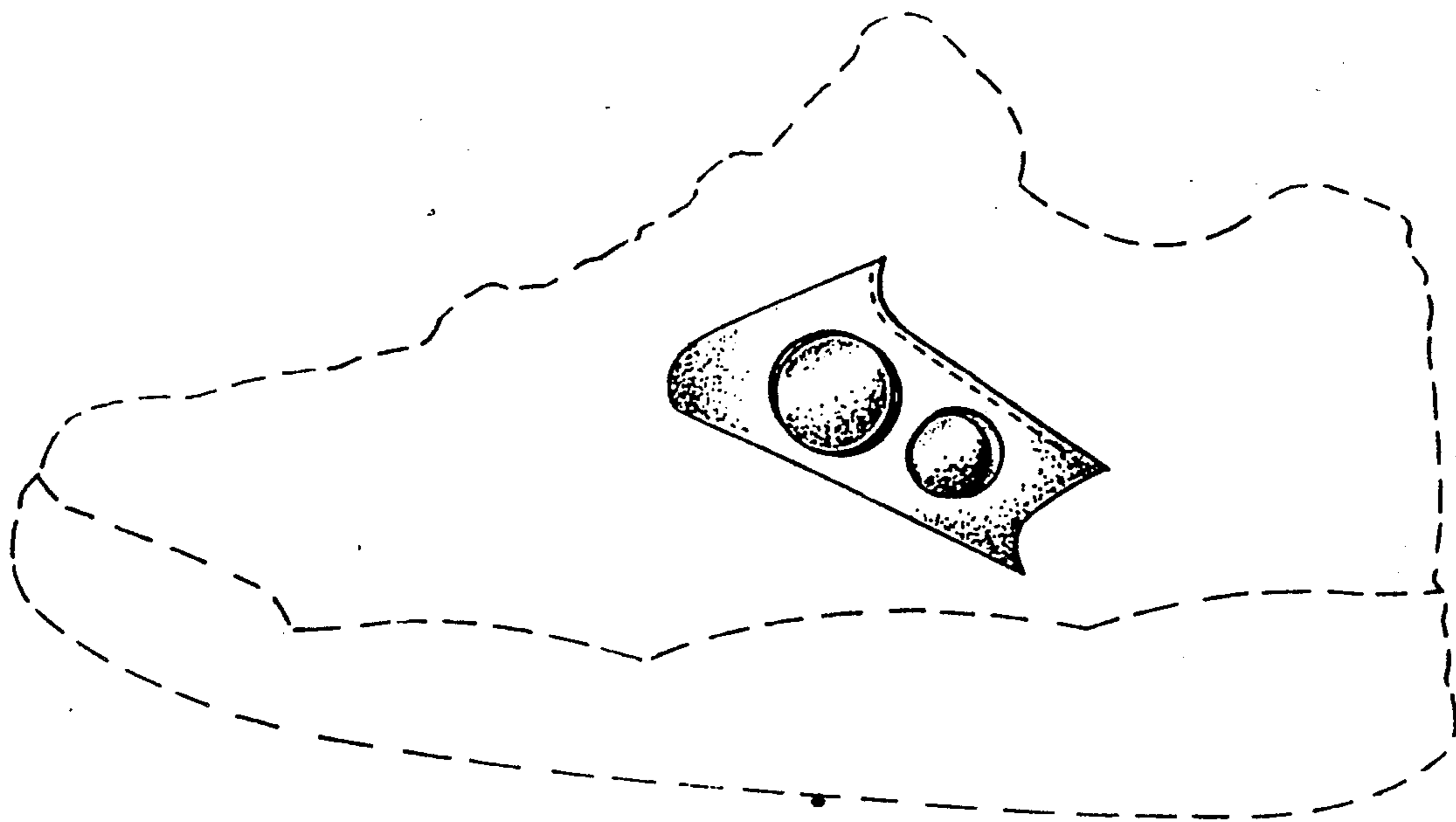

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for side element for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing a second embodiment of our new design; FIG. 3 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing a third embodiment of our new design; FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing a fourth embodiment of our new design; FIG. 5 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing a fifth embodiment of our new design; and, FIG. 6 is an elevational view of a side element for a shoe upper showing a sixth embodiment of our new design. The broken line showing of a shoe upper in the Figures is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design therefor.



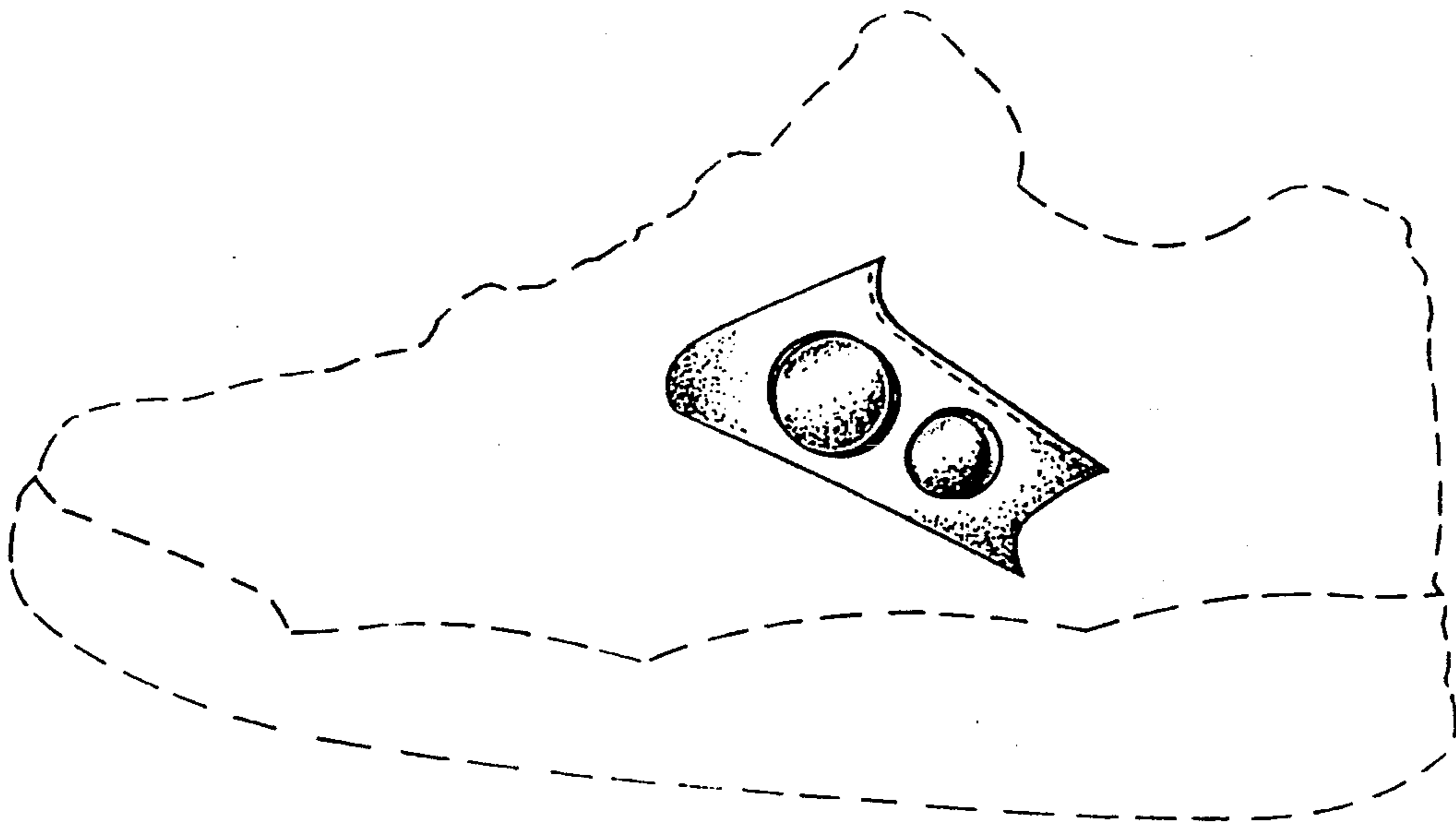

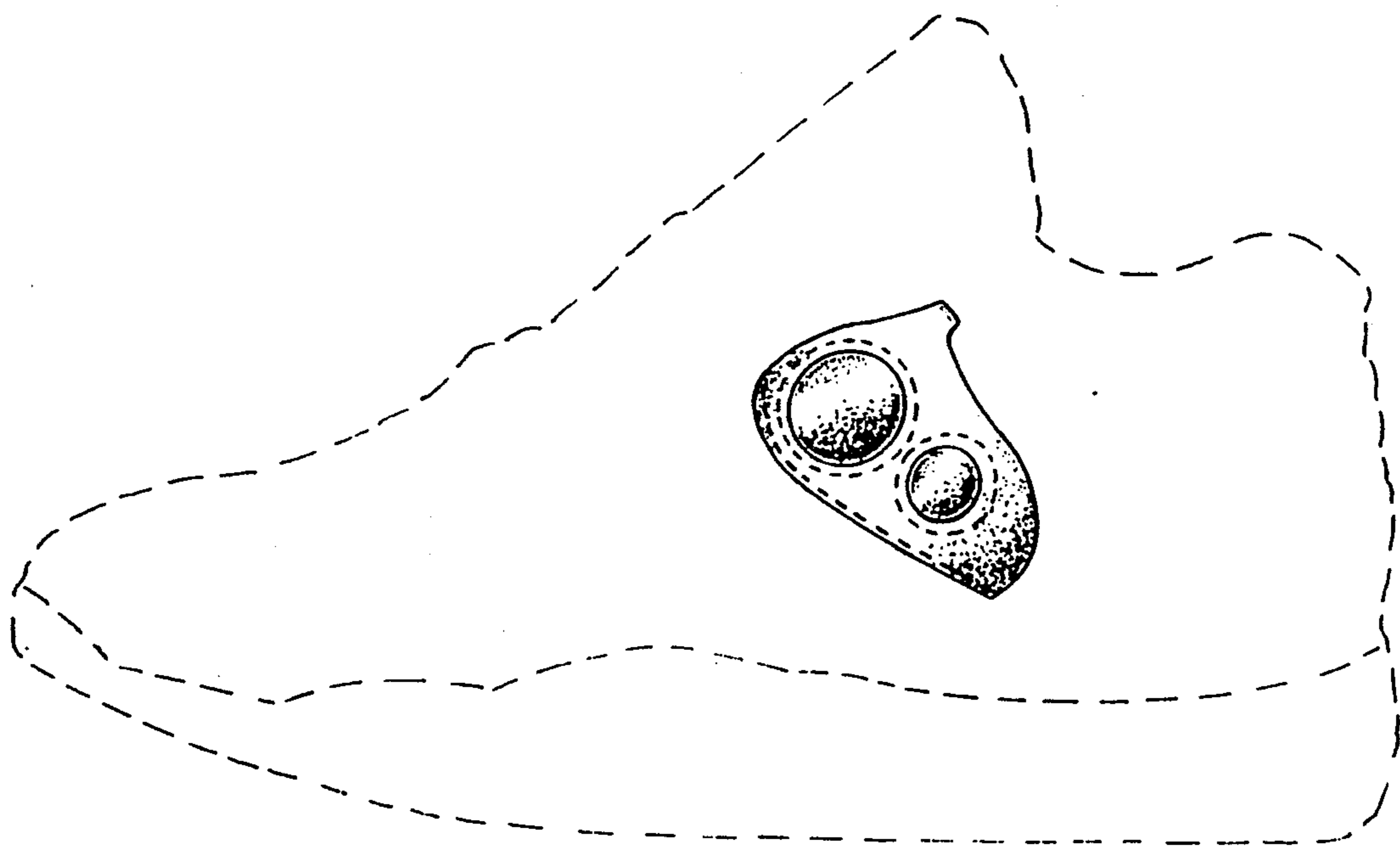

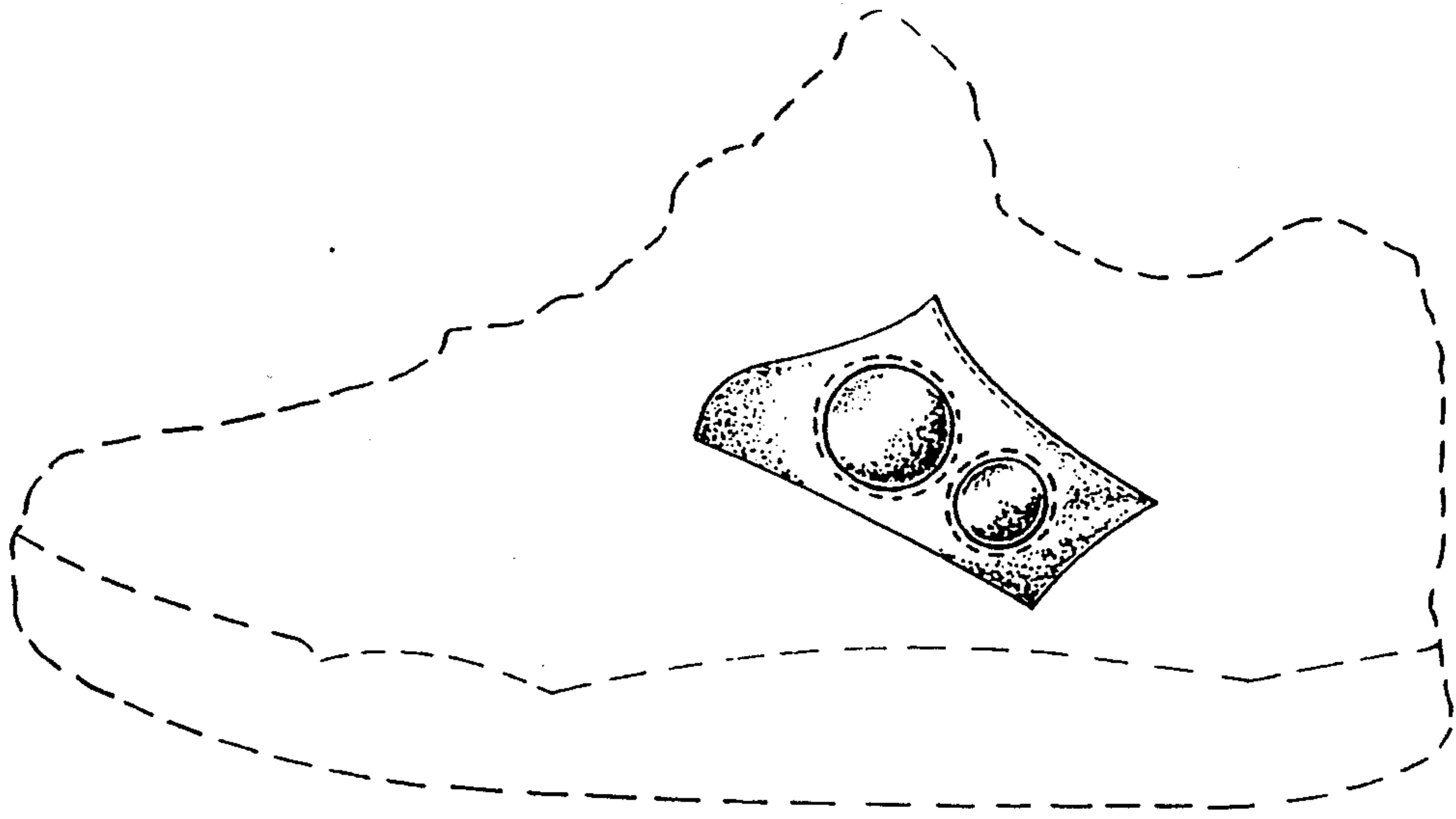

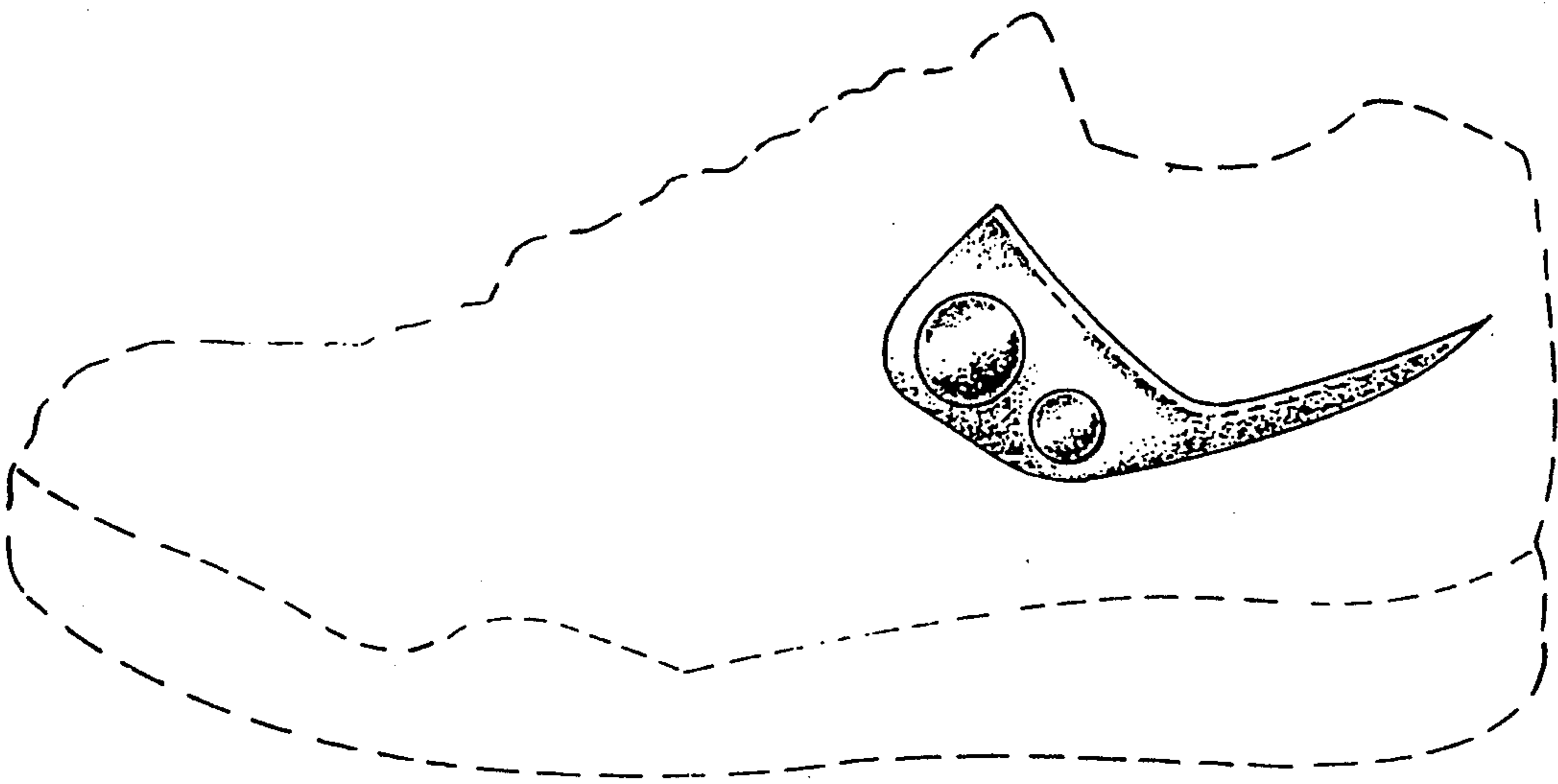

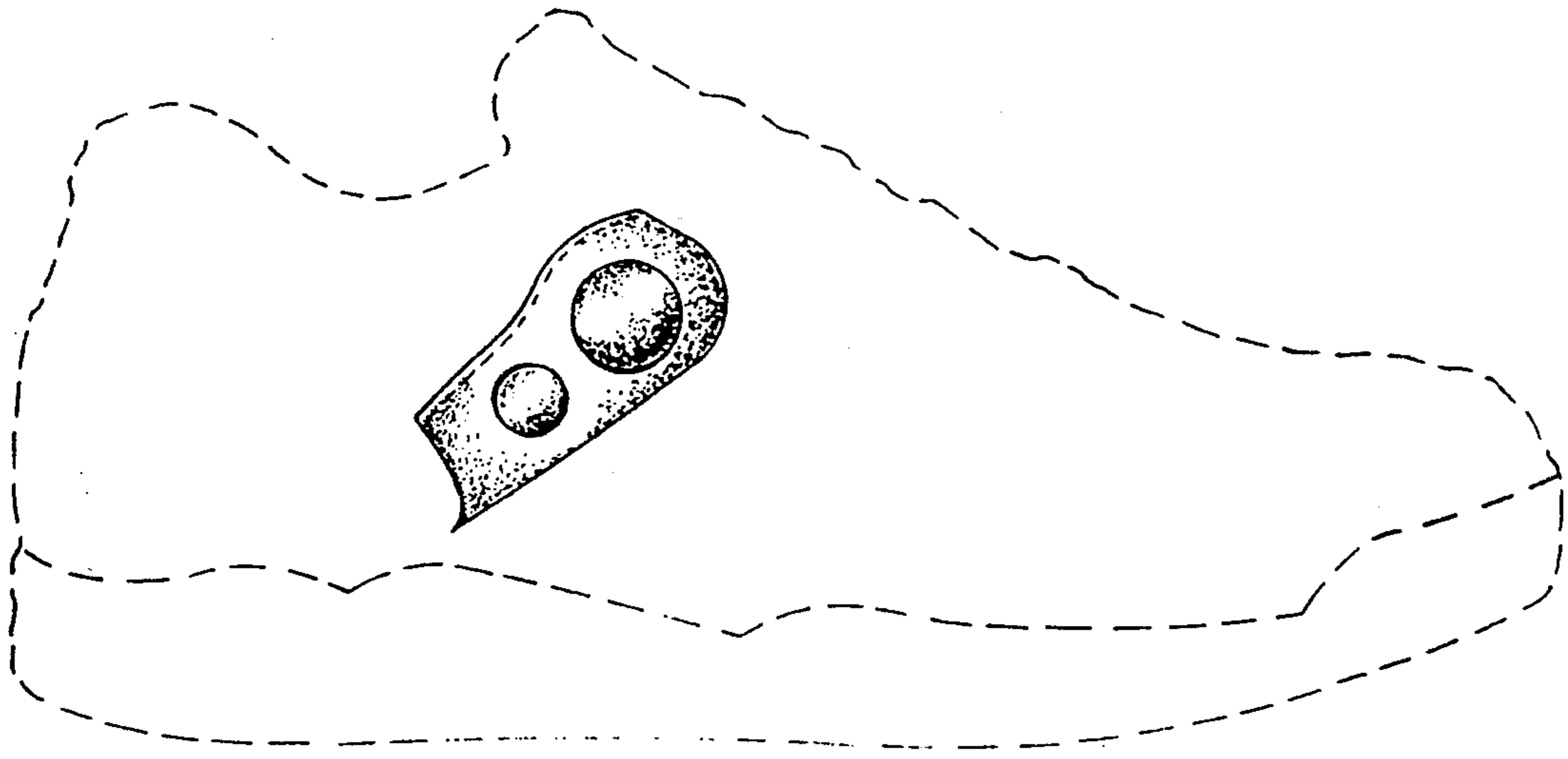

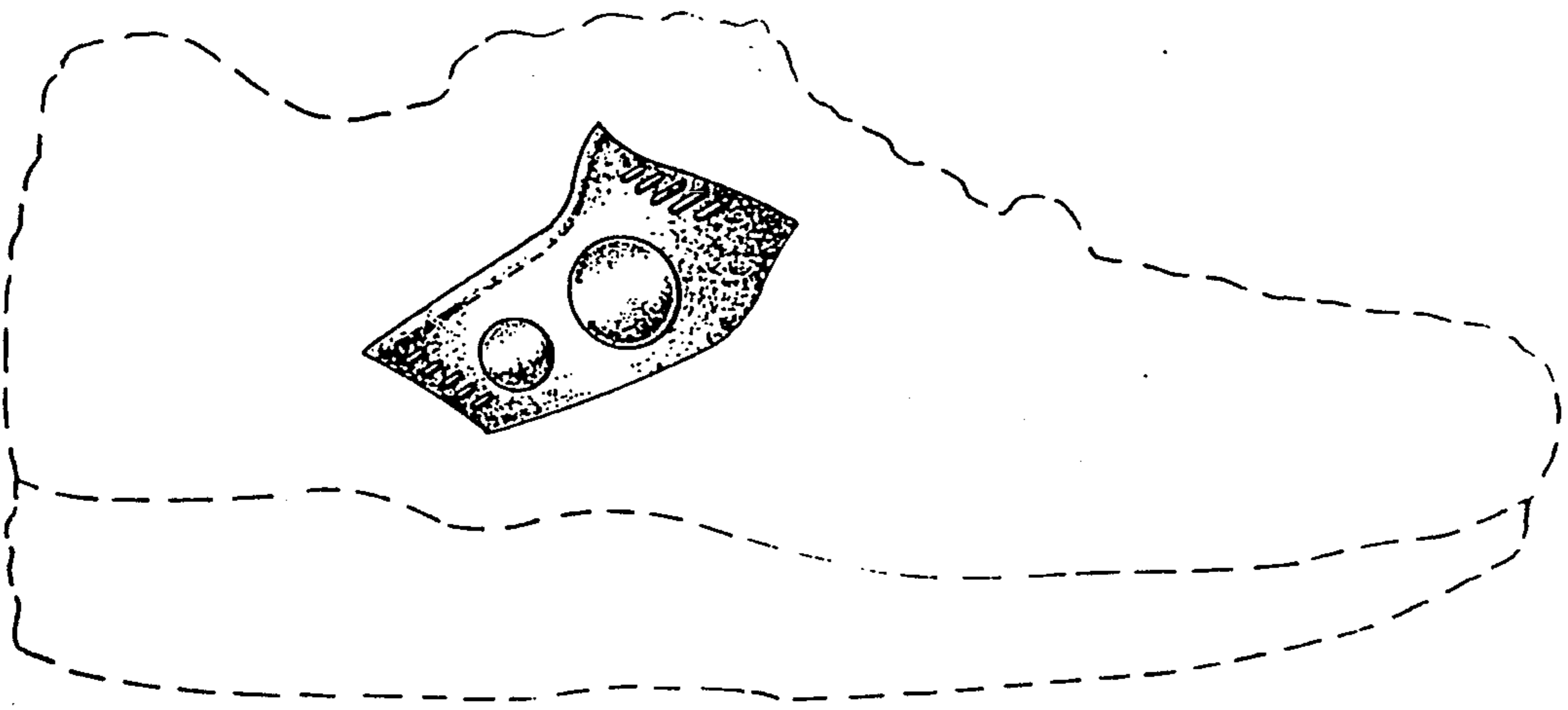
