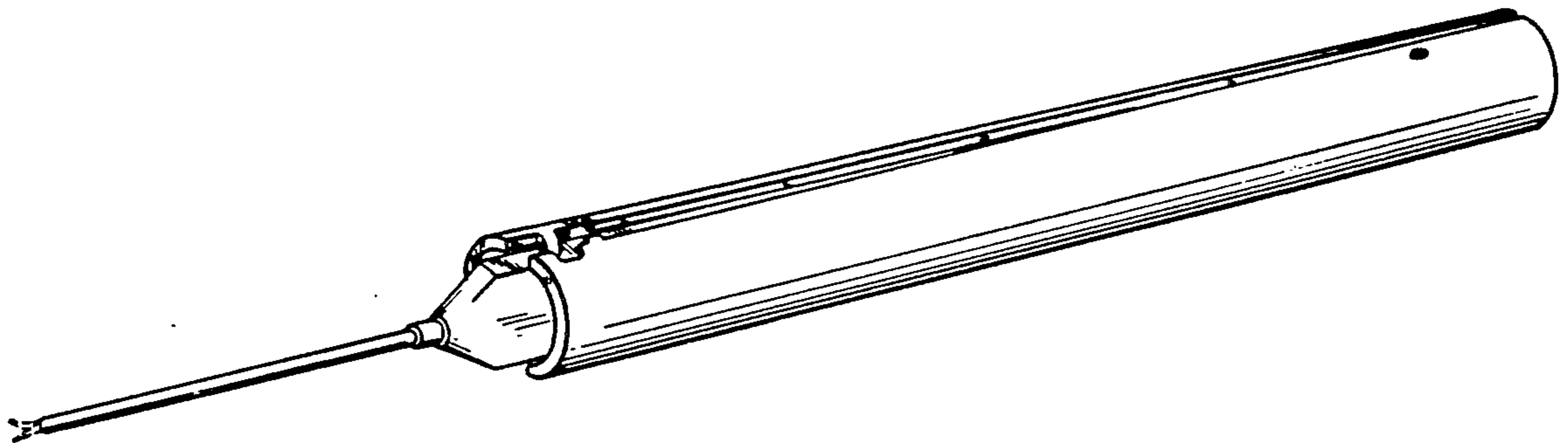

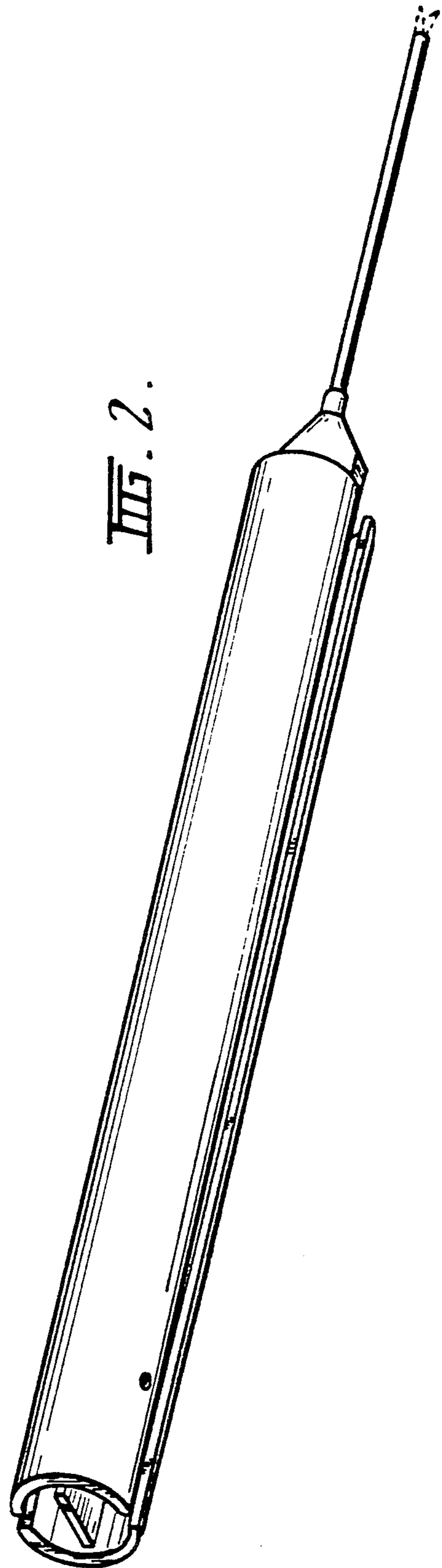
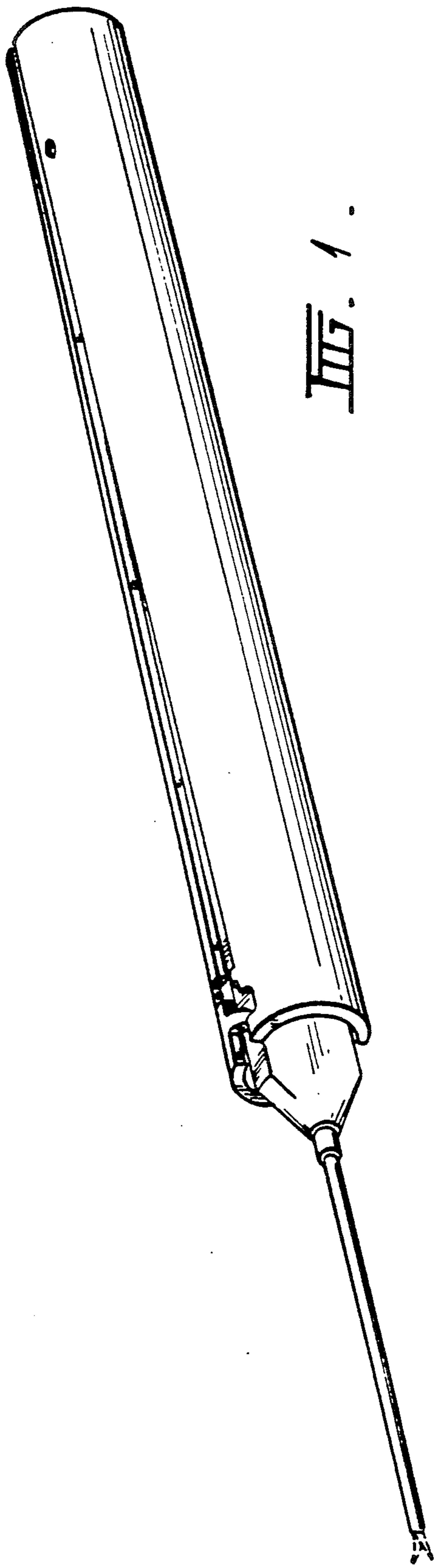

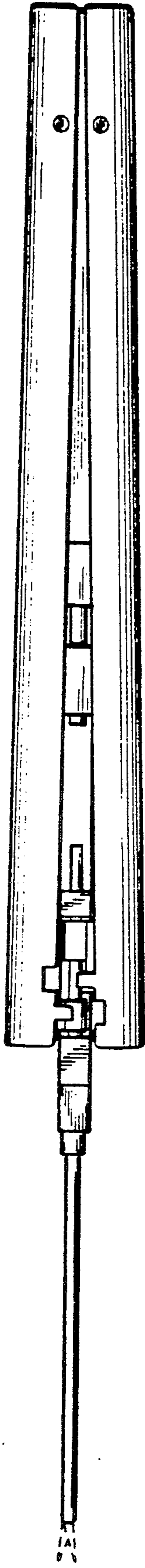
The ornamental design for a handle assembly for micro-surgical instruments, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

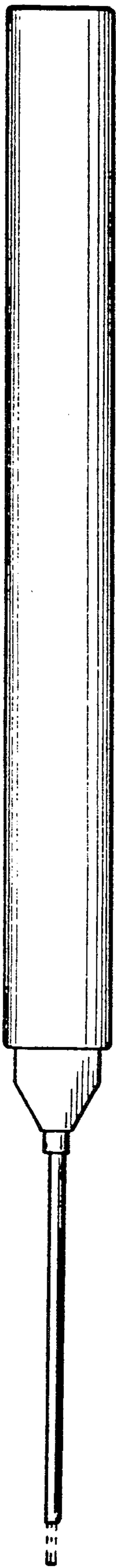
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a handle assembly for micro-surgical instruments showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof. The broken lines showing the scissors element in FIGS. 1 through 6 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



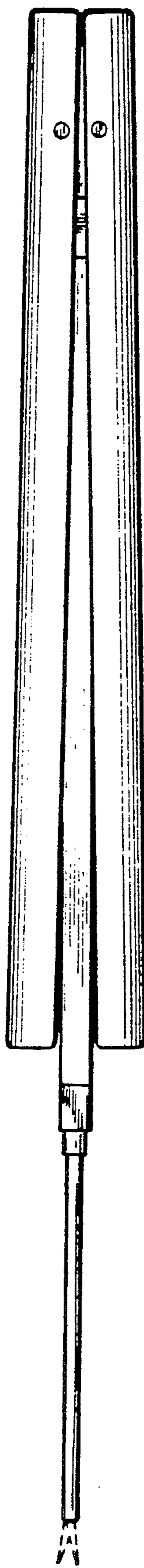




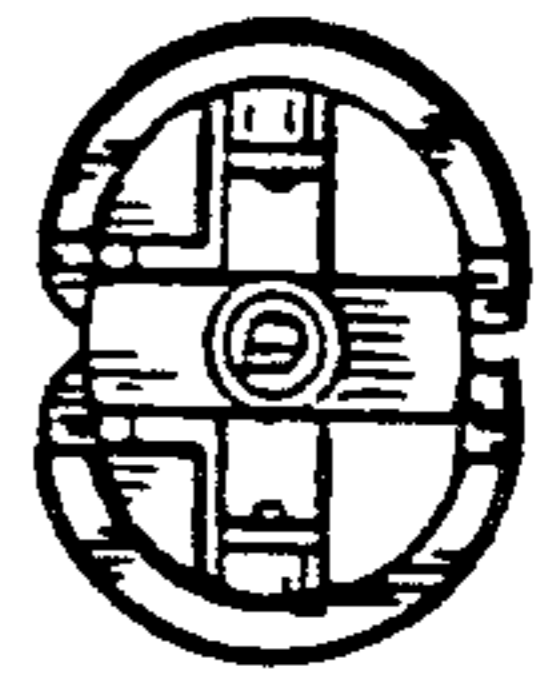

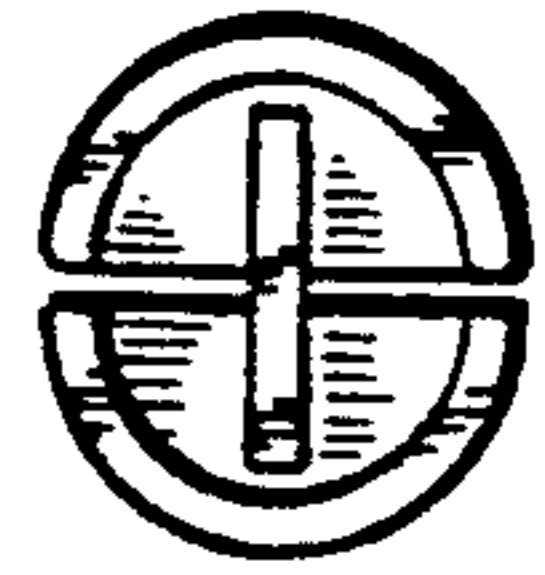
