The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

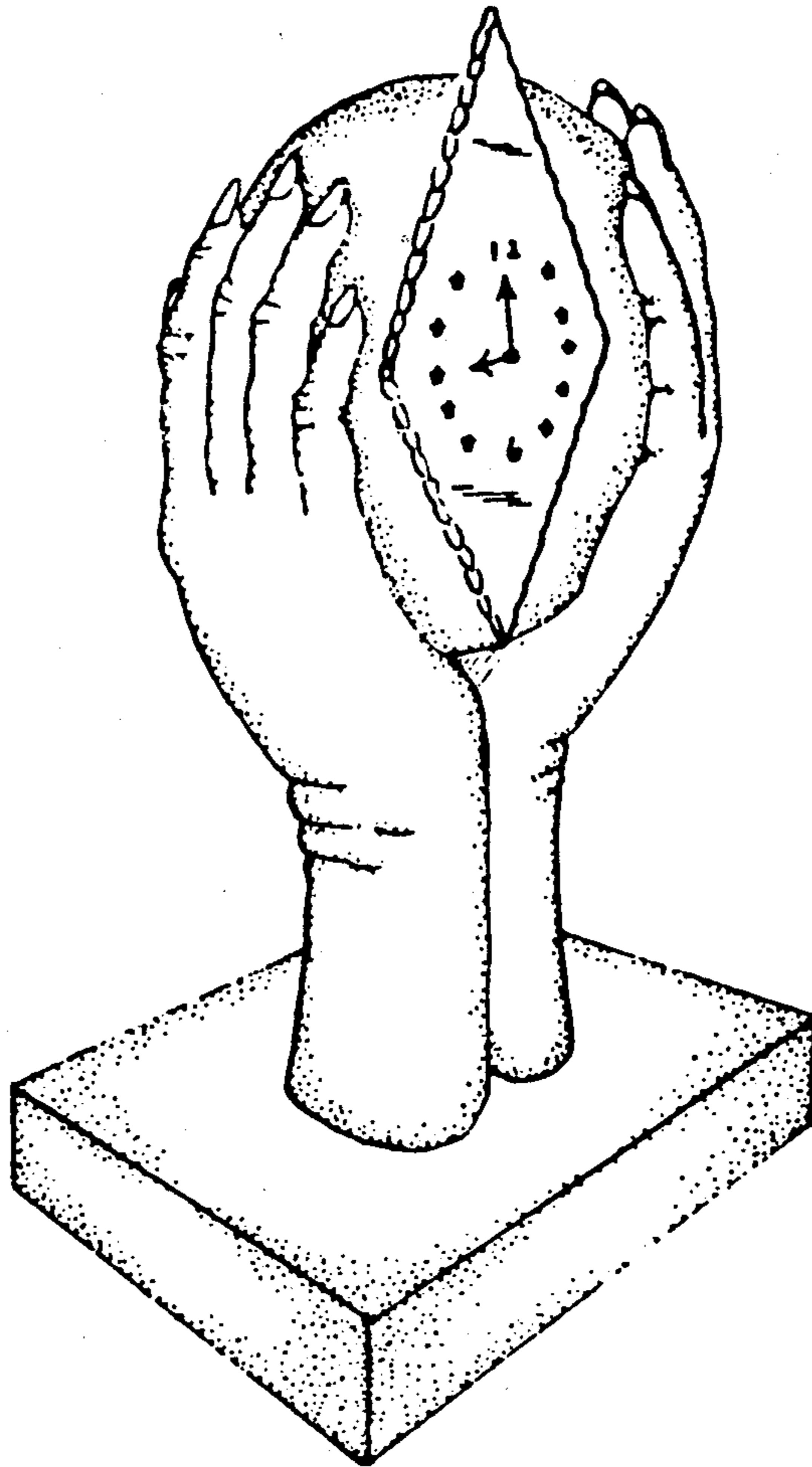
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front and top-left perspective view thereof.



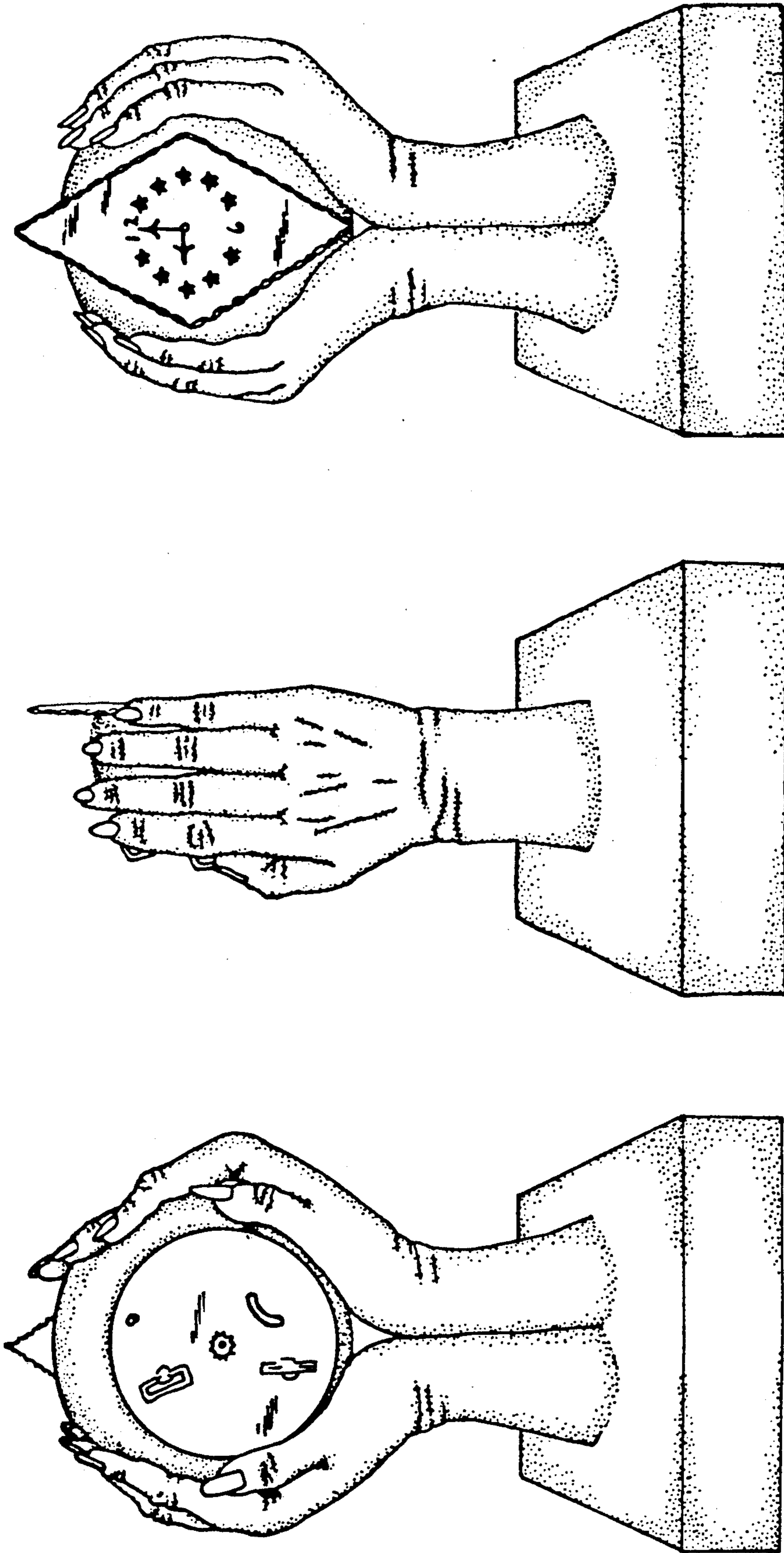

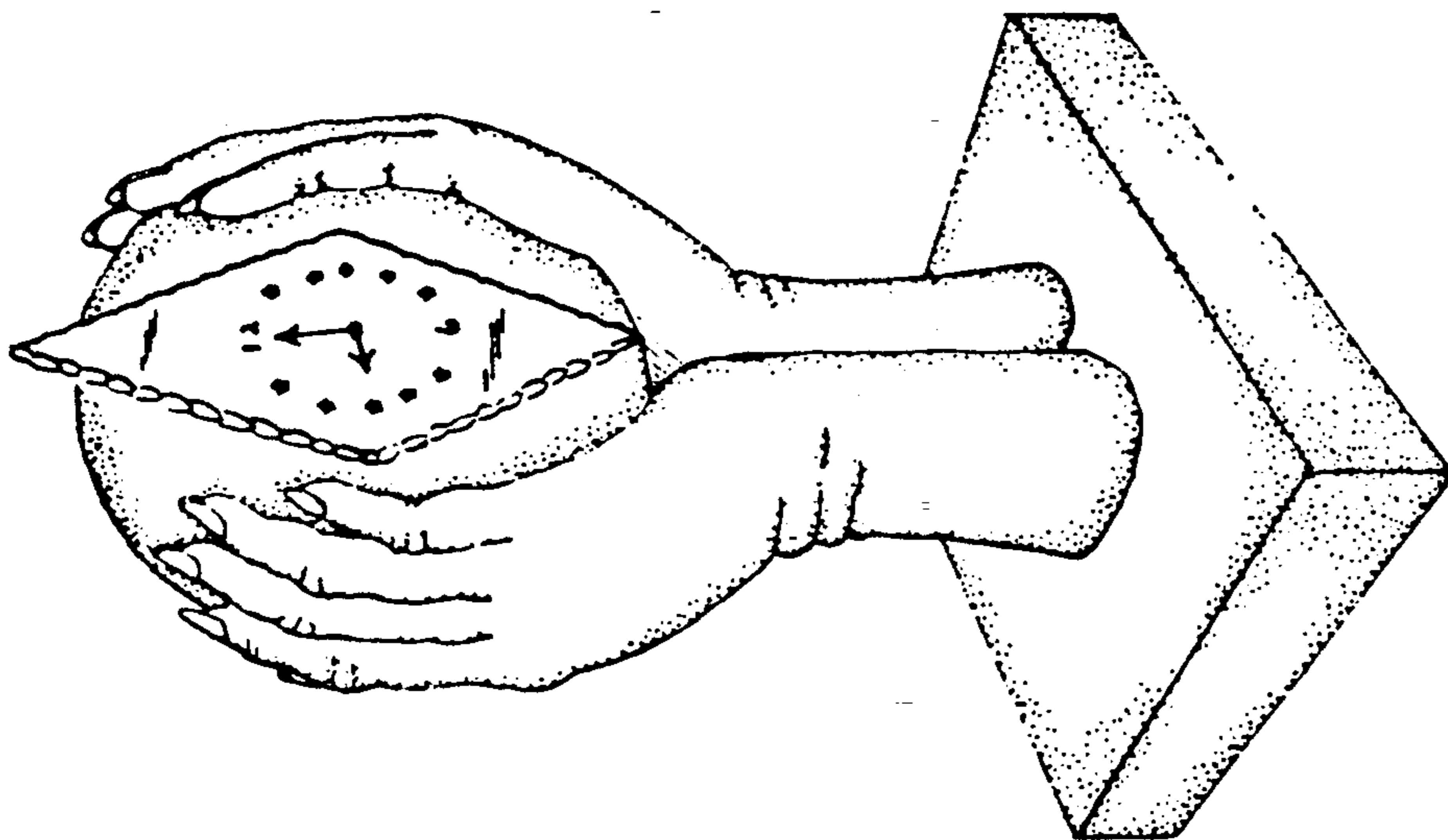
