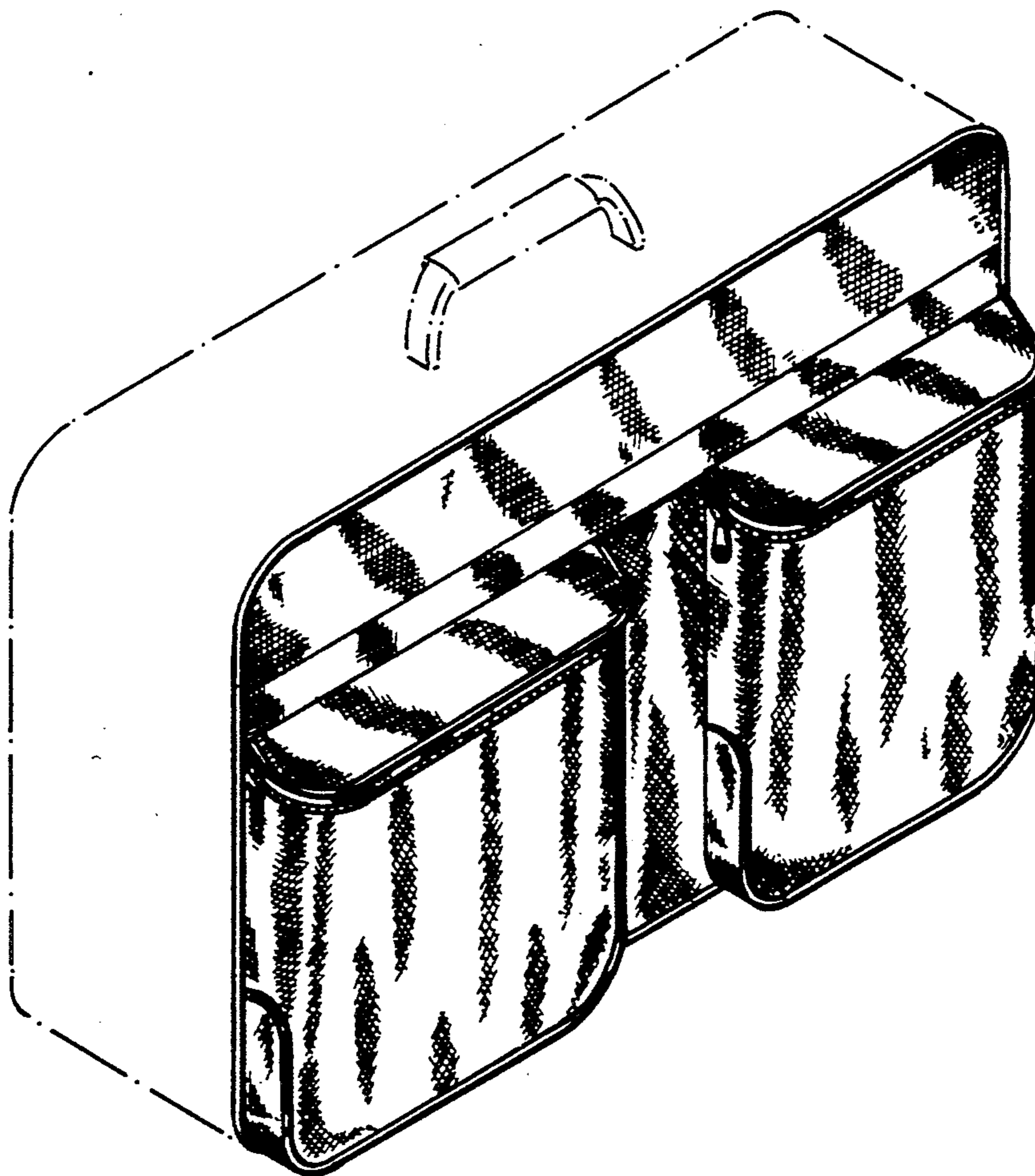

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a side panel of soft luggage, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a side panel of soft luggage showing our new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view thereof.



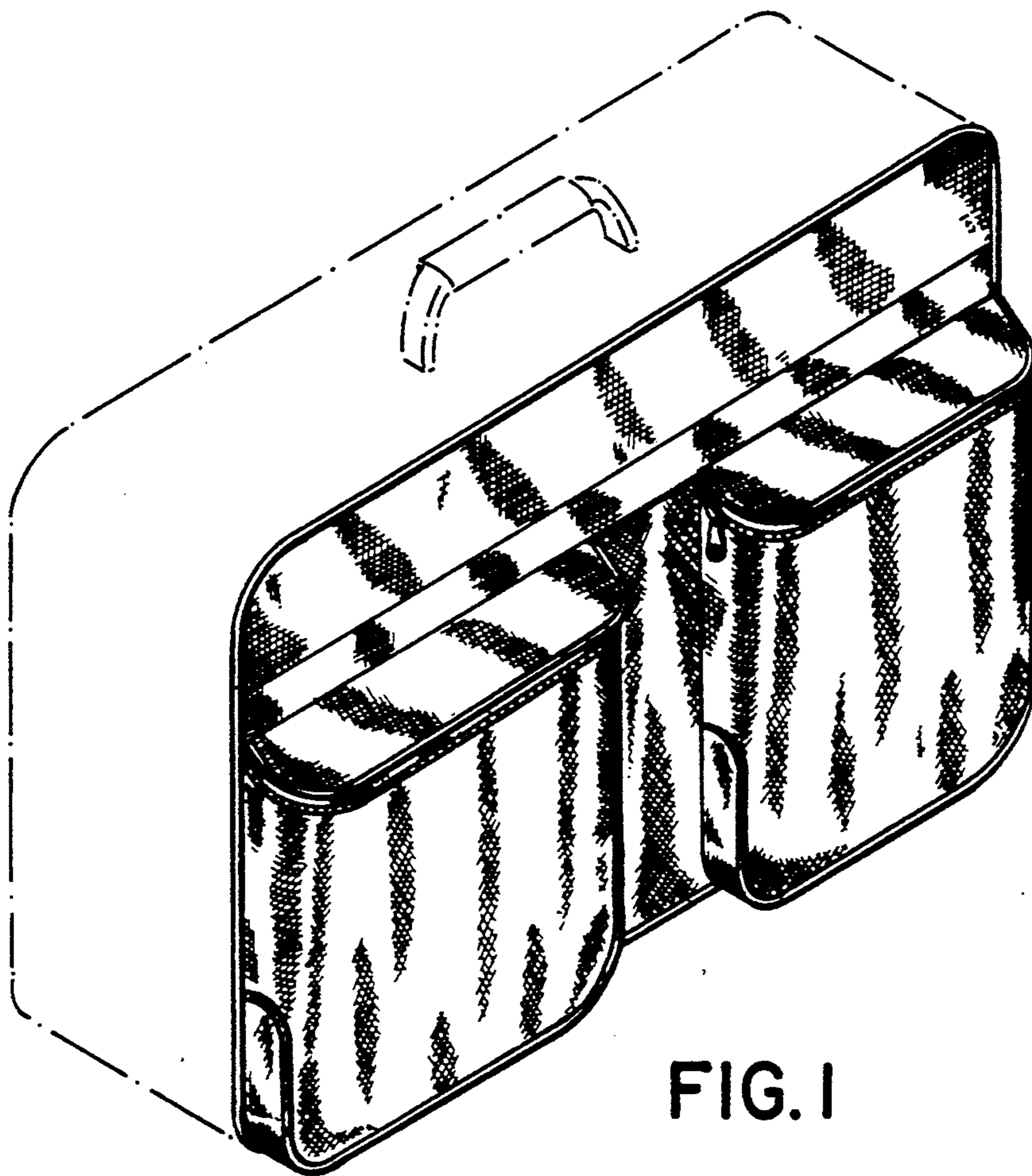

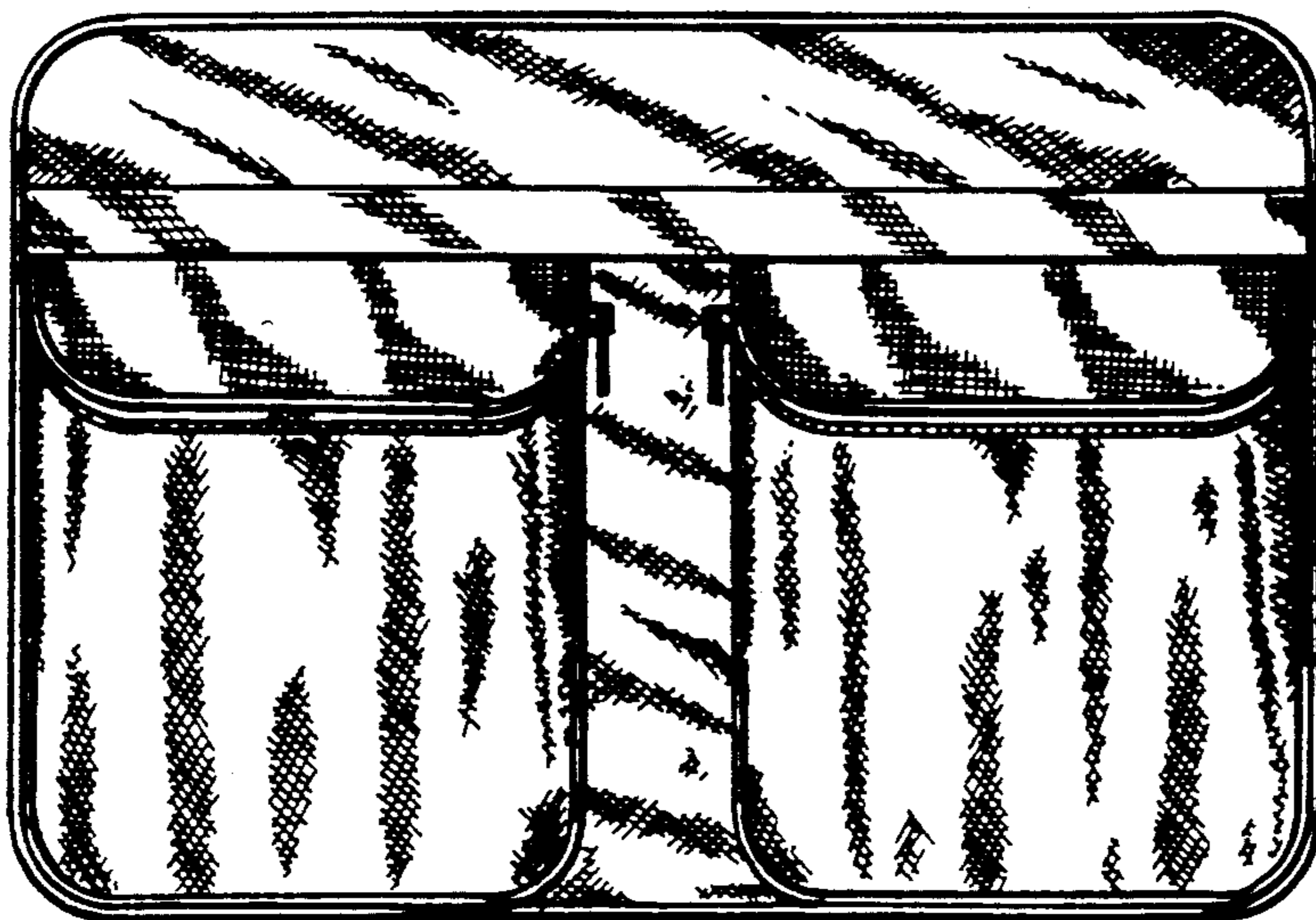

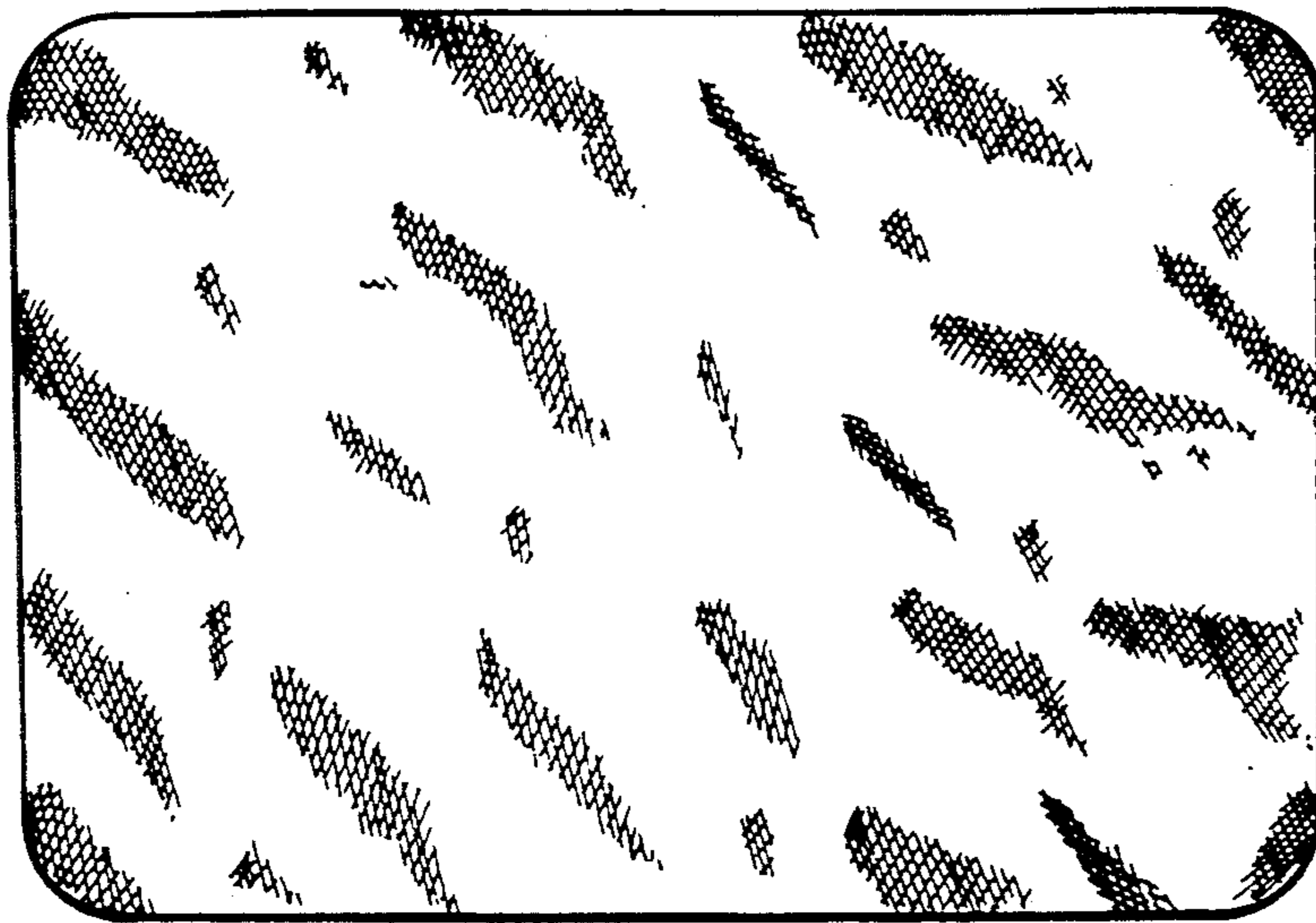
