## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined vehicle hood shield and windshield deflector, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a combined vehicle hood shield and windshield deflector showing my new design attached to a pickup truck which is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and is not part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof; the side opposite that shown being a mirror image;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a combined vehicle hood shield and windshield deflector showing a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7; the side opposite that shown being a mirror image.

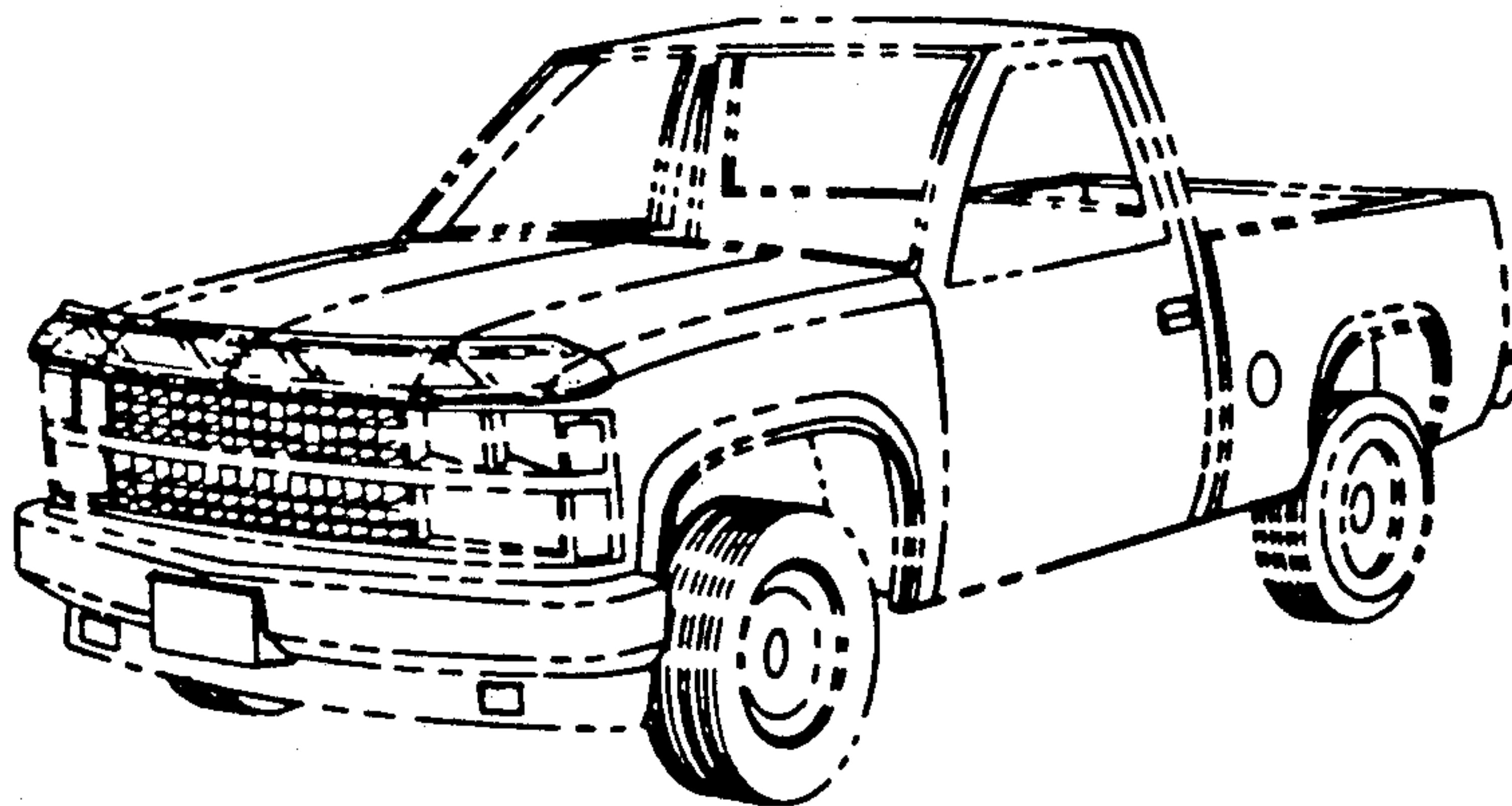

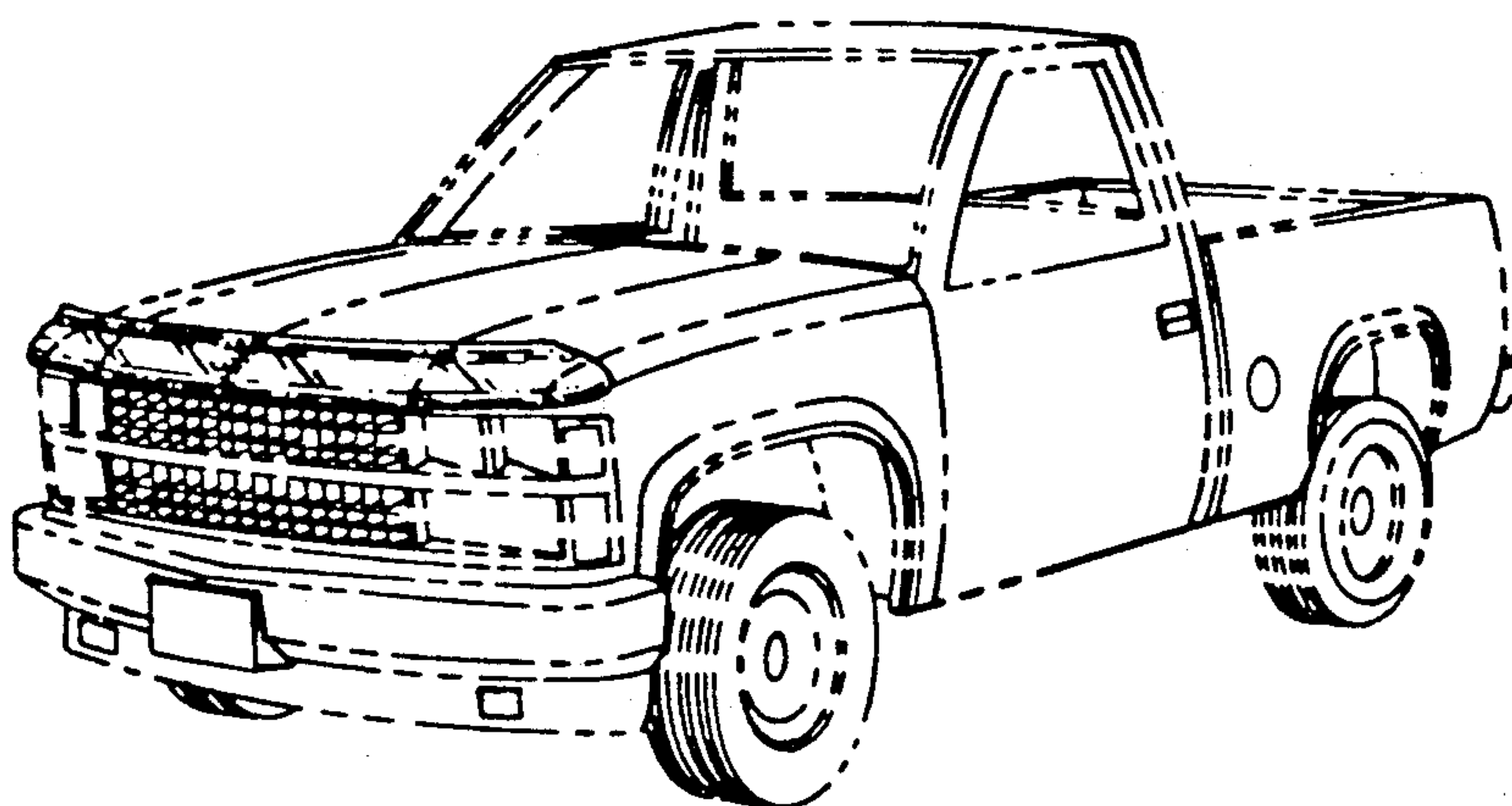

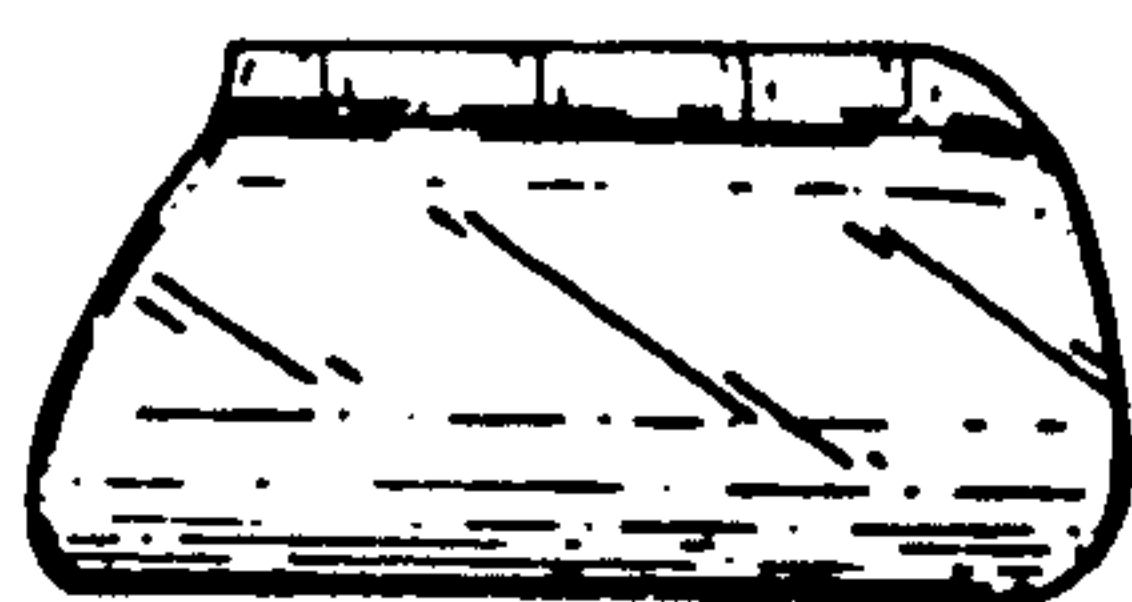

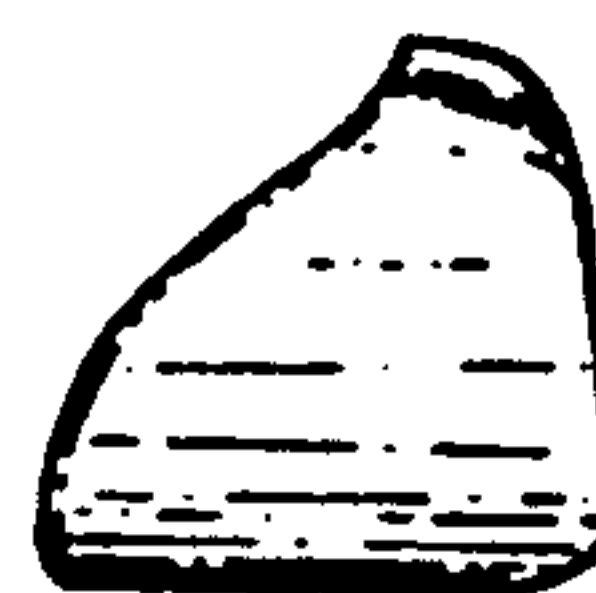

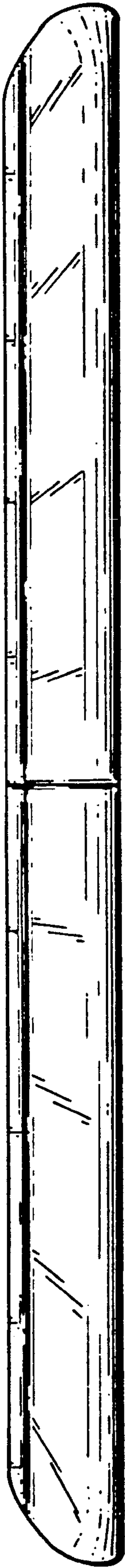

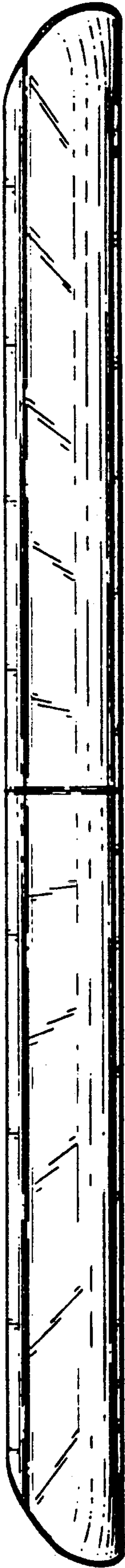

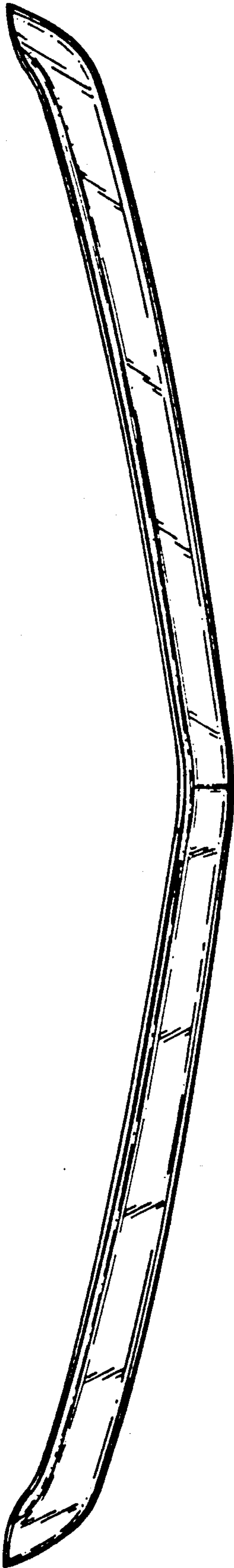

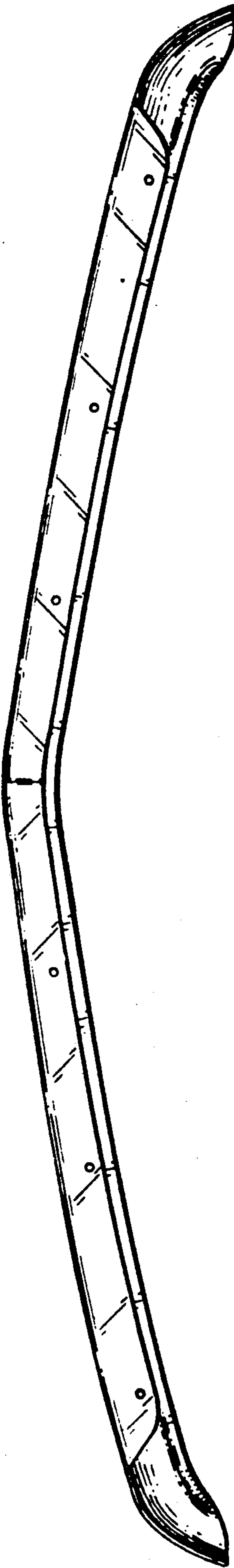

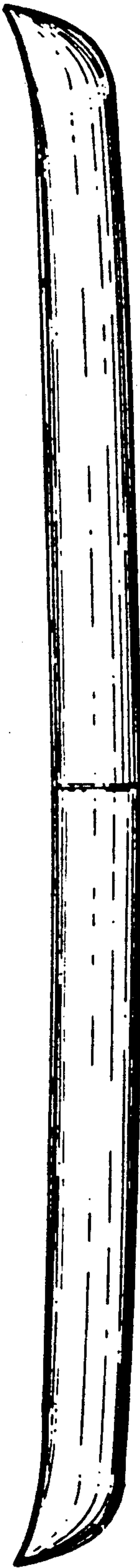
