FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a top, front perspective view thereof; and.

FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view thereof.


The broken lines showing a semi-automatic magazine are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.






