The ornamental design for cabinet for office furniture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a frontal perspective view of the cabinet, showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of same.

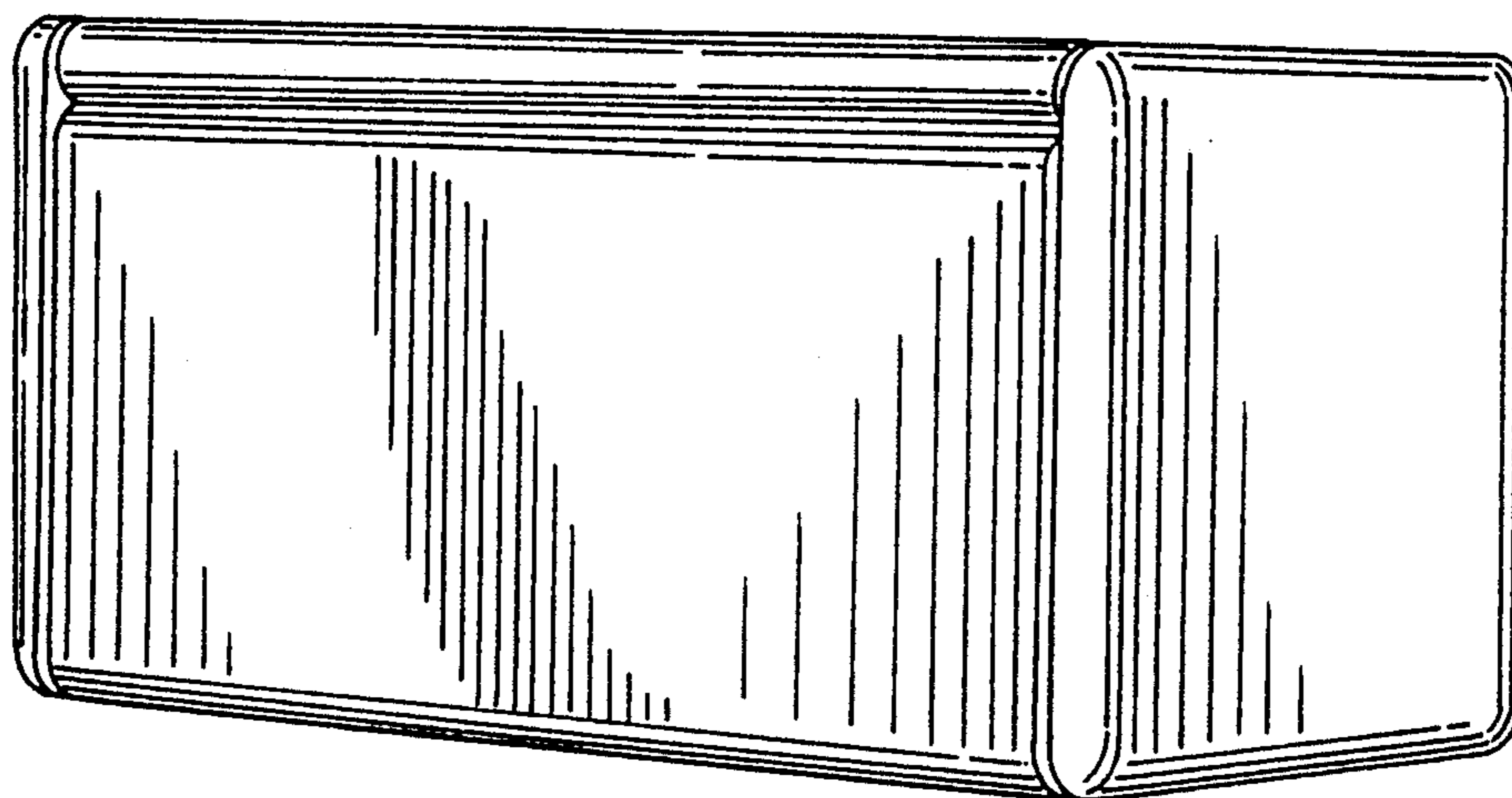

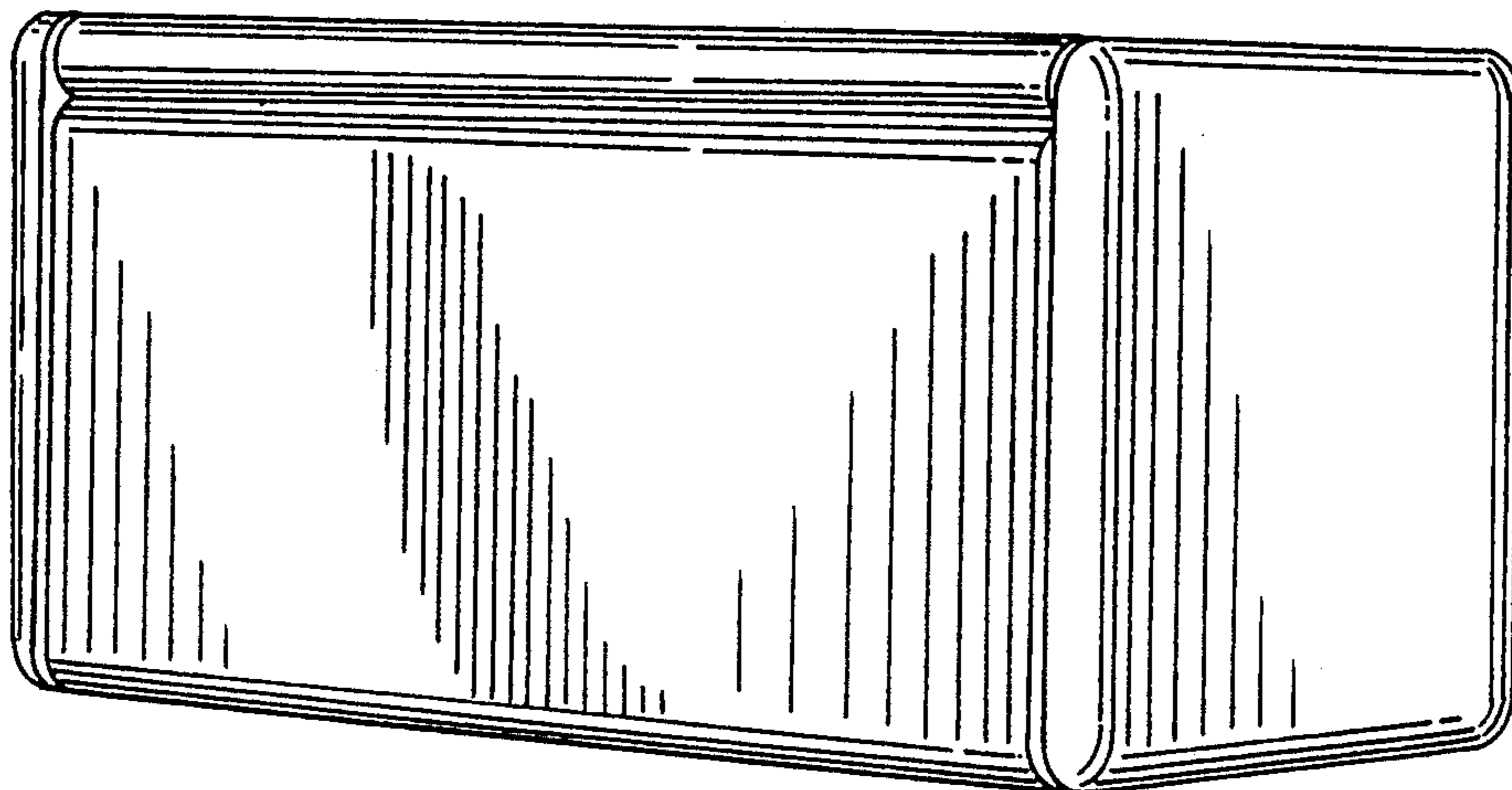

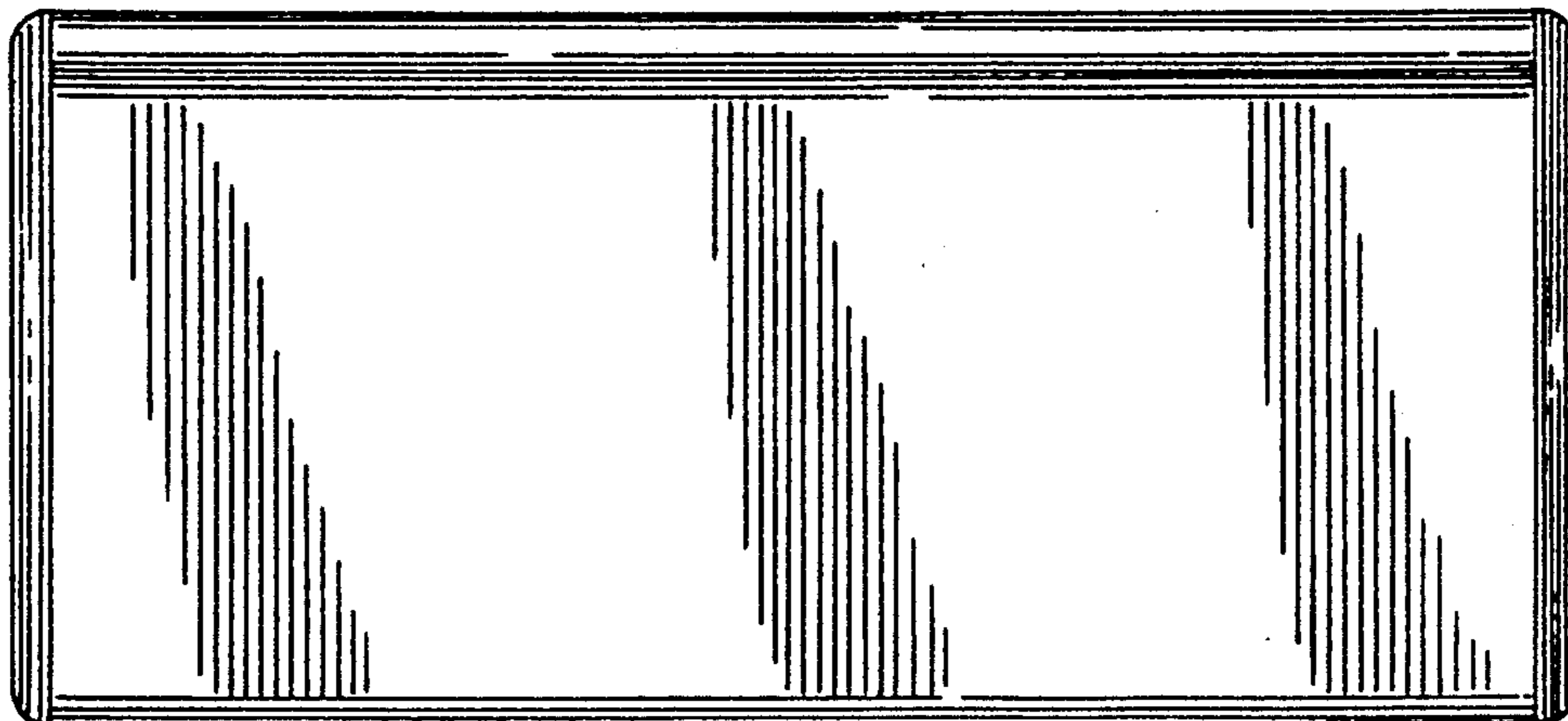

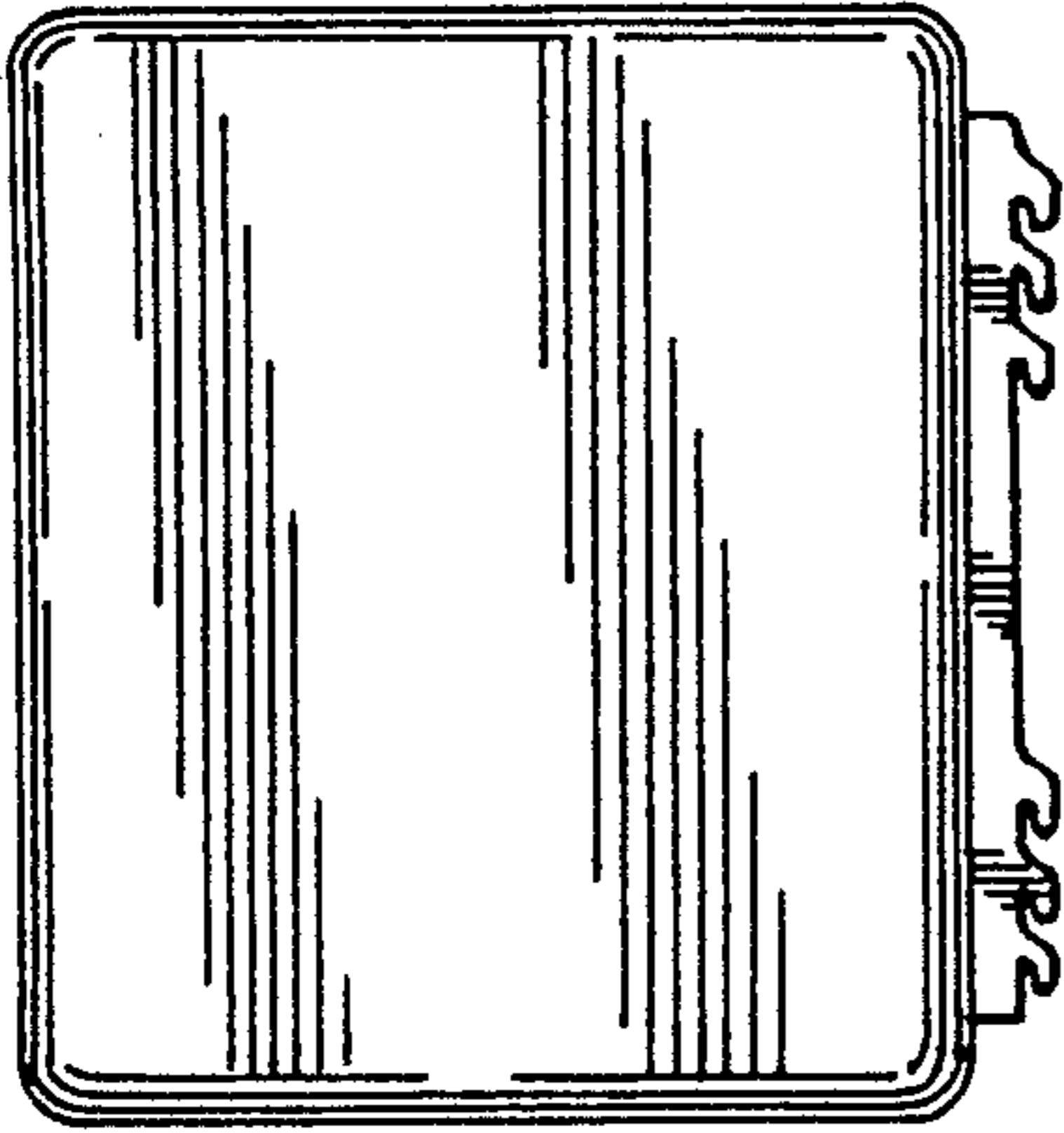

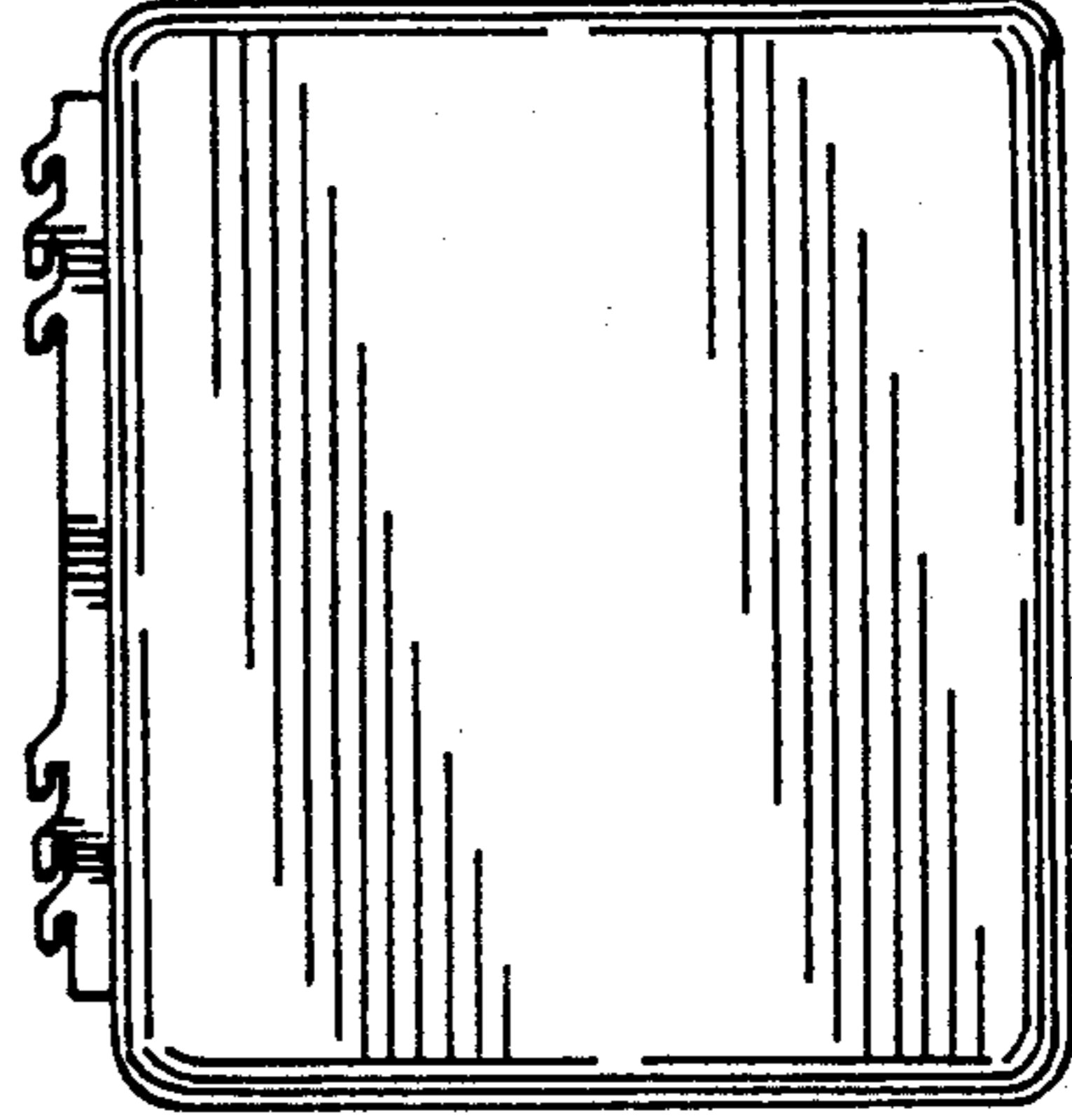

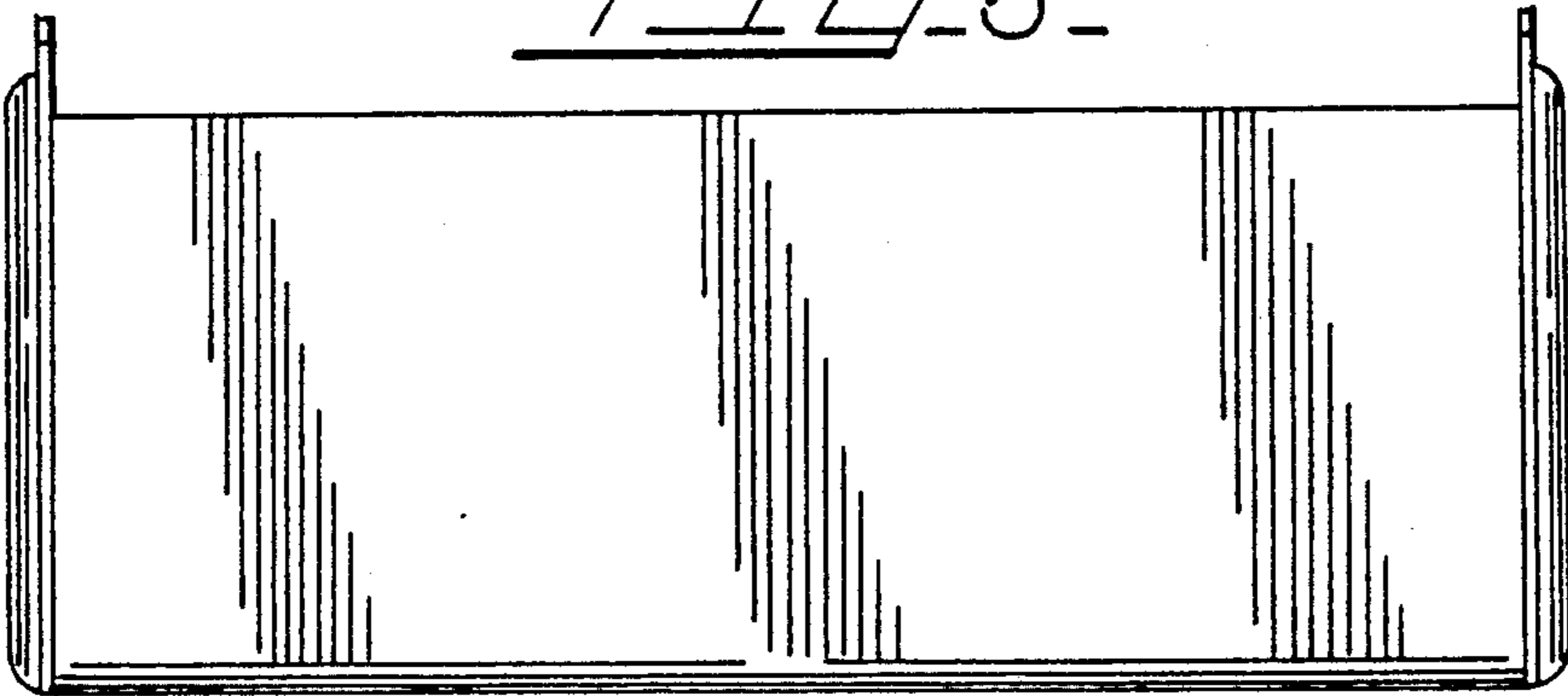

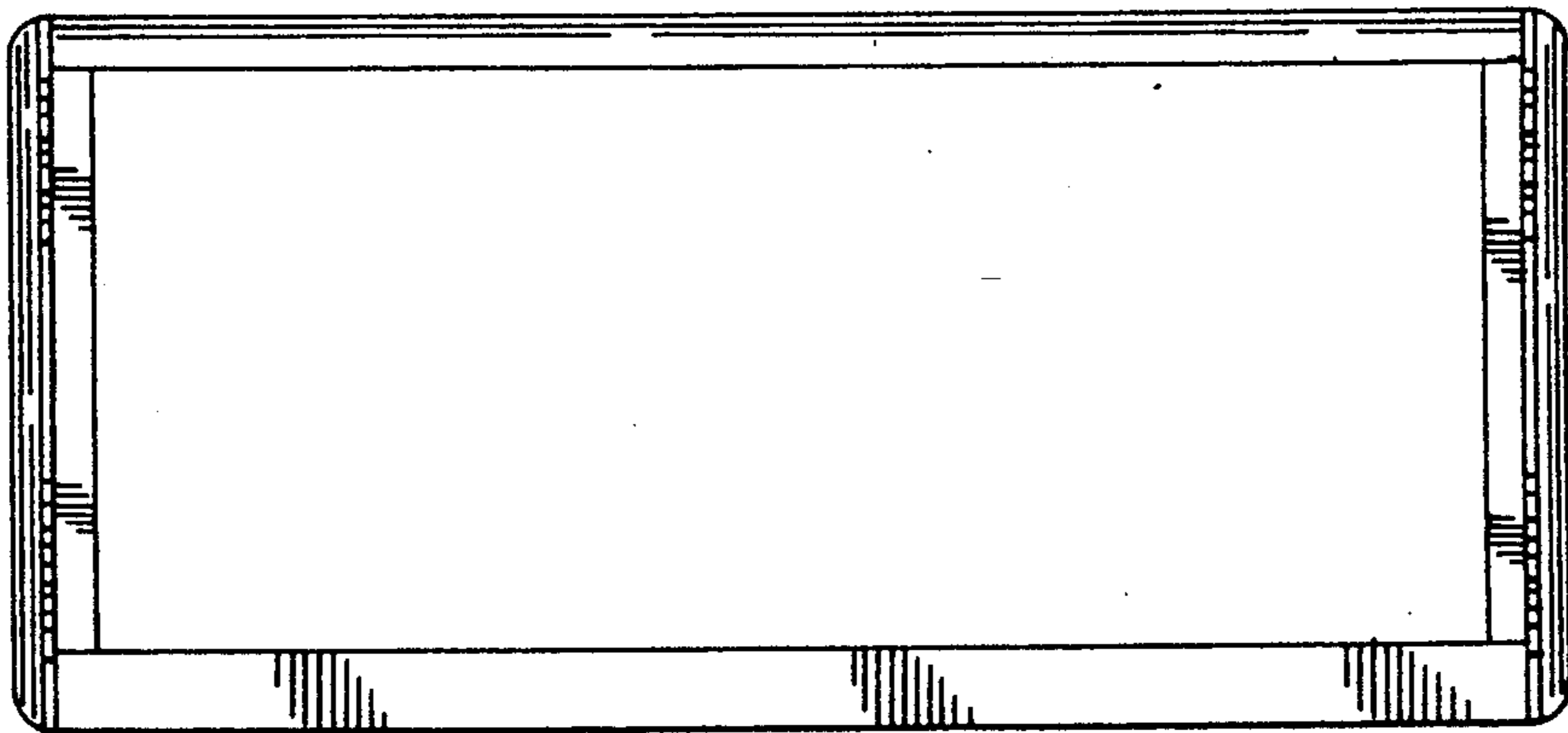
