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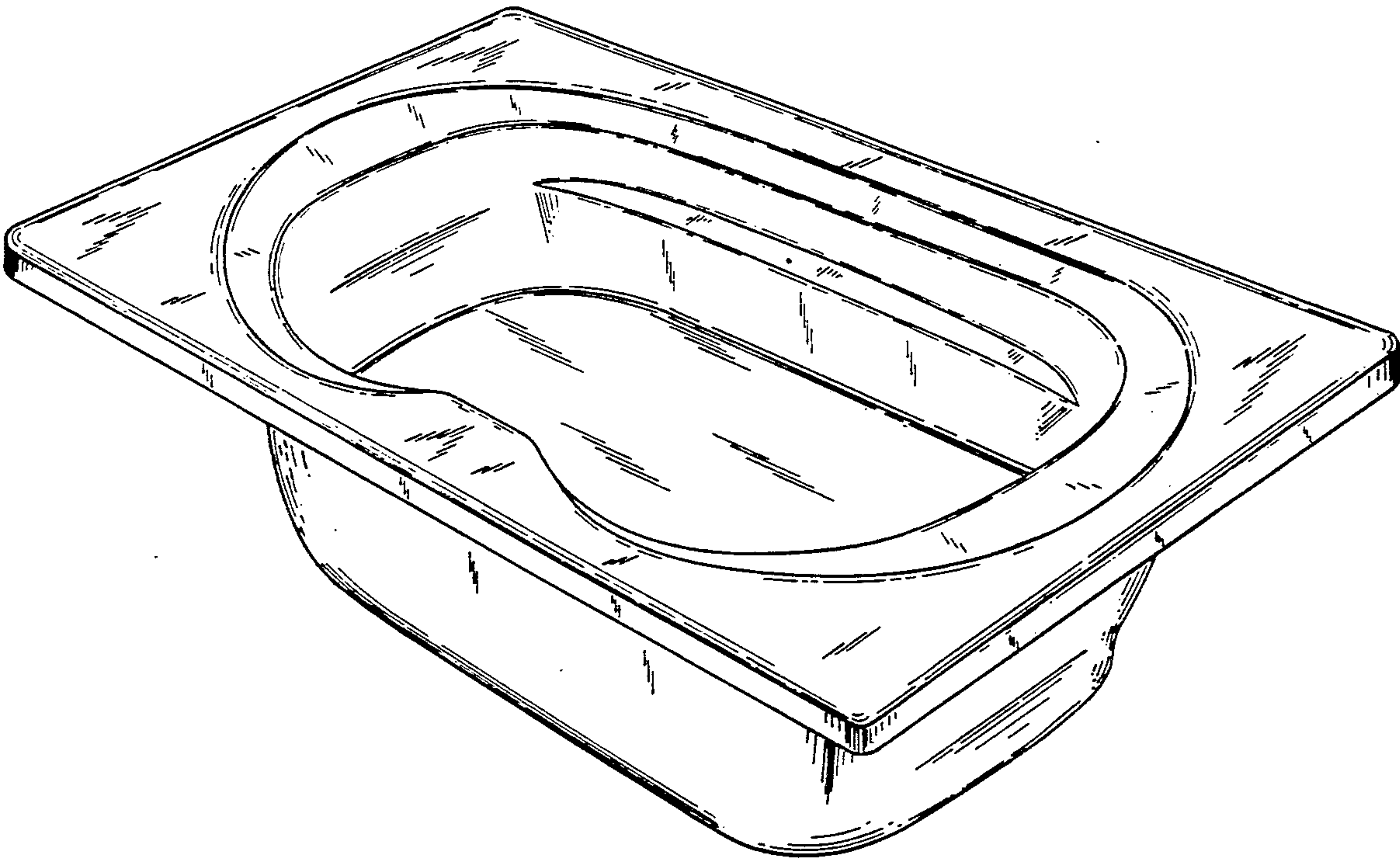

The ornamental design for a bathtub, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right end of a bathtub showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view thereof, the left end being a mirror image of the right end;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 2; and,
FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view taken on line 8—8 of FIG. 2.



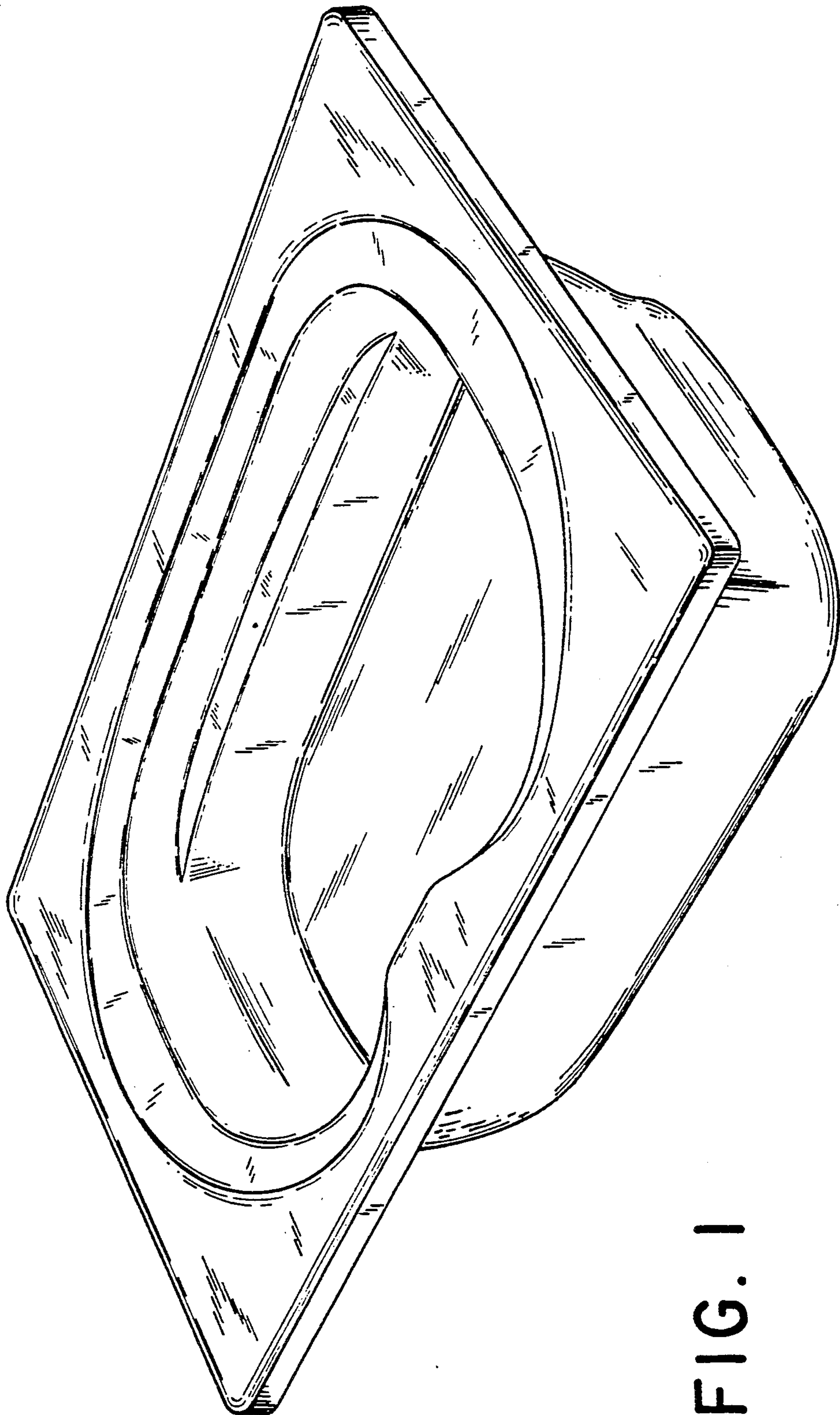
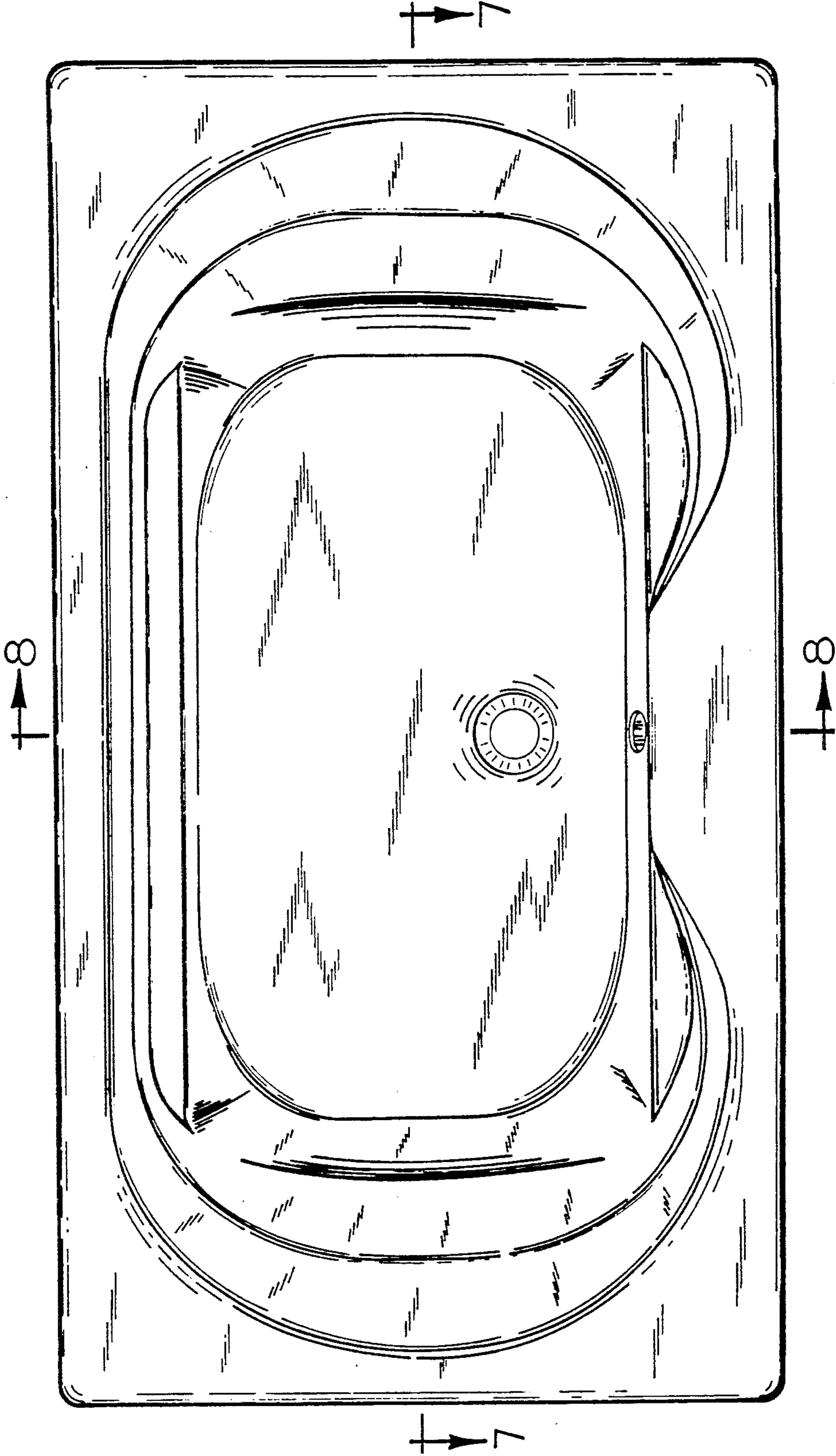

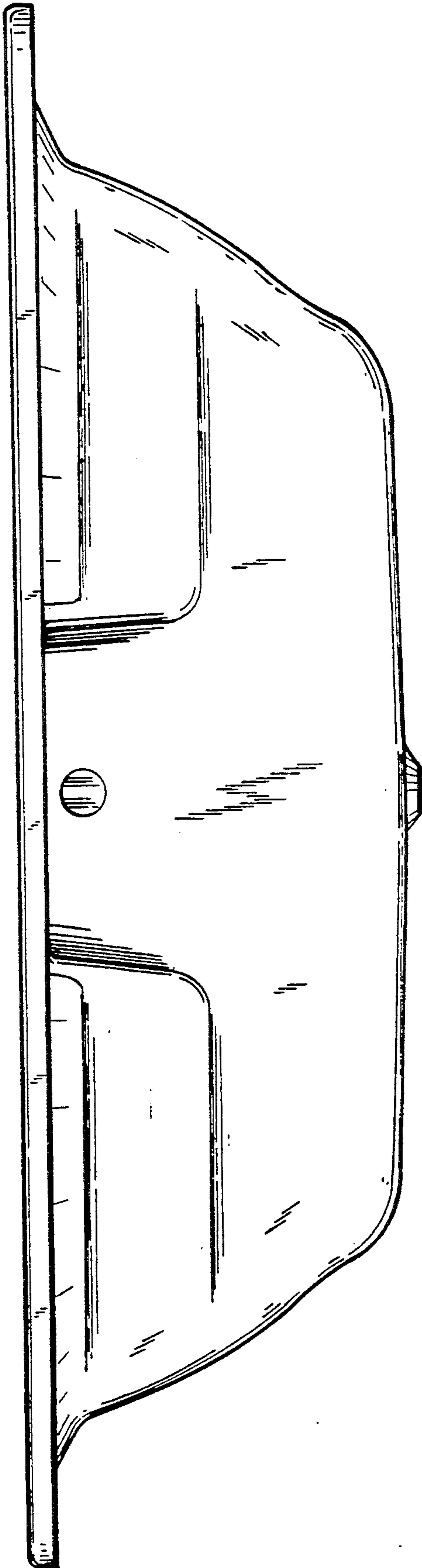

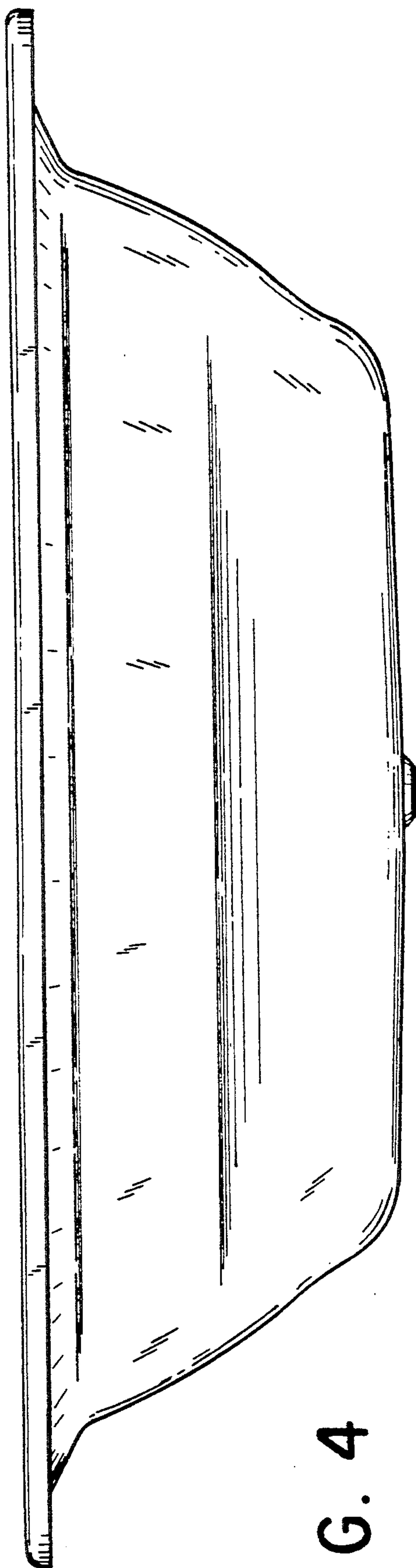

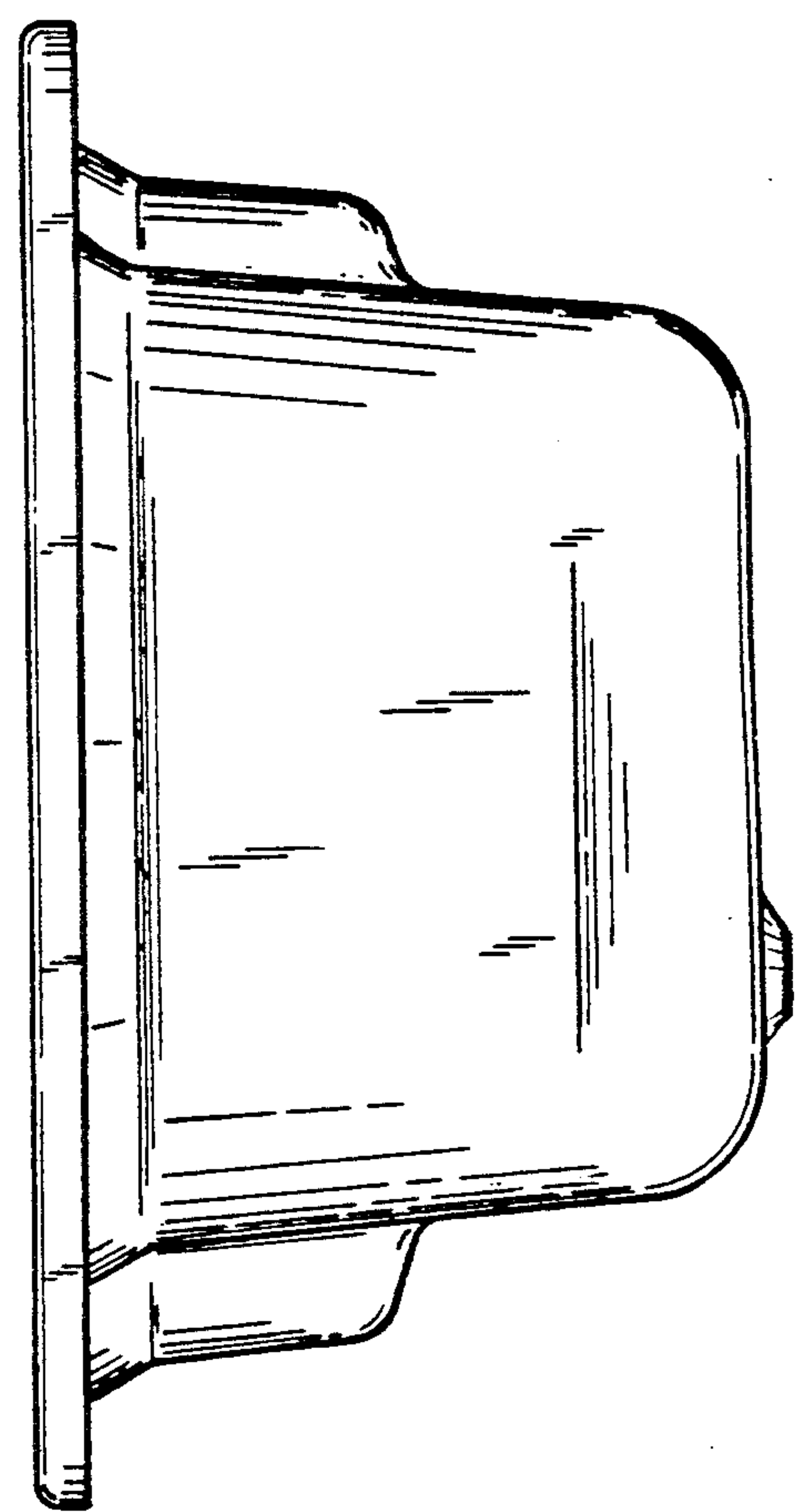

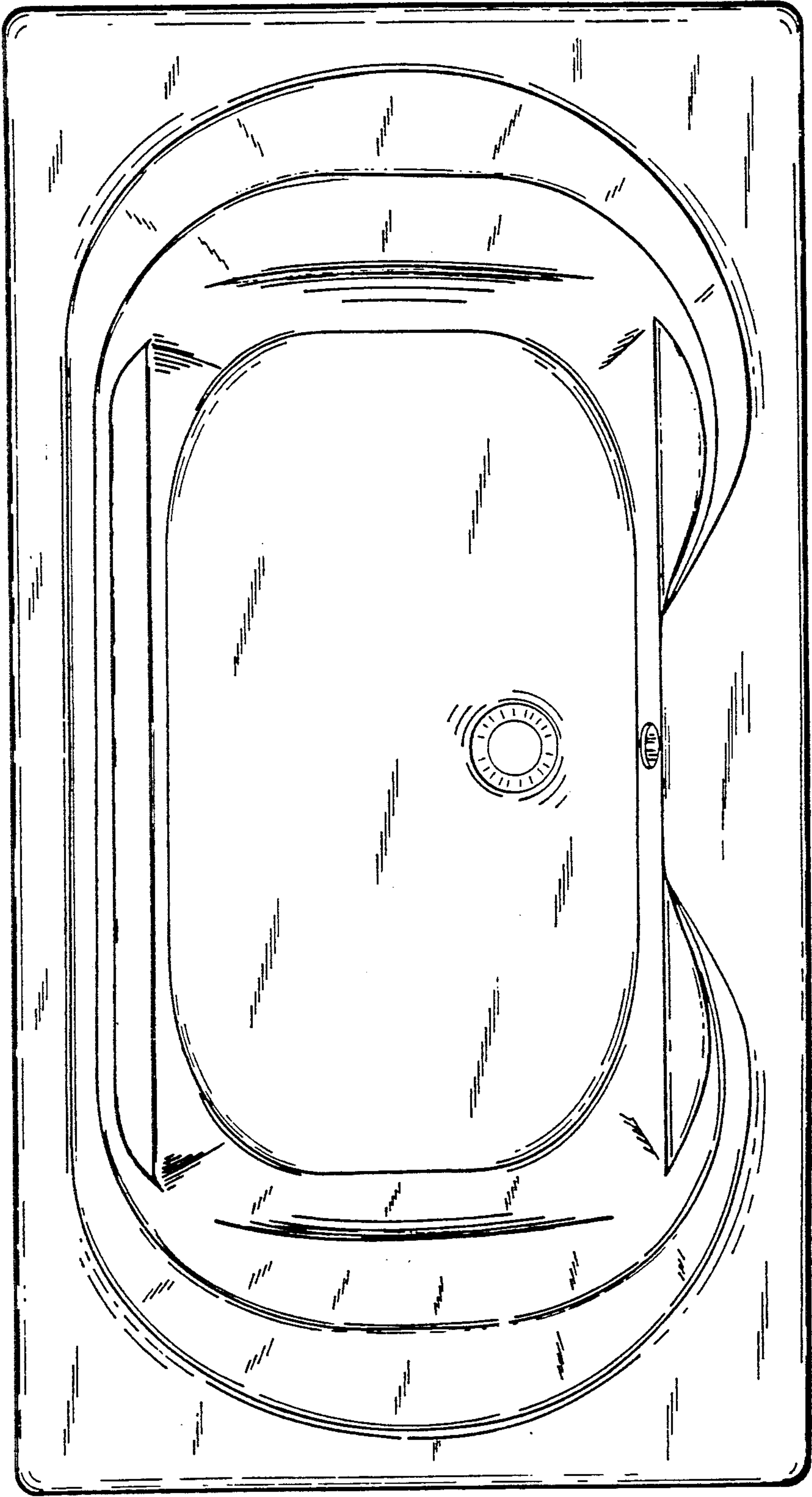

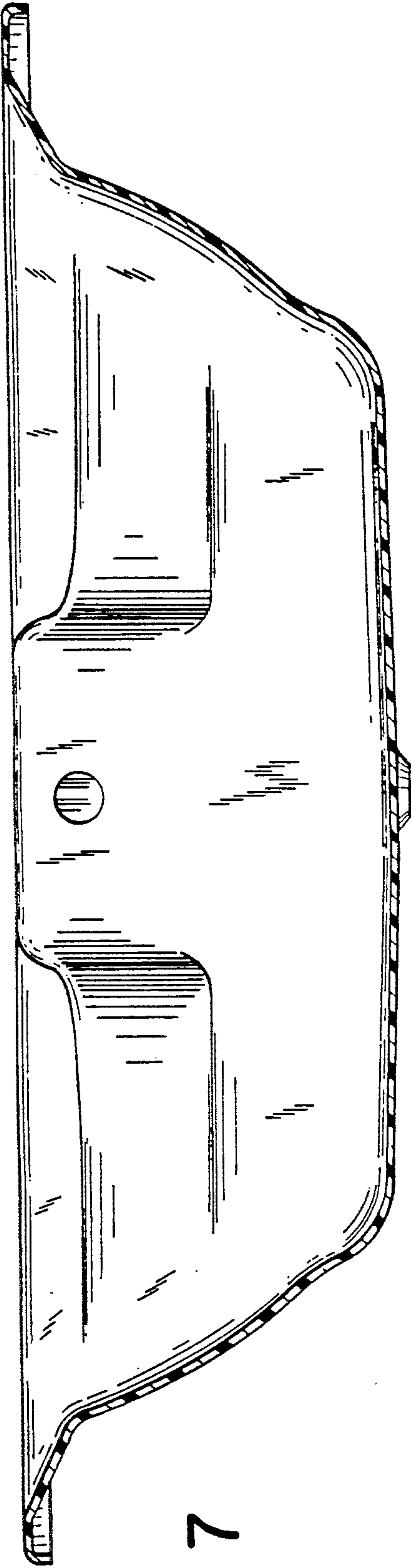

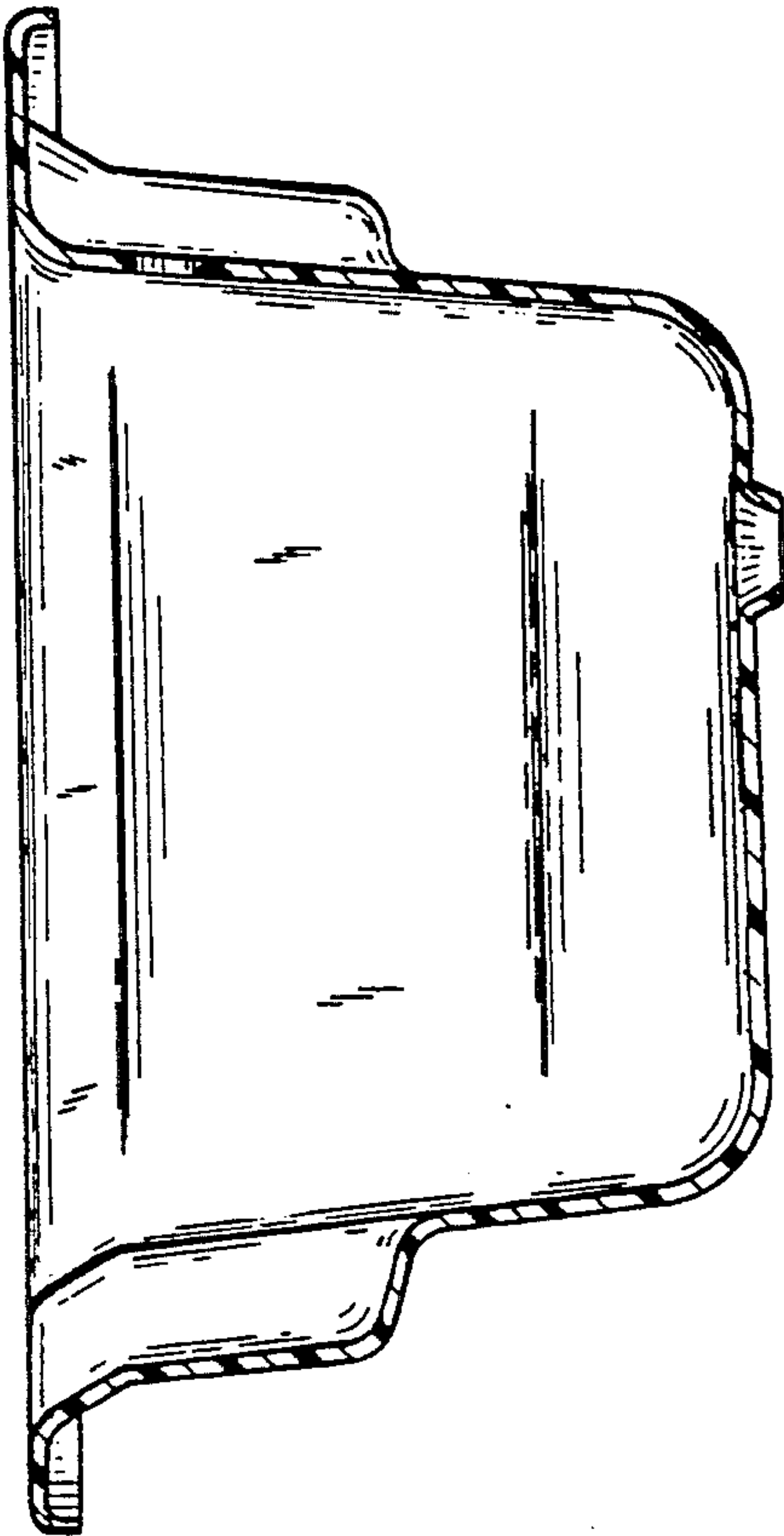
