[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a food package, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a food package showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevation thereof, the right side elevation being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof and of the fourth embodiment;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof and of the second, third, fourth and fifth embodiments;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevation thereof and of the fourth embodiment;  
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 8 is a front elevation of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 9 is a rear elevation of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 12 is a front elevation of FIG. 11;  
 FIG. 13 is a rear elevation of FIG. 11 and of the fifth embodiment;  
 FIG. 14 is a top plan view of FIG. 11 and of the fifth embodiment;  
 FIG. 15 is a front elevation of a fourth embodiment of FIG. 1; and,  
 FIG. 16 is a front elevation of a fifth embodiment of FIG. 1.

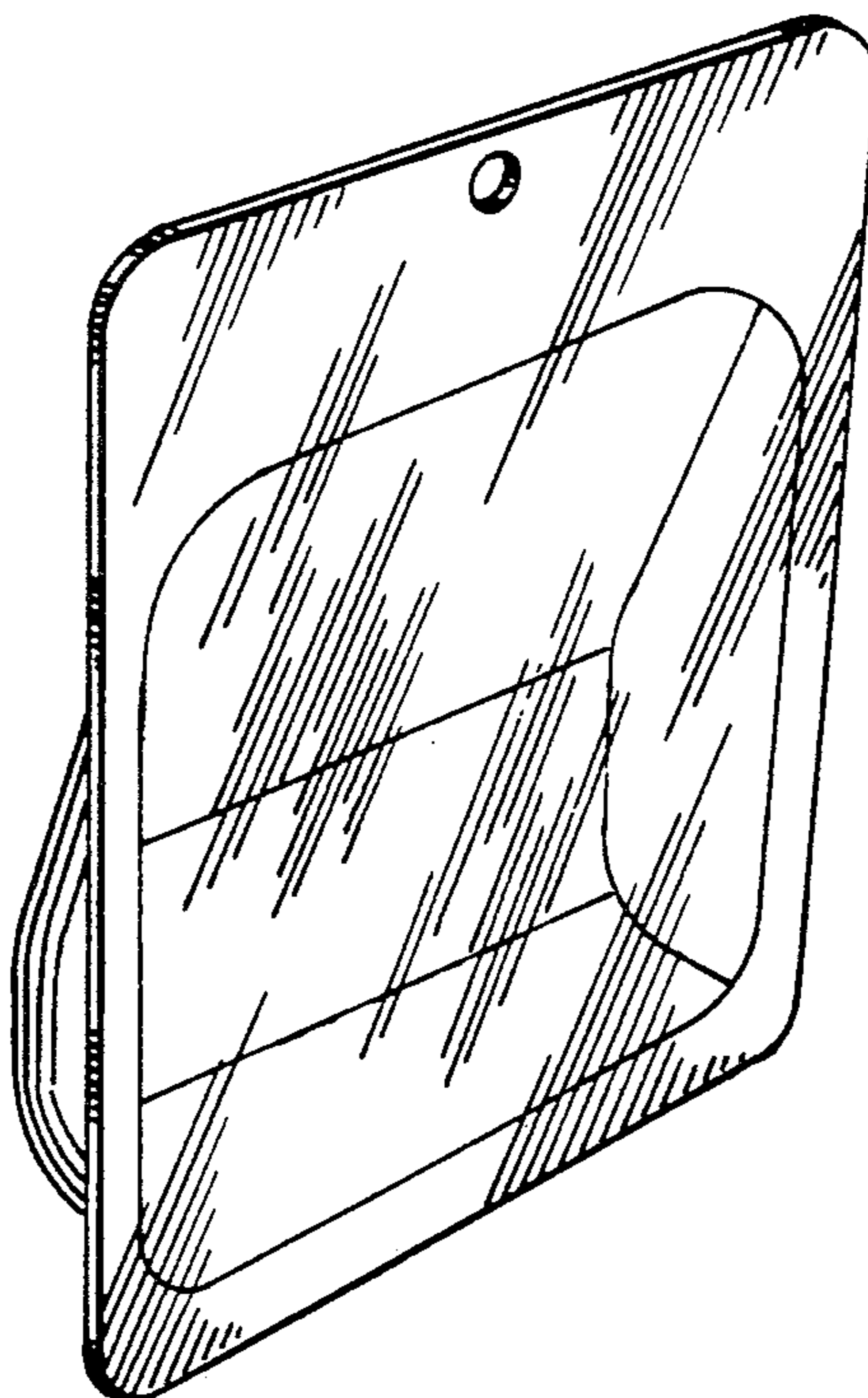

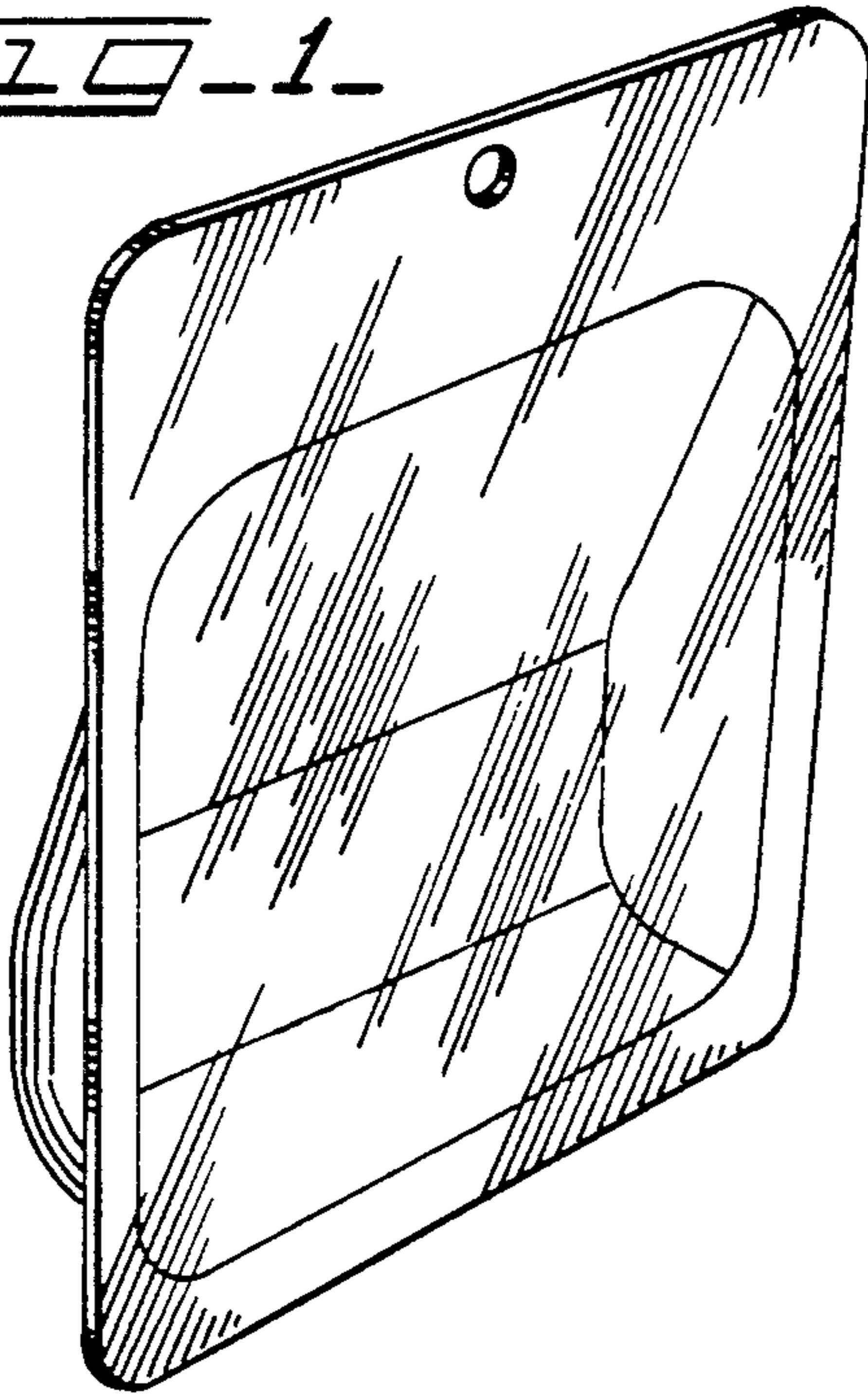

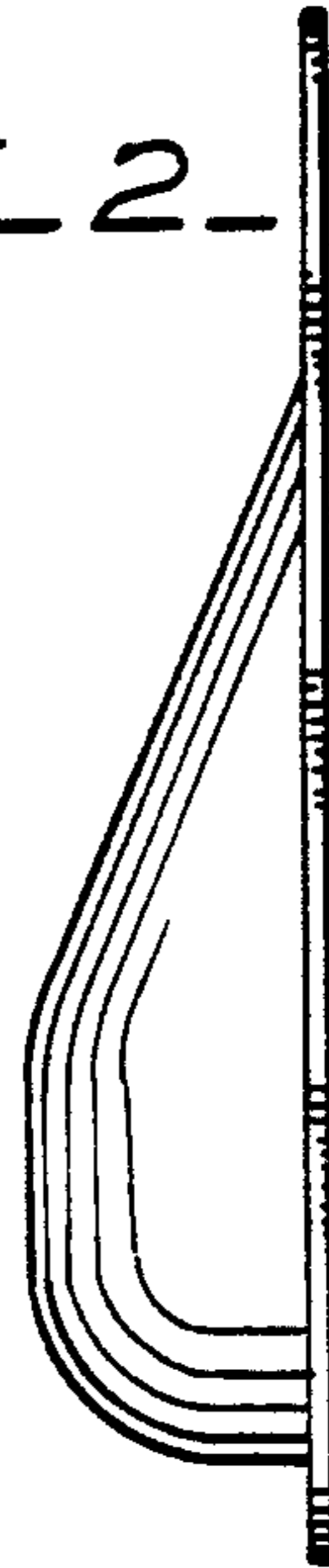

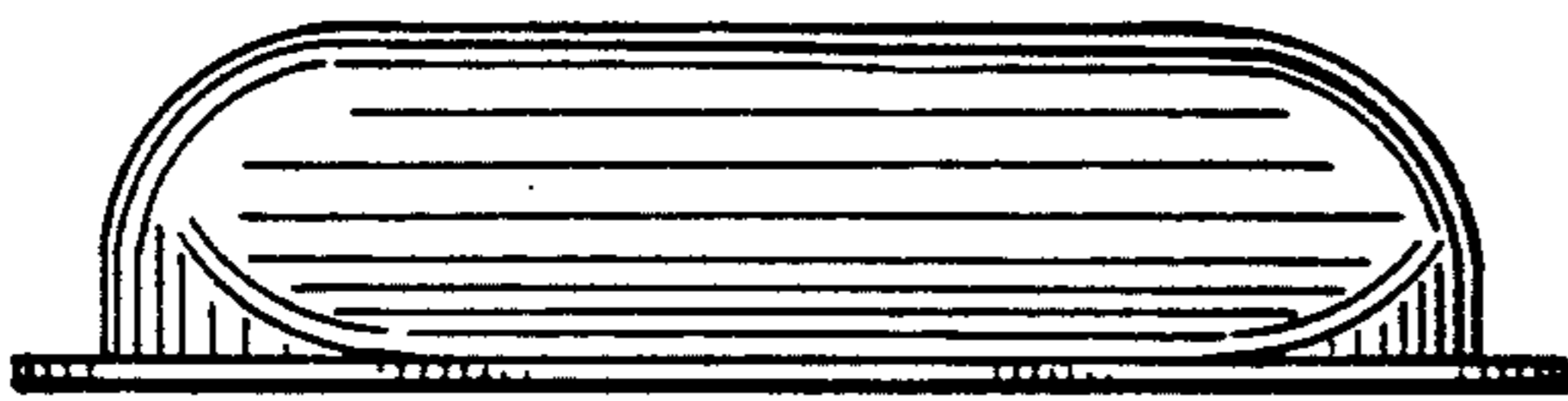

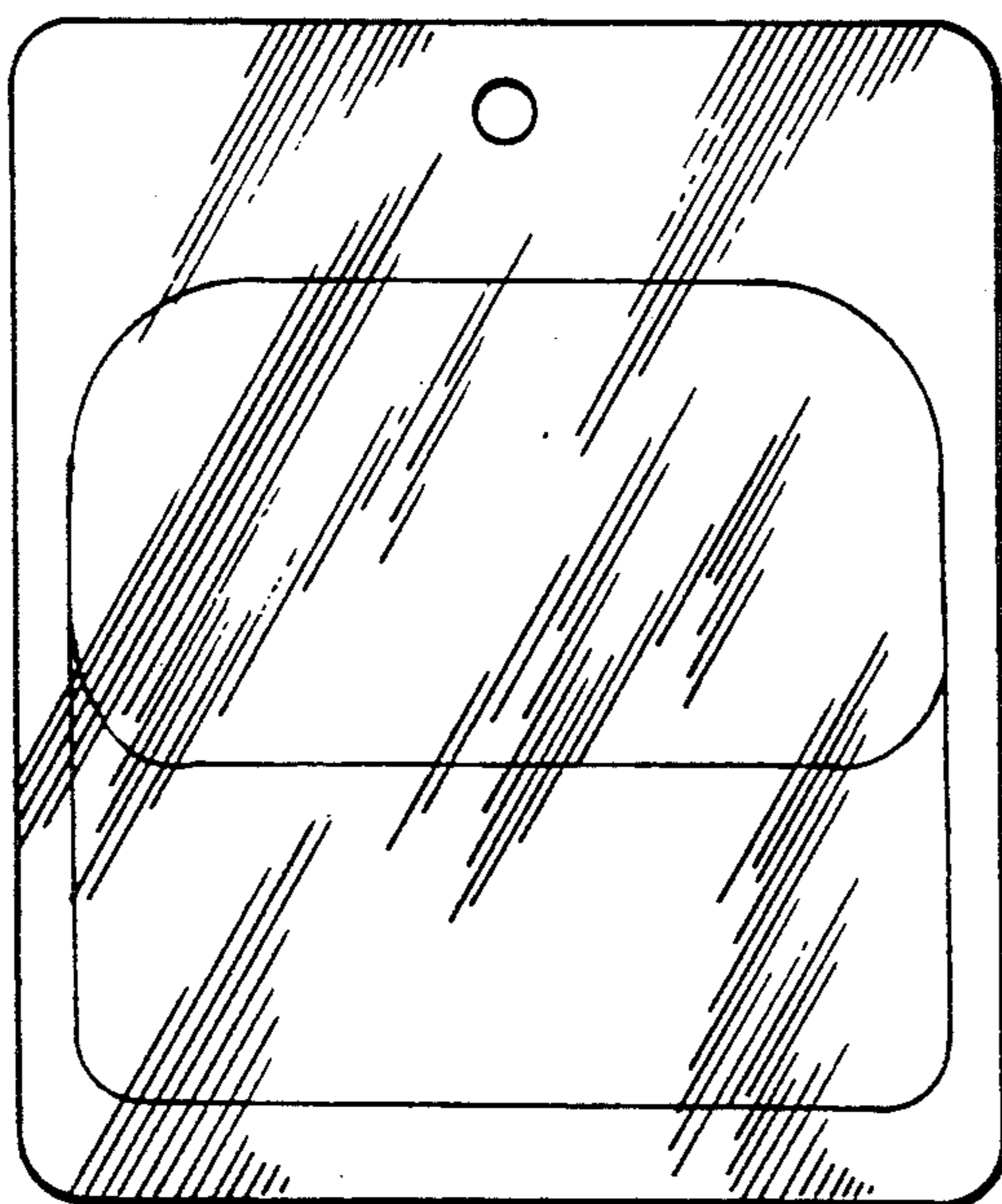

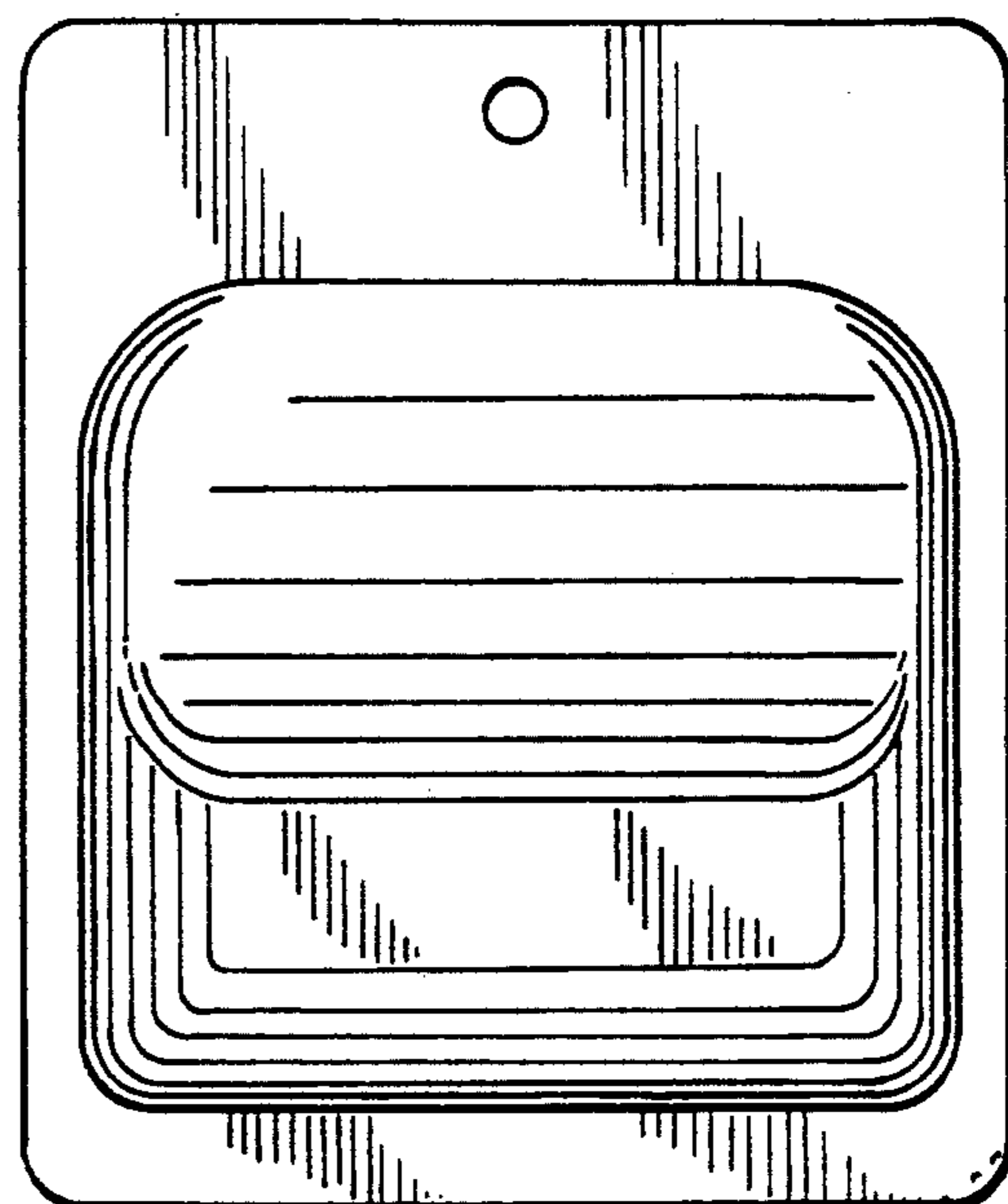

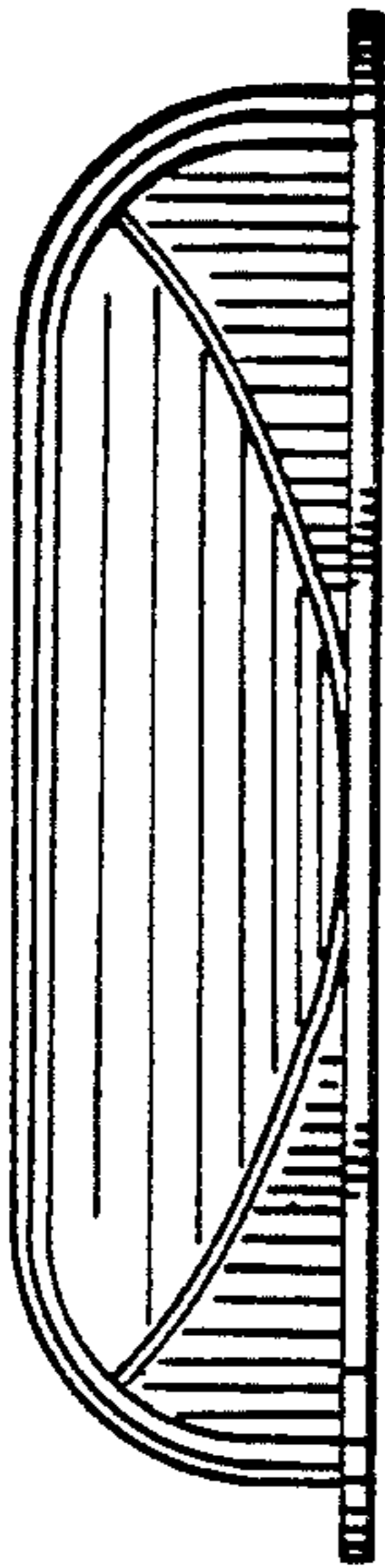

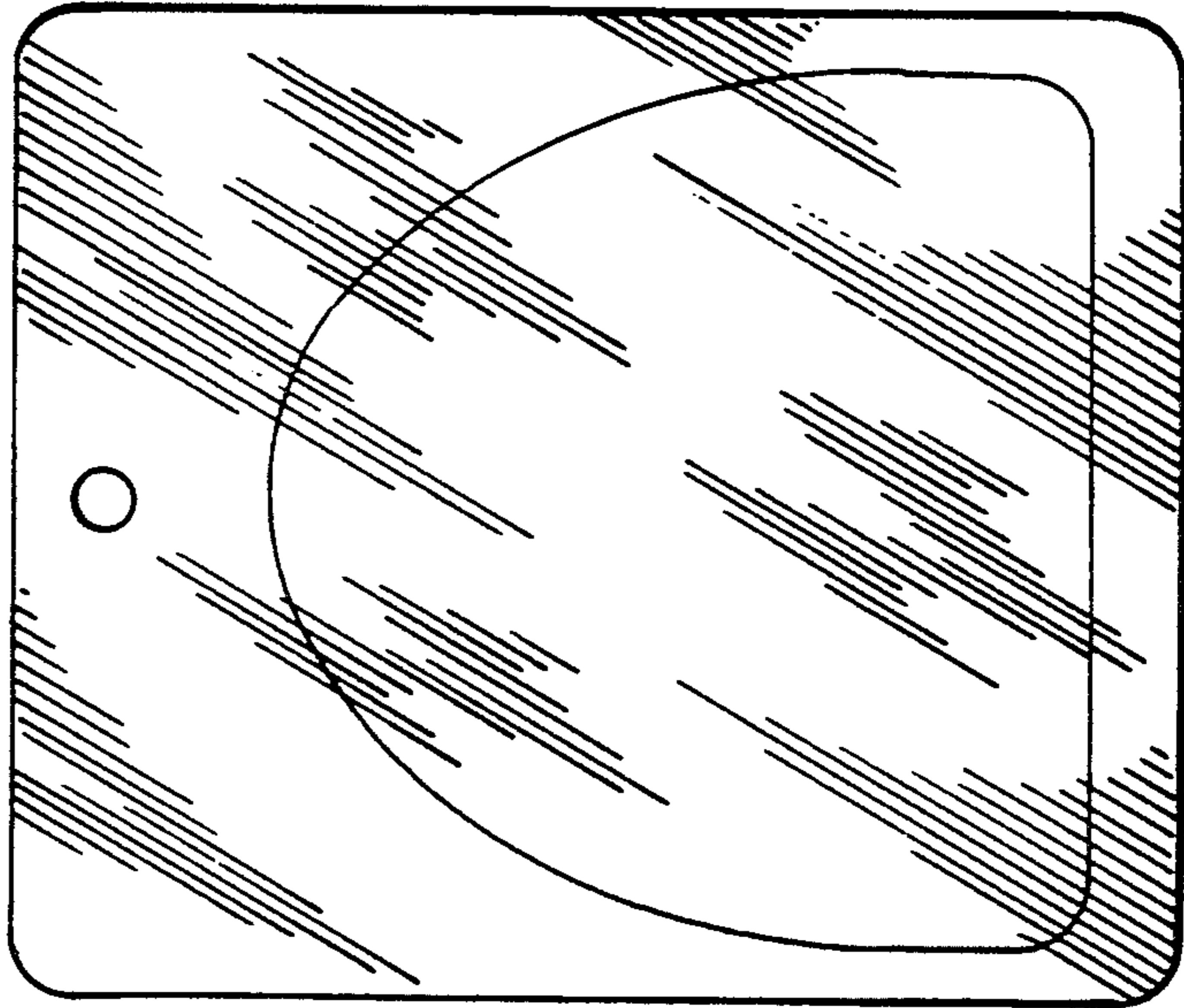

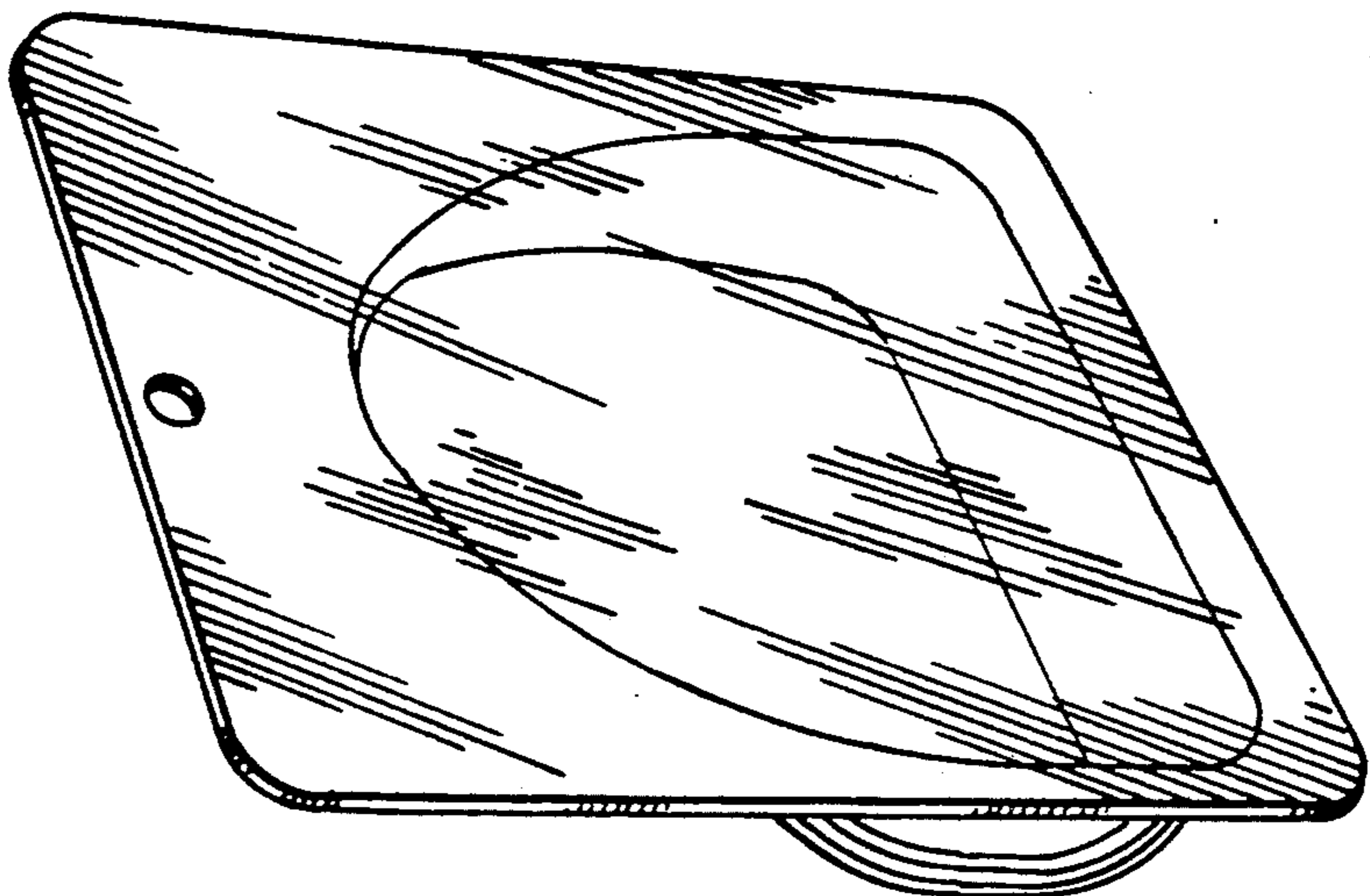

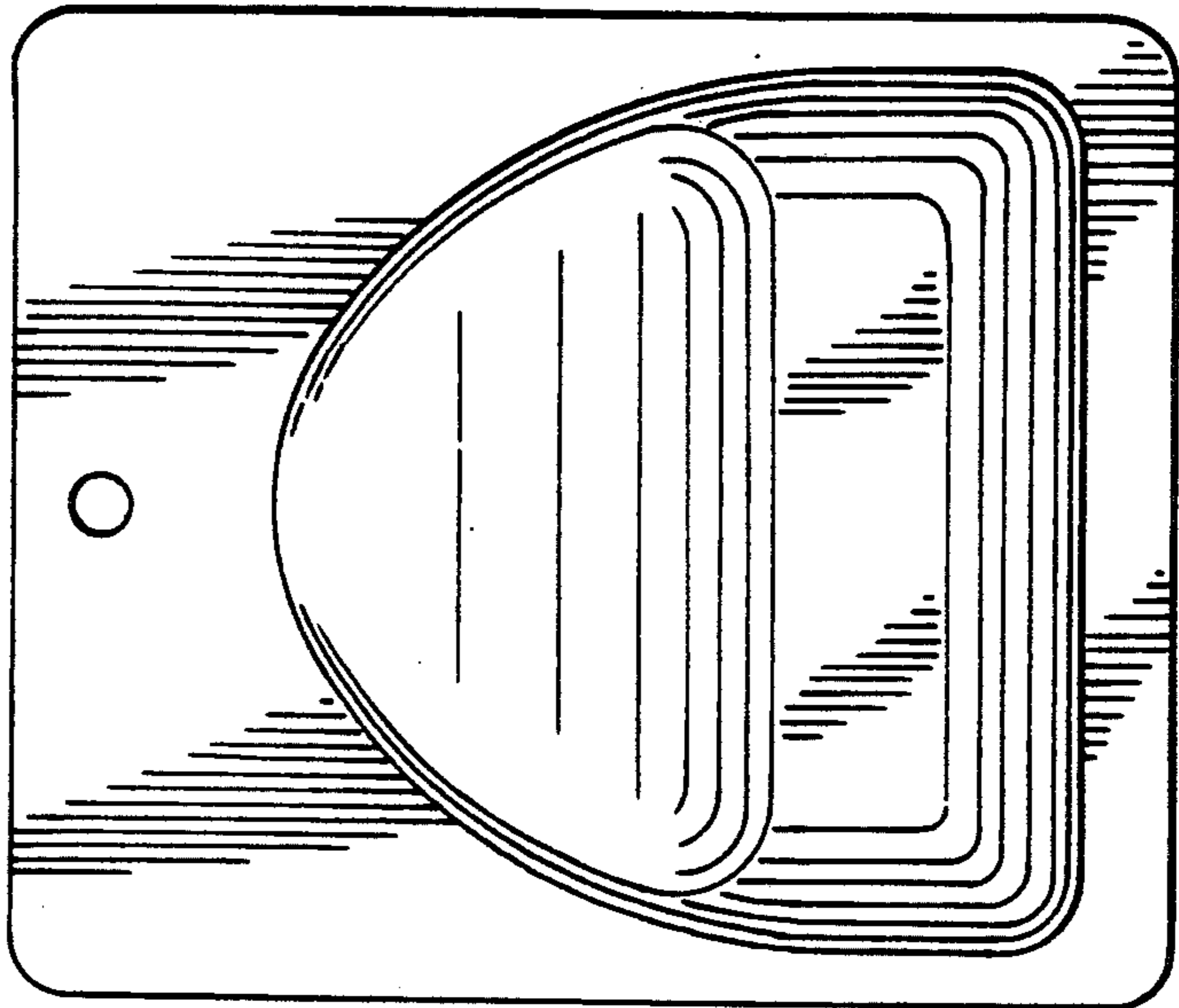

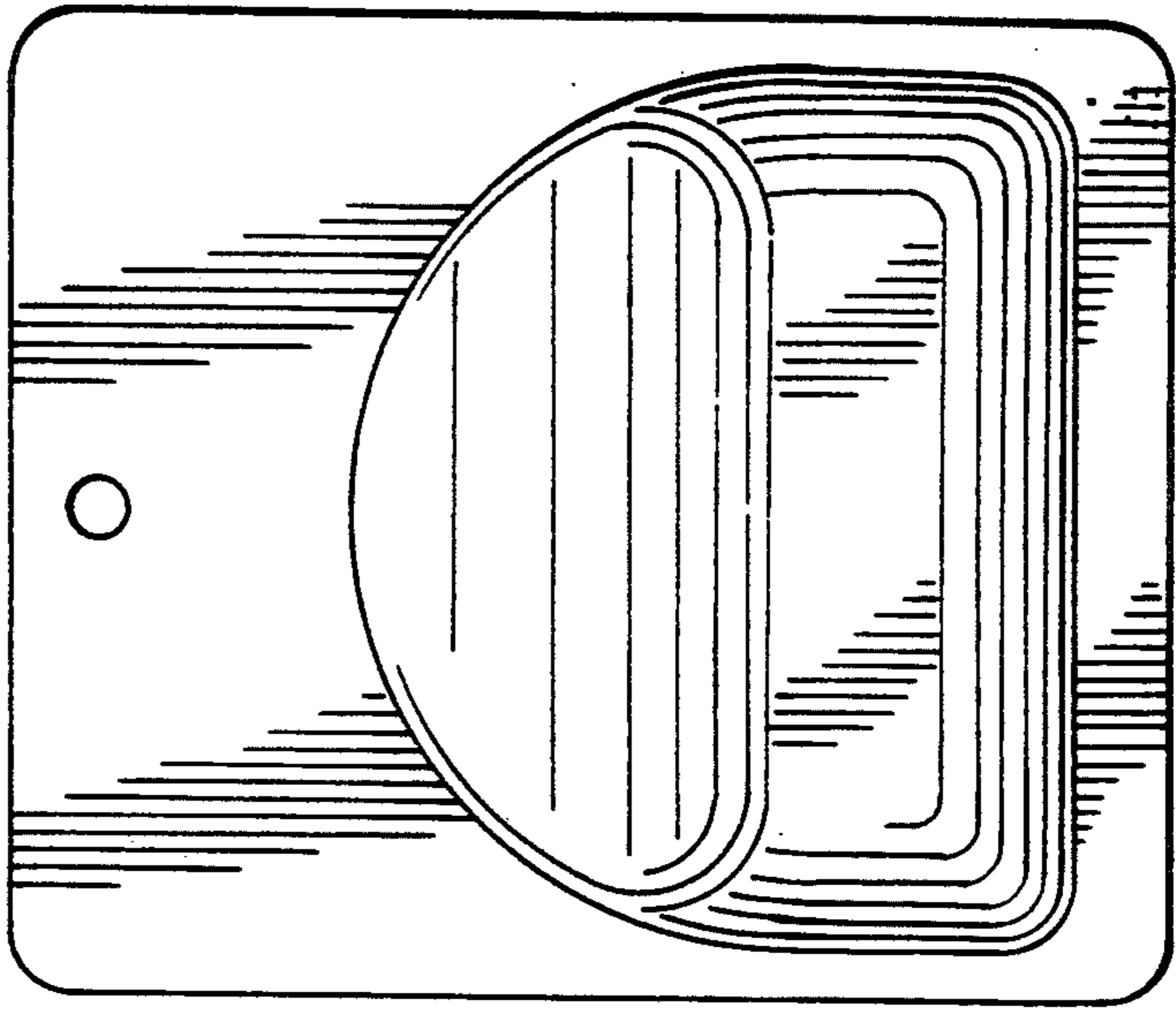

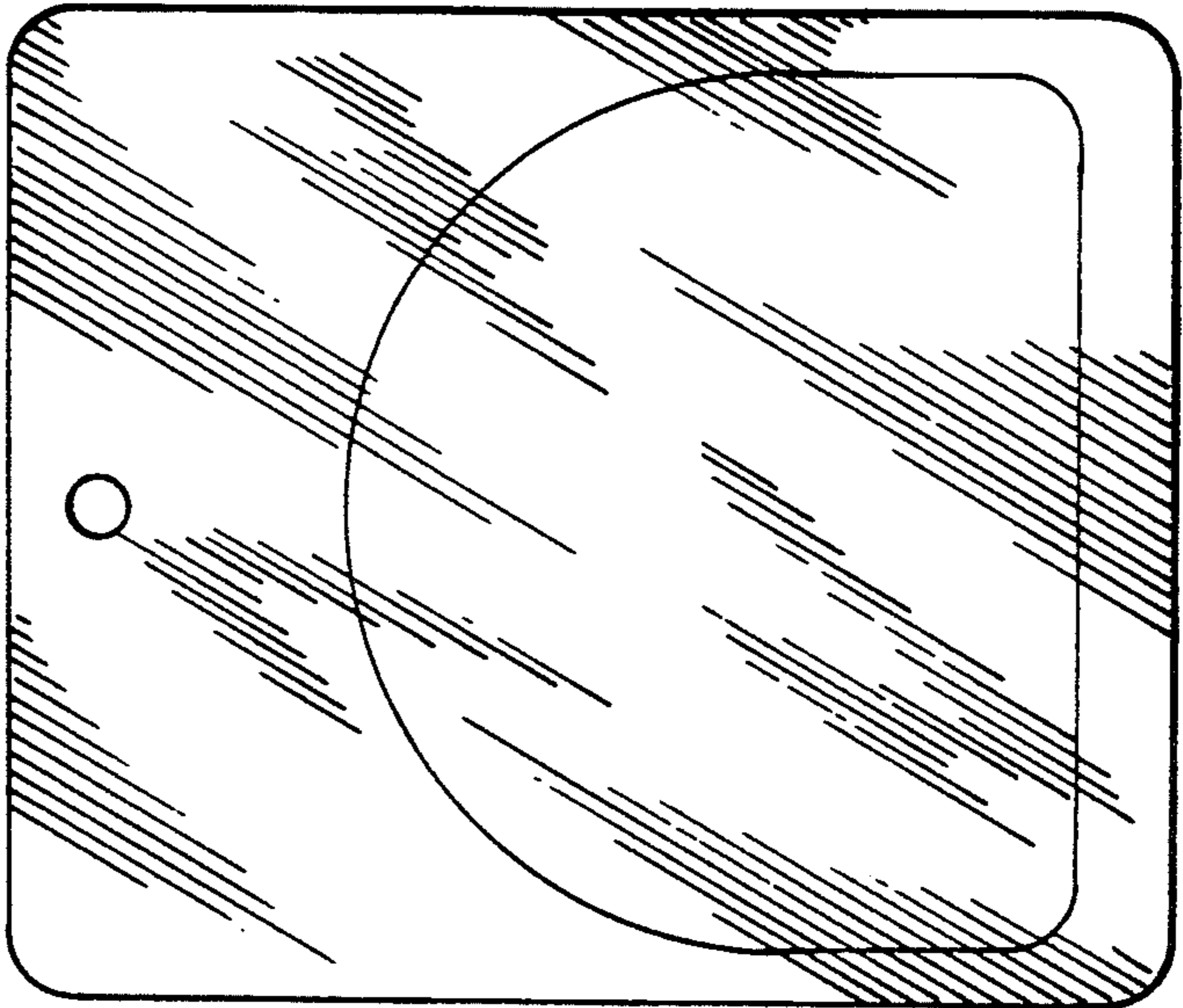

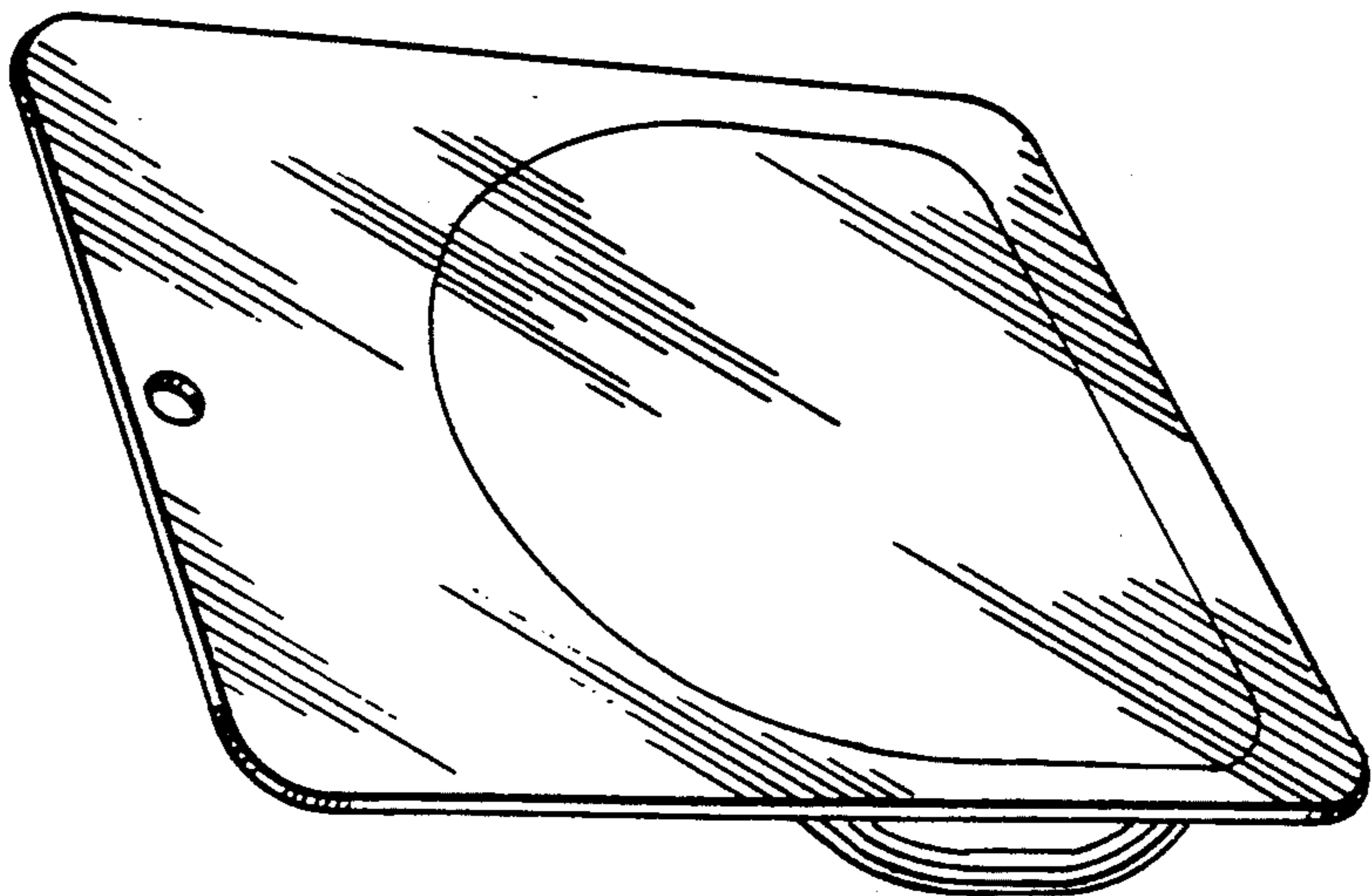

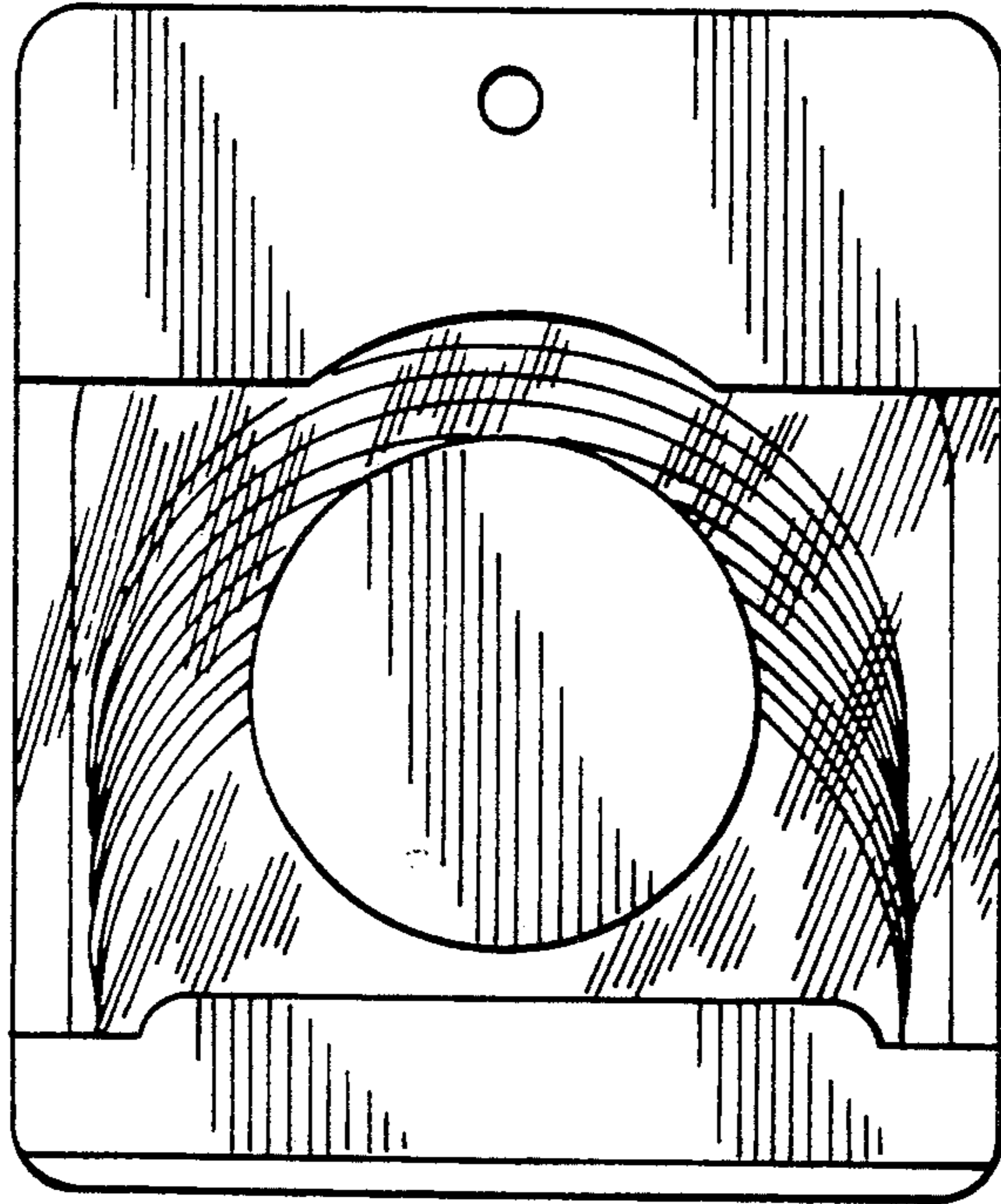
