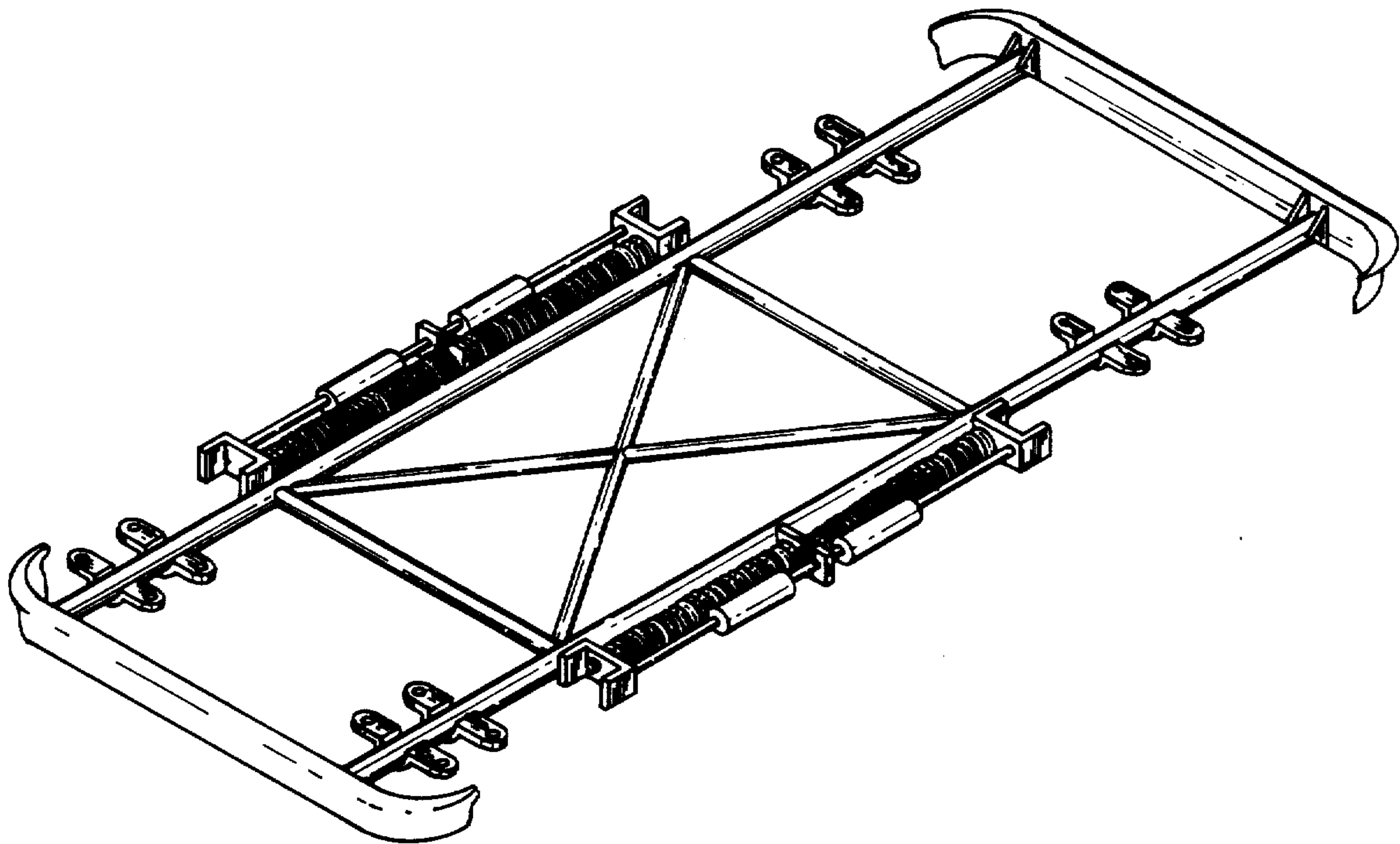

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shock absorbing bumper unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the shock absorbing bumper unit embodying the design of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



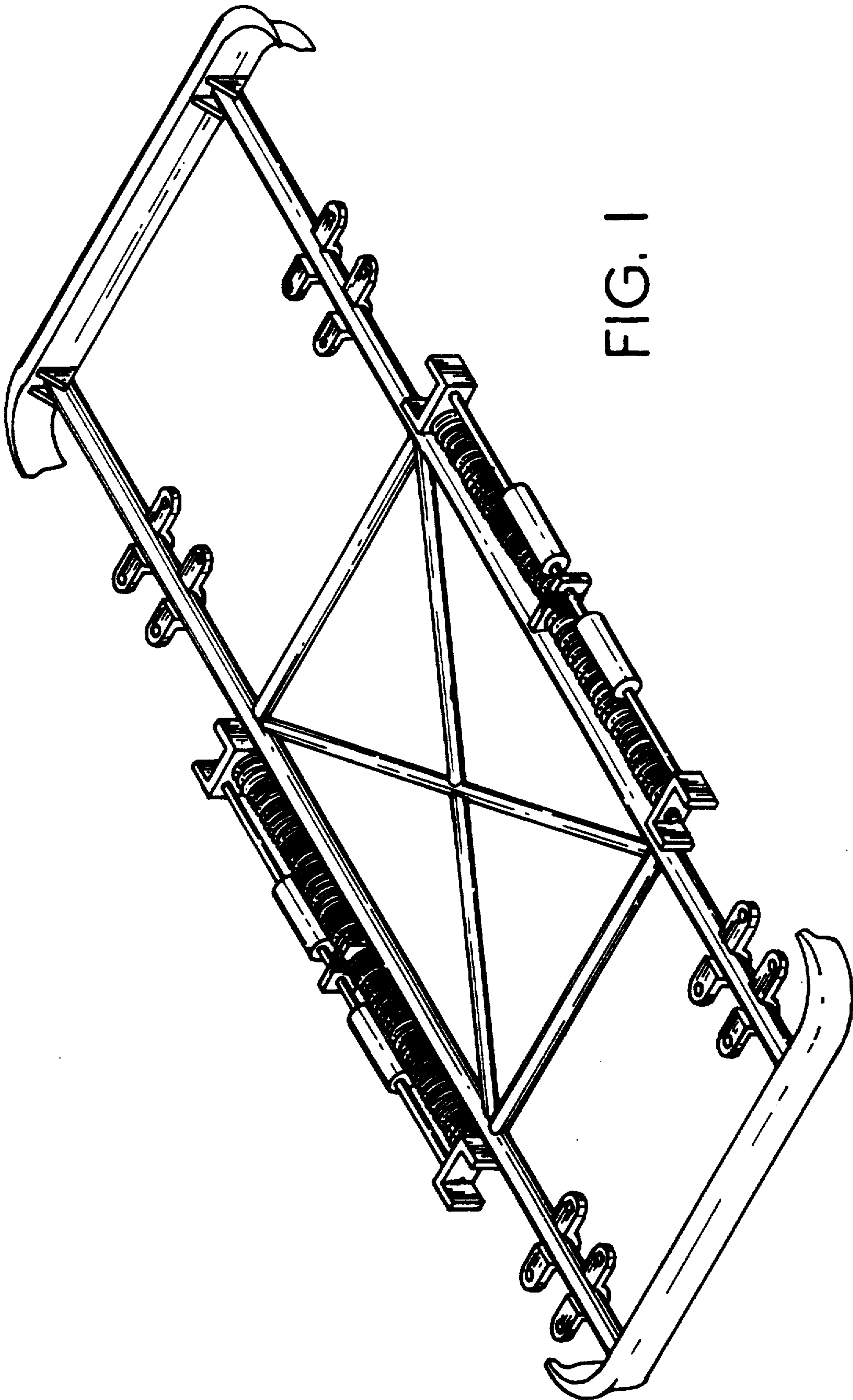

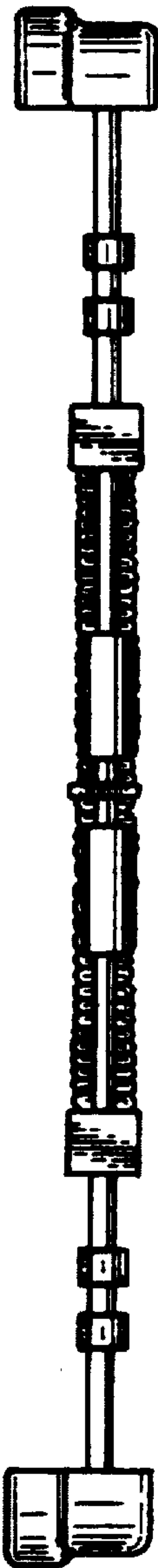

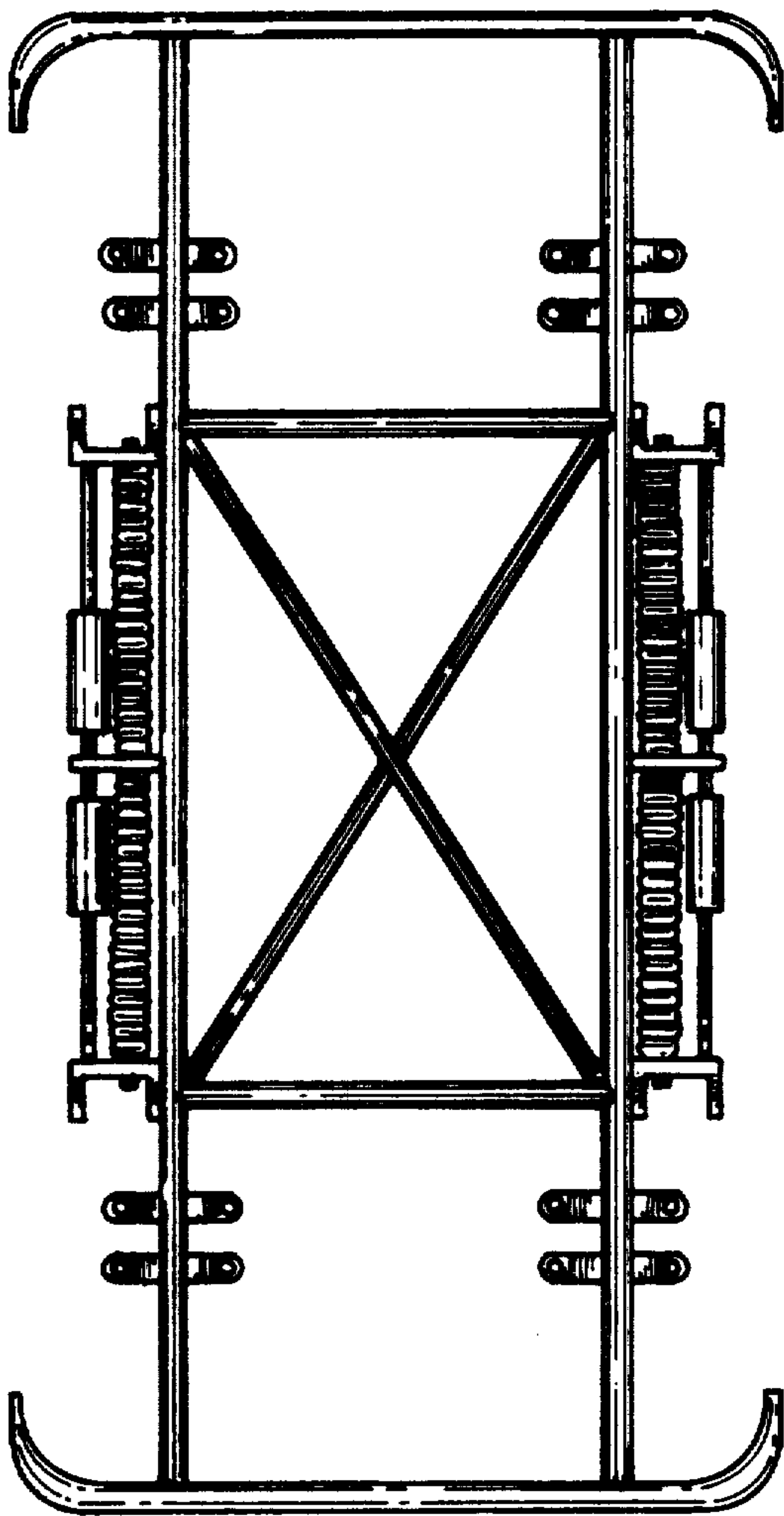

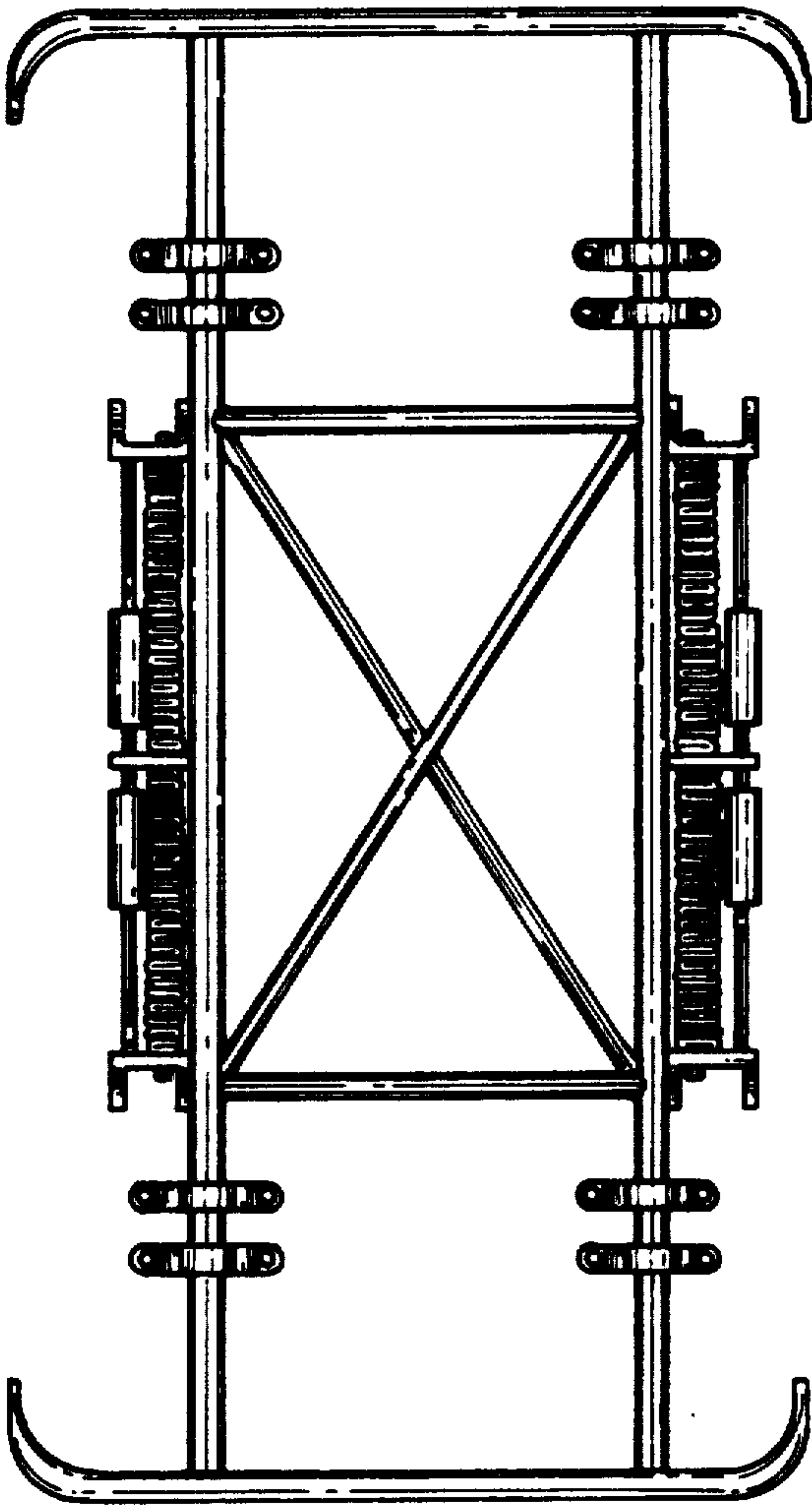
