The ornamental design for an illuminated sculpture, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an illuminated sculpture showing my new design, the right side elevational view being identical;

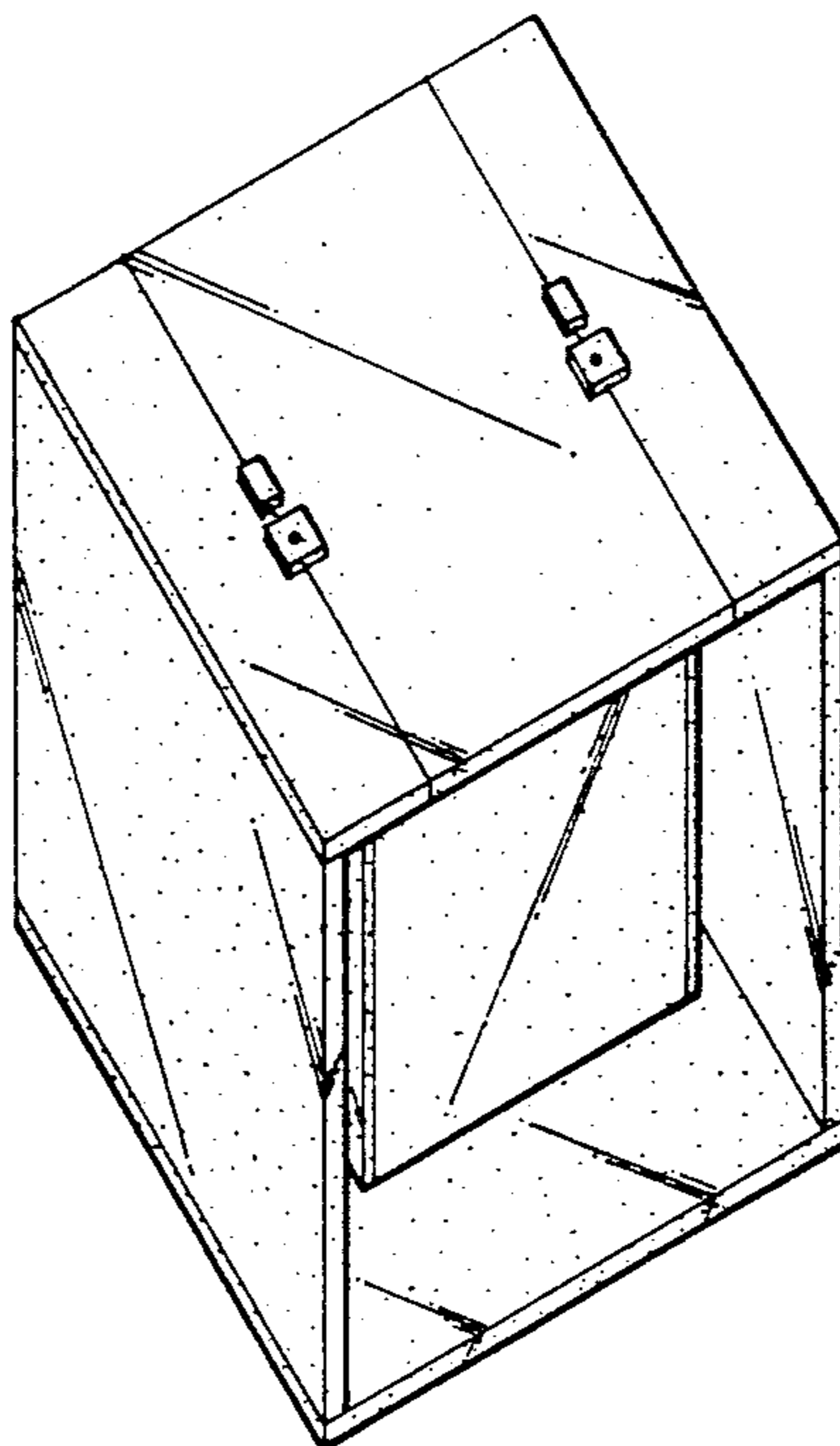
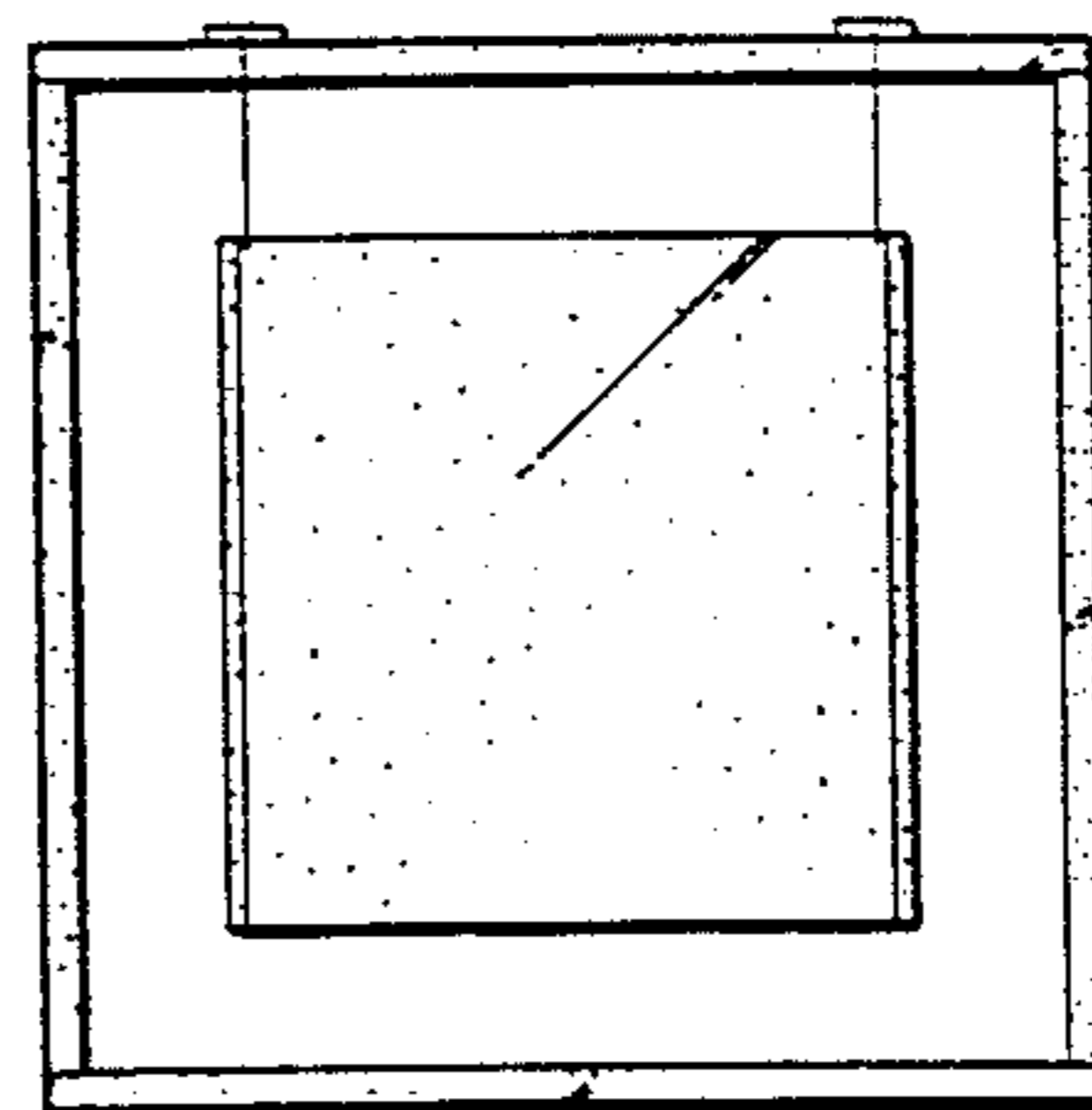
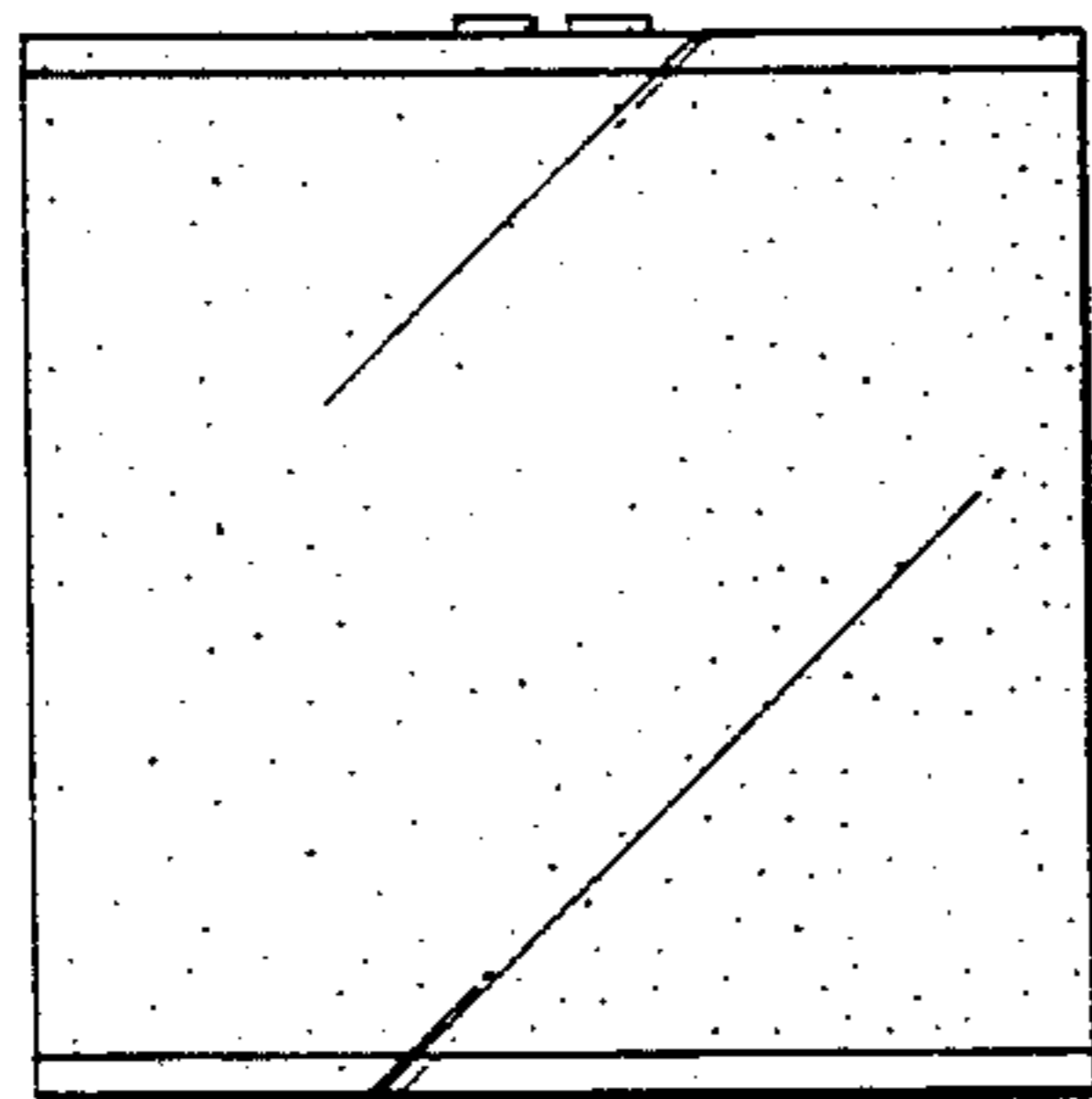
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being identical;

The stippled surfaces of the design are translucent.



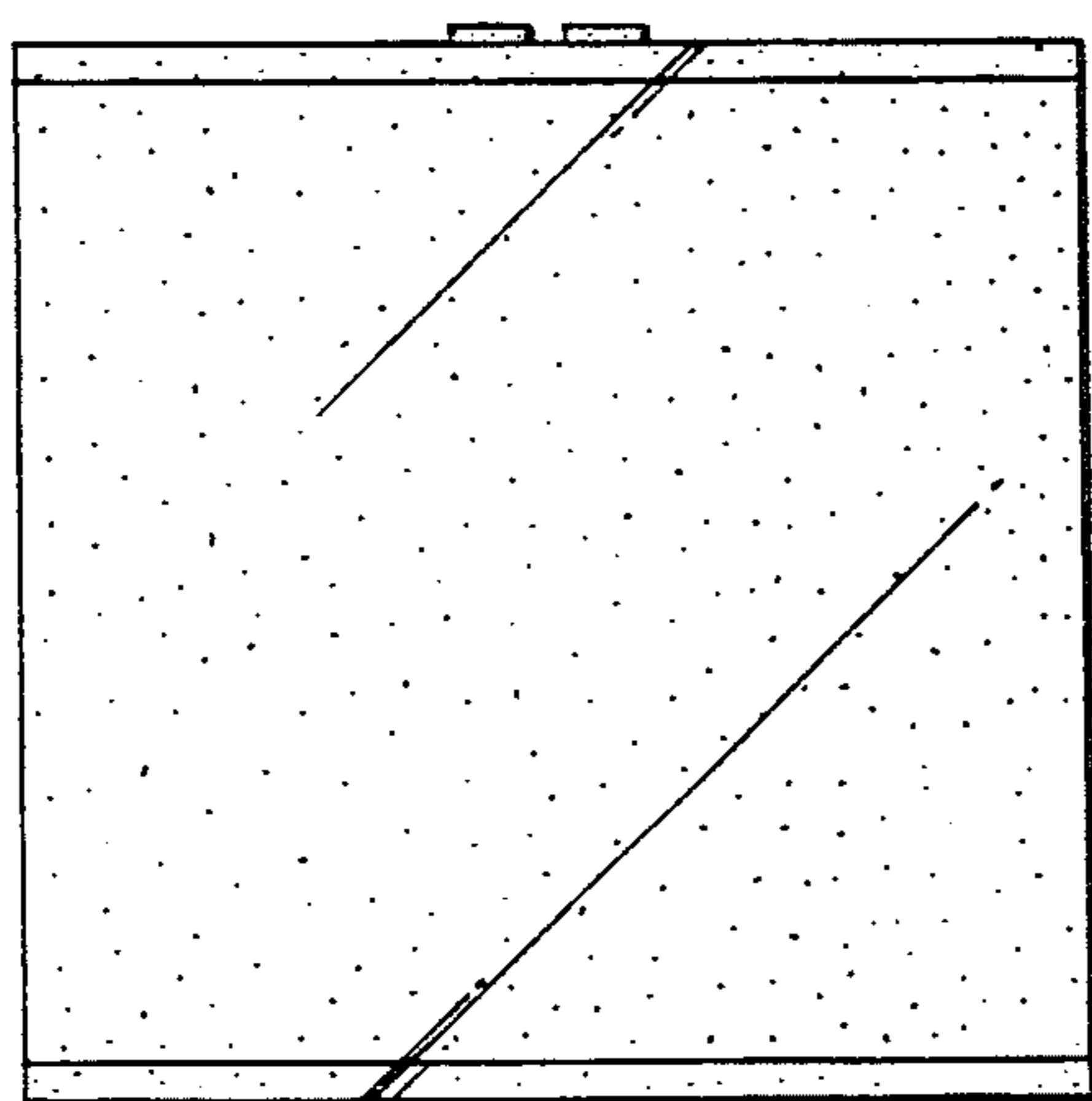

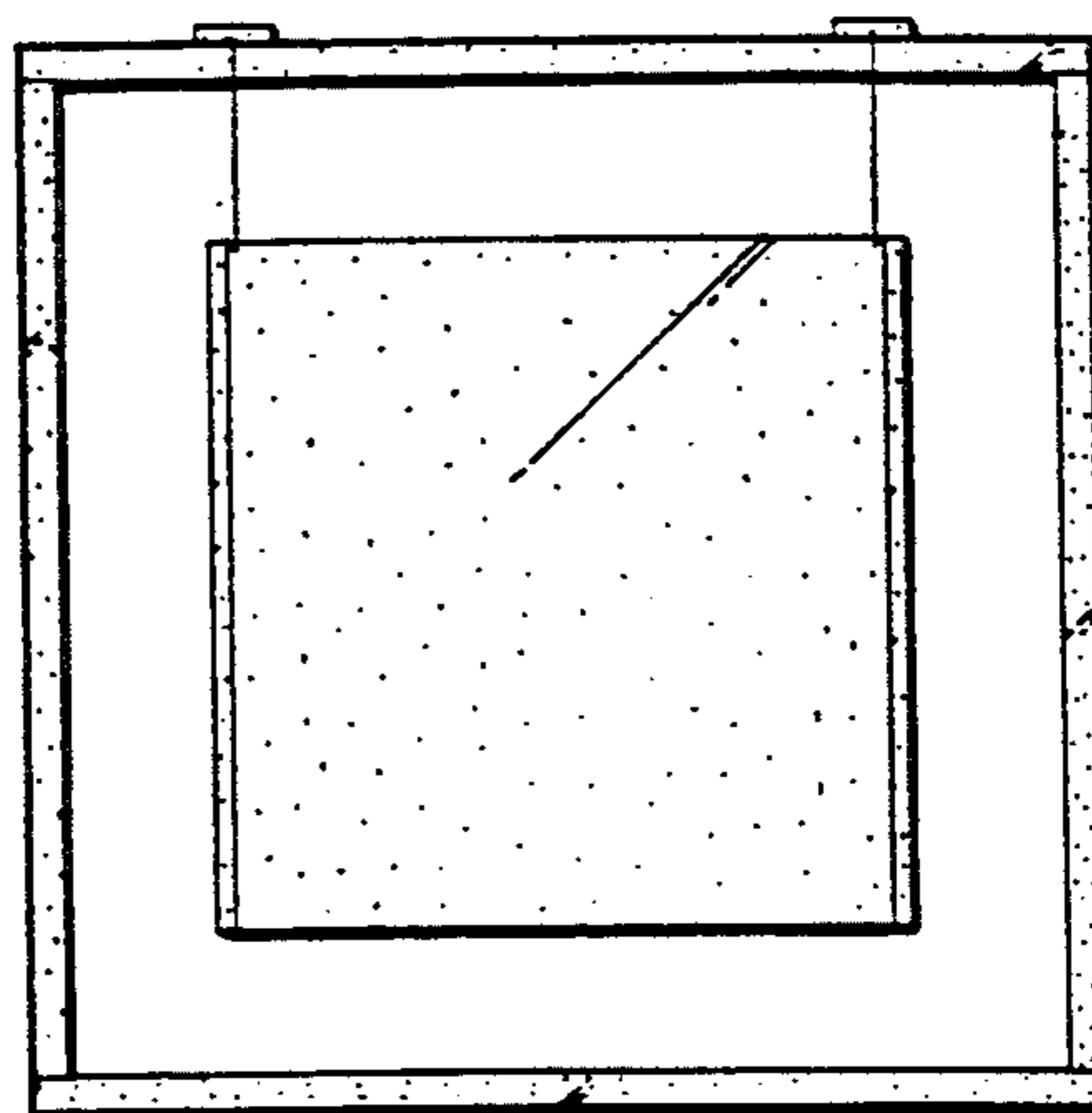

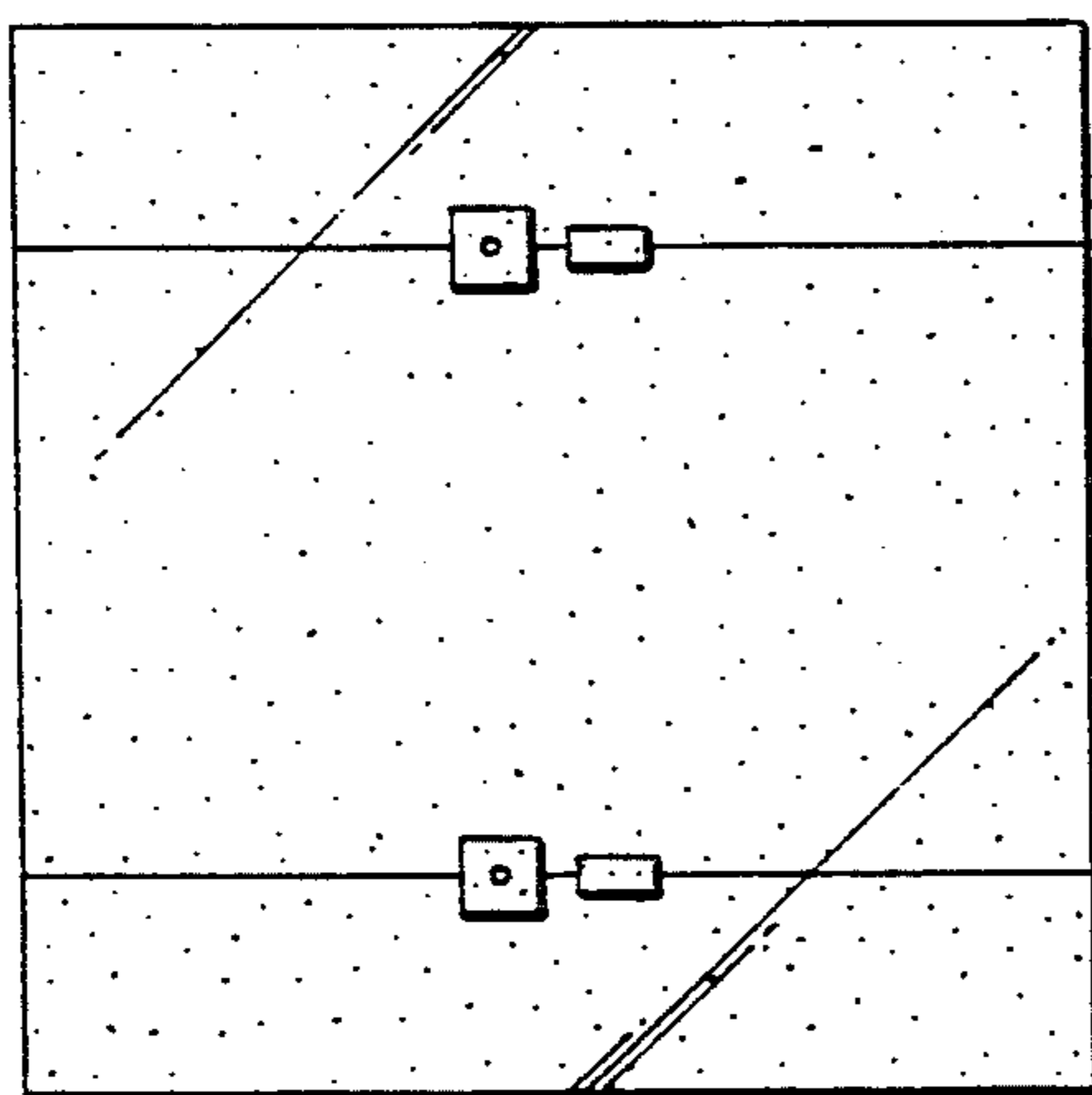

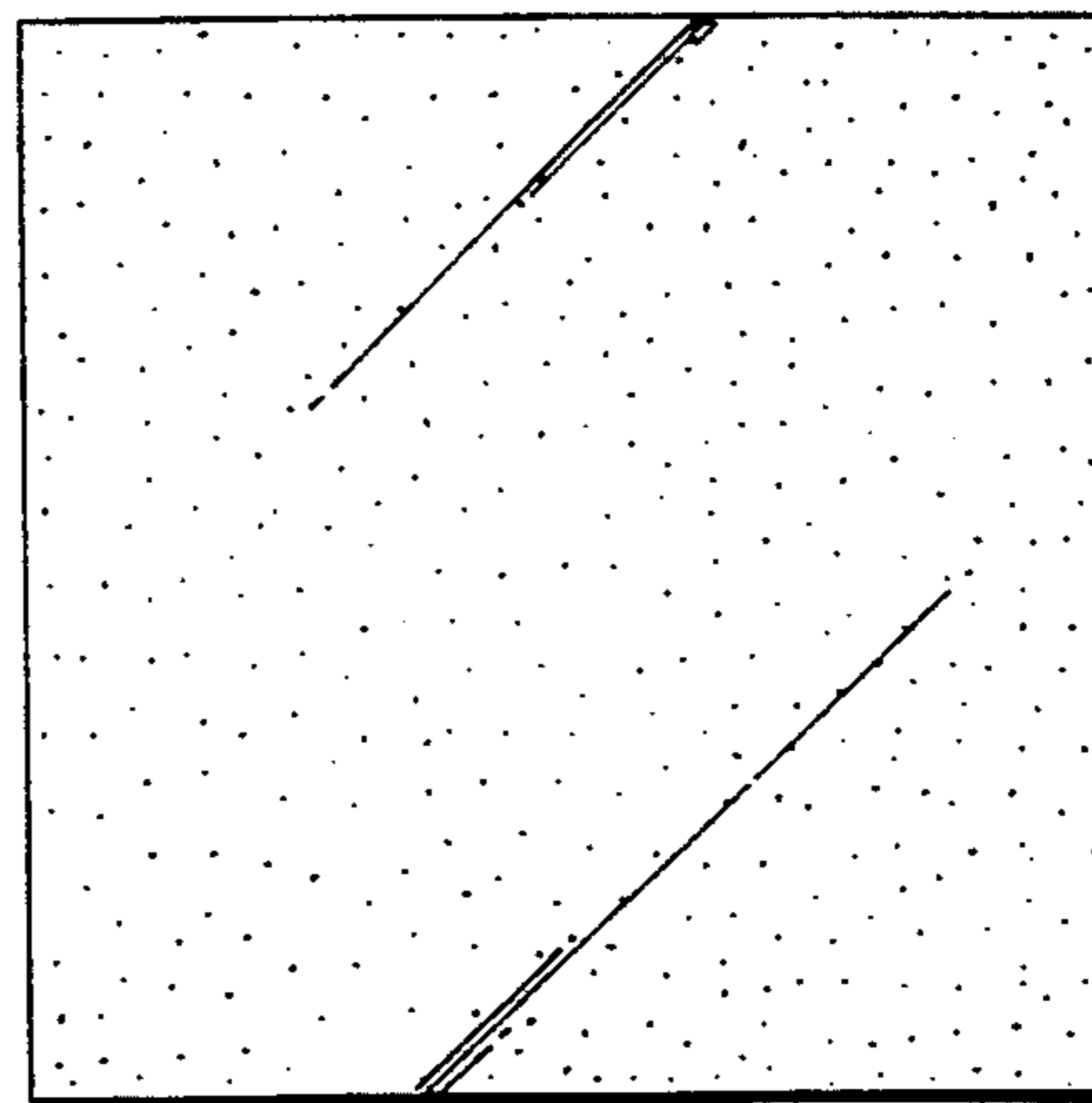

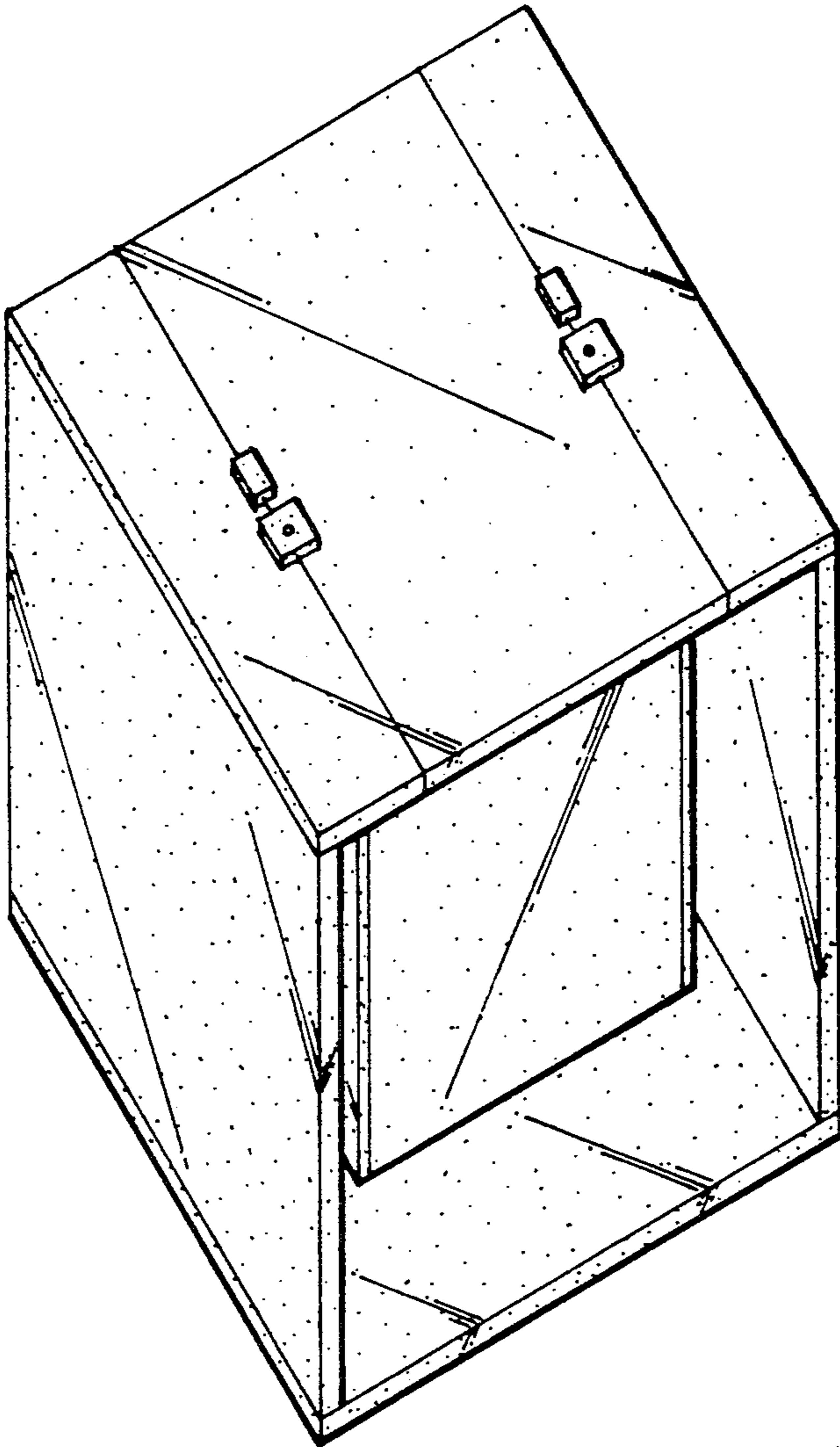
