
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a lavatory showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being the mirror image of the left side shown;


FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2; and,

The fragmentary broken line representations of holes in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for the purpose of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.










