nated sculpture showing my new design;

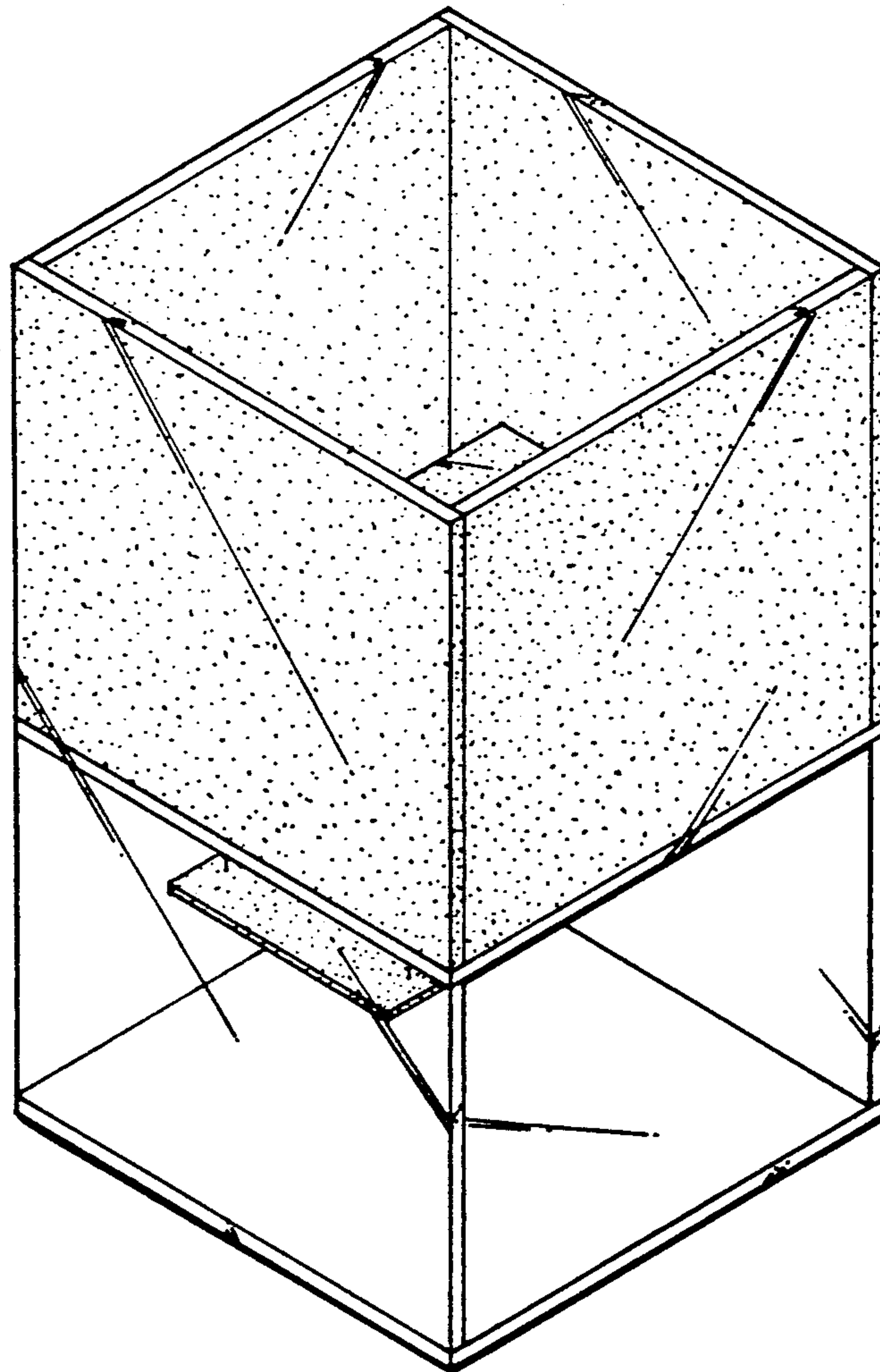
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged

The stippled surfaces of the design are translucent.



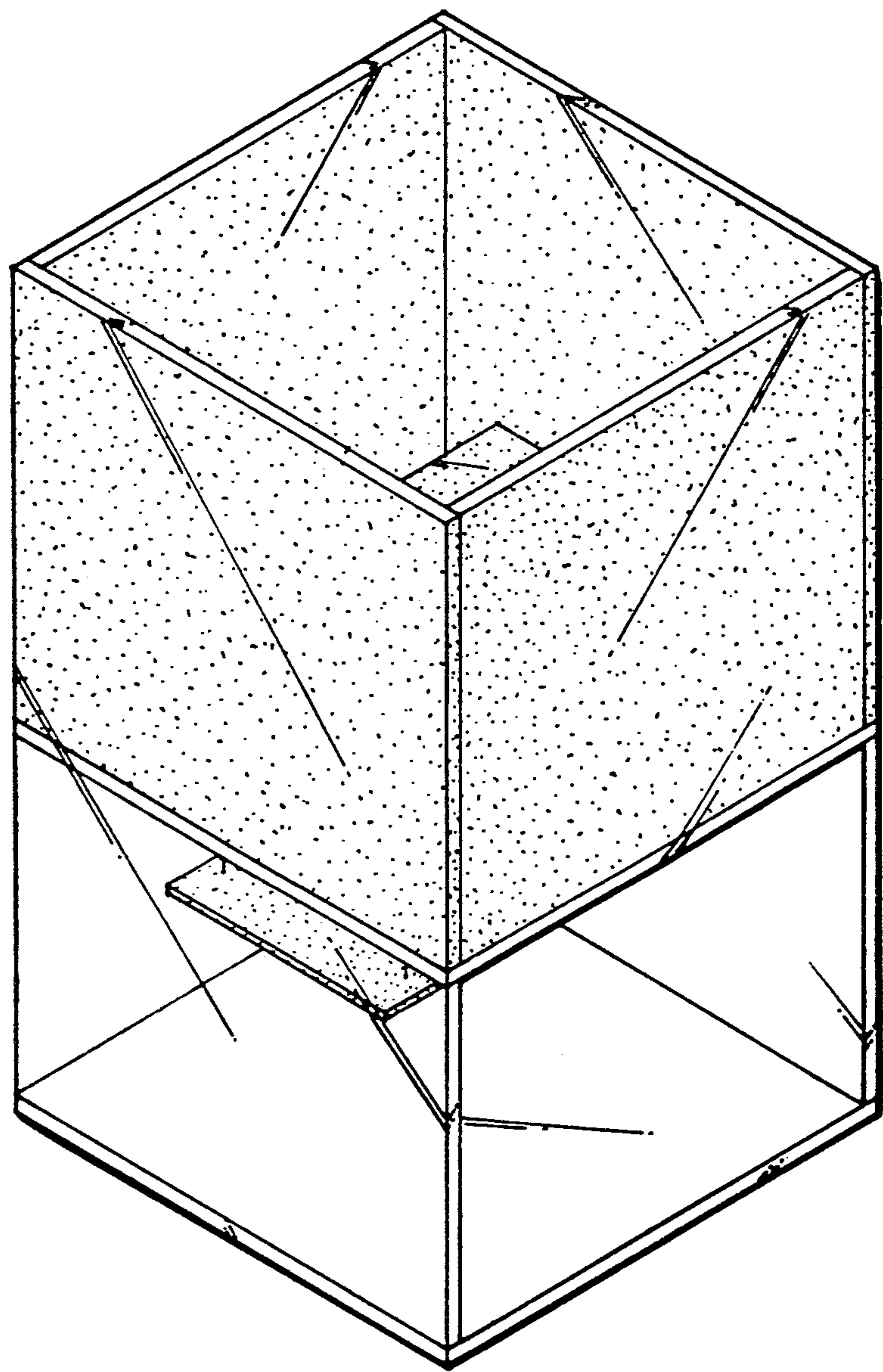

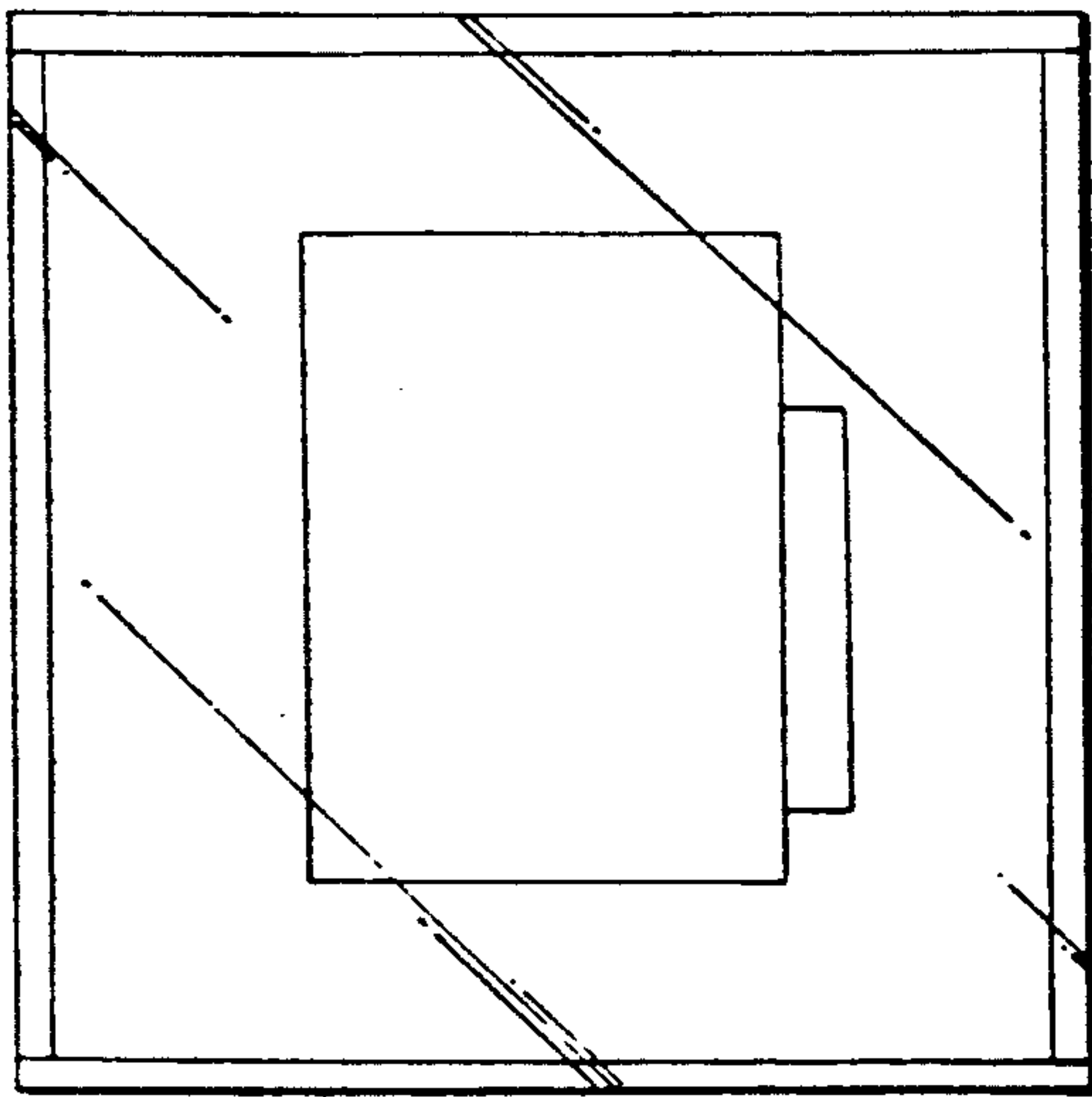

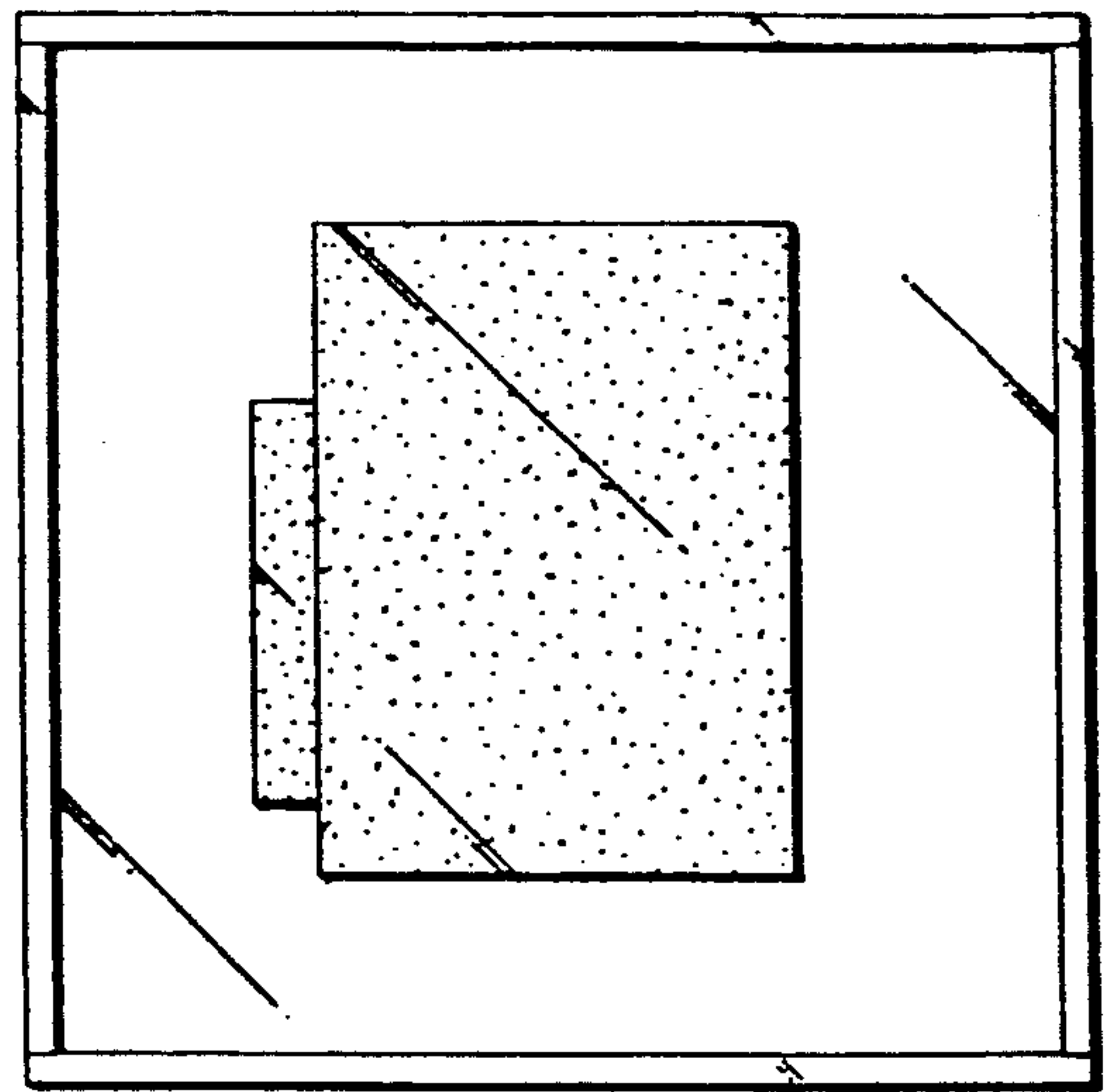

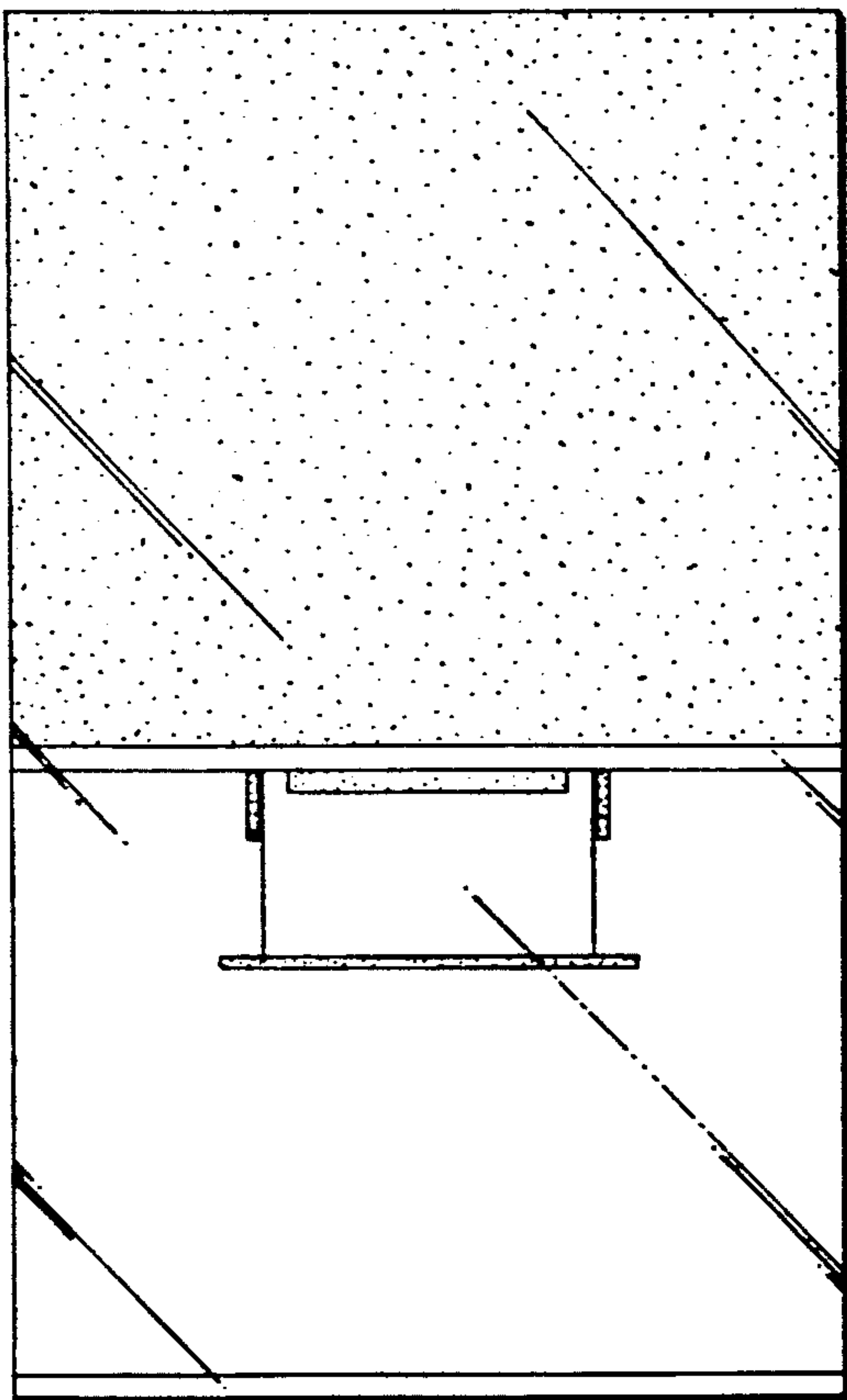

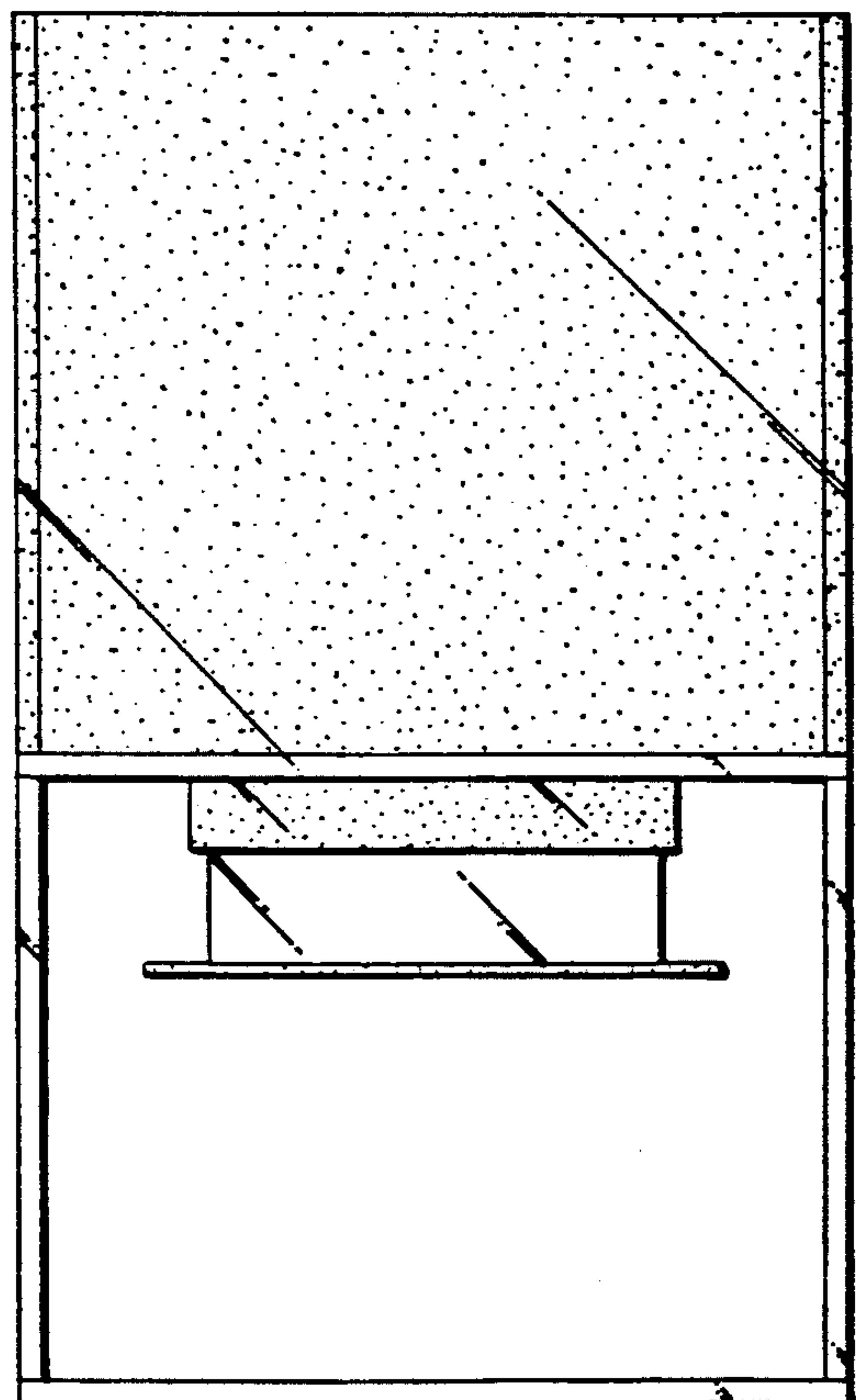
