FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

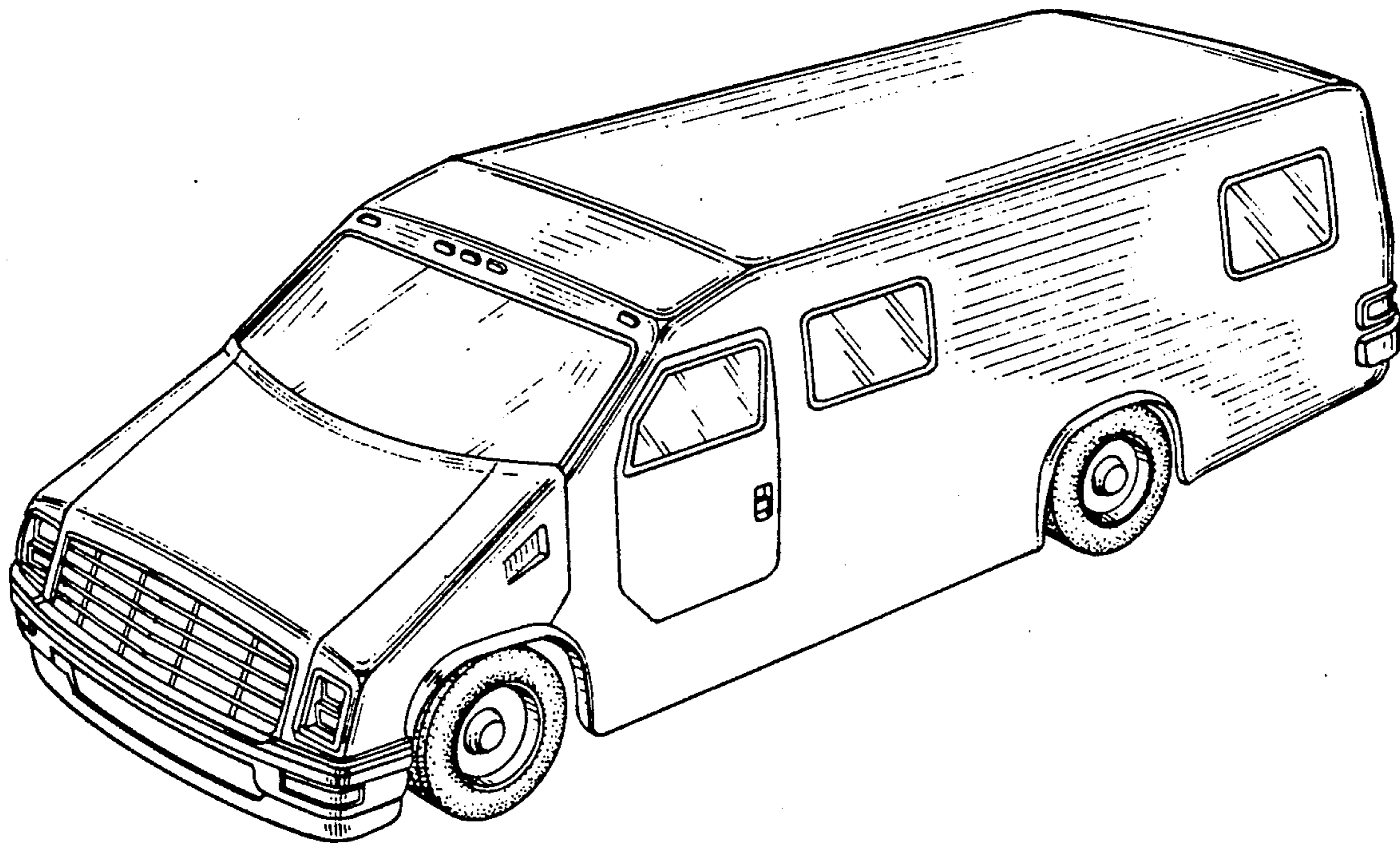
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the recreational vehicle showing a second embodiment of our new design;

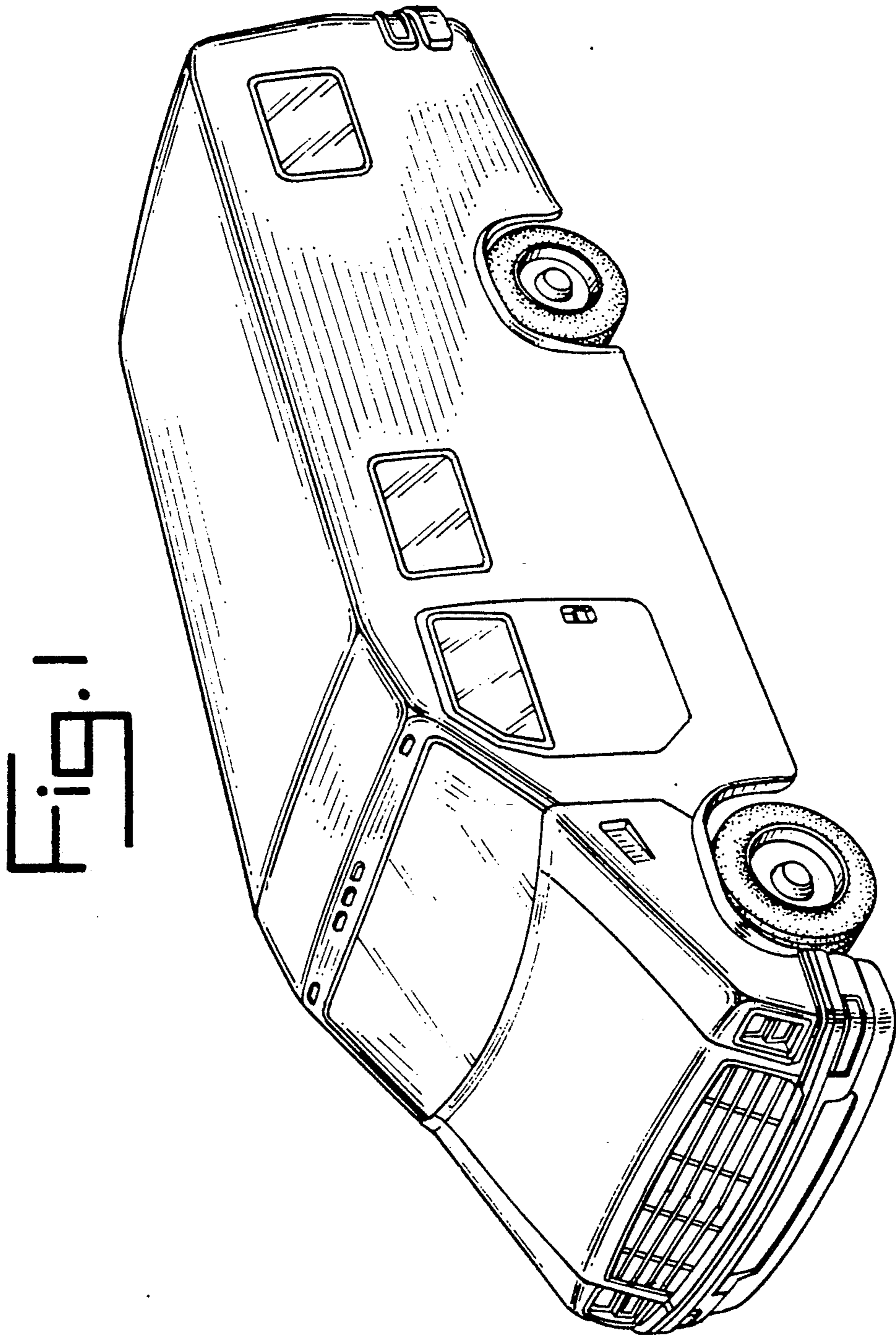
FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of the second embodiment.





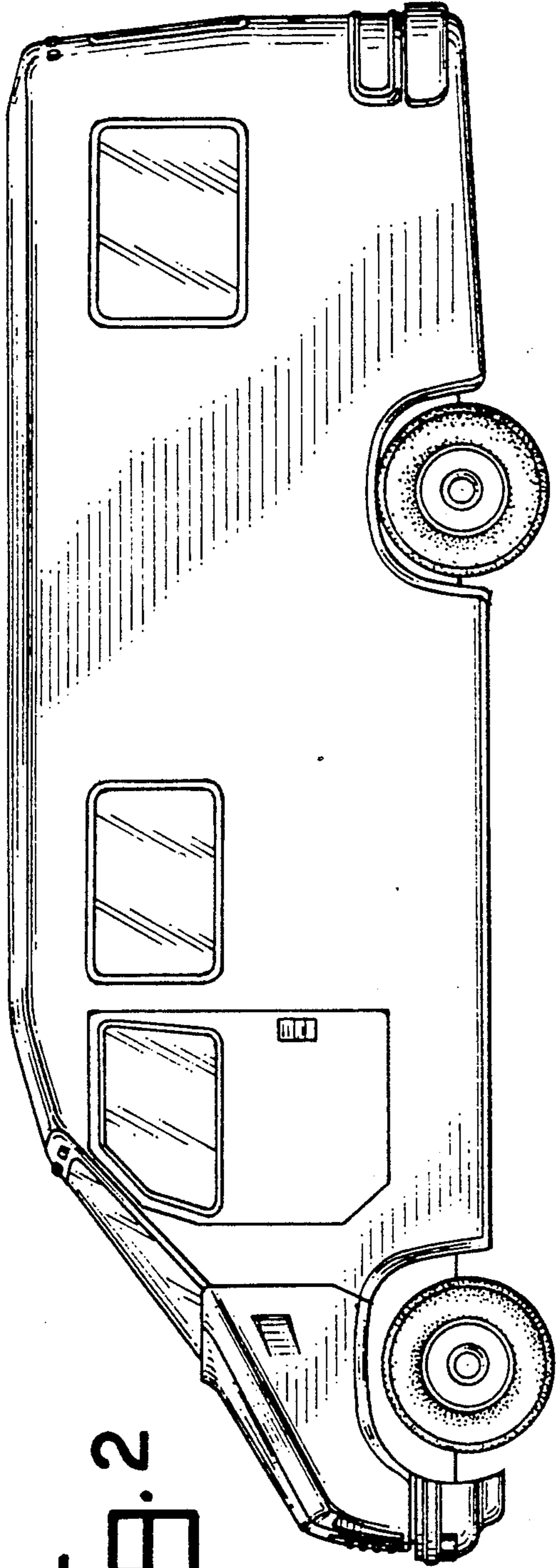

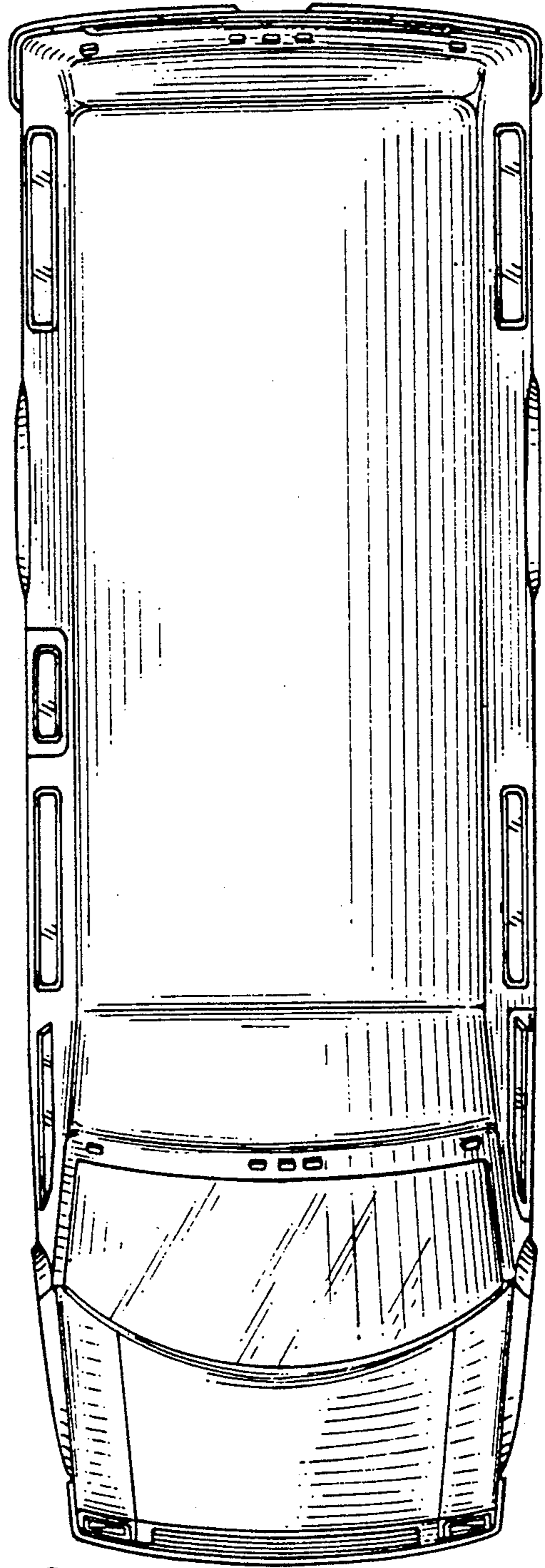

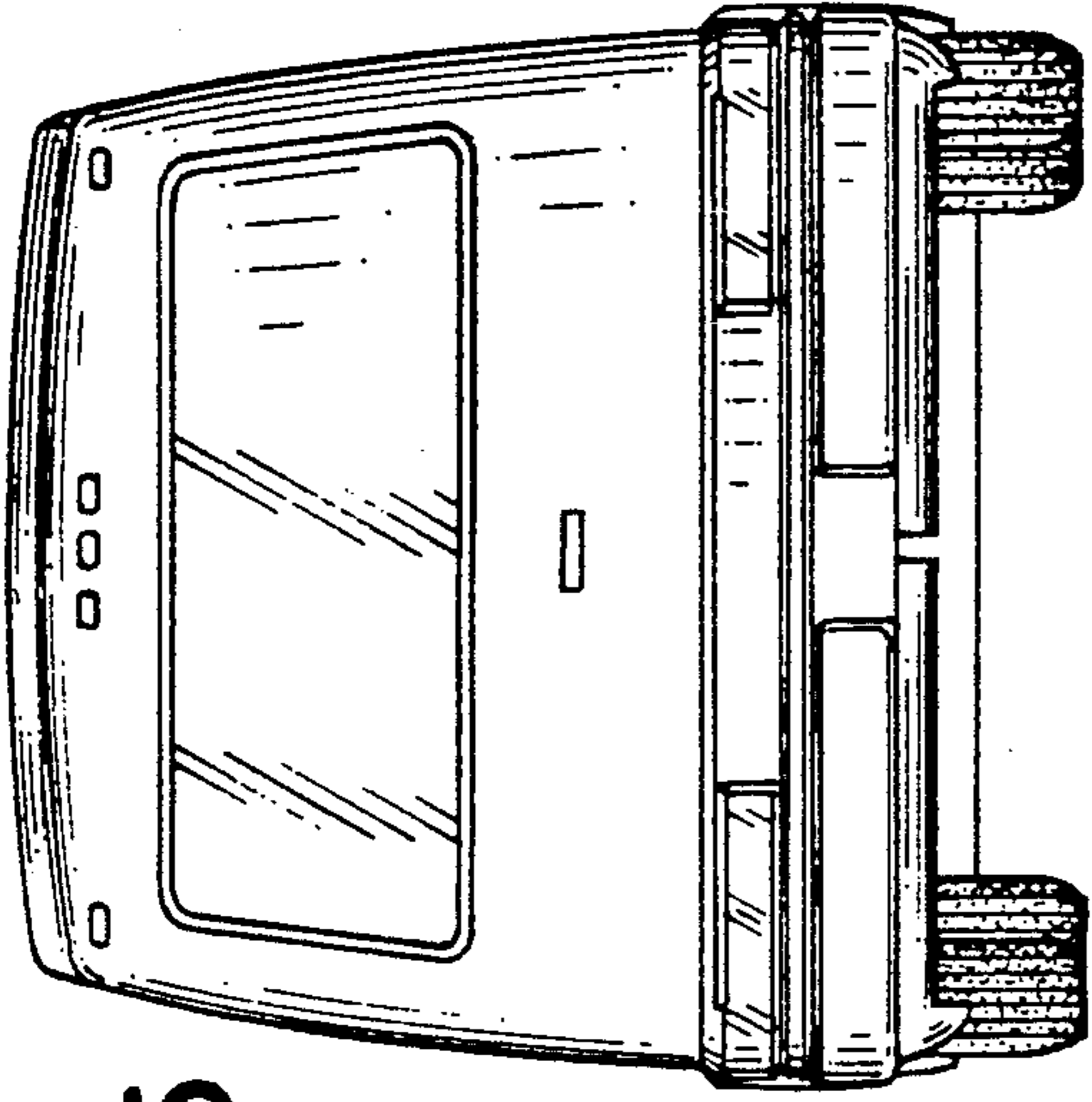

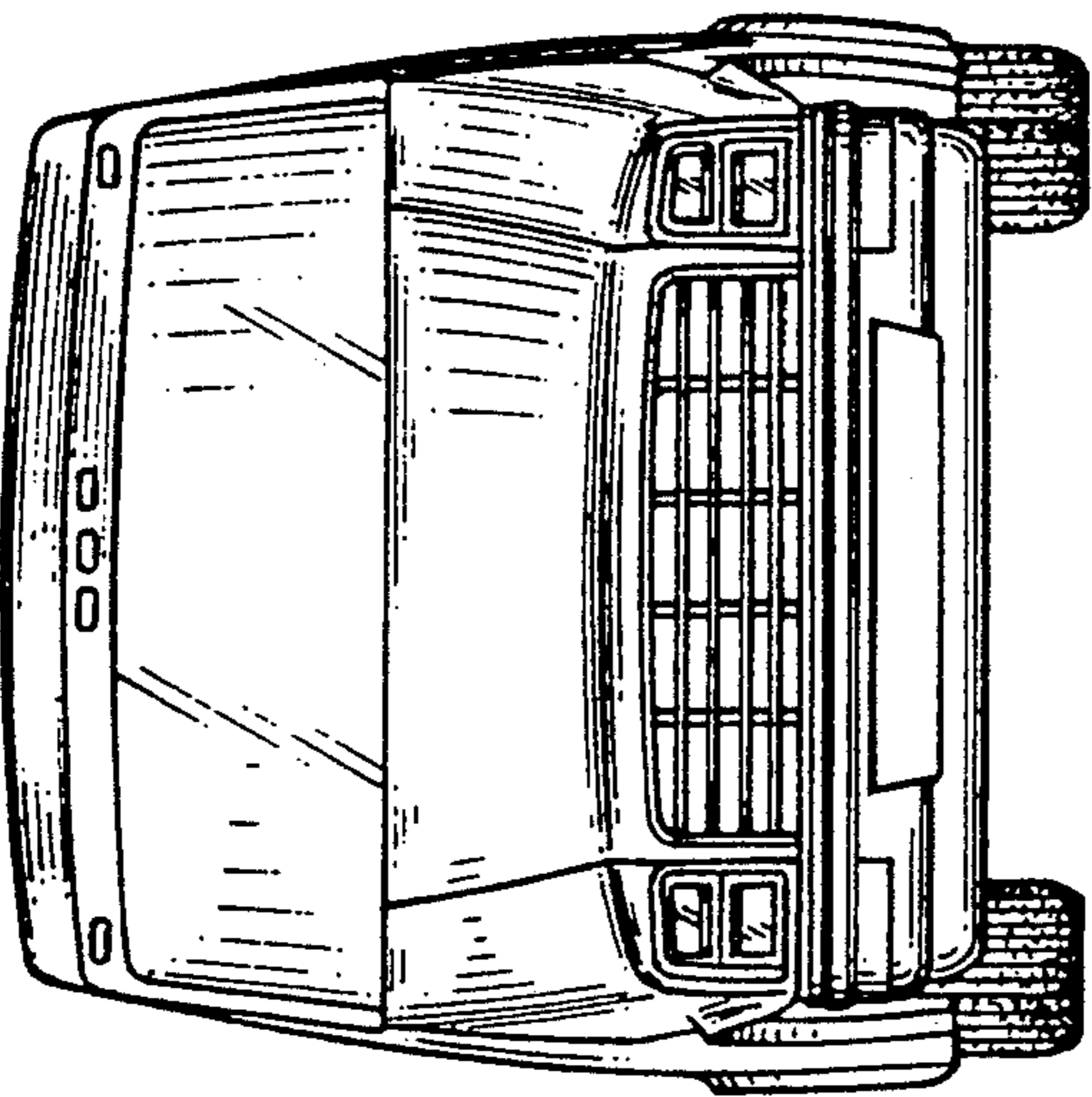

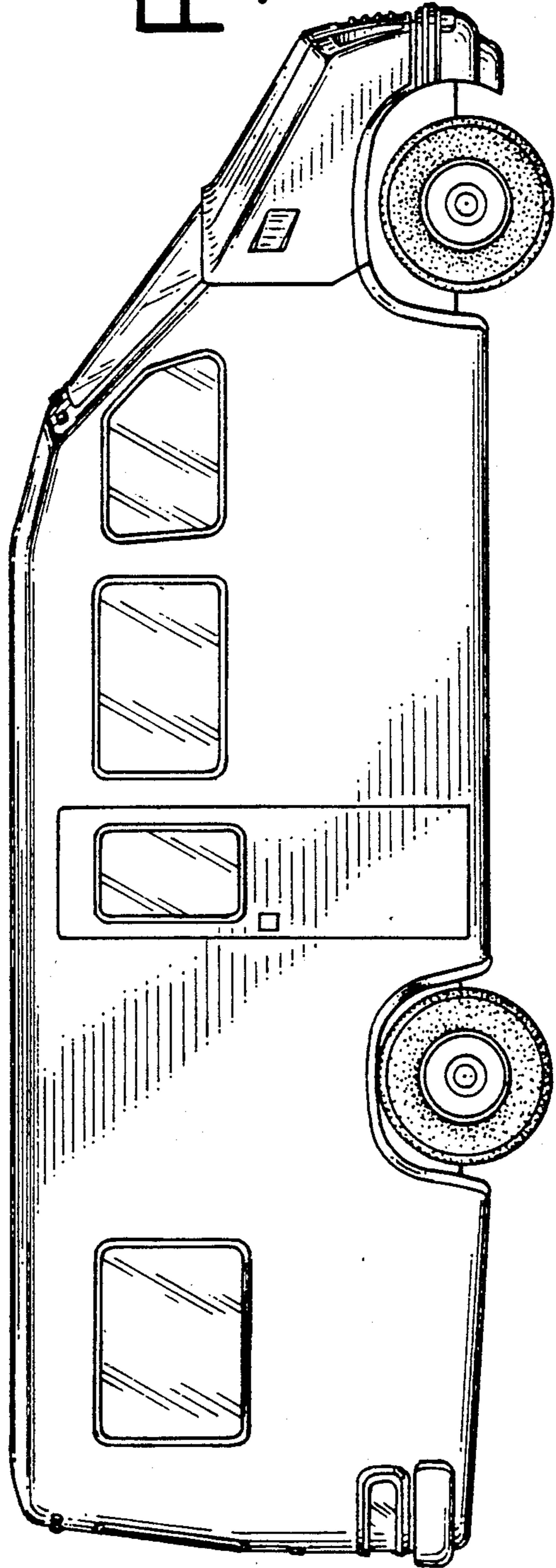
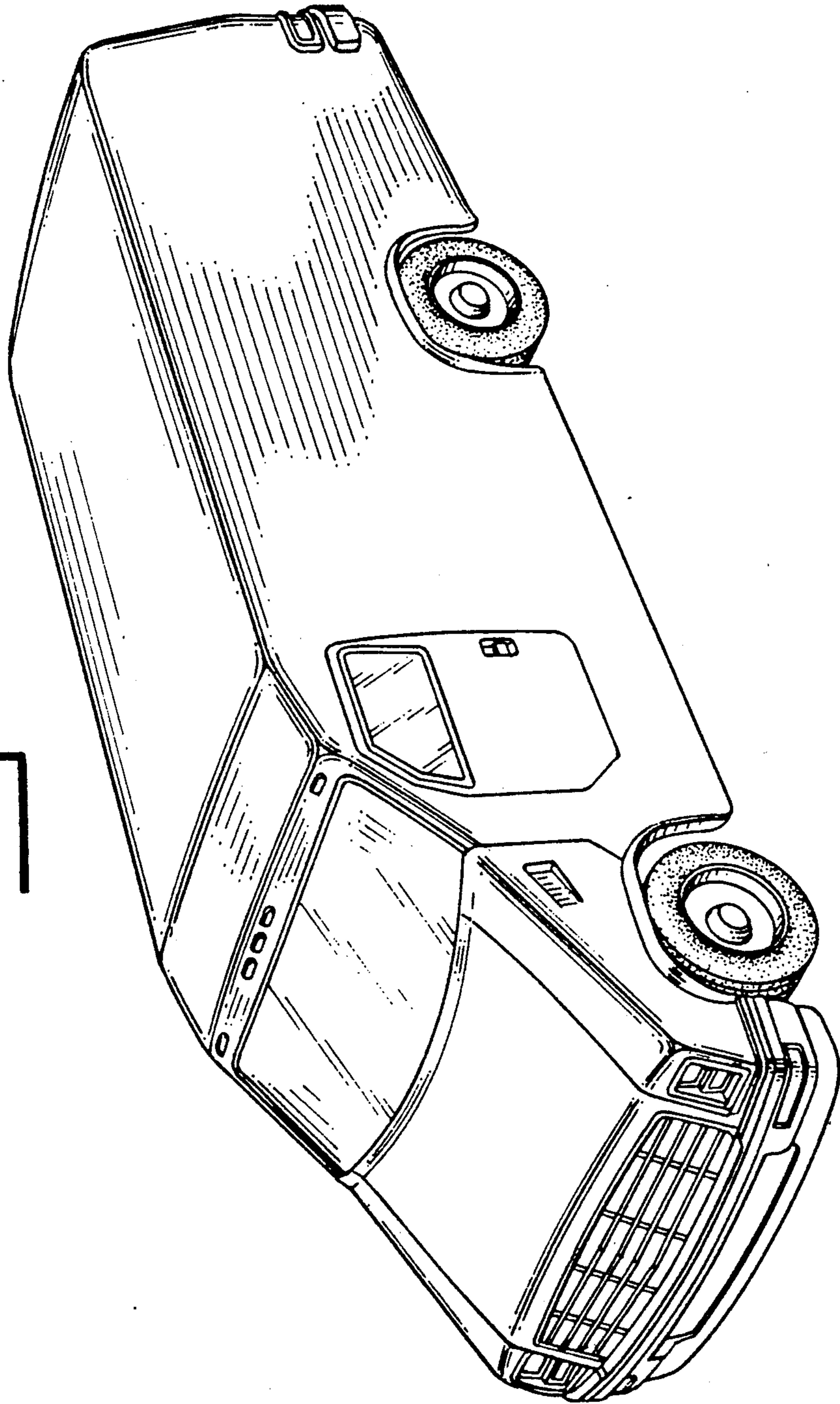

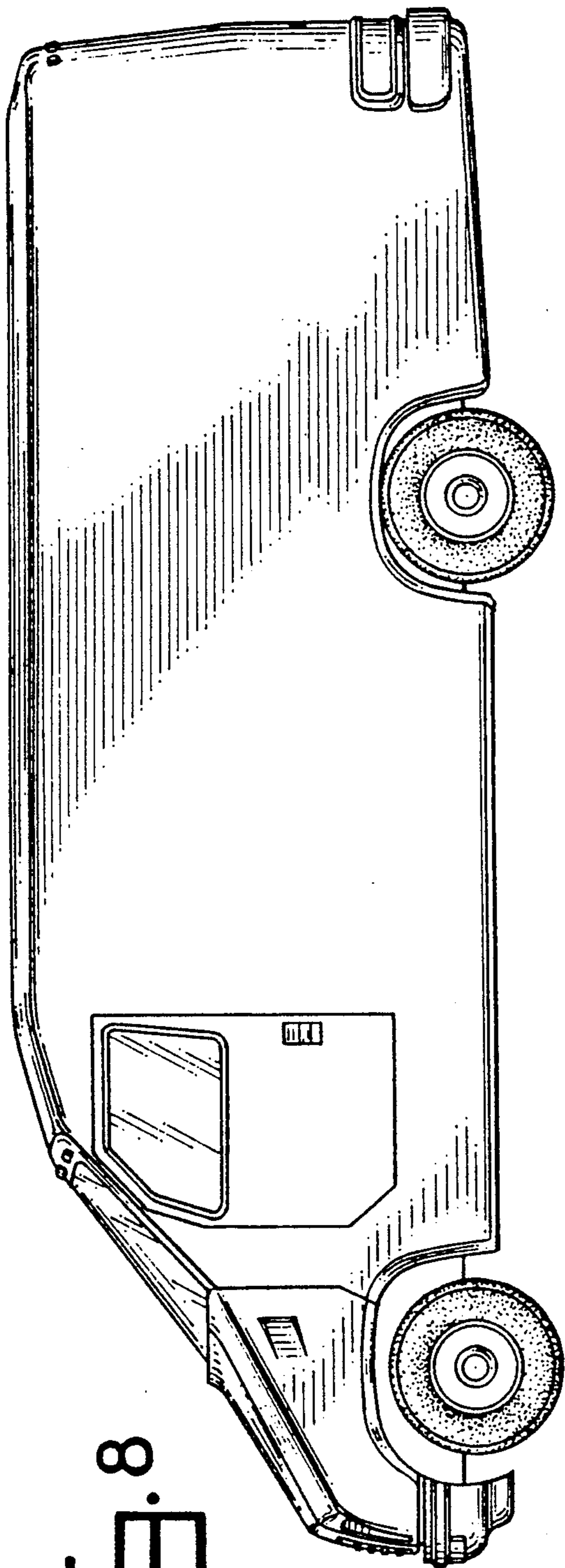

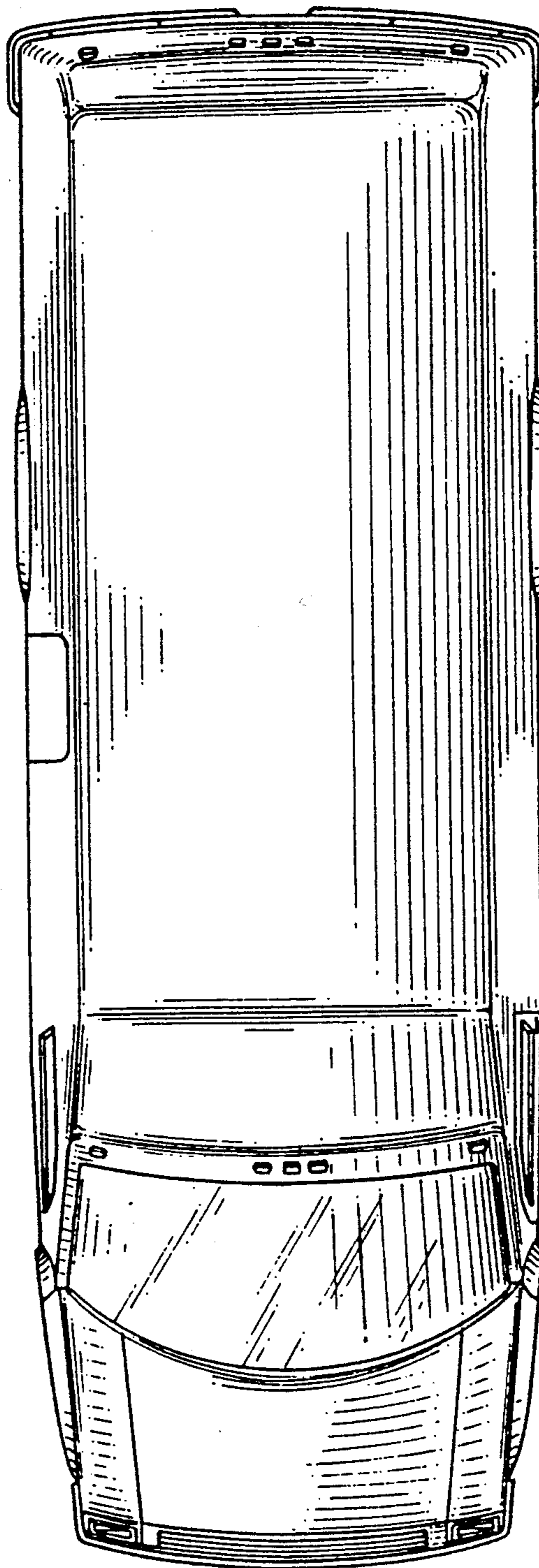

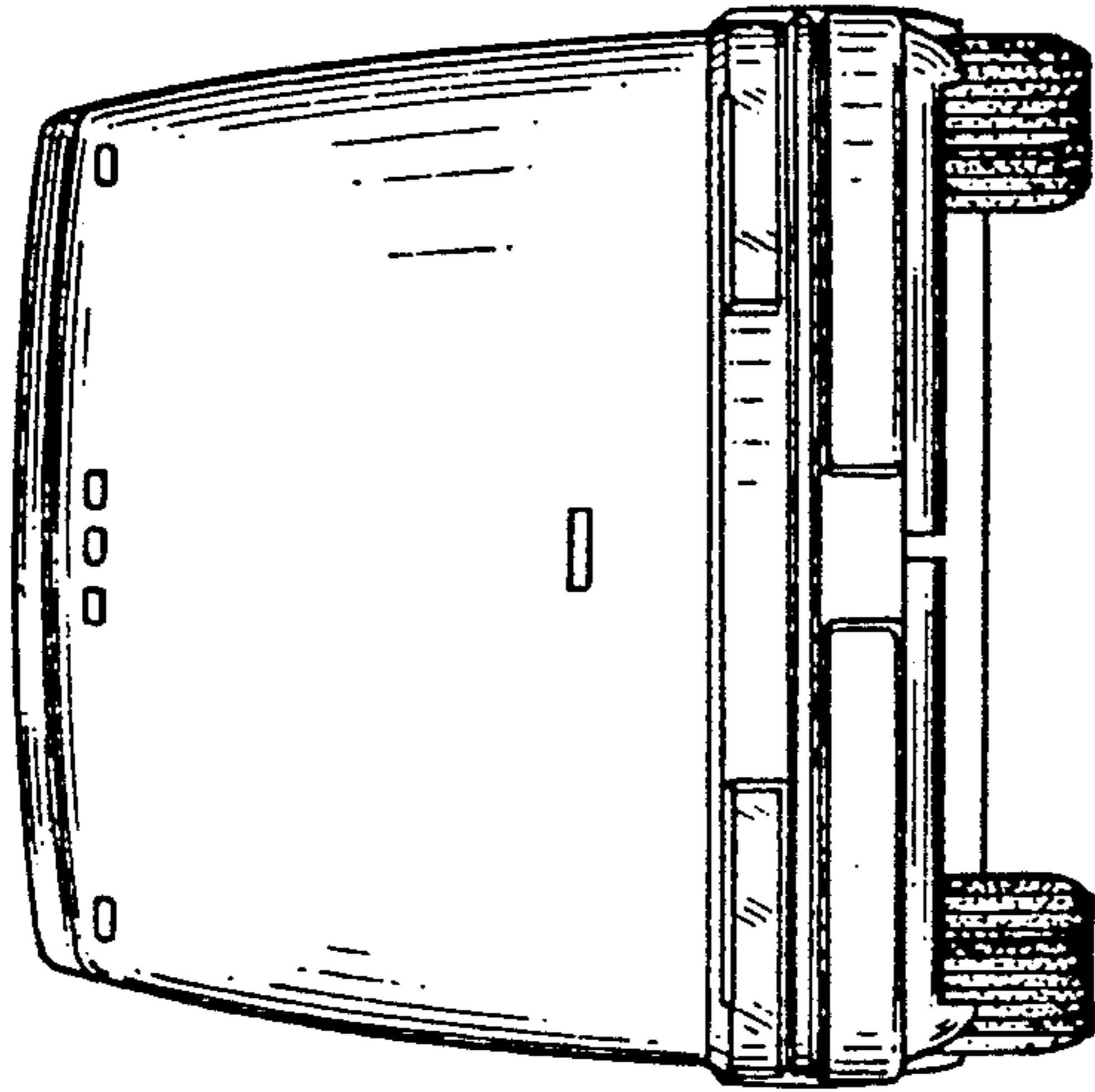

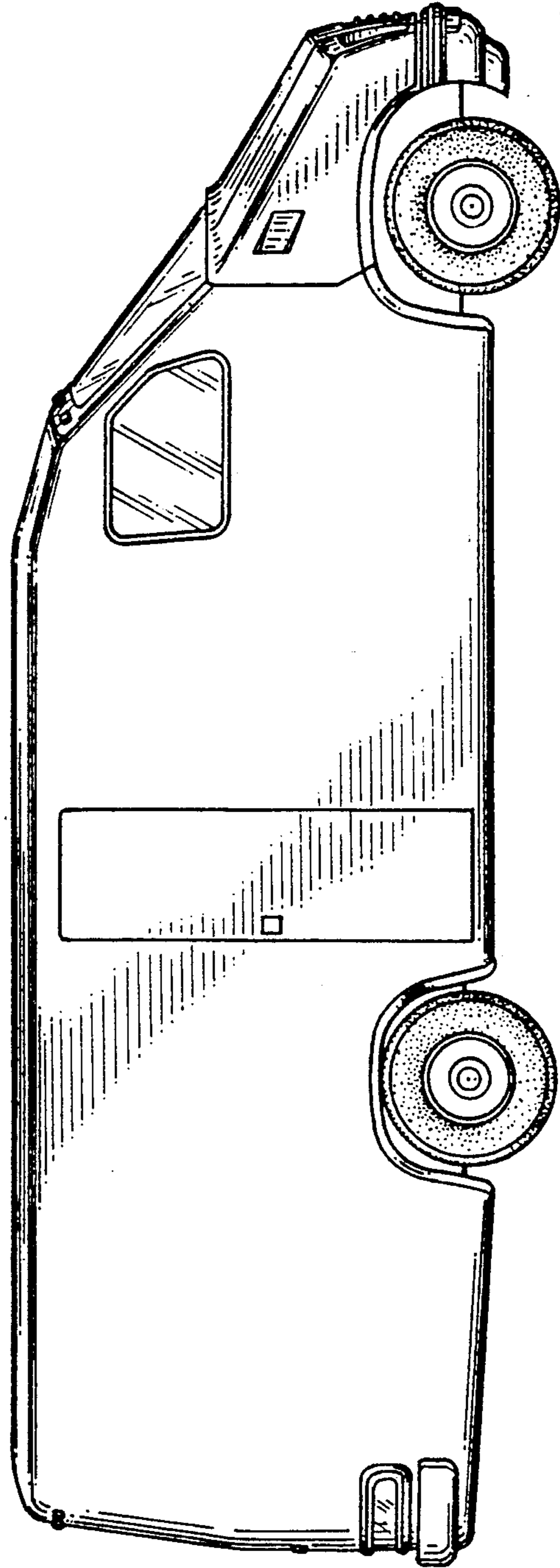
